[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an arm cushion for a crutch, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an arm cushion for a crutch showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof. The broken line showing of a crutch in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purpose only and does not form any part of the claimed design.

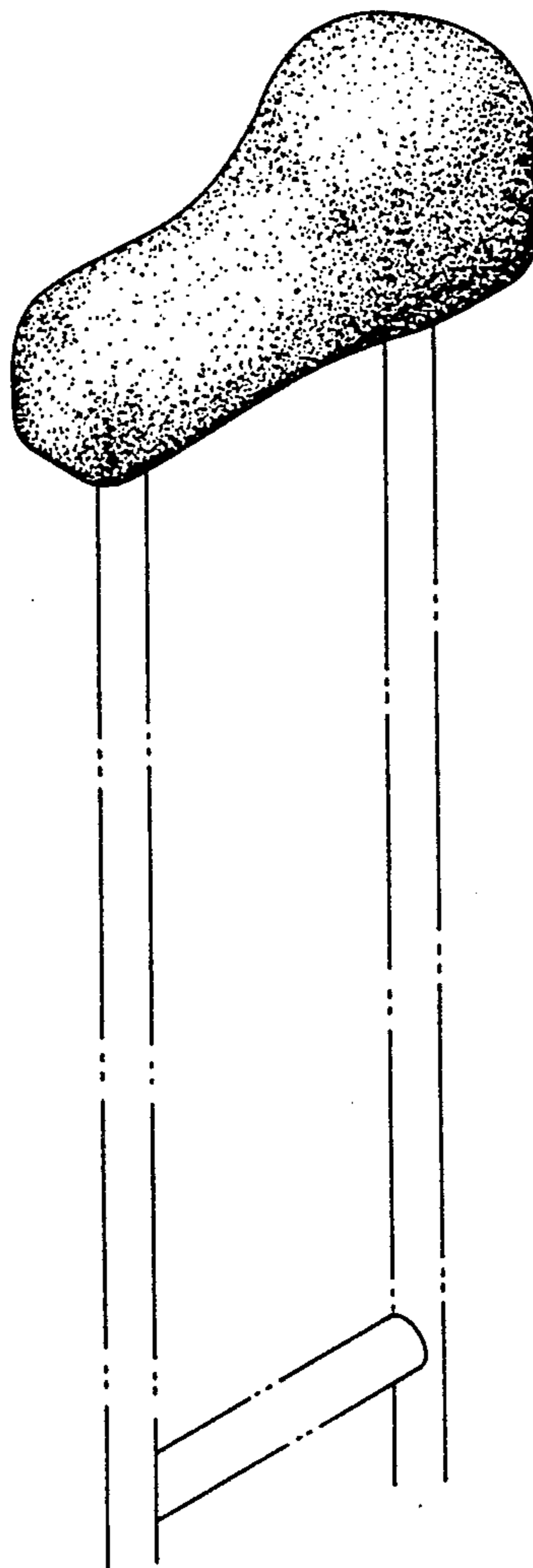

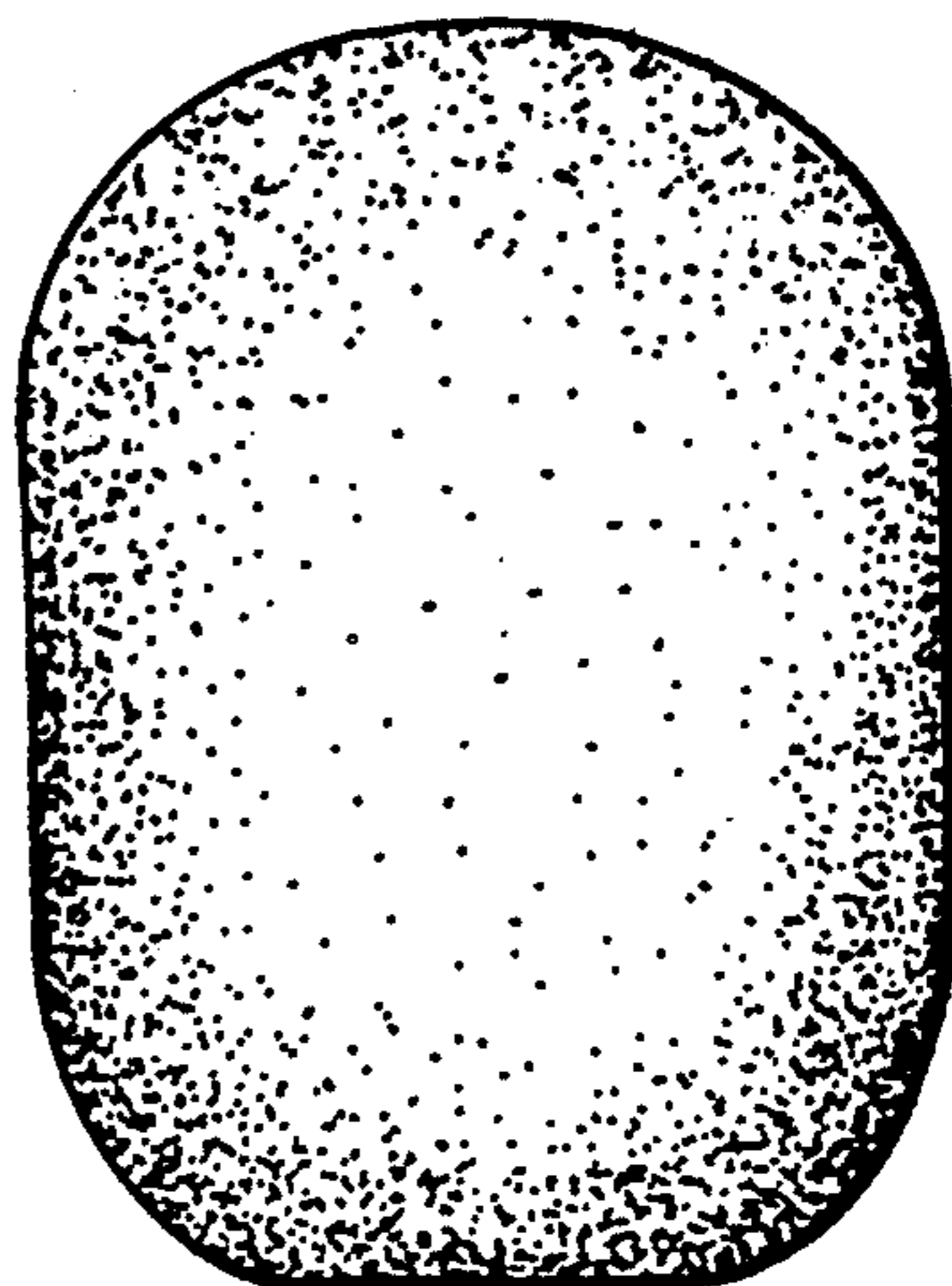
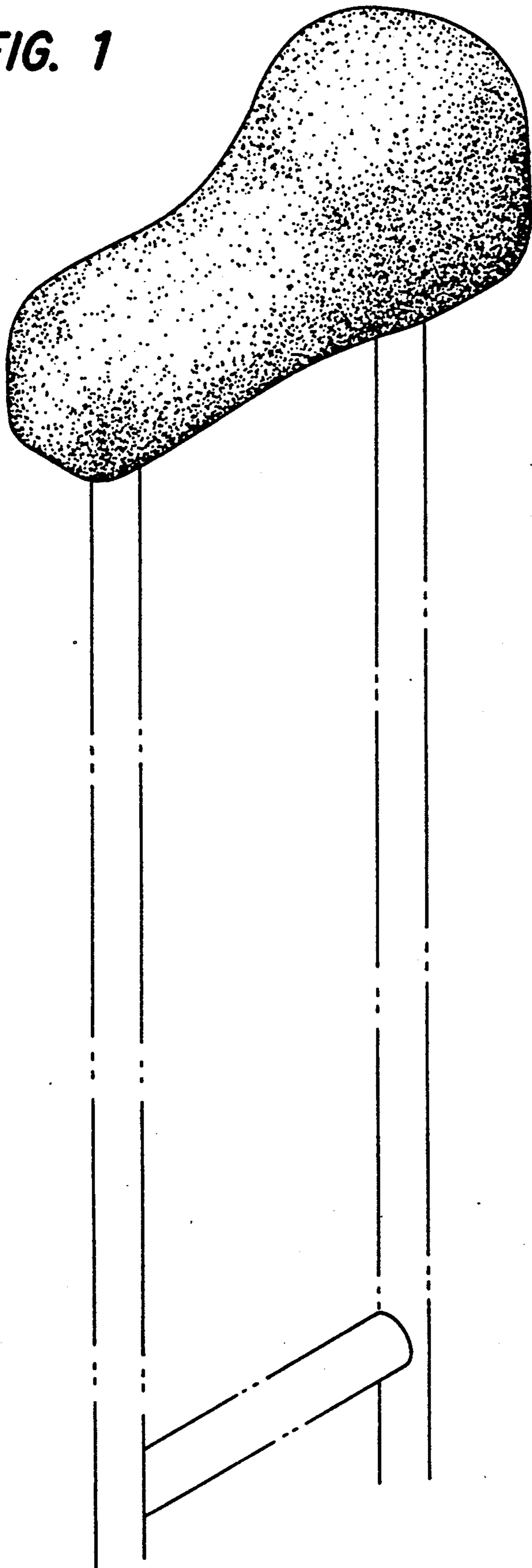

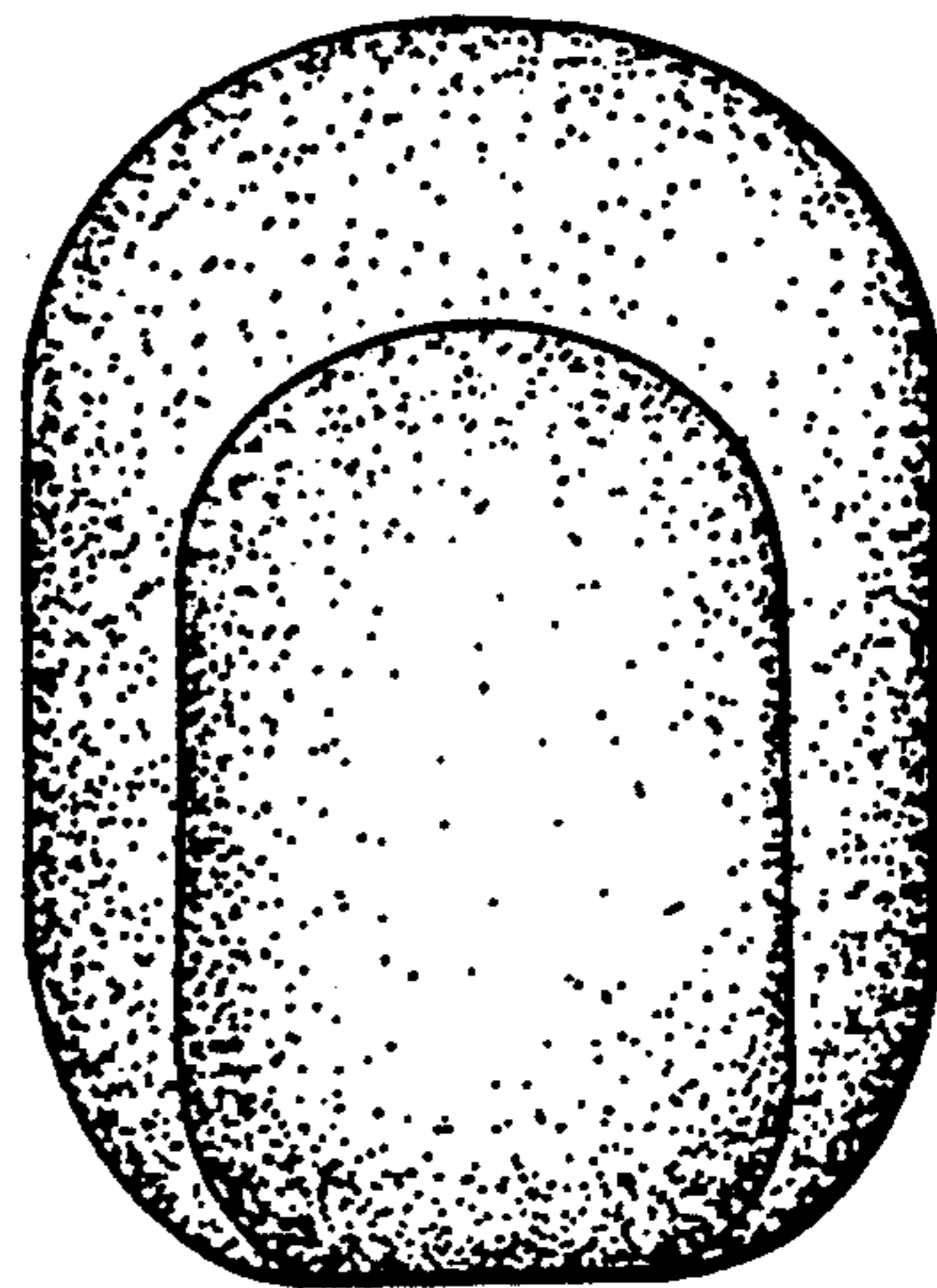

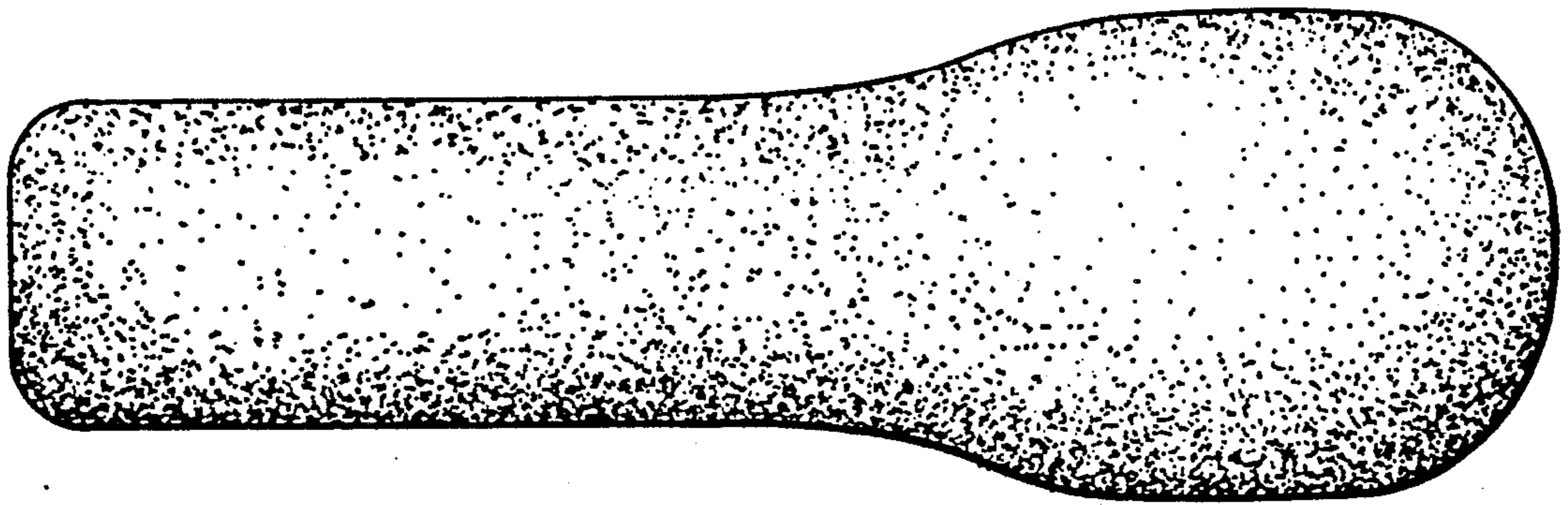

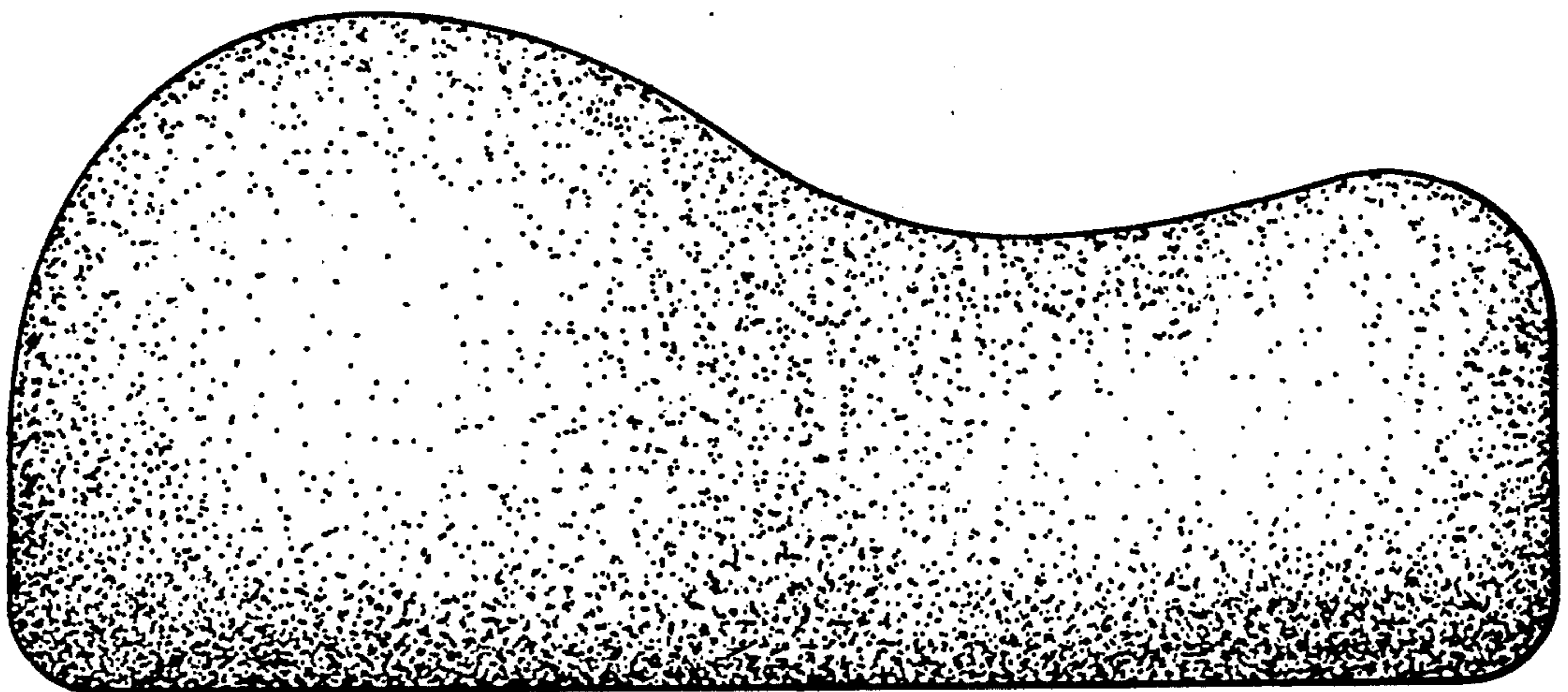

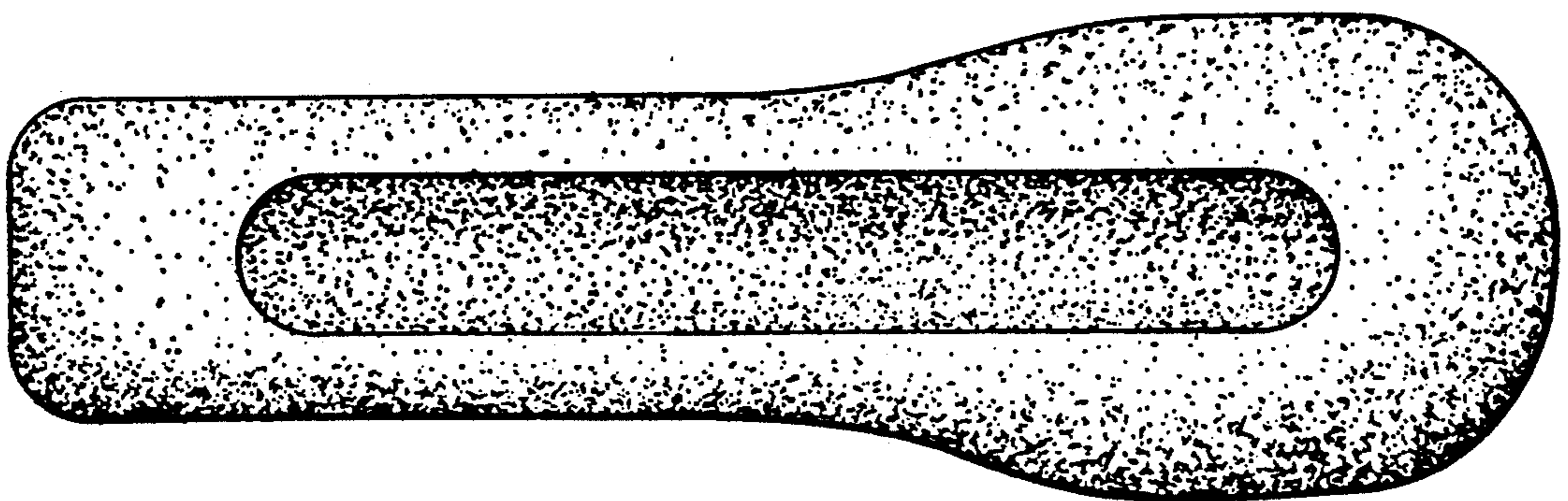
