The ornamental design for a combined digital audio disc player, radio and tape recorder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of the digital audio disc player, radio and tape recorder showing my new design with antenna raised and covers open;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

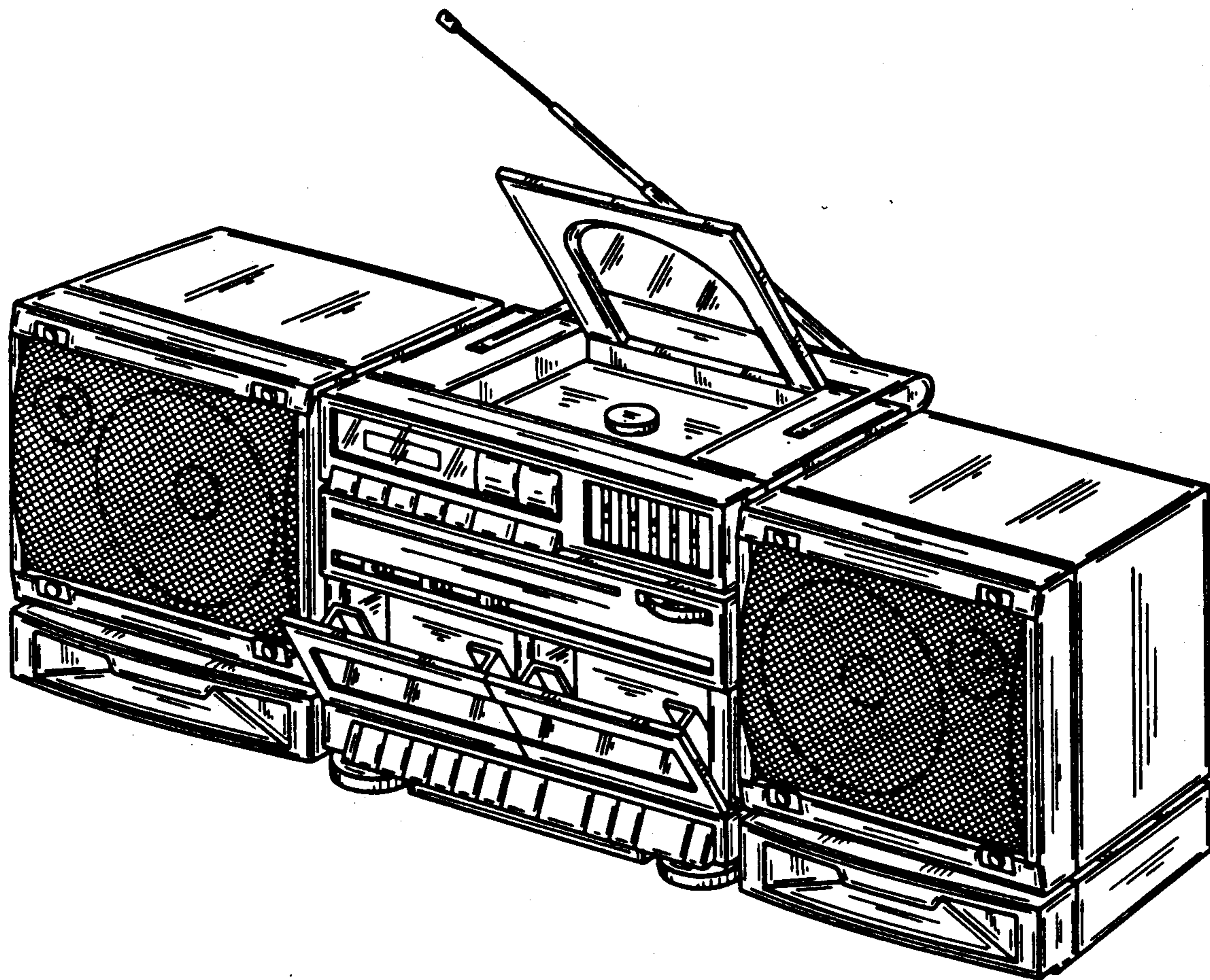
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.



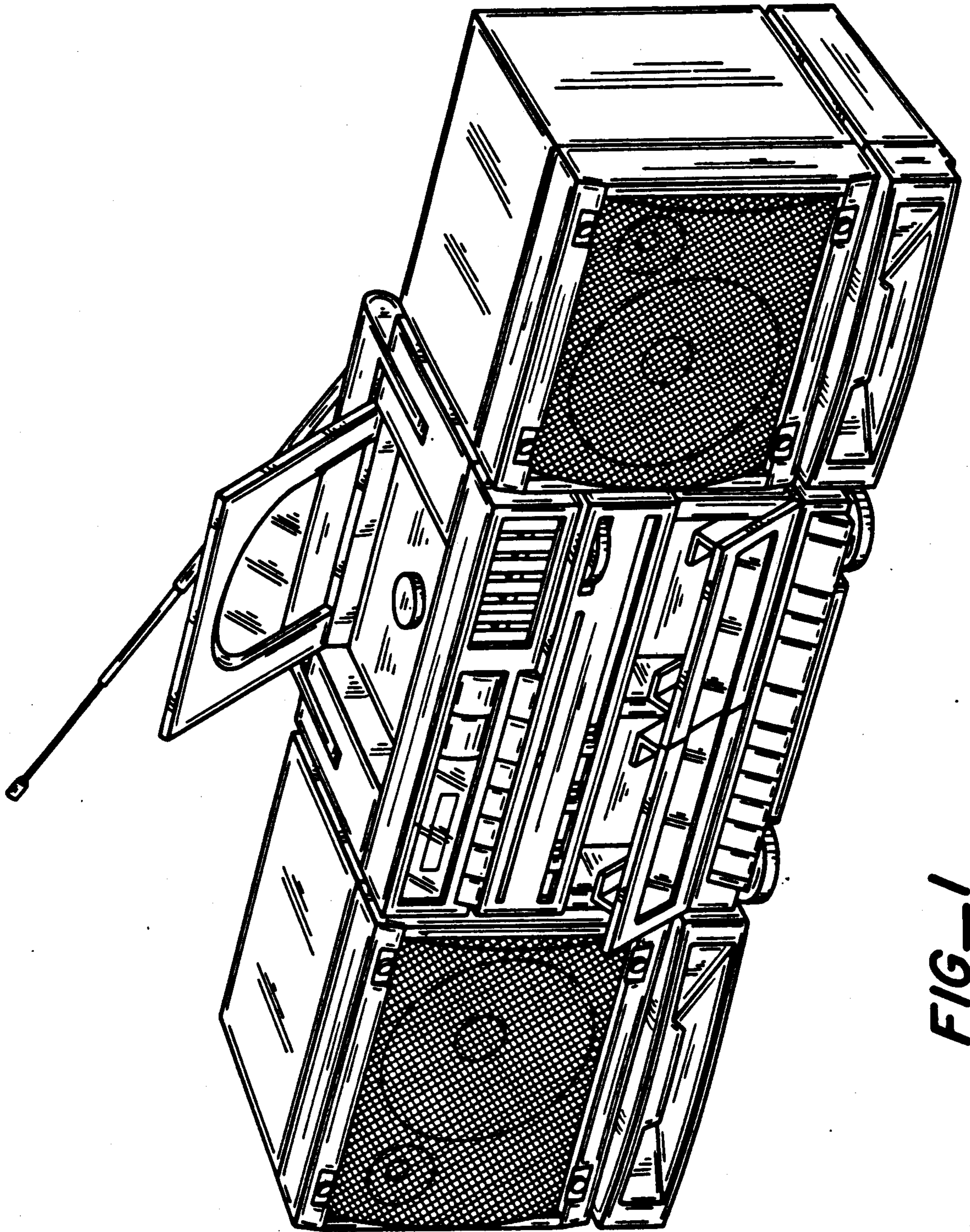
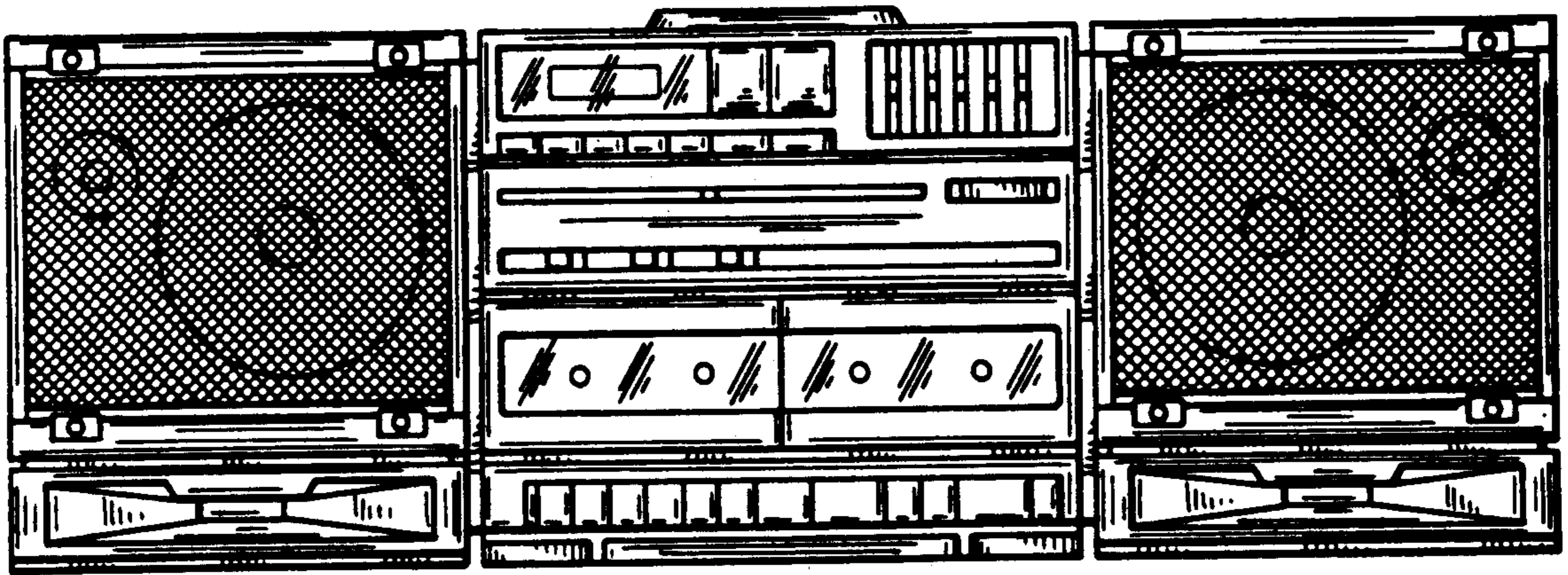
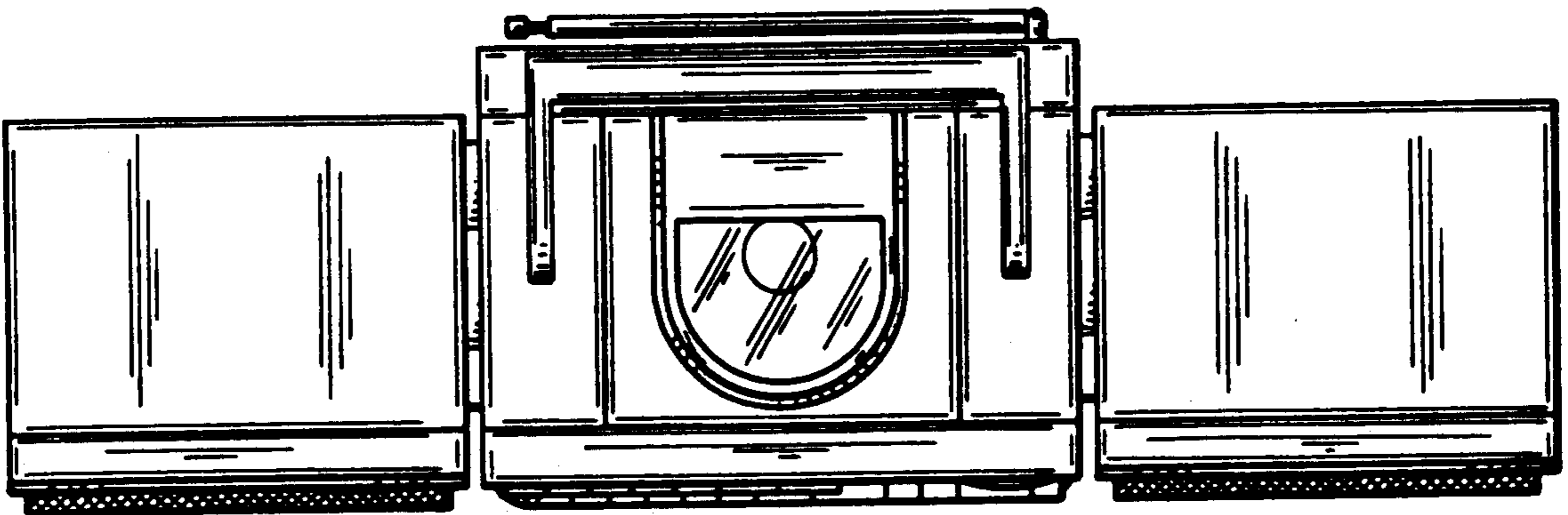


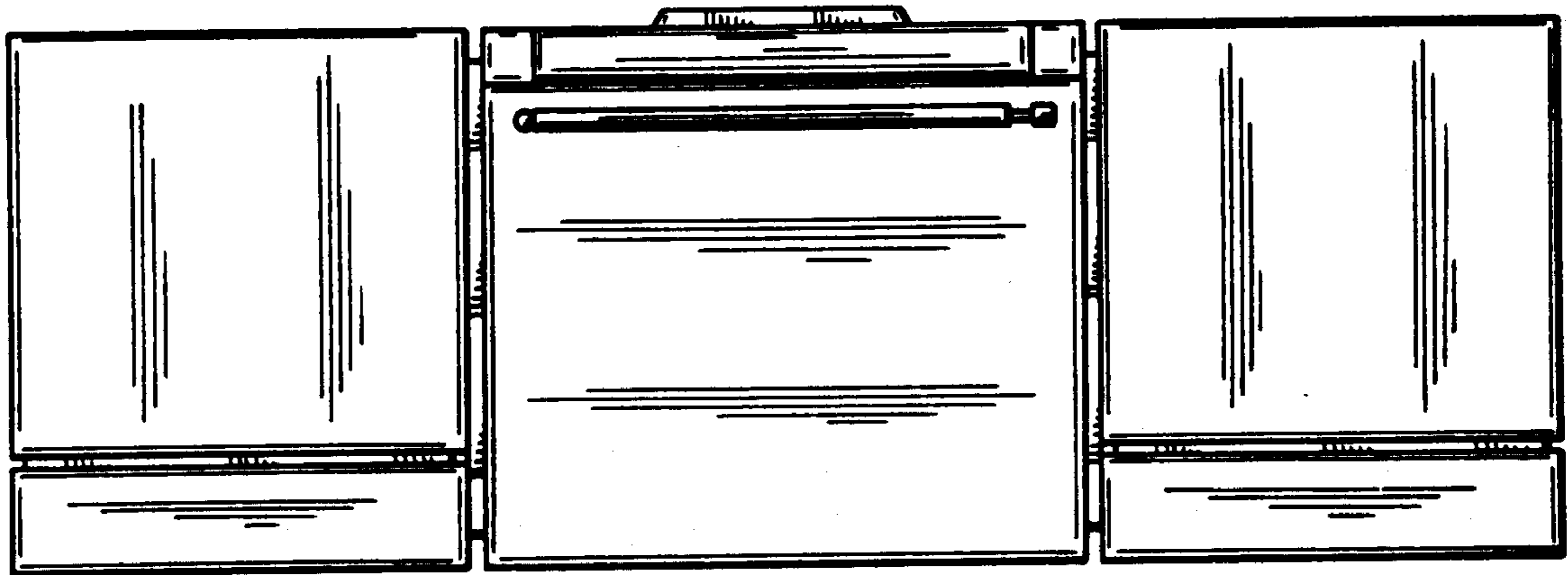

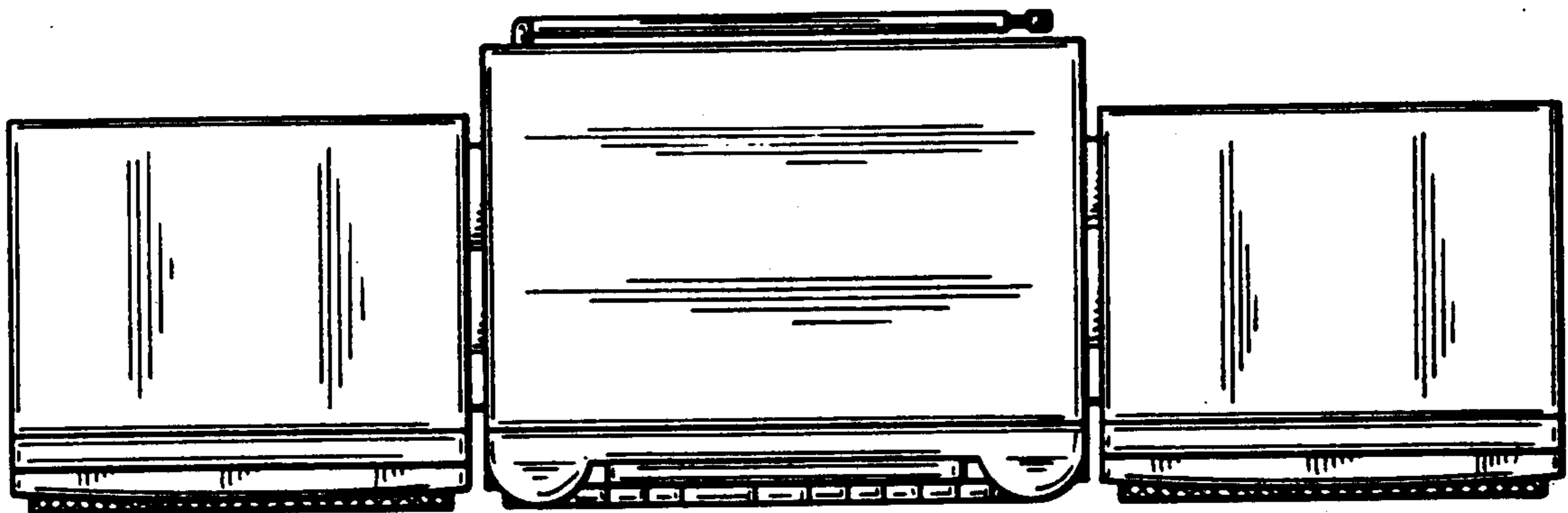

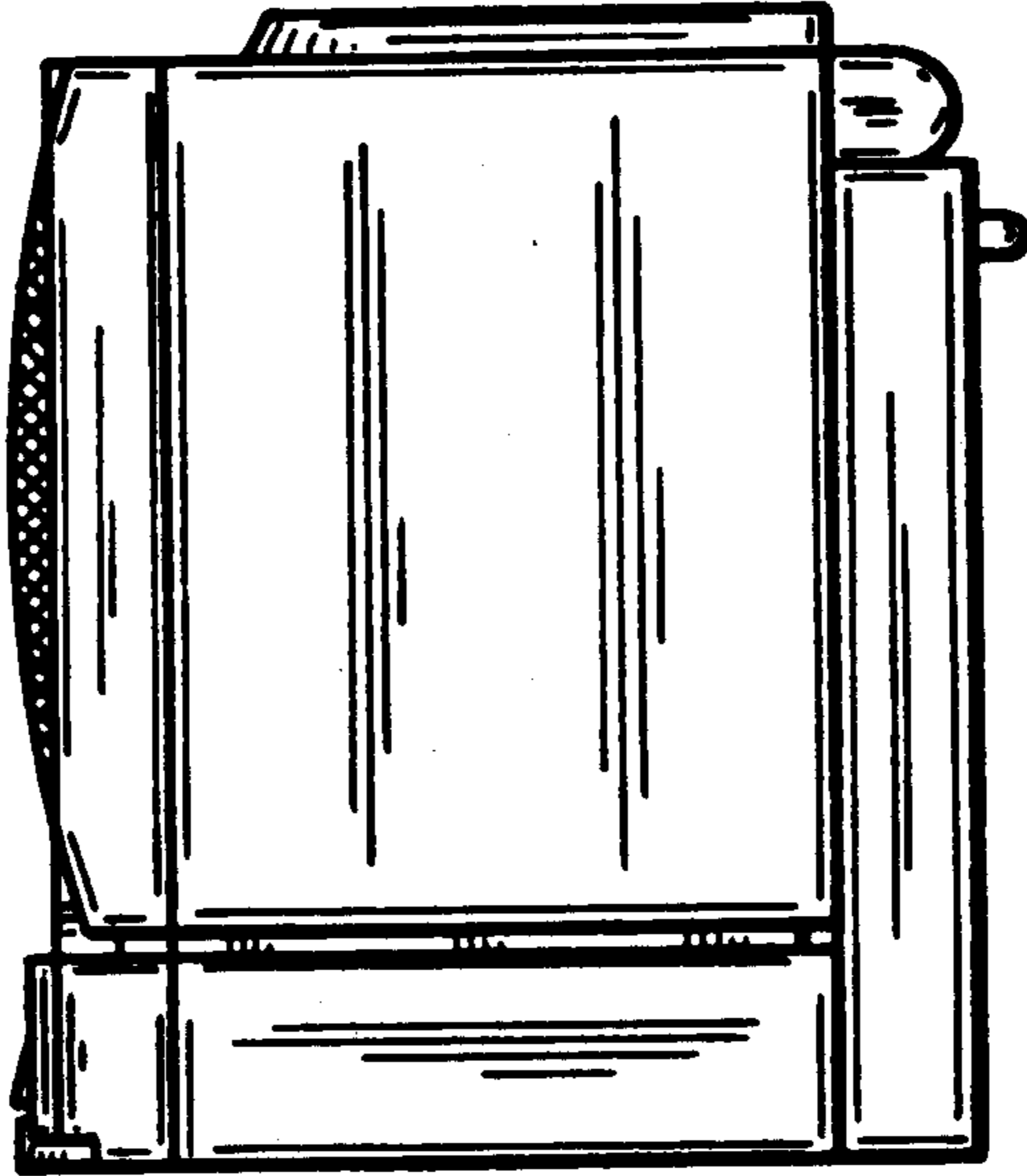

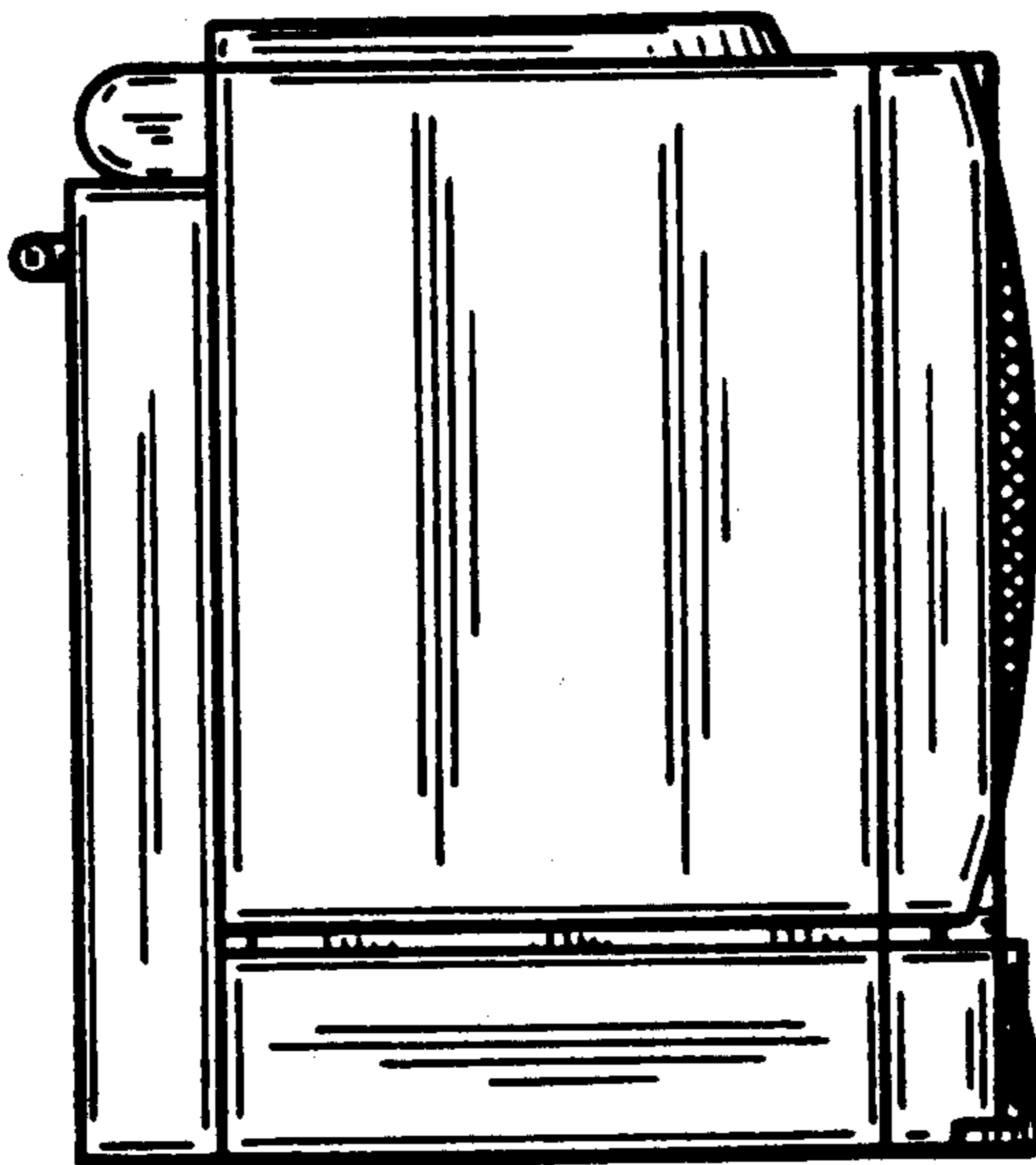
