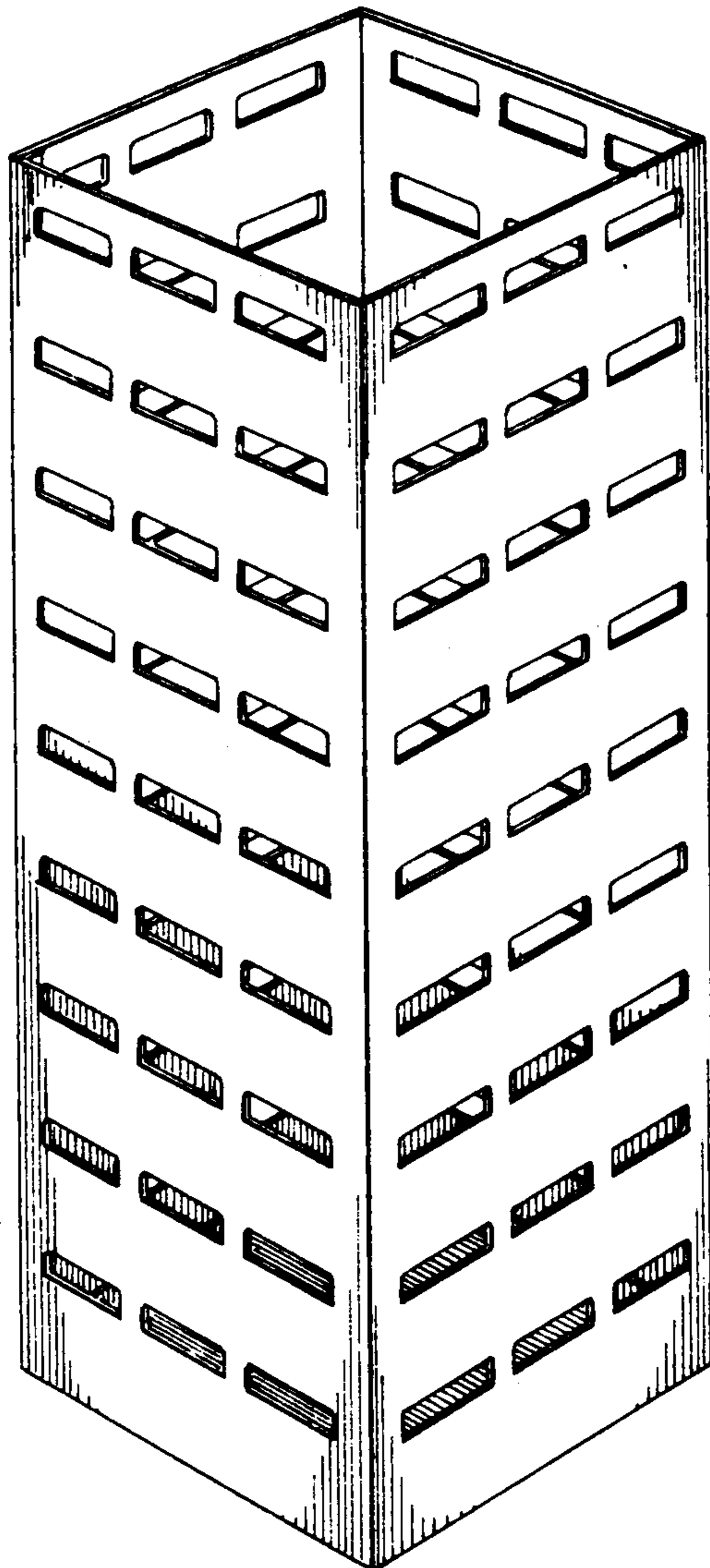

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a jewelry display stand showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the sides not shown being identical in appearance thereto;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



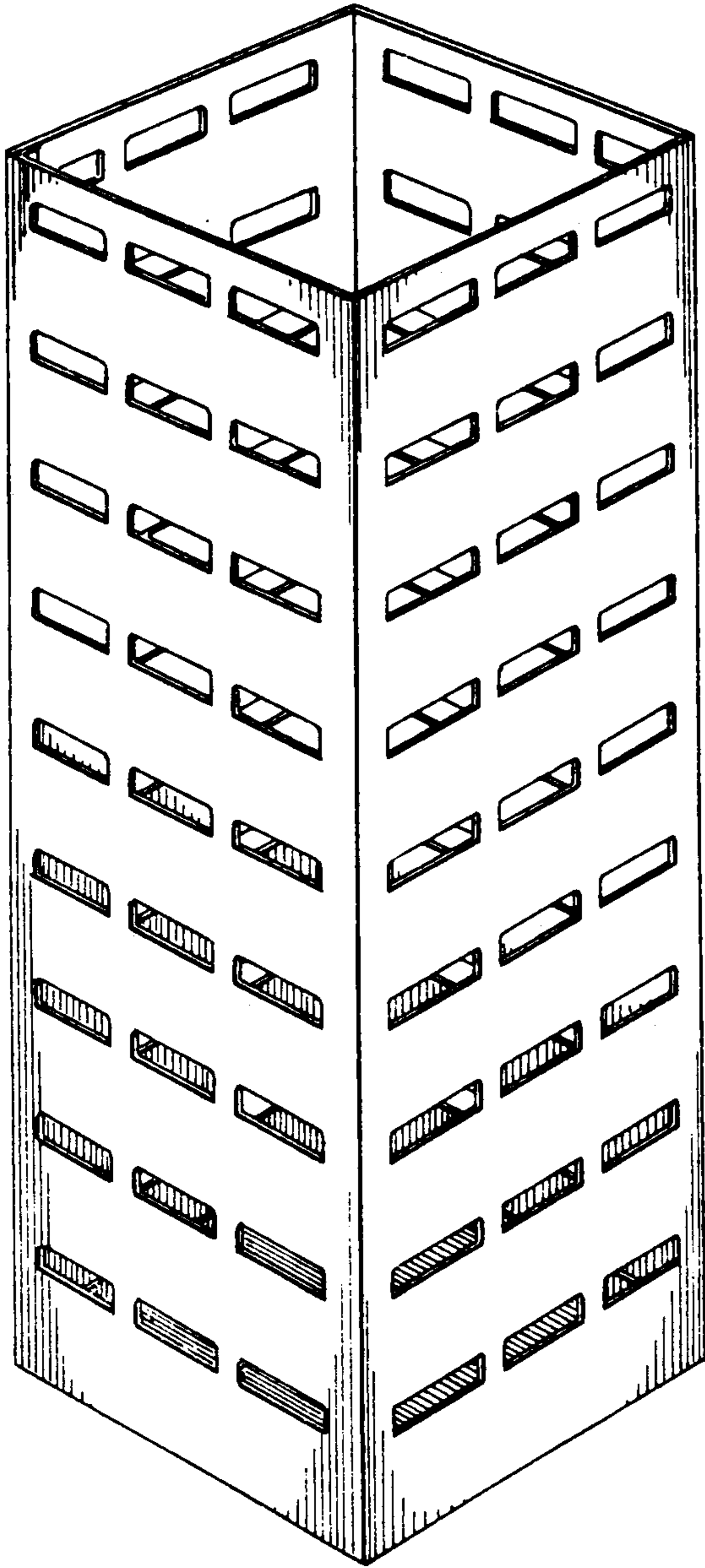

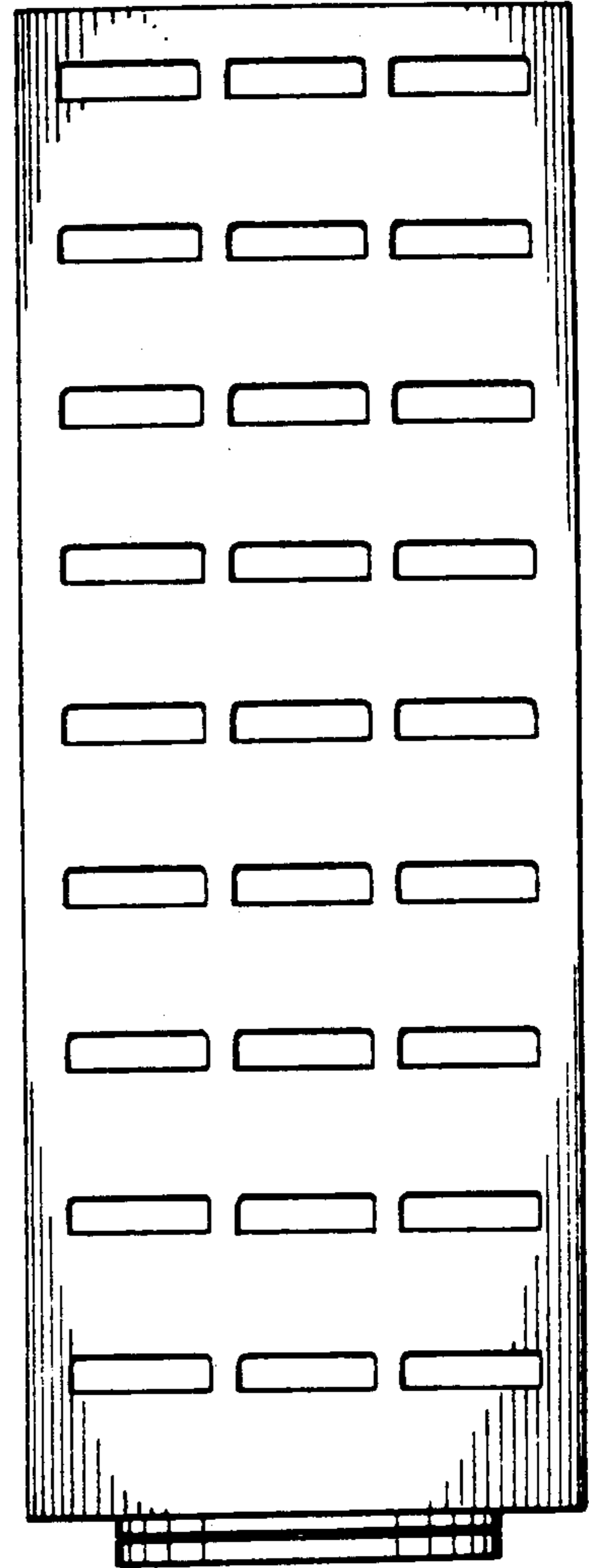

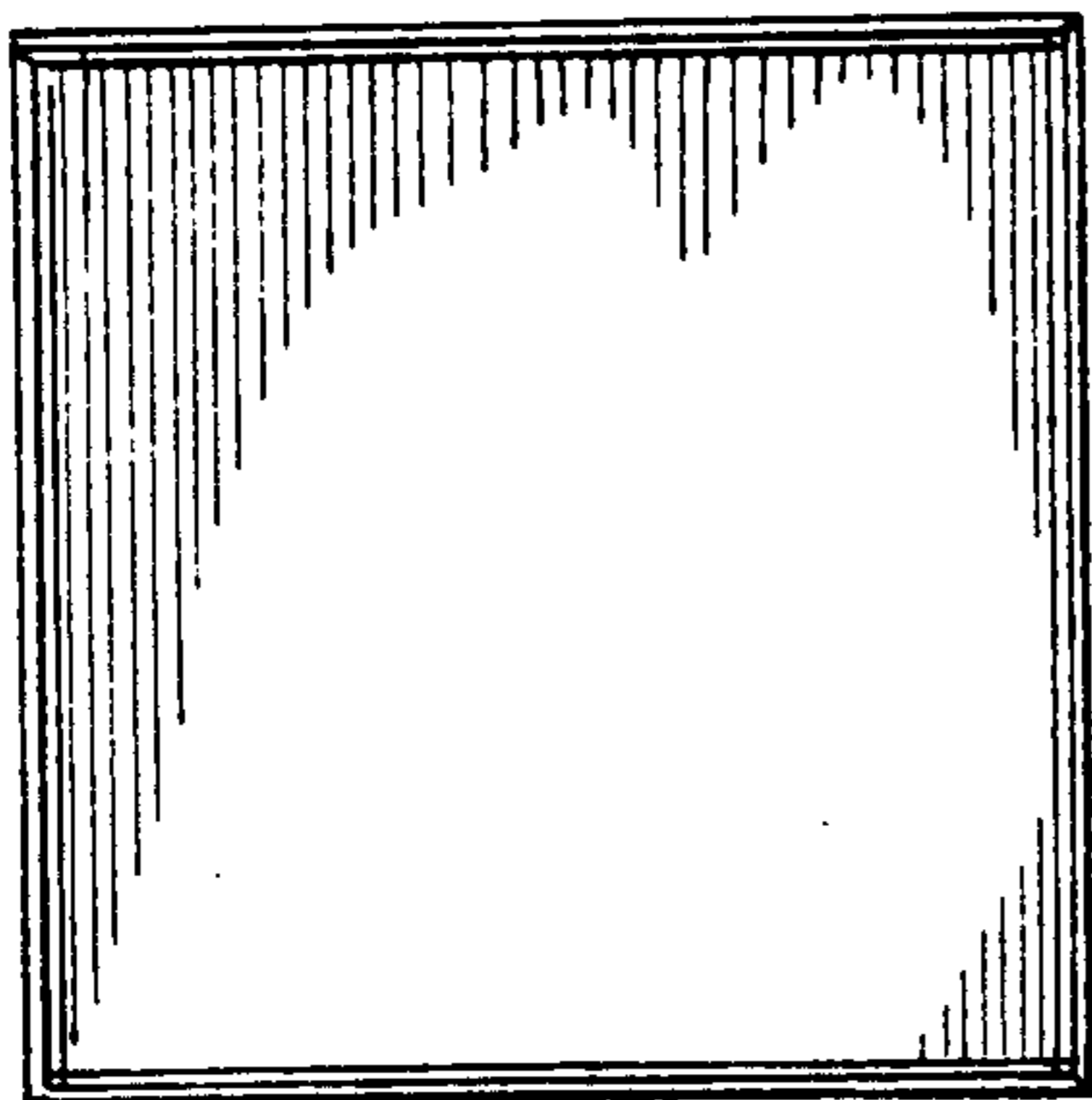

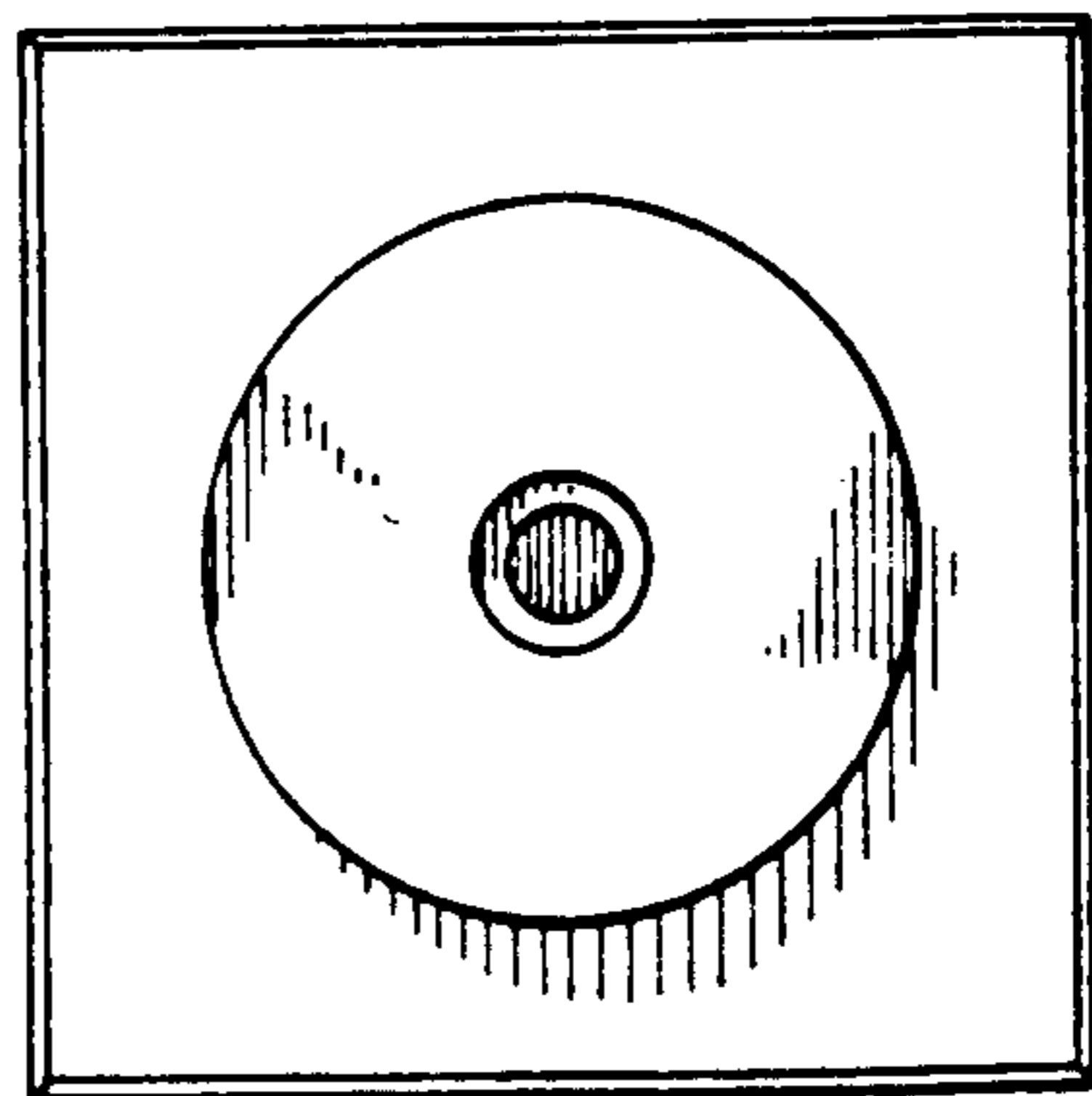
