FIG. 5 is a perspective view.

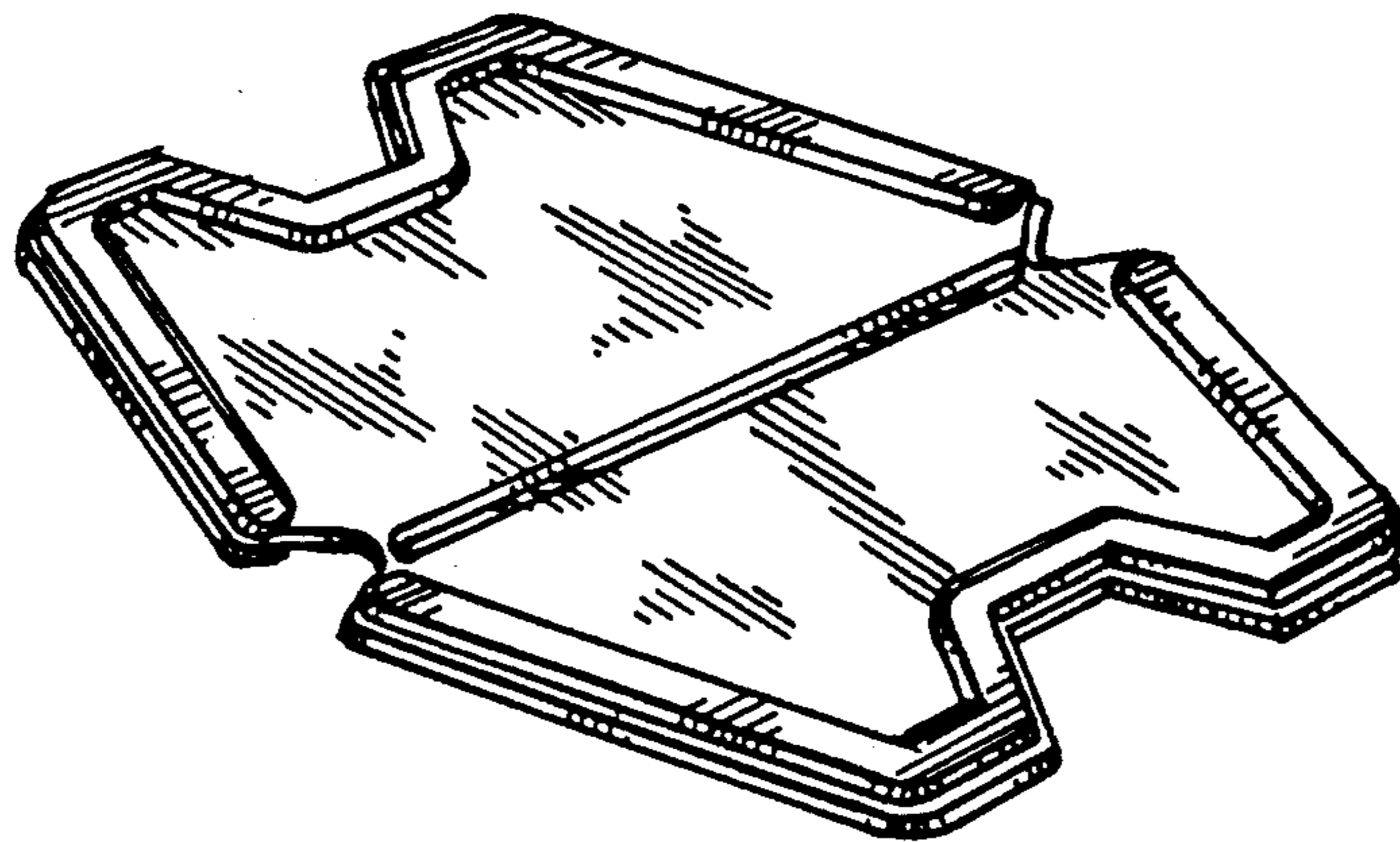

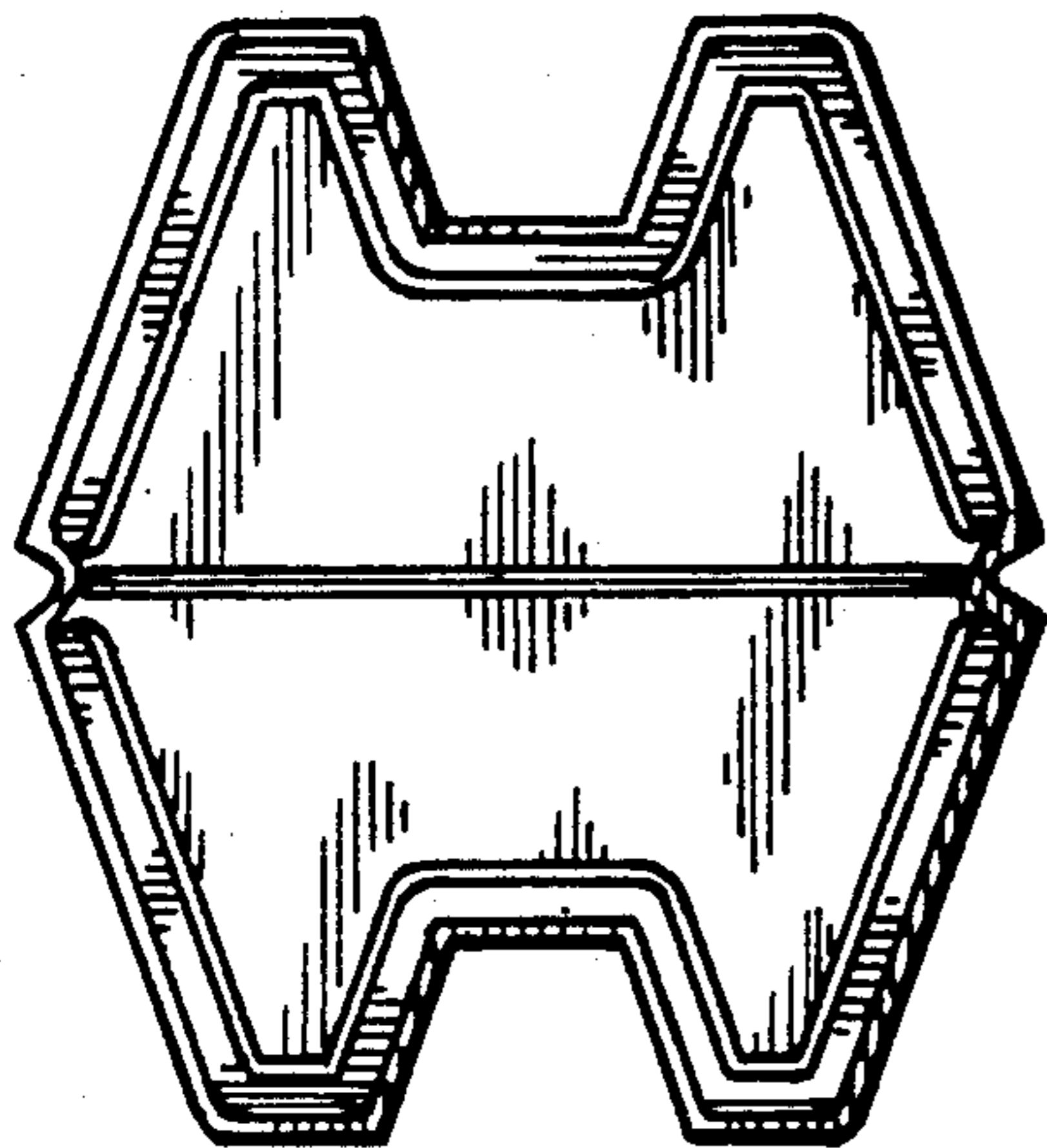

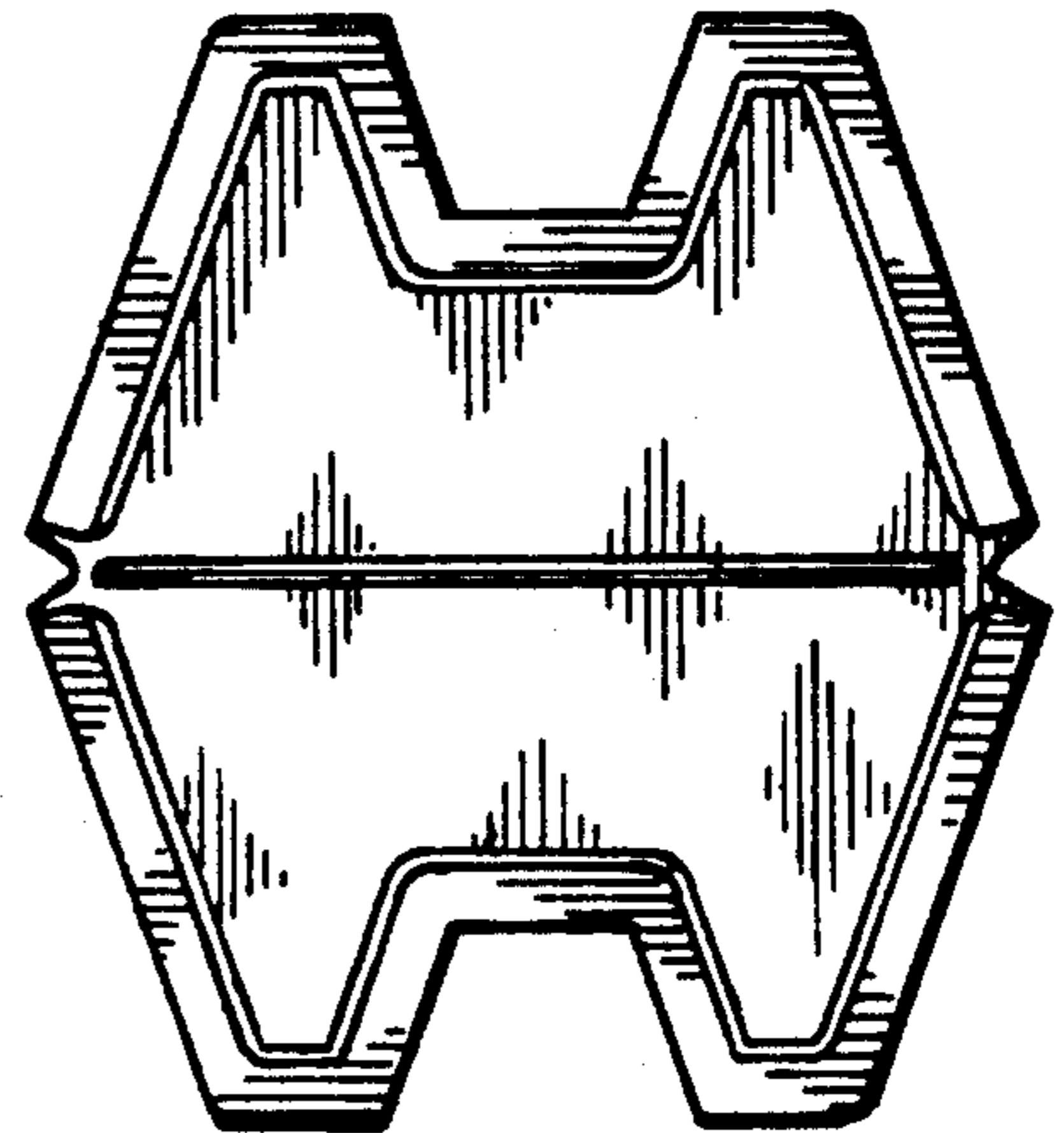

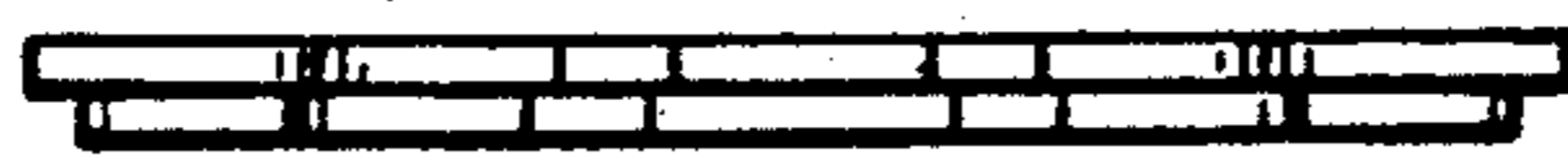
