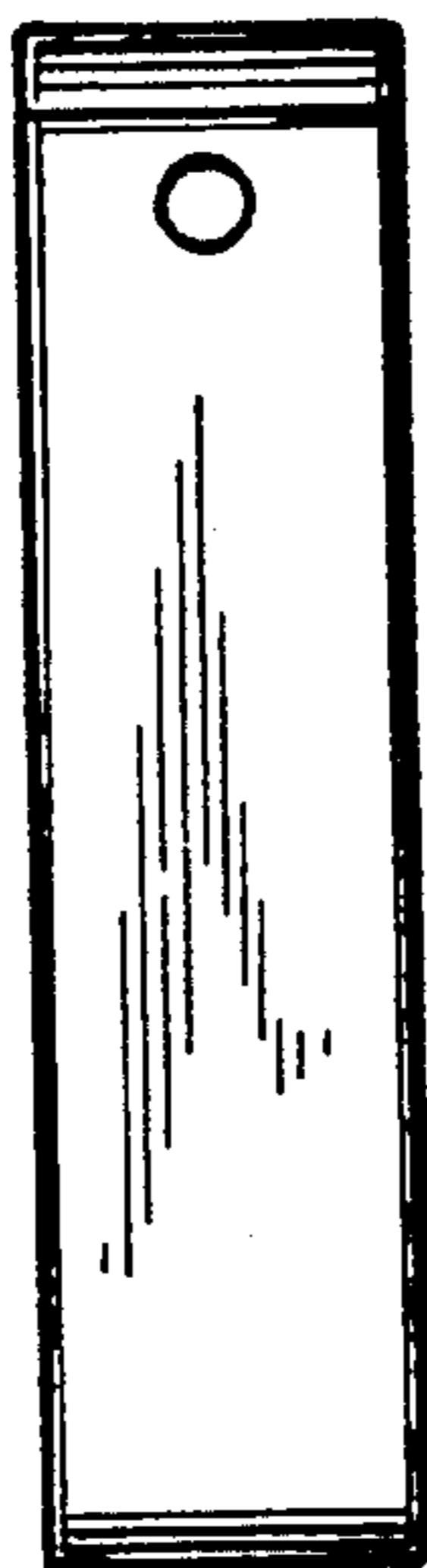
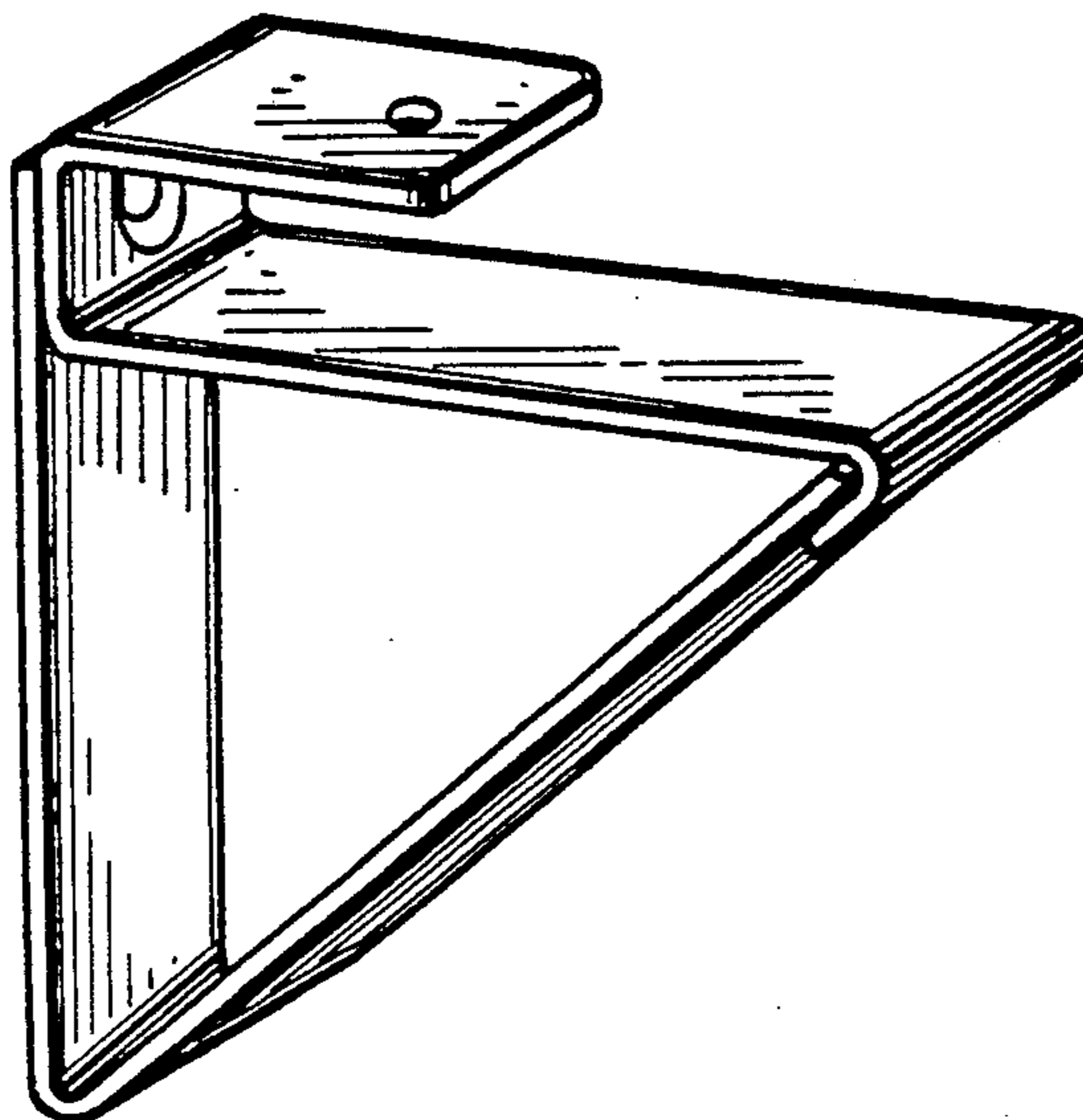

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 a right side, top and rear perspective view of a shelf bracket showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, and the side opposite being a mirror image;

 FIG. 5 is a top plan thereof.



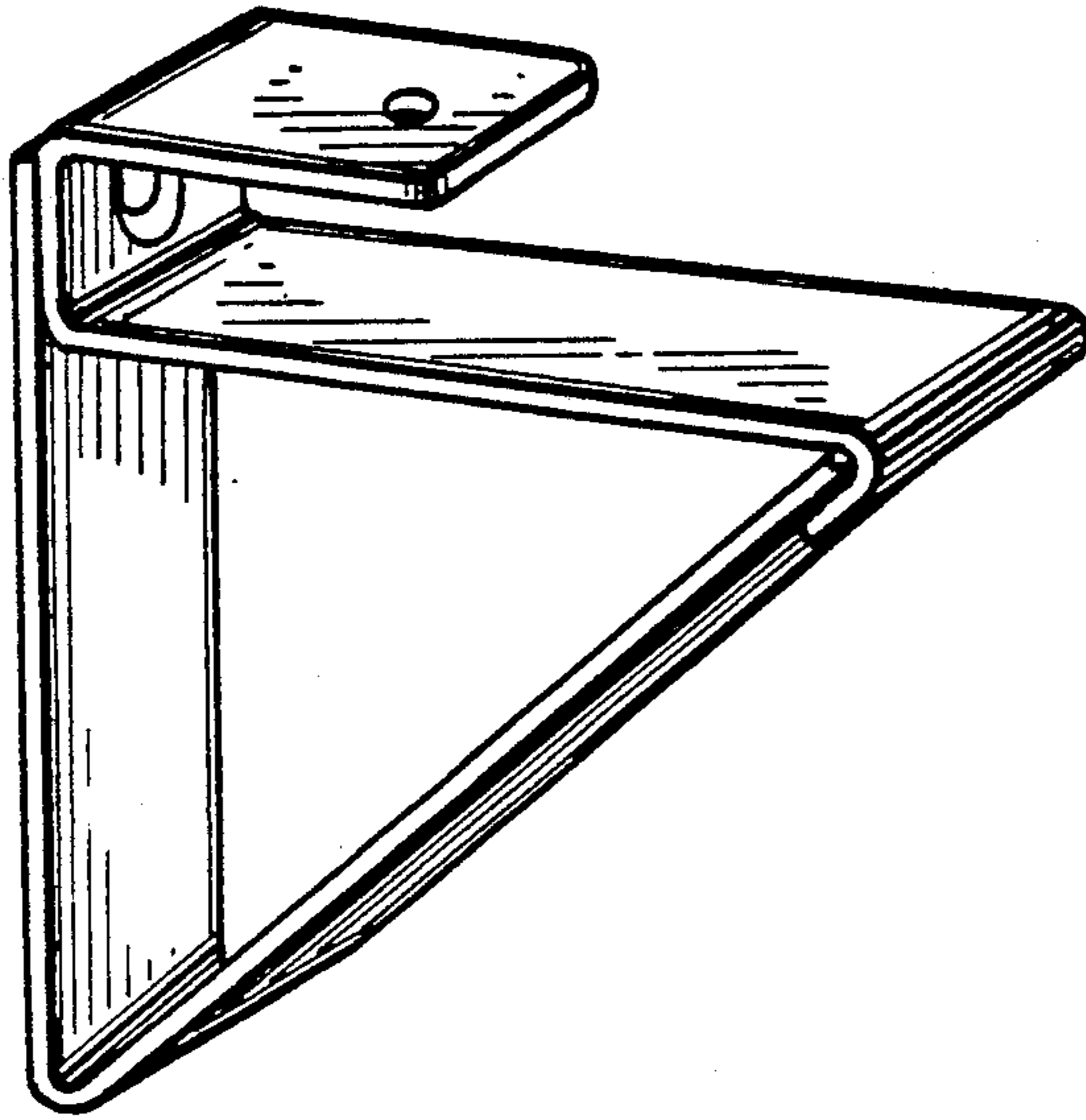

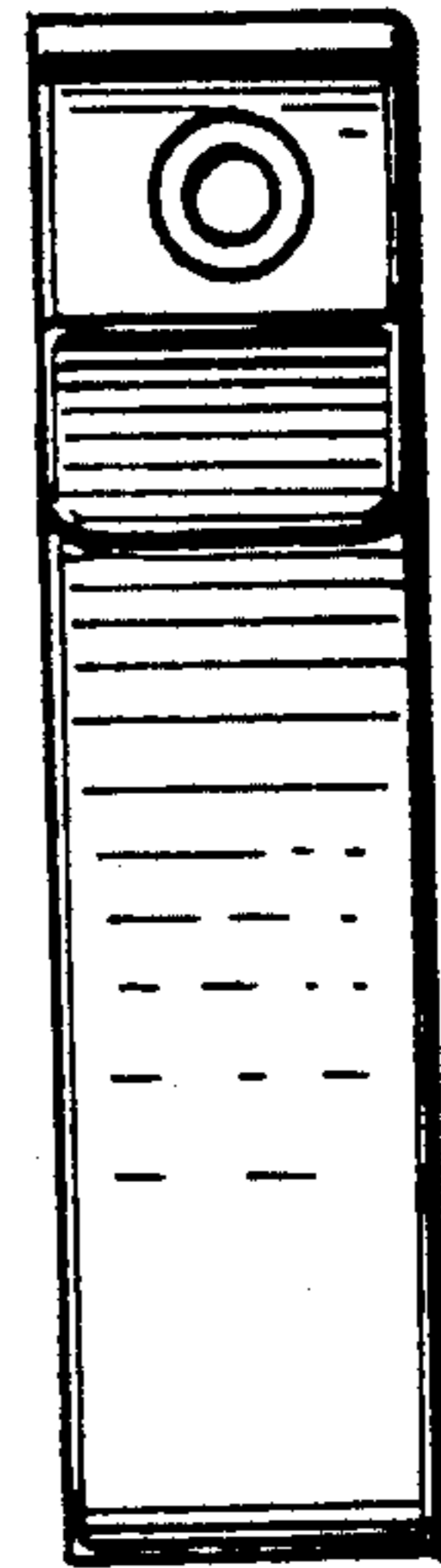

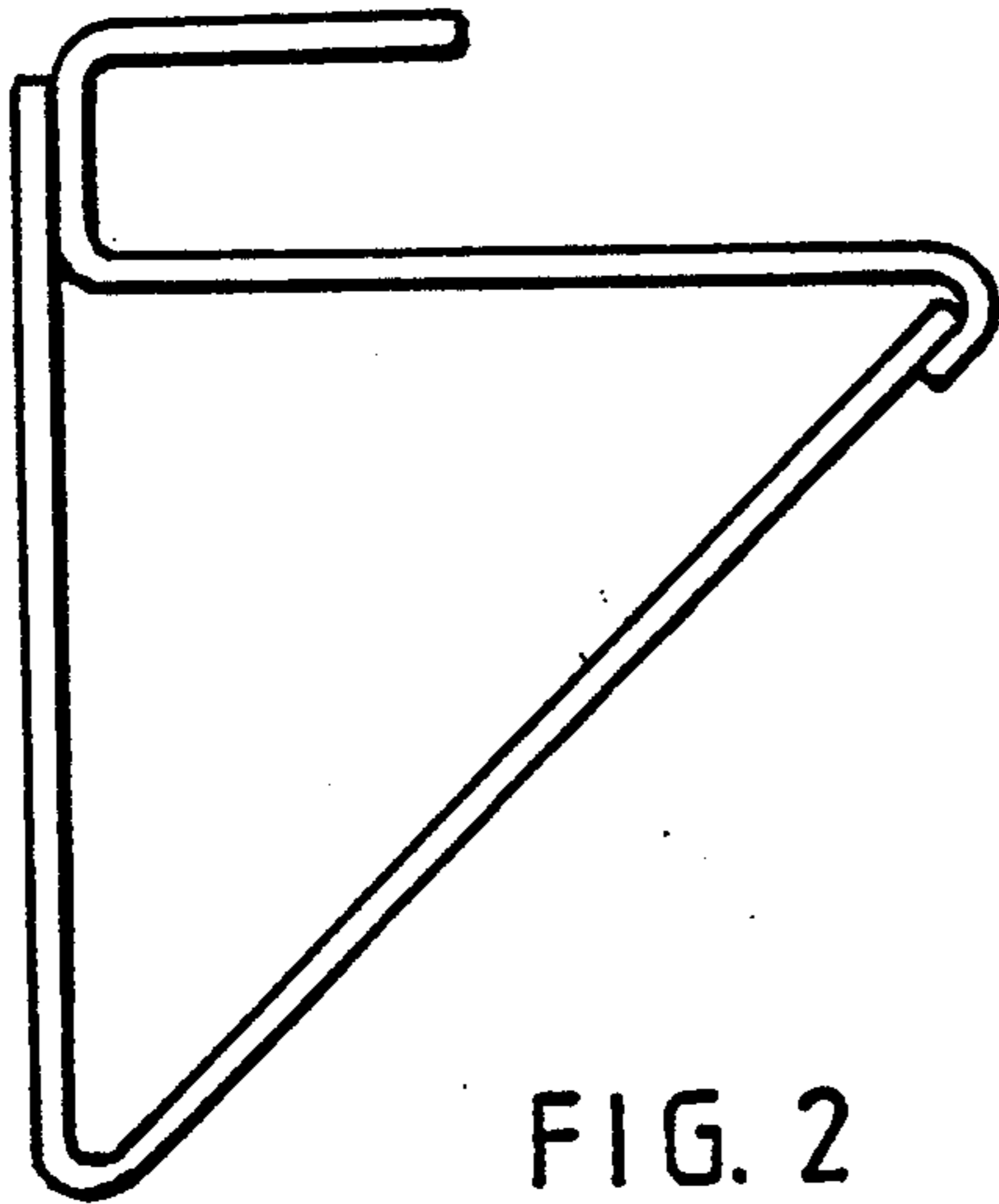

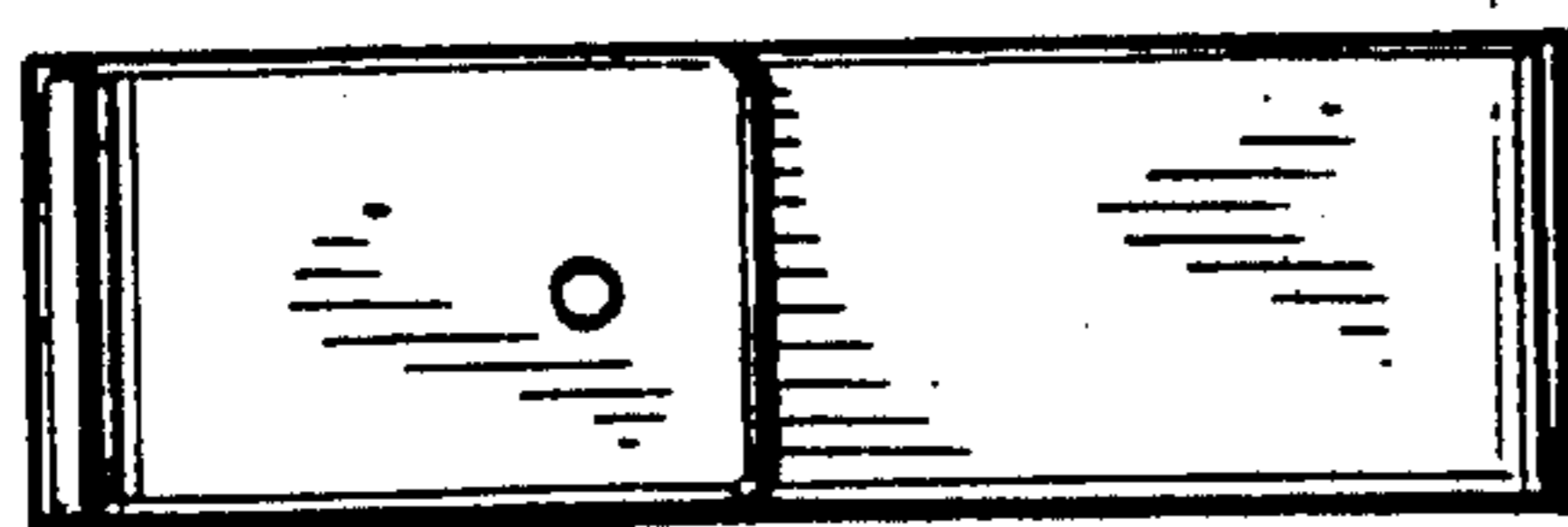
