[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tire, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The FIGURE is a perspective view of a tire showing our new design, it being understood that the tread pattern is repeated uniformly throughout the circumference of the tire as shown schematically by solid lines, the opposite side being the same as that shown.
