FIG. 7 is a top, rear and right side perspective view thereof.

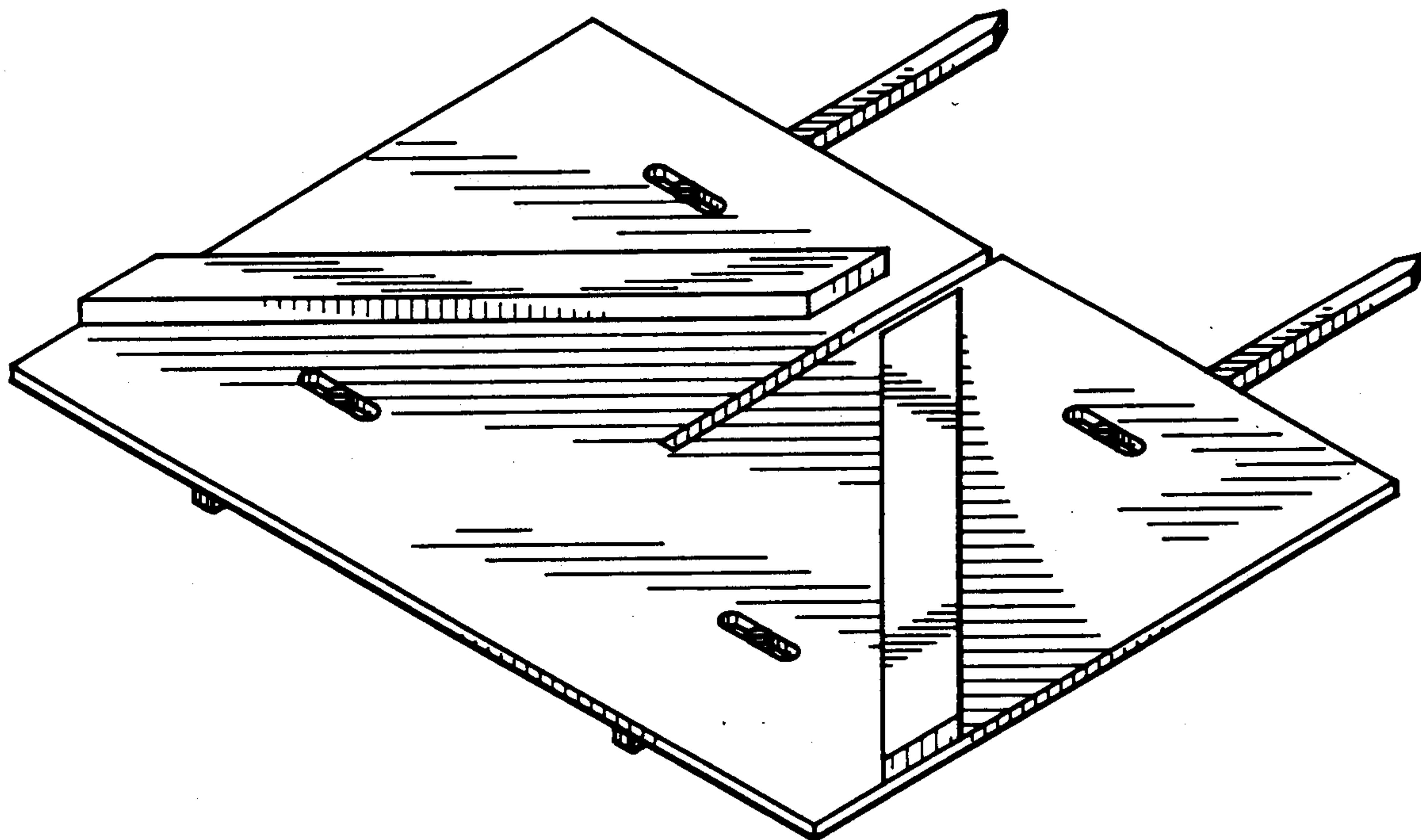

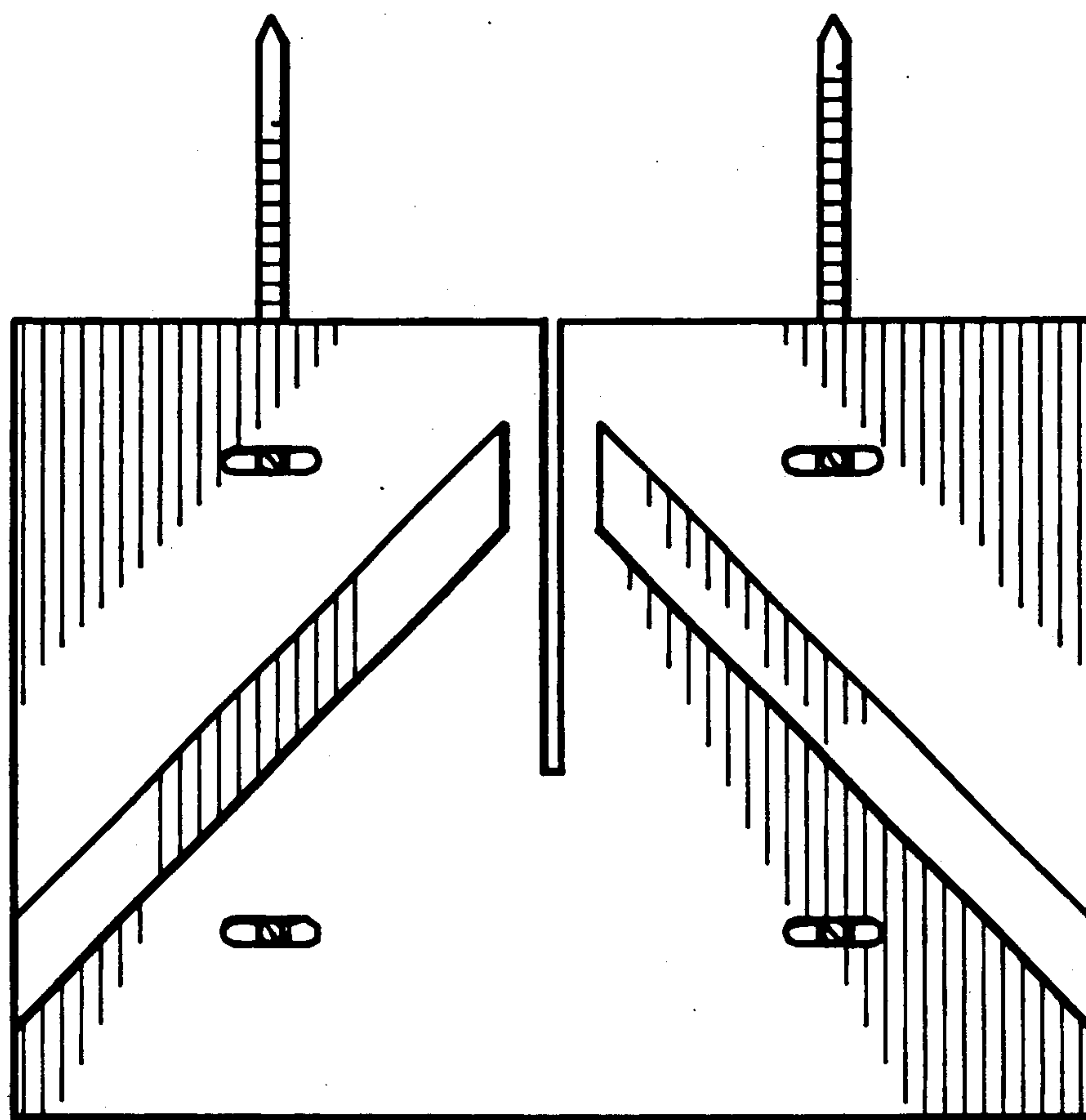
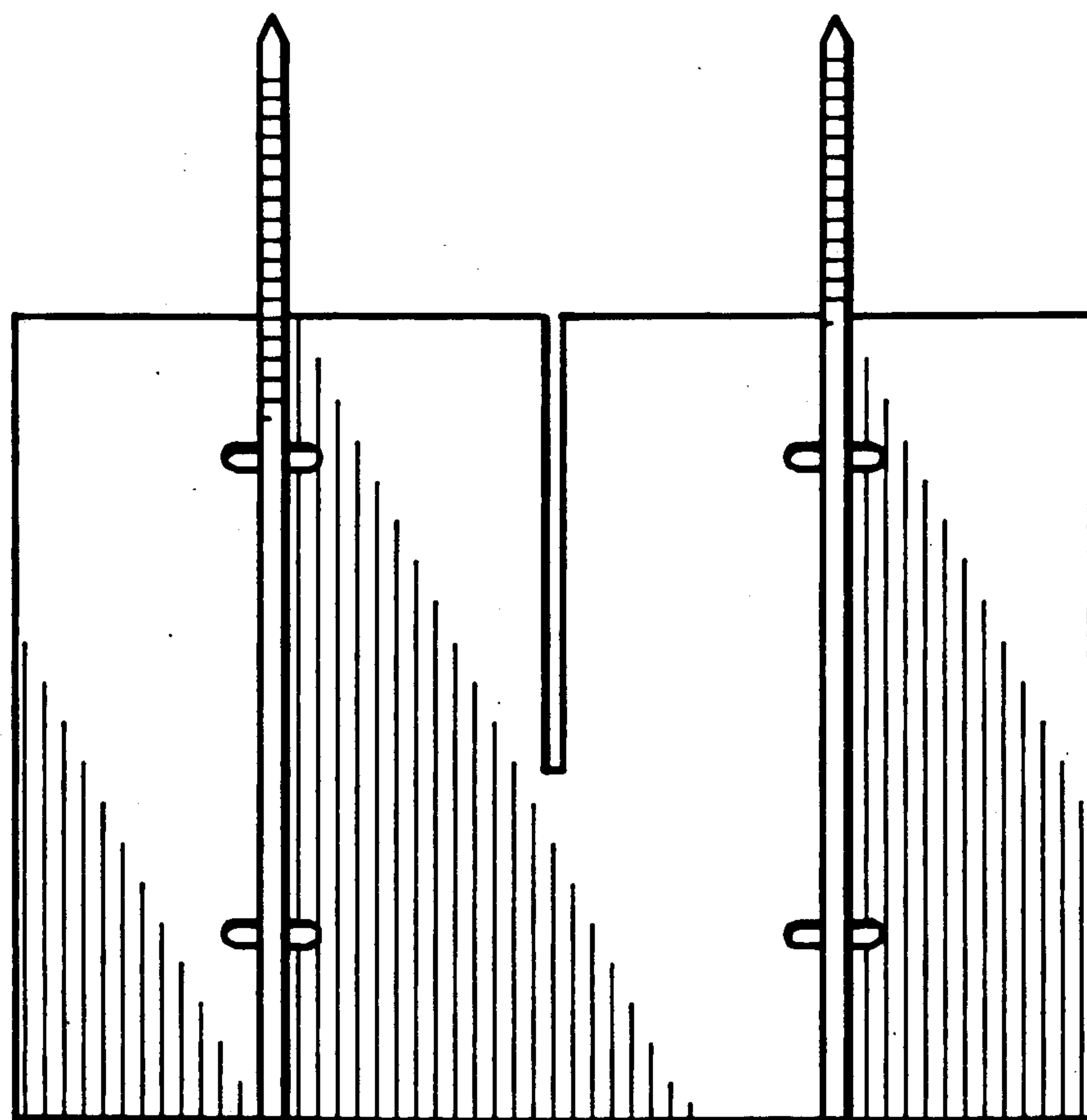

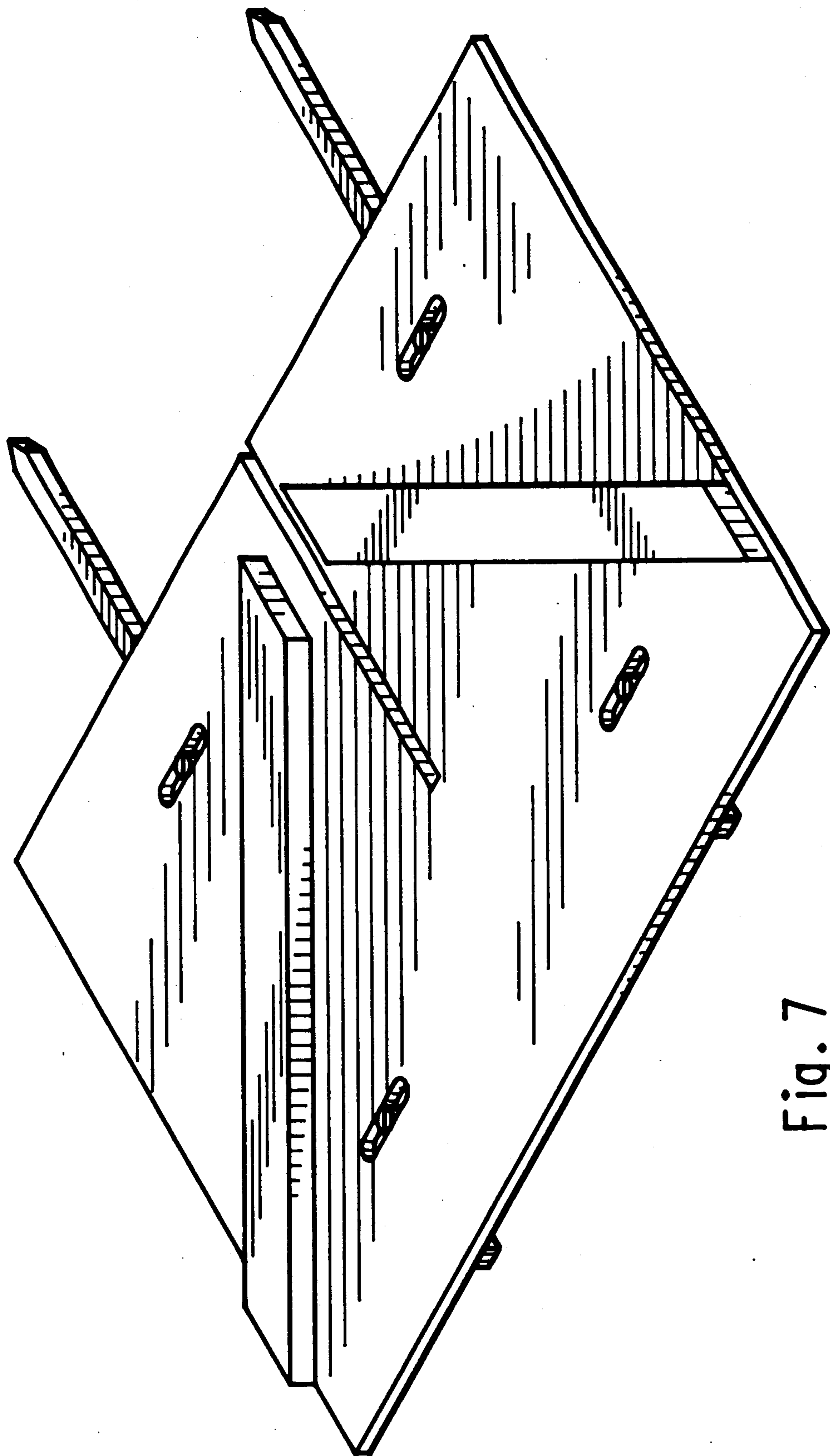
