


[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a stand for remote control units, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a stand for remote control units showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is an elevational view, the other sides being identical thereto; FIG. 5 is a perspective view, the broken line showing of control units is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design; FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the stand for remote control units shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 9 is a front elevational view, the rear view being identical thereto; FIG. 10 is a left side elevational view, the right side being identical thereto; and FIG. 11 is a perspective view, the broken line showing of control units is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
























