DESCRIPTION

FIG. 7 is a back elevational view thereof.

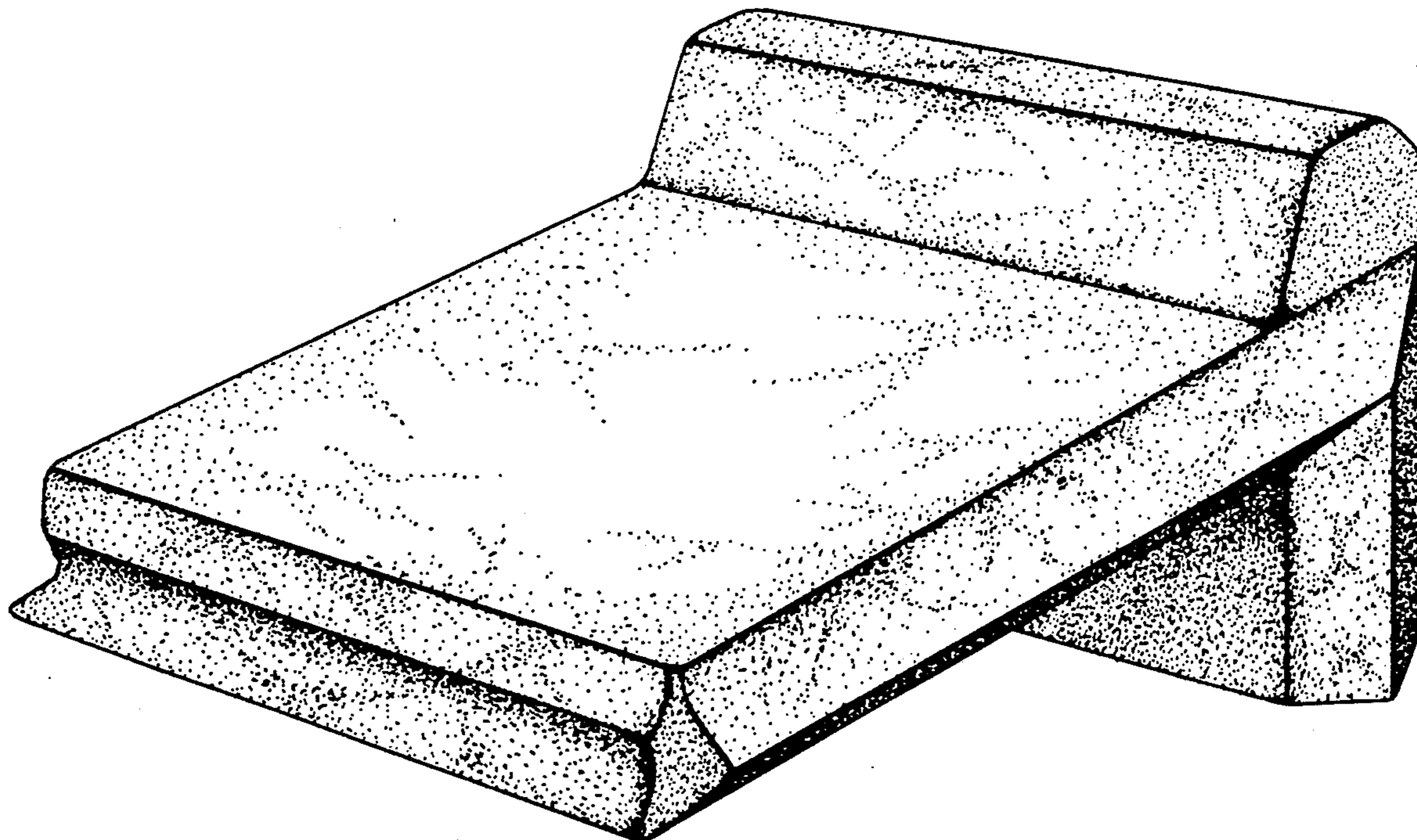

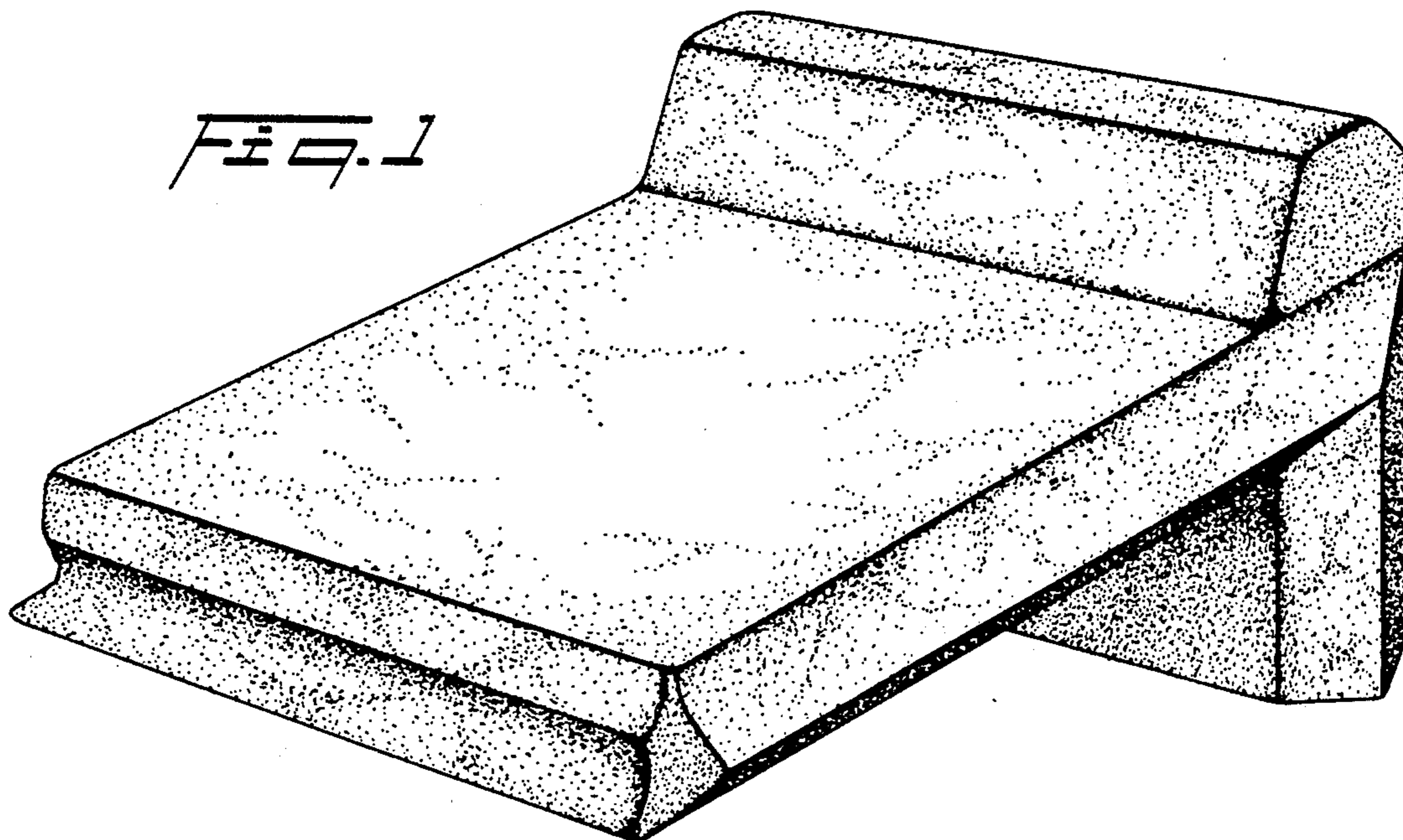

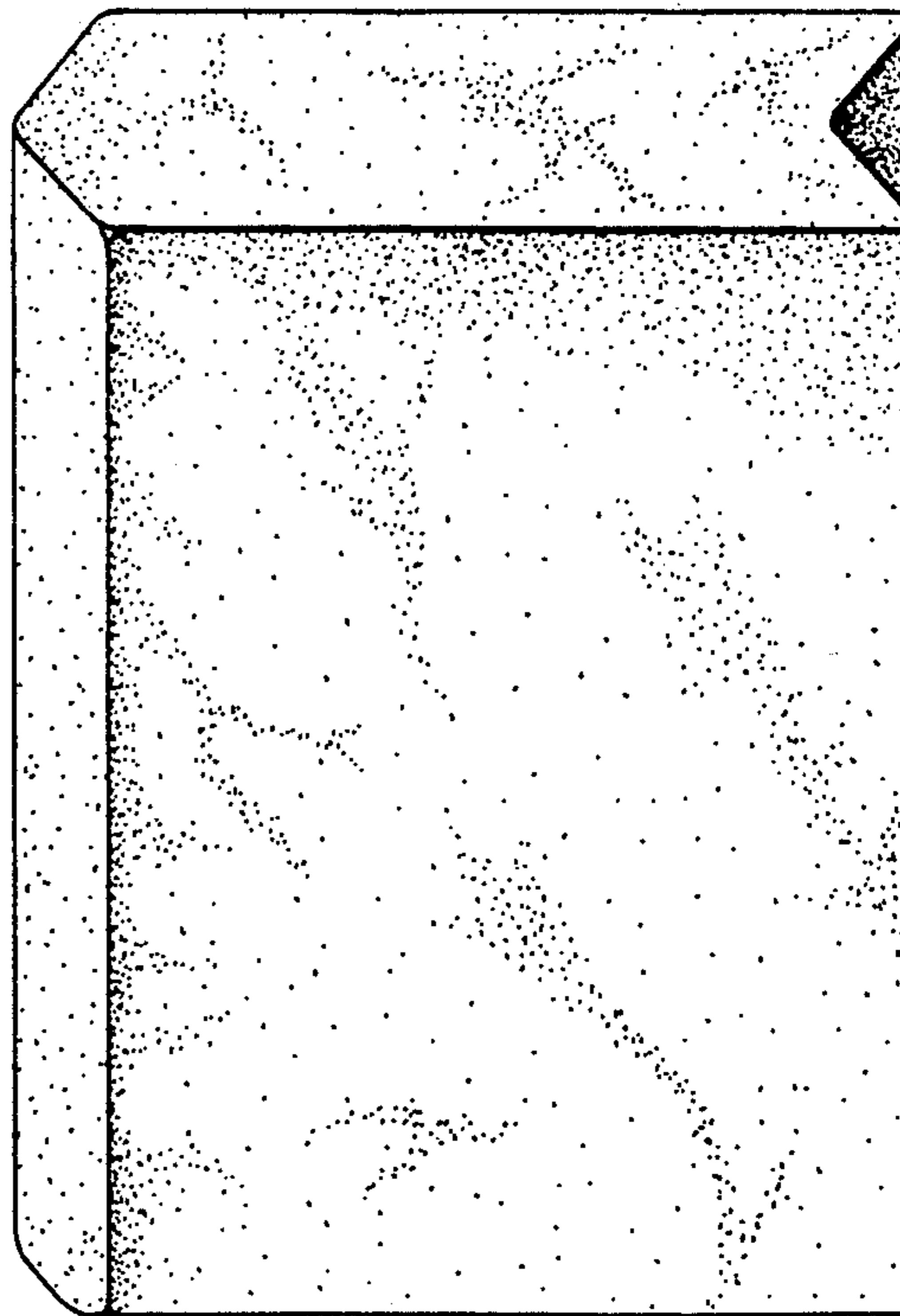

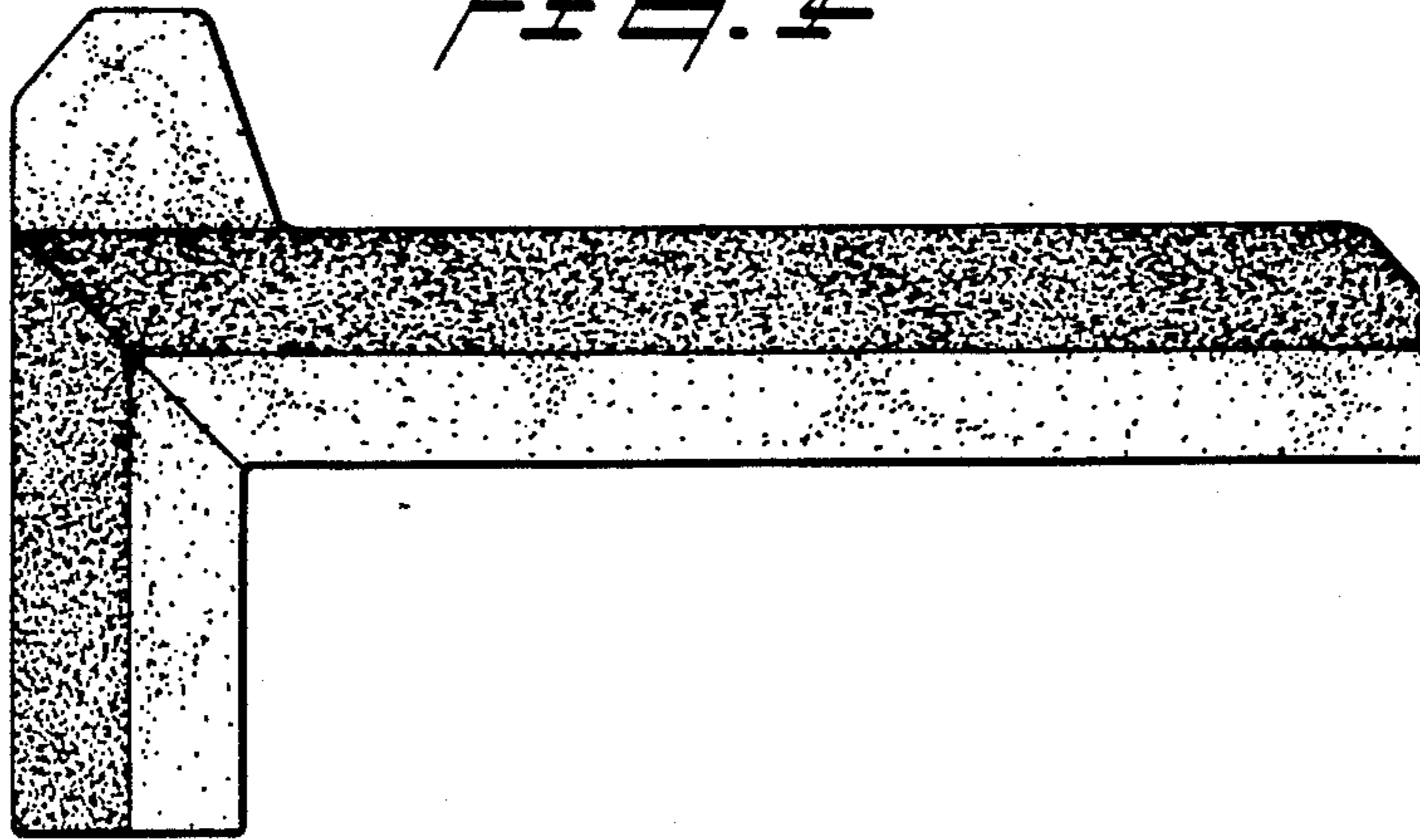

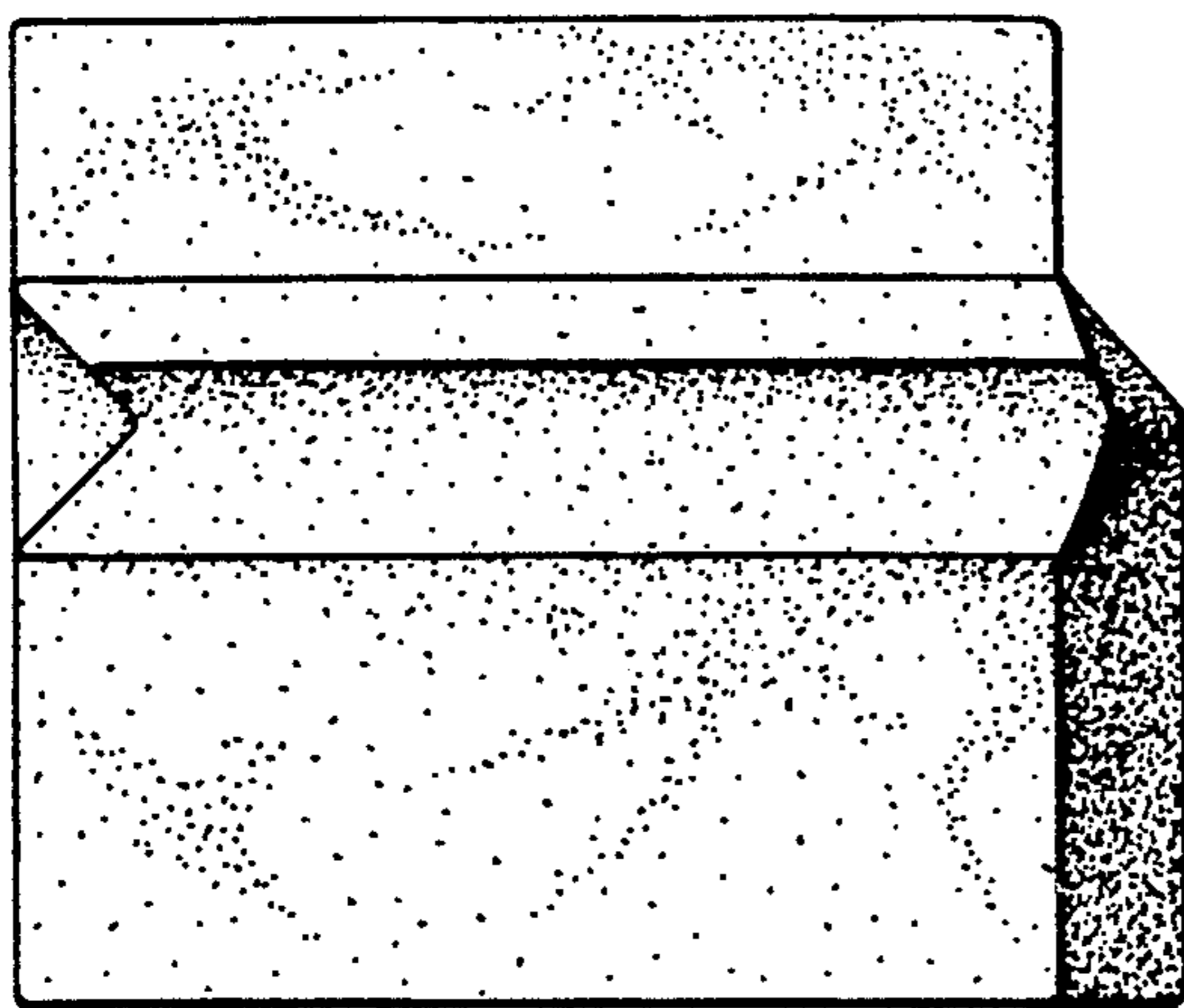
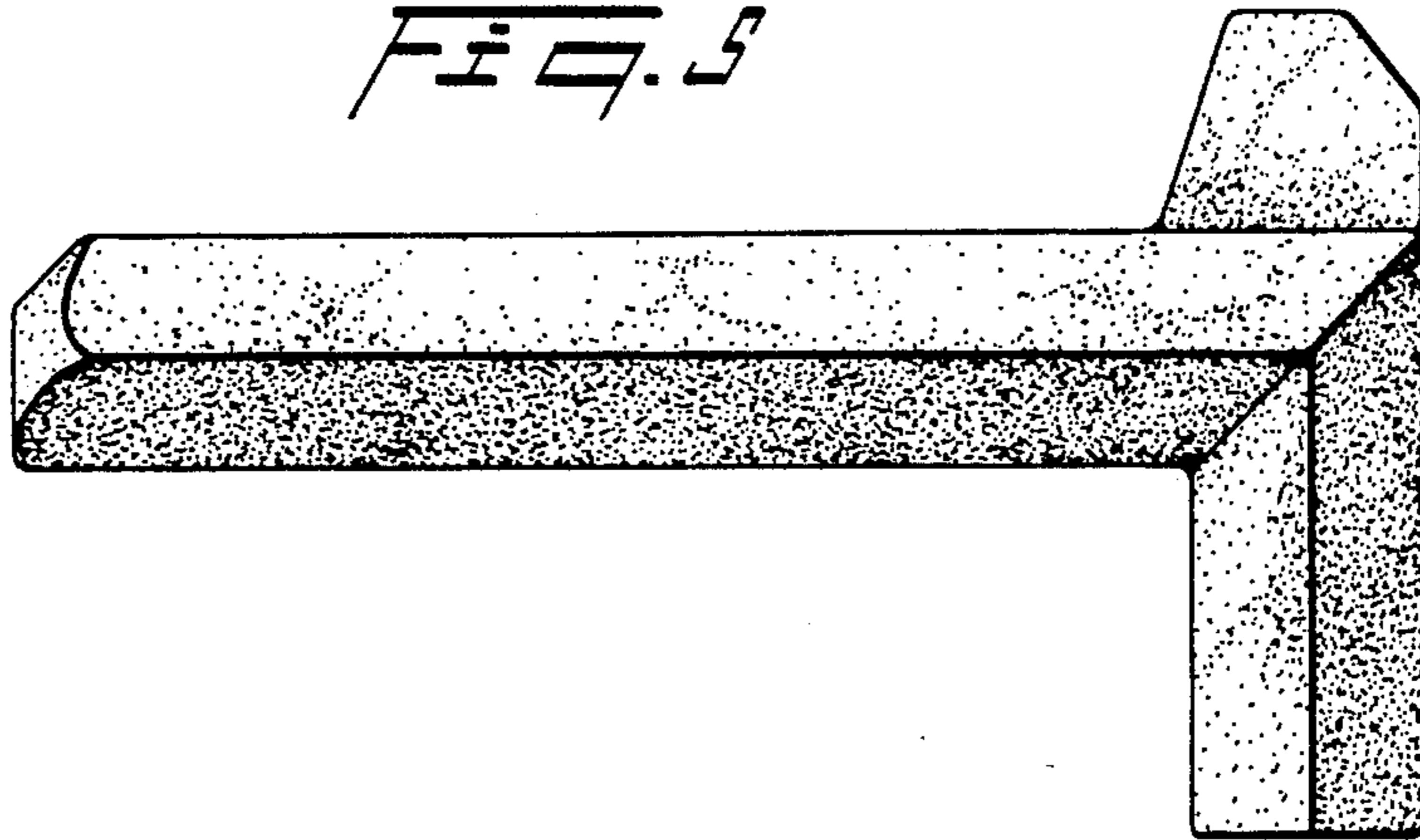

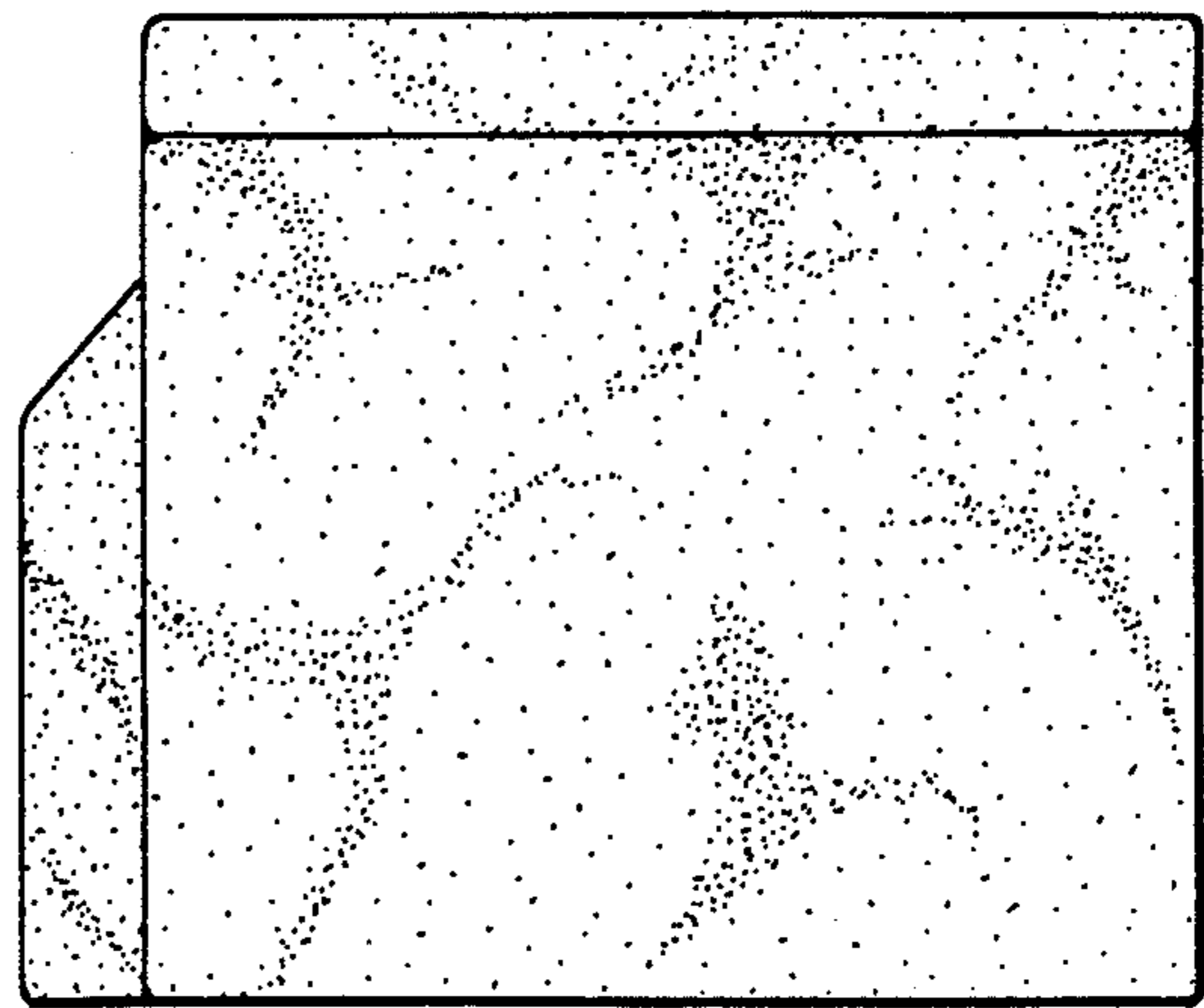
