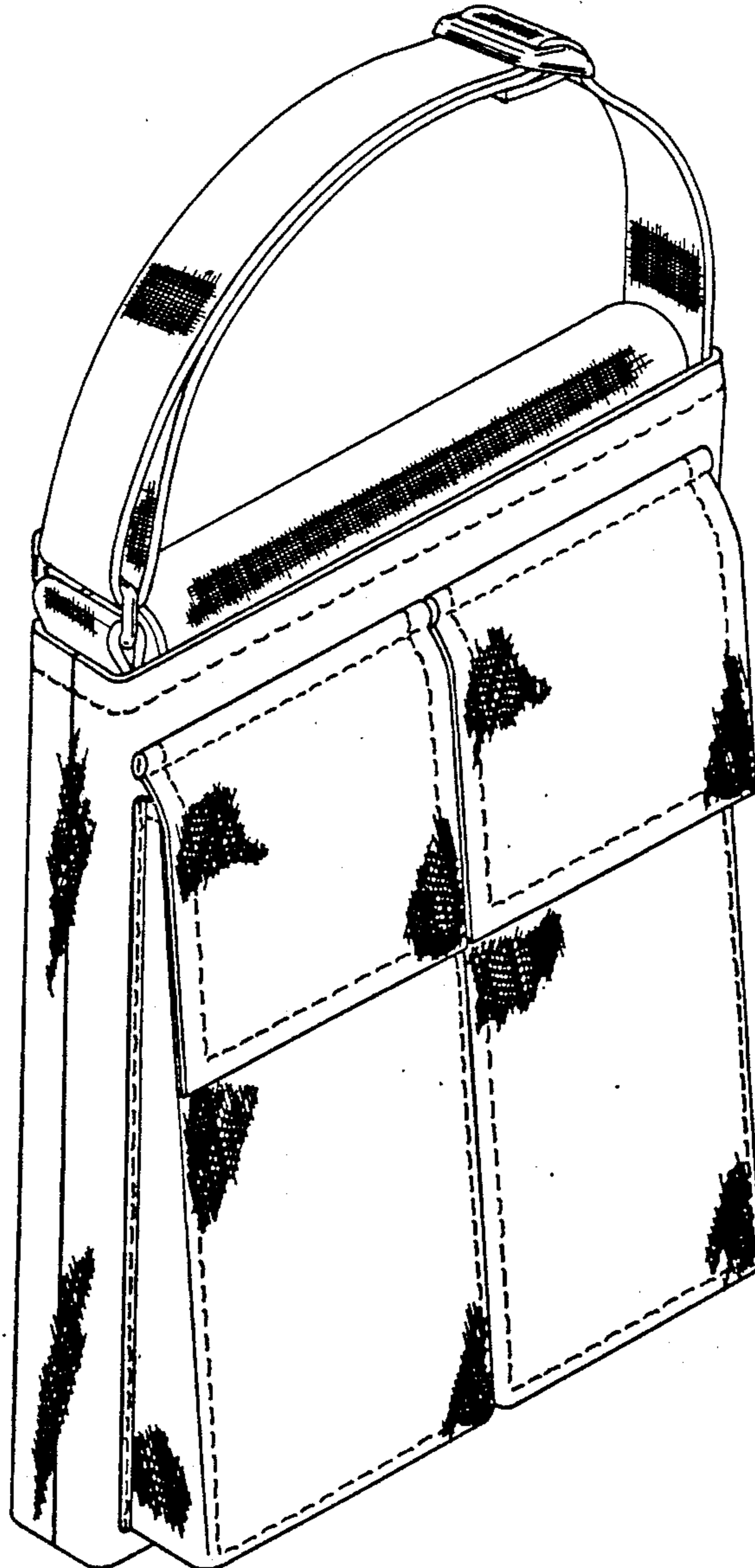

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an art supply carrying case, showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view, the right side being a mirror image thereof;

 FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view thereof.



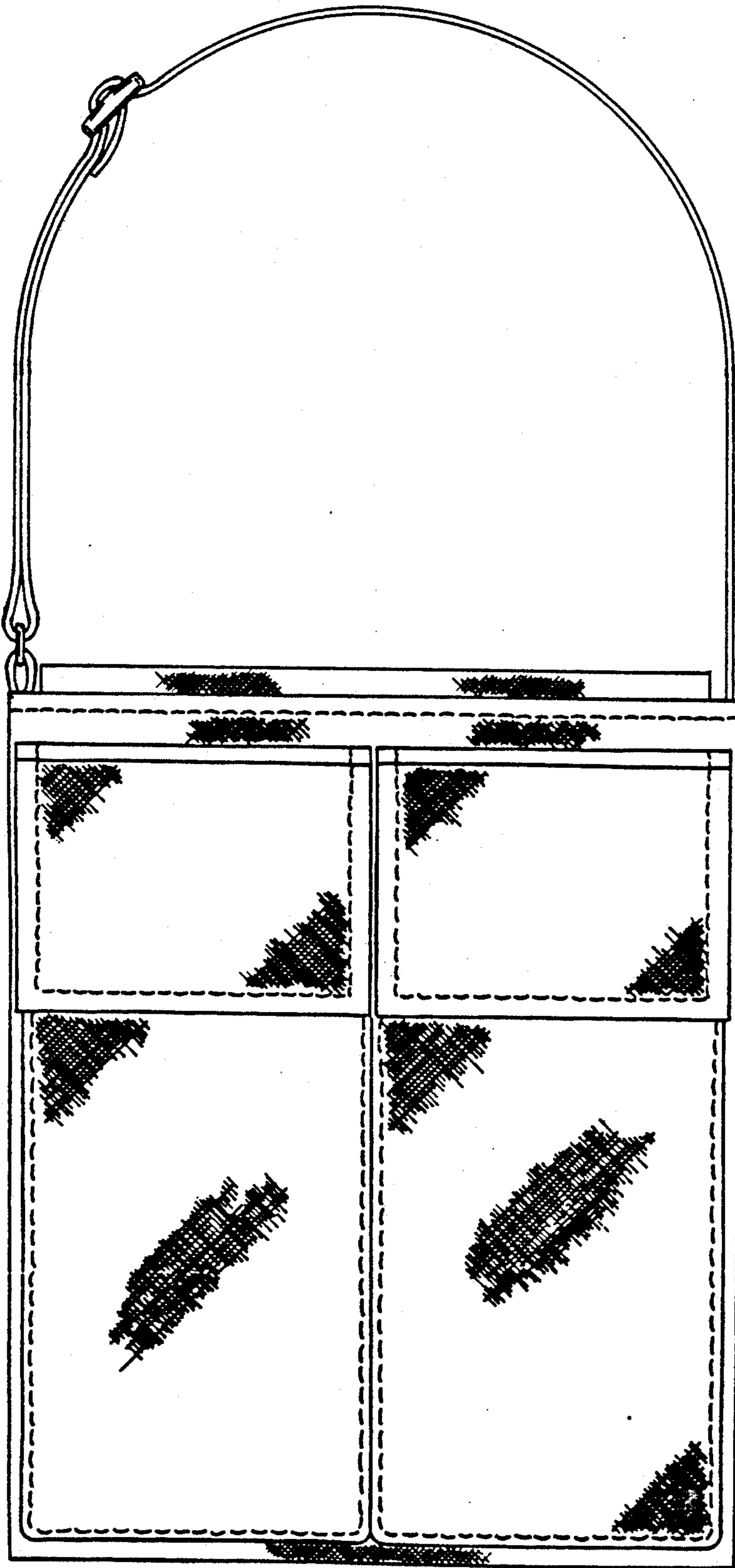

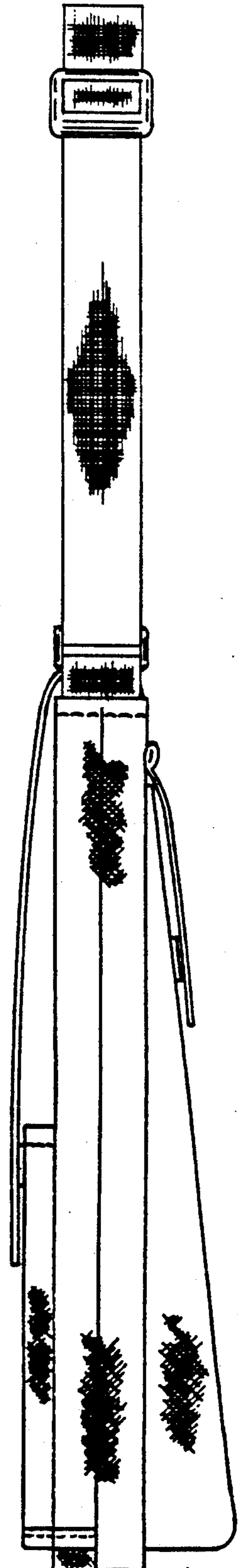

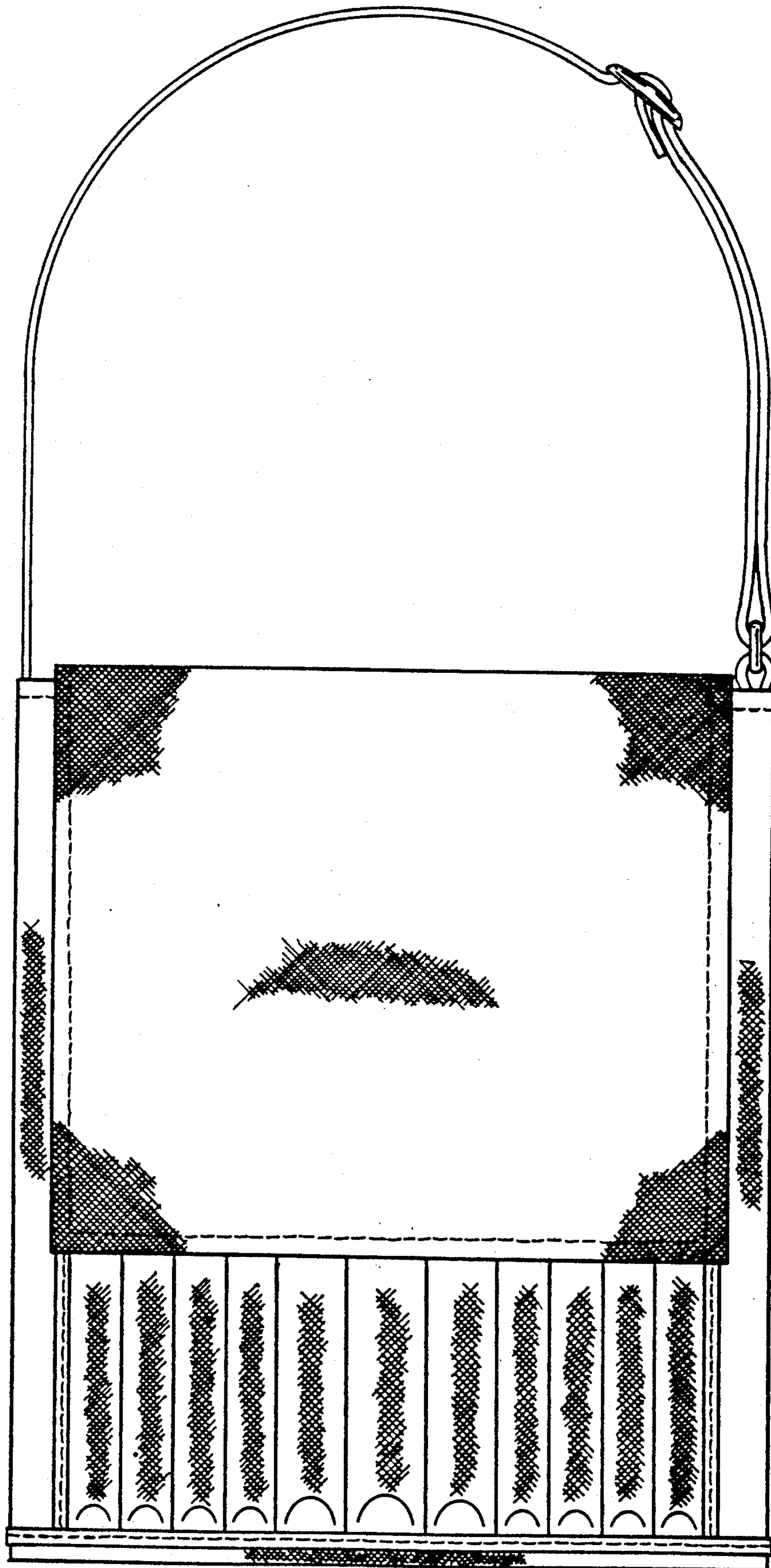

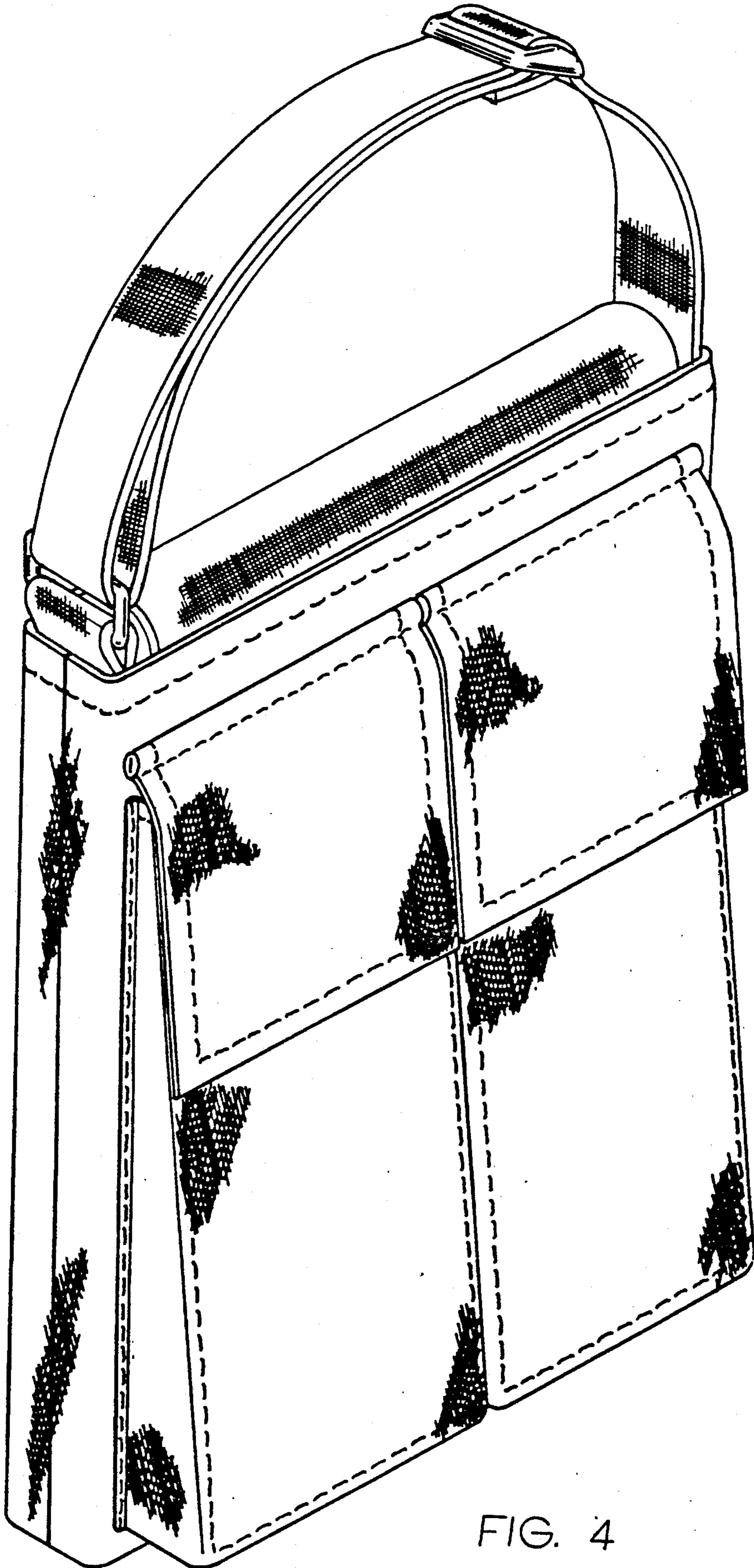

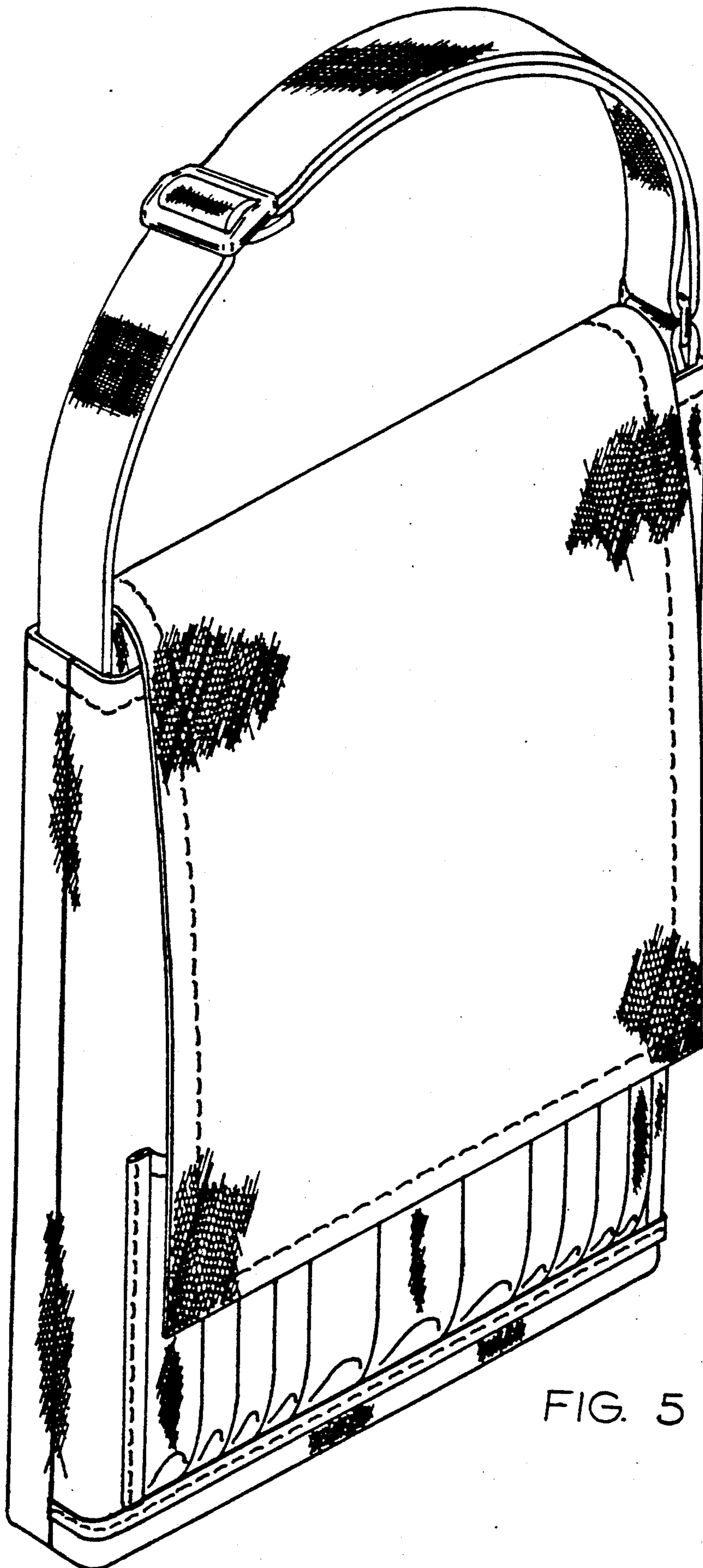
