identical;

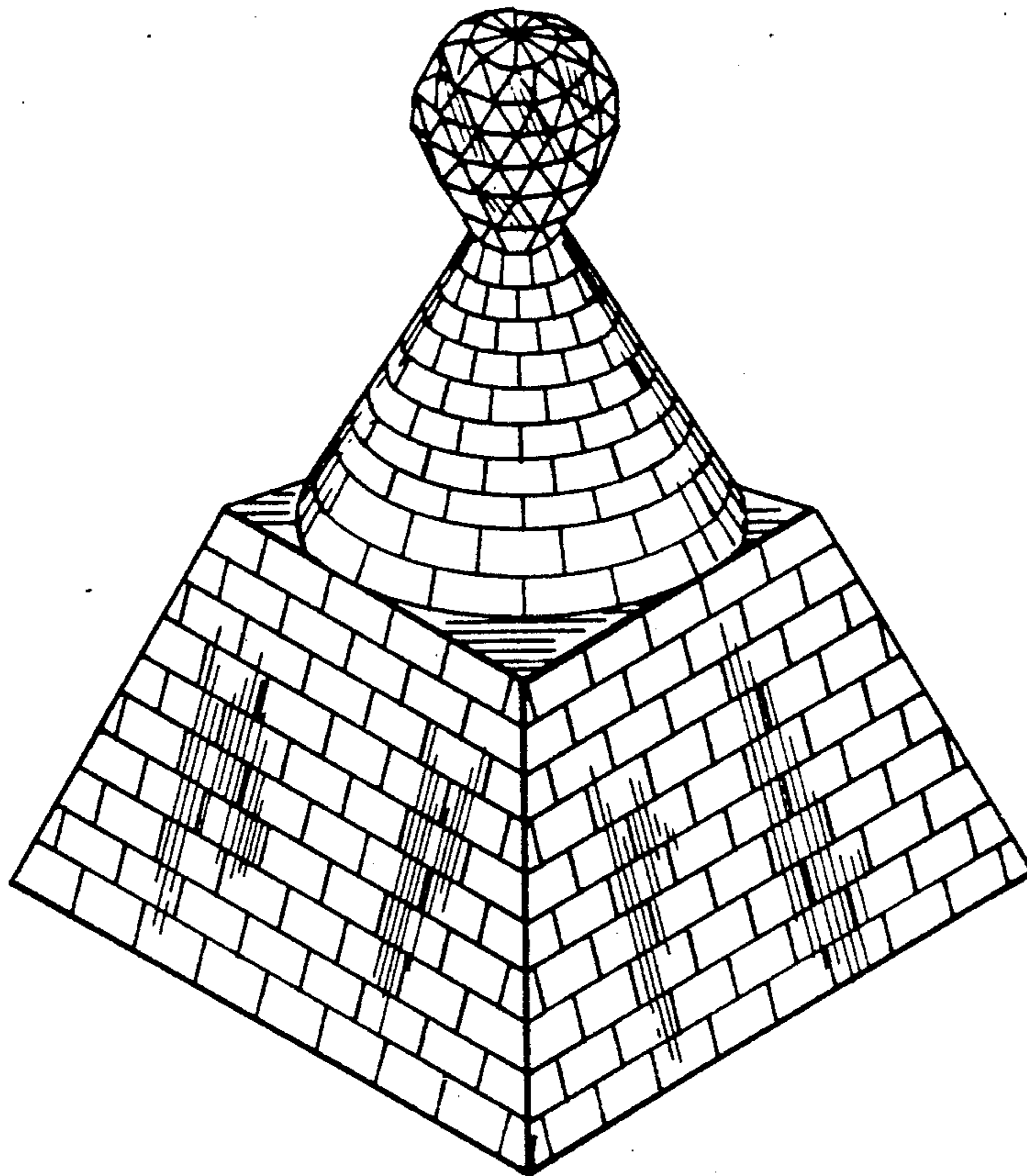
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

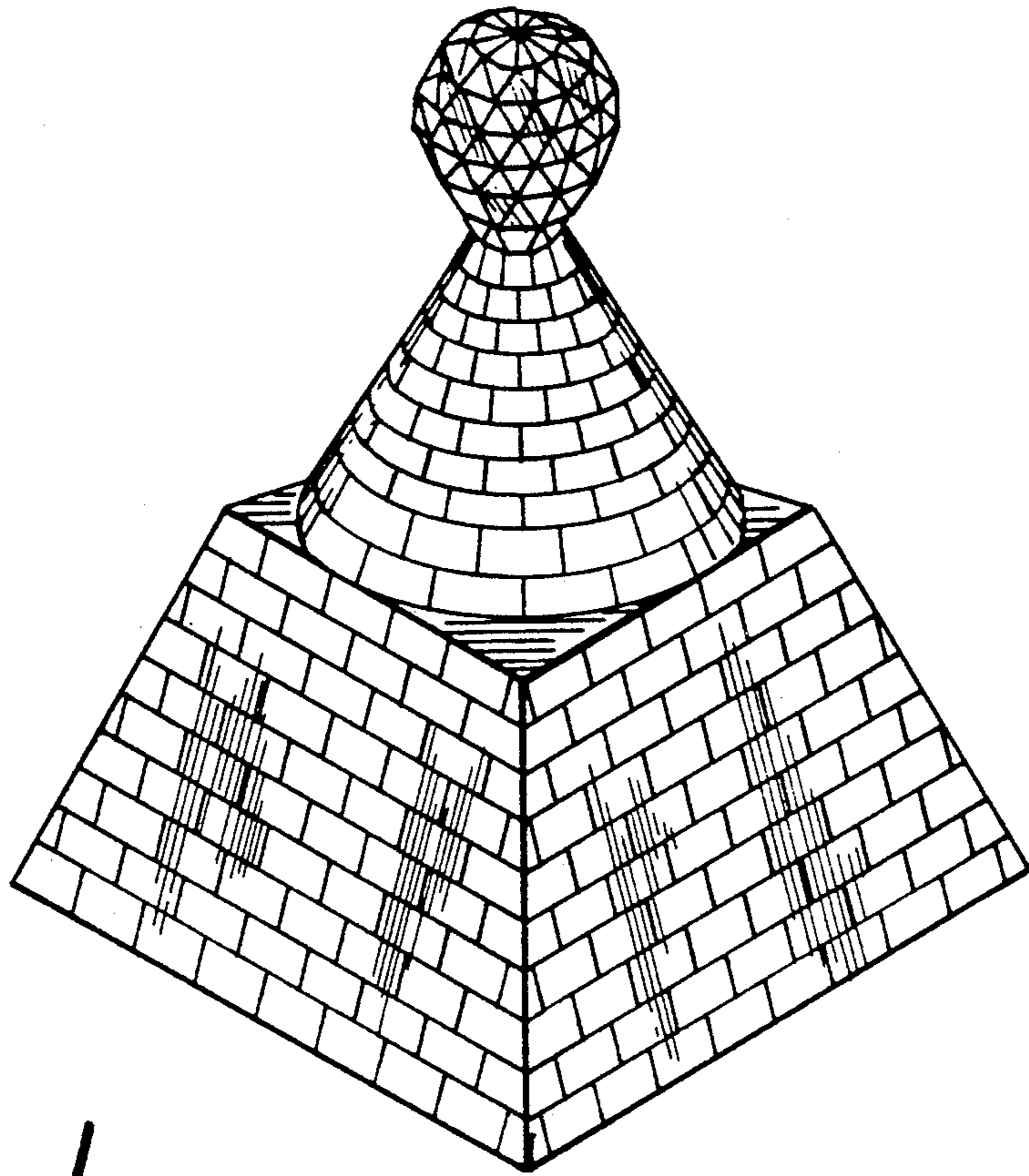

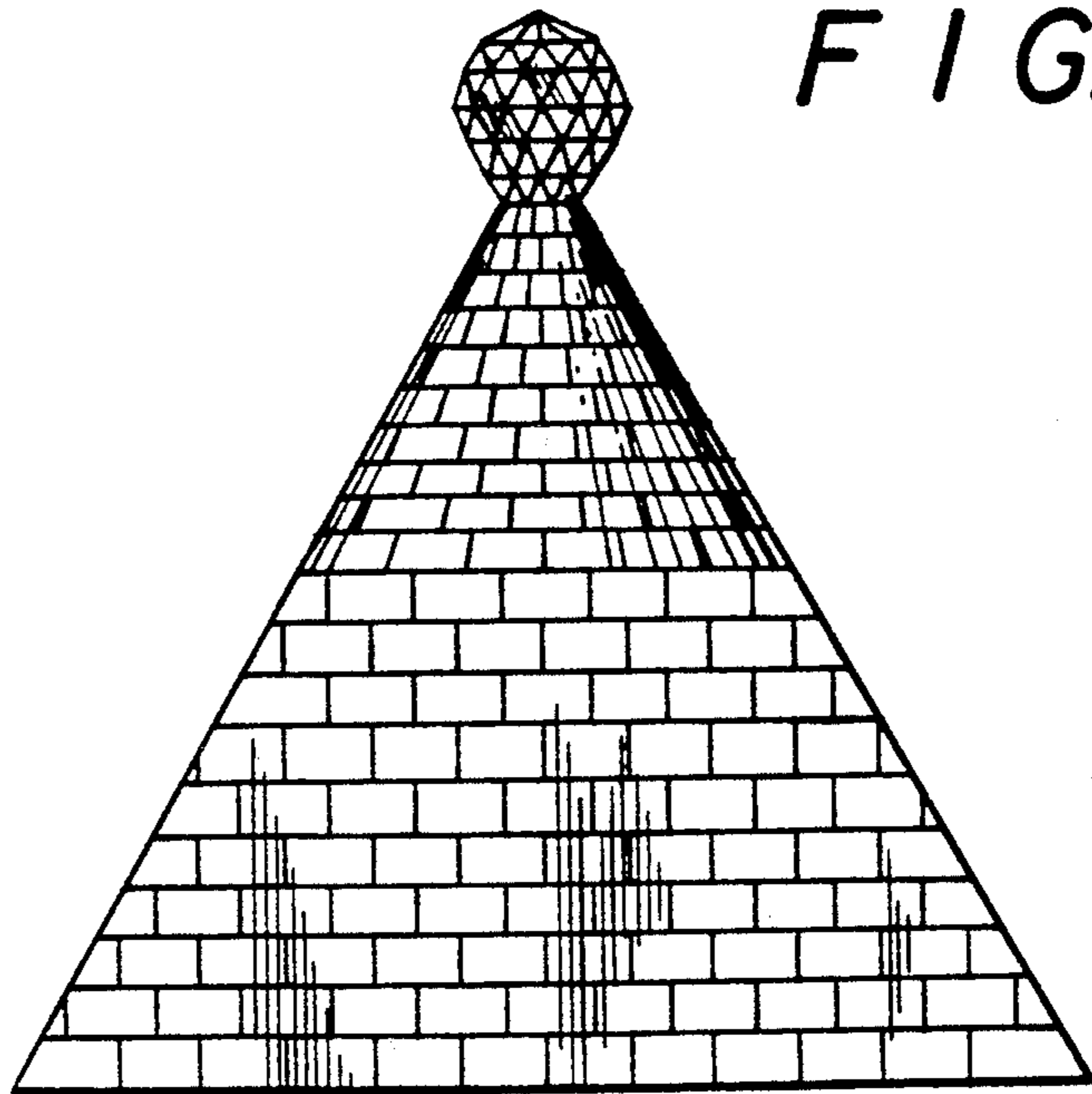

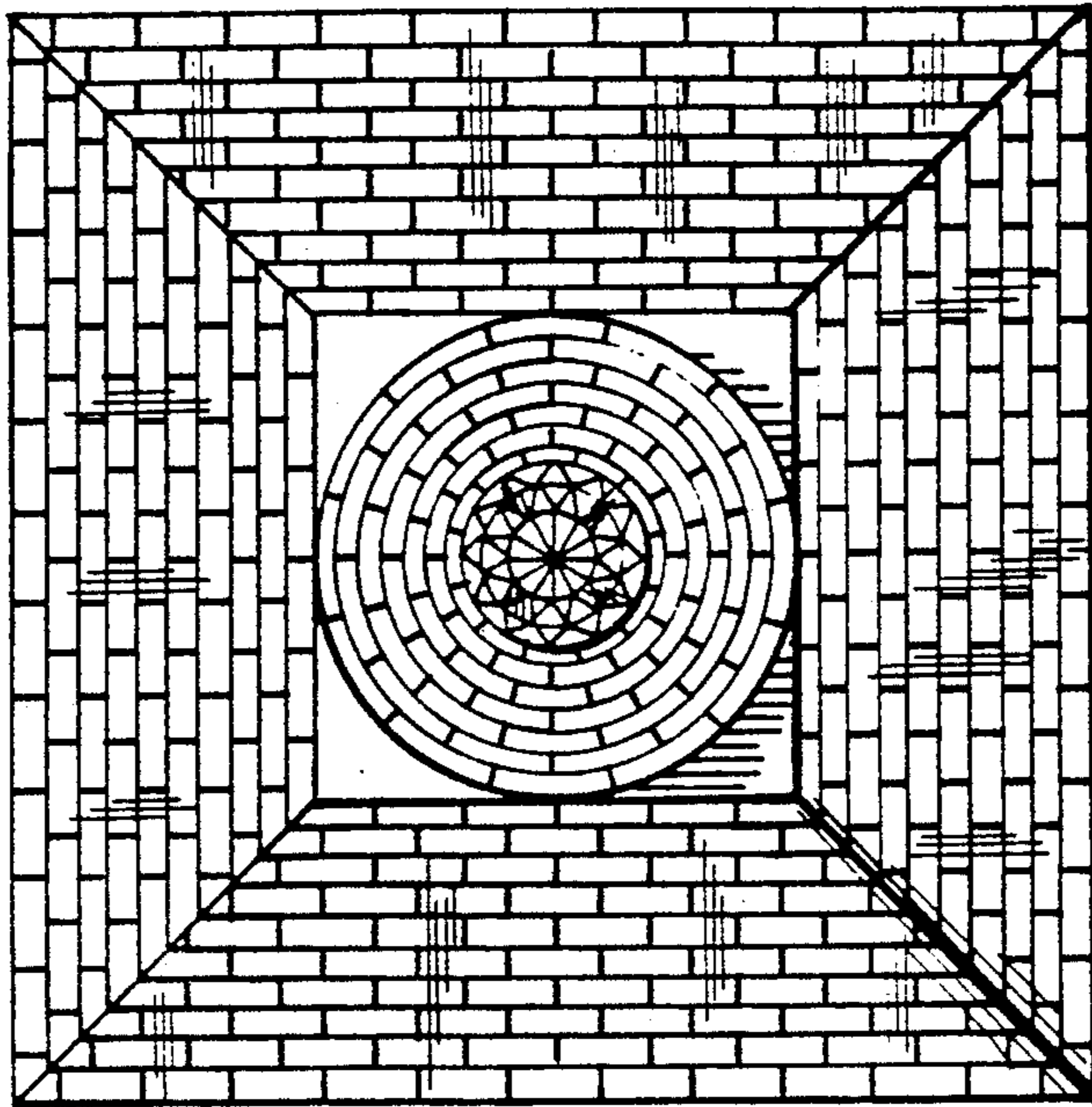

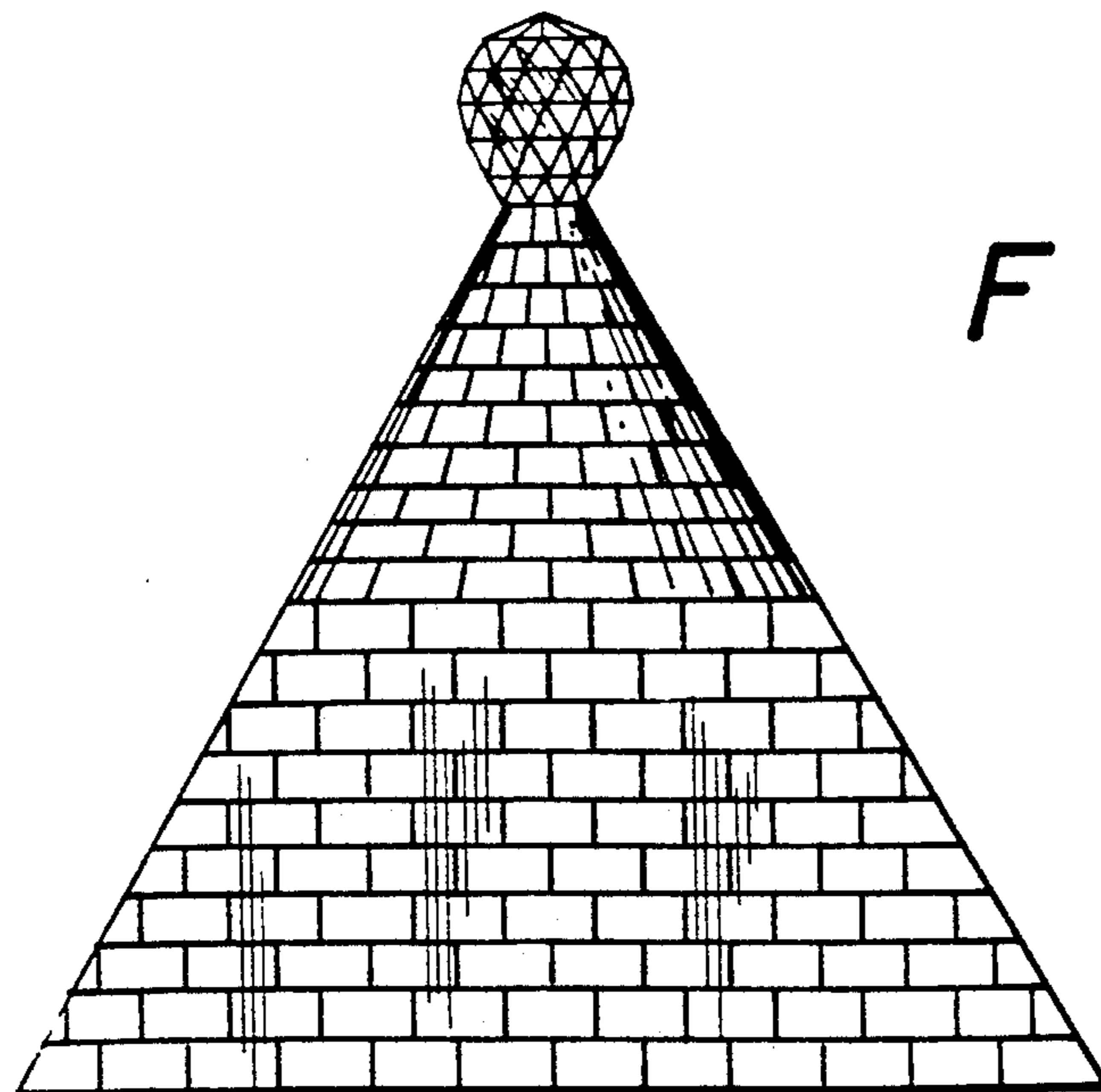
