FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a tread design for a glove showing my new design, the rear view being identical;

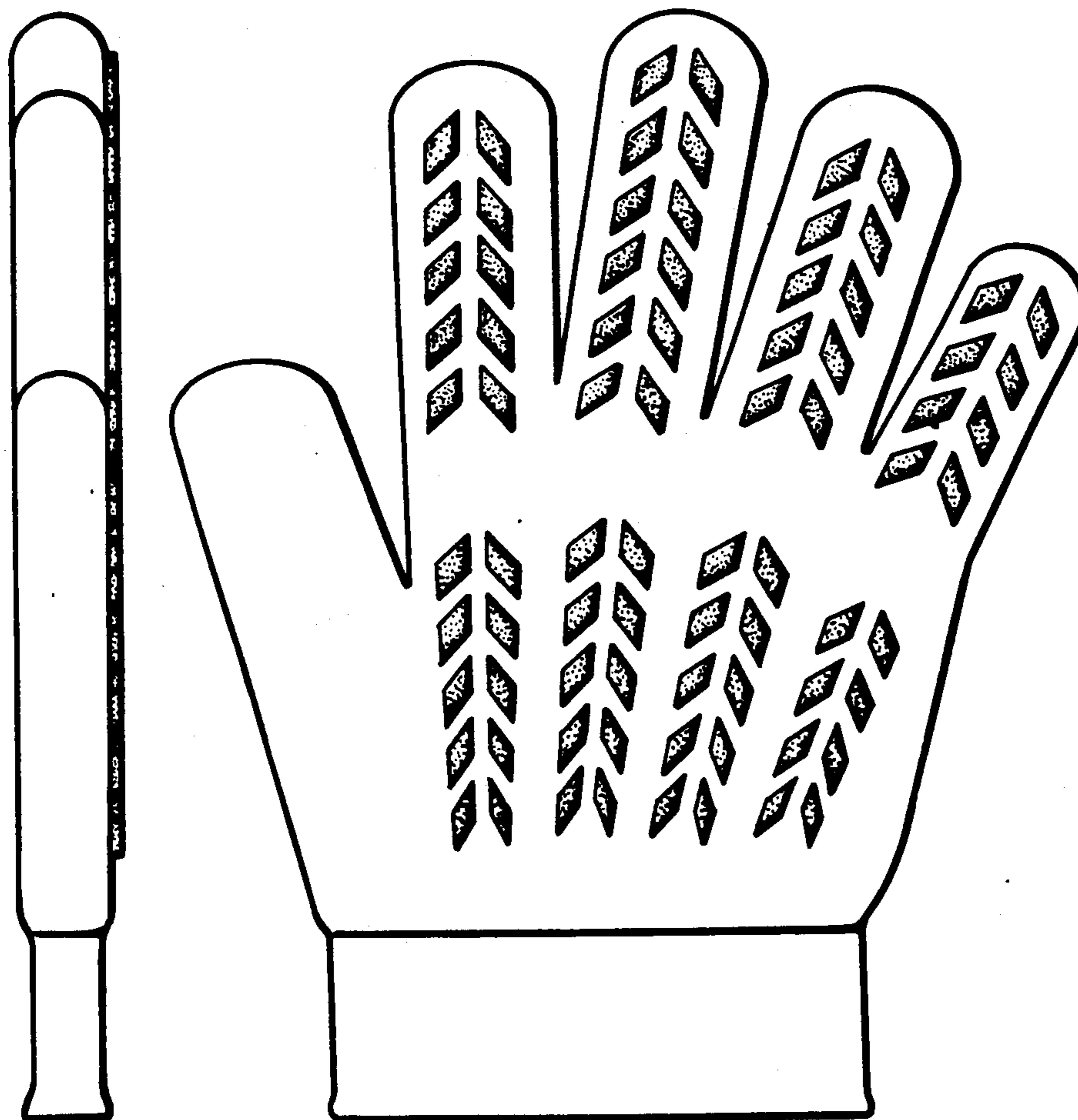
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

The broken lines showing of the glove is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



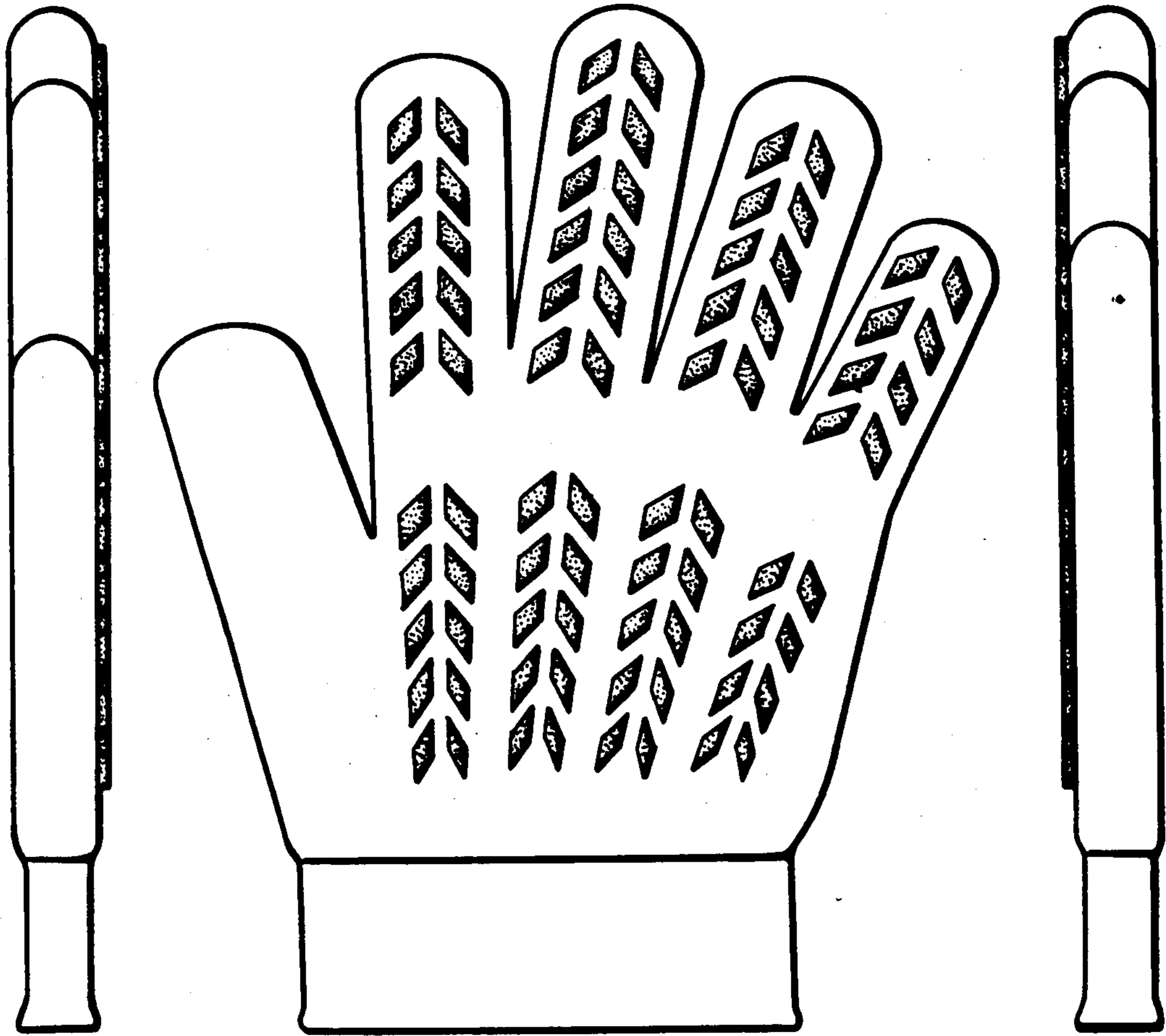

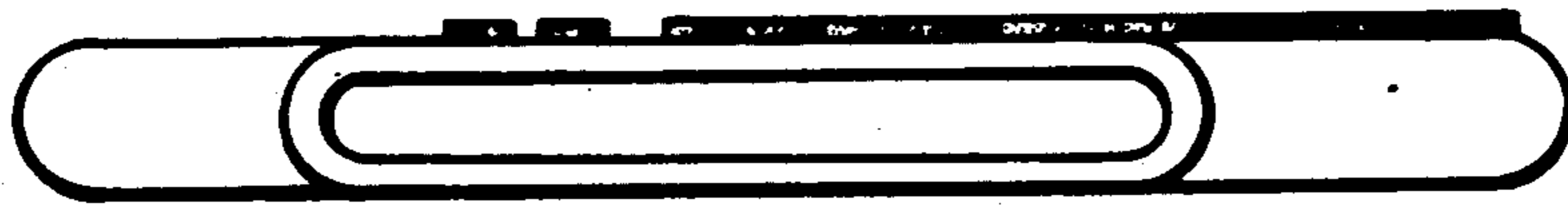
