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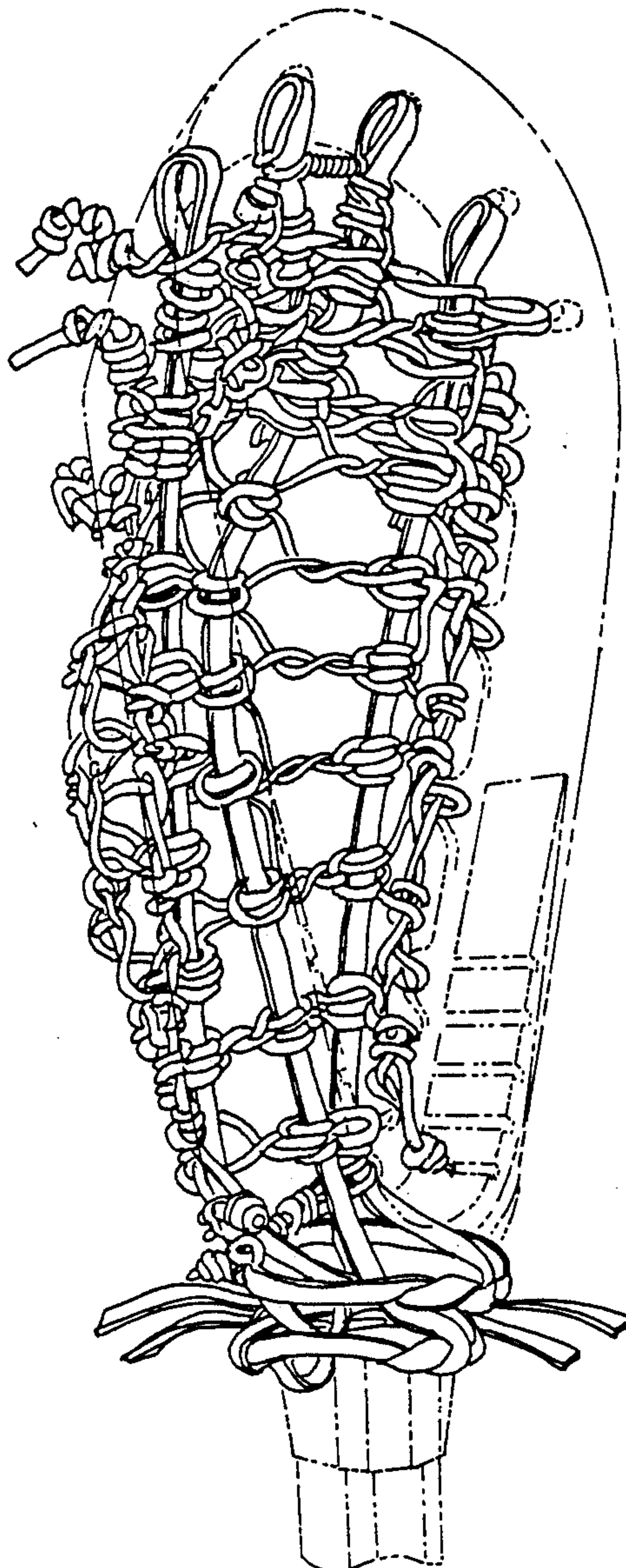

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the lacrosse stick
pocket showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

tive purposes only.



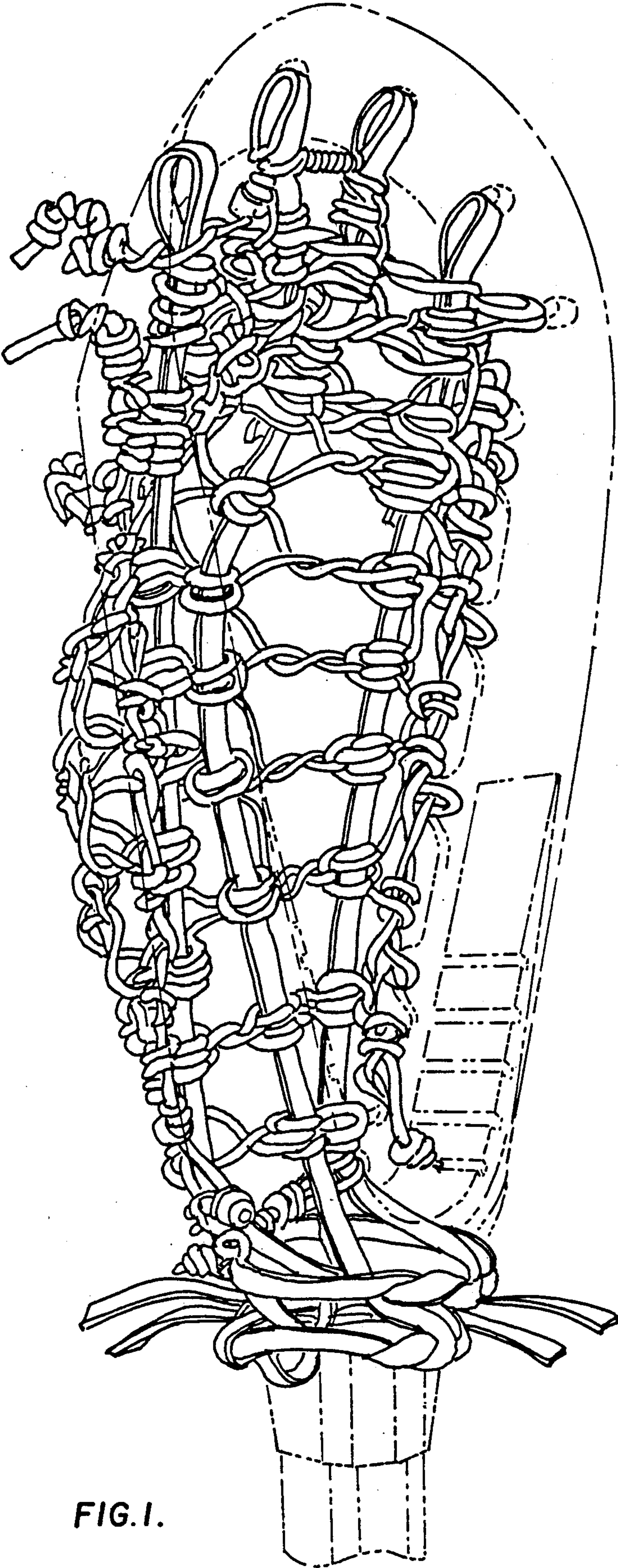

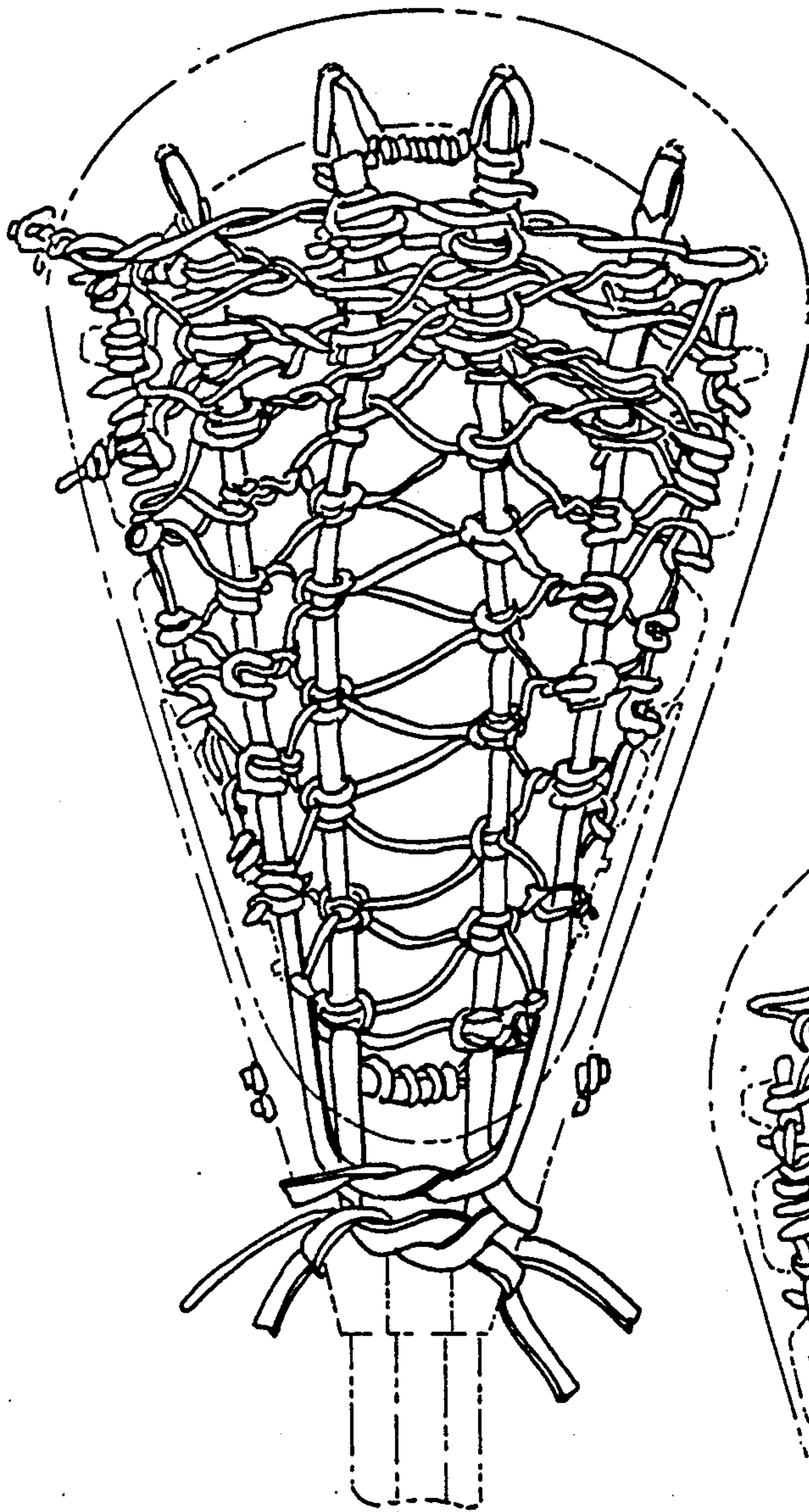

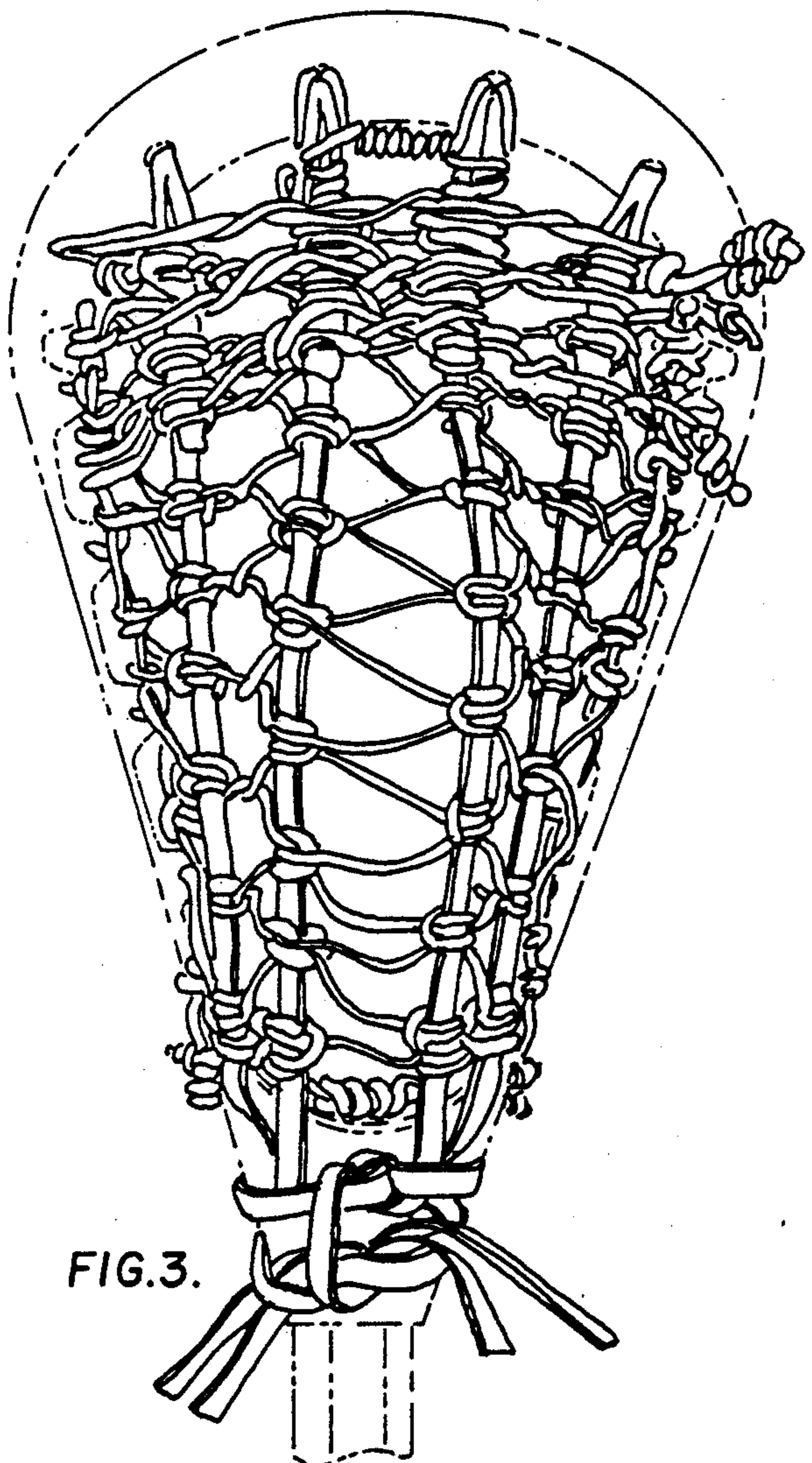

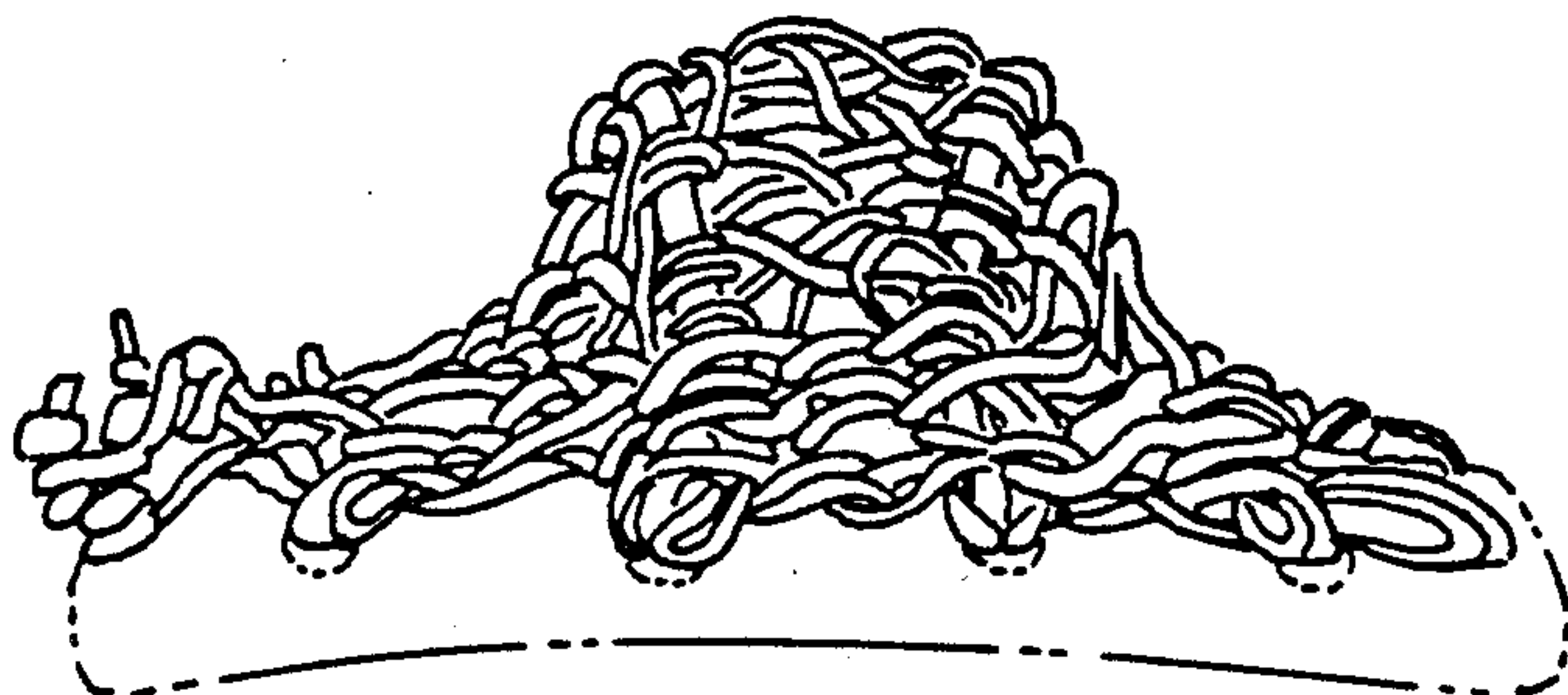

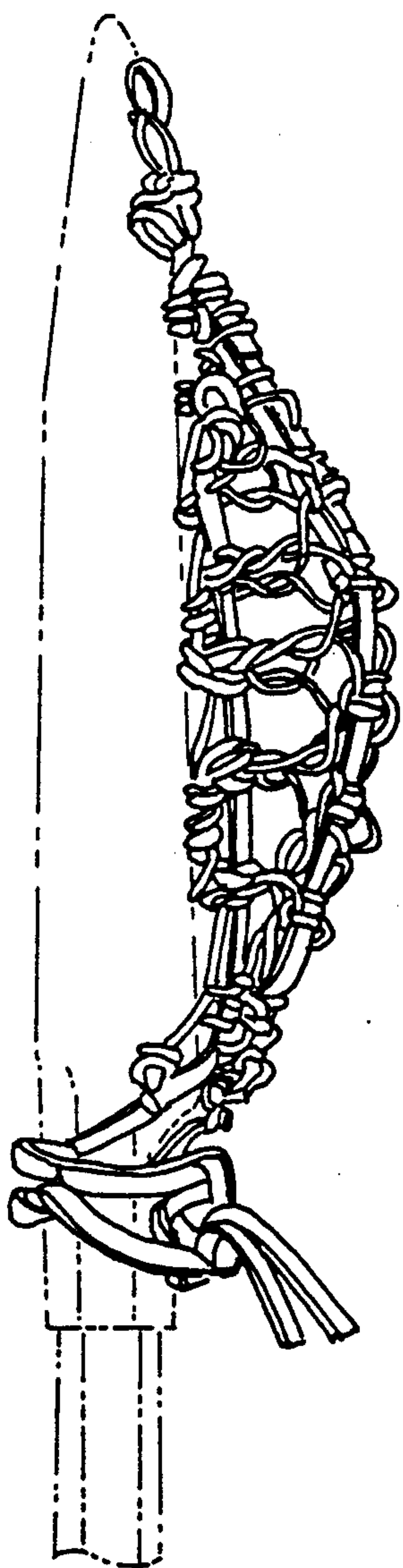

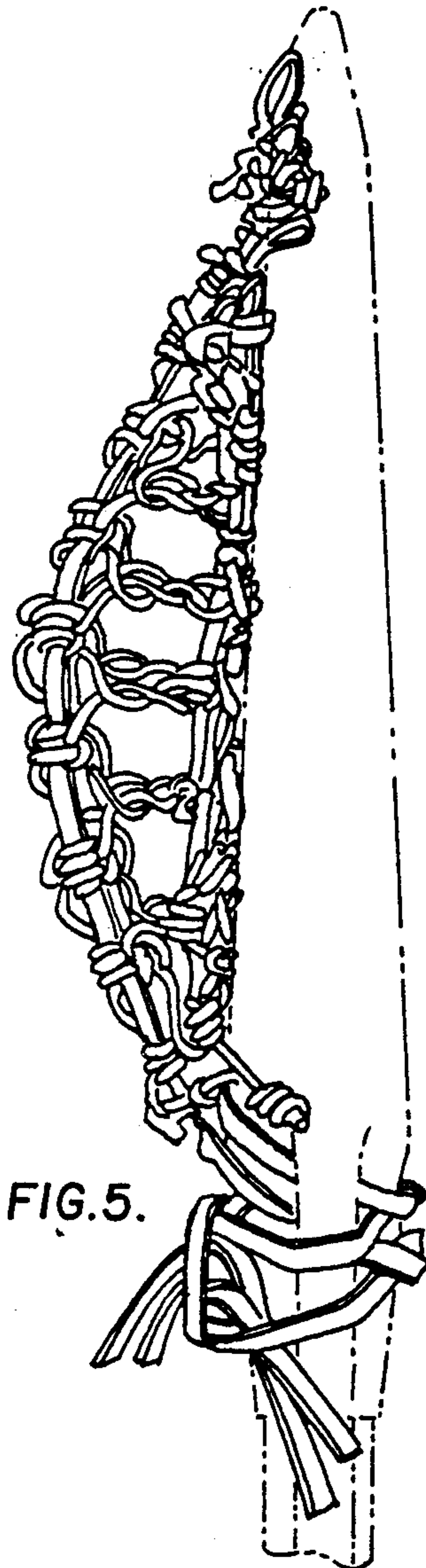

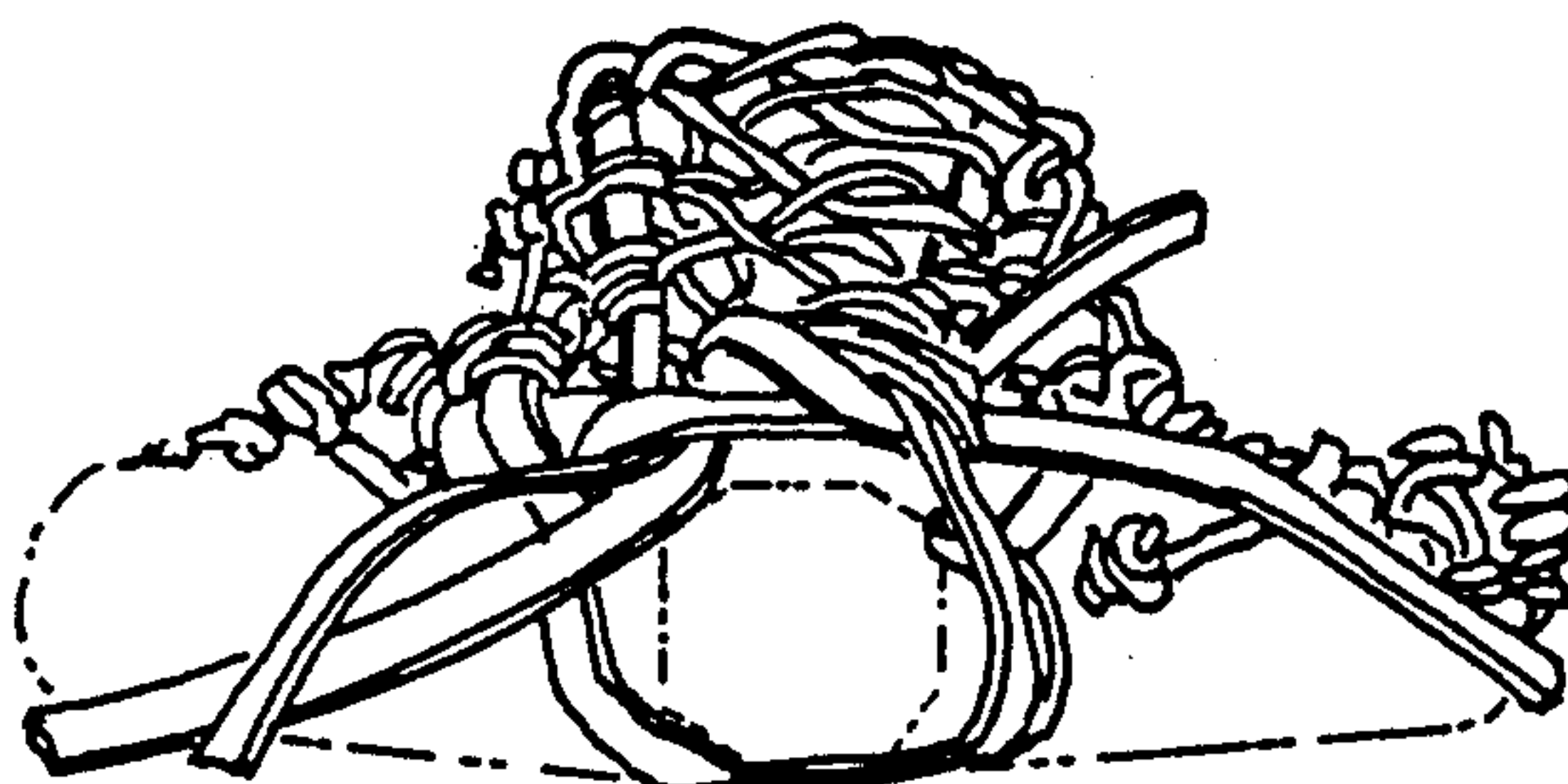
