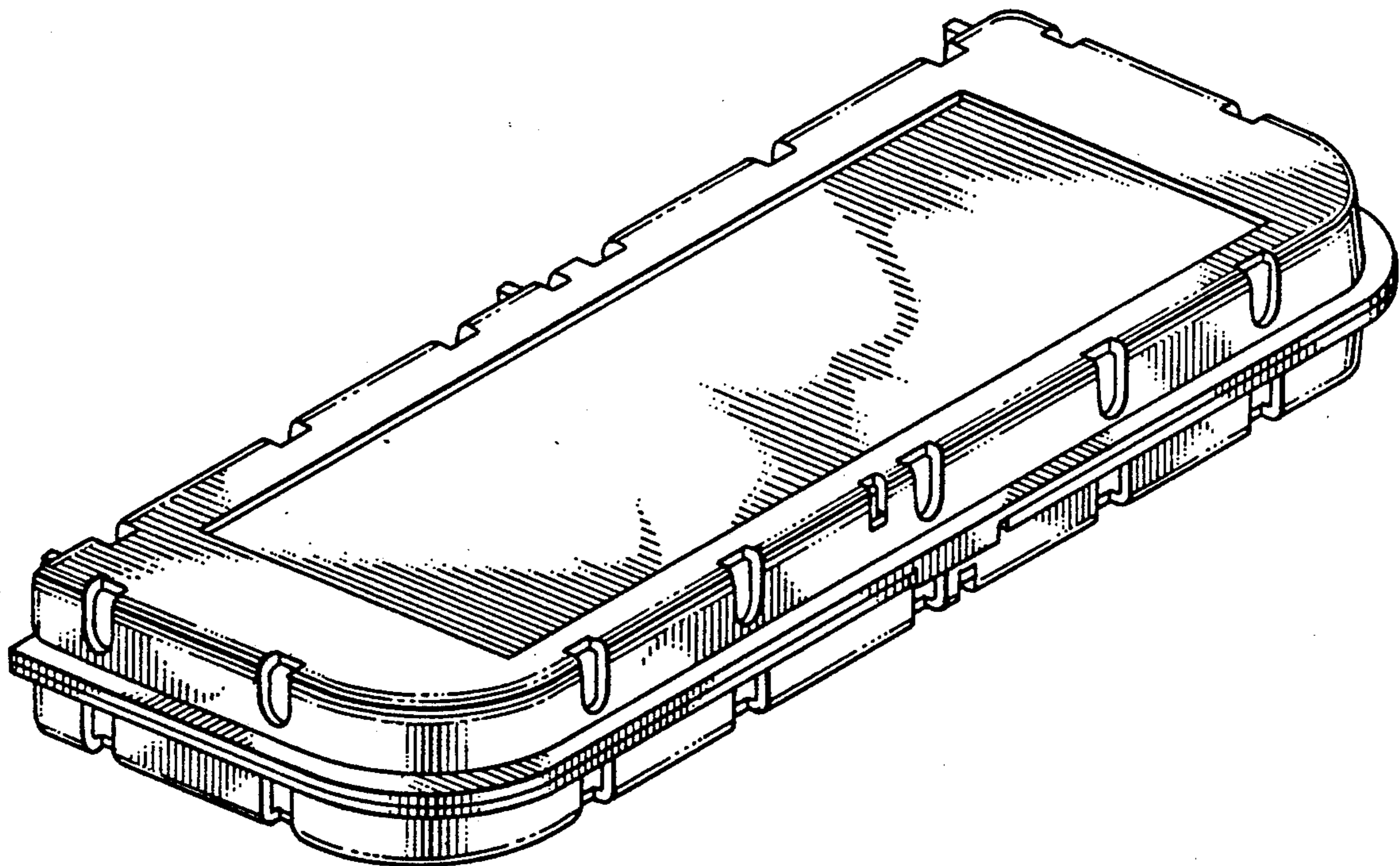

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a sterilization case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and left side perspective view of a sterilization case, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a perspective view in the open position.



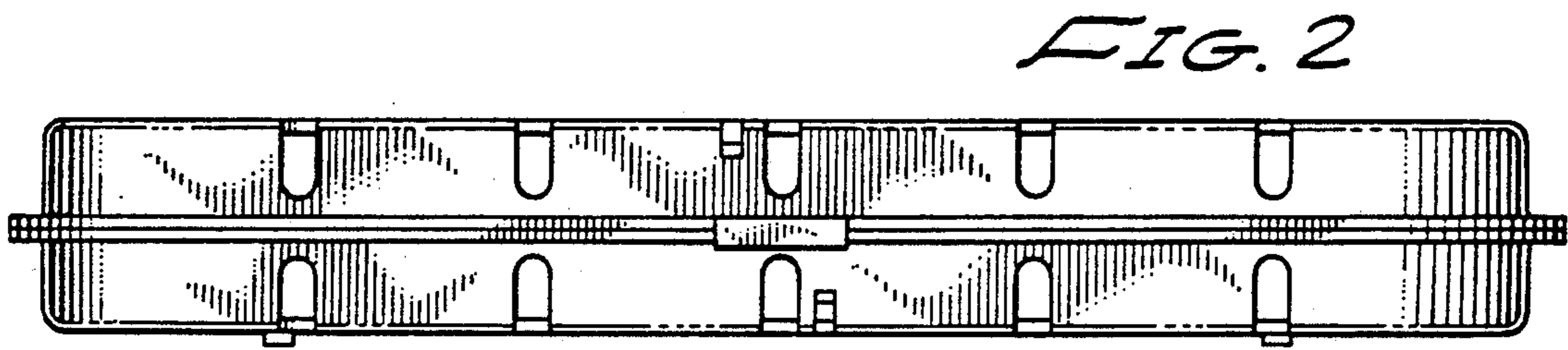
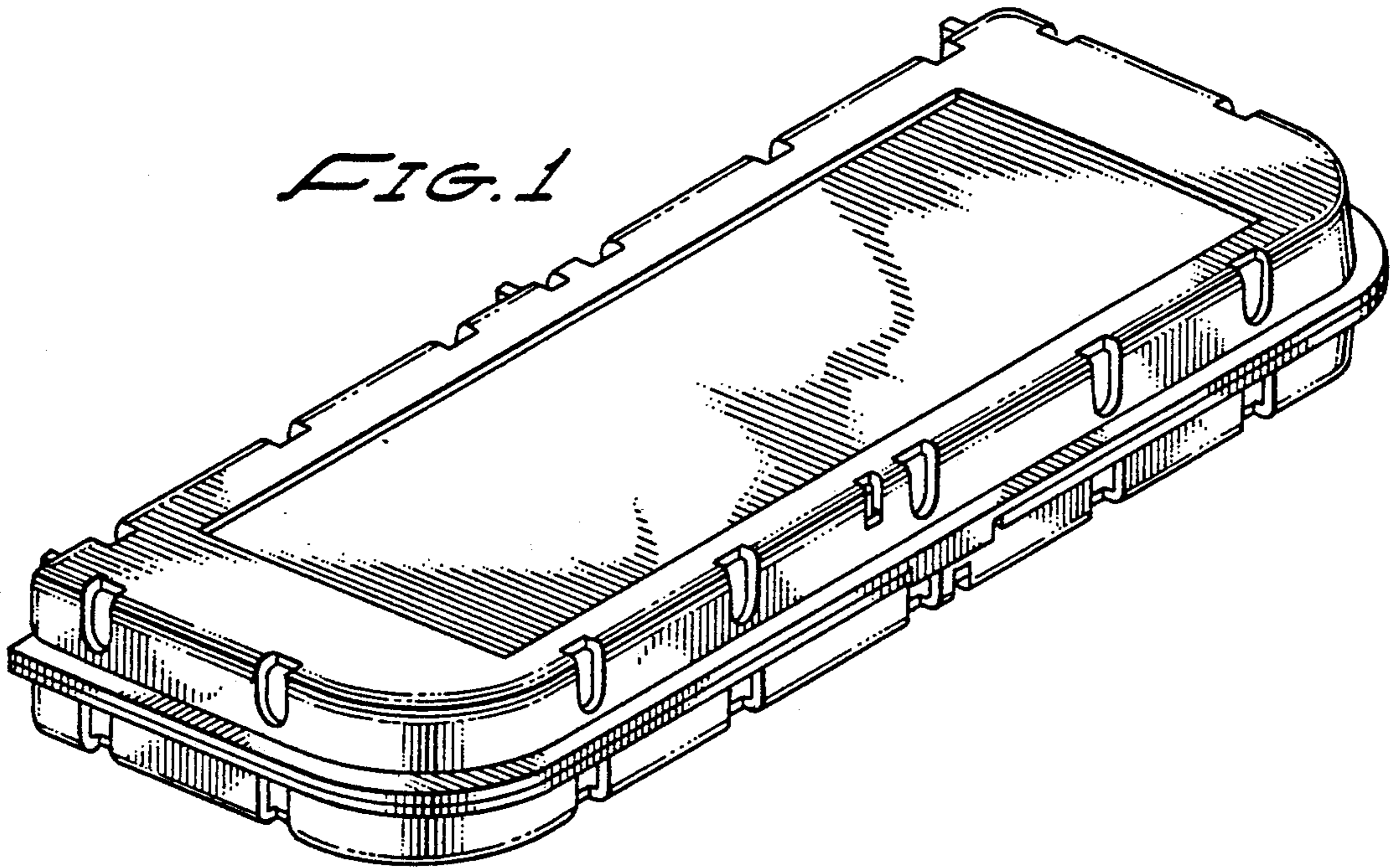

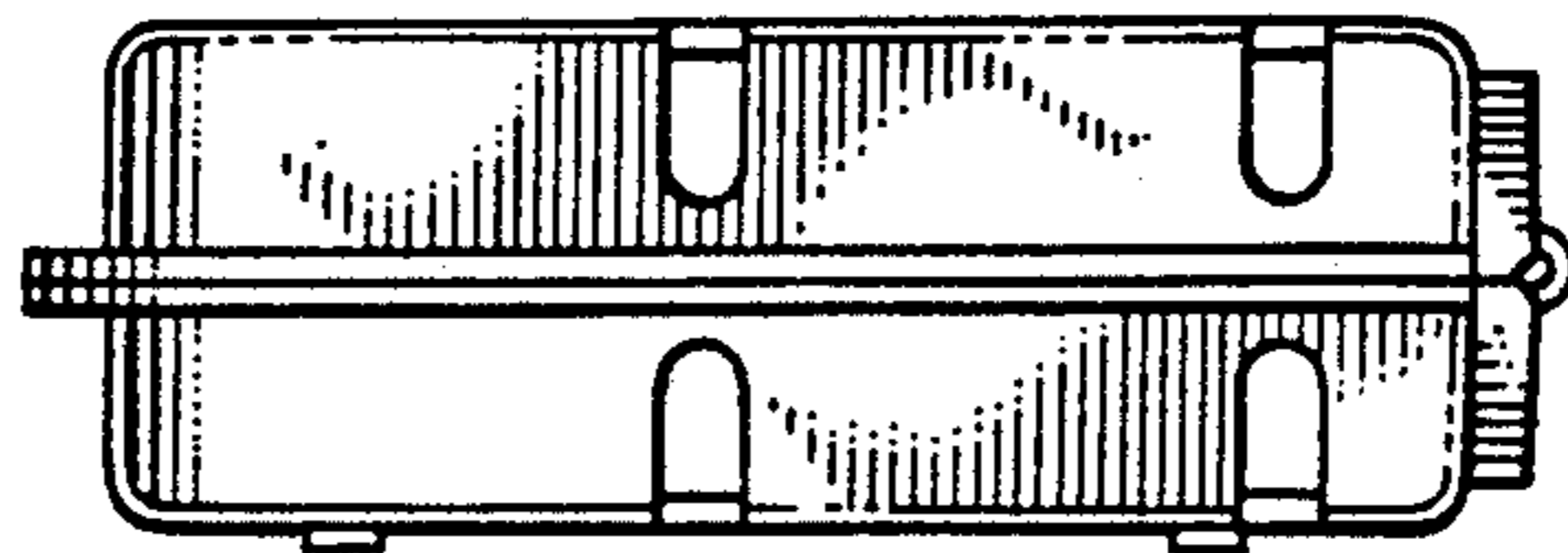
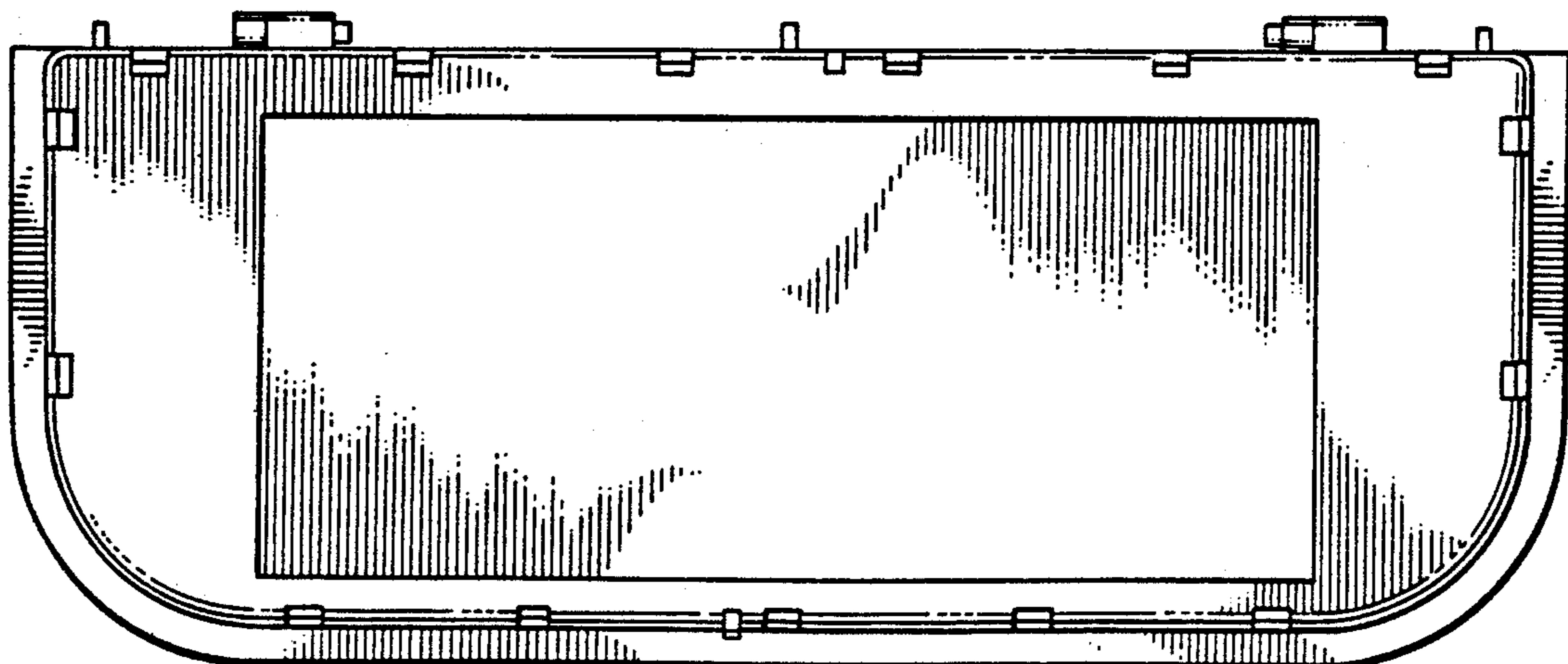

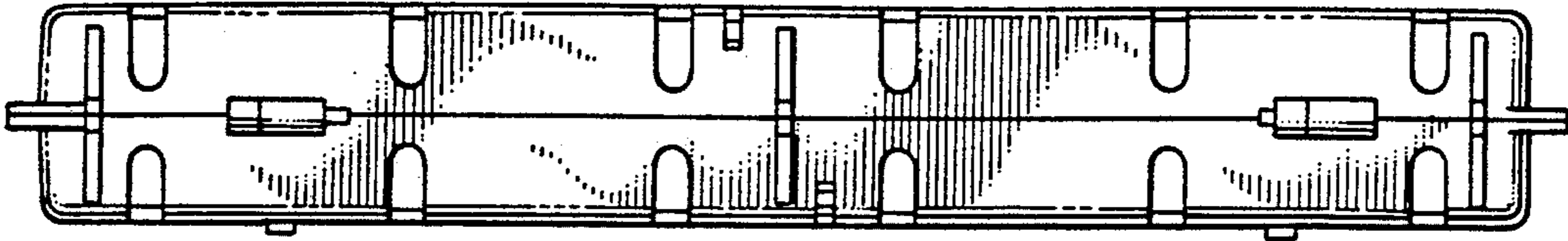

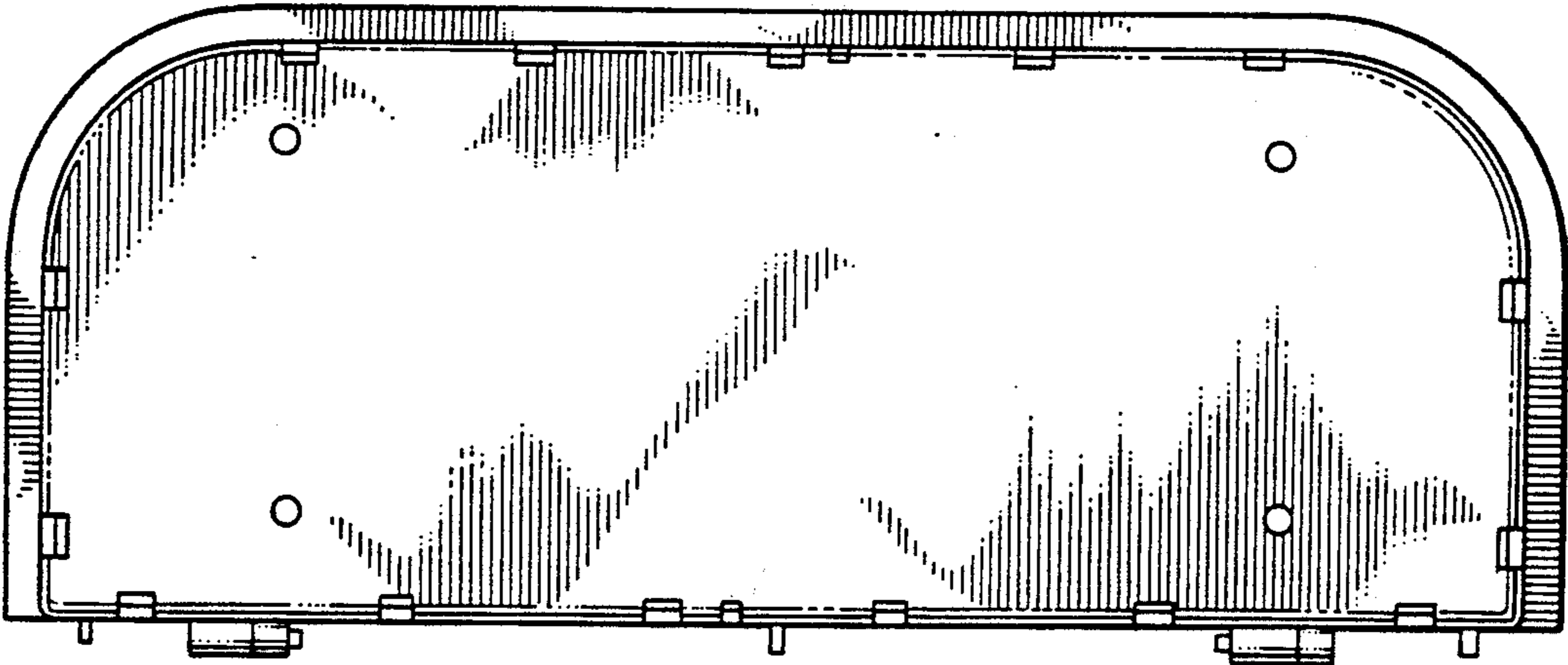

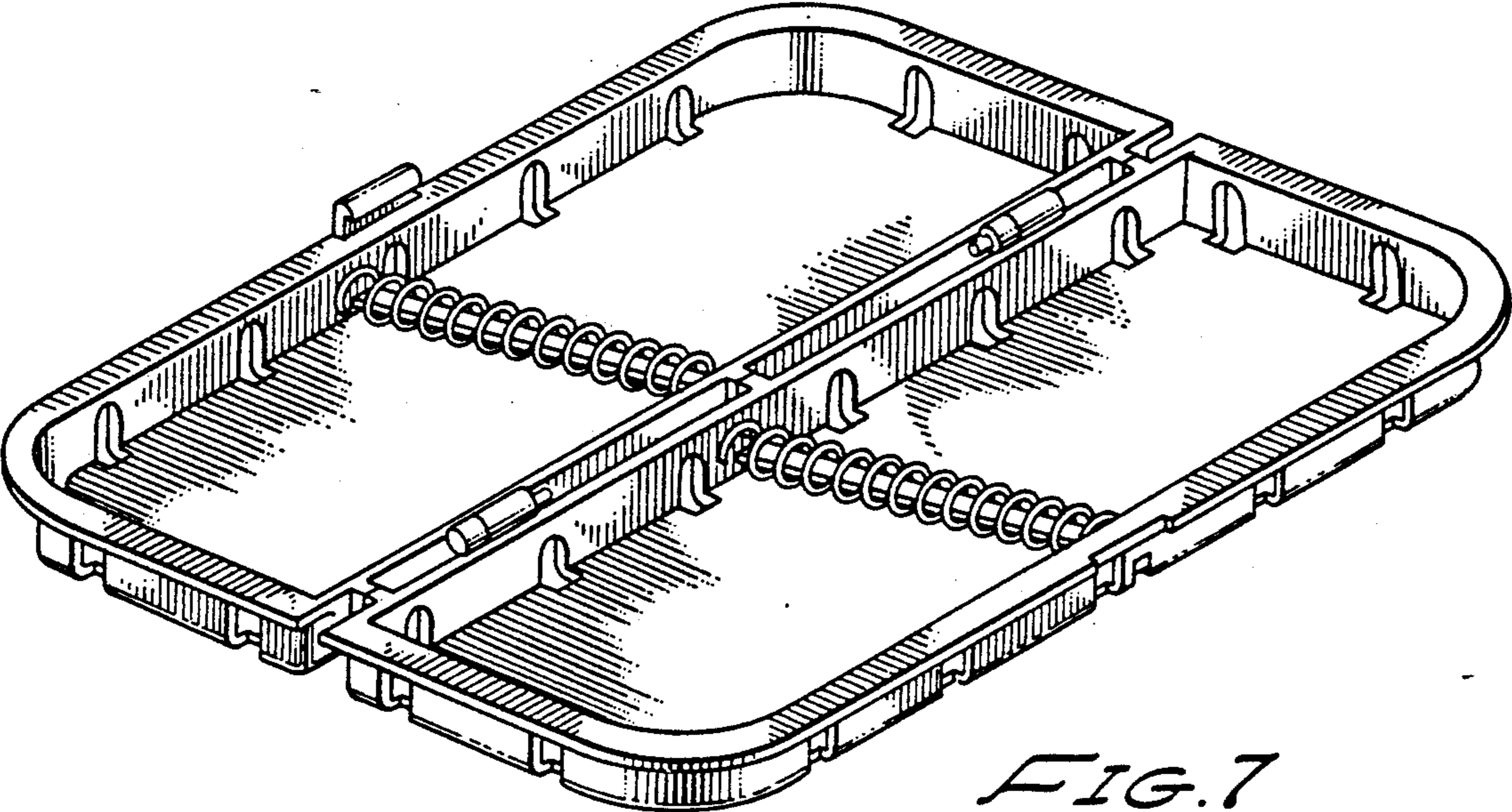
