[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a boat bottom protector, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and side perspective view of a boat bottom protector showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side perspective view thereof showing the protector attached to a multi-hull vessel, the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side elevational view being a mirror image of that shown;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a cross sectional view thereof, along line 6—6 of FIG. 4; and
FIG. 7 is a front perspective view thereof.

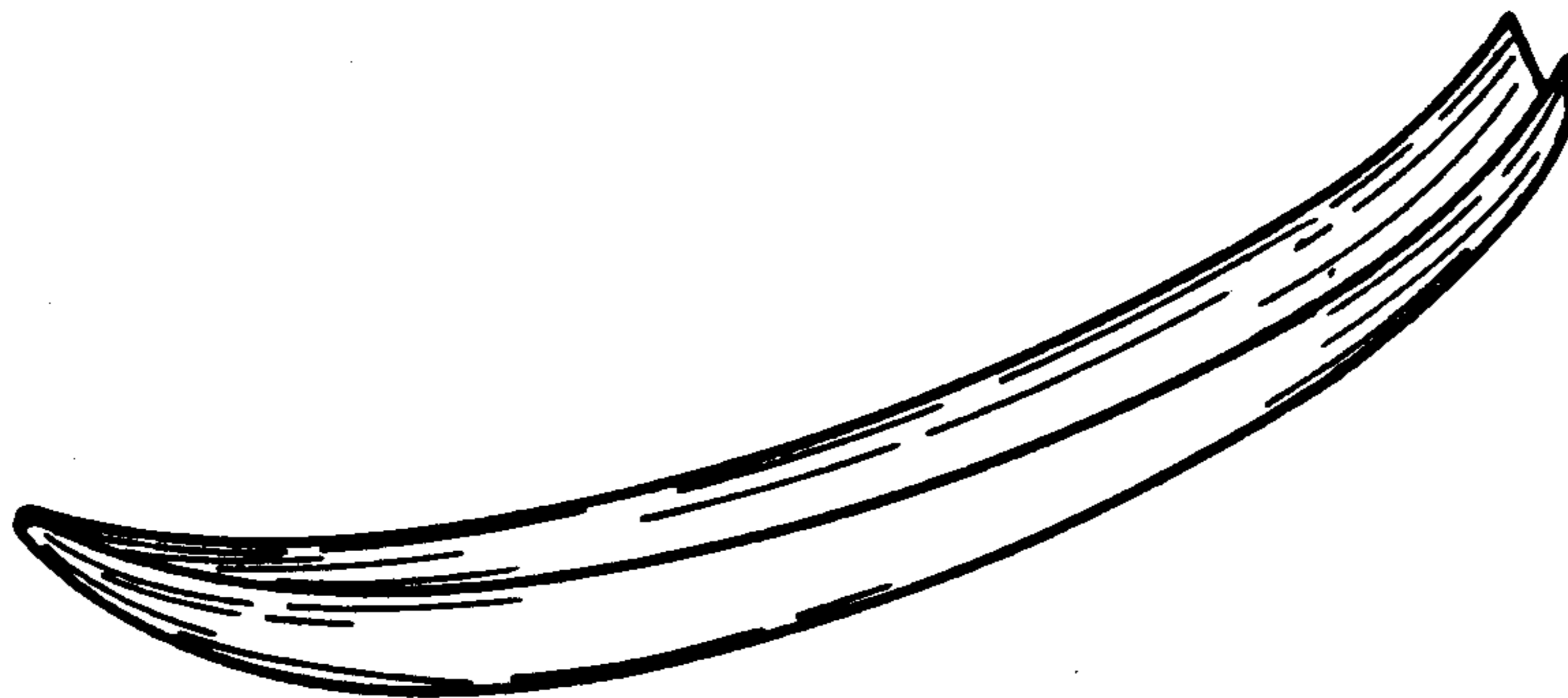

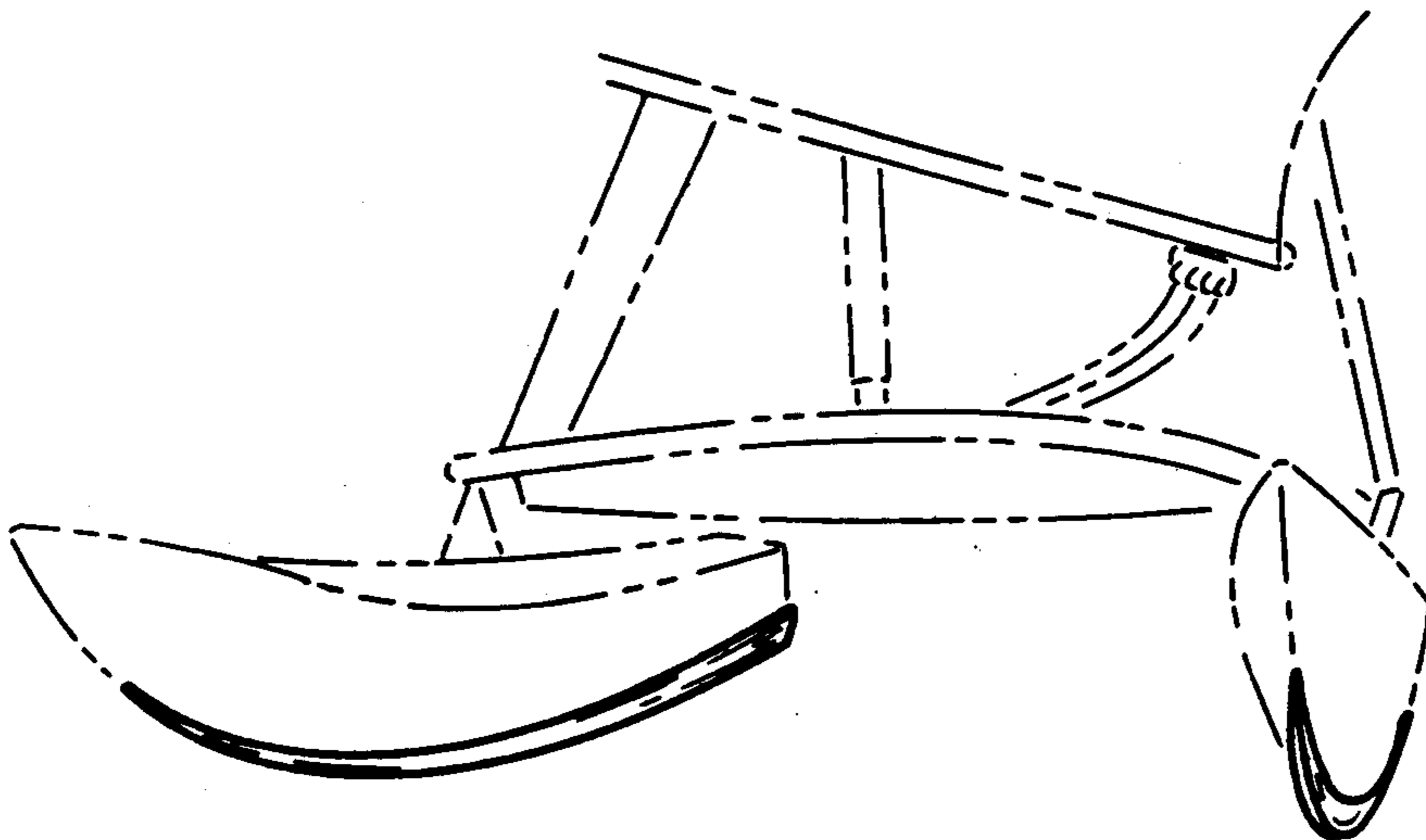

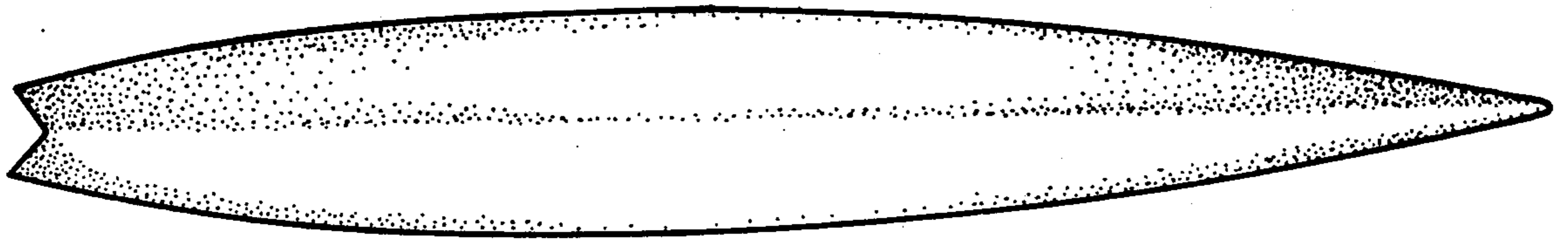

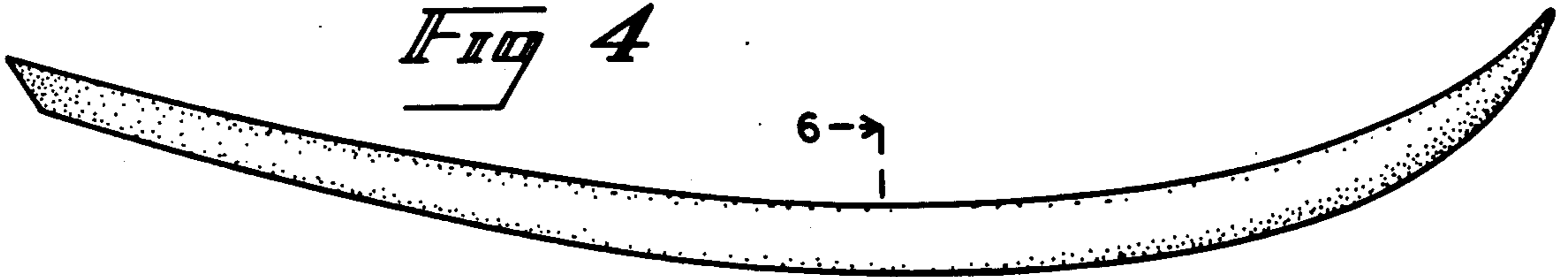

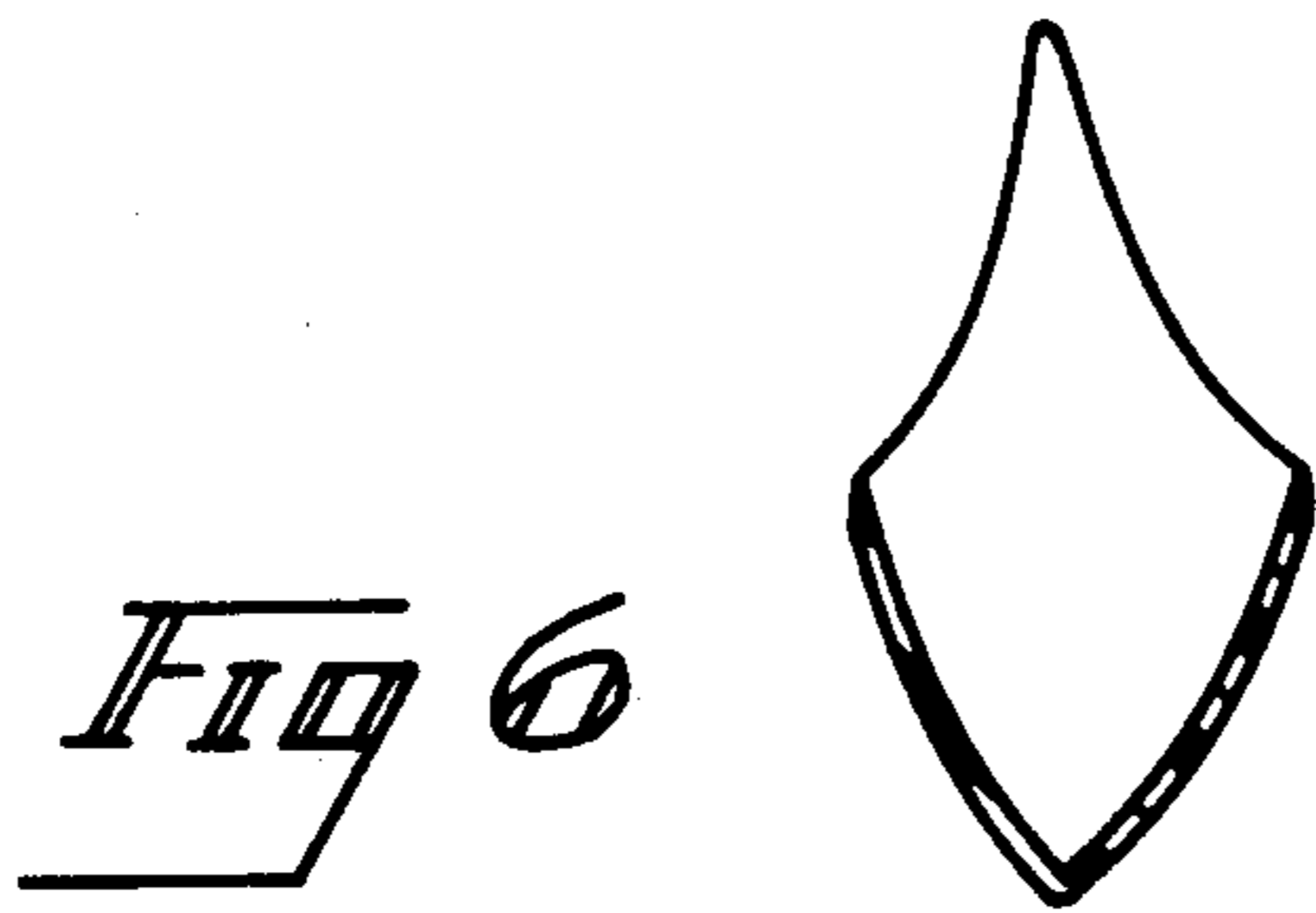

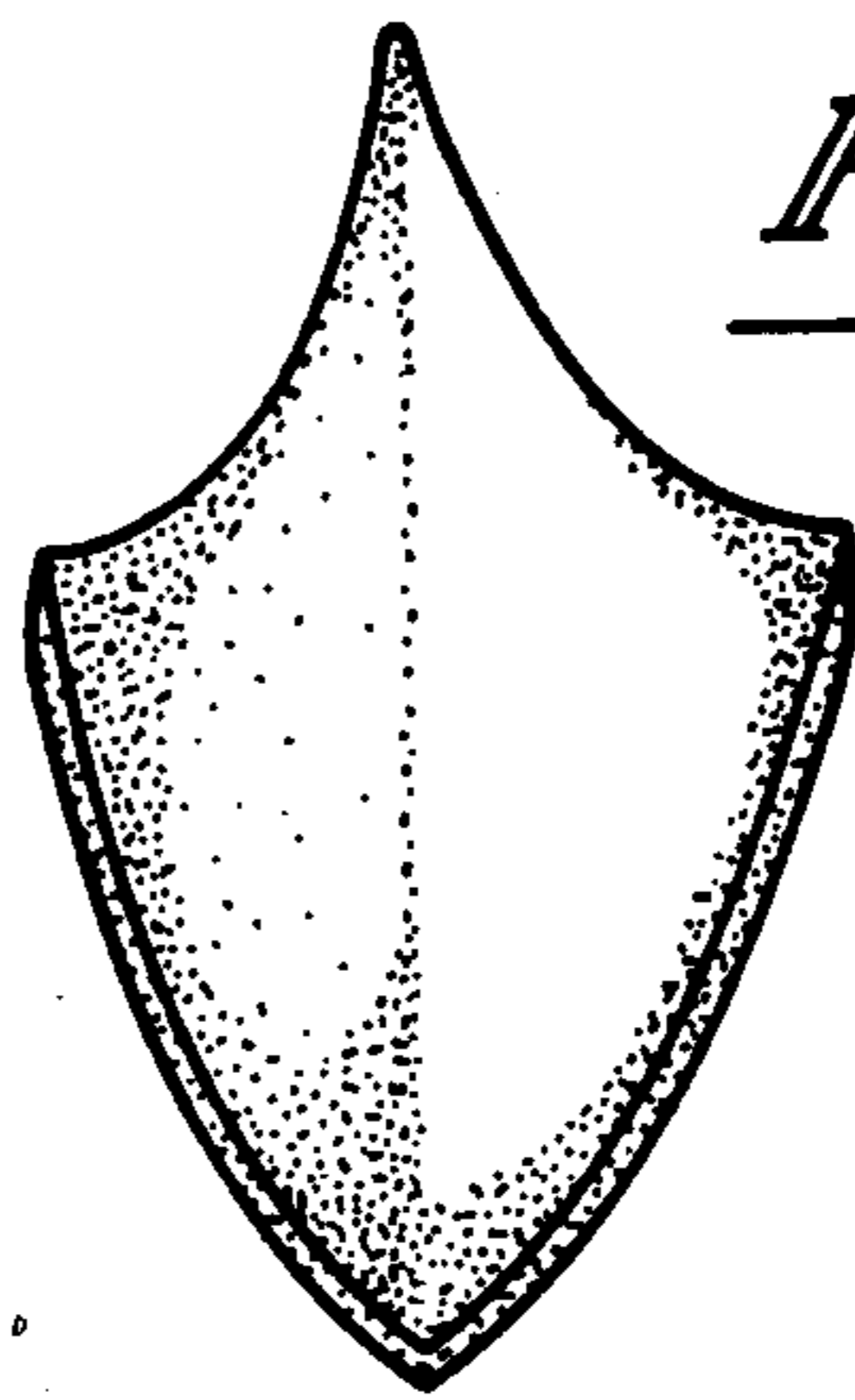

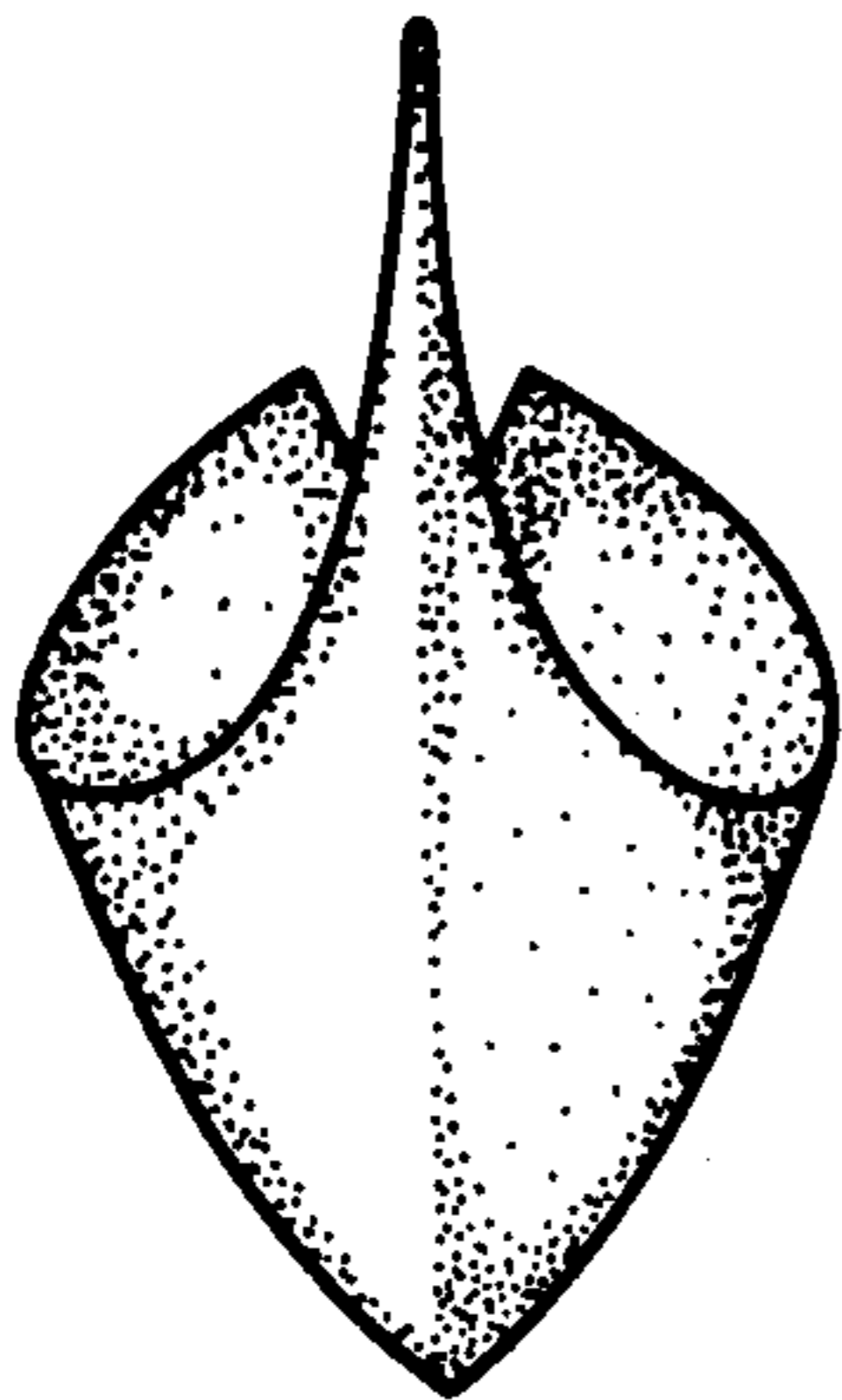
