The ornamental design for a golf shoe cleaning unit for attachment to a golf car, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a golf shoe cleaning unit for attachment to a golf car showing my new design, it being understood that the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged perspective view thereof in open condition;

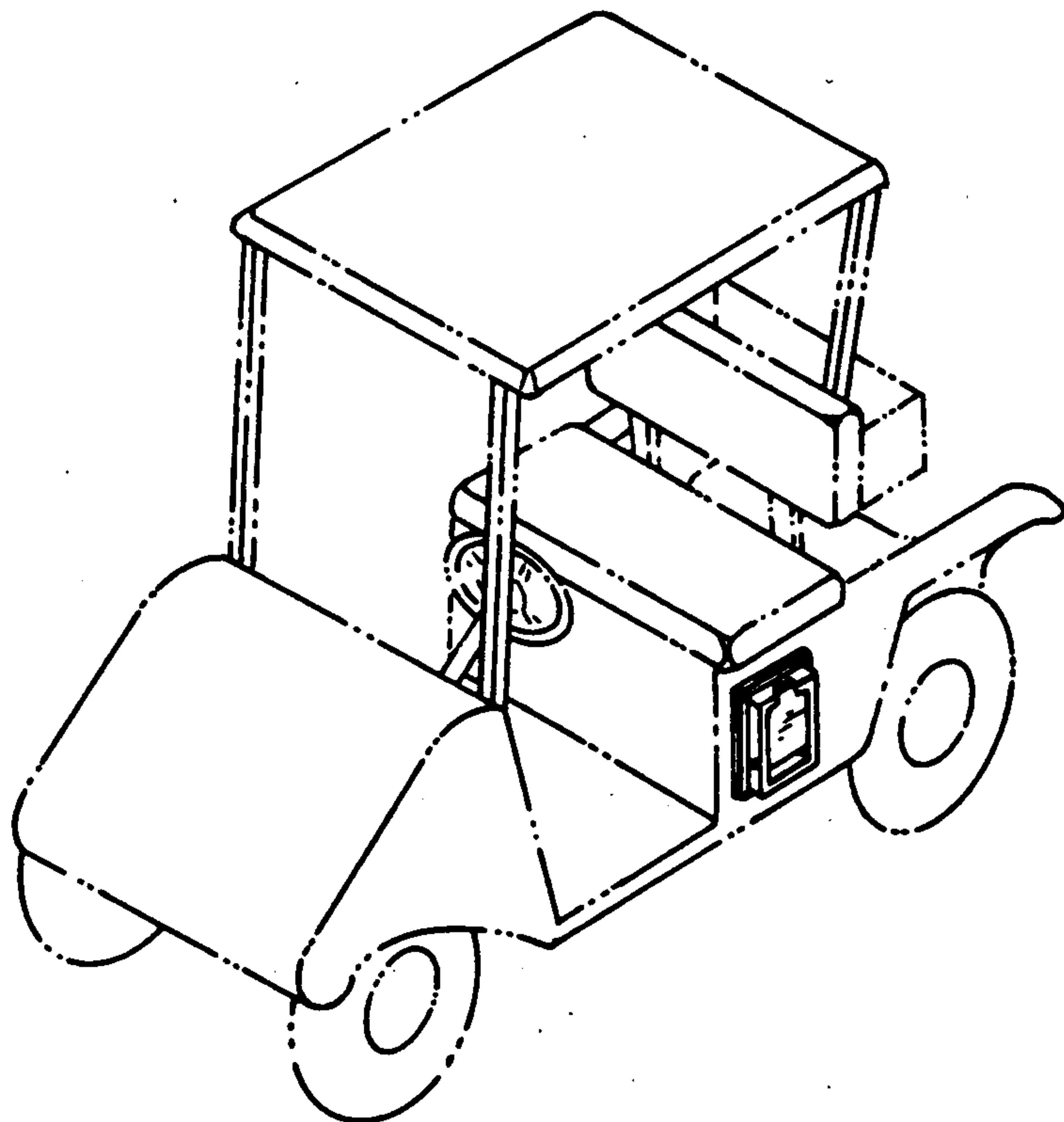
FIG. 4 is an enlarged front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof.



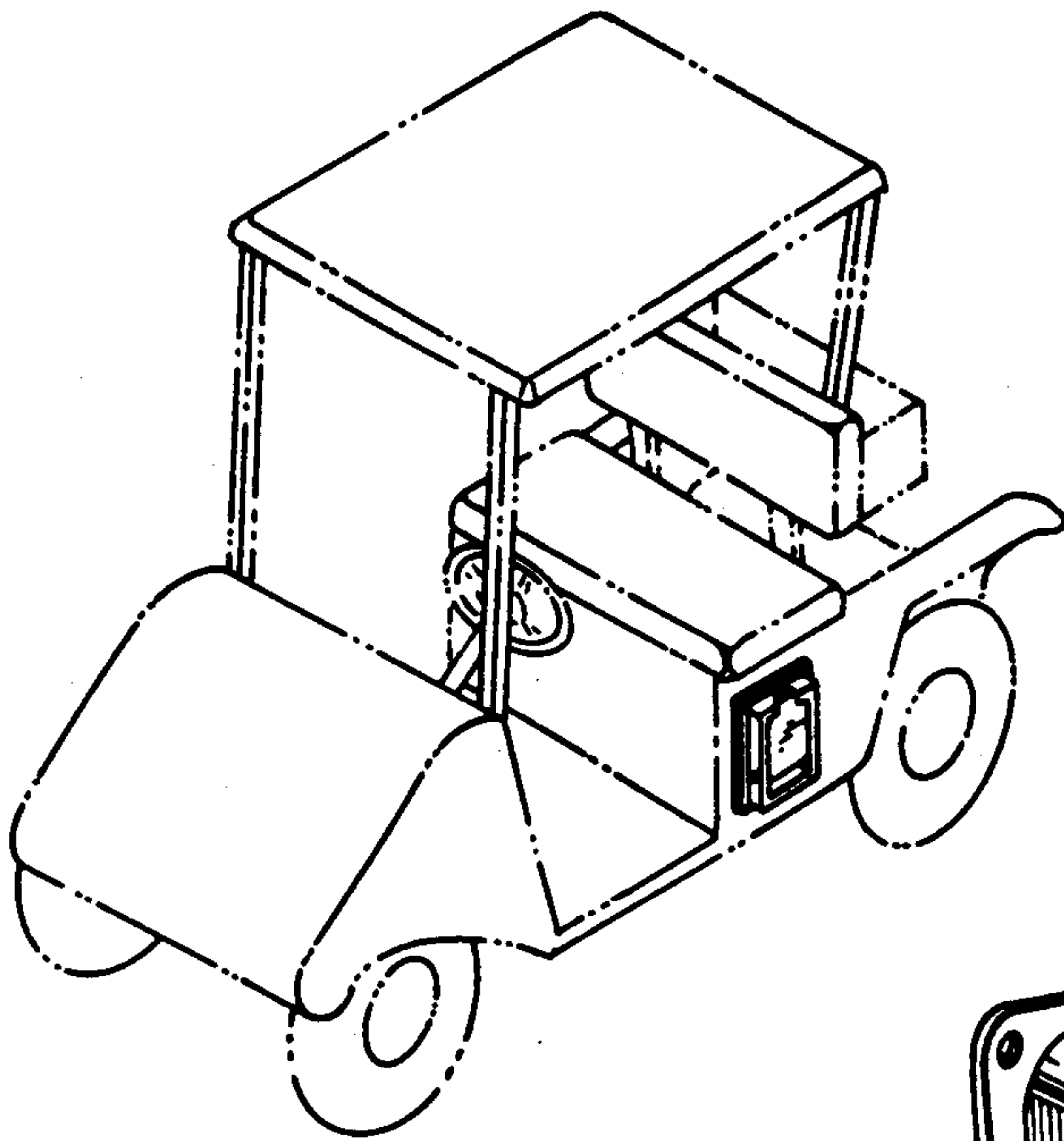

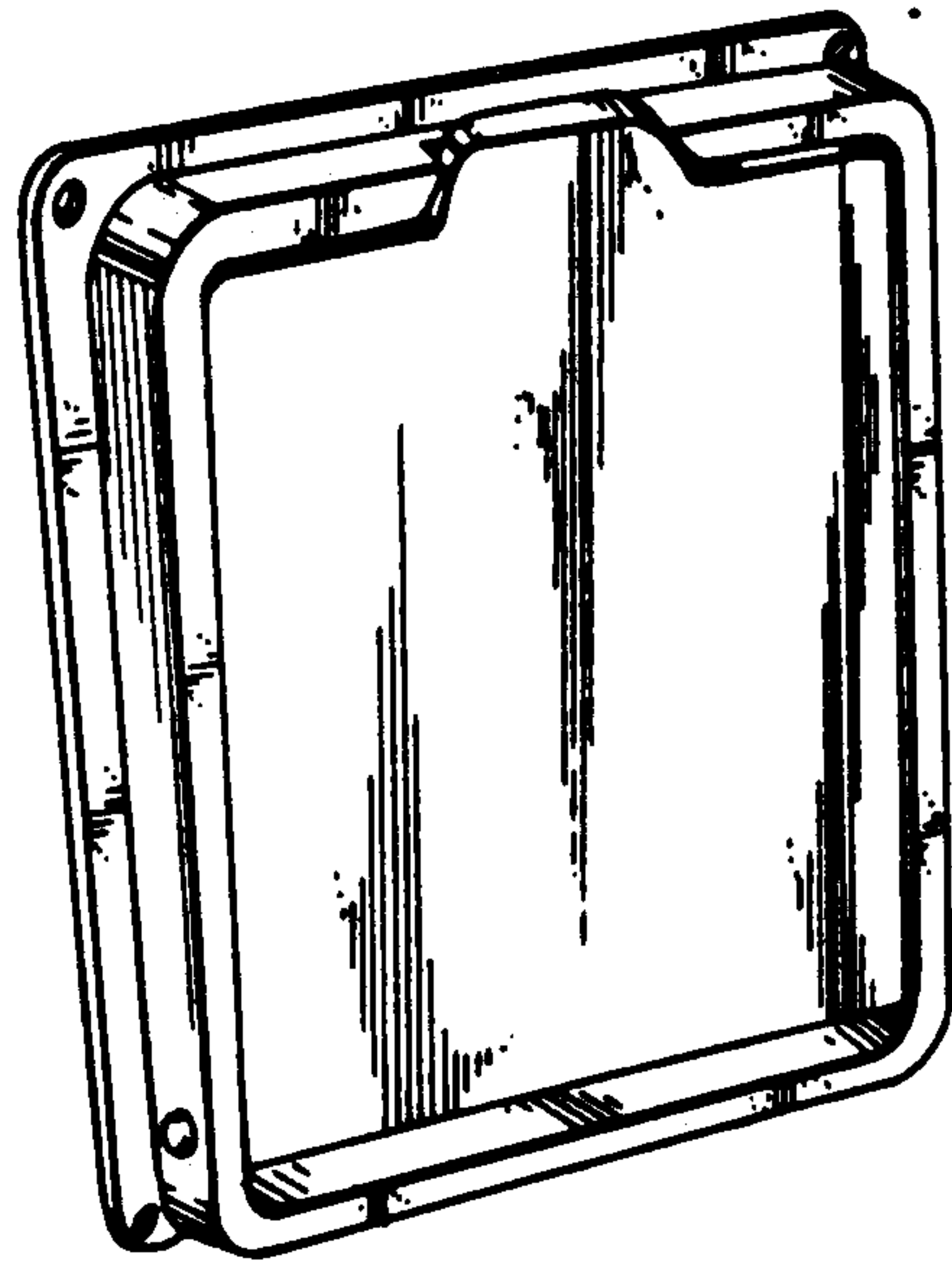

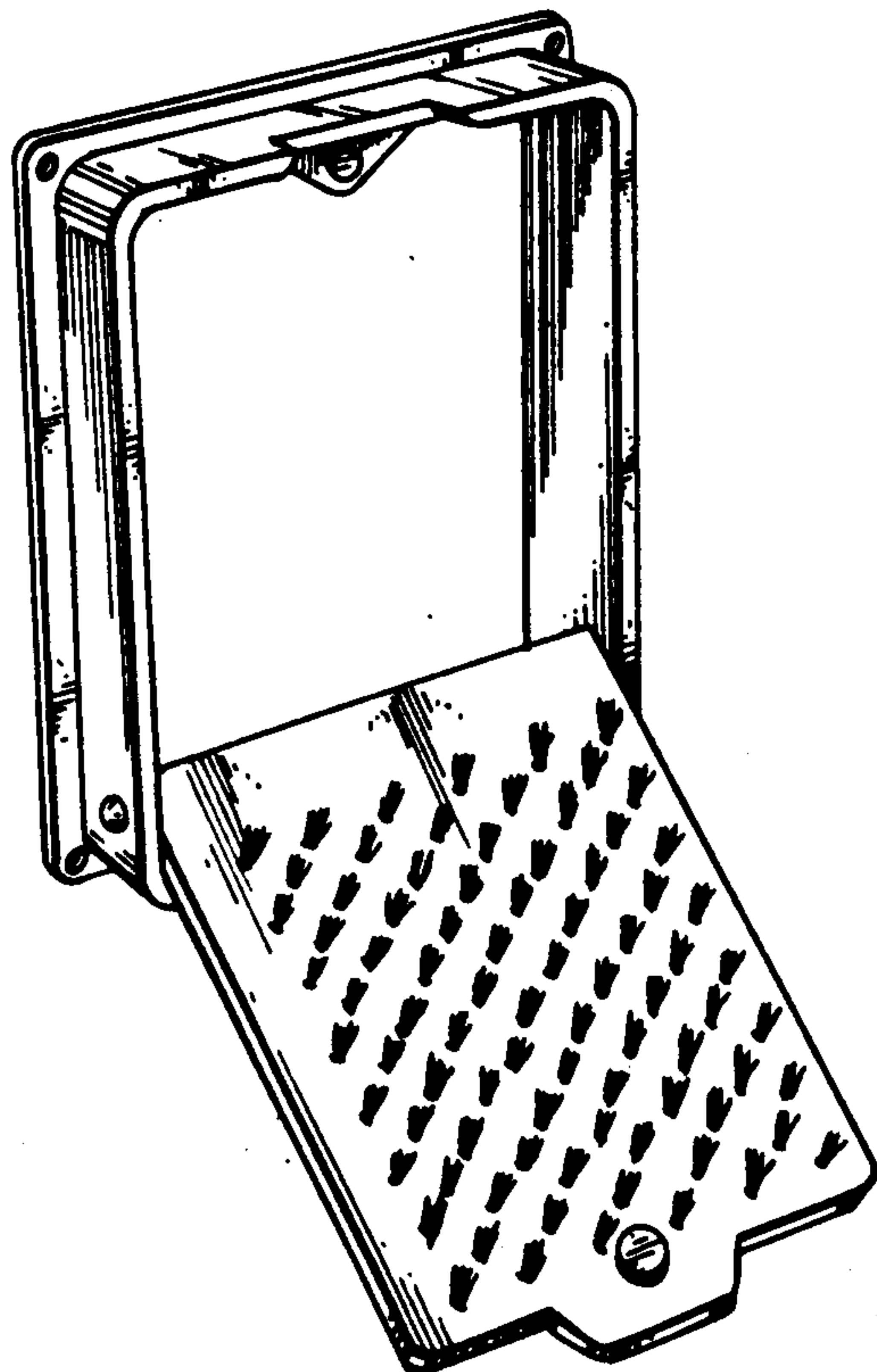

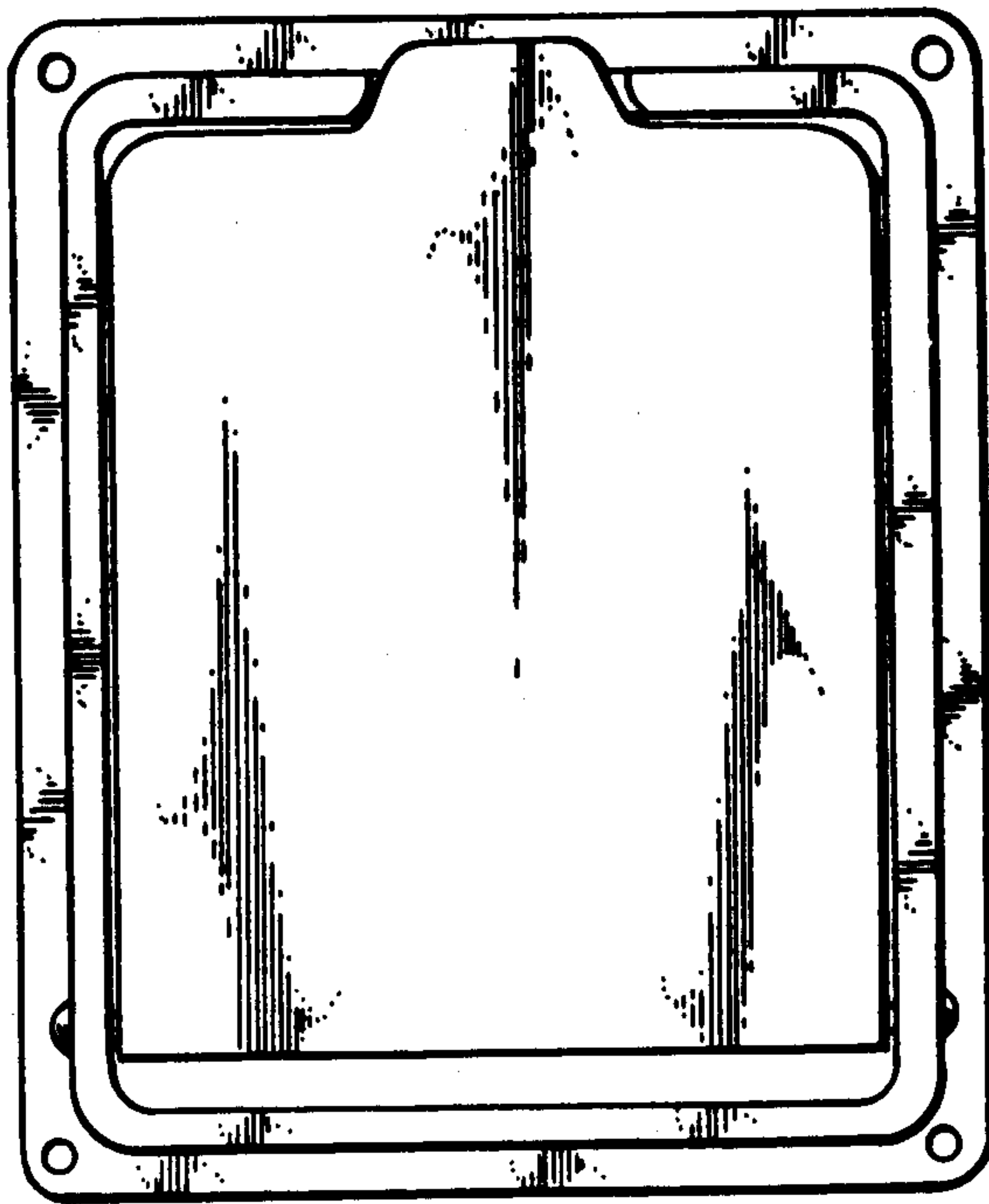

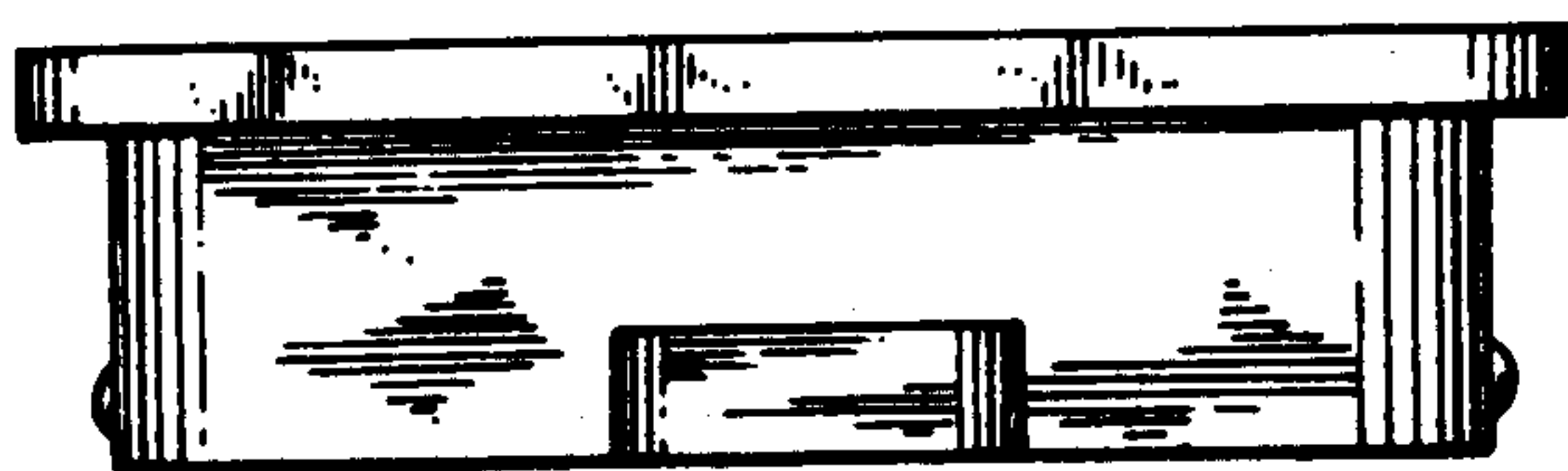
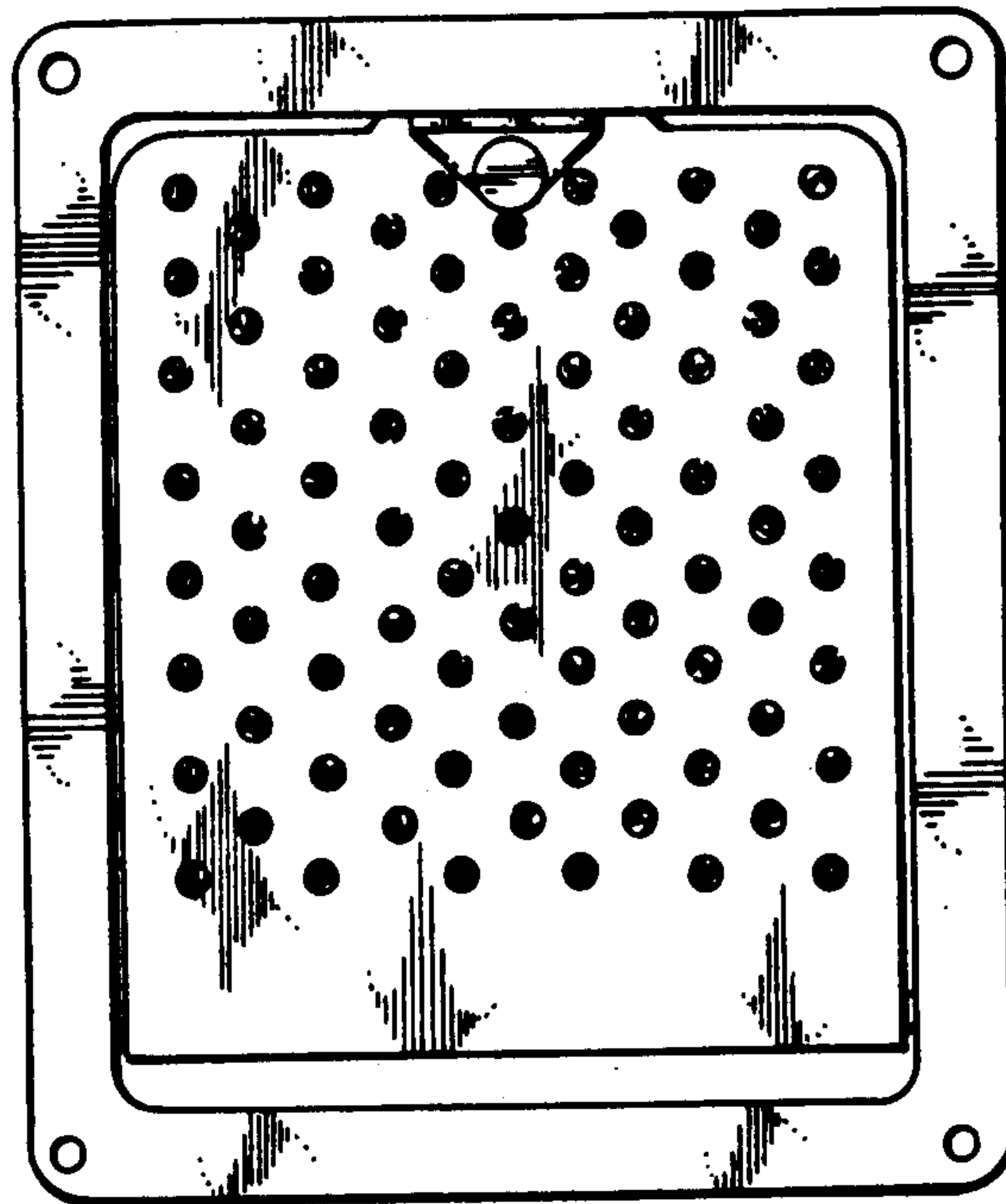

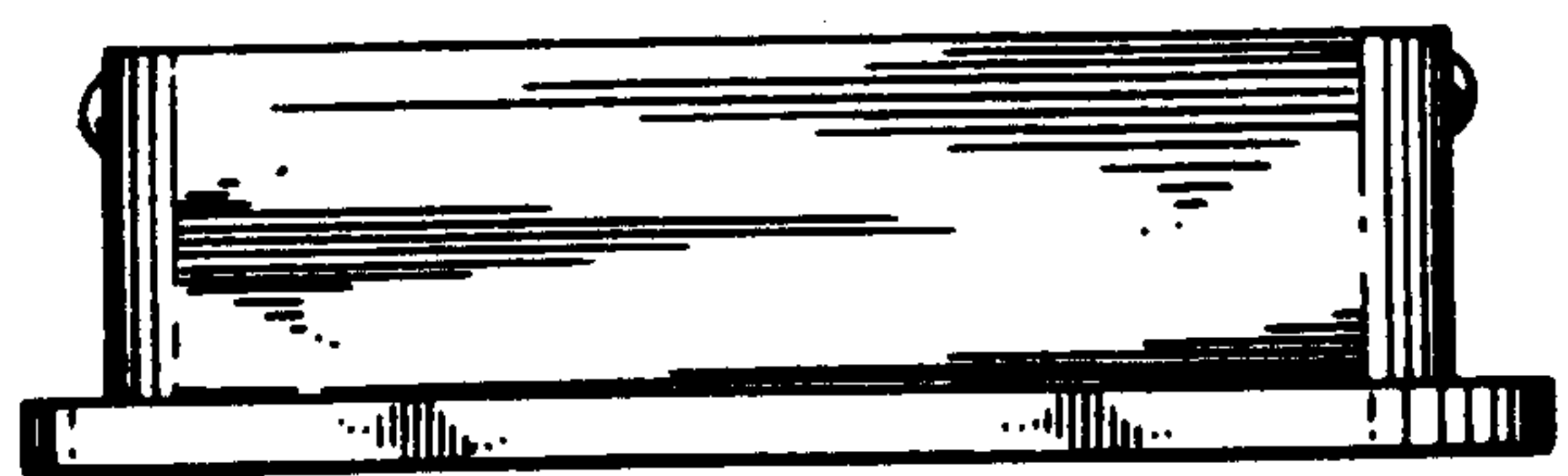
