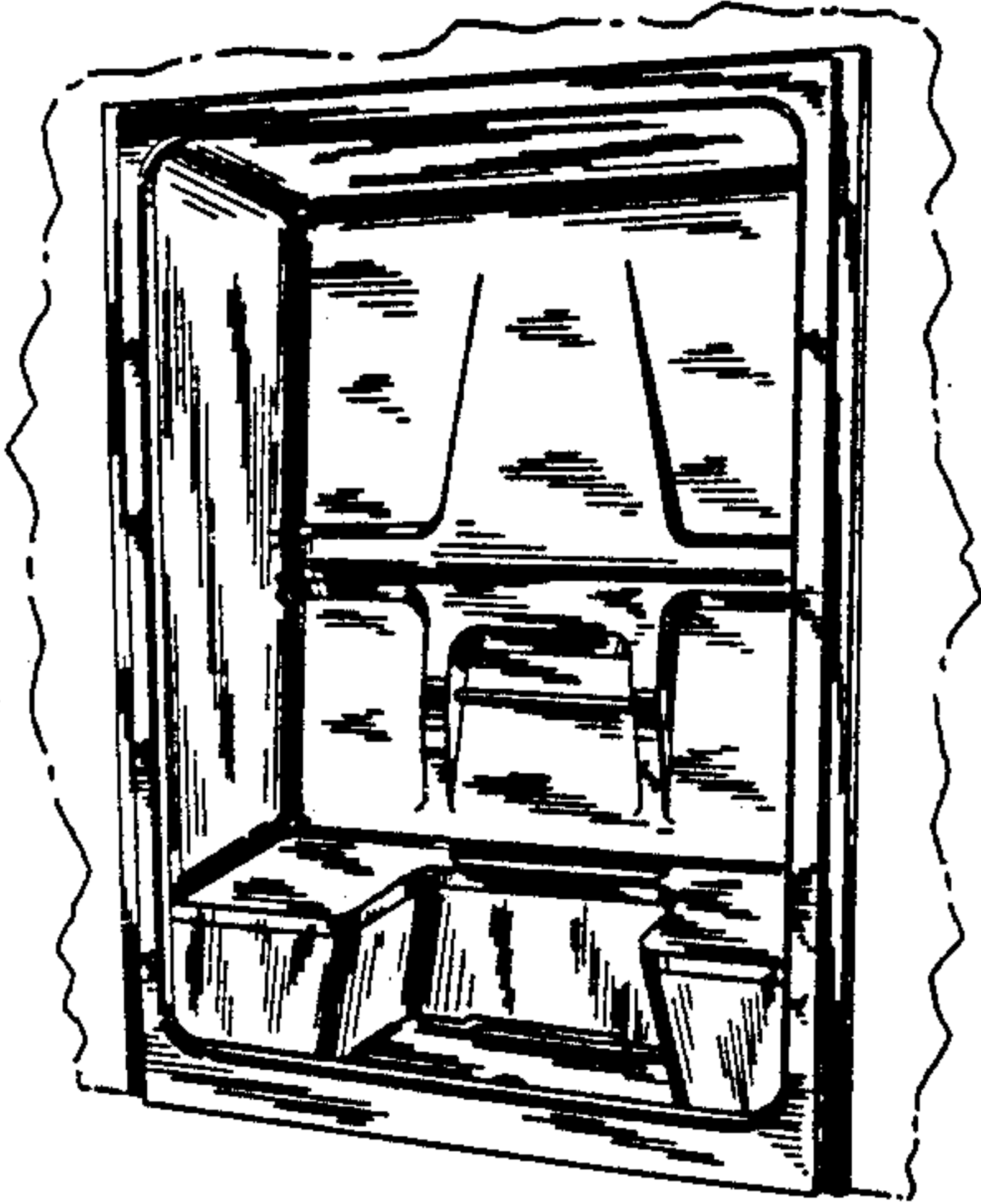

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shower stall or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of a shower stall or the like showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 3—3 of FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 2;
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 2;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 9 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment thereof;
FIG. 11 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 11—11 of FIG. 10;
FIG. 12 is a front elevational view of a third embodiment thereof;
FIG. 13 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 13—13 of FIG. 12; and
FIG. 14 is a front elevational view of a fourth embodiment thereof.
The fragmentary broken line representation of a bathroom wall in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only and forms no part of the claimed design.



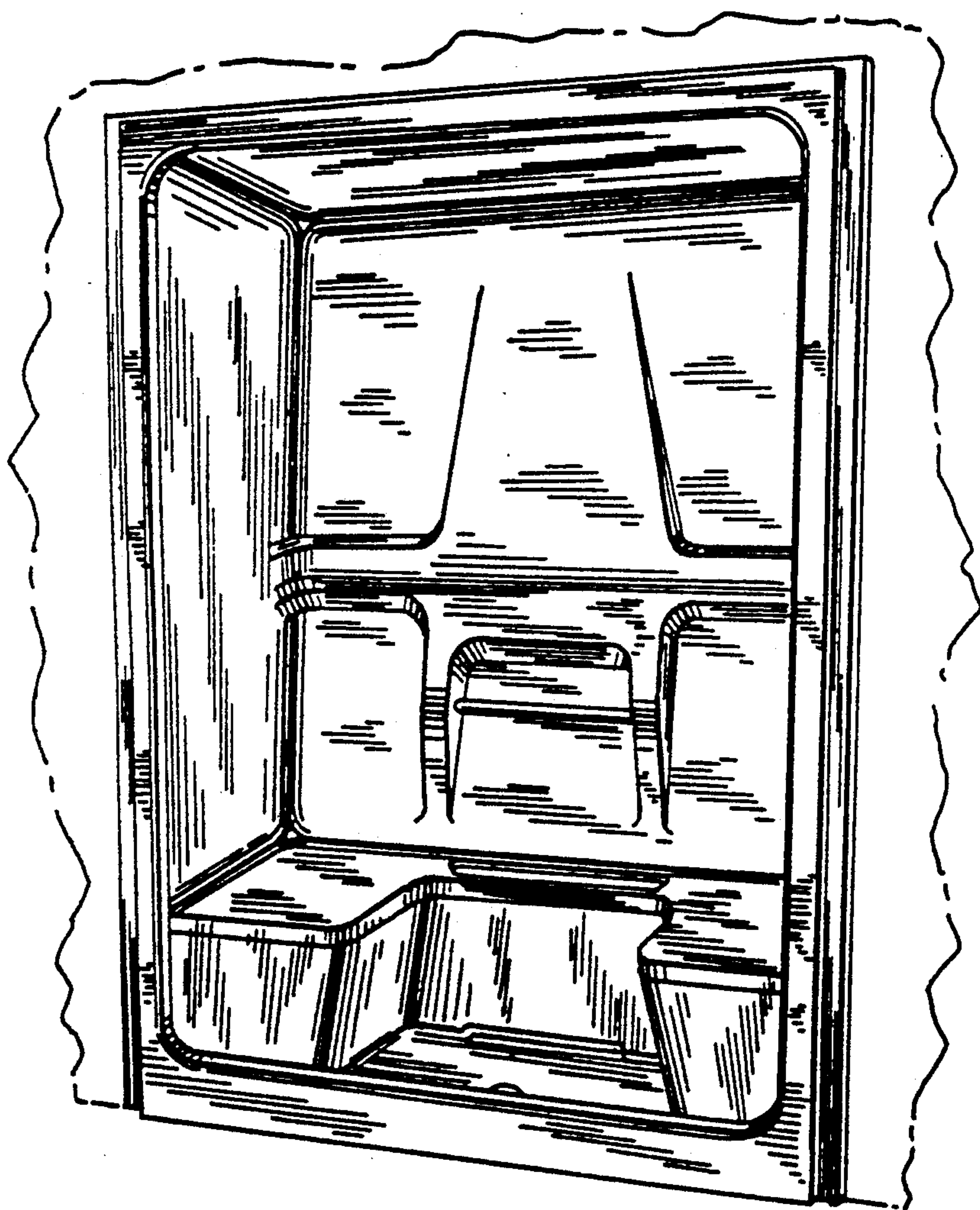

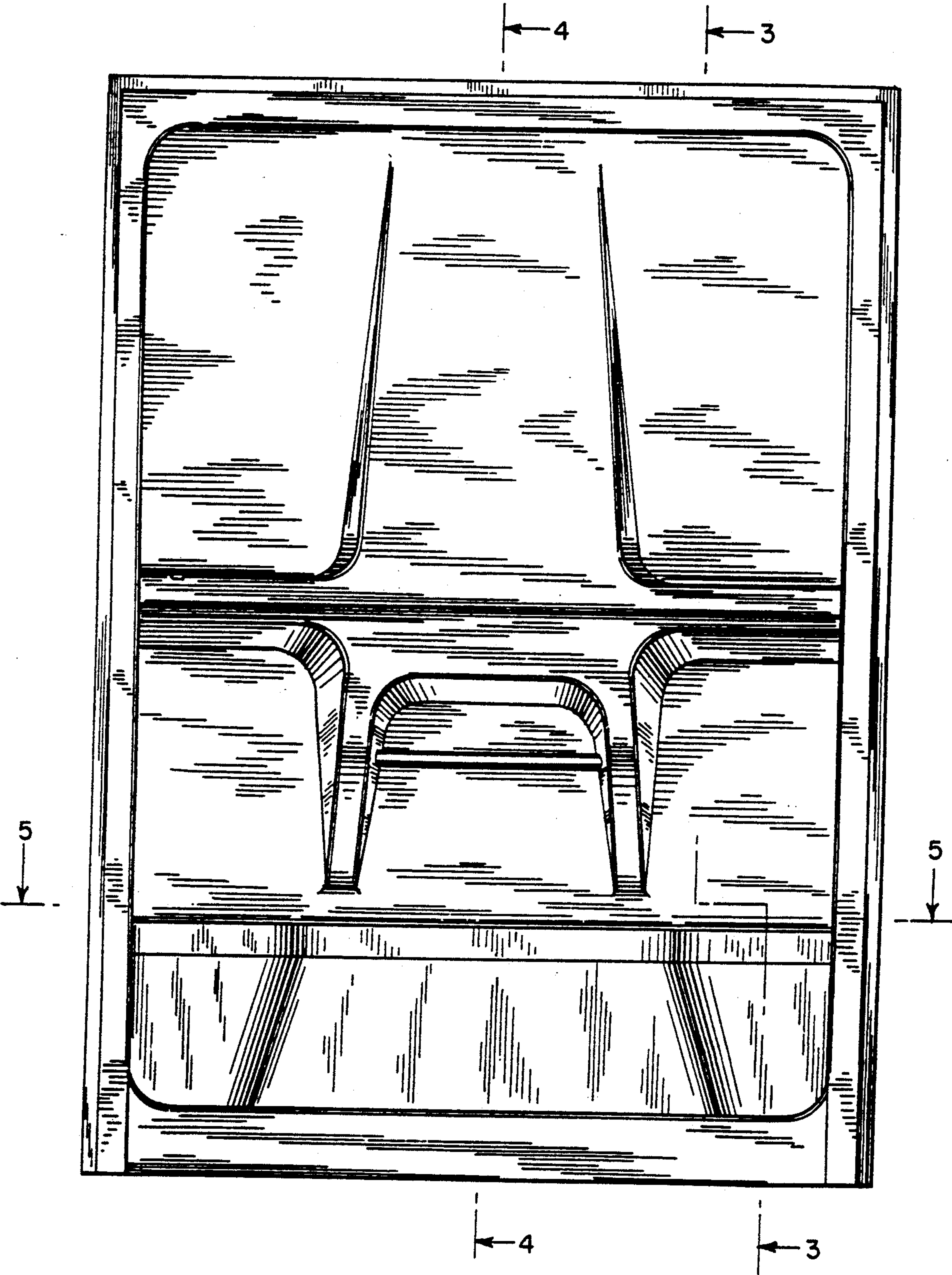

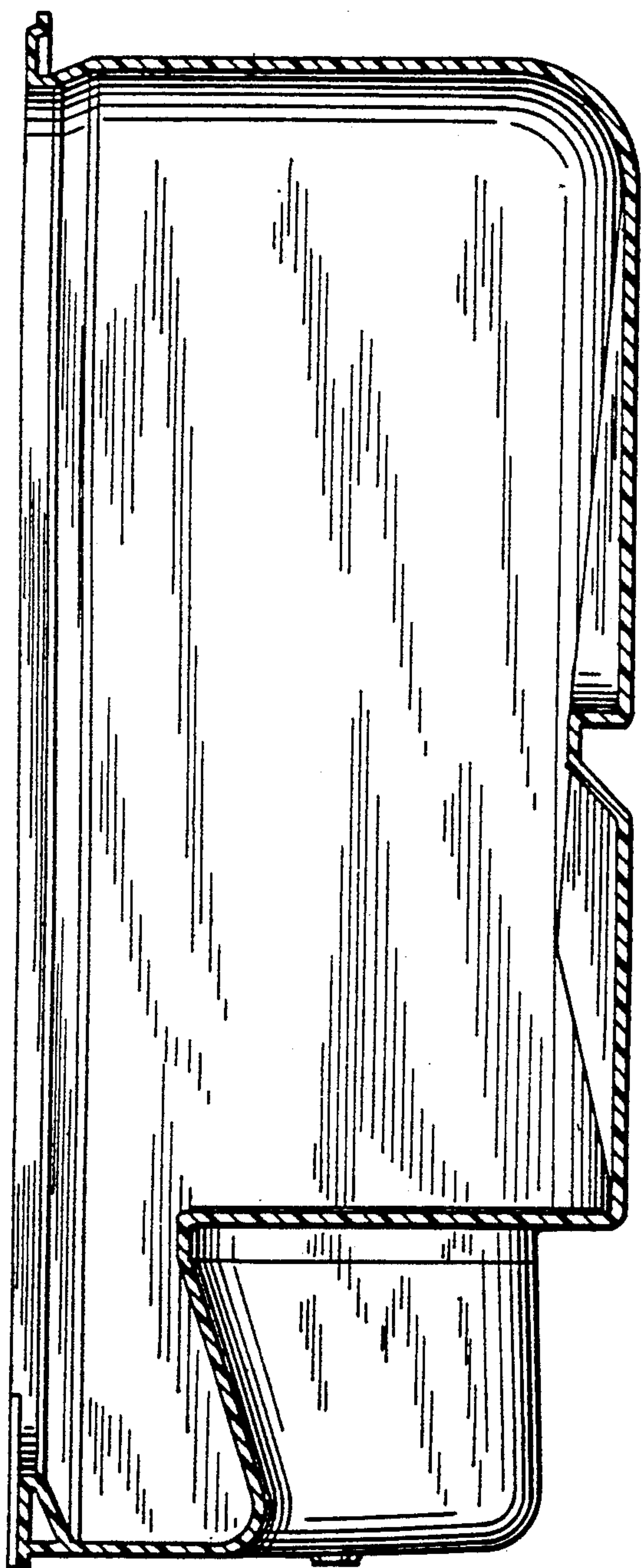

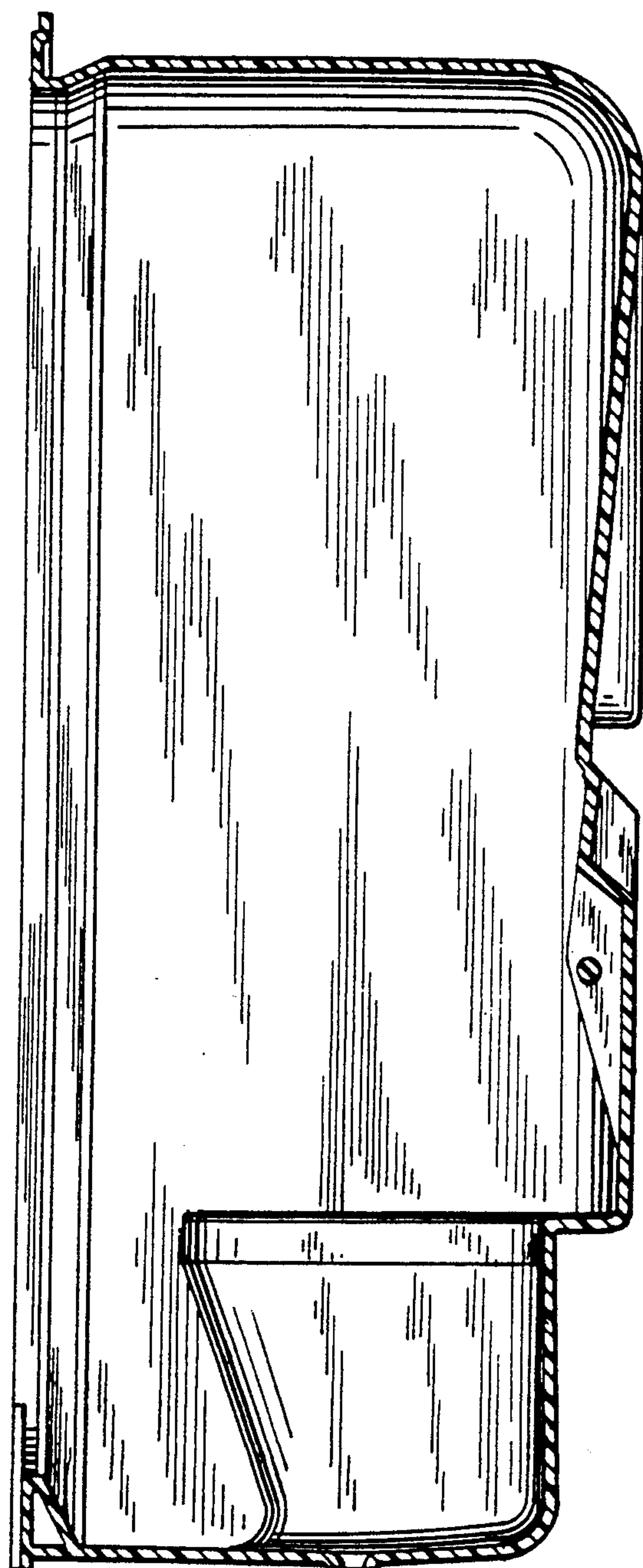

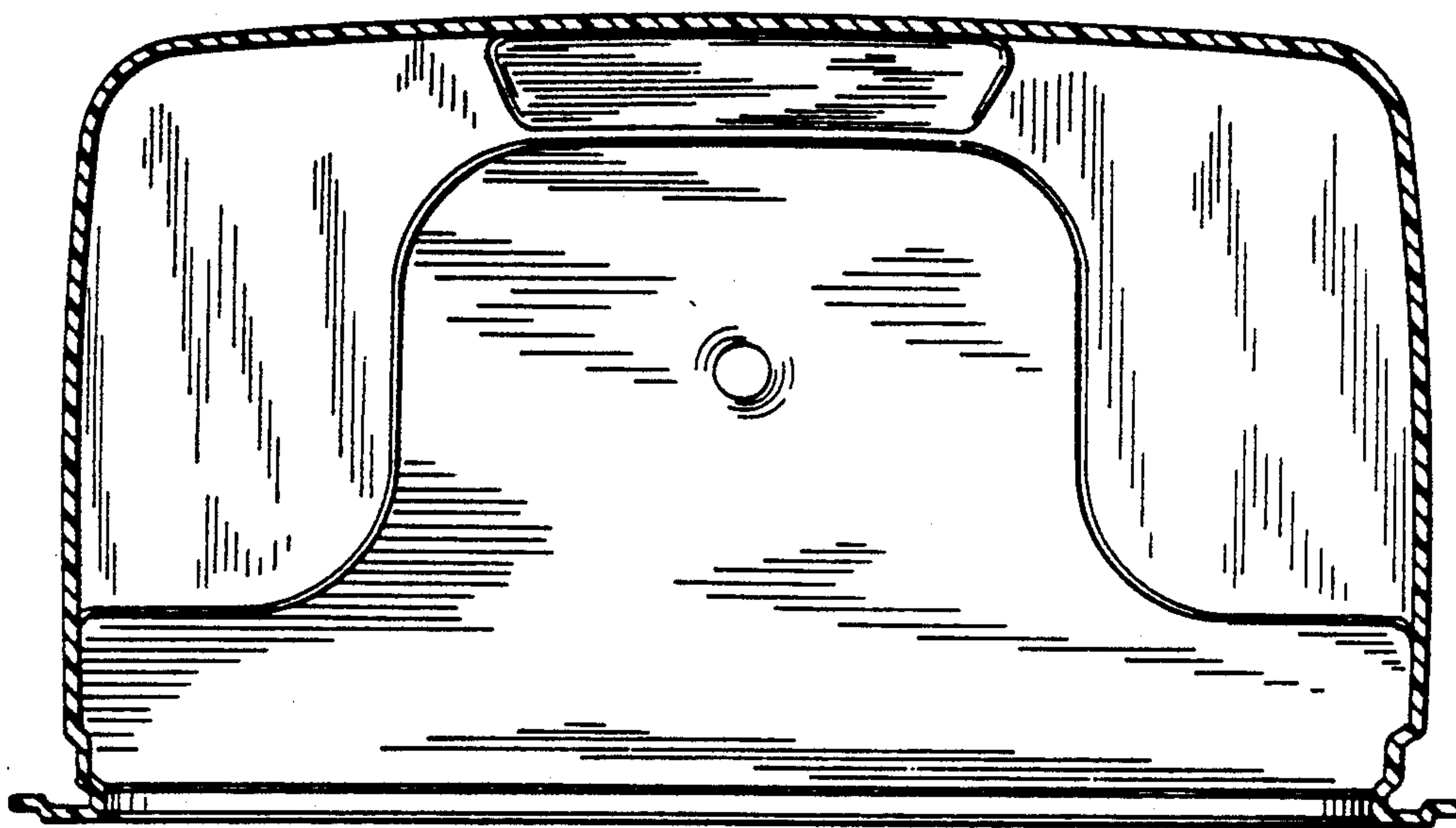

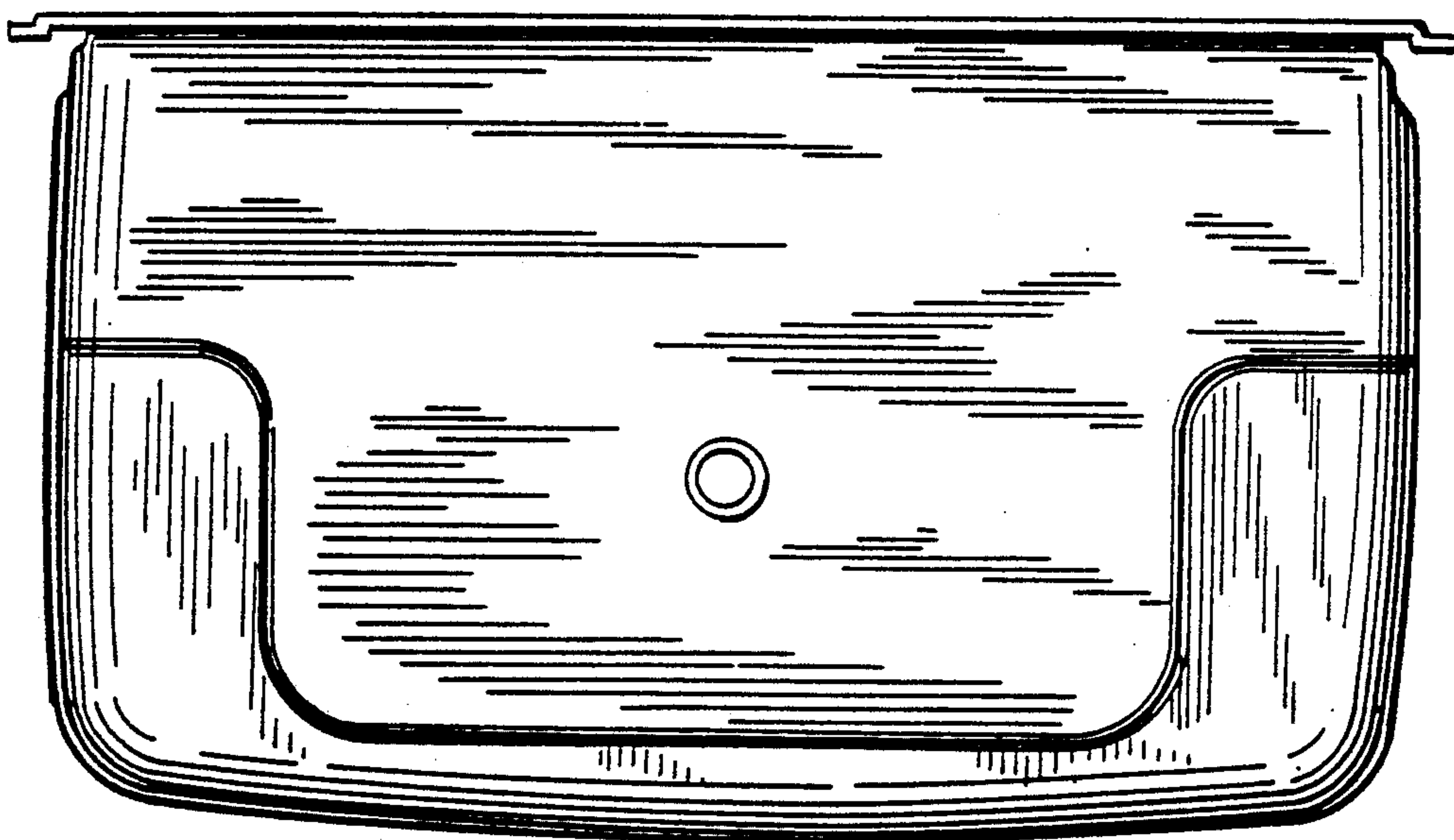

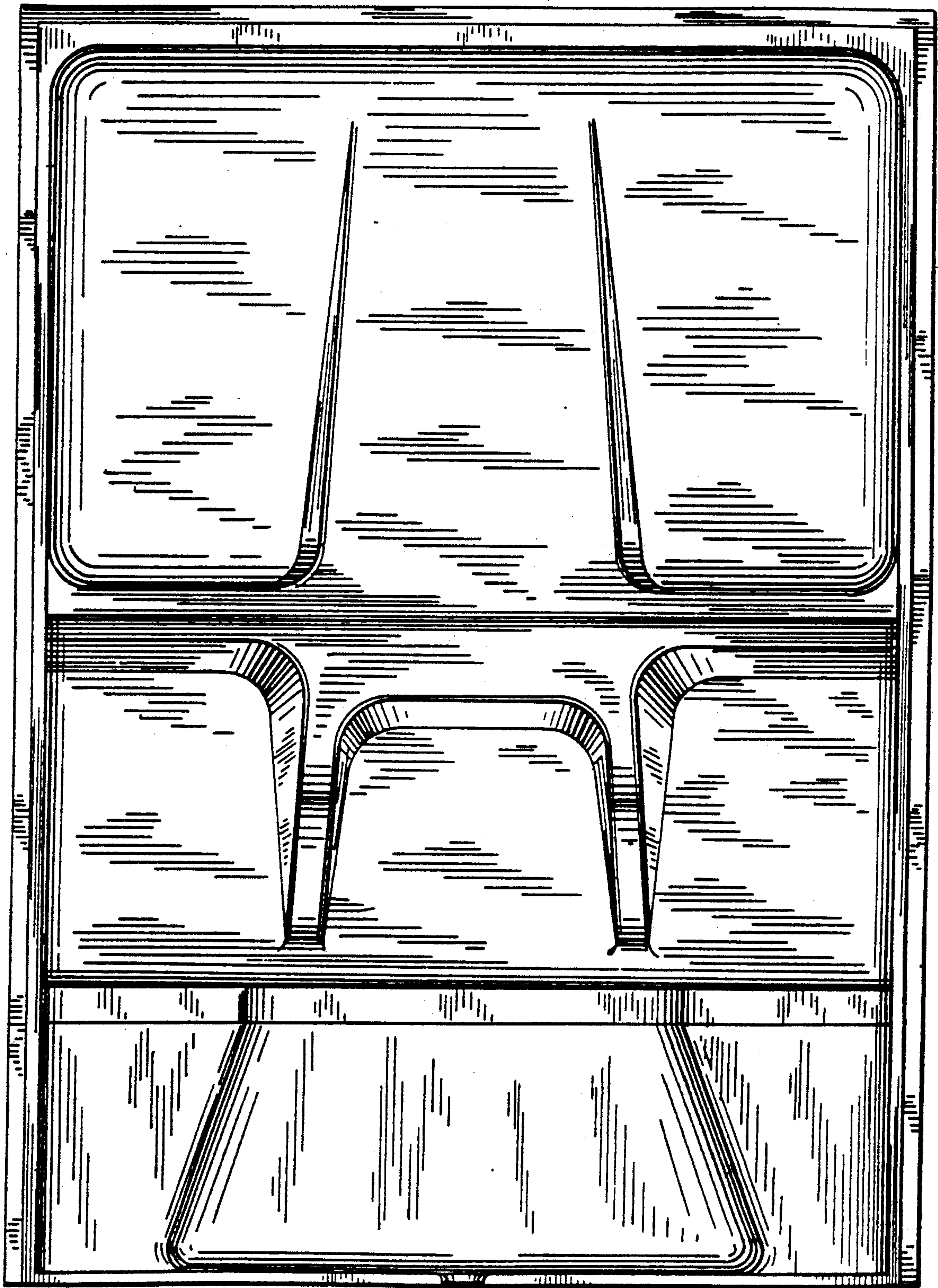

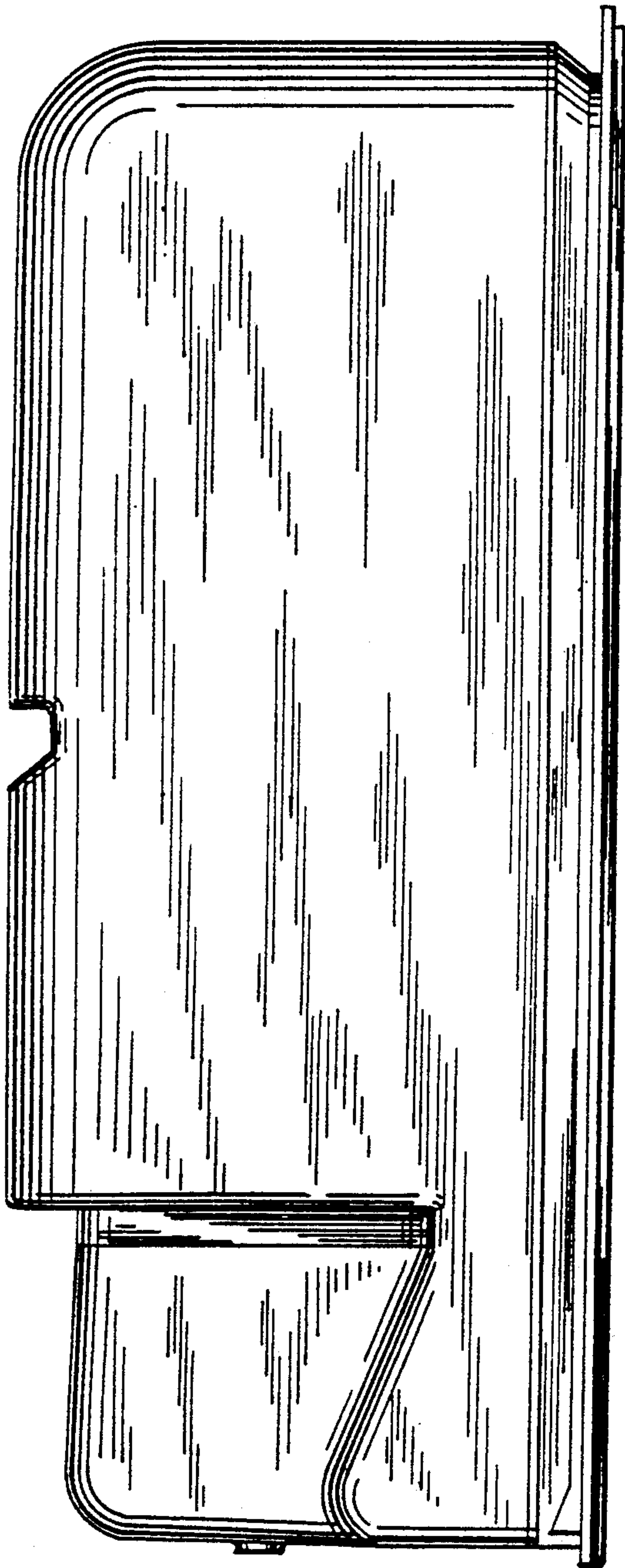

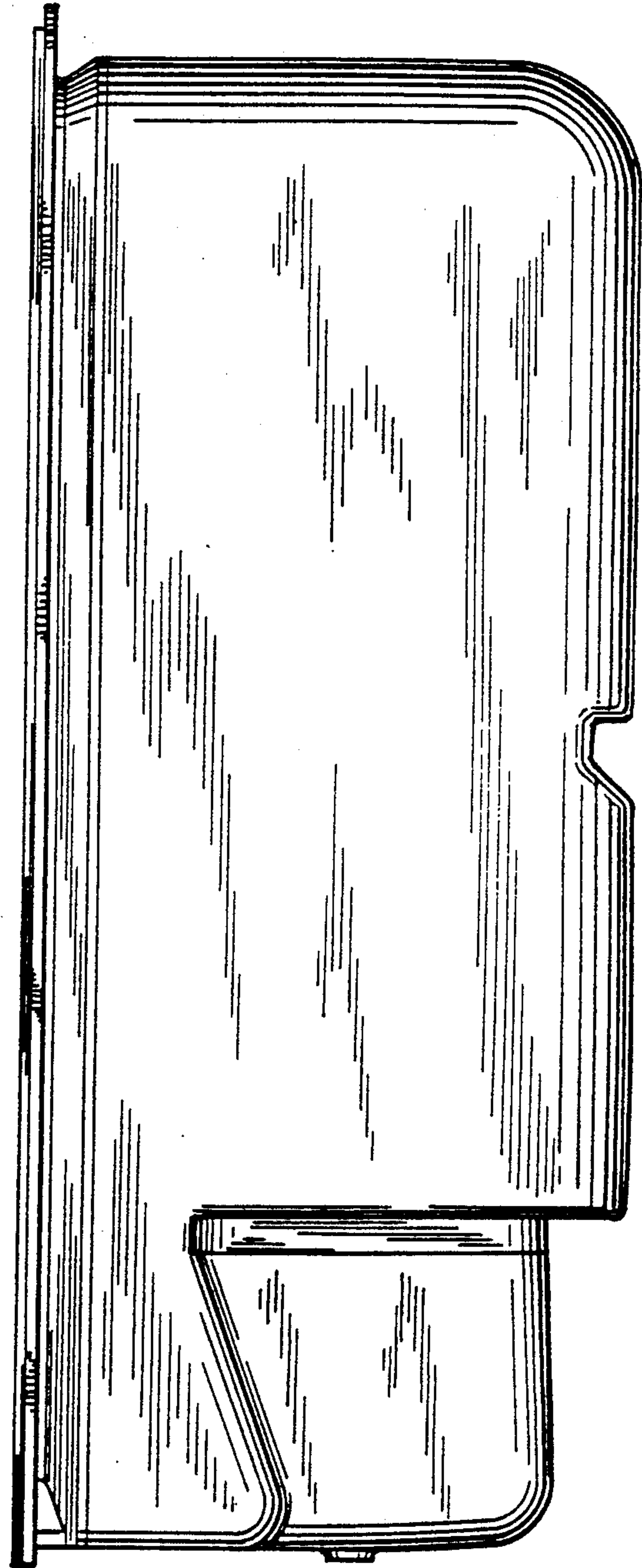

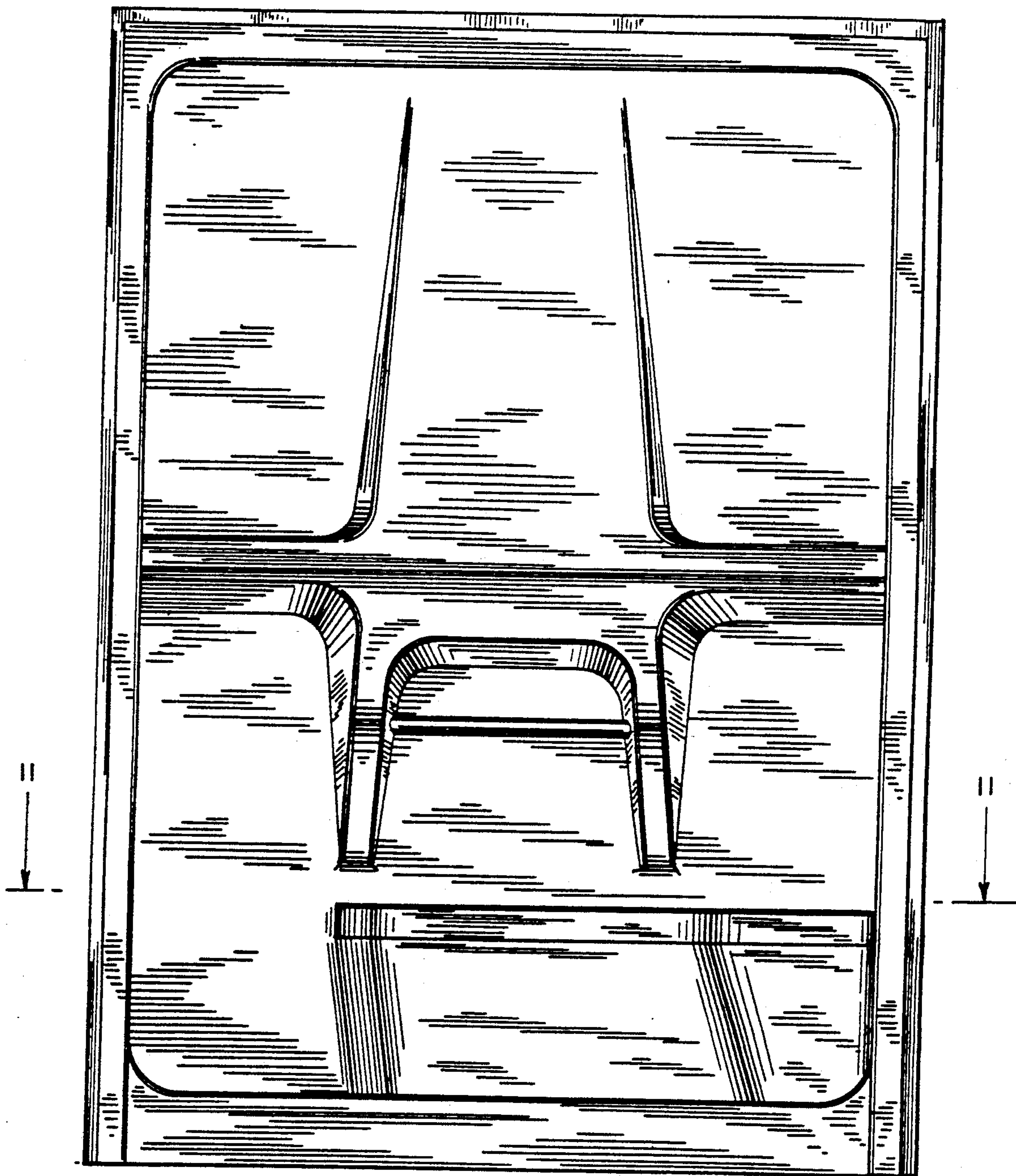

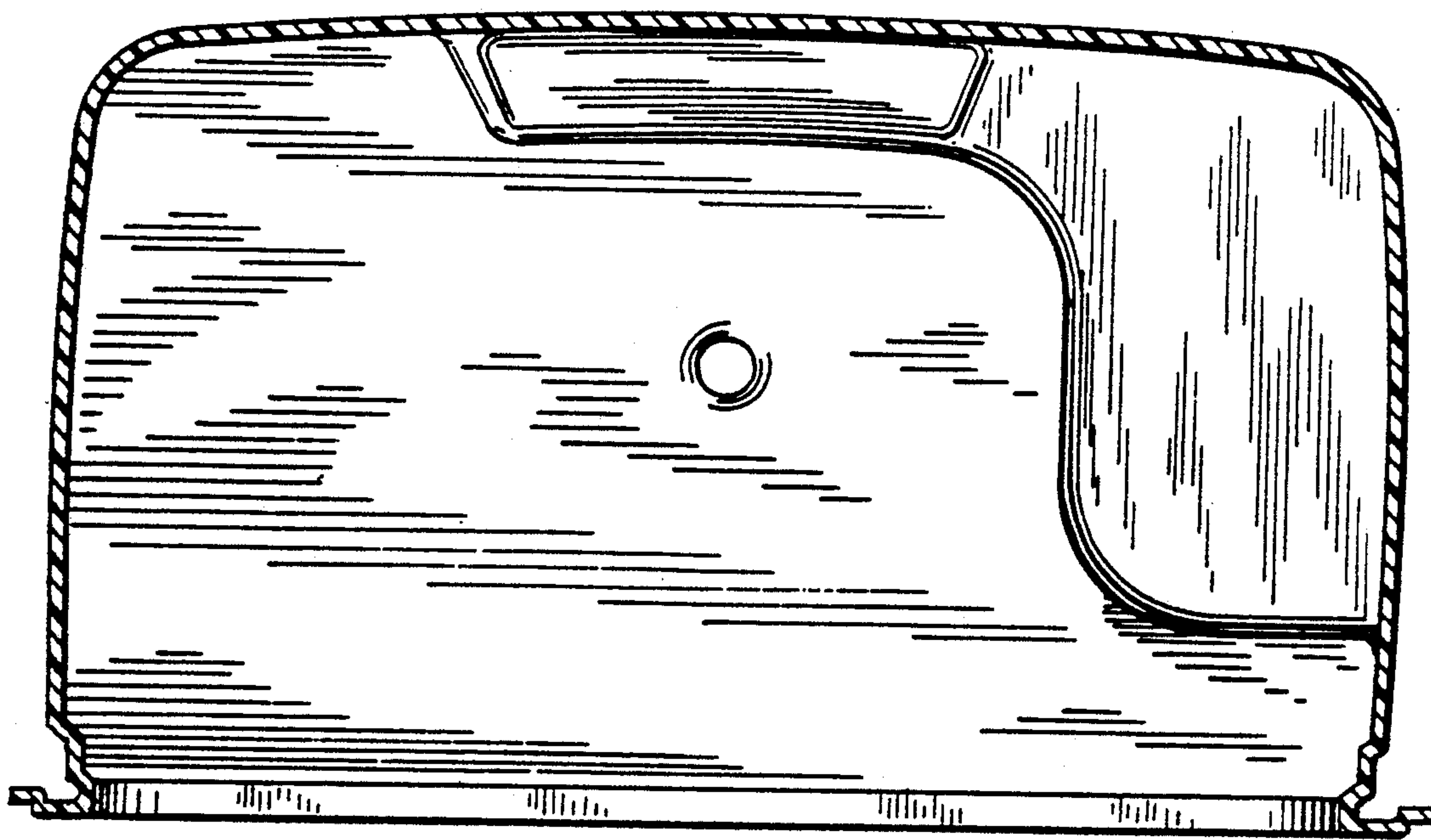

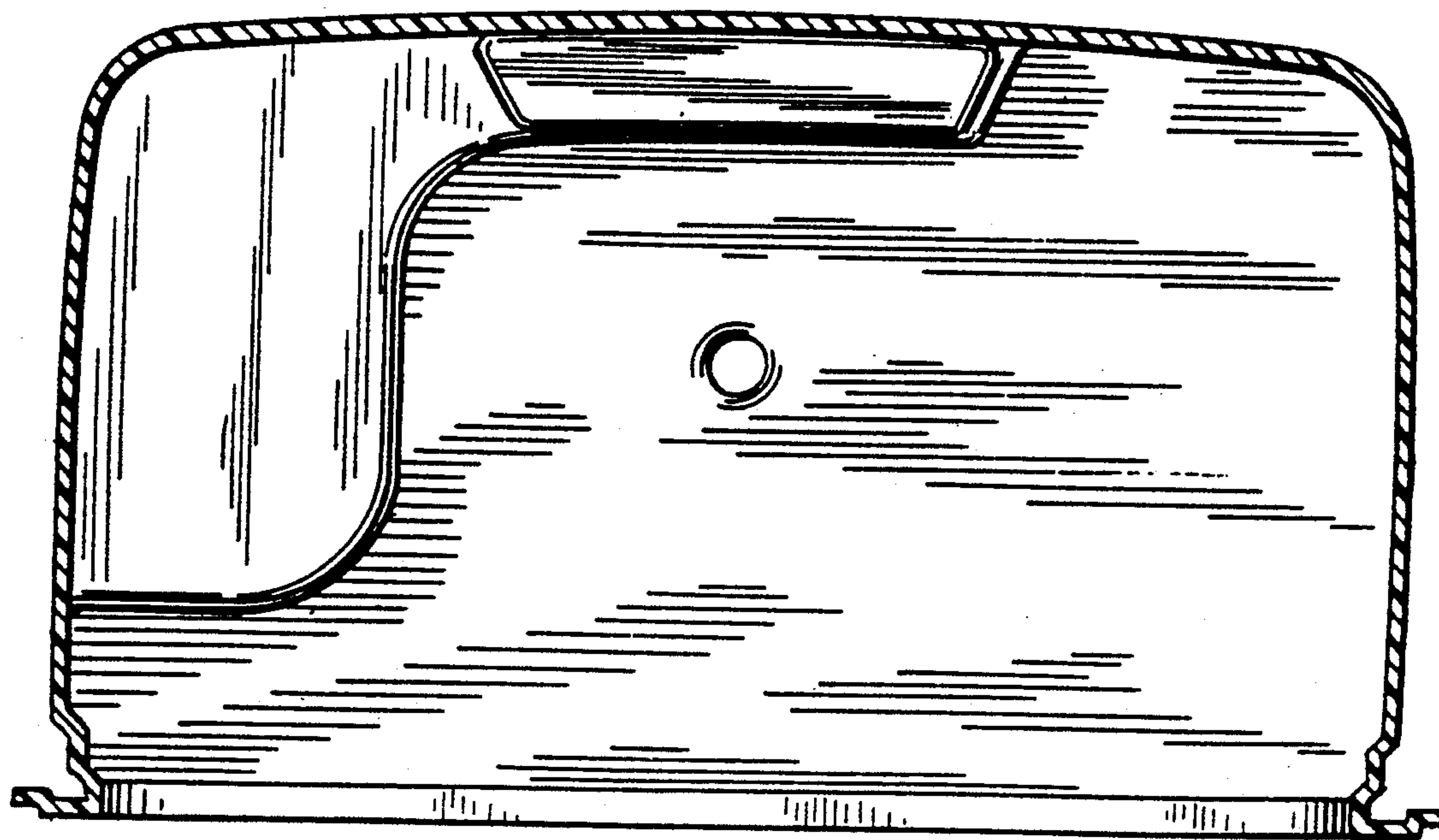

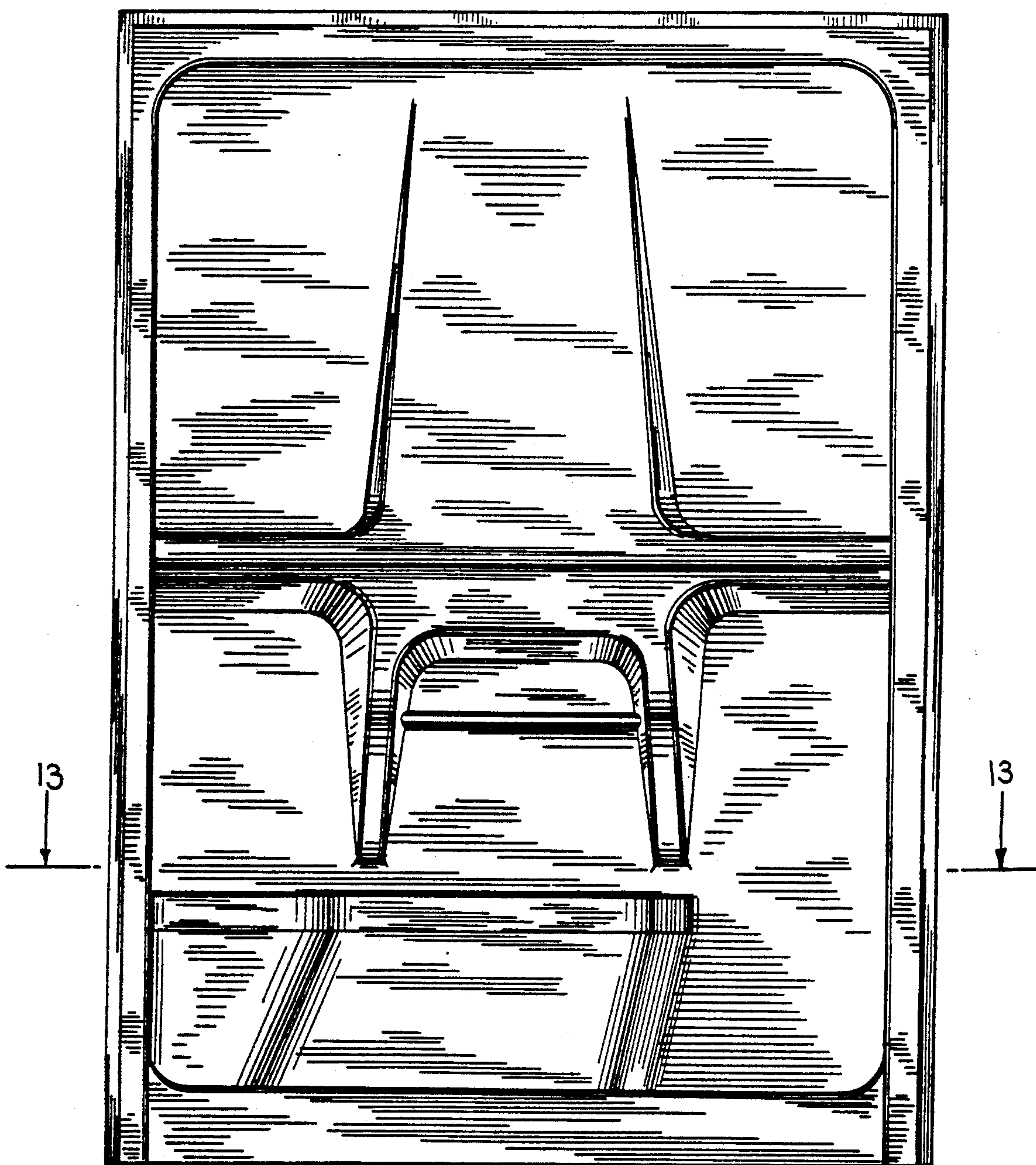

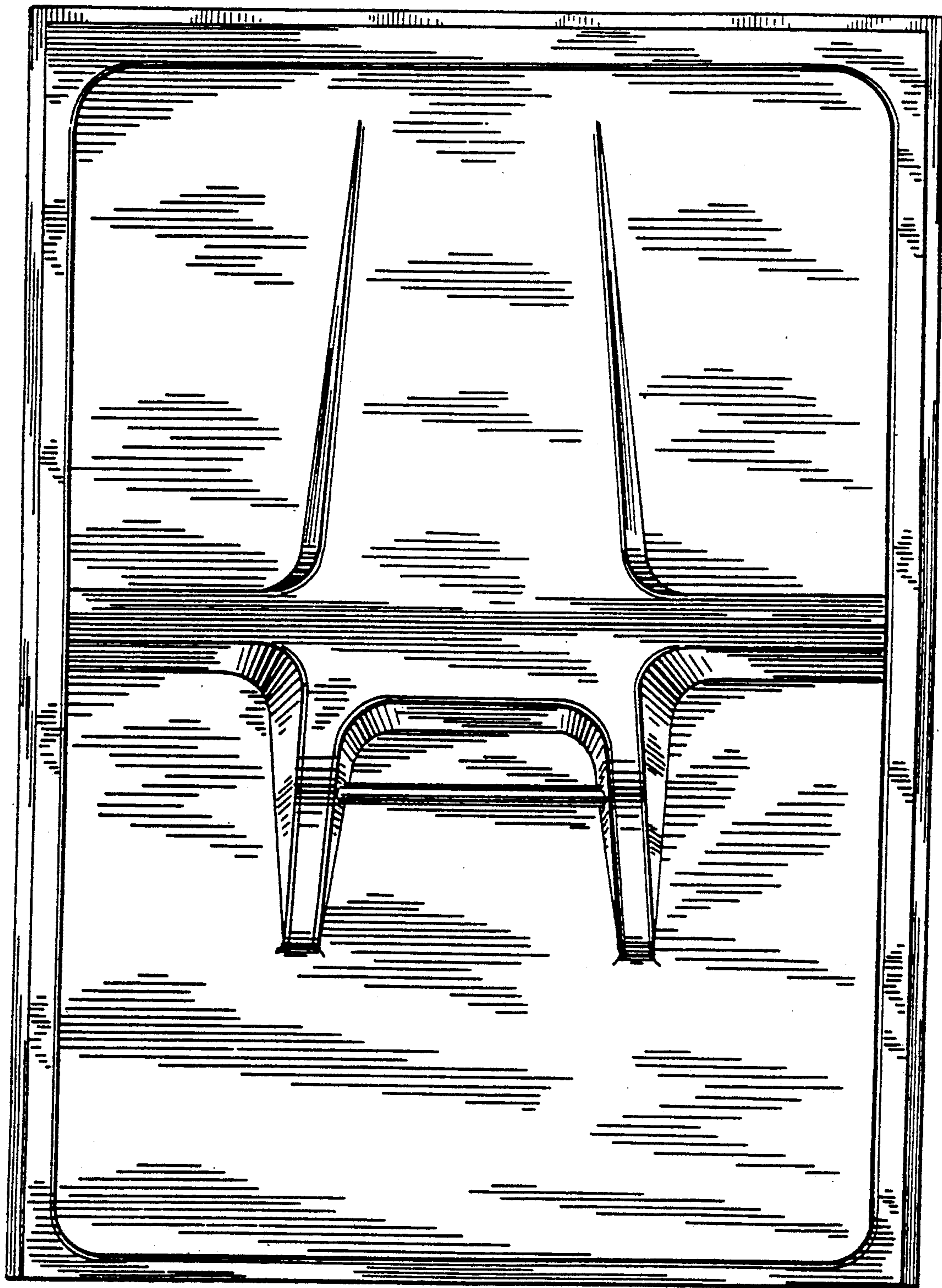
