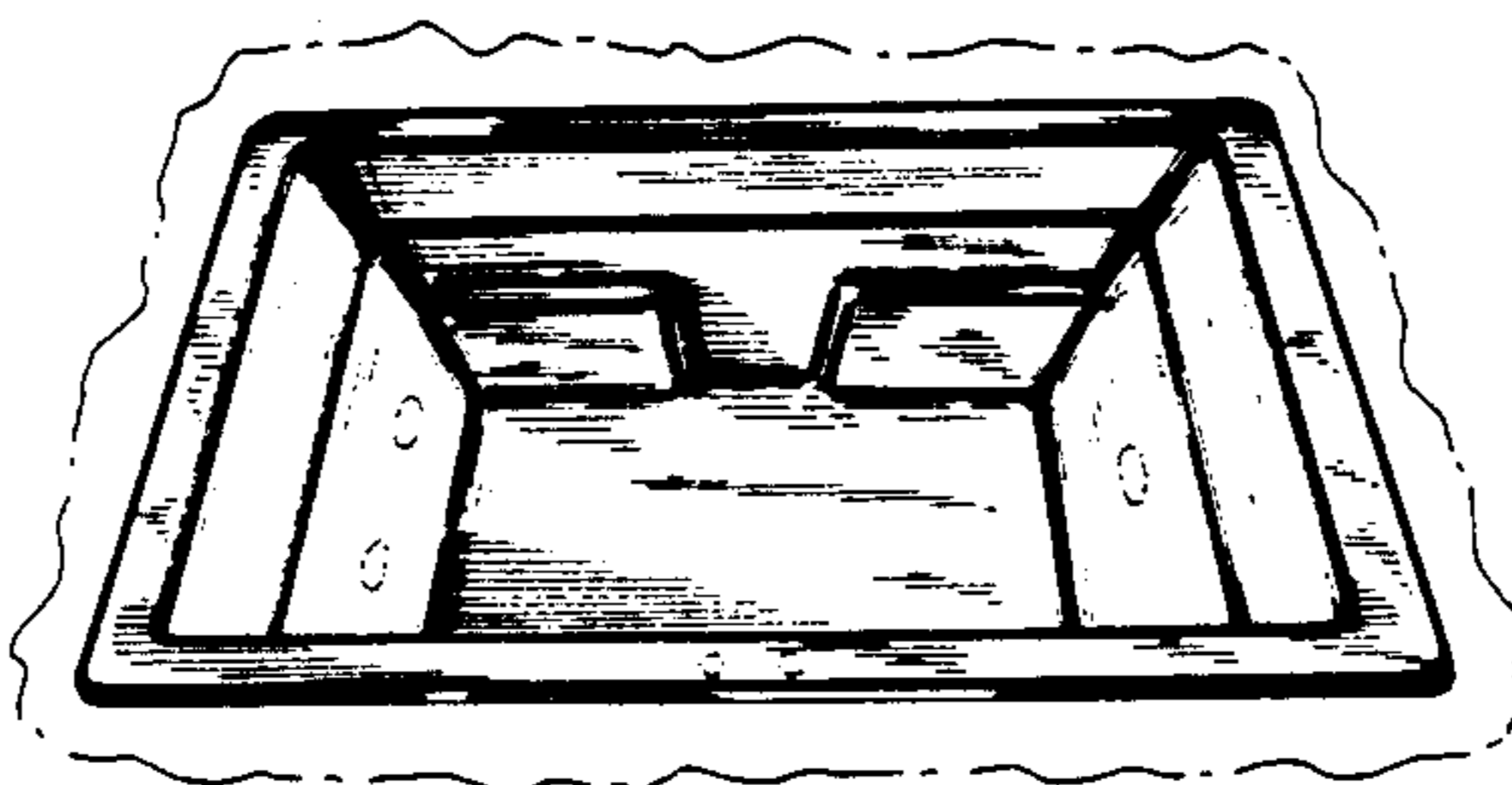
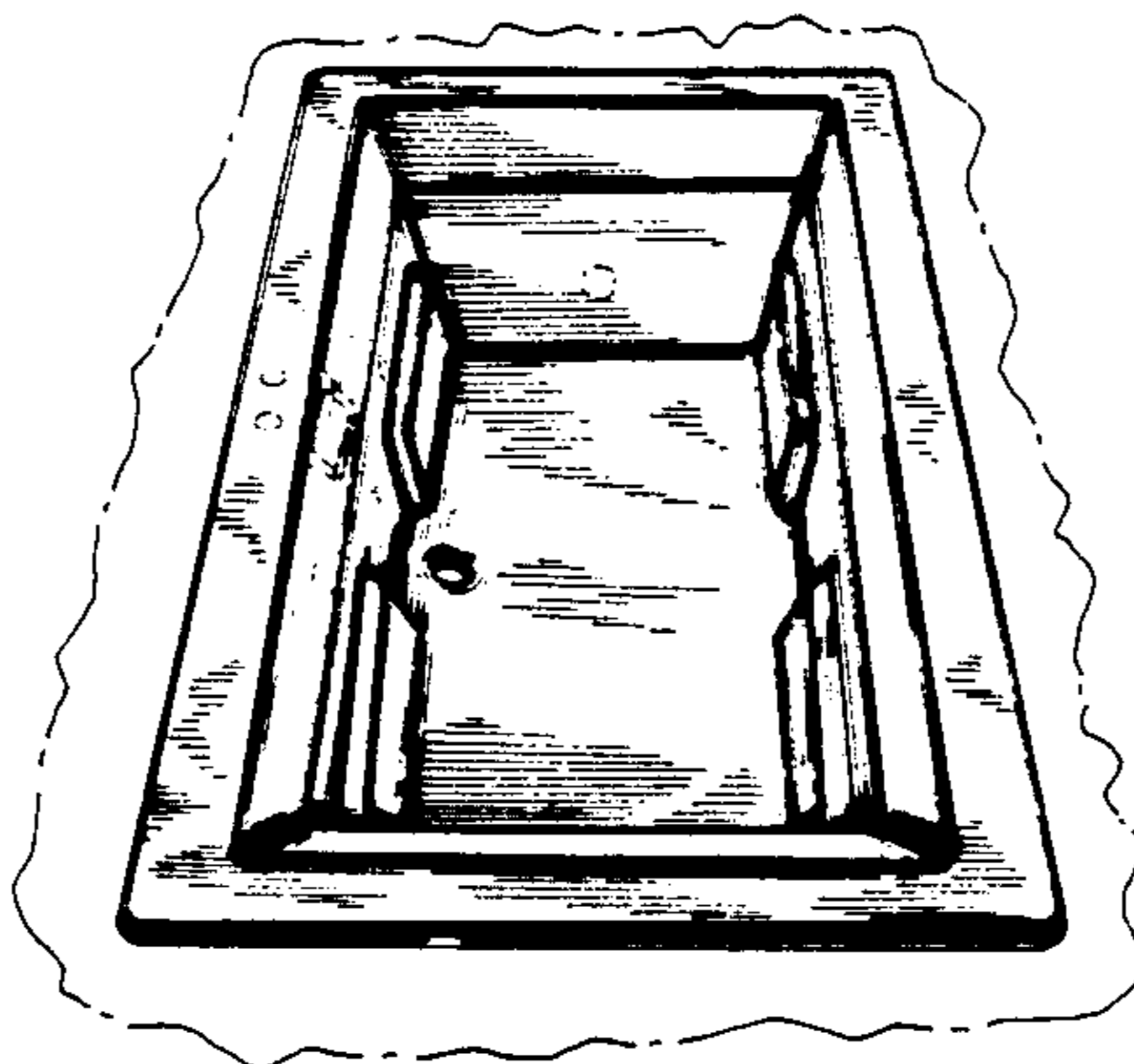
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tub or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view, taken from the top and right side, of a tub or the like showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a second perspective view taken from the top and front side thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale; FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 3; FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 3; FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 6—6 of FIG. 3; FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment thereof, taken from the top and right side; FIG. 8 is a second perspective view, taken from the top and front side thereof; FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale; FIG. 10 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 10—10 of FIG. 9; FIG. 11 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 11—11 of FIG. 9; and FIG. 12 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 12—12 of FIG. 9.

The fragmentary broken line representations of holes in FIGS. 1-3, 5-9, 11, and 12, and of an overflow well and/or cover in FIGS. 1, 3, 4, 6, 7, and 10 are for the purpose of illustration only.



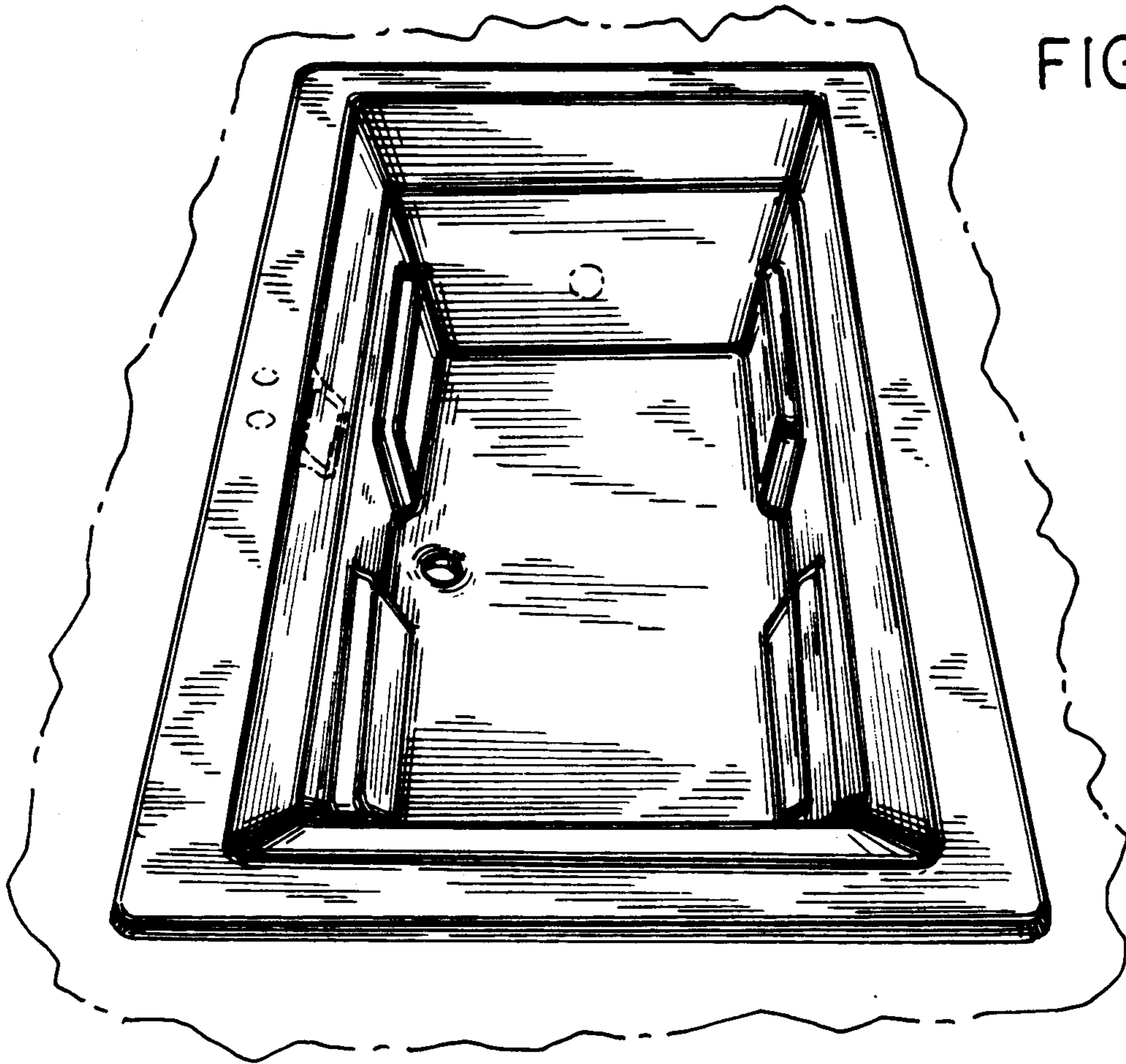

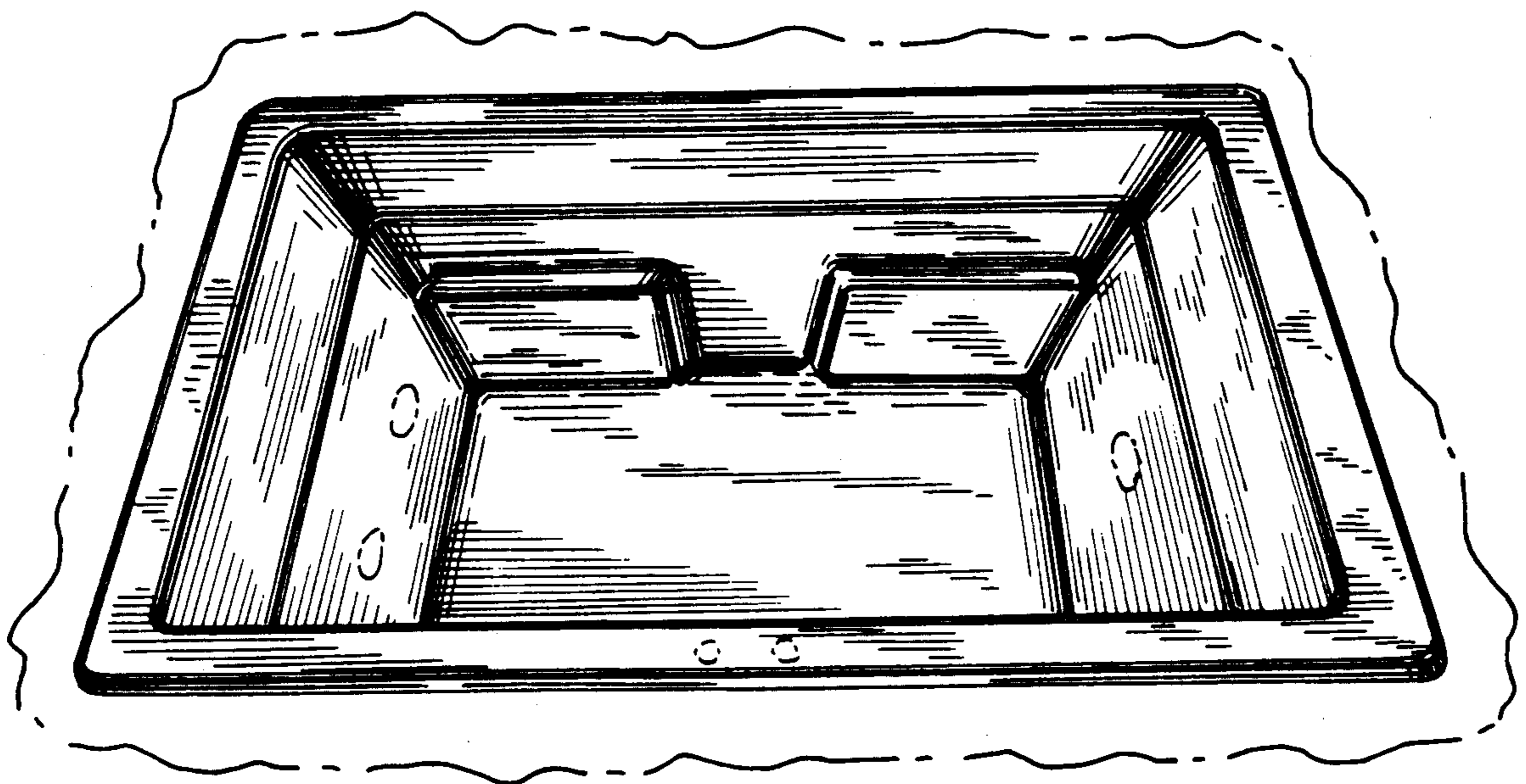

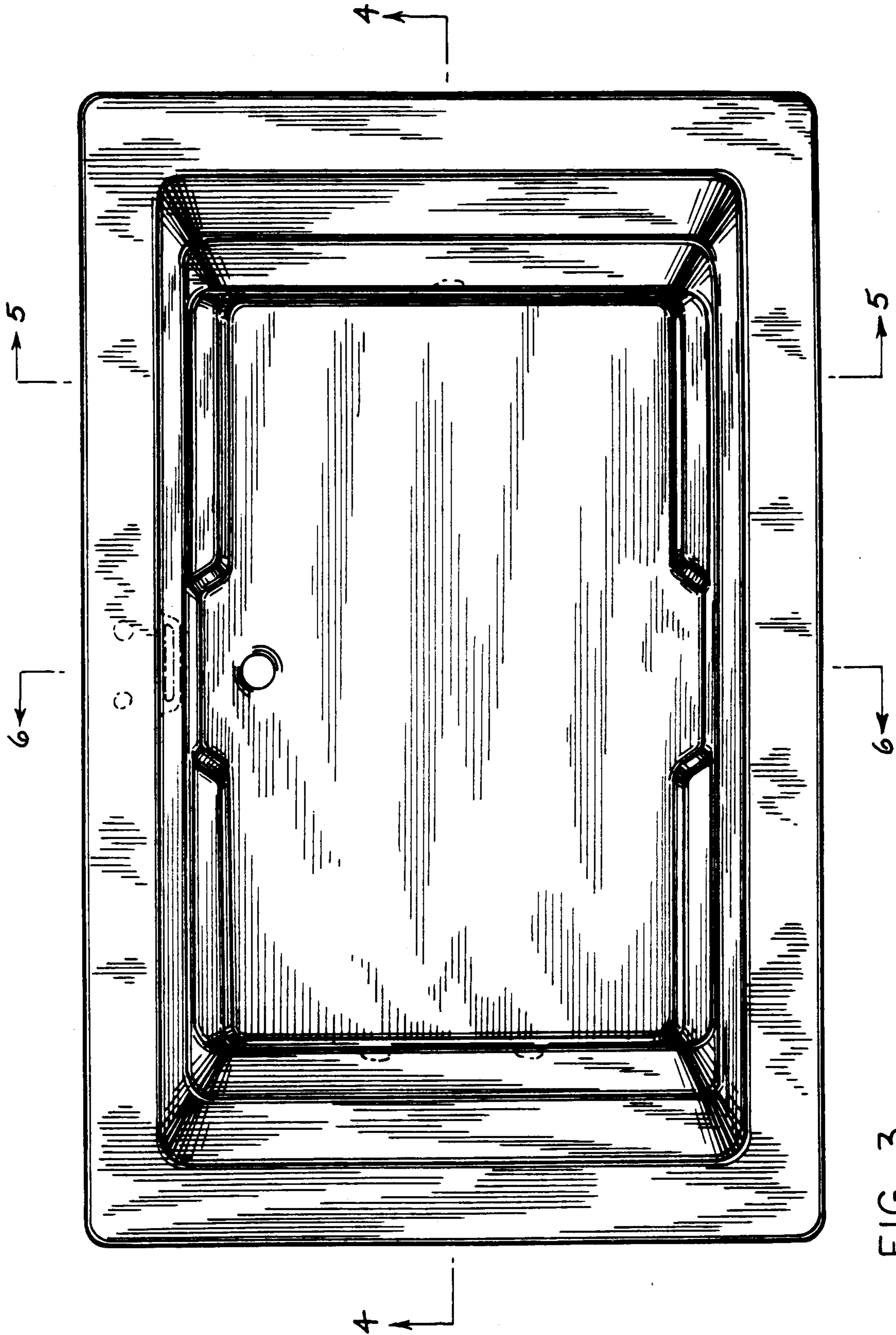

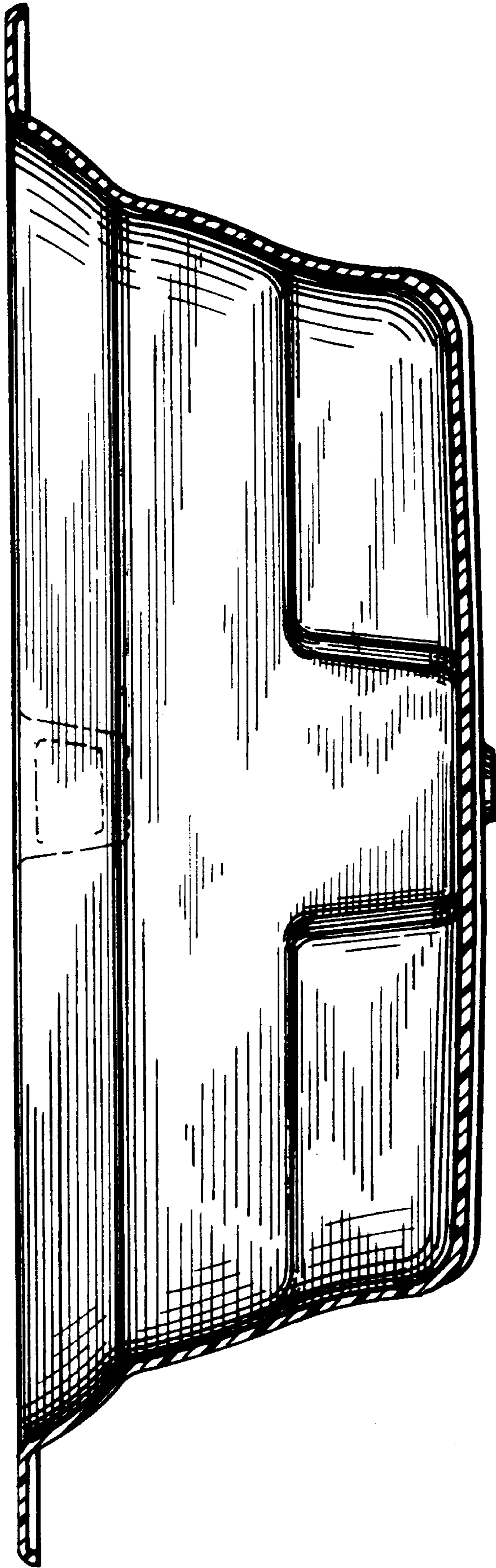

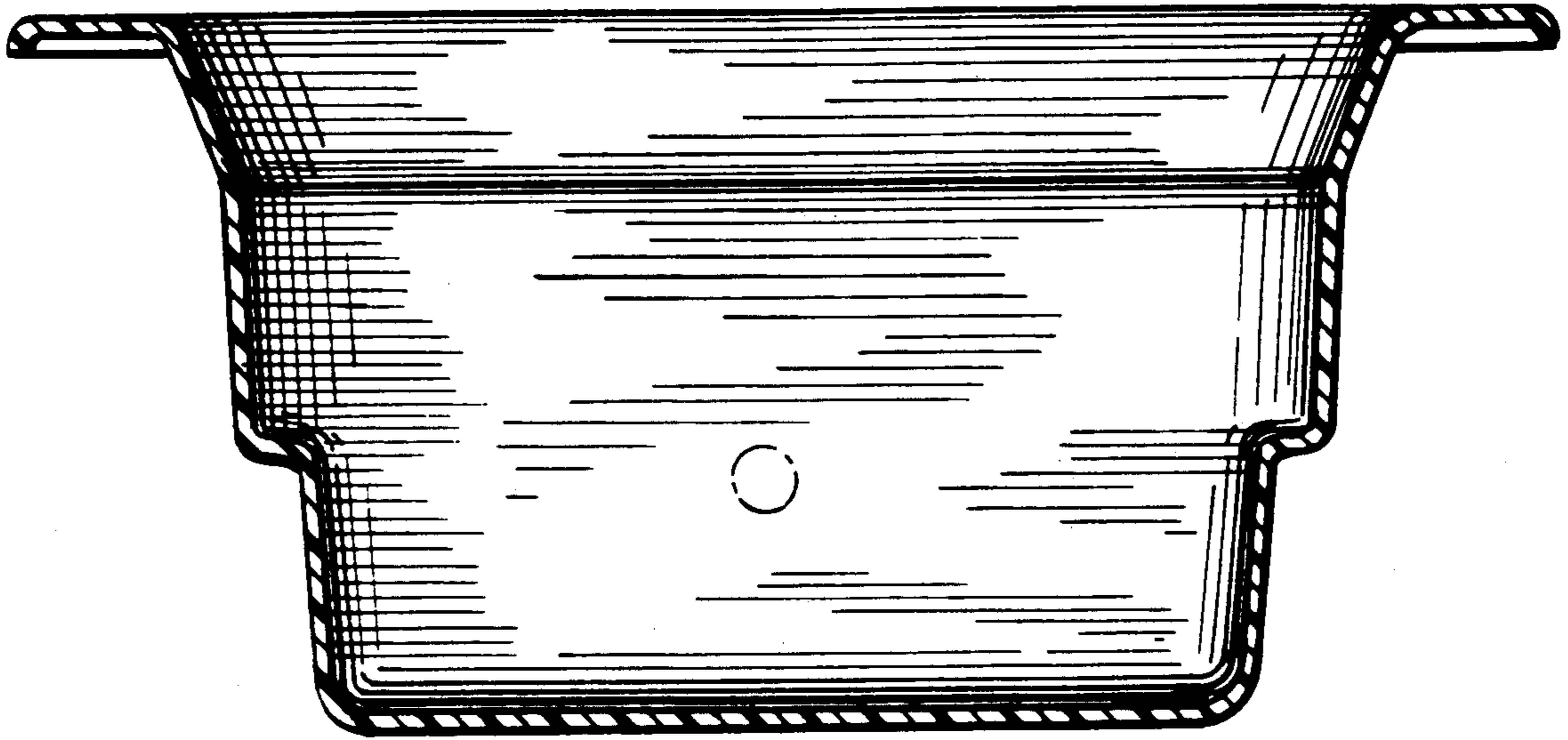

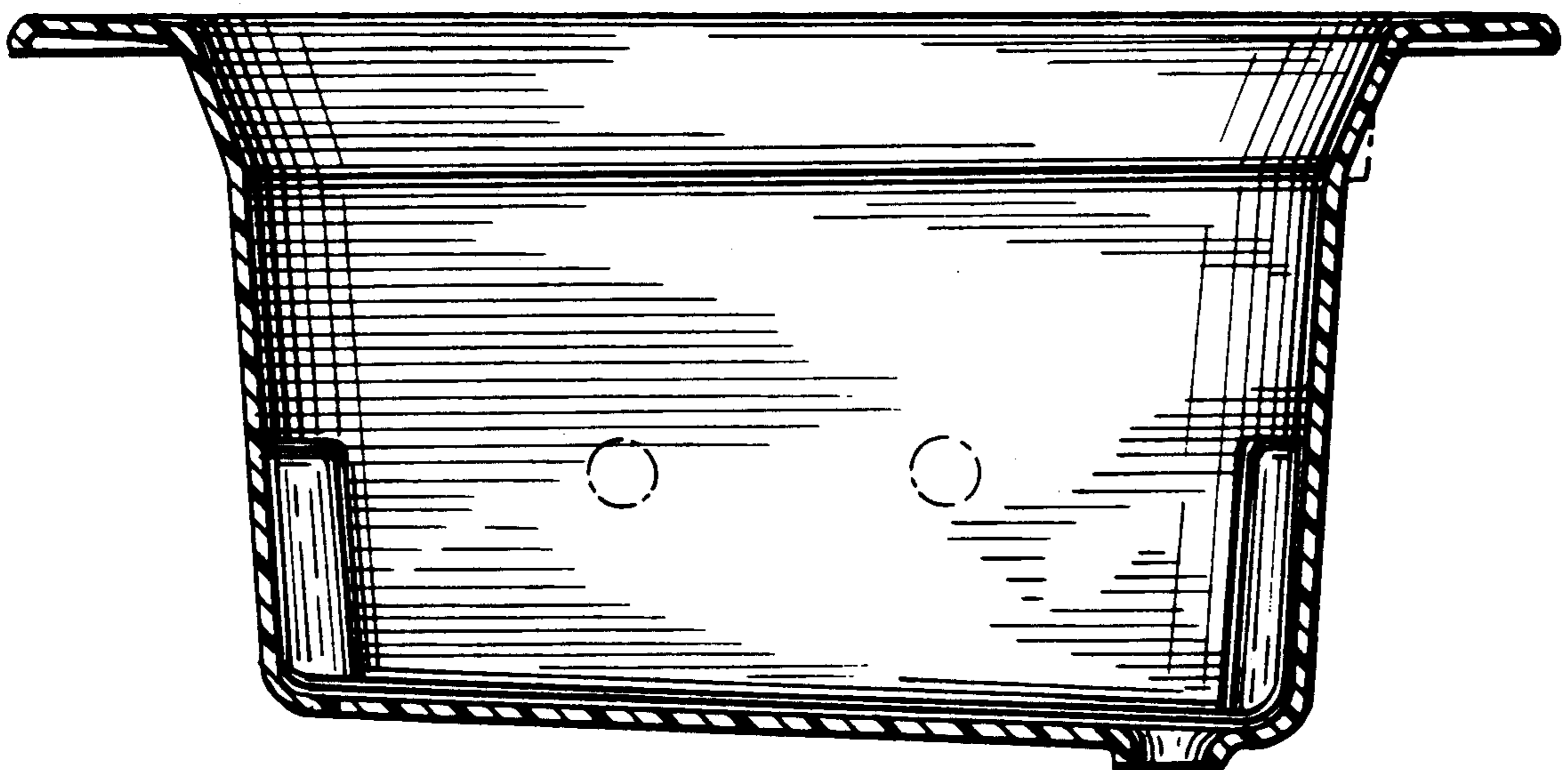

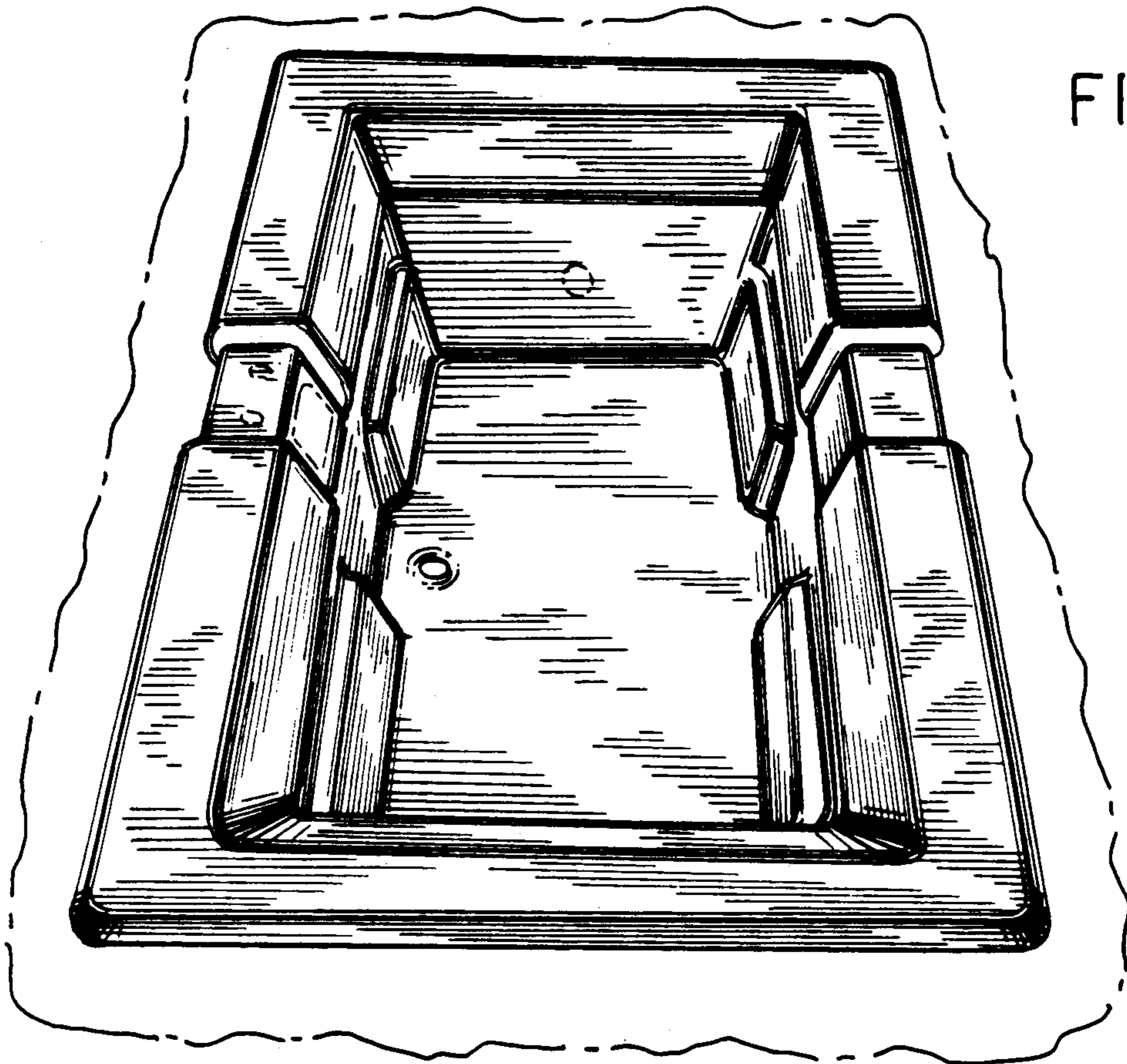

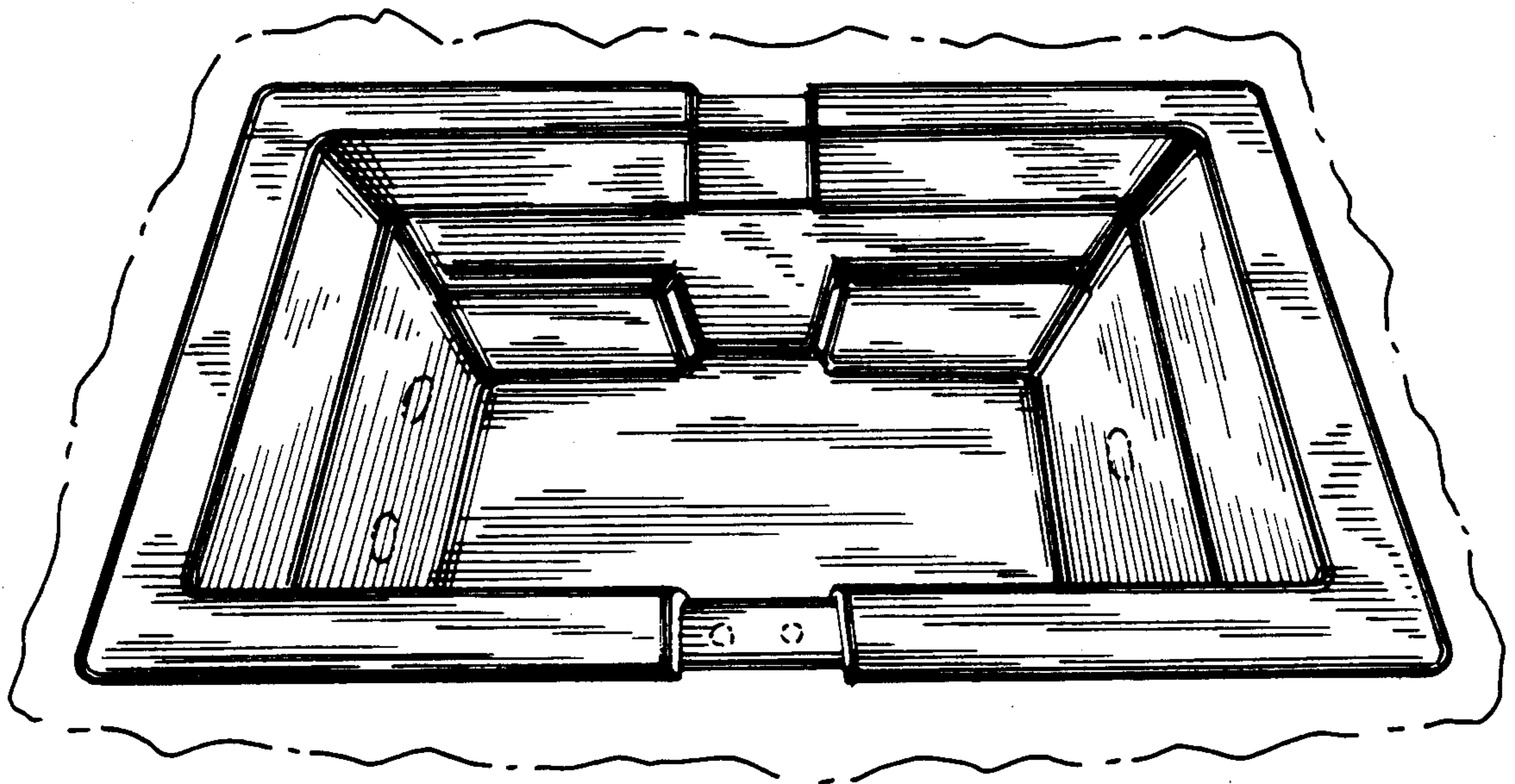

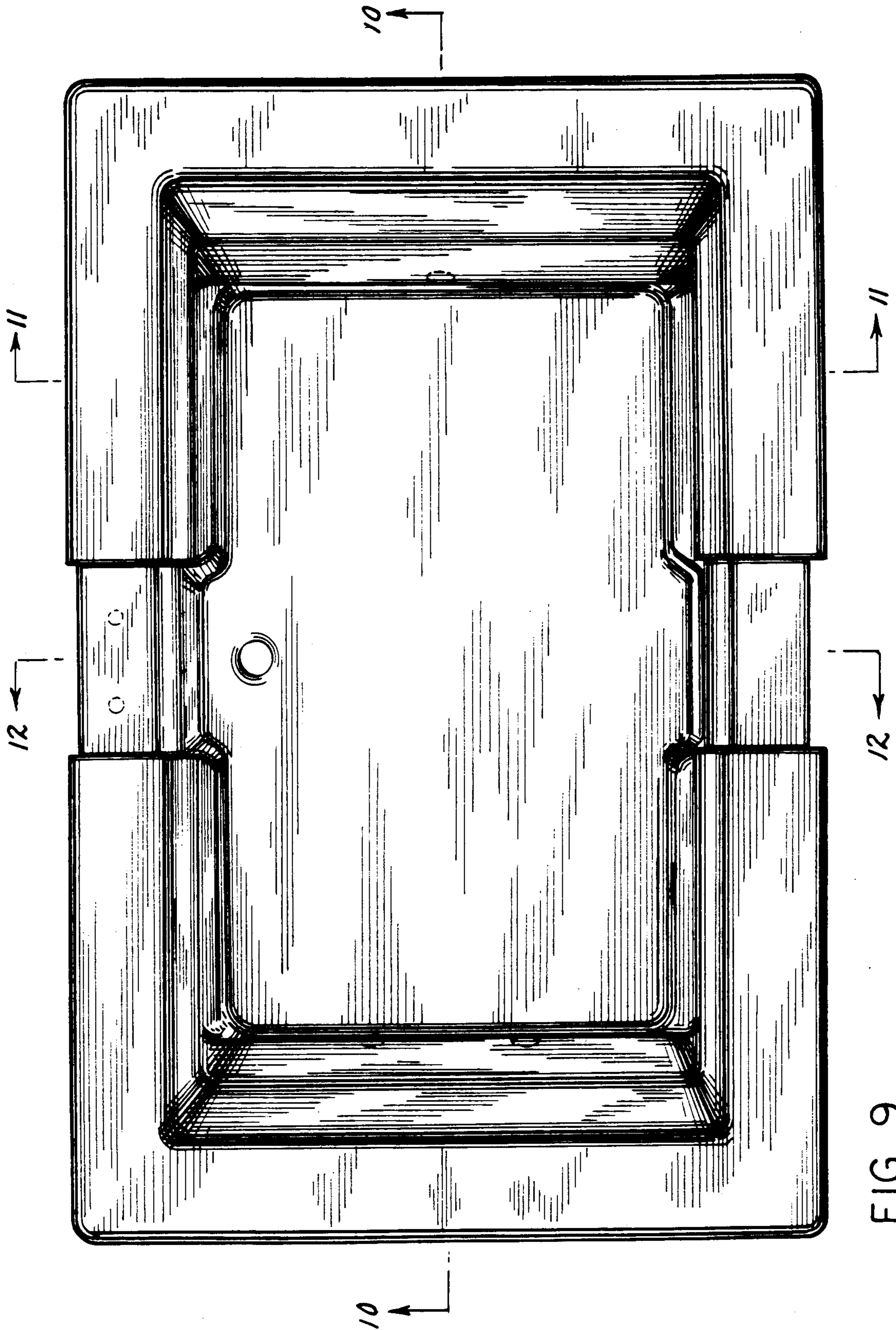

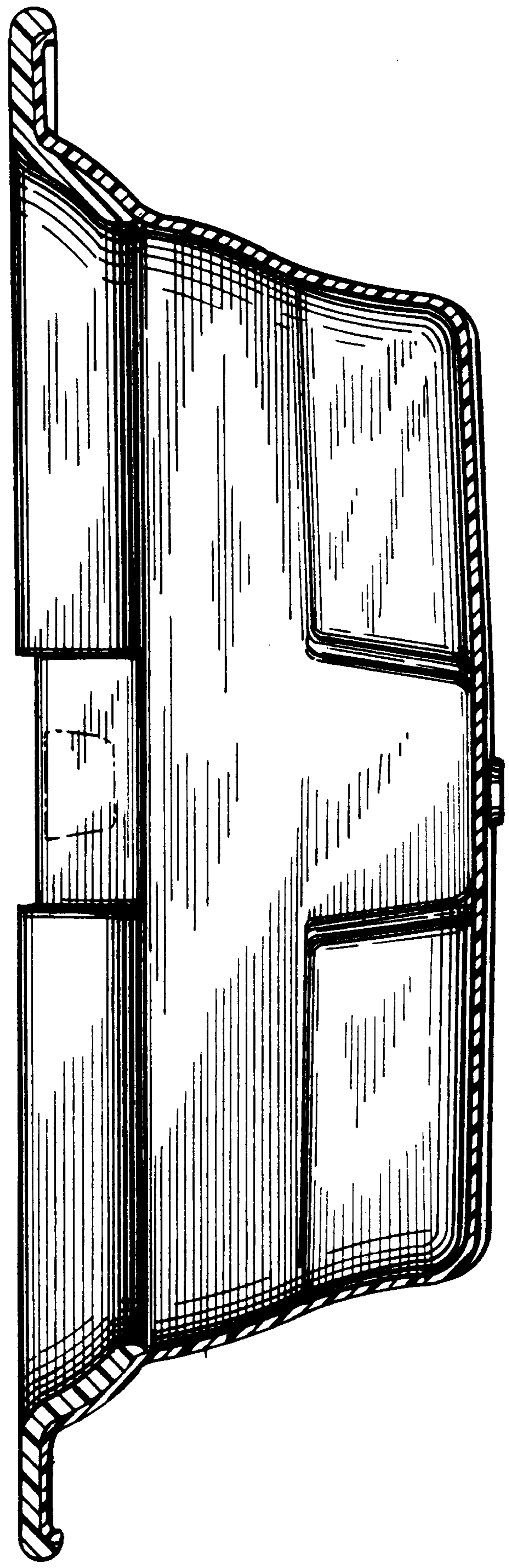

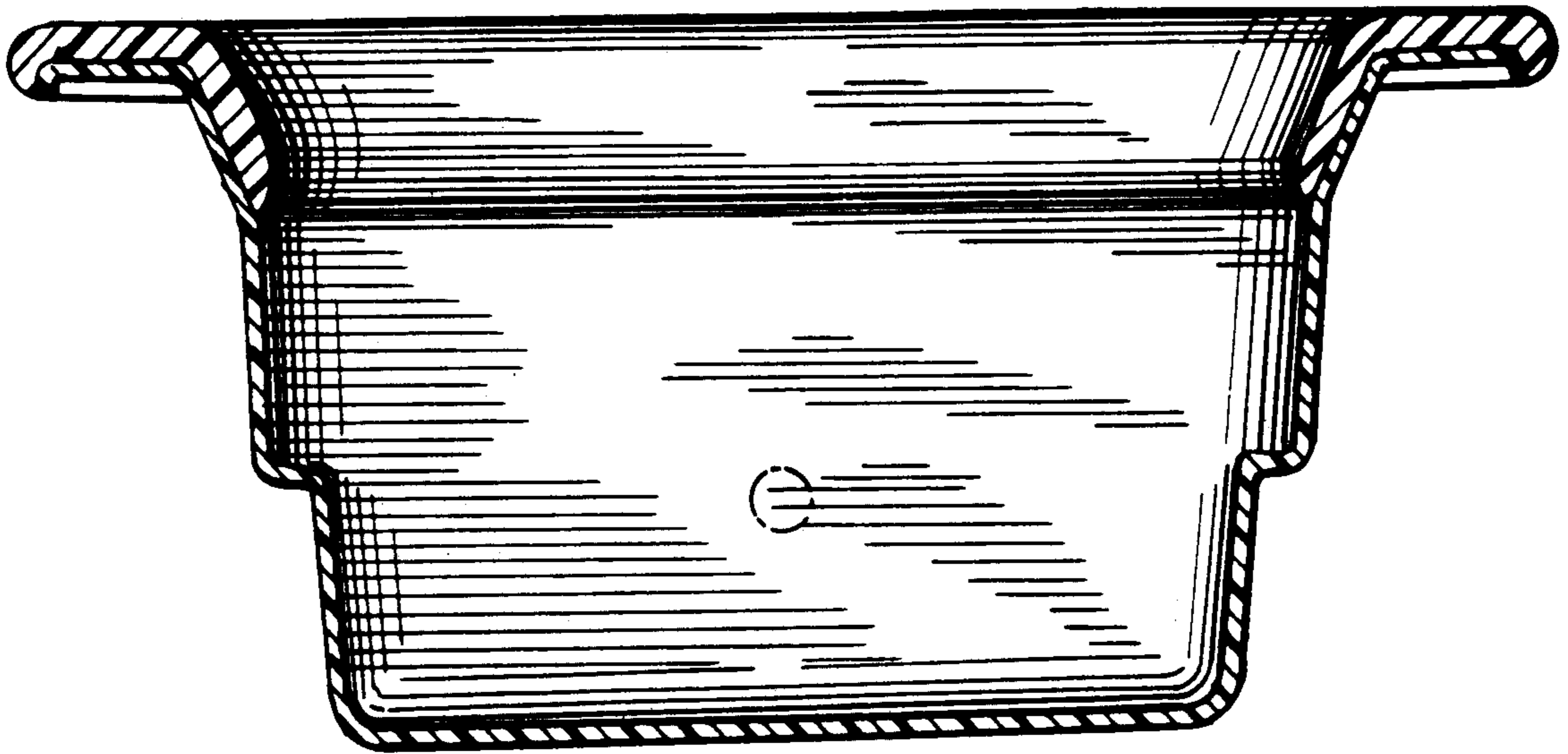

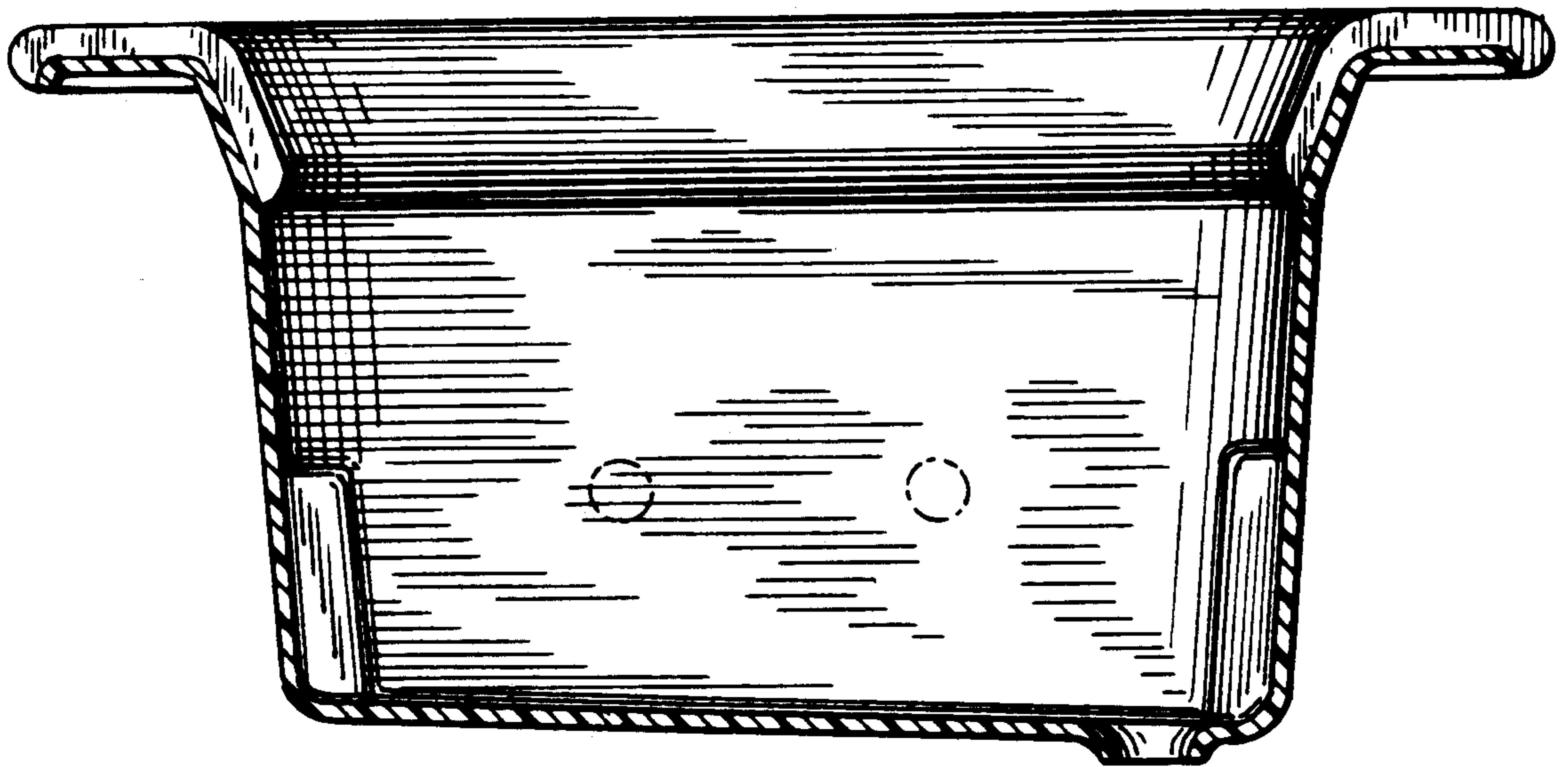
