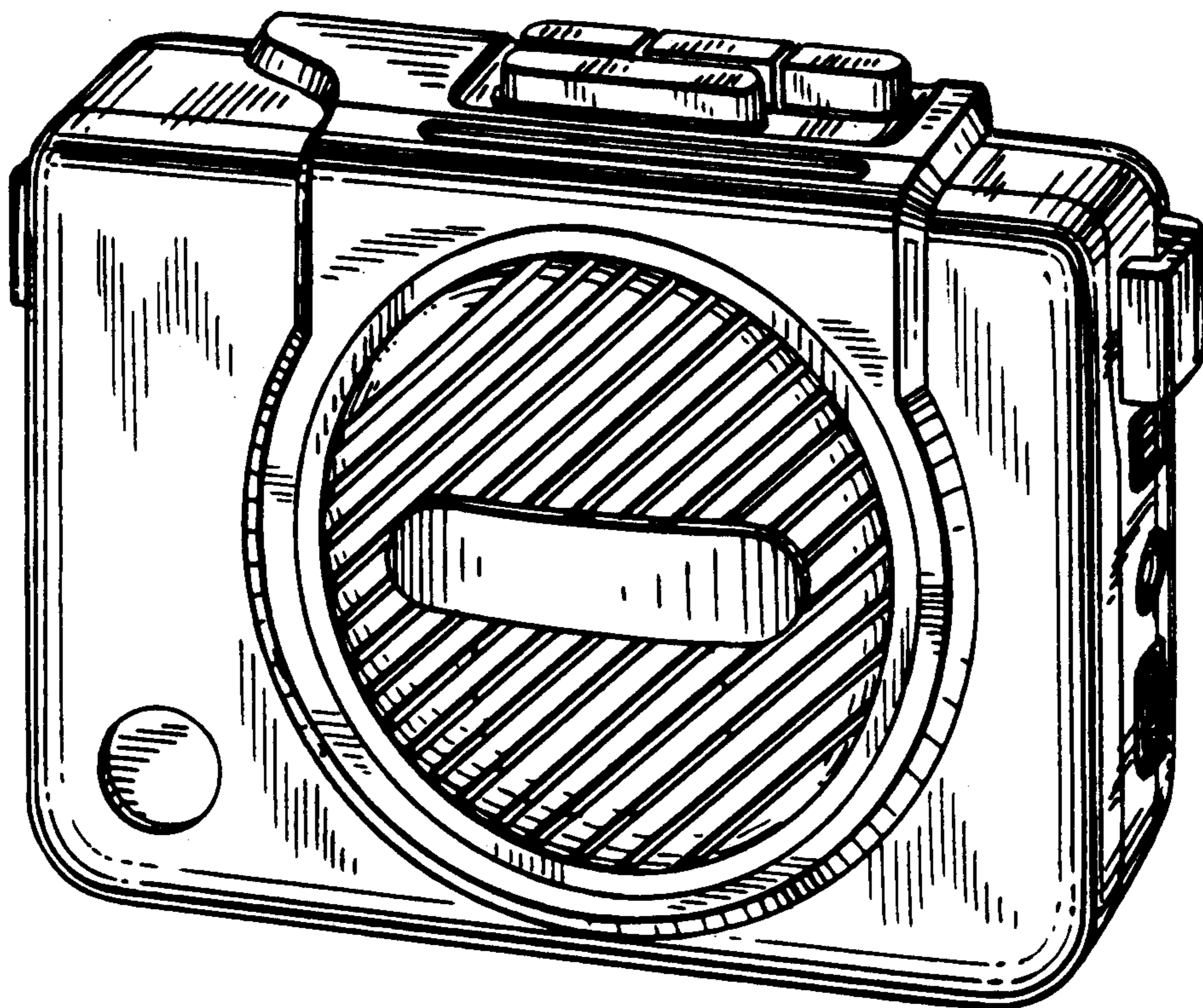

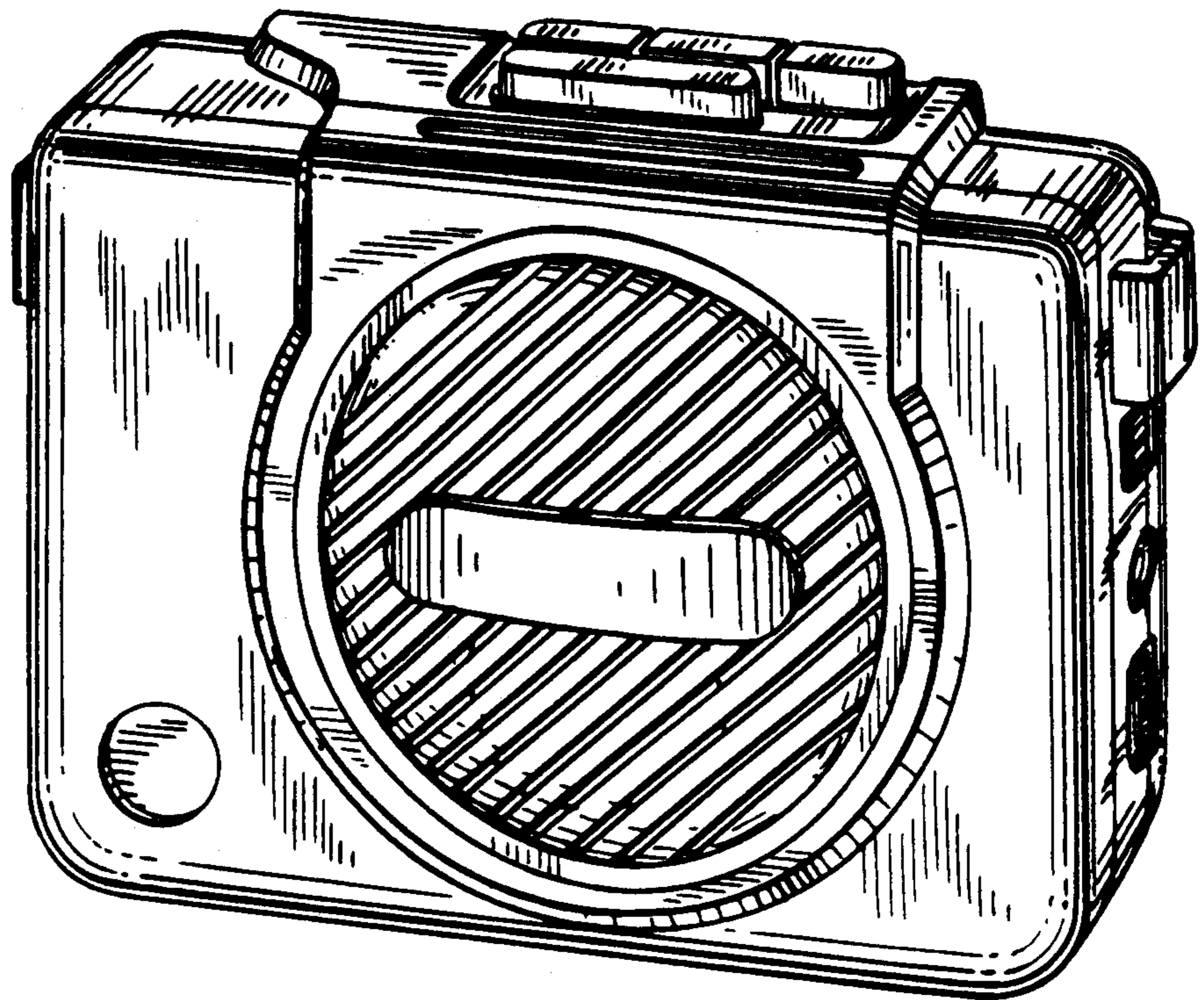
The ornamental design for a tape player, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

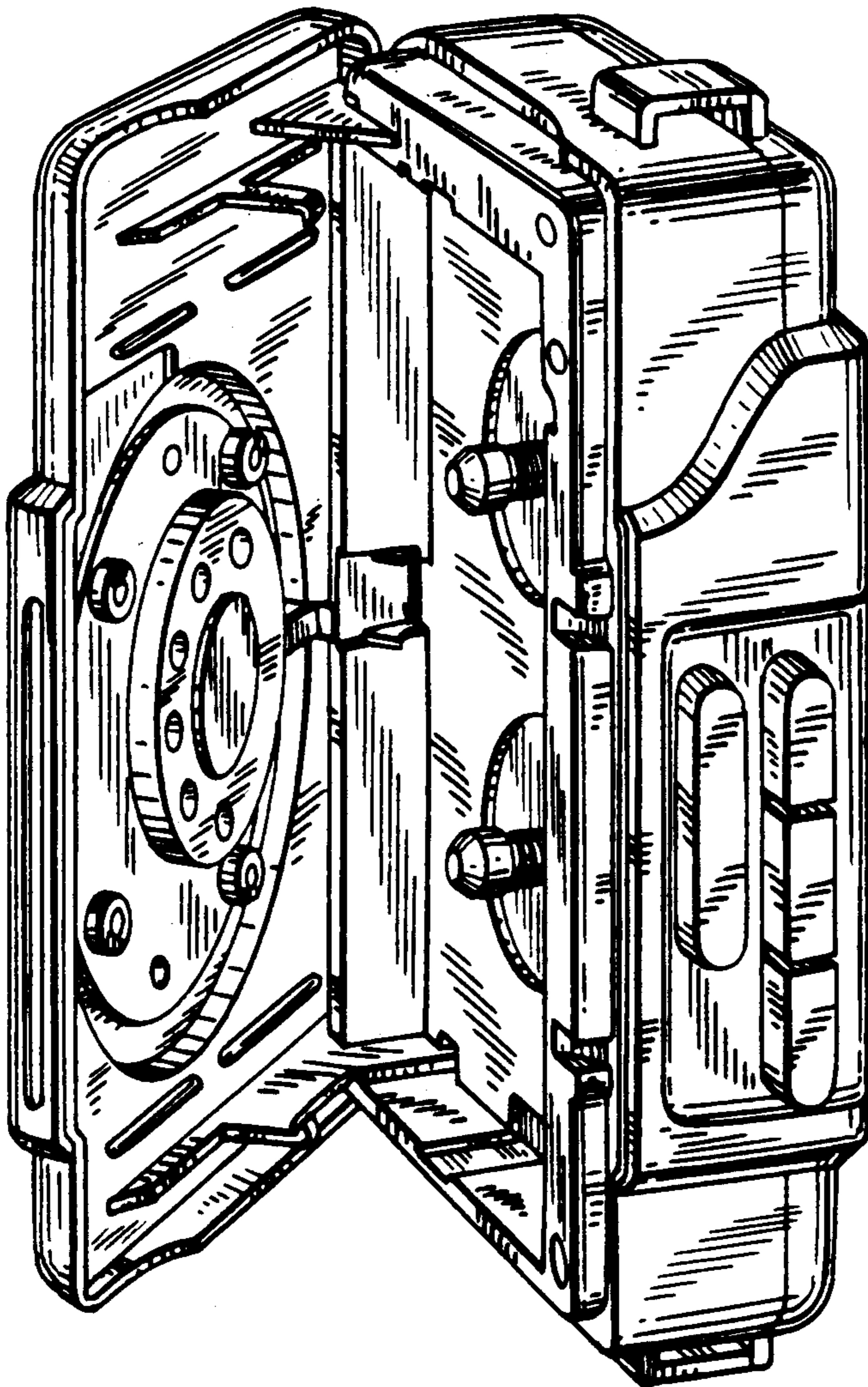
FIG. 1 is a top, front and right-side perspective view of a tape player, showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof, shown rotated 180° and shown with cassette lid in the open position;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.



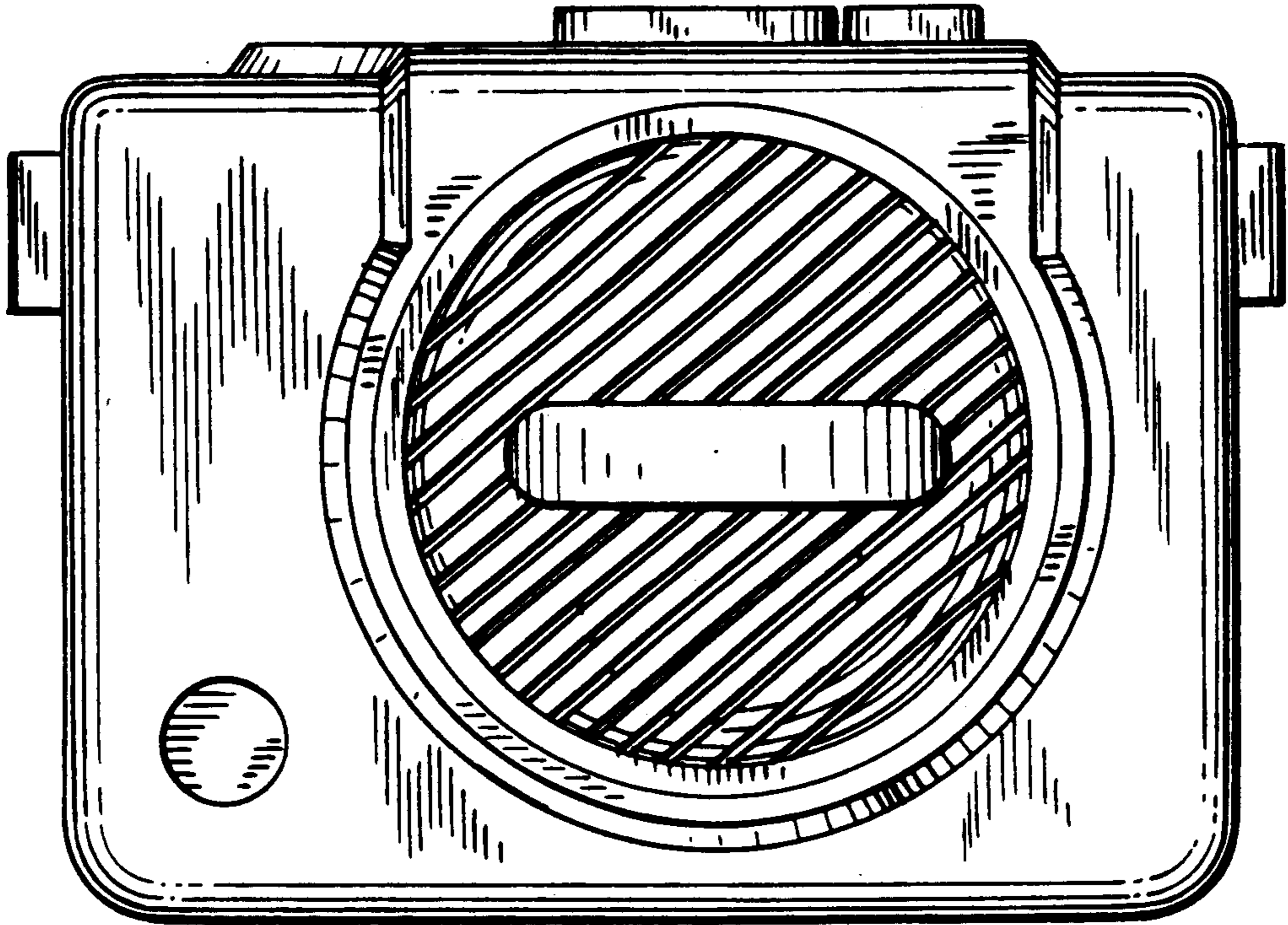

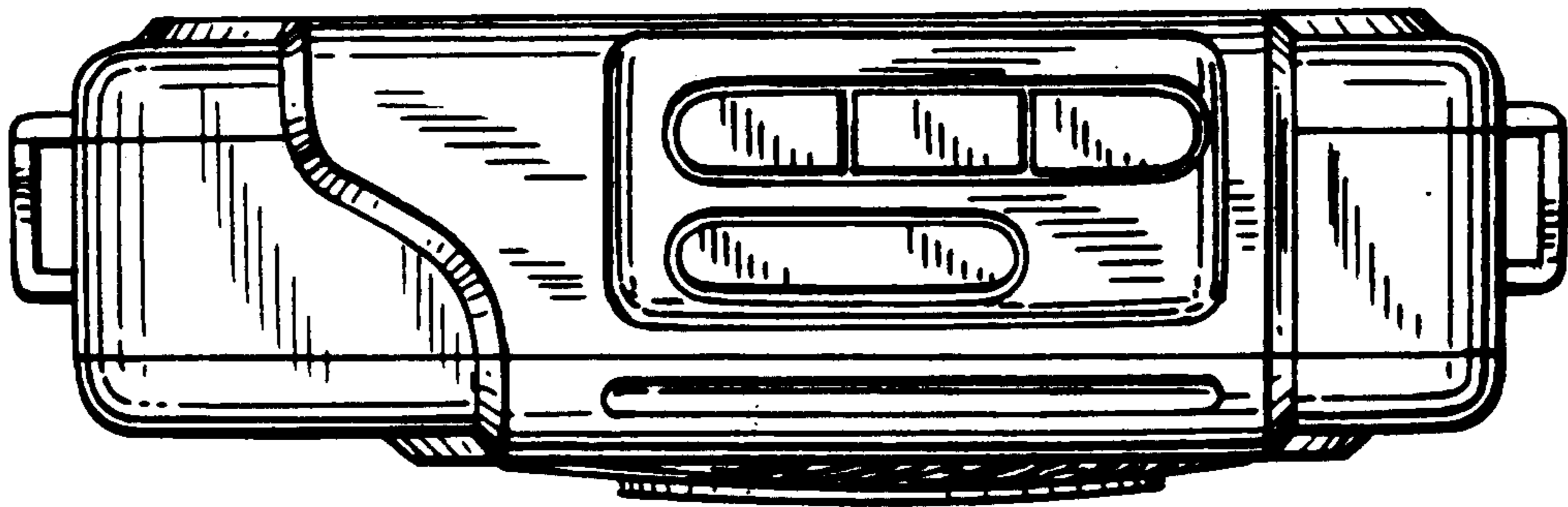

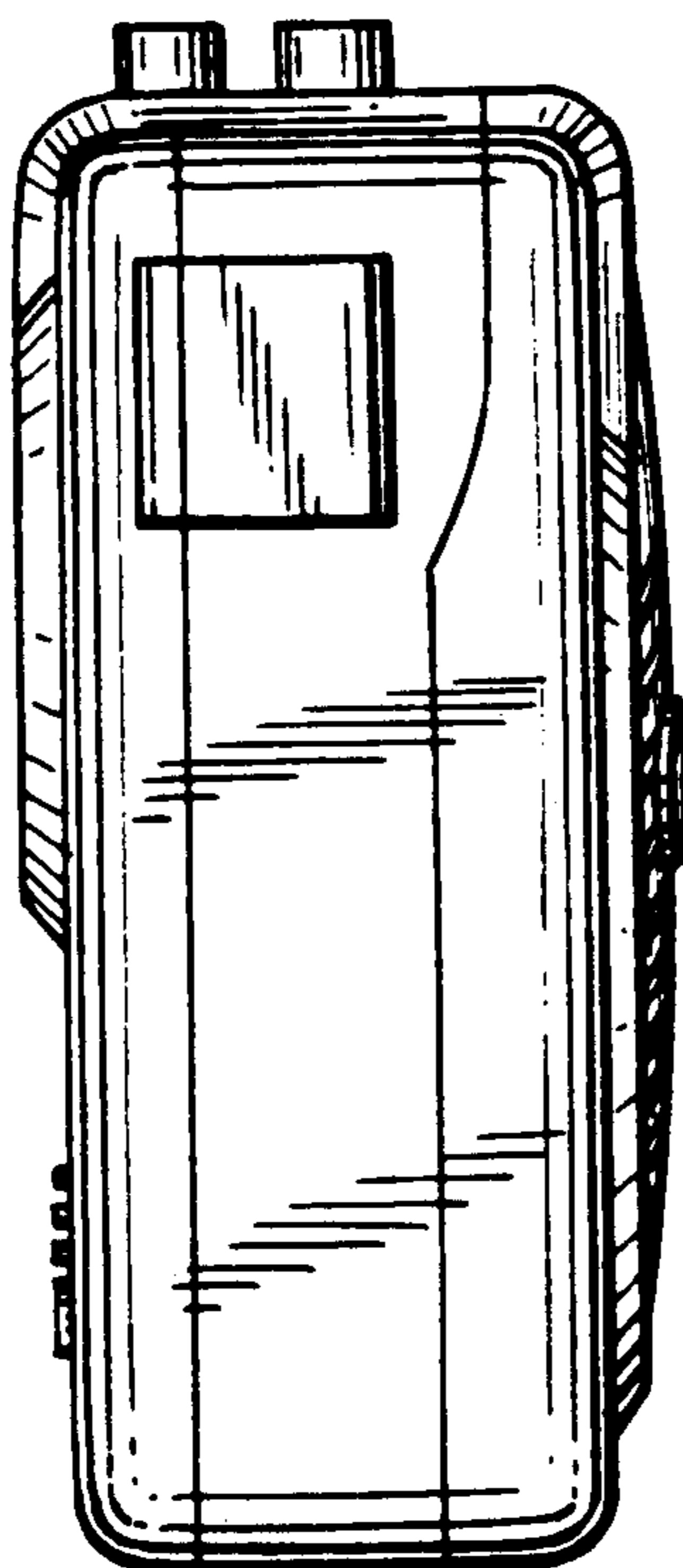
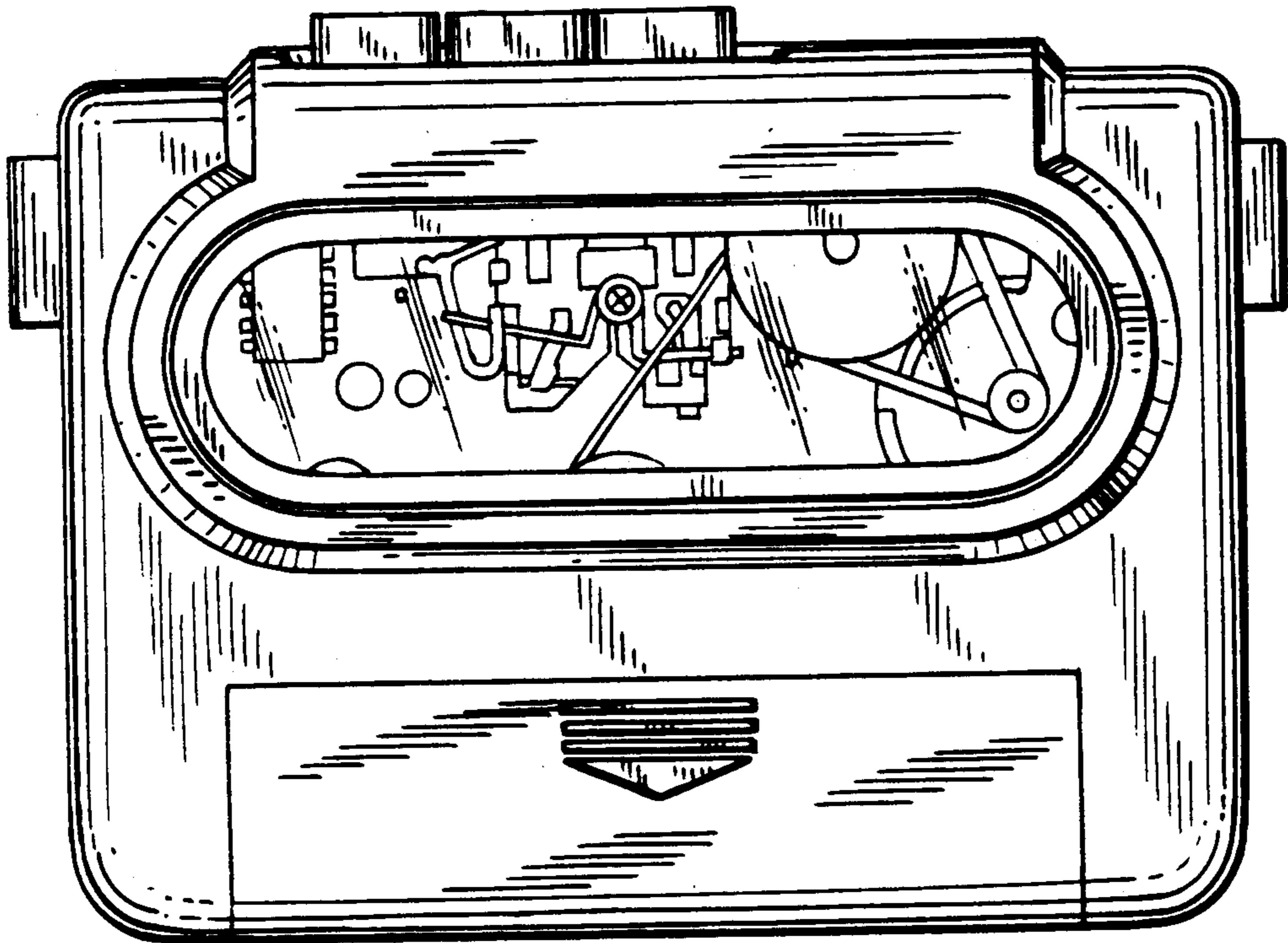

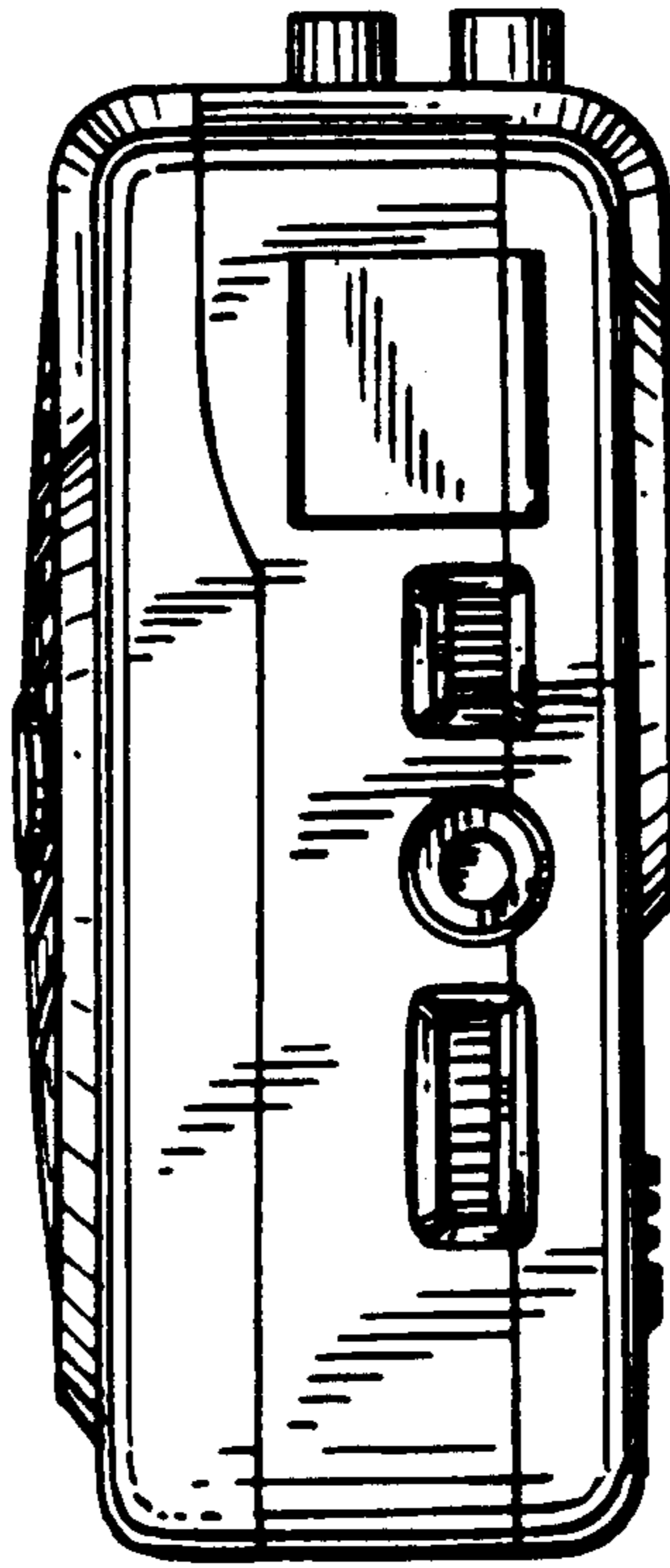
