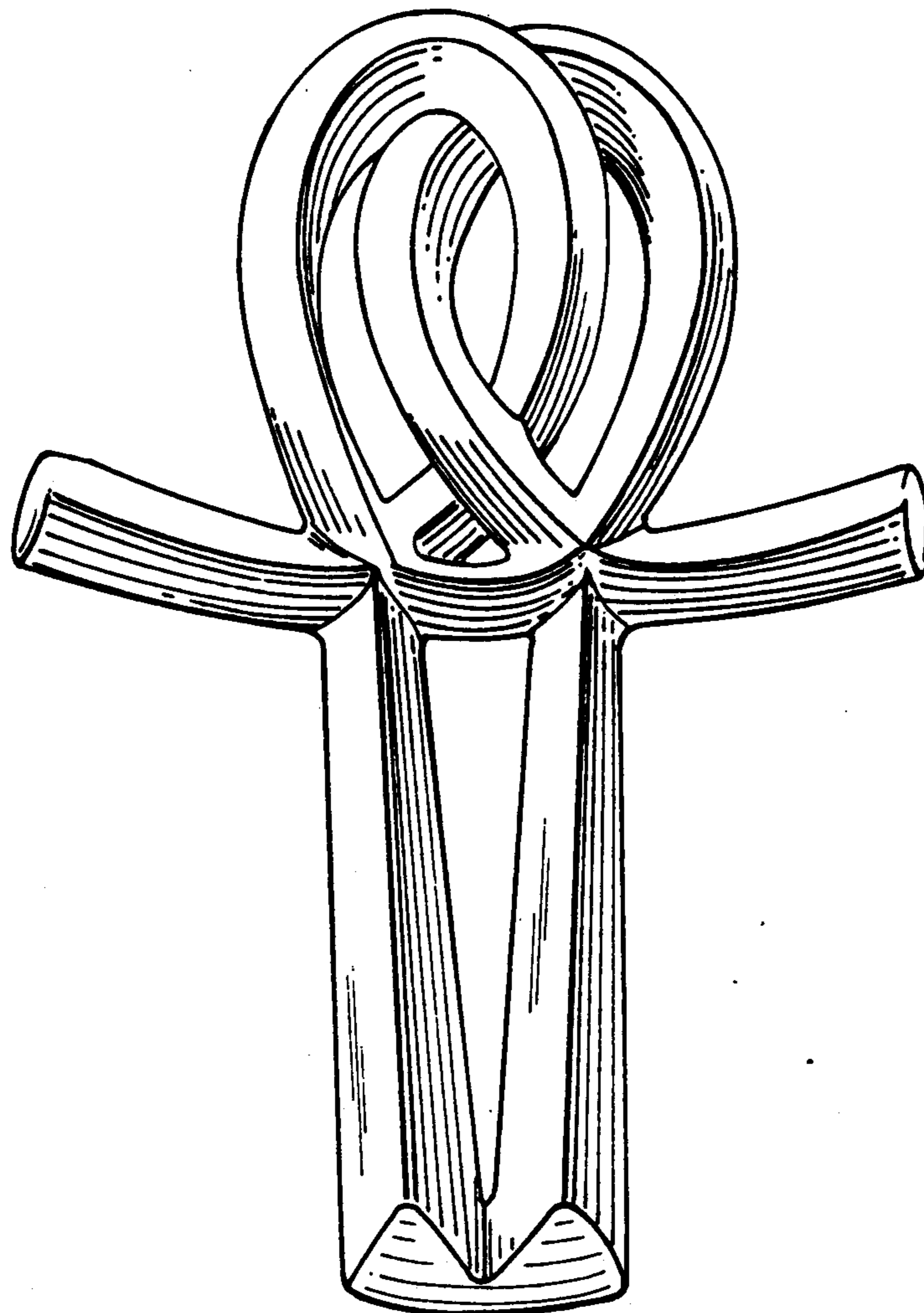

FIG. 4 is a bottom end view thereof.



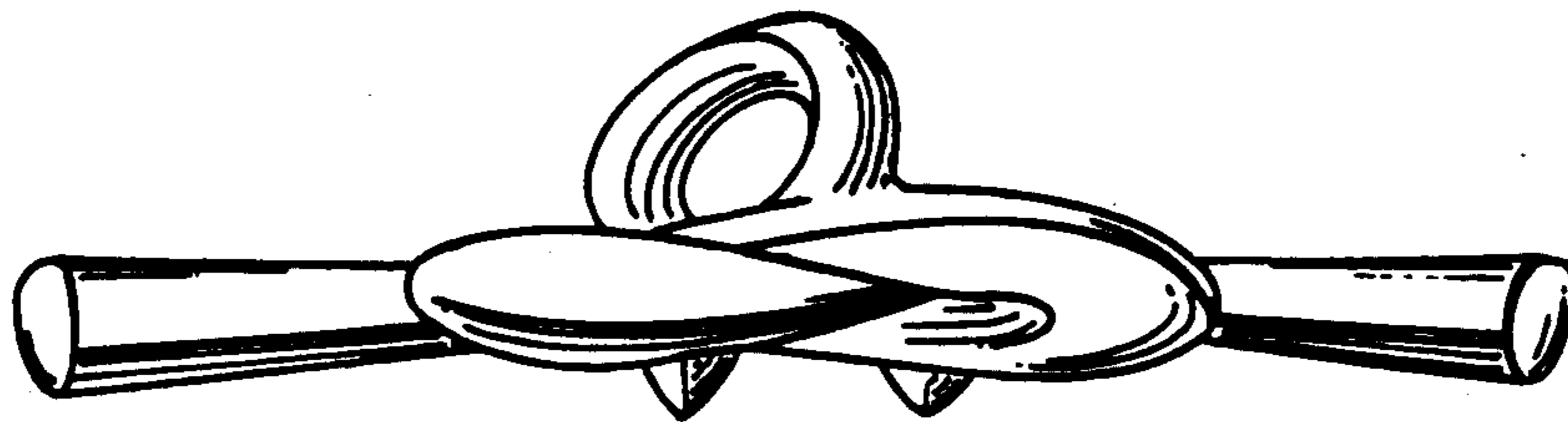

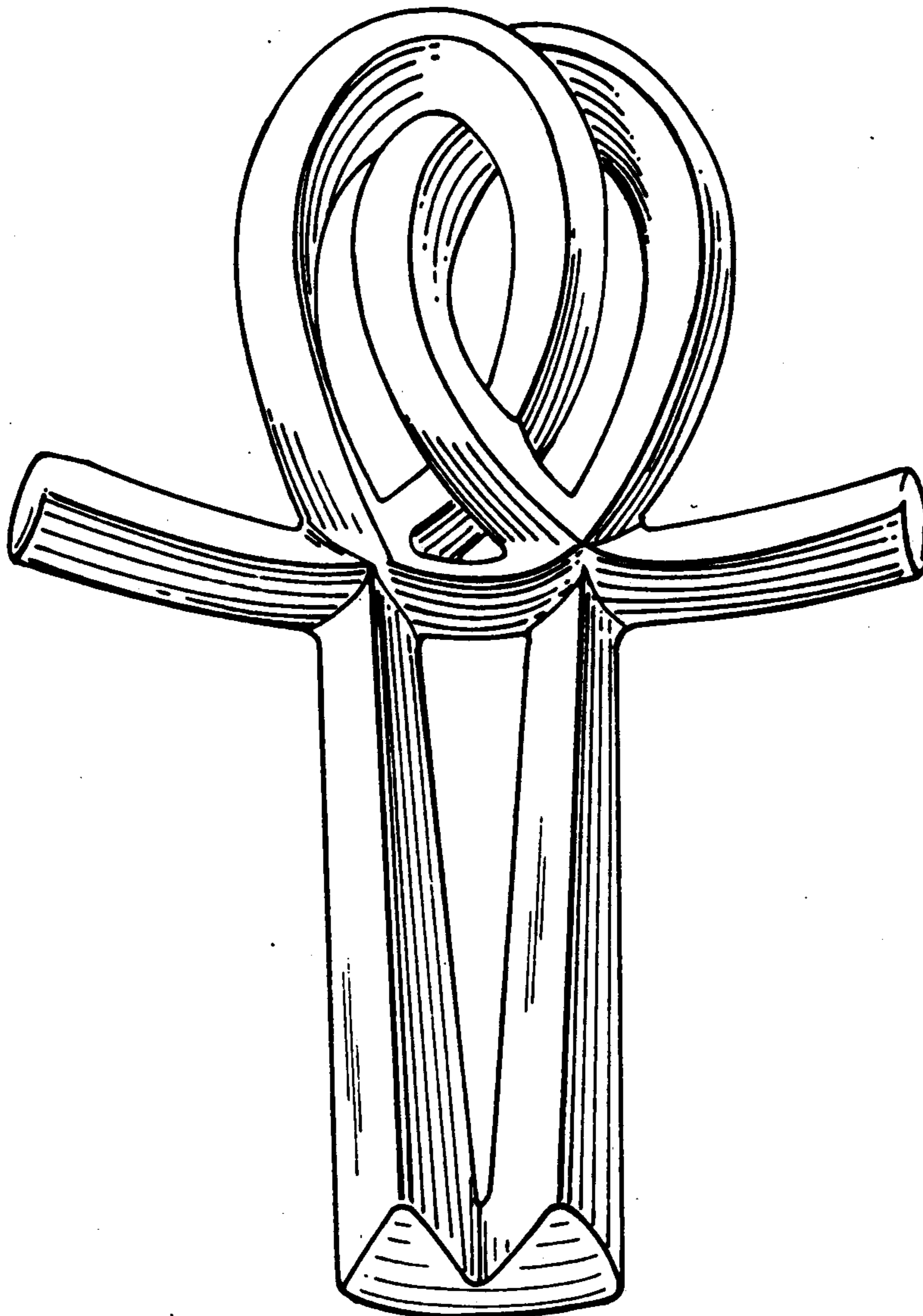

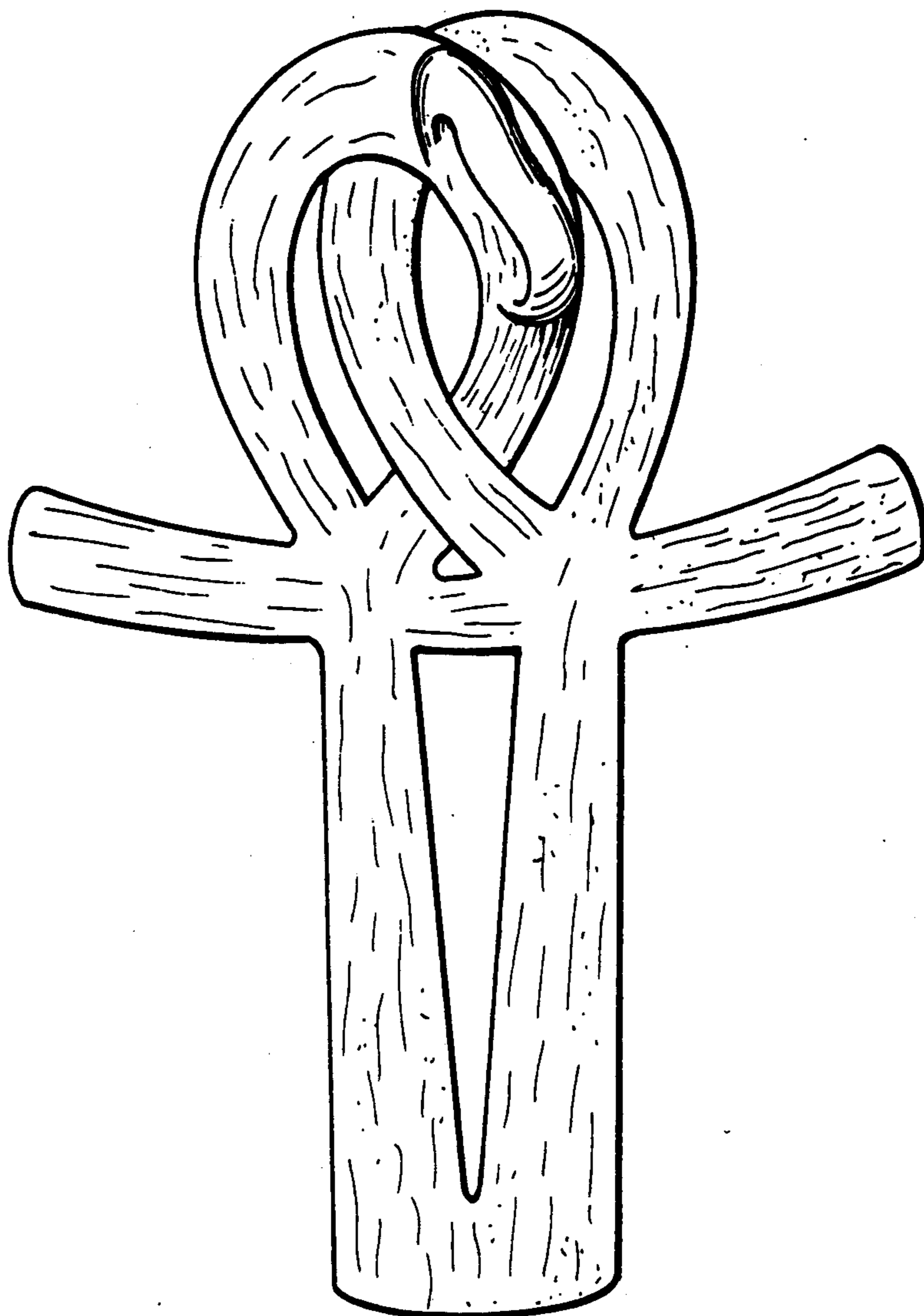

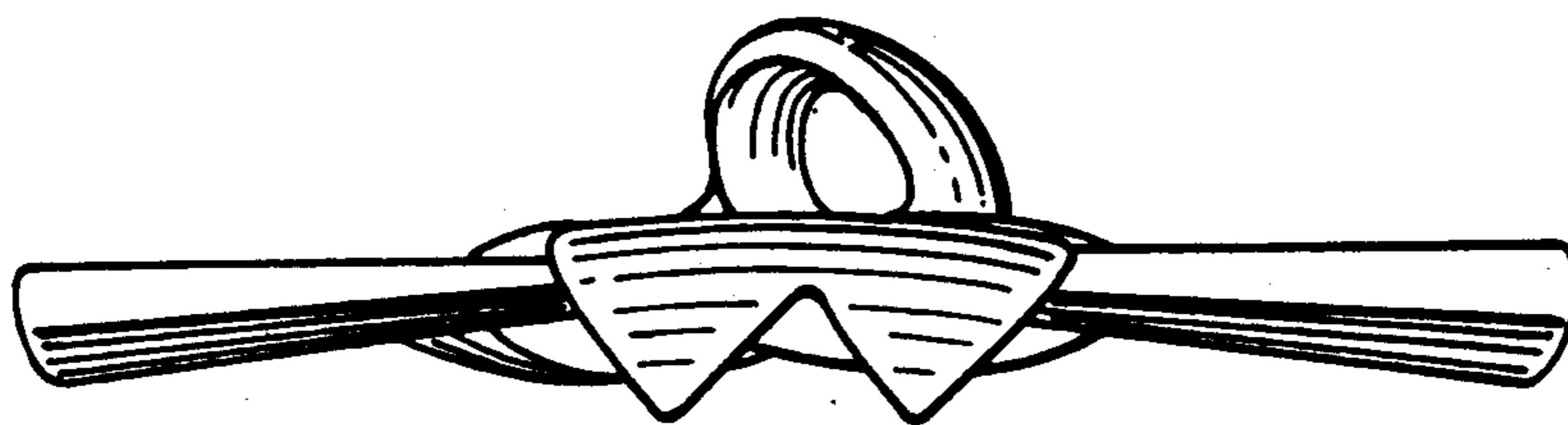
