FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

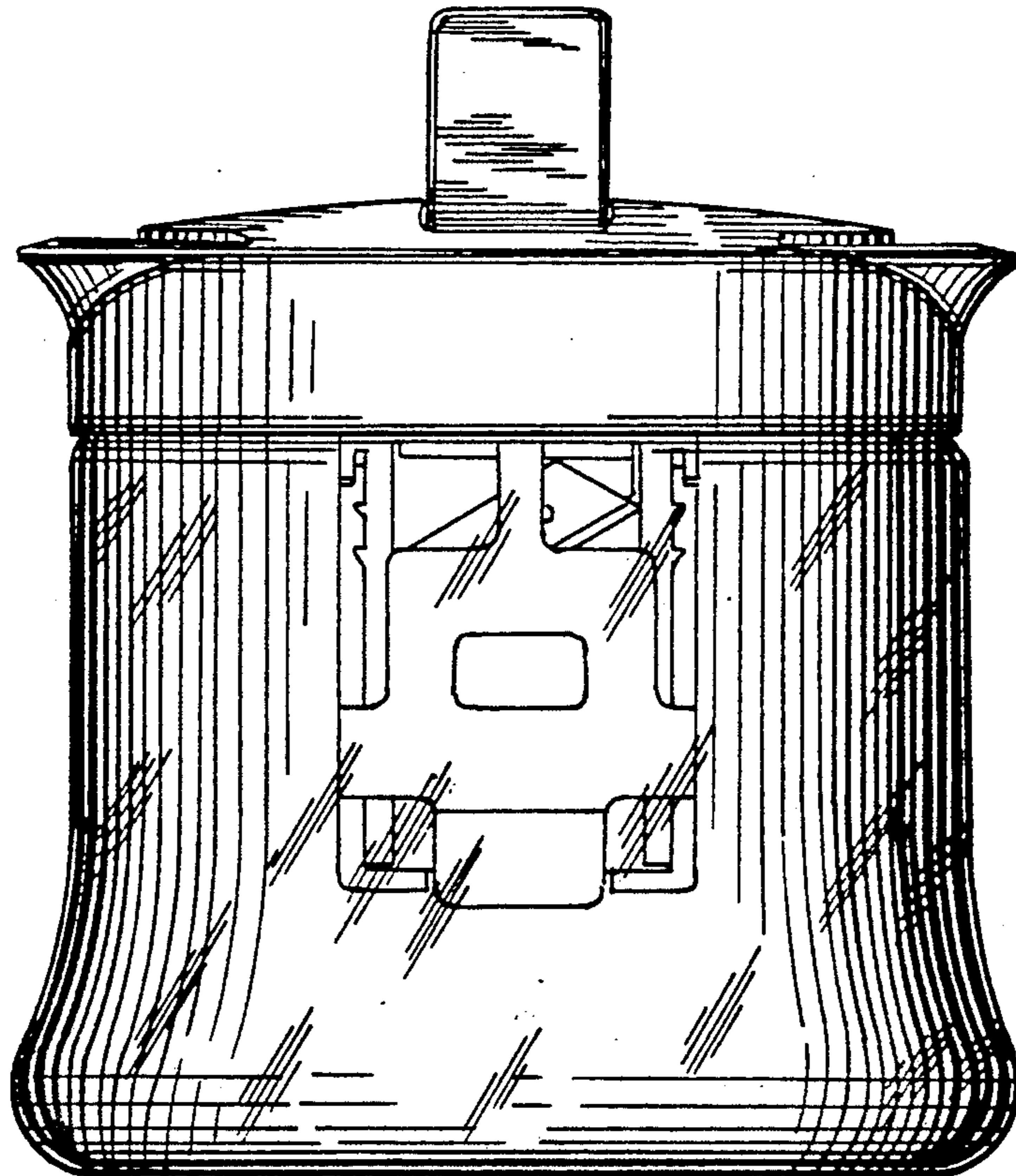
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof with the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; and

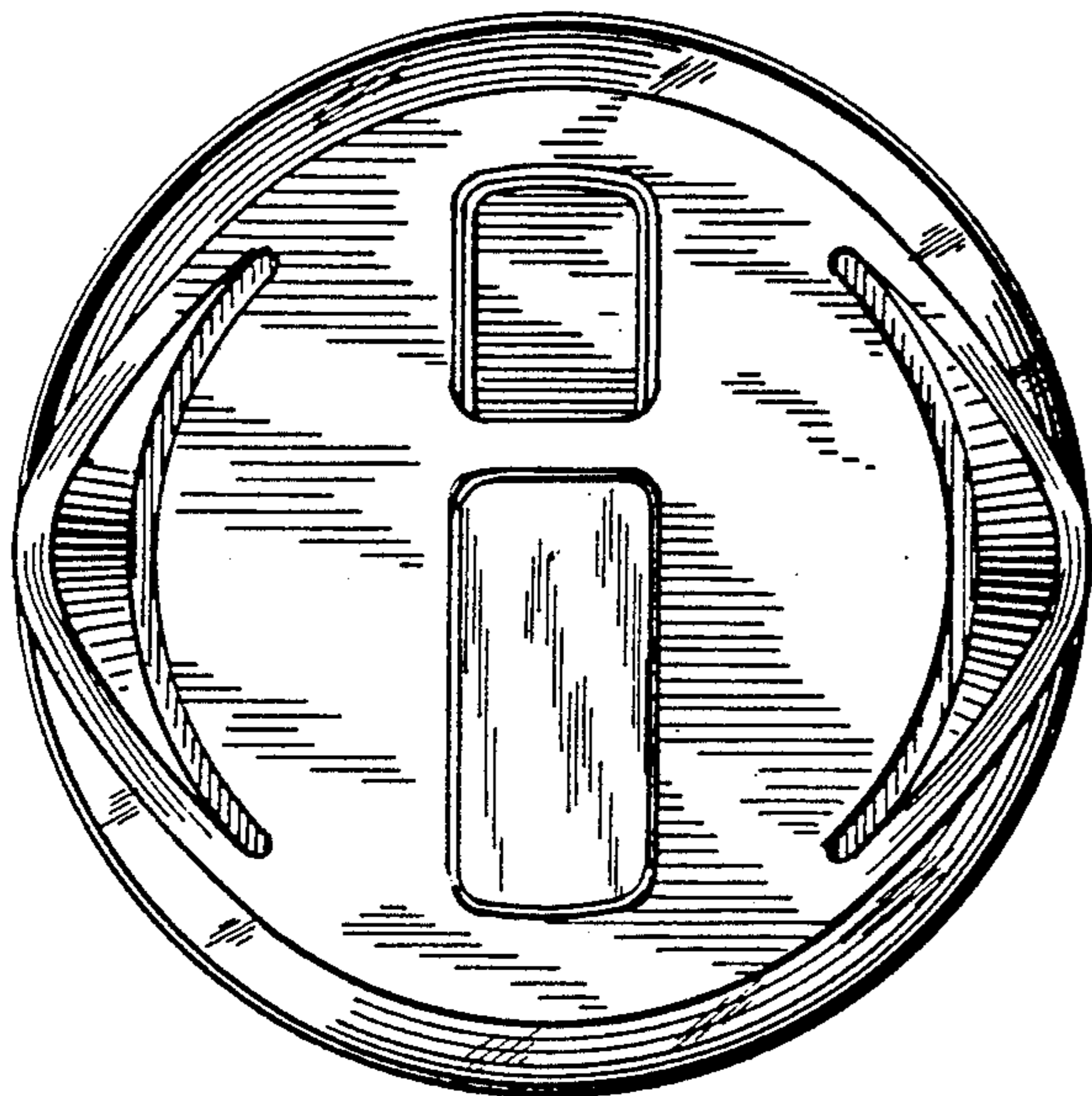

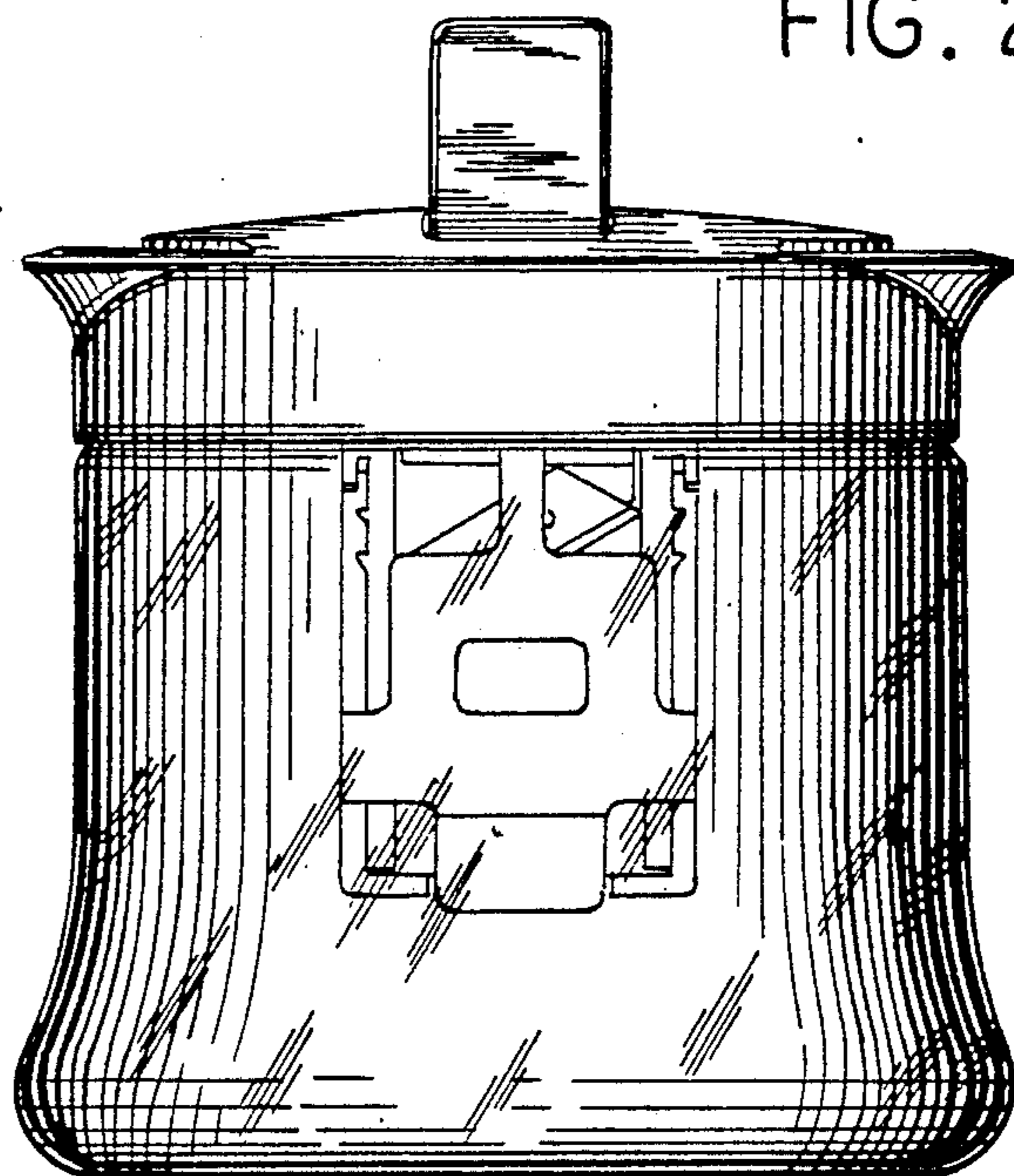

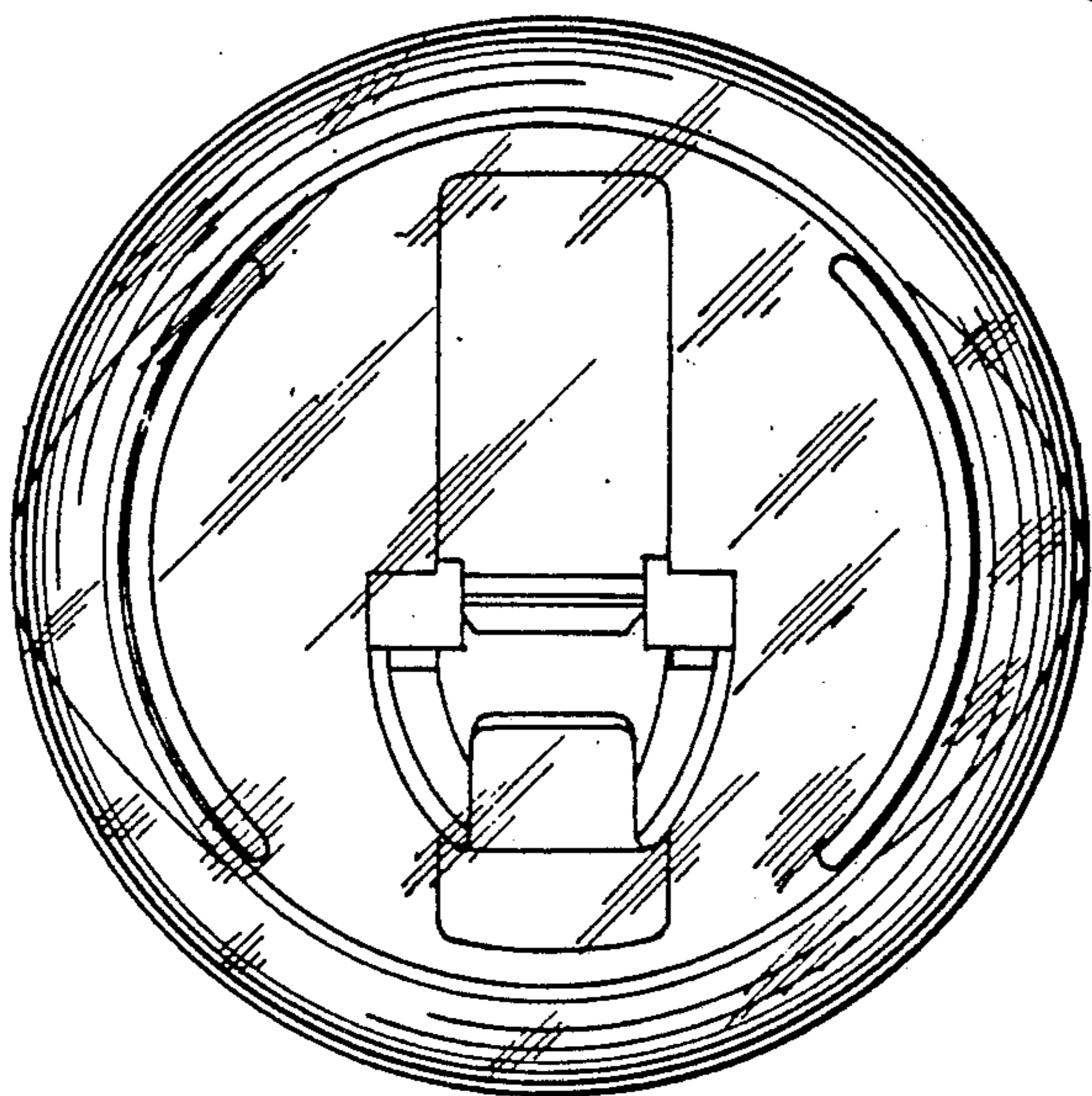

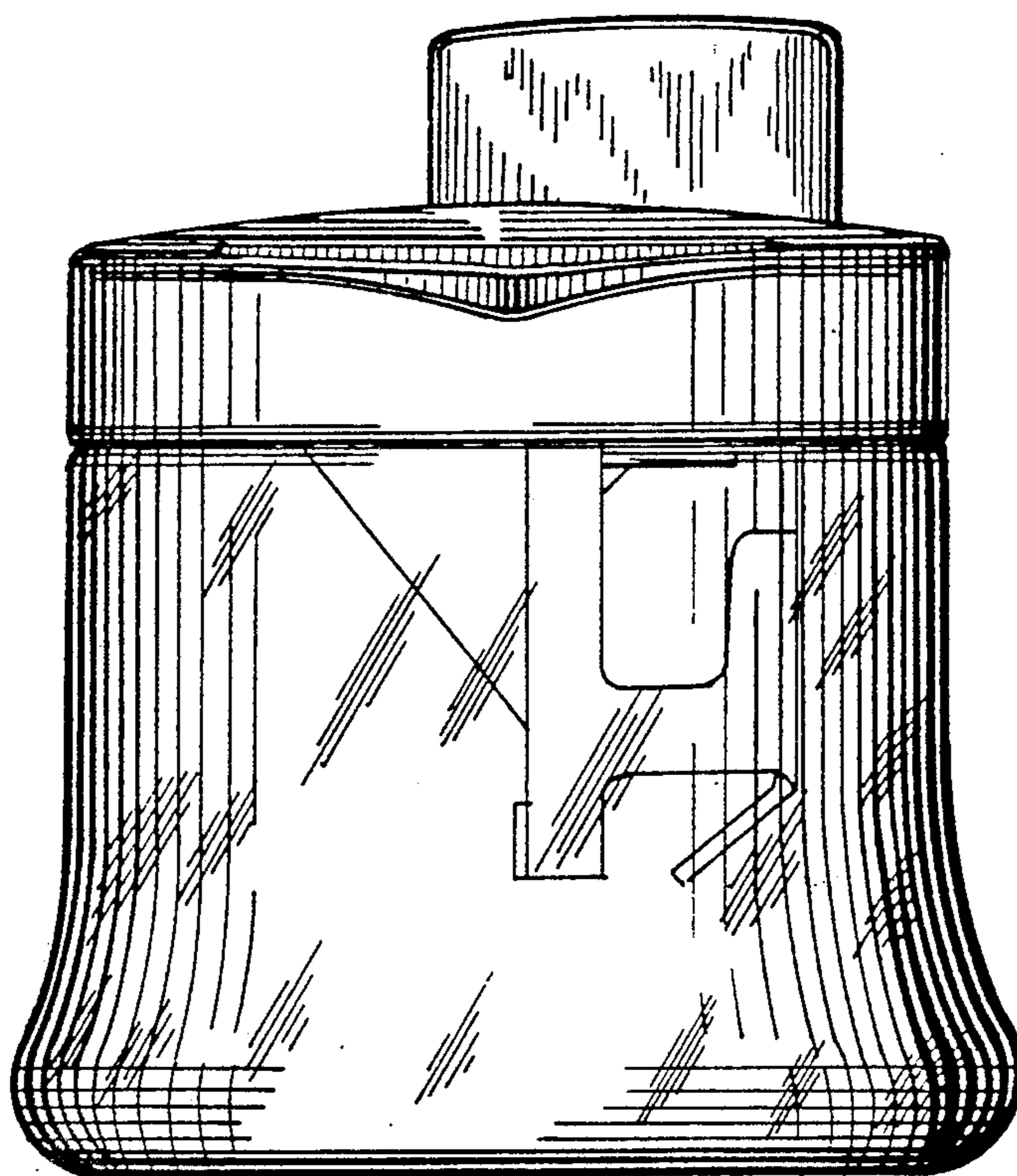
