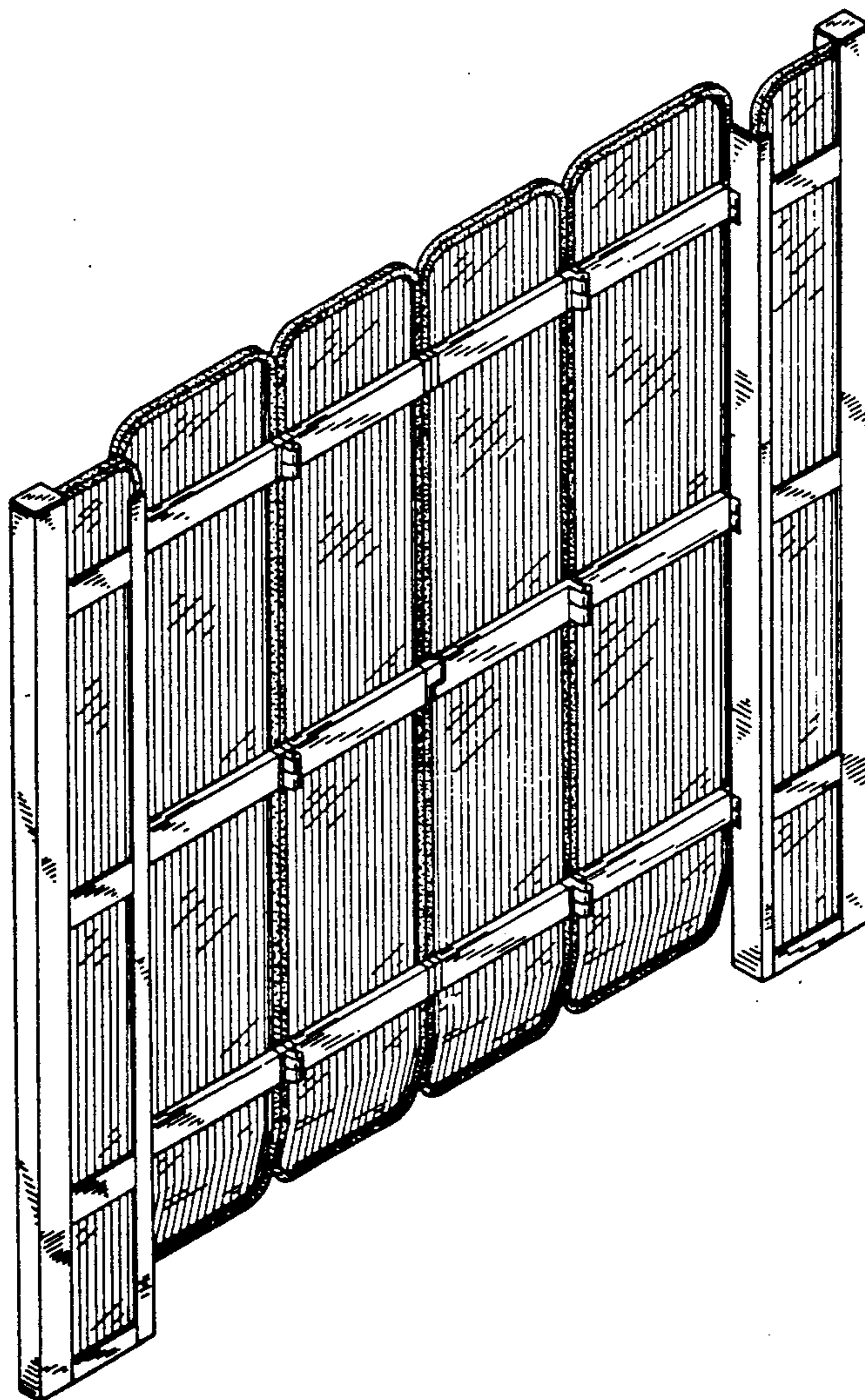

The ornamental design for a shower door, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side of a shower door showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a perspective view taken from the top, rear and left side thereof; FIG. 3 is a perspective view taken from the top, rear and left side of second embodiment thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 1, the right side being a mirror image of the left side shown; and FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 3.



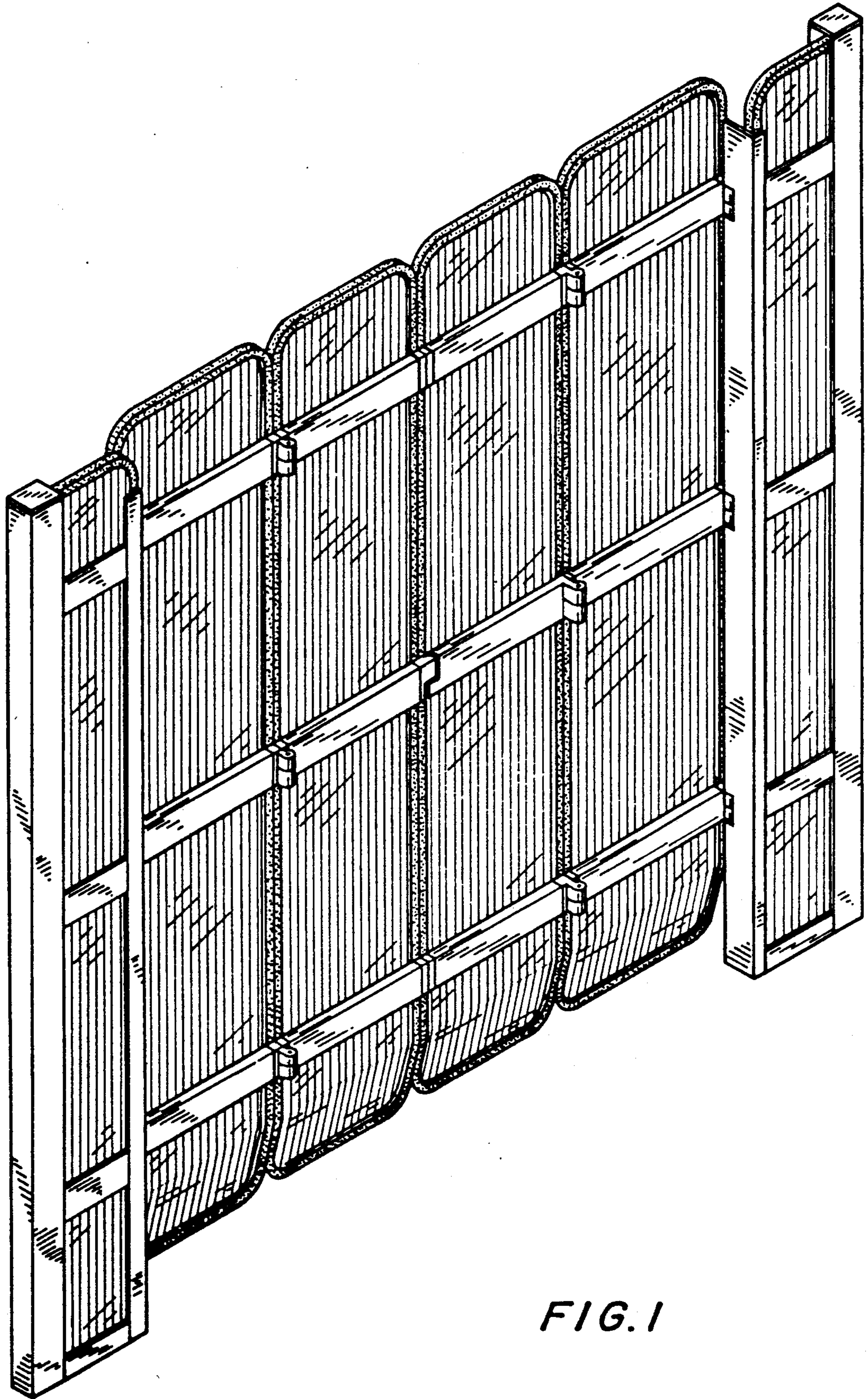

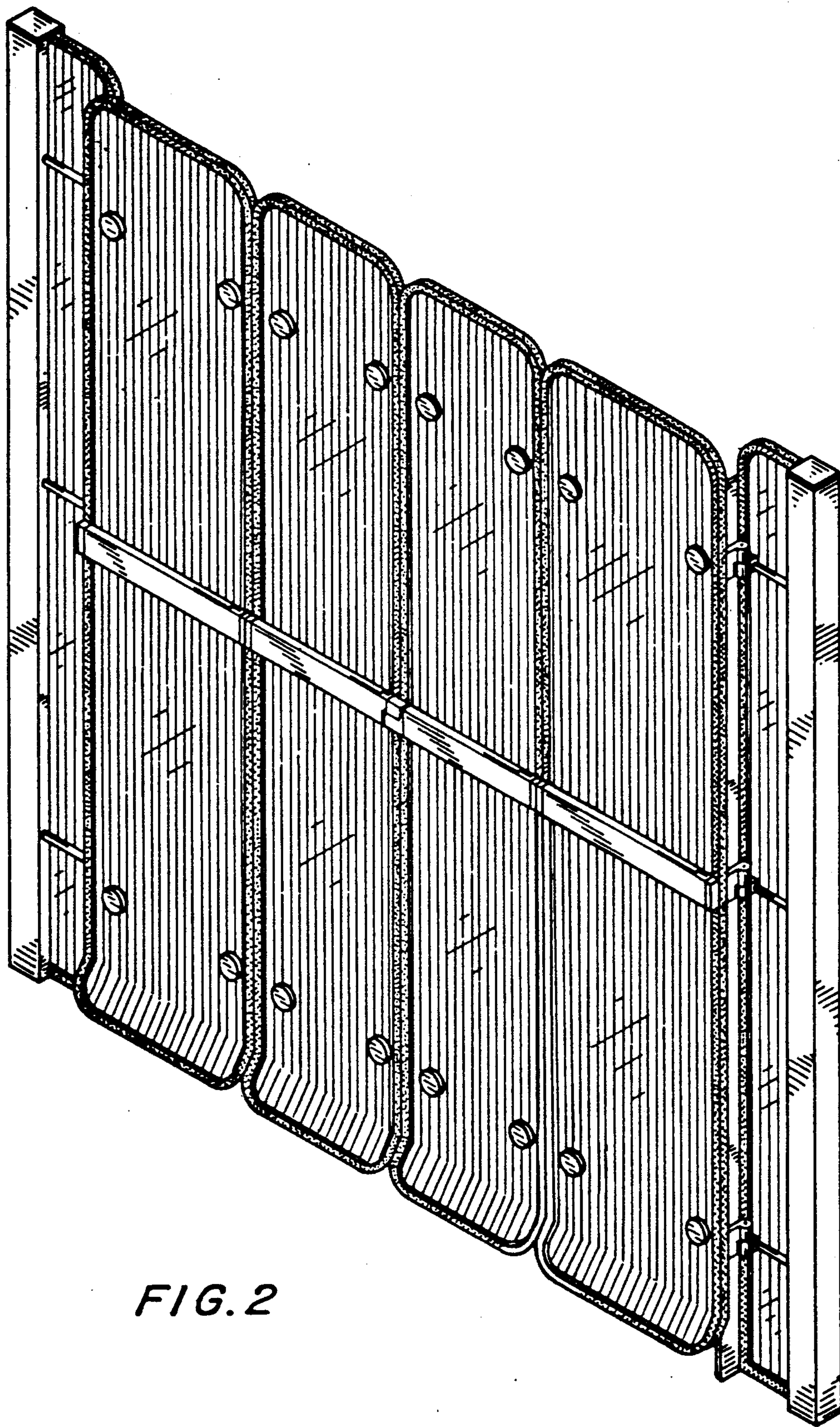

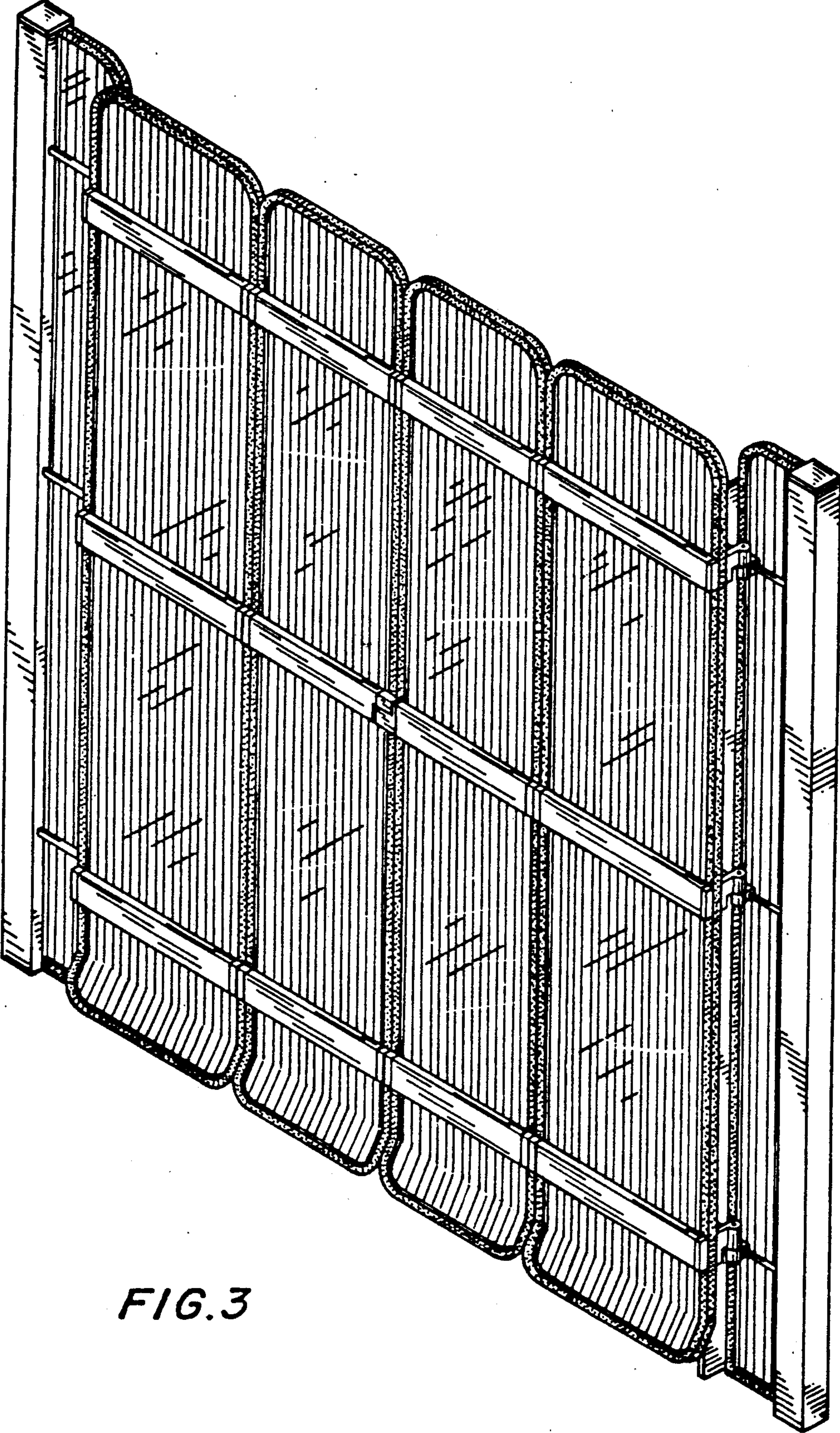

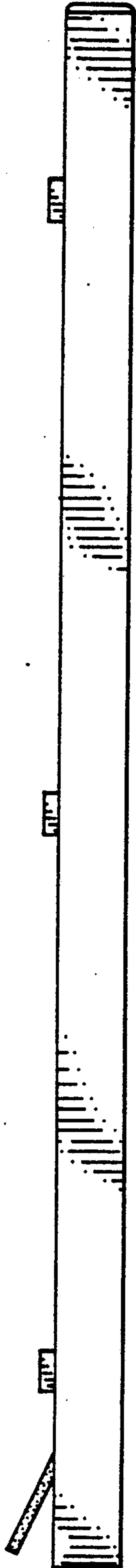

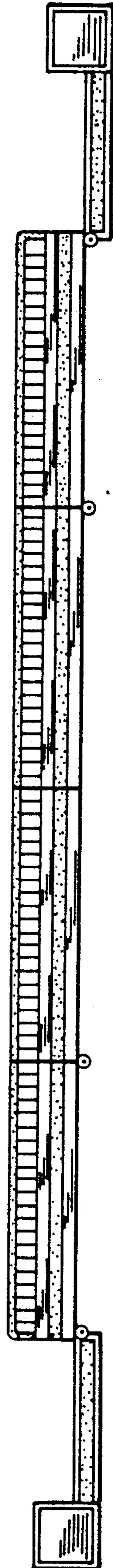
