DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top and front of a pedestal lavatory showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and right side thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image of the right side shown; and FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.

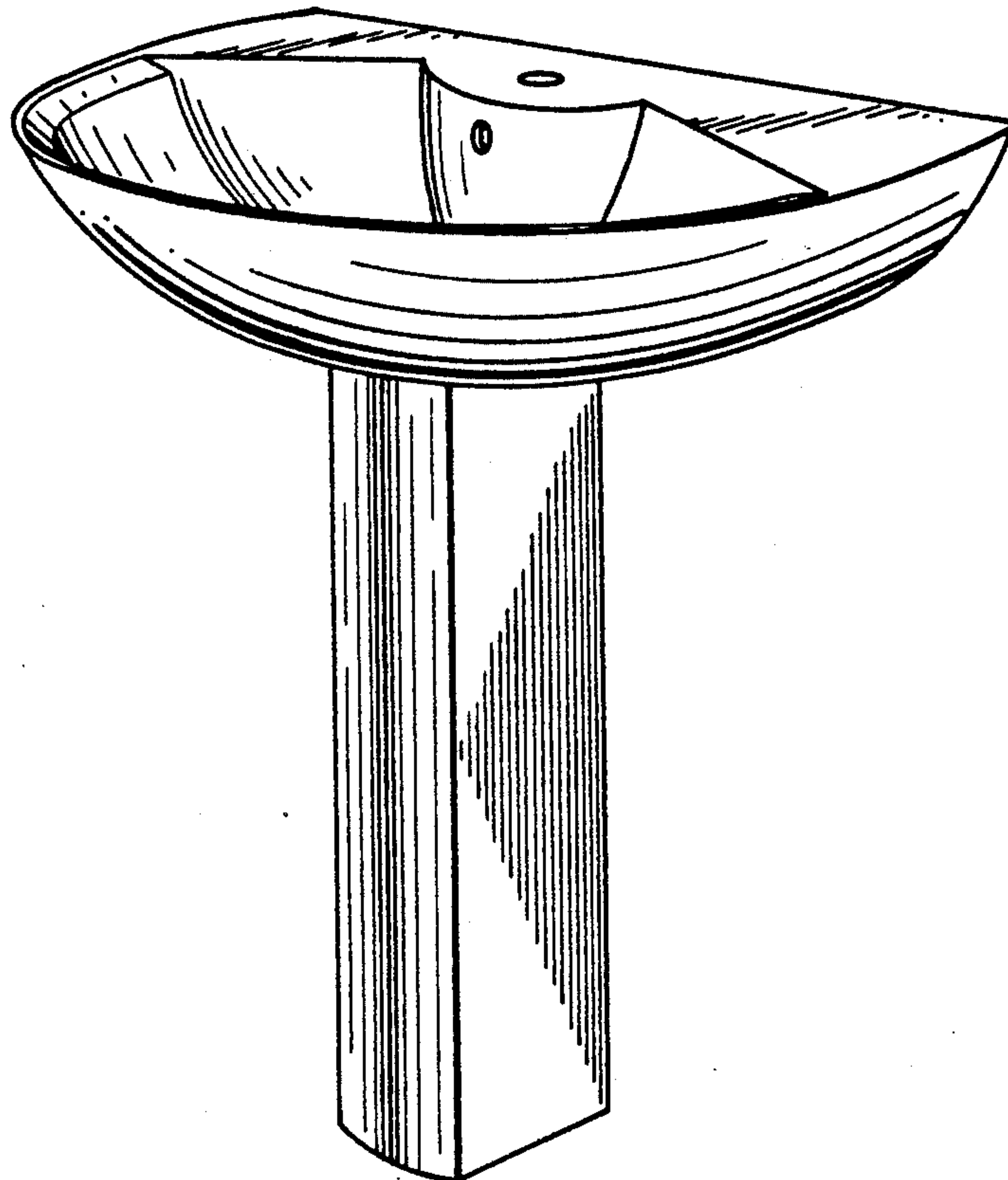

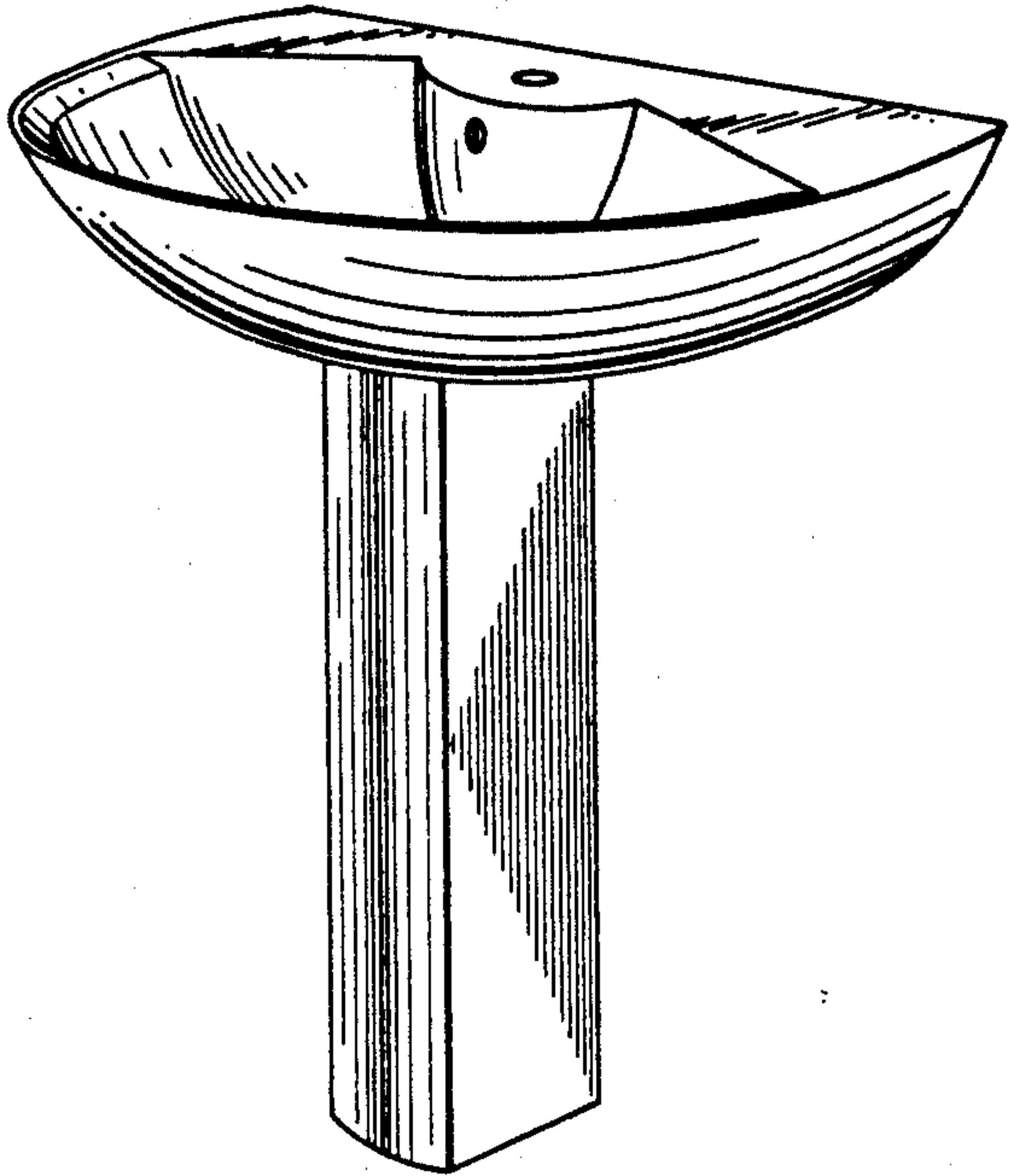

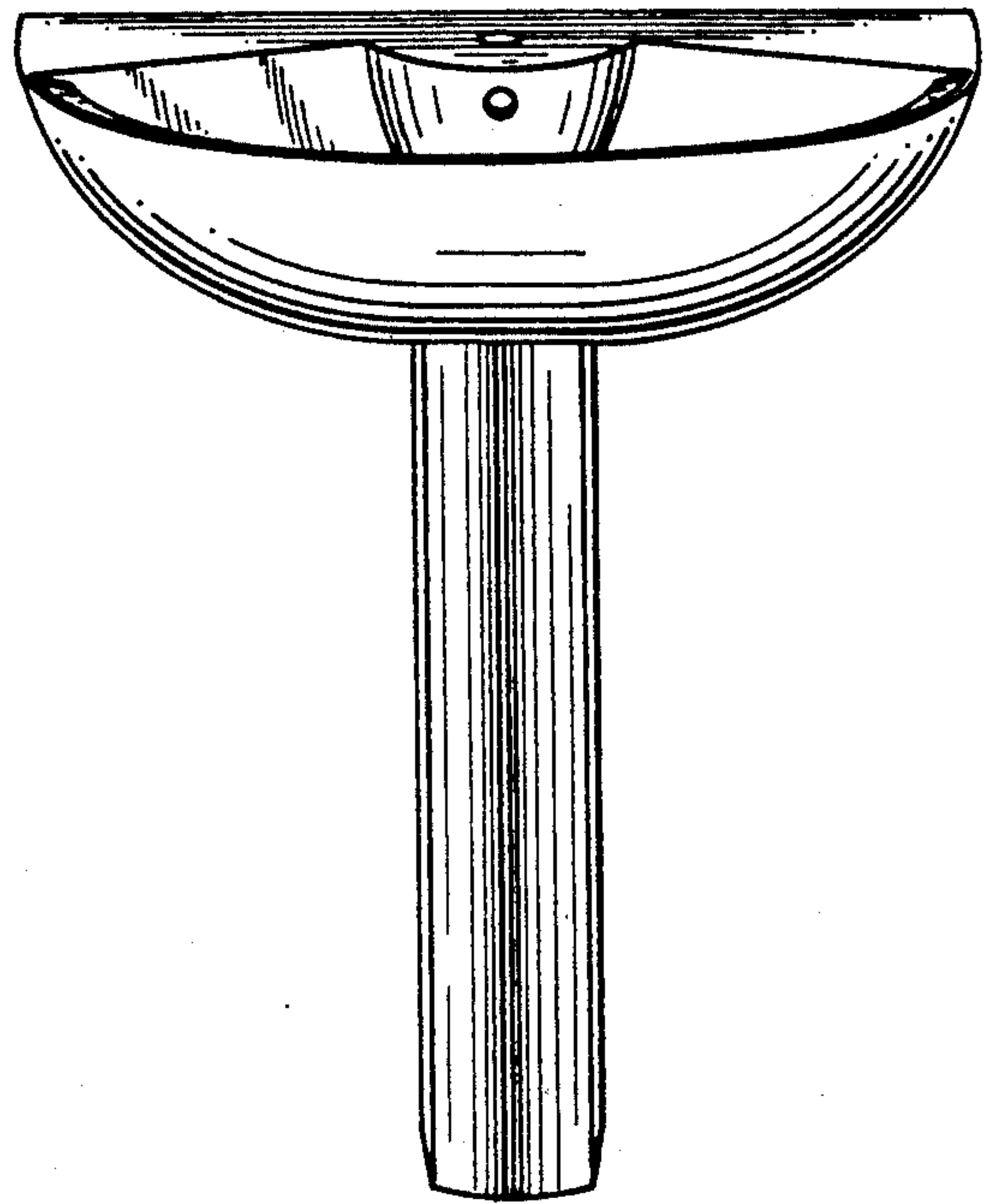

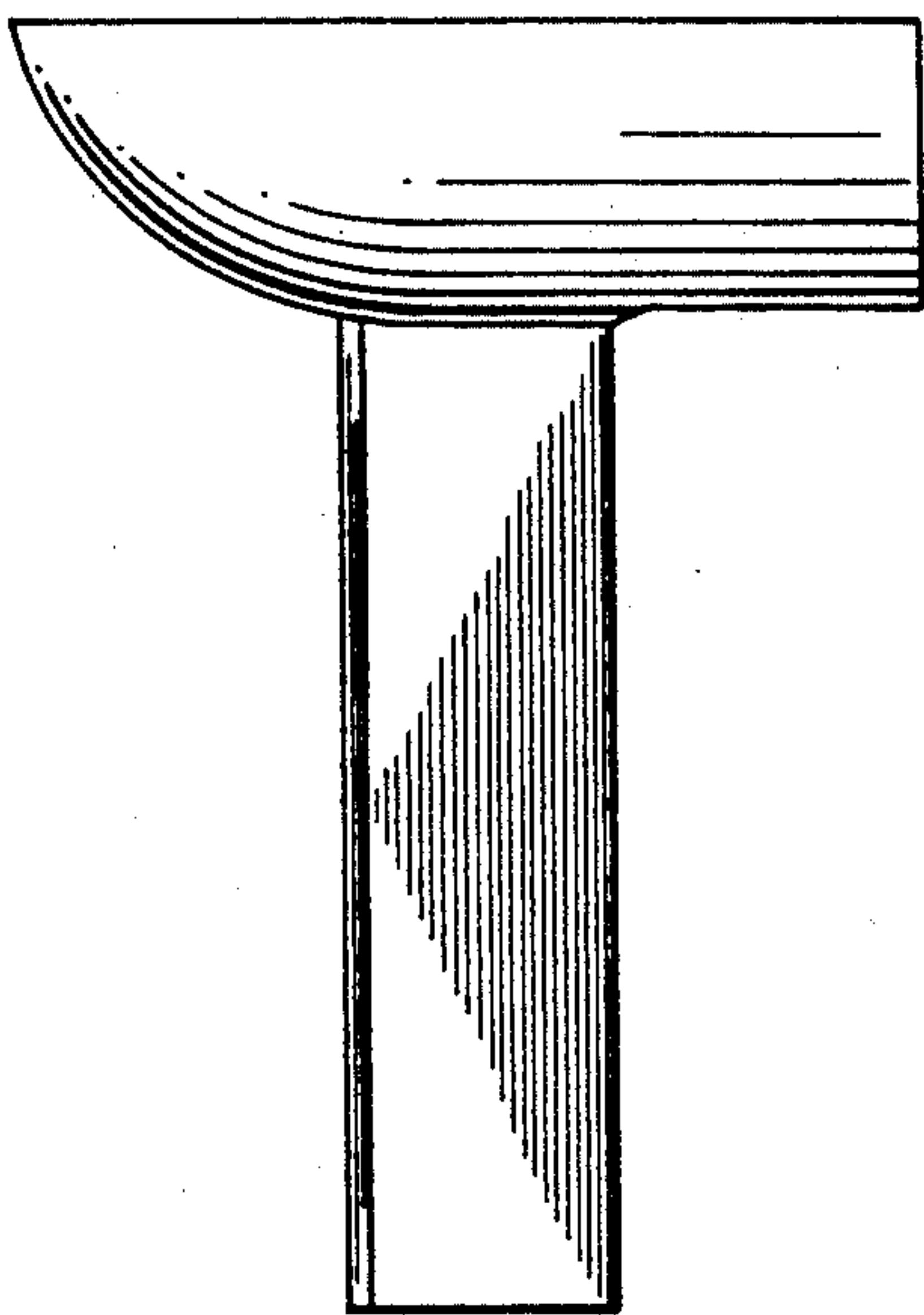
