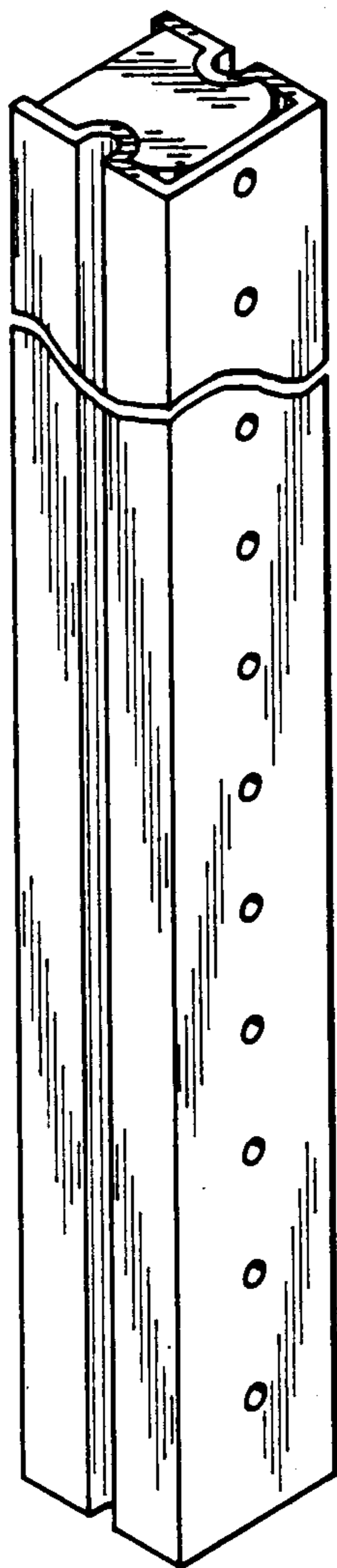

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a clamp for securing plastic over windows, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a clamp for securing plastic over windows, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is an exploded left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is an exploded right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is an exploded top plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is an exploded bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 8 is rear perspective view thereof; and, FIG. 9 is a front perspective view thereof. The clamp is shown broken away in all views to indicate indeterminate length.



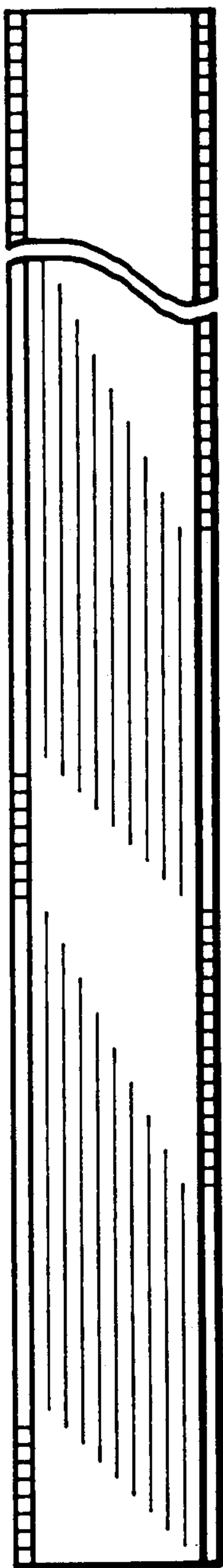

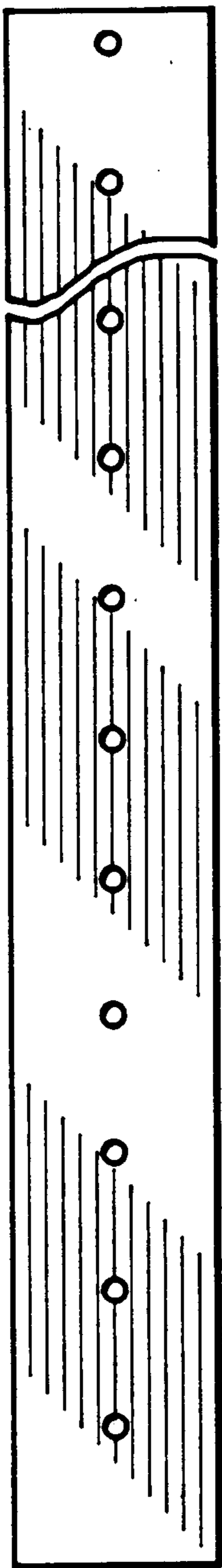

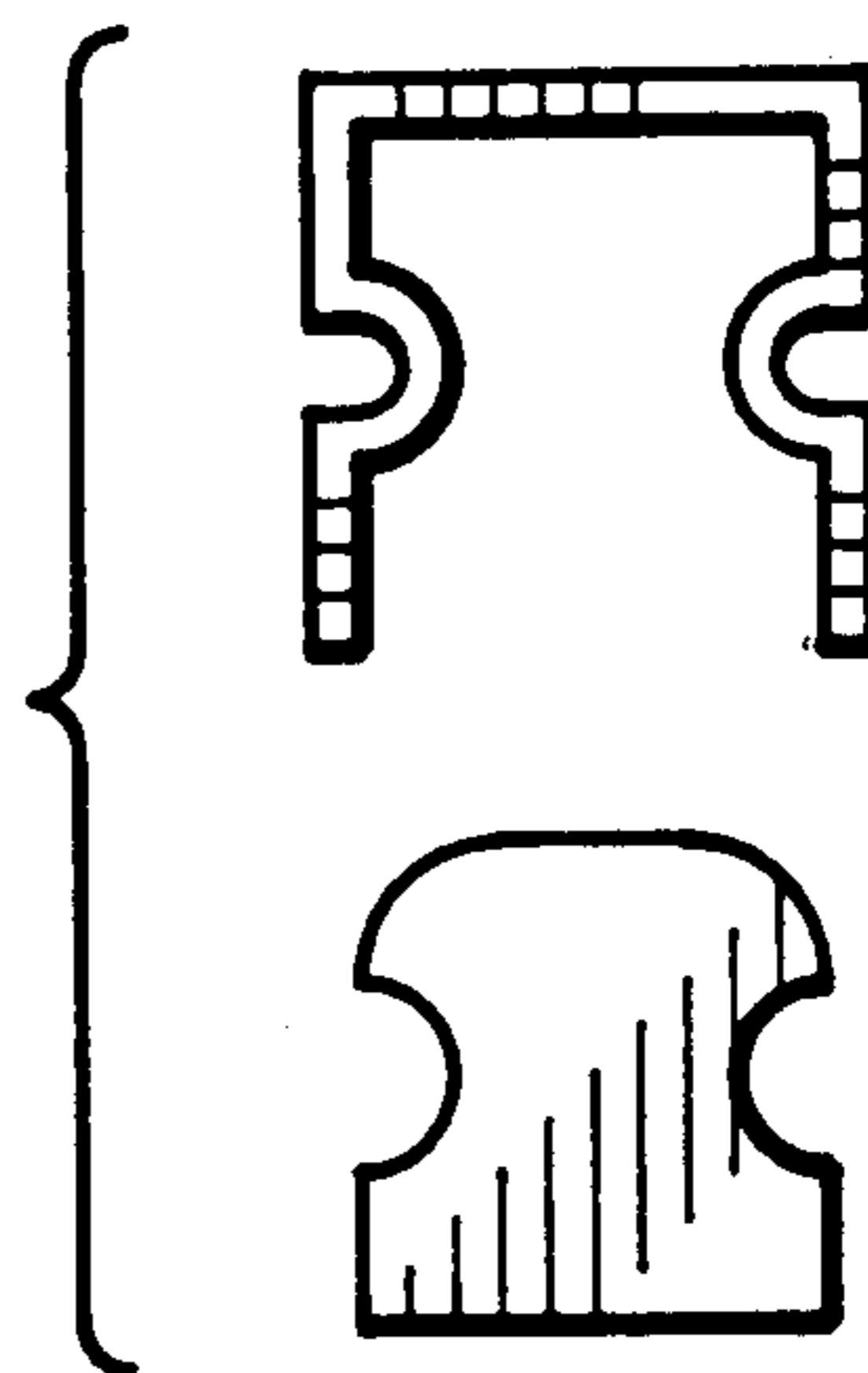

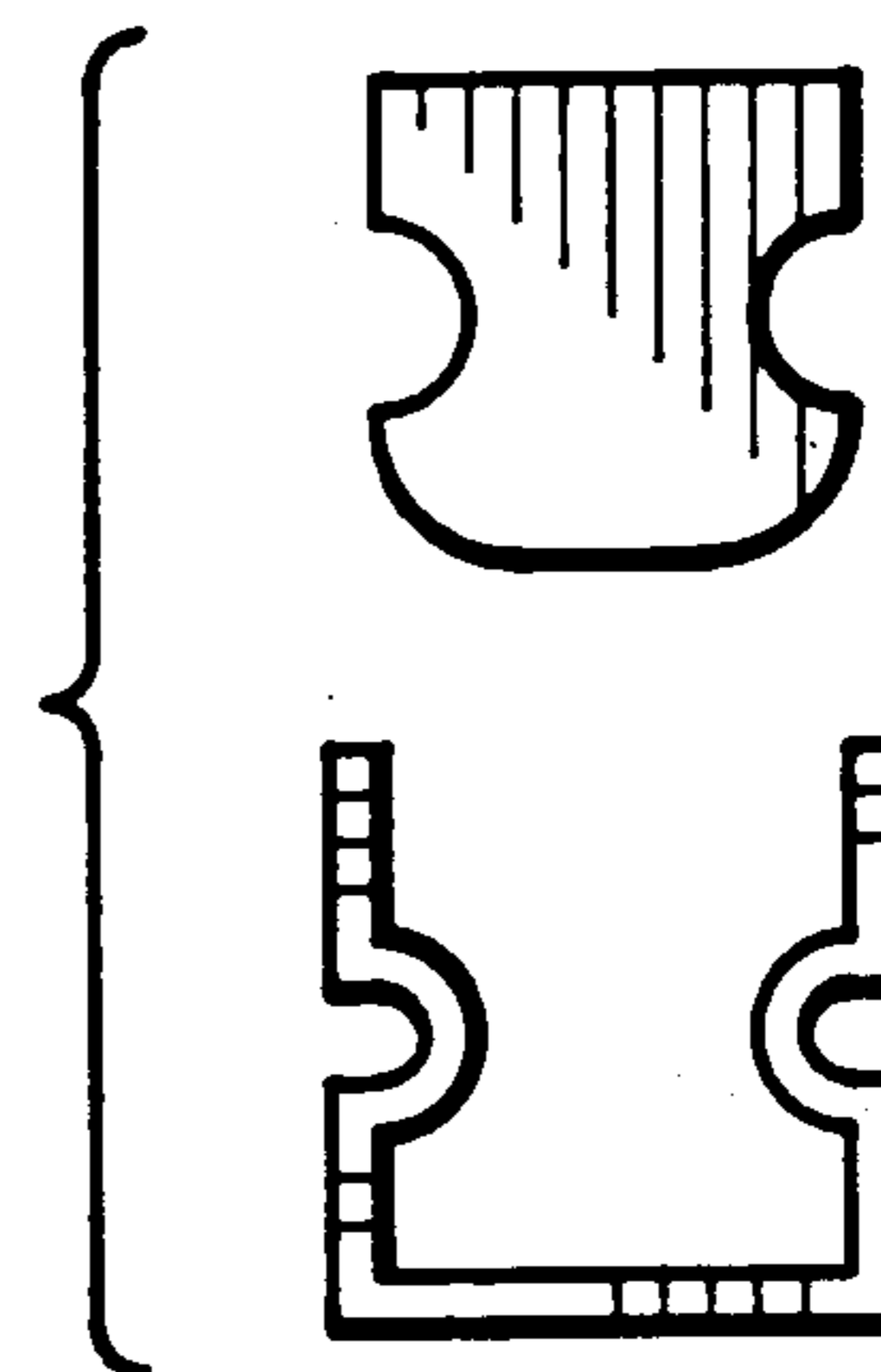

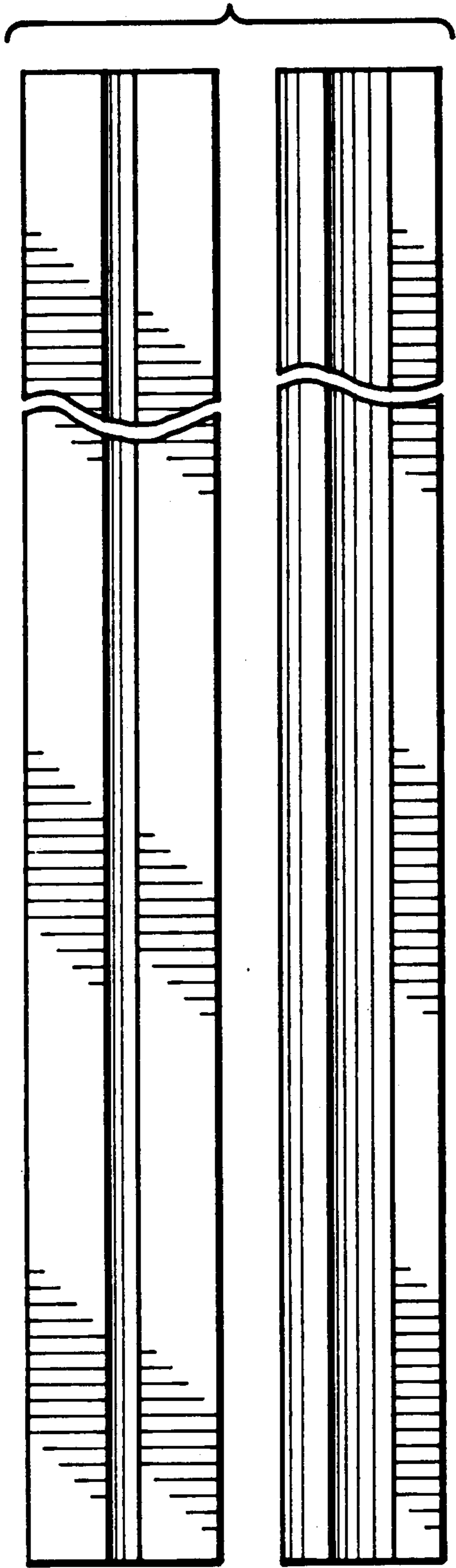

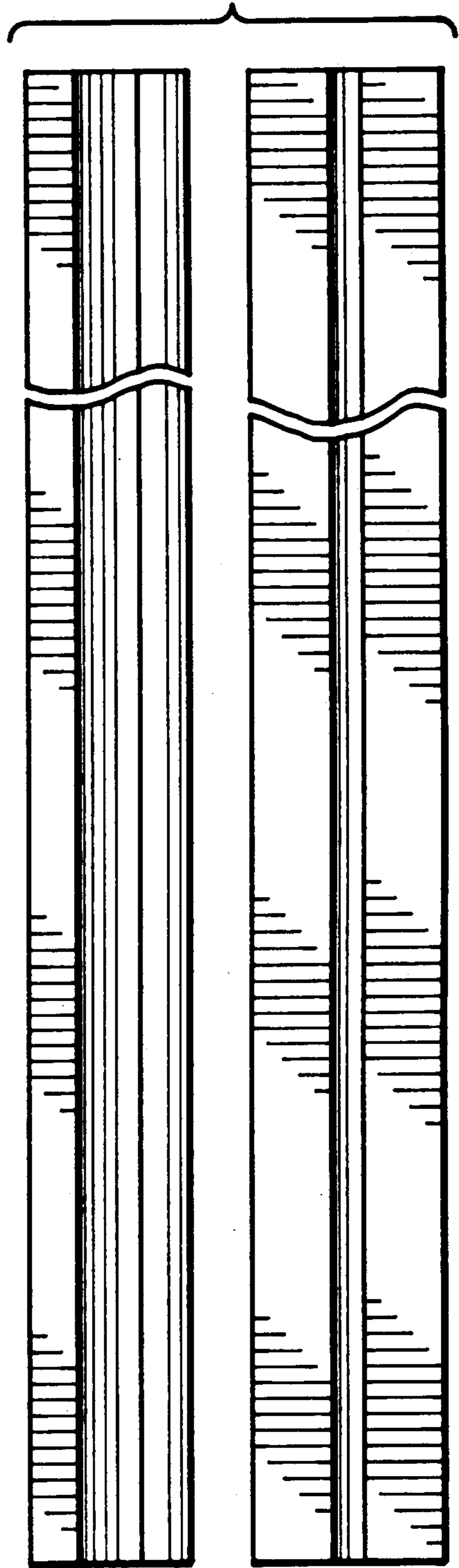

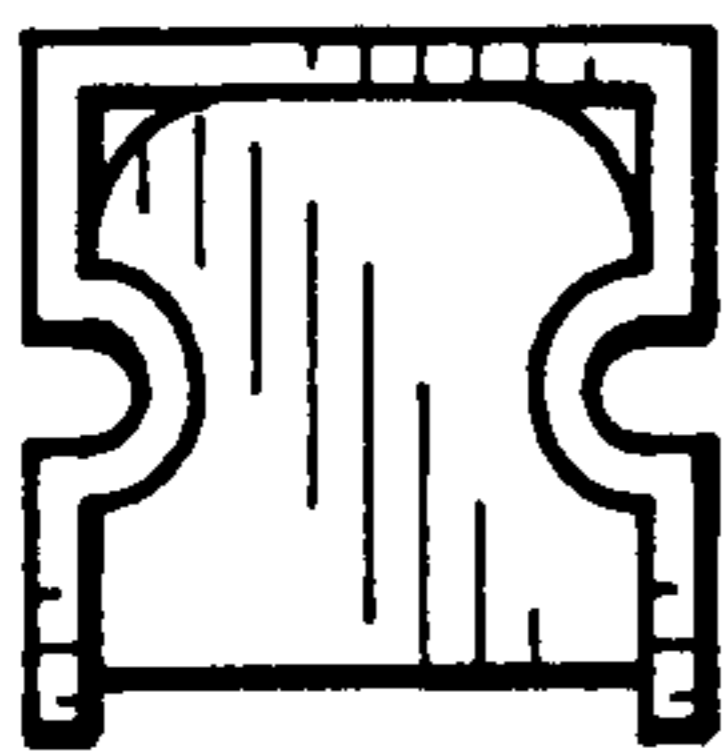

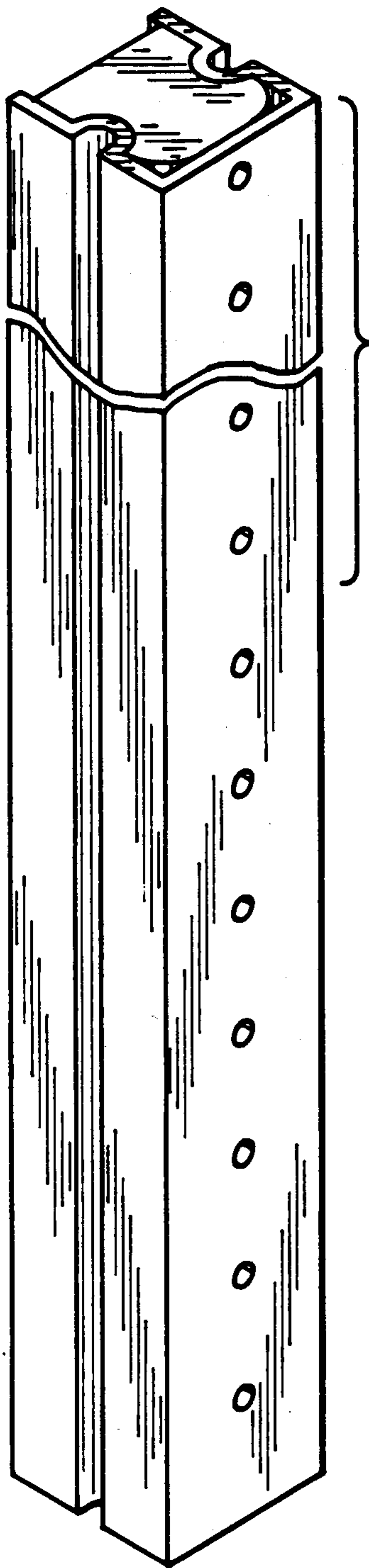

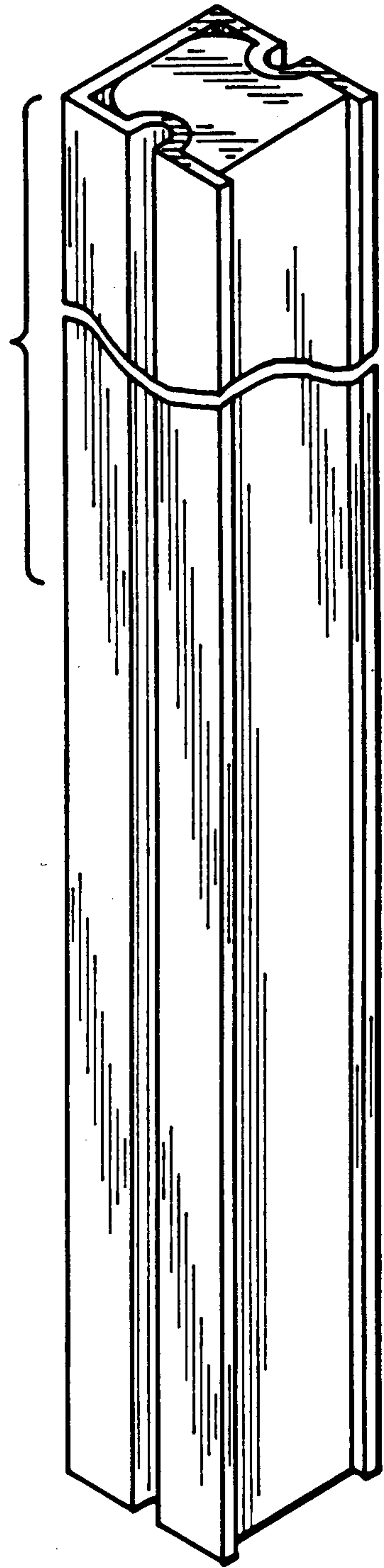
