FIG. 3 is a side elevational view;

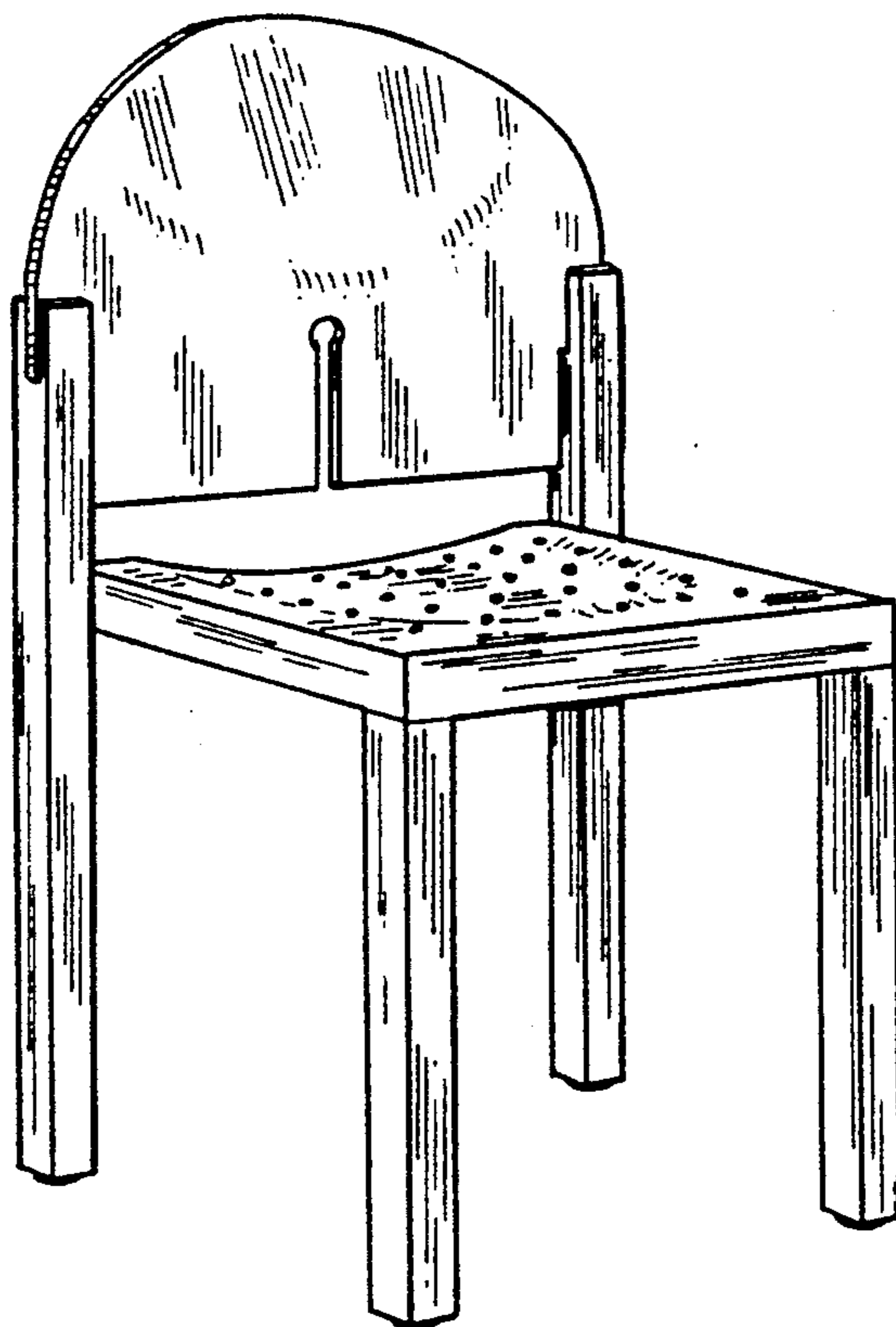
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view; and

FIG. 8 is a front perspective view of a third embodiment of the chair showing my new design.



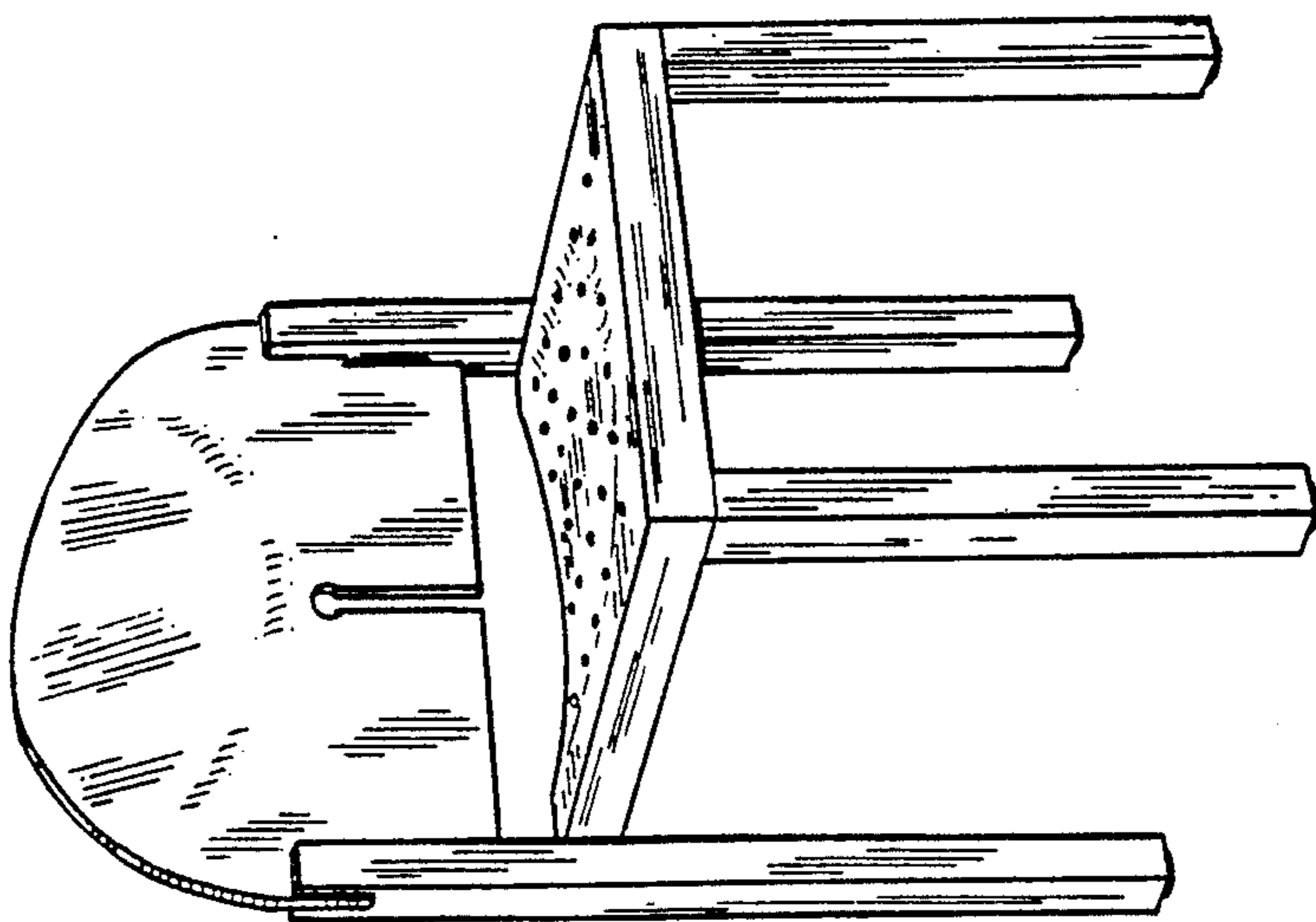

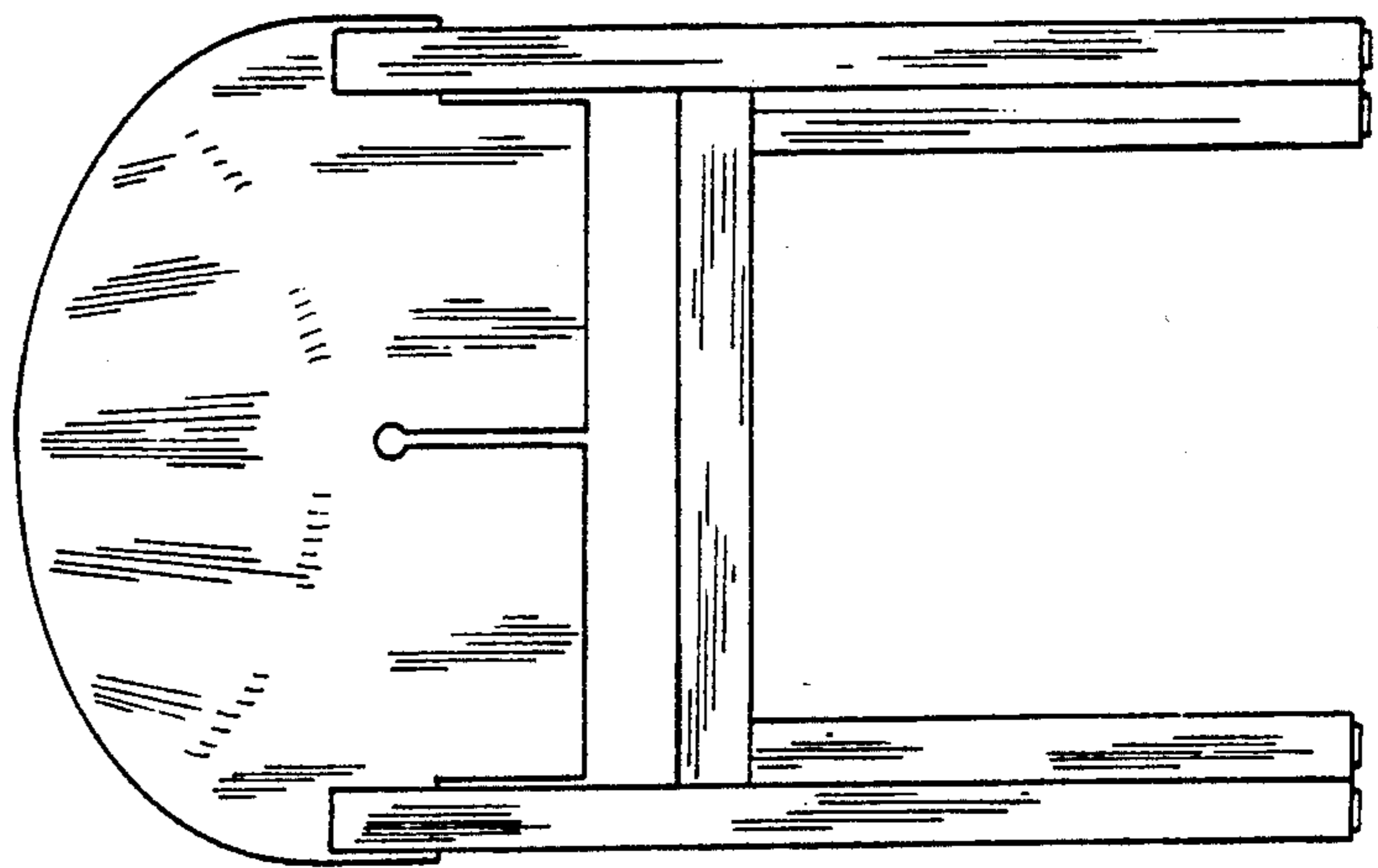

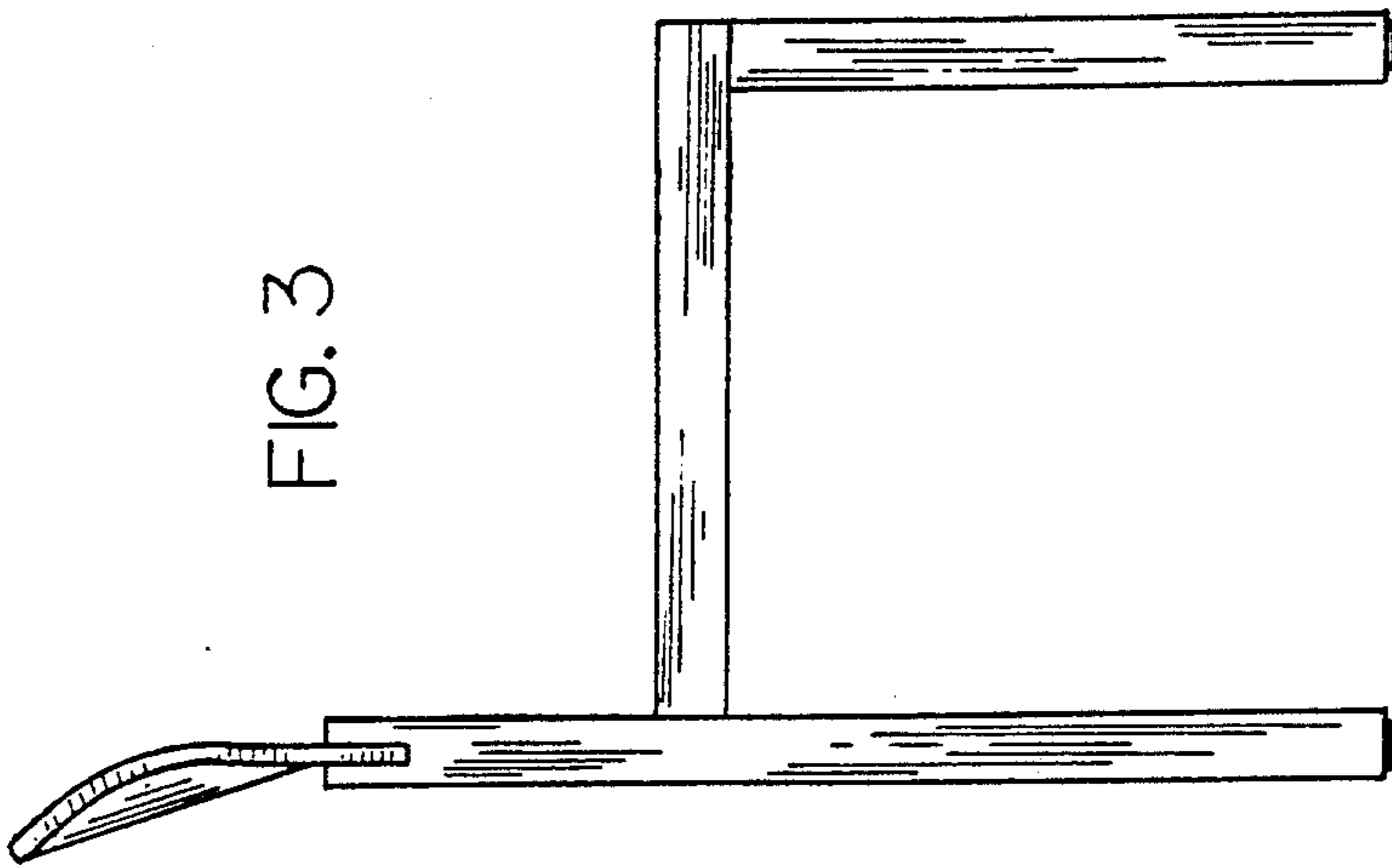

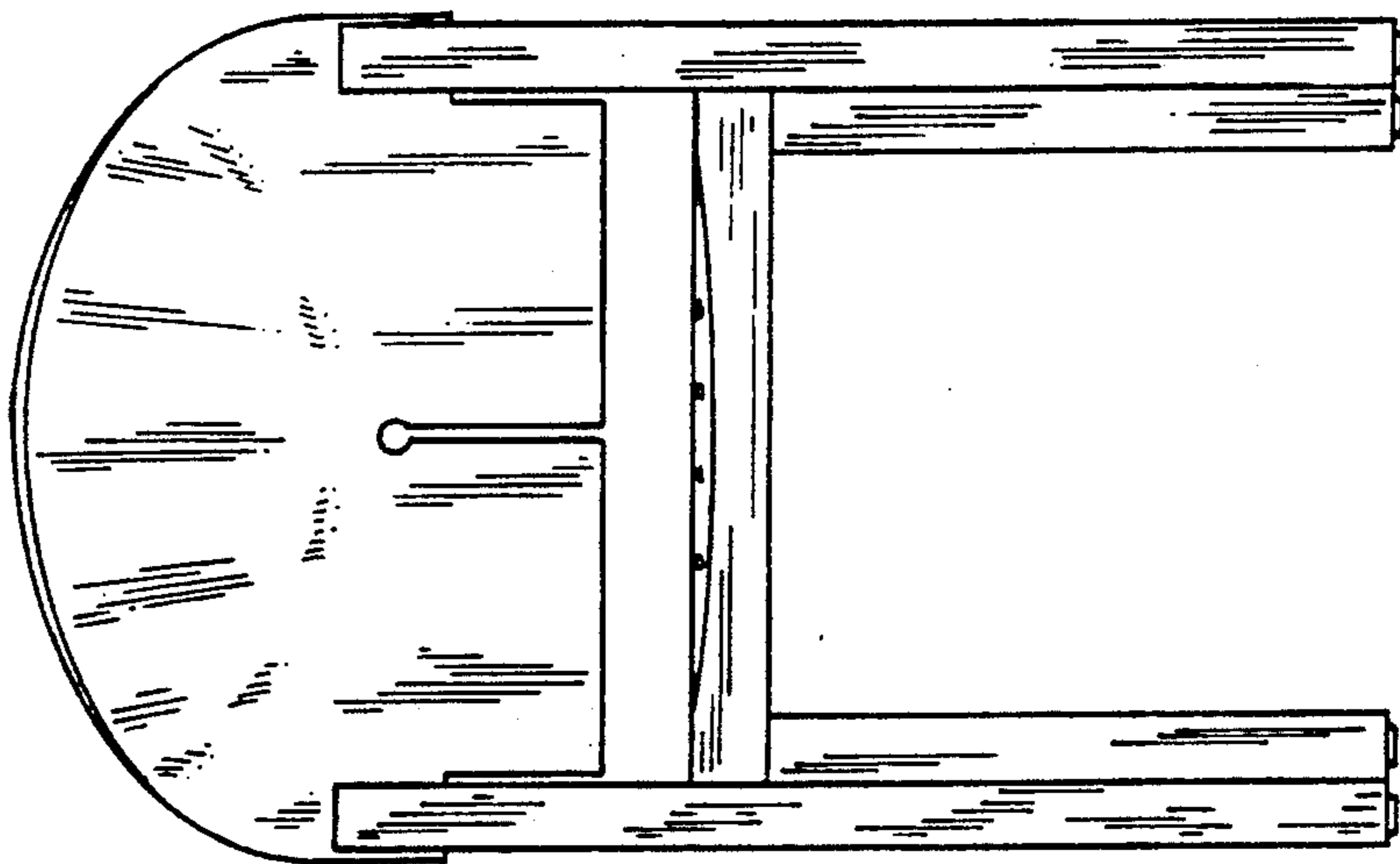

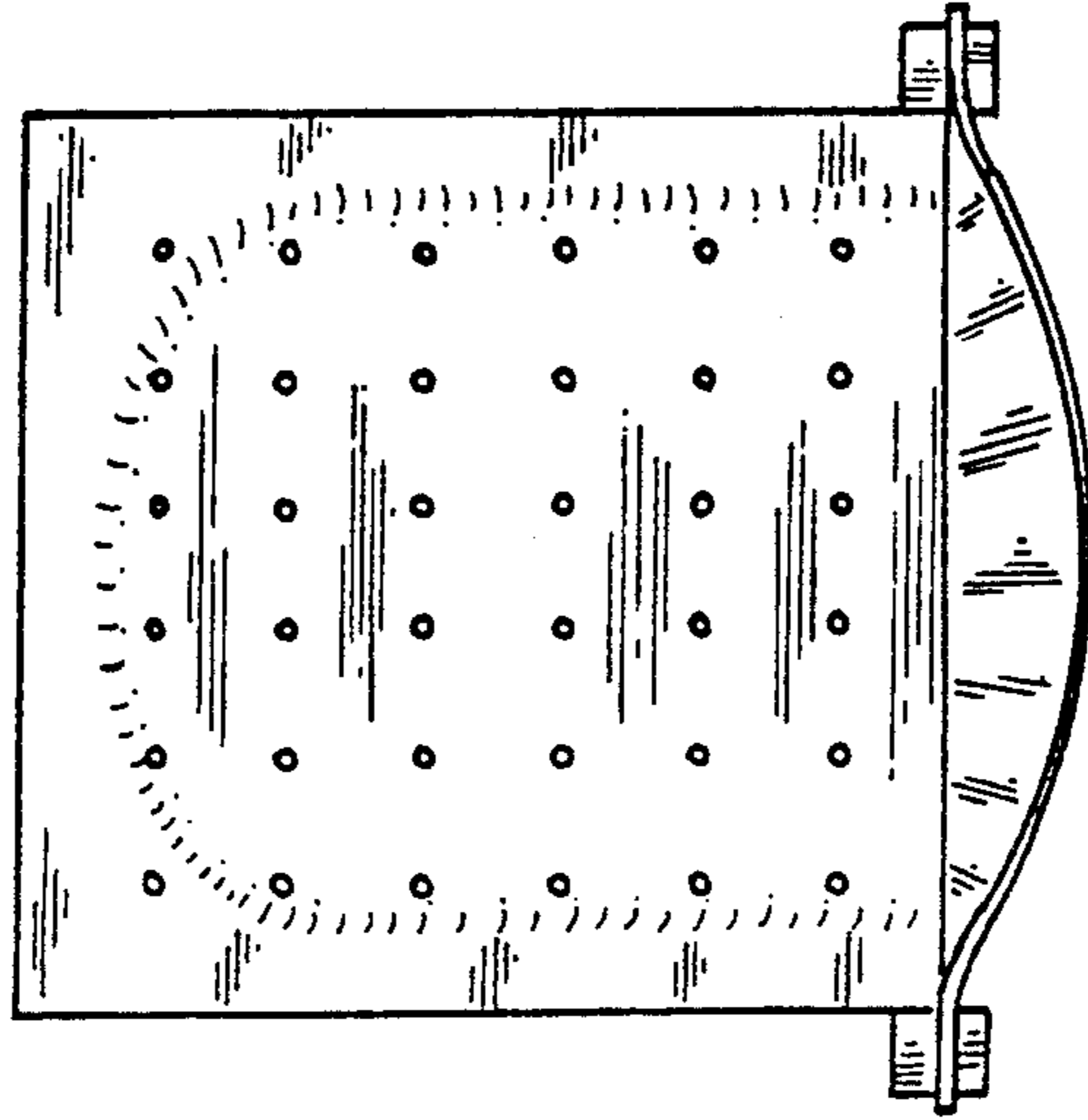

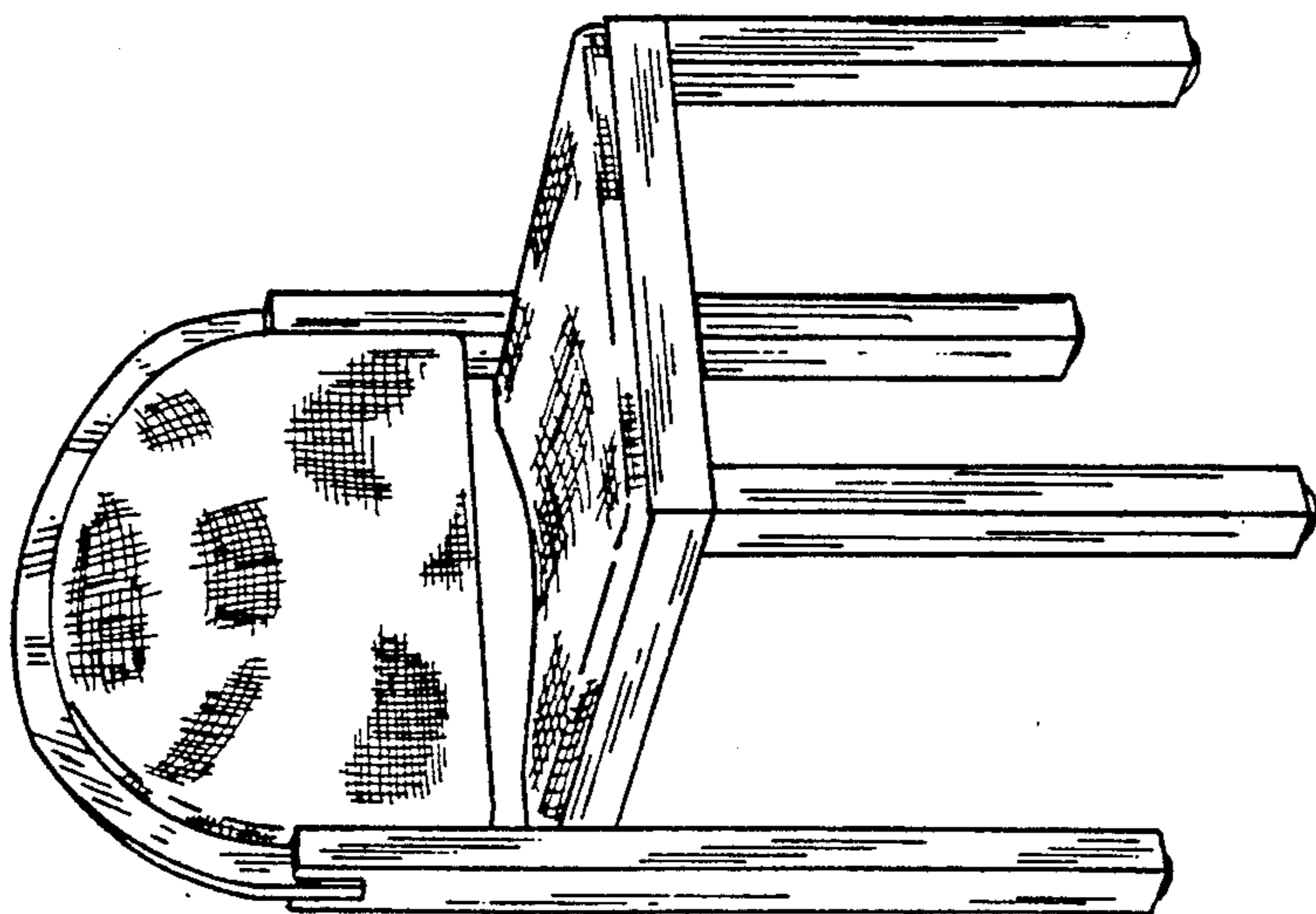

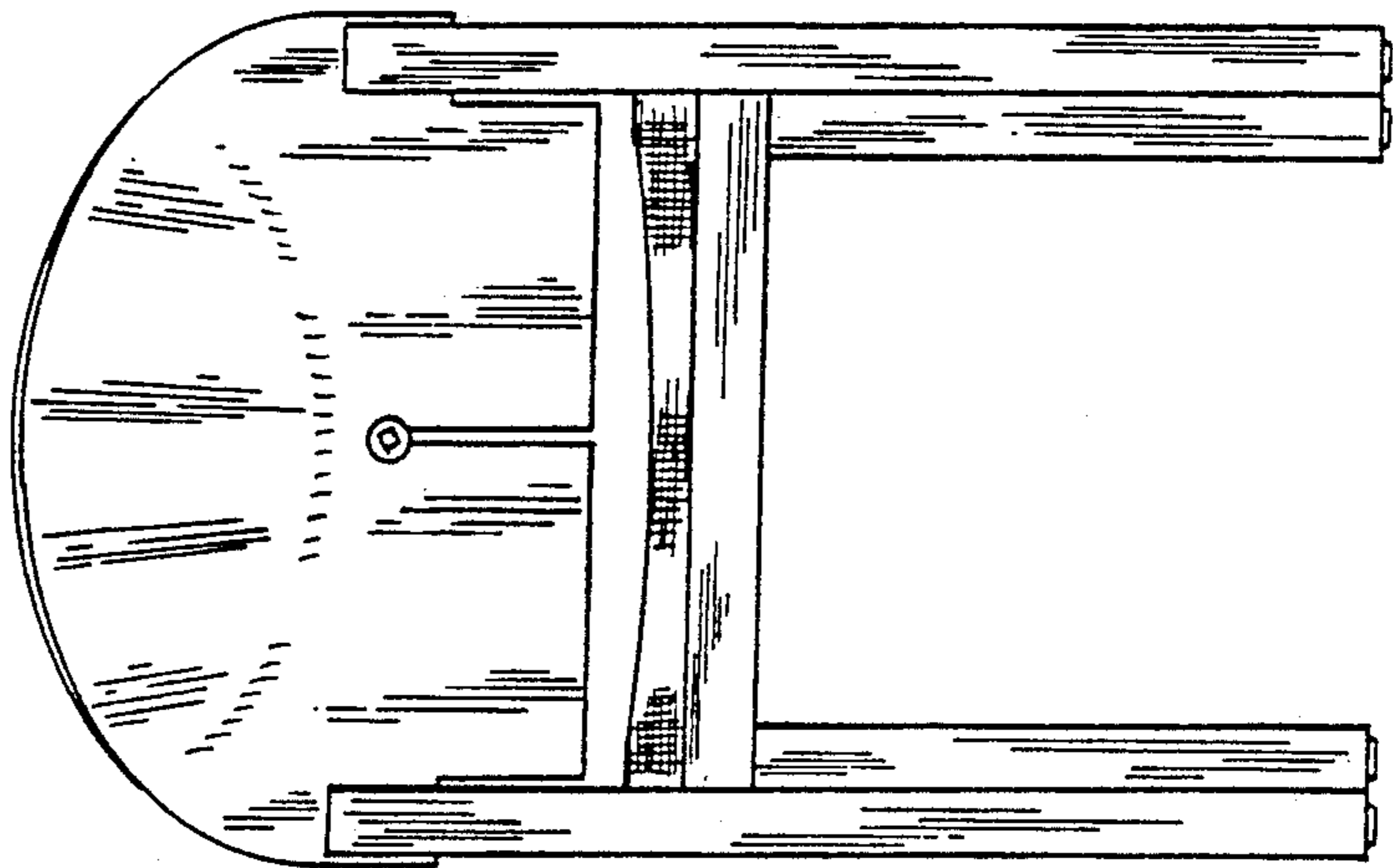

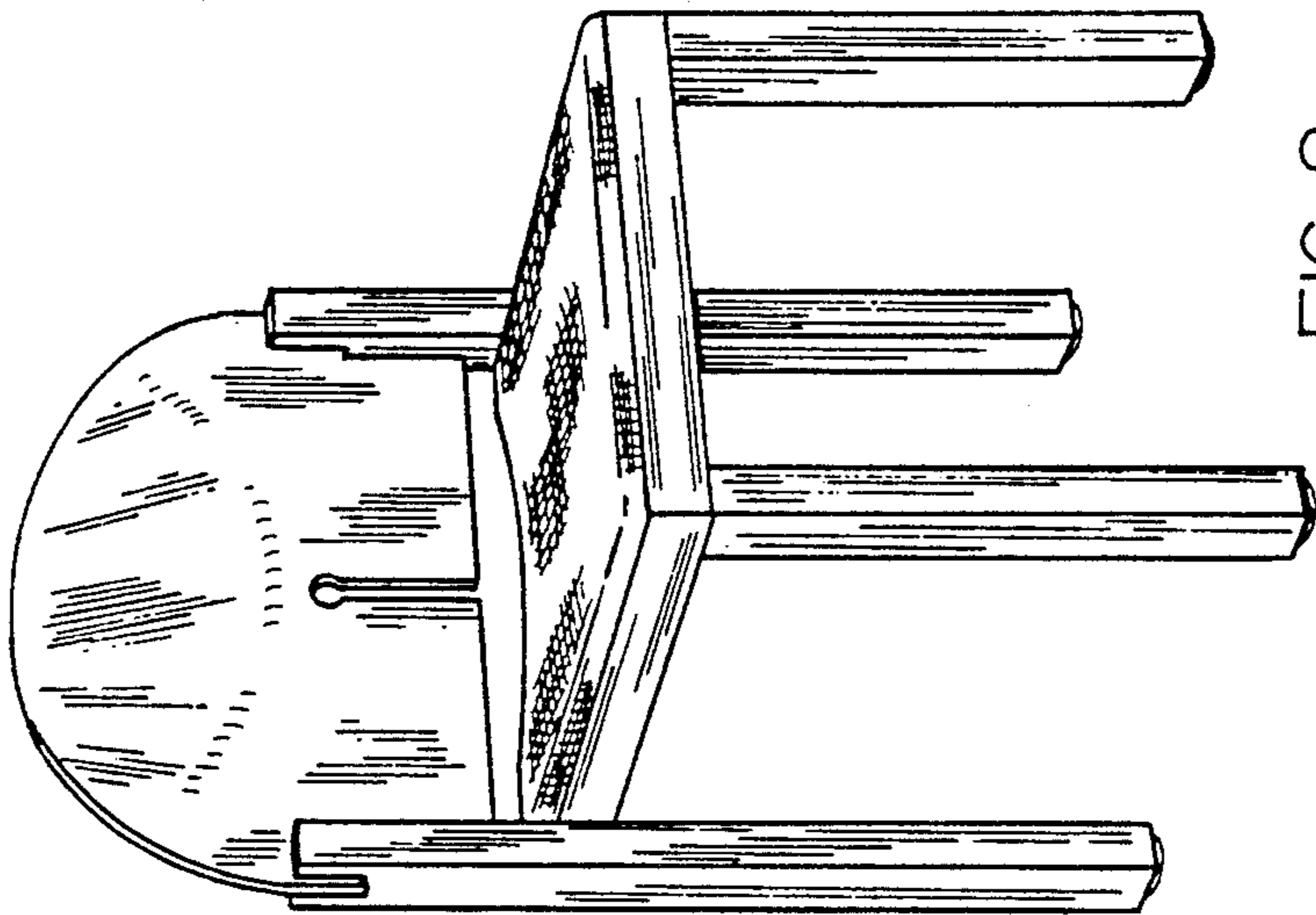
