[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a thermal carafe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a thermal carafe showing our new design; the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 5 is an exploded perspective view thereof. The undisclosed bottom surface is conventional in appearance.

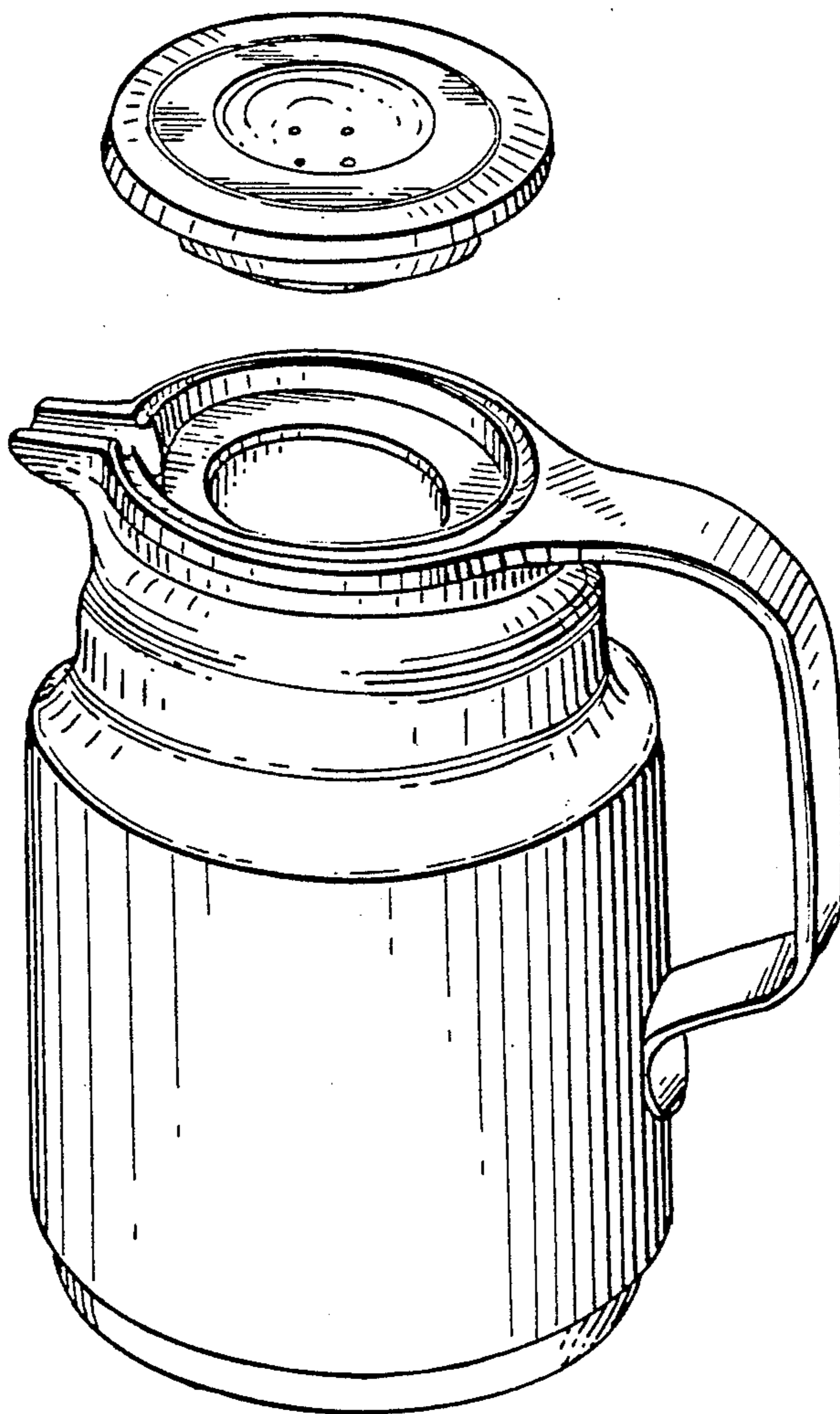

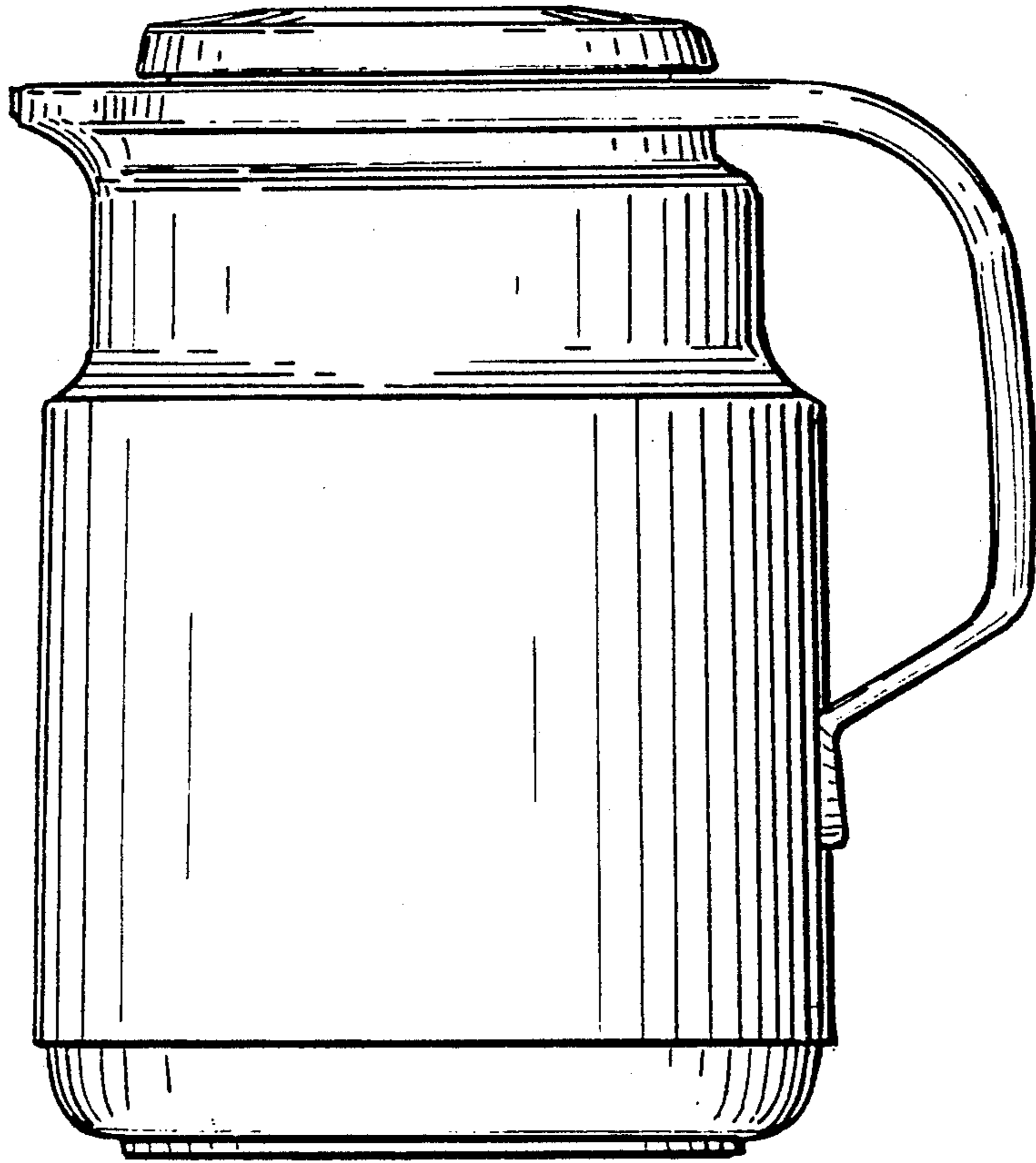

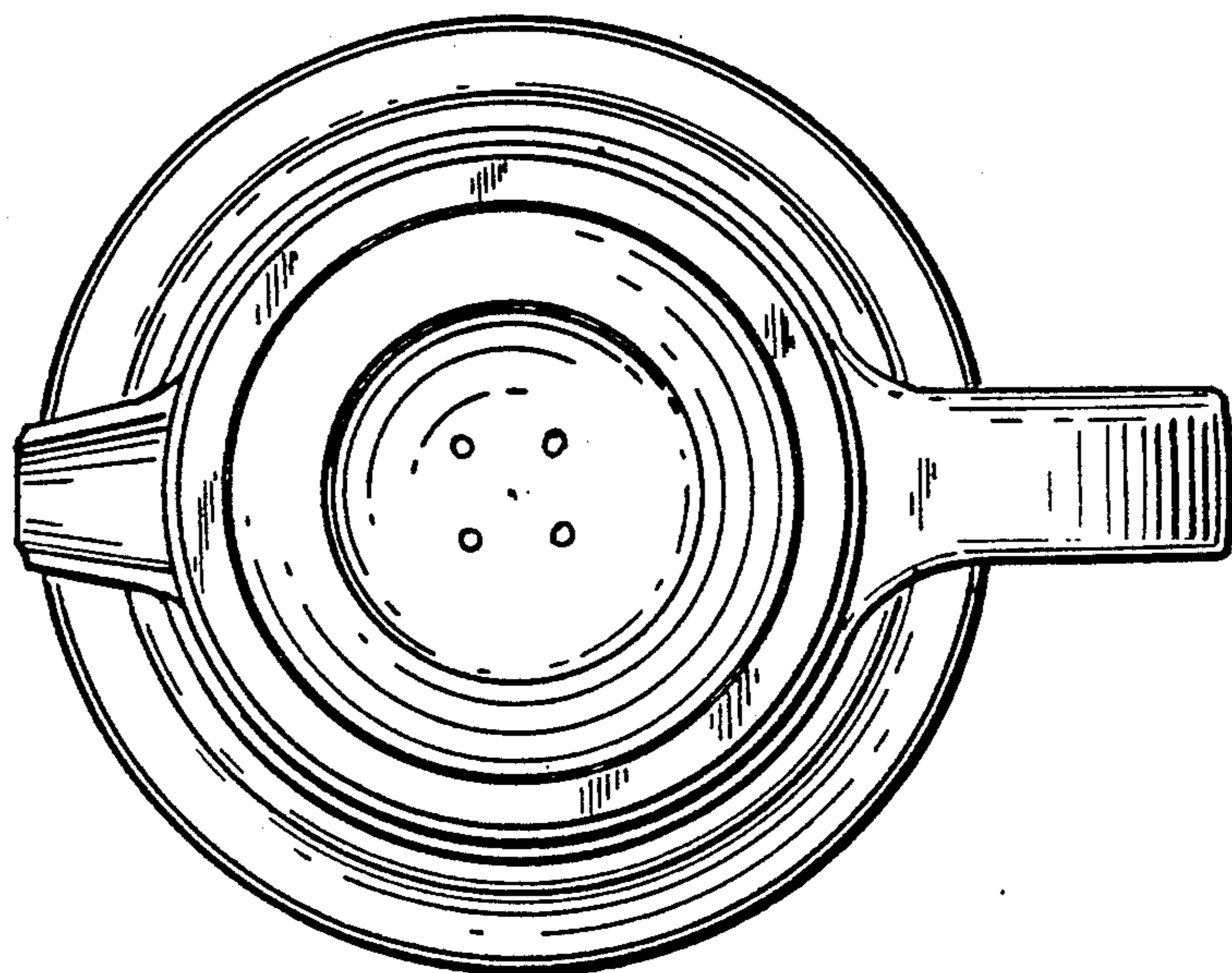

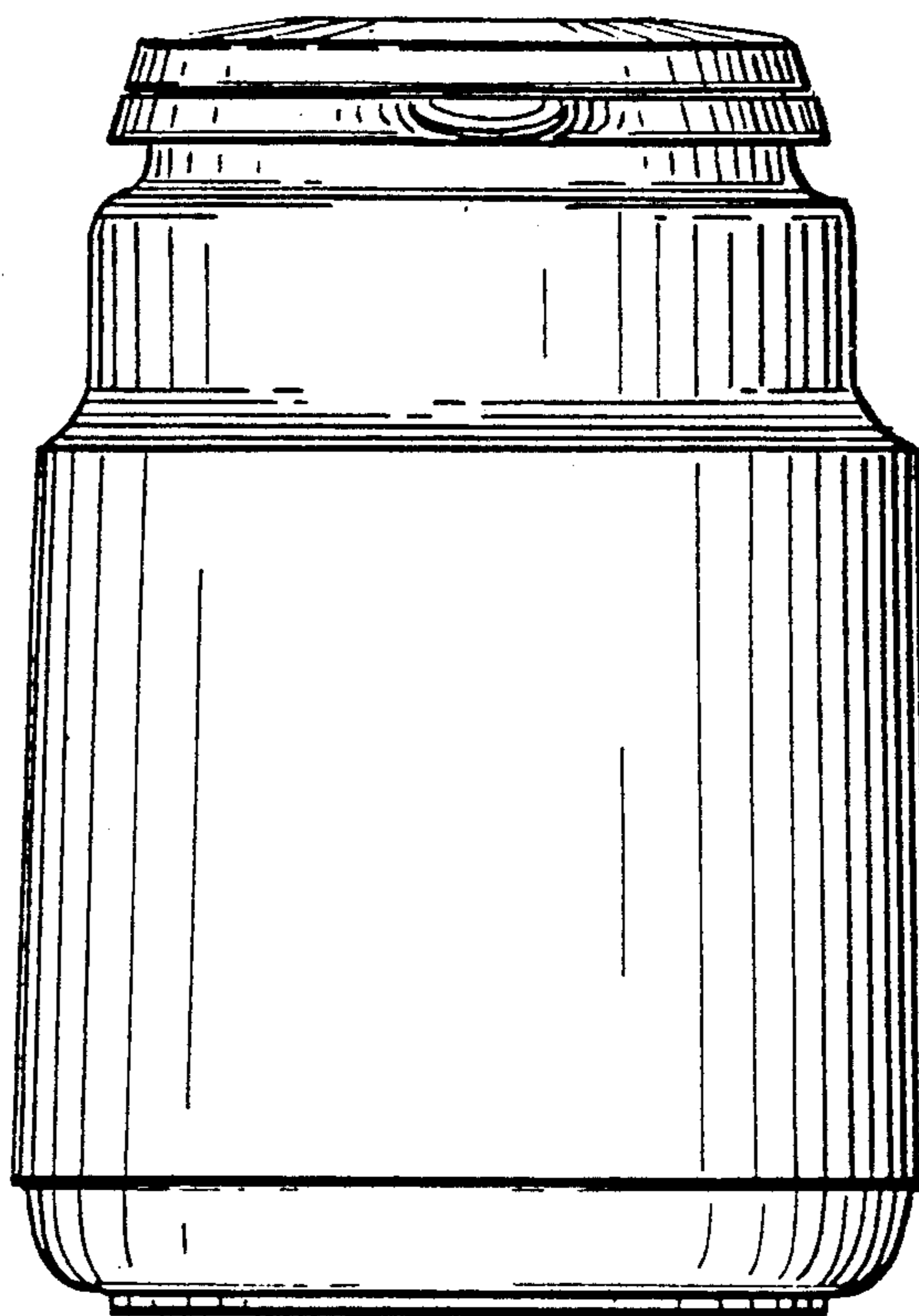

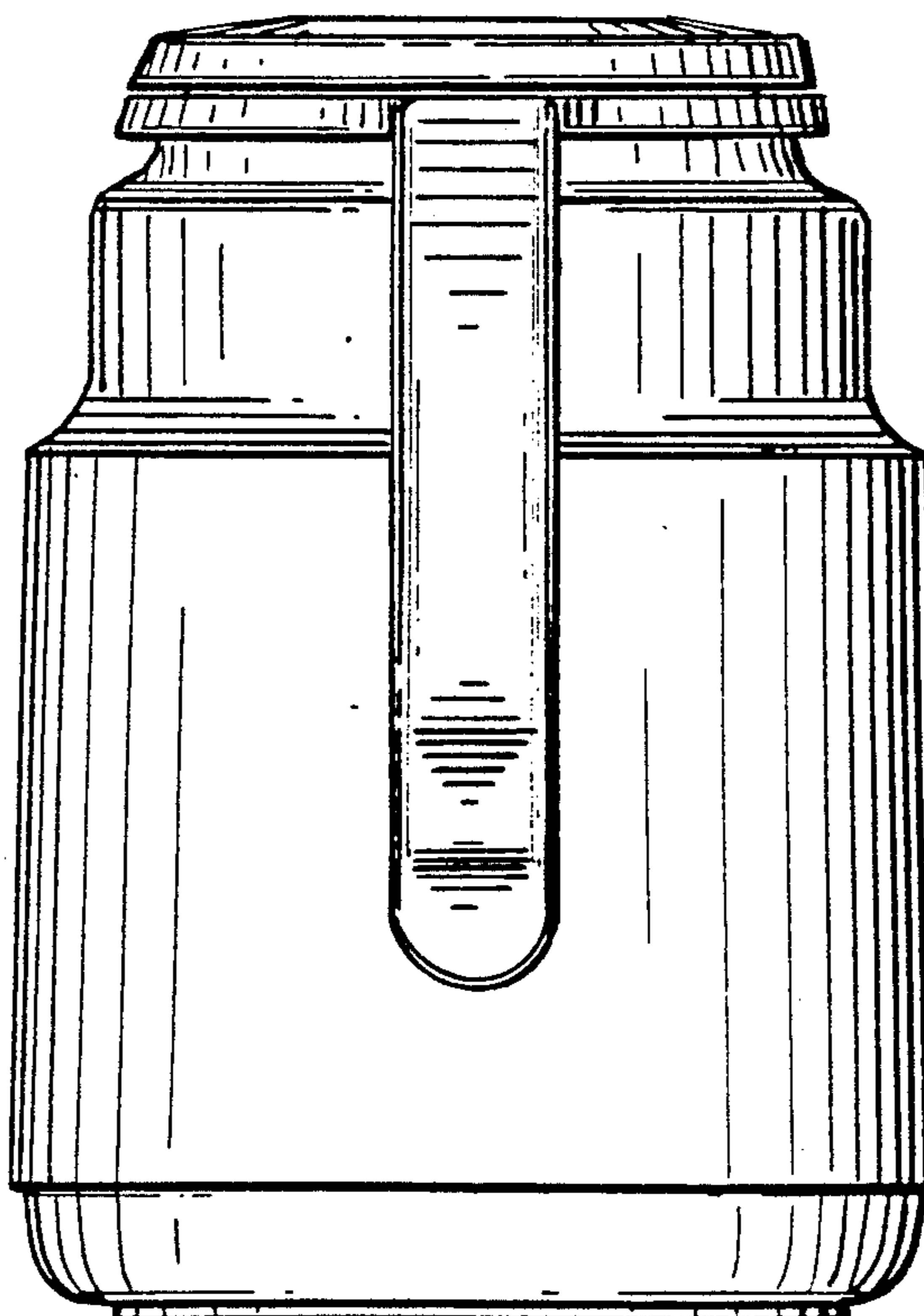
