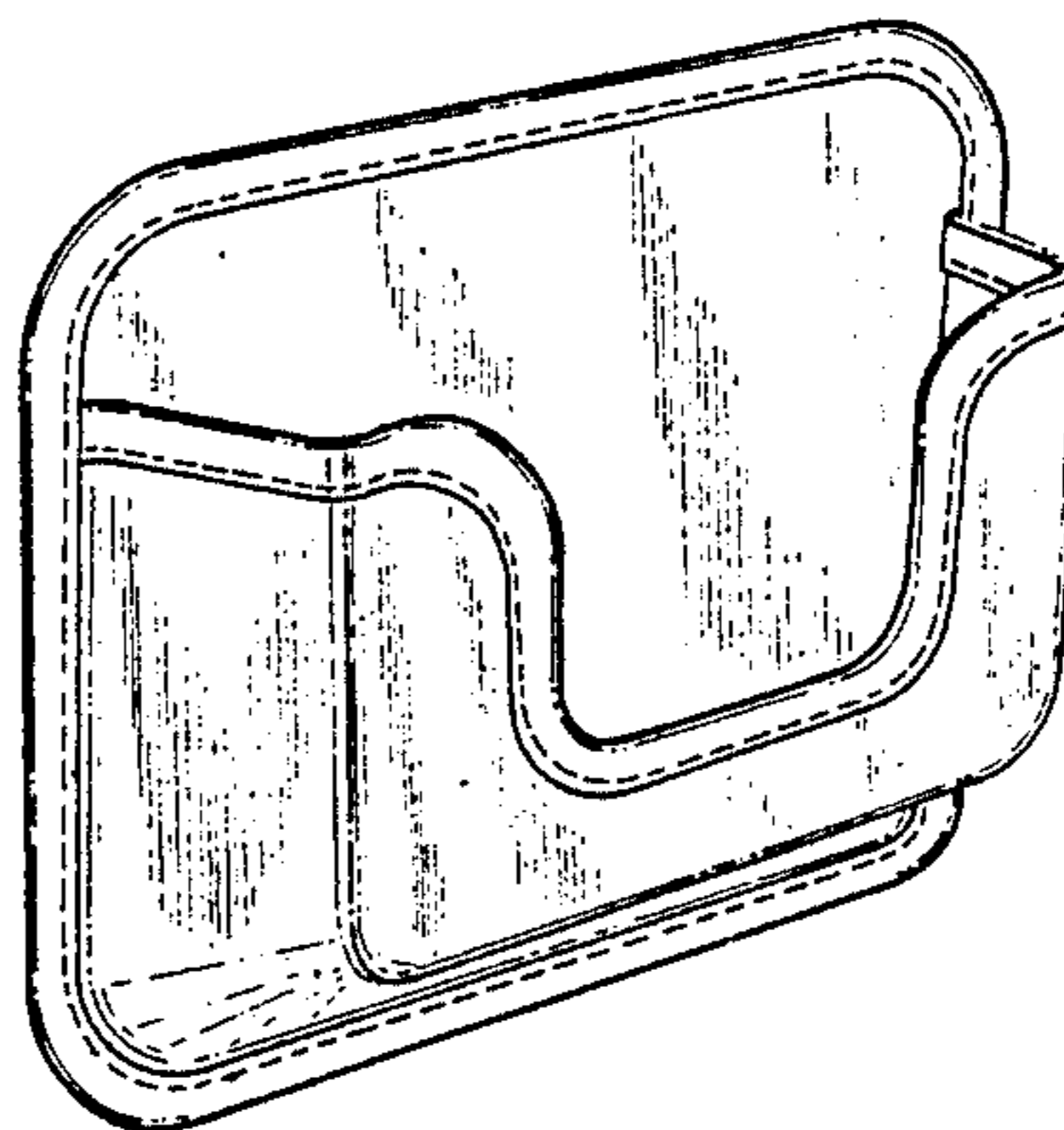
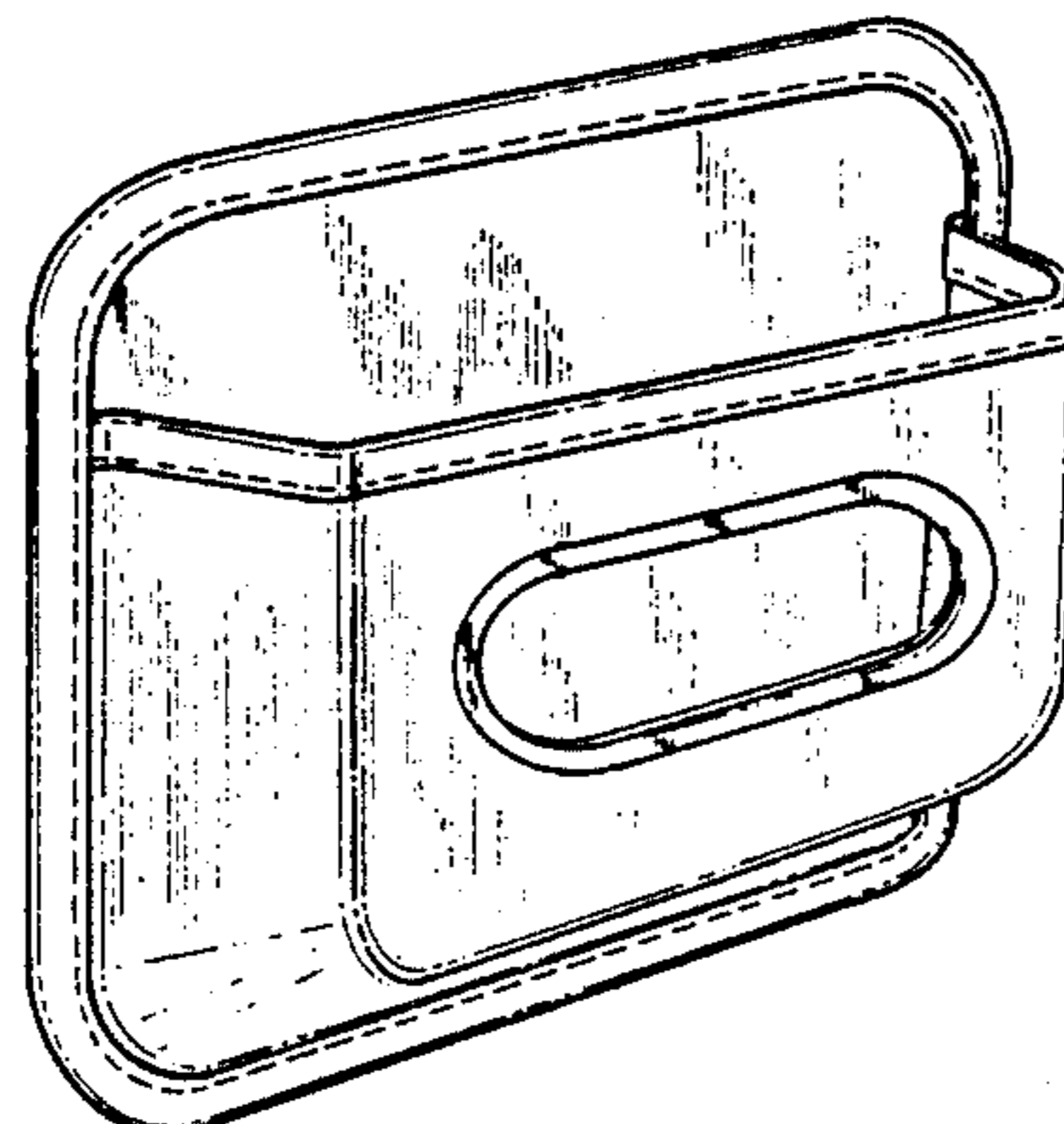
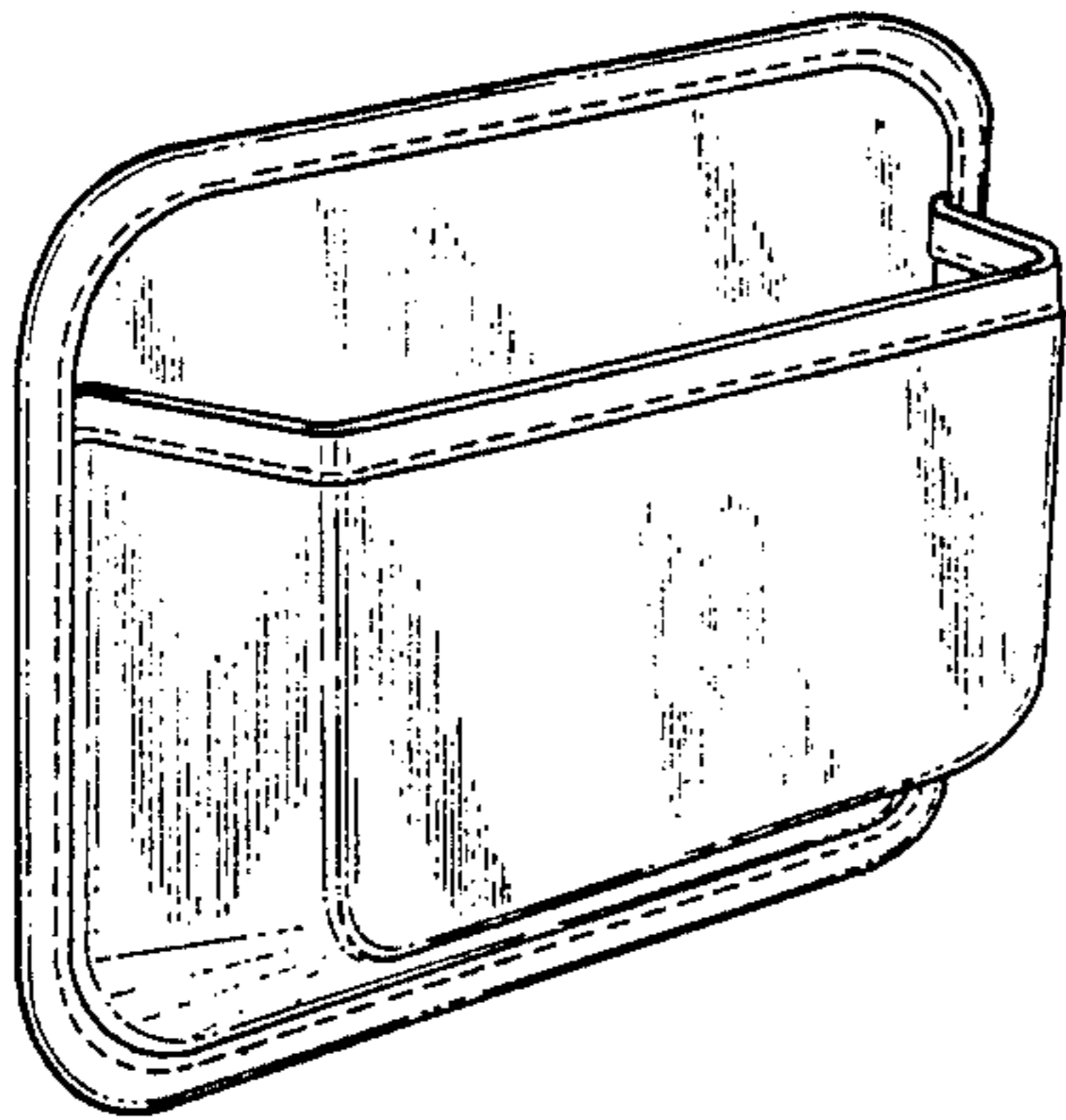

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an article holder for vehicle interior, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an article holder for vehicle interior showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a perspective view of an article holder for vehicle interior showing a modified form of our new design; FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the FIG. 6 variant; FIG. 8 is a fragmentary sectional view on an enlarged scale taken along line 8—8 of FIG. 7; FIG. 9 is a side elevational view of the FIG. 6 variant, the opposite side being a mirror image; FIG. 10 is a top plan view of the FIG. 6 variant; FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view of the FIG. 6 variant; FIG. 12 is a perspective view of an article holder for vehicle interior showing another modified form of our new design; FIG. 13 is a front elevational view of the FIG. 12 variant; FIG. 14 is a side elevational view of the FIG. 12 variant, the opposite side being a mirror image; FIG. 15 is a top plan view of the FIG. 12 variant; FIG. 16 is a bottom plan view of the FIG. 12 variant. The backs thereof are substantially flat and unornamented.



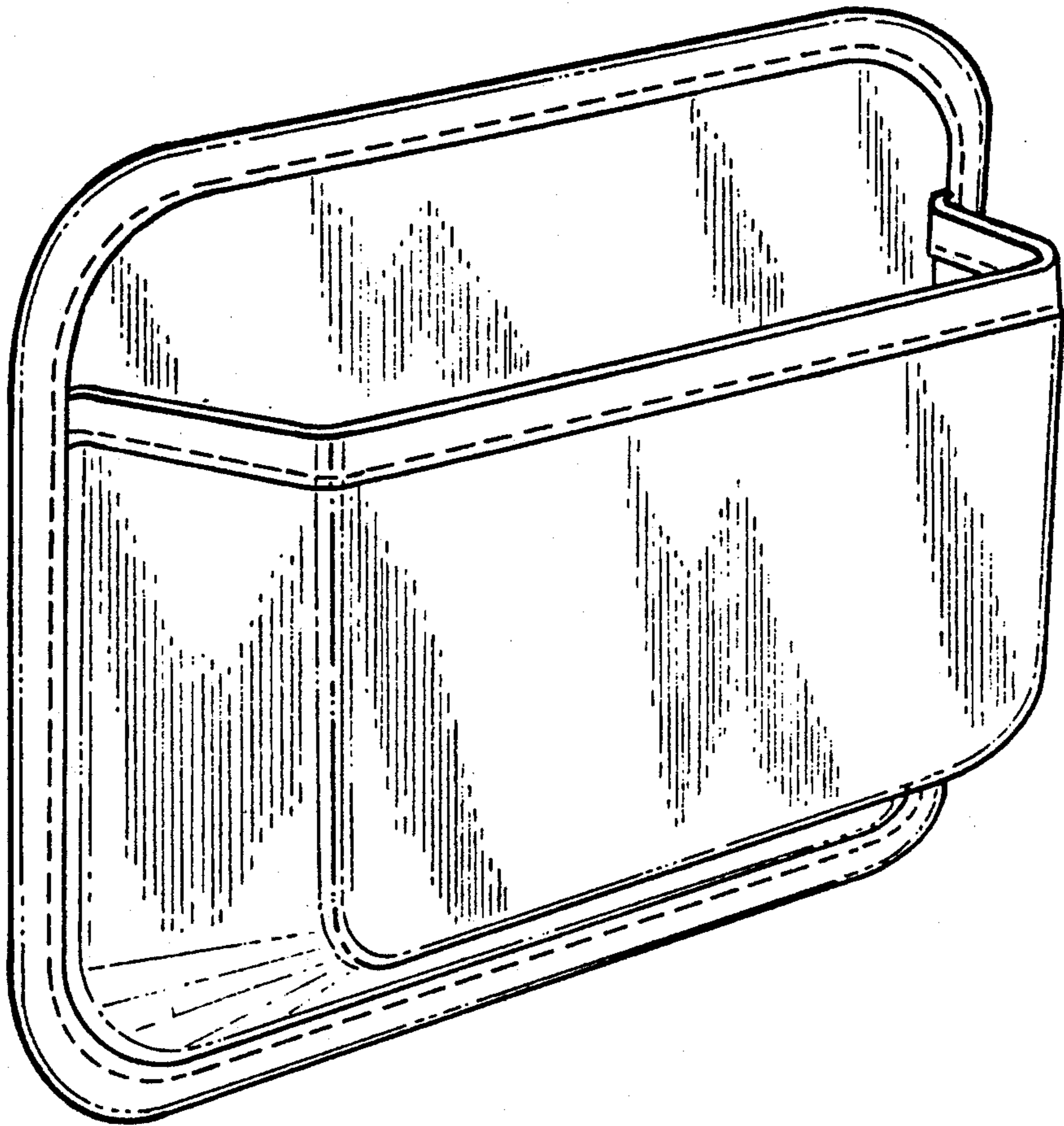

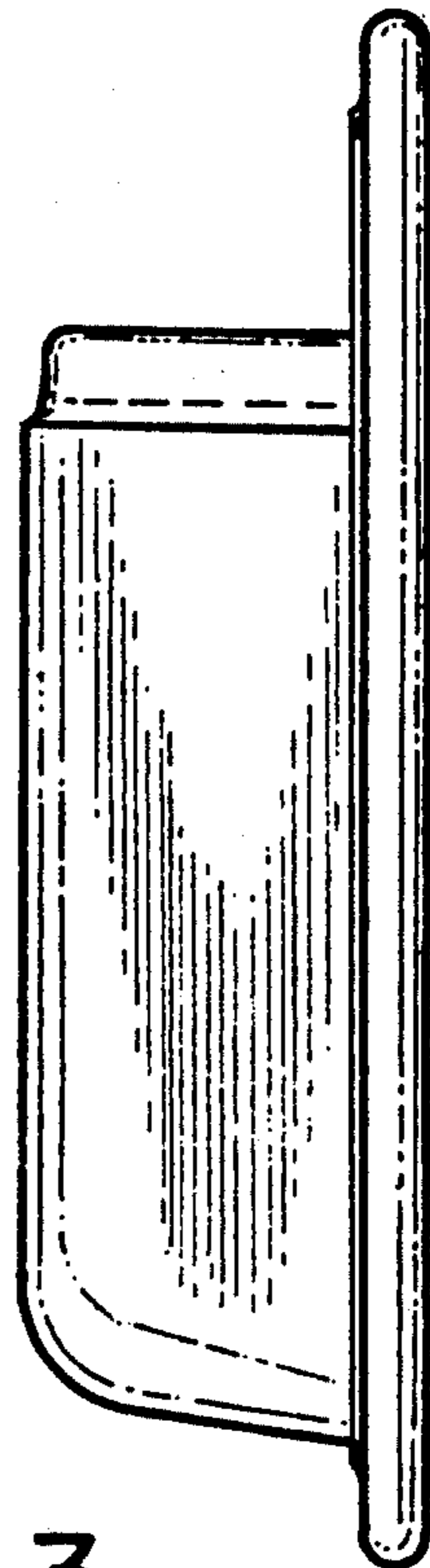

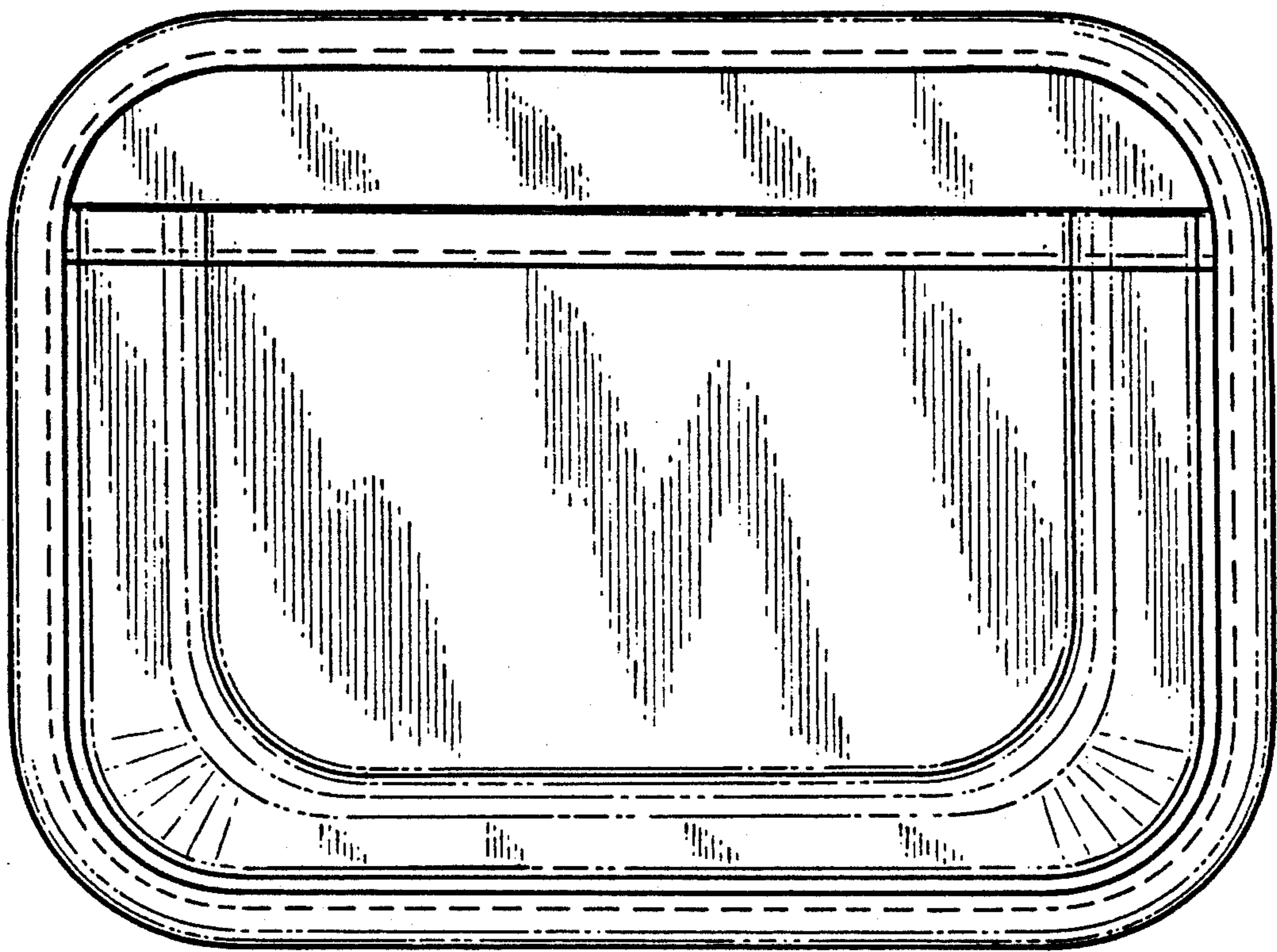

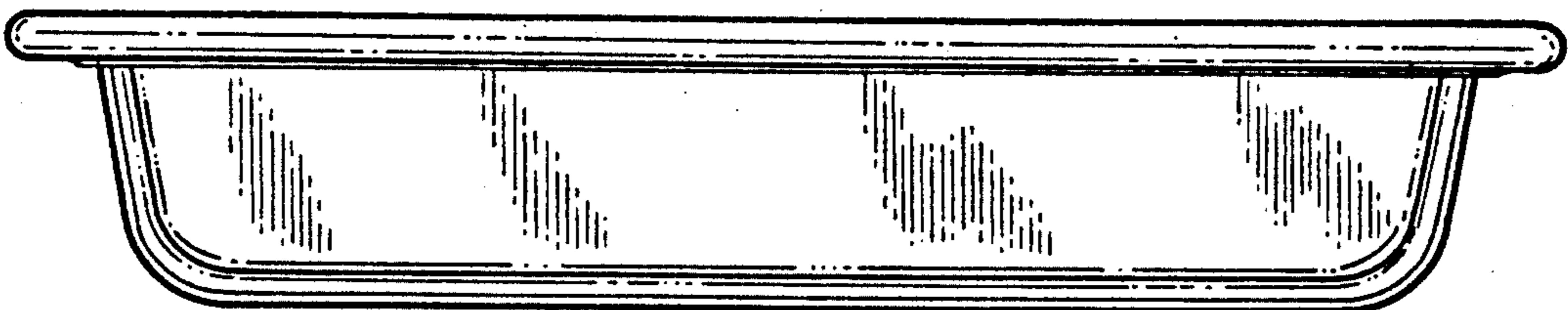

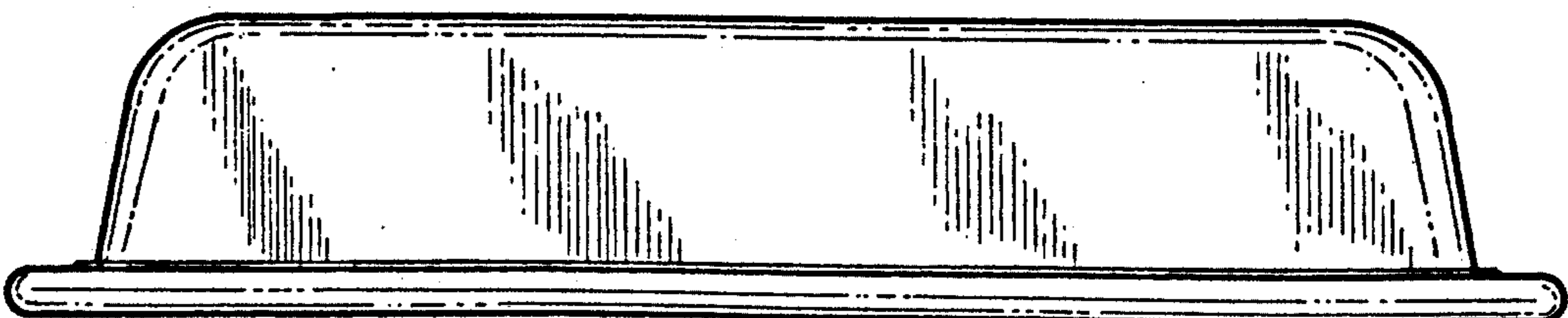

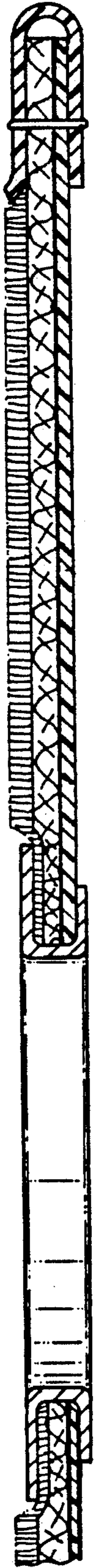

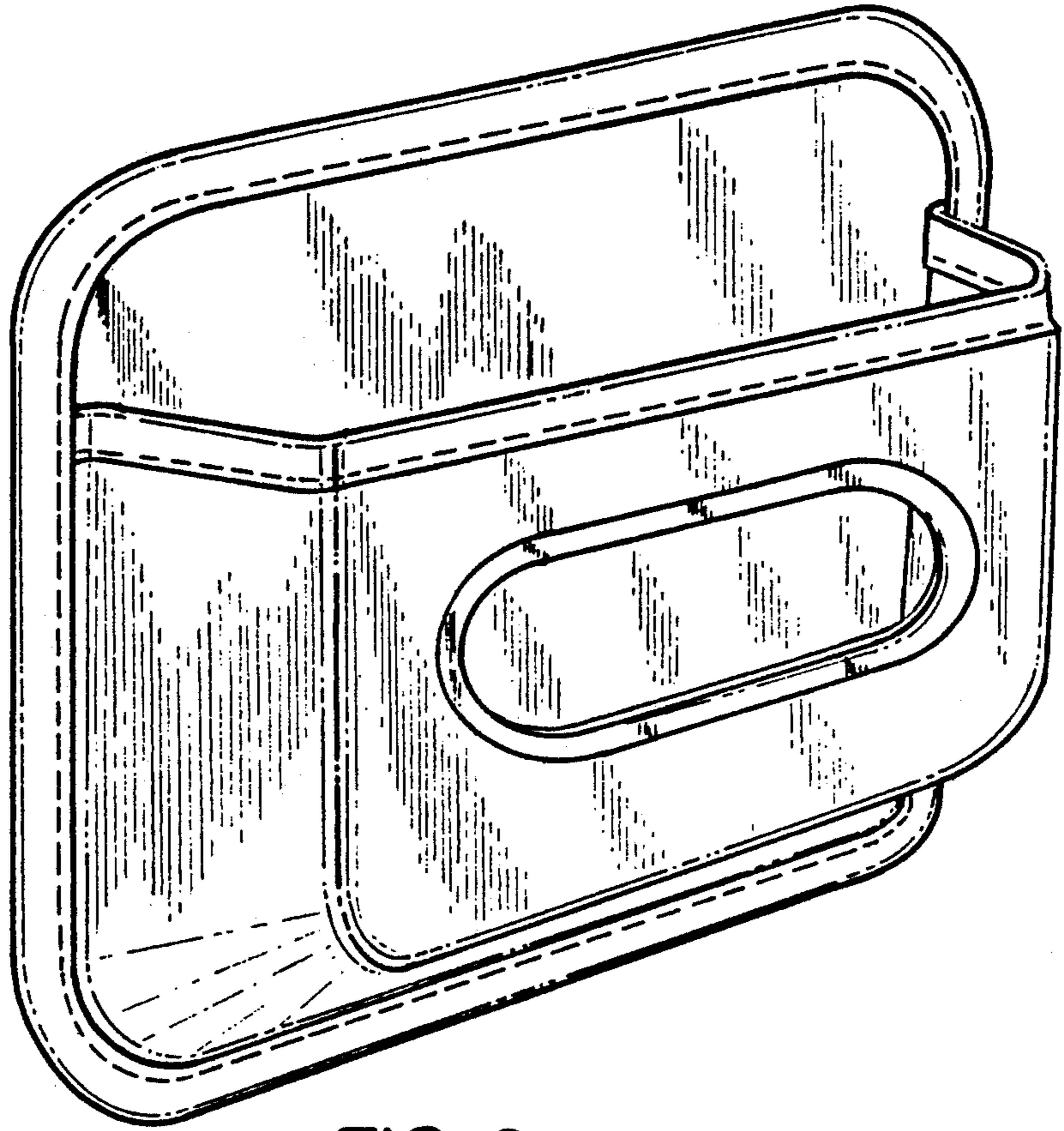

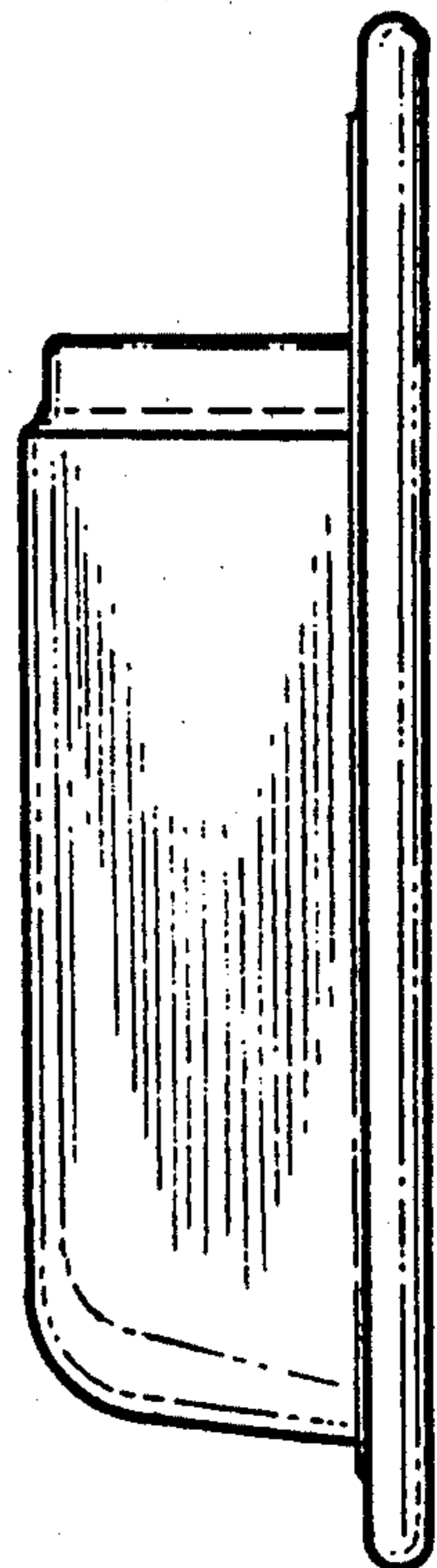

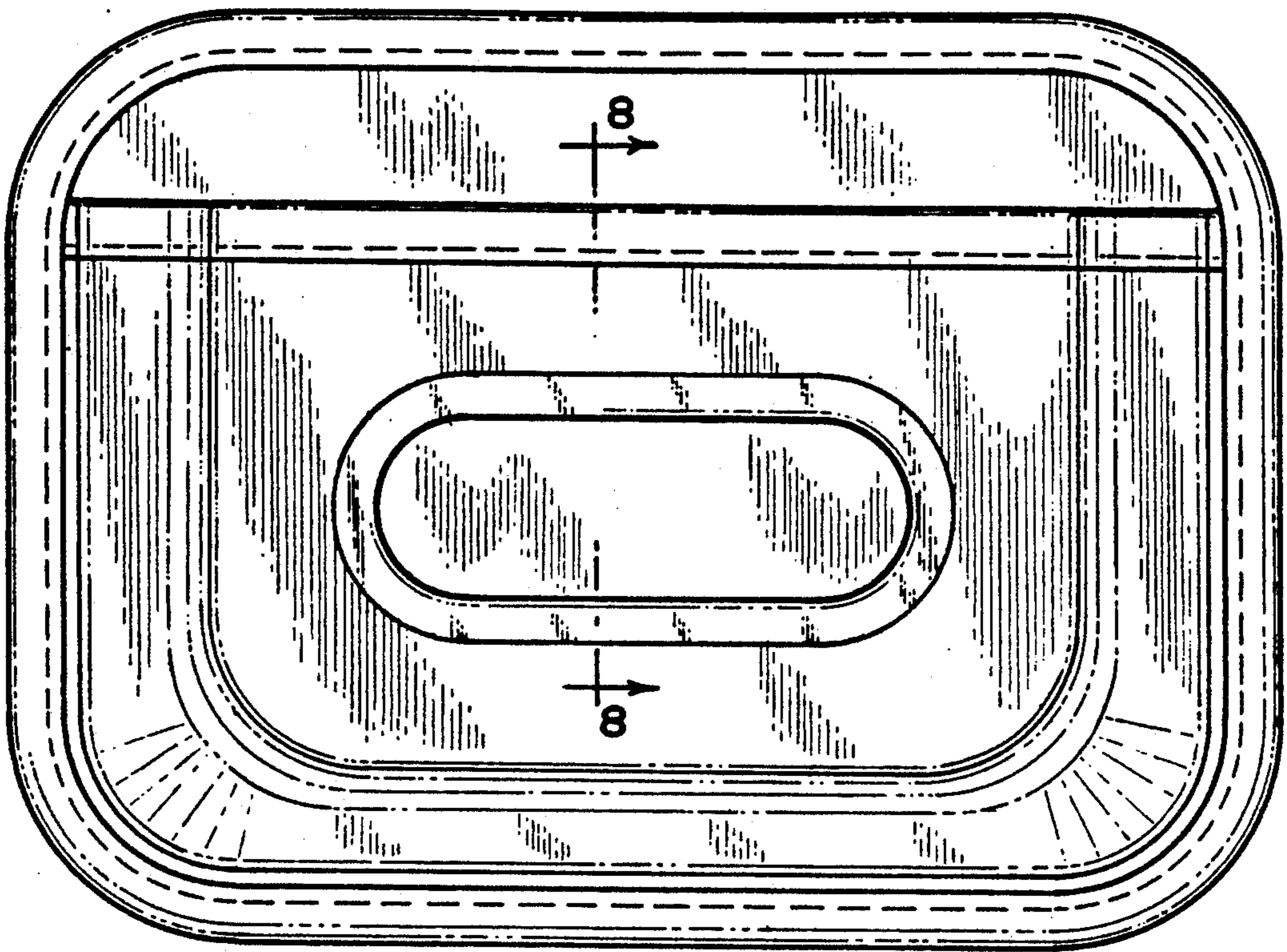

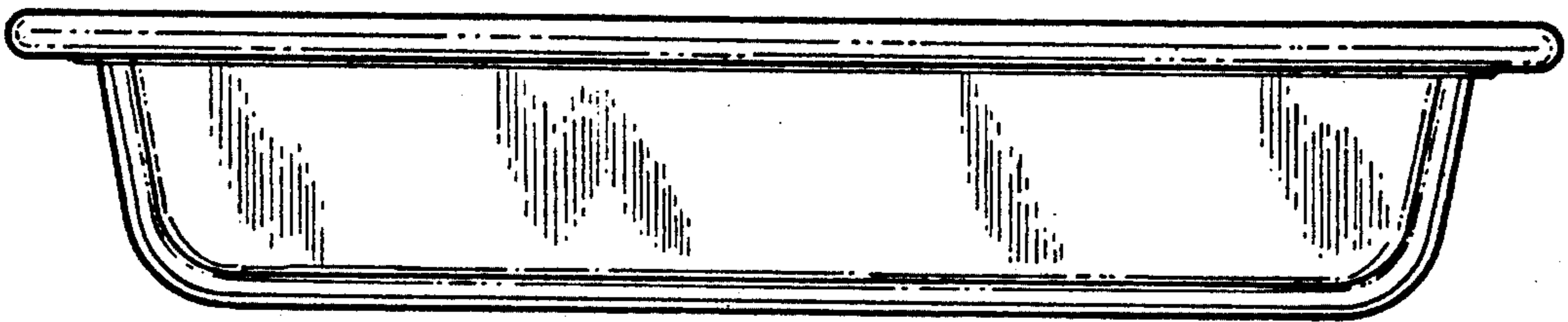

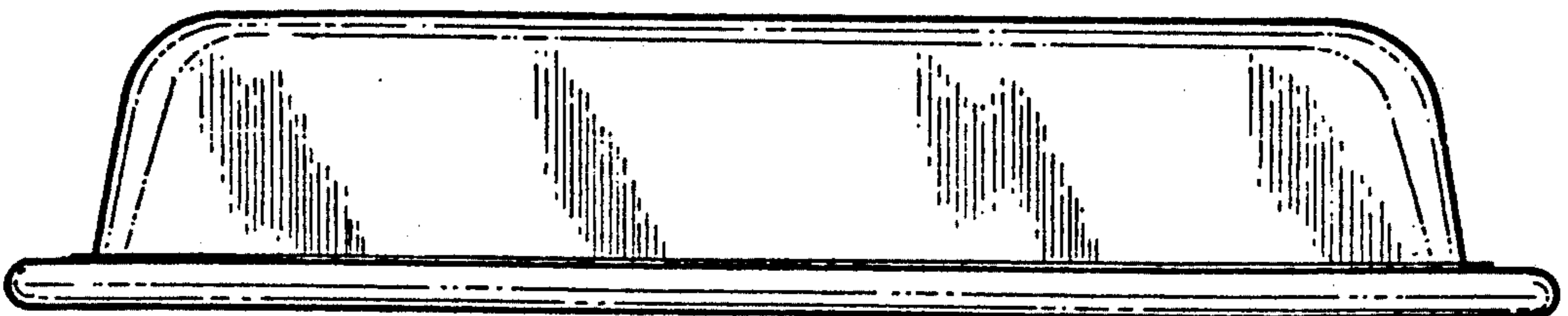

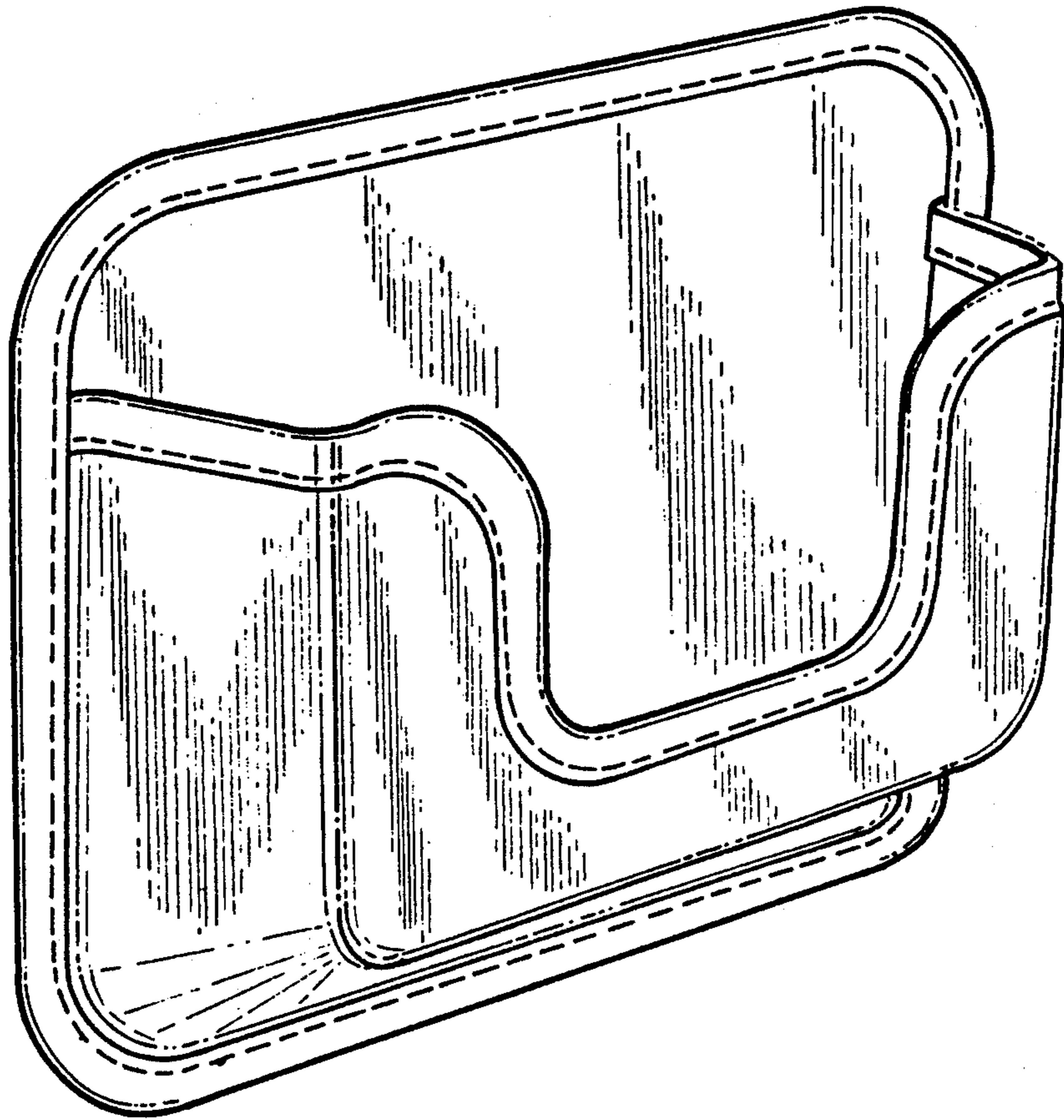

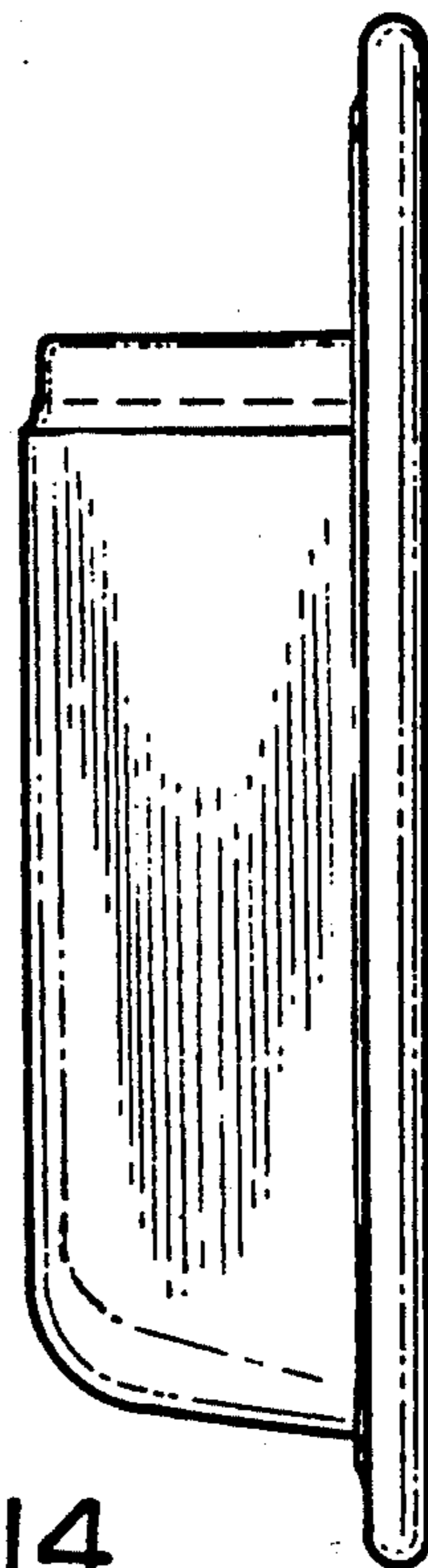

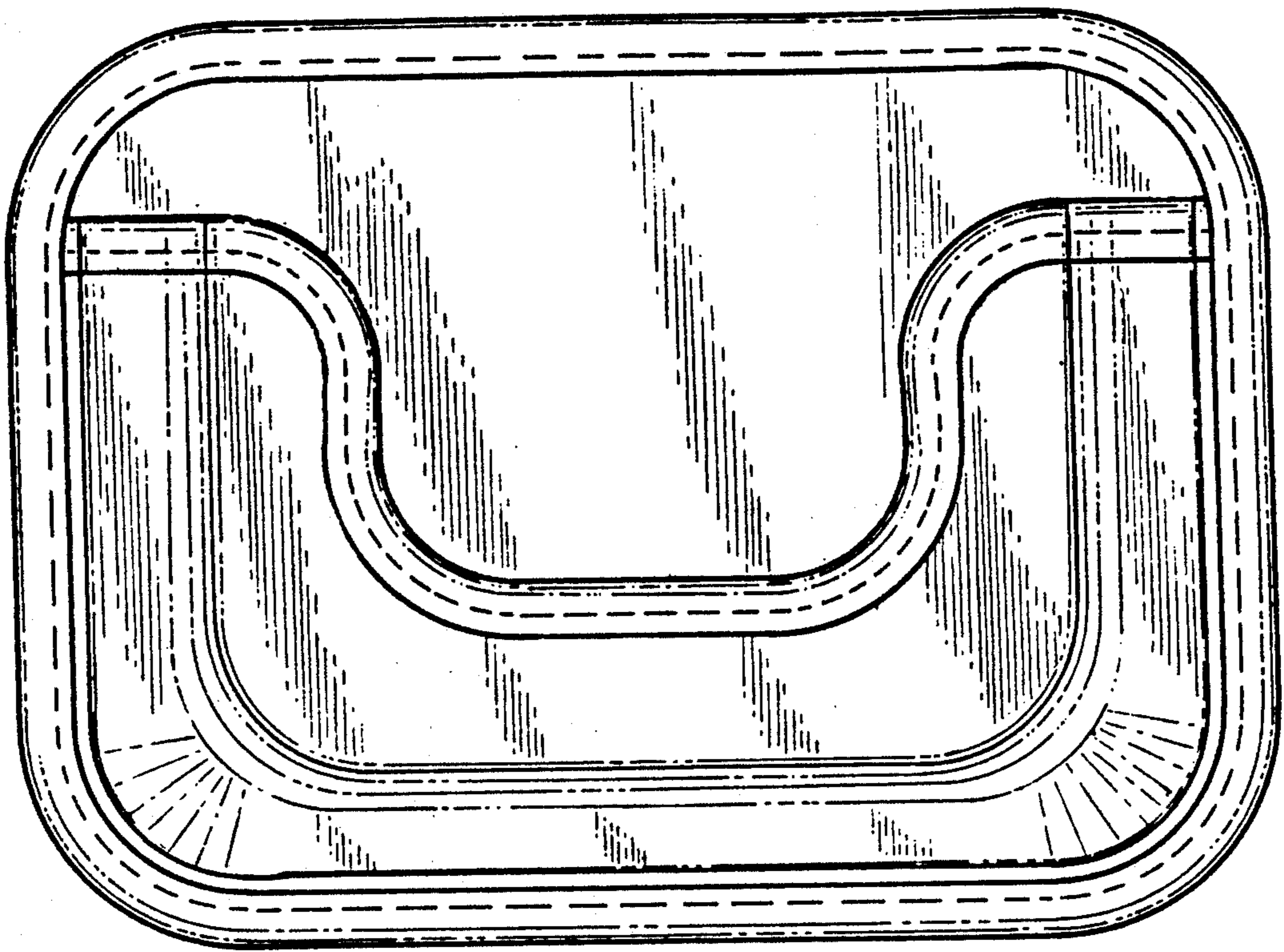

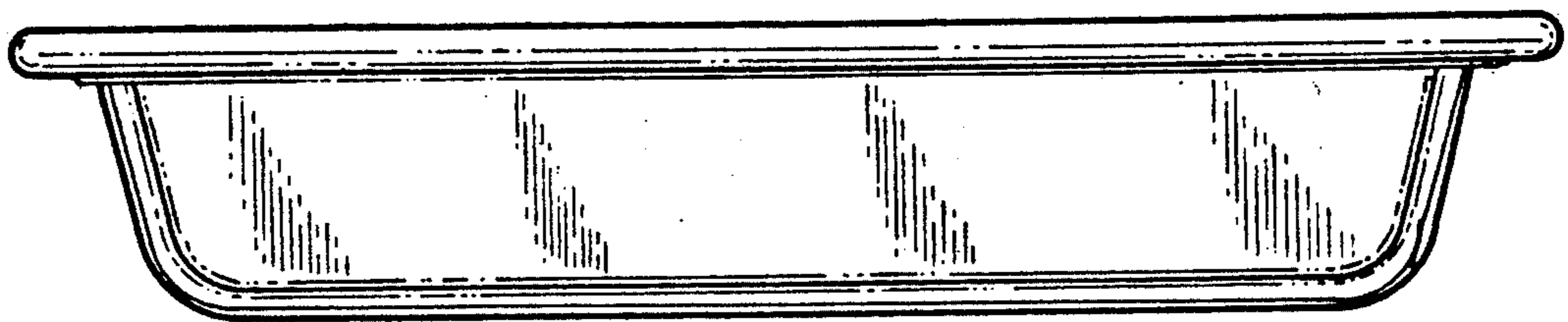

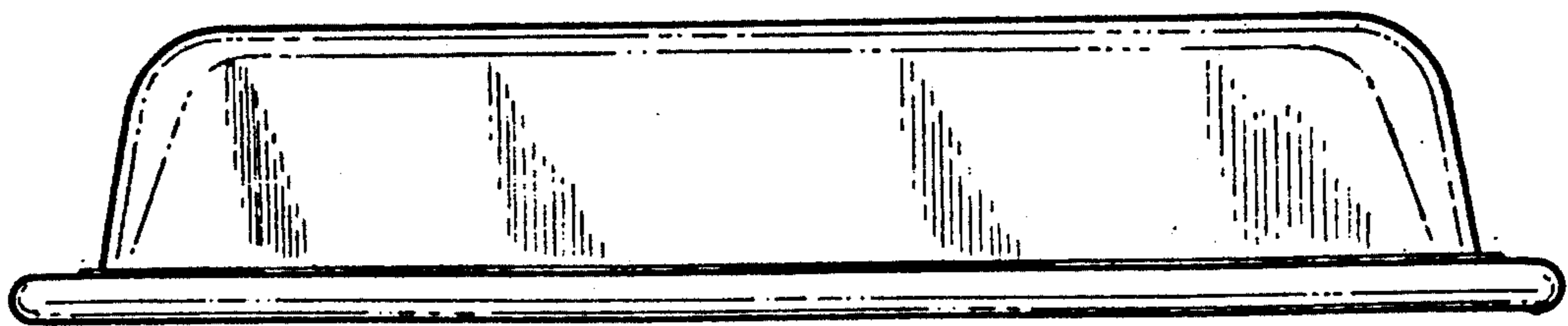
