The ornamental design for a brassiere, as shown and described.

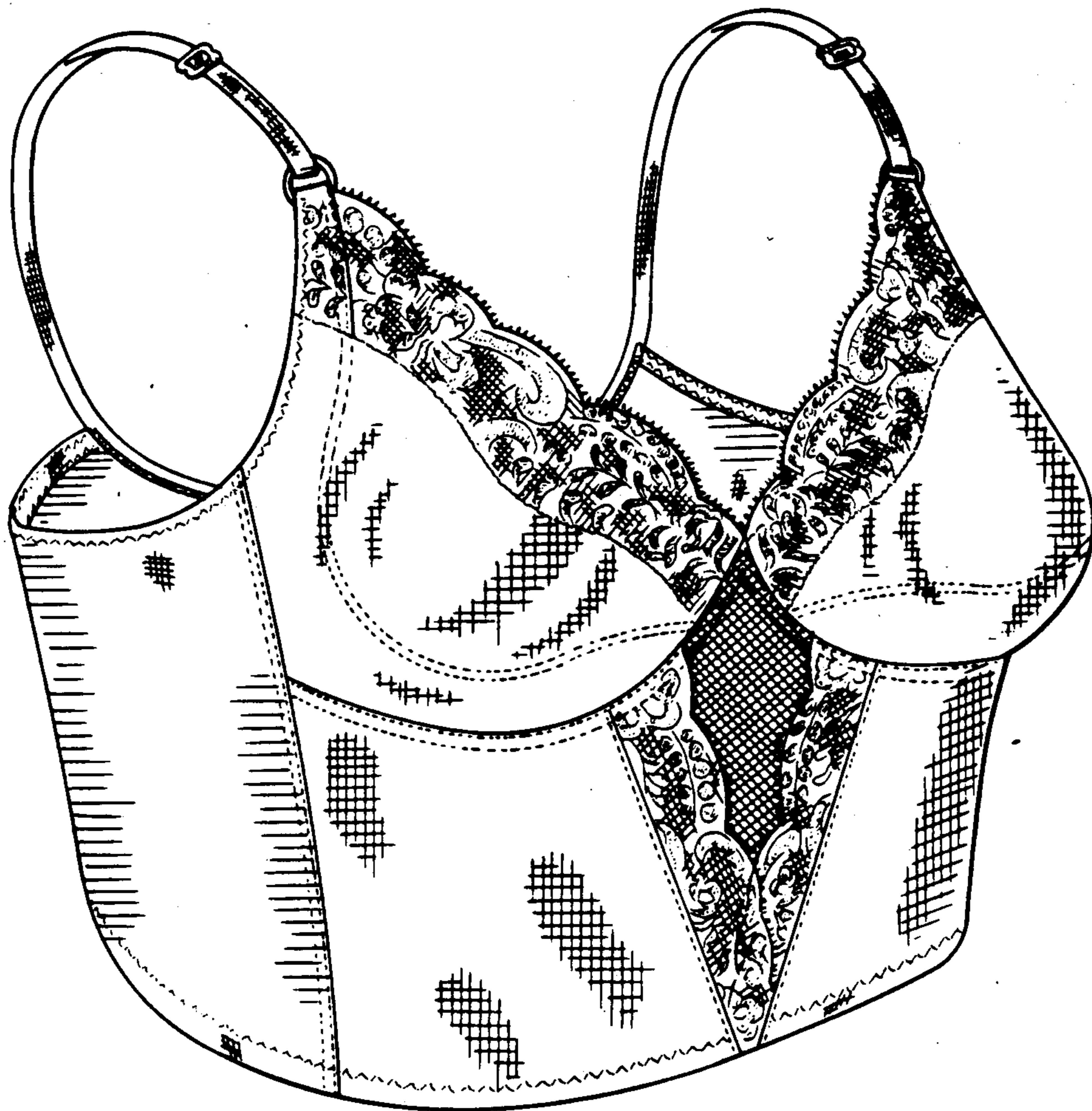
DESCRIPTION

The broken lines shown in the figures represent conventional stitching.



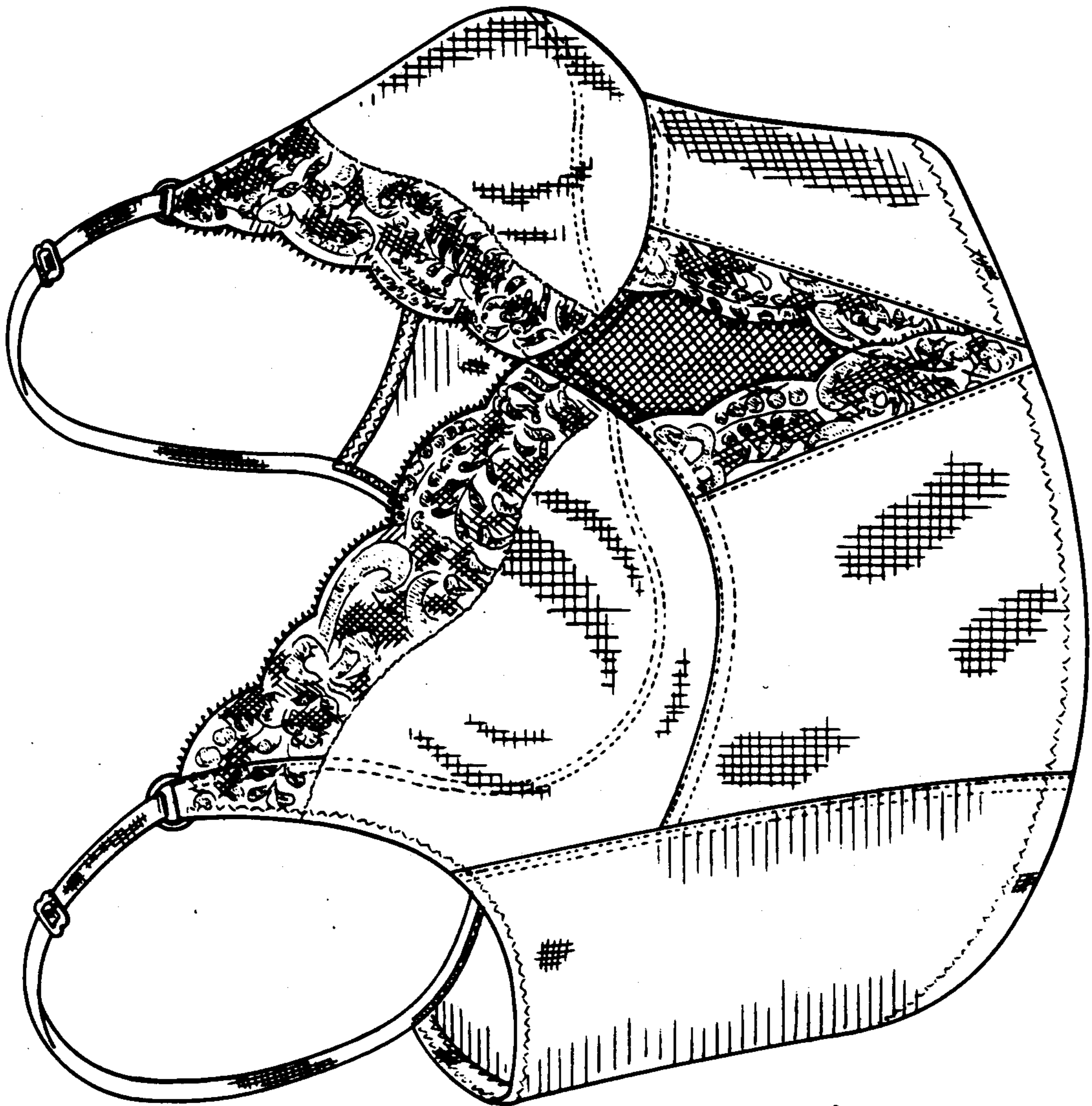
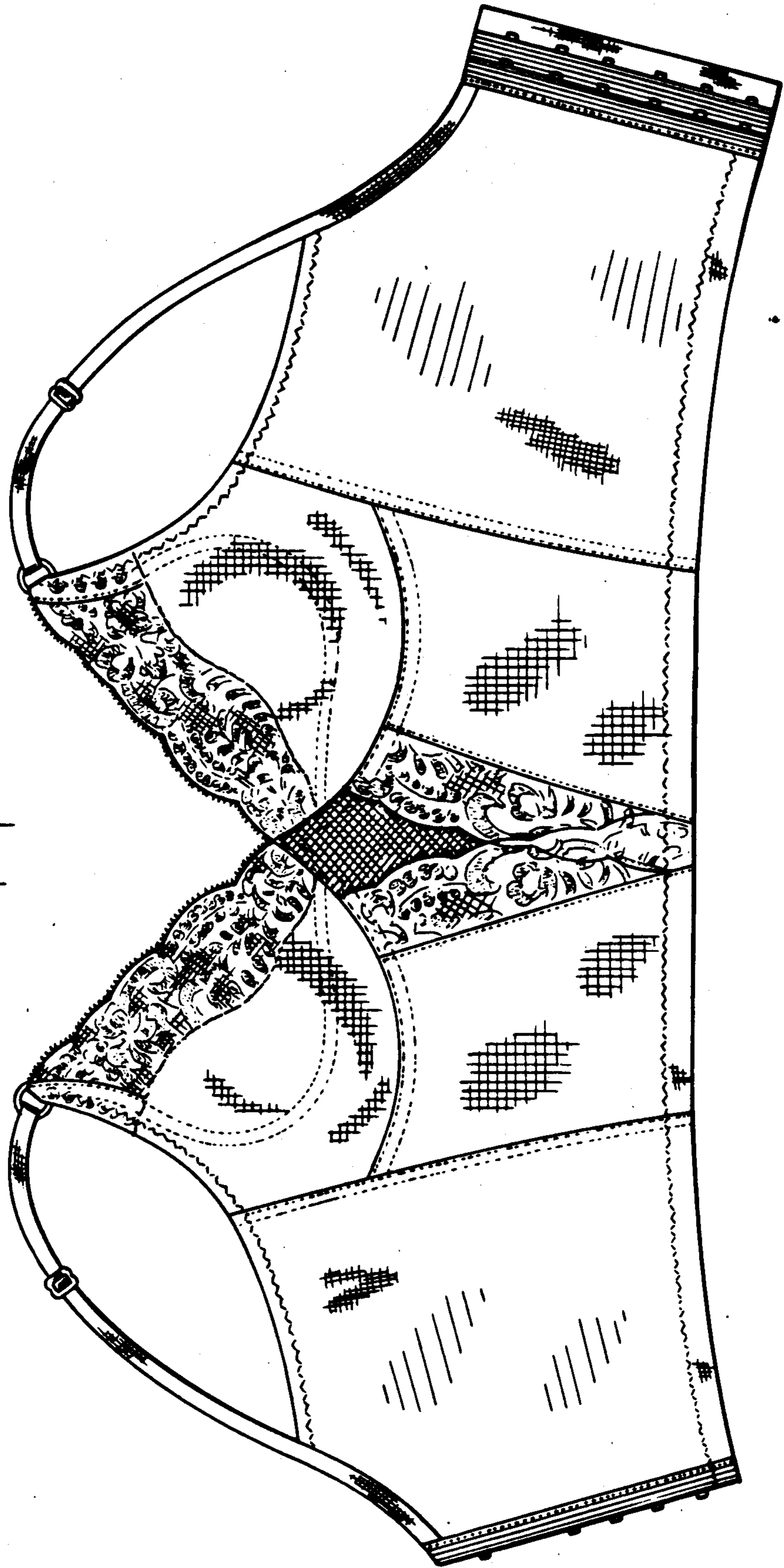

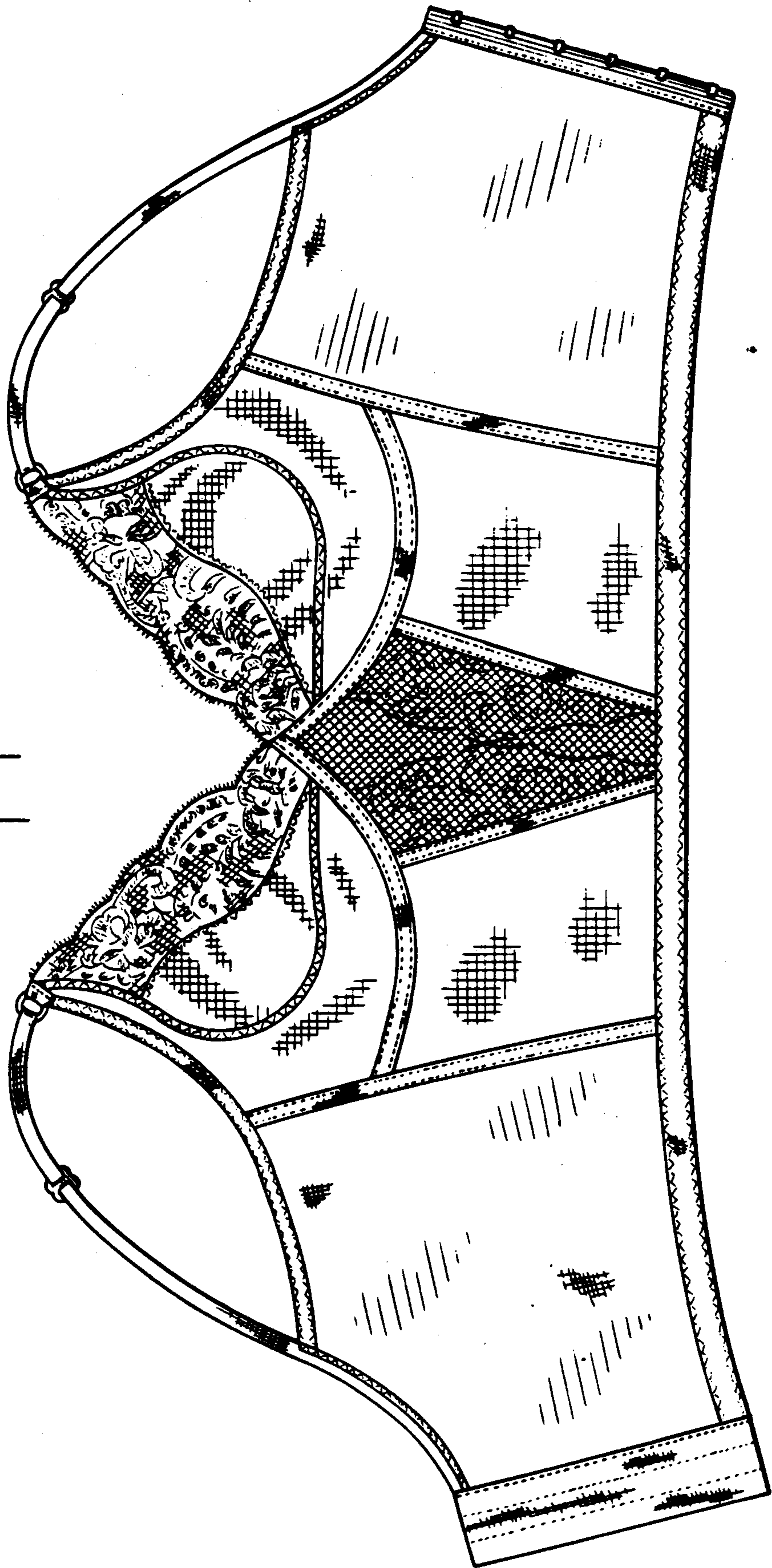
