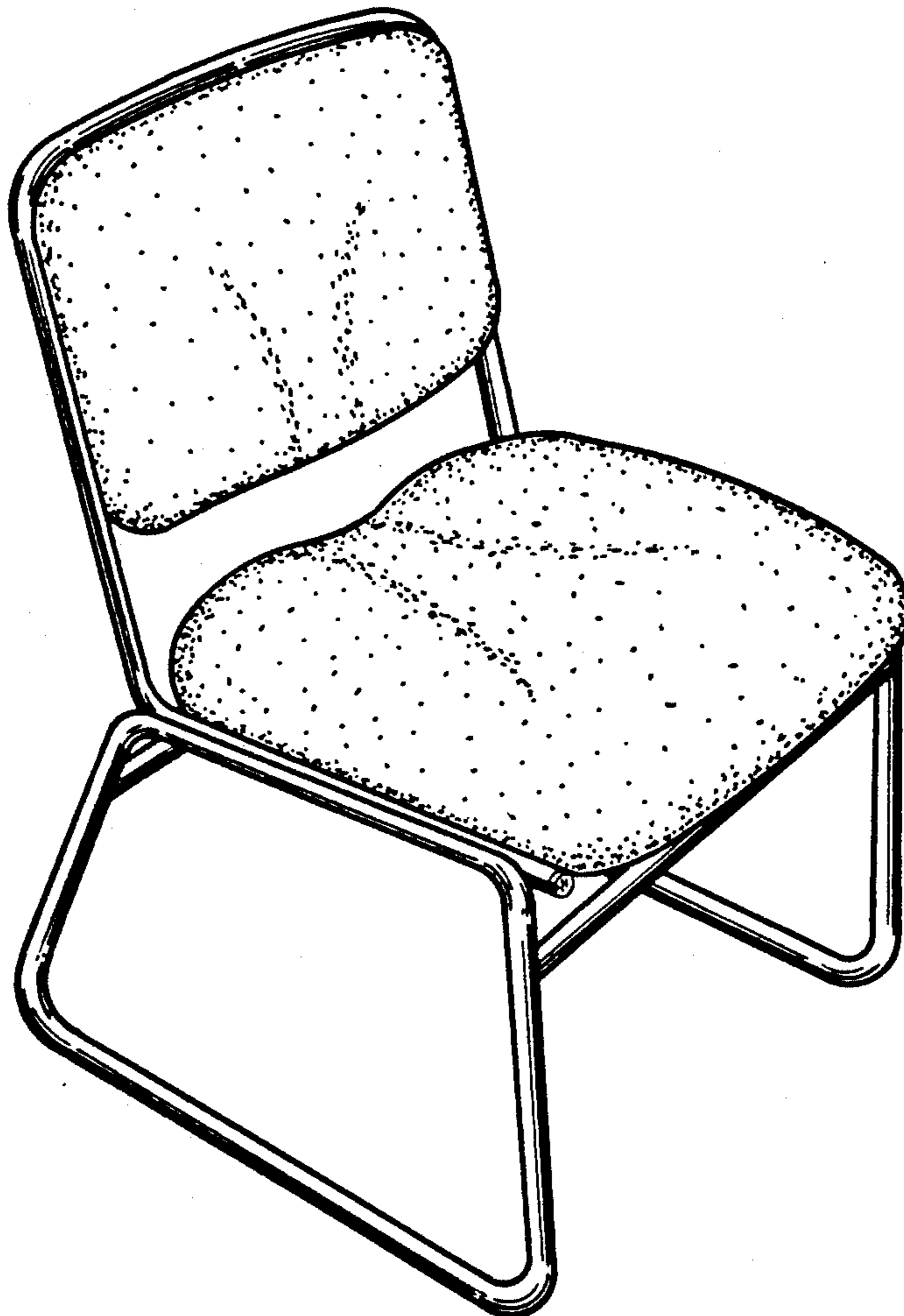
FIG. 1 is a top left-front perspective view of a chair
showing my new design;

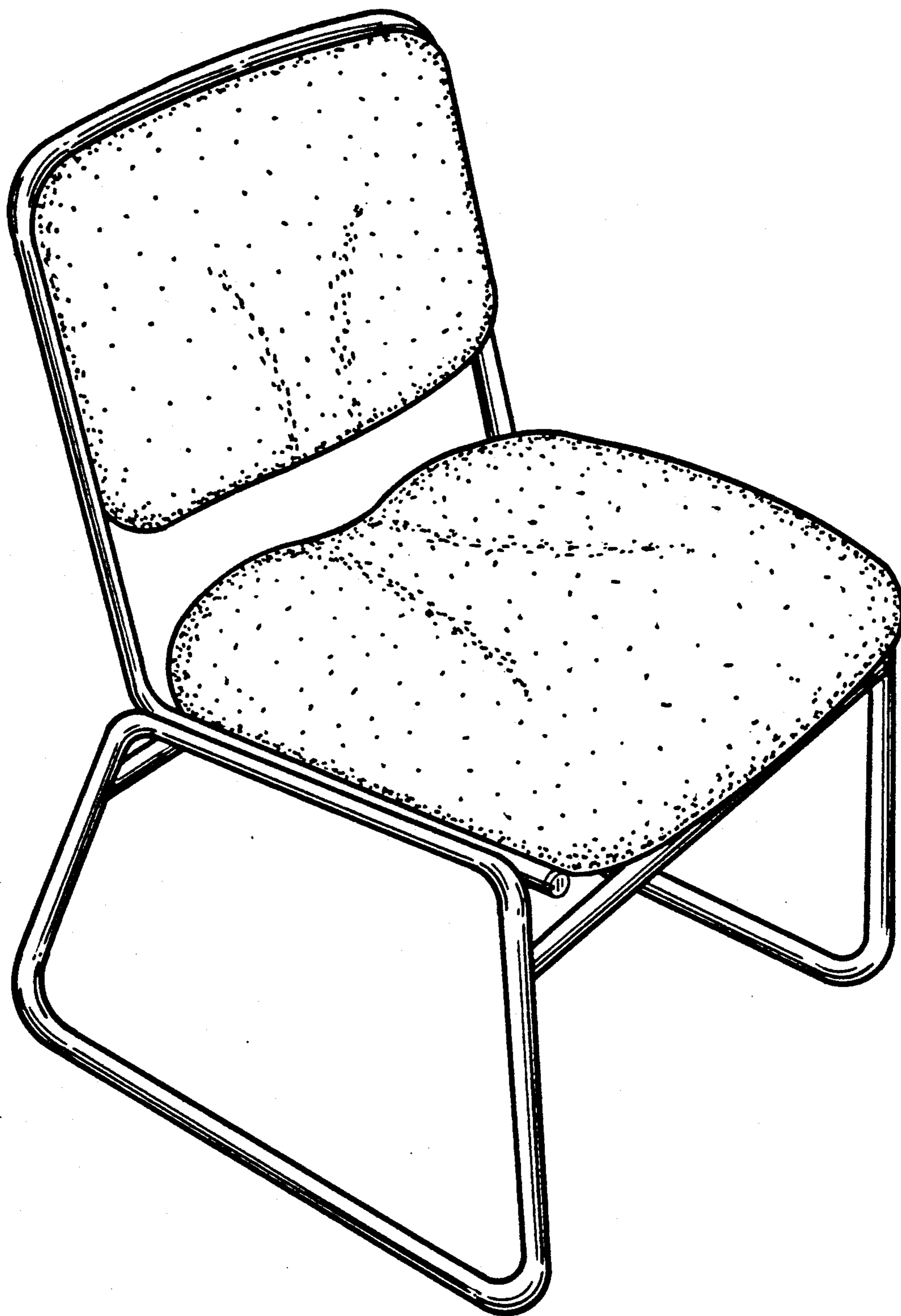
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof;

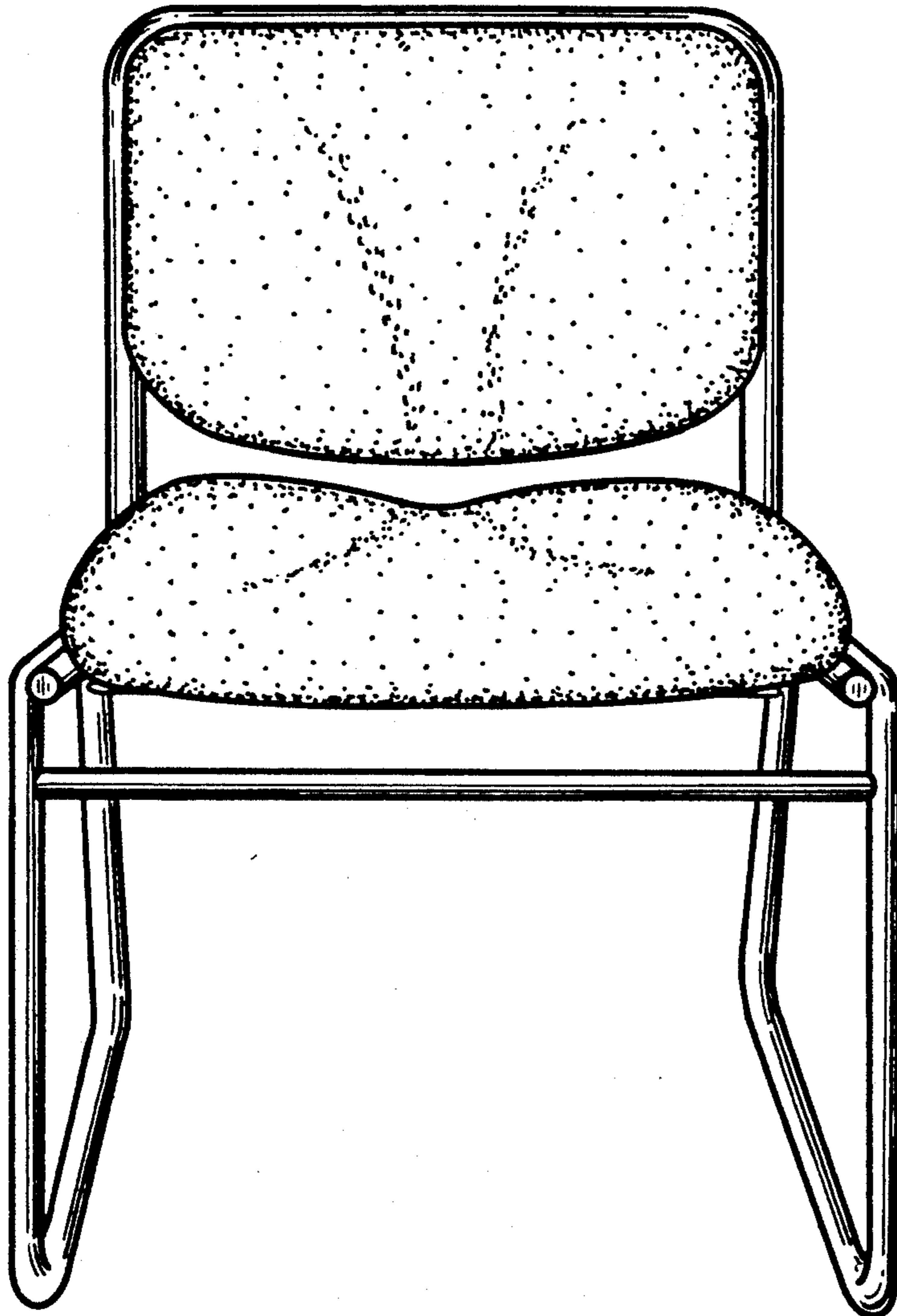

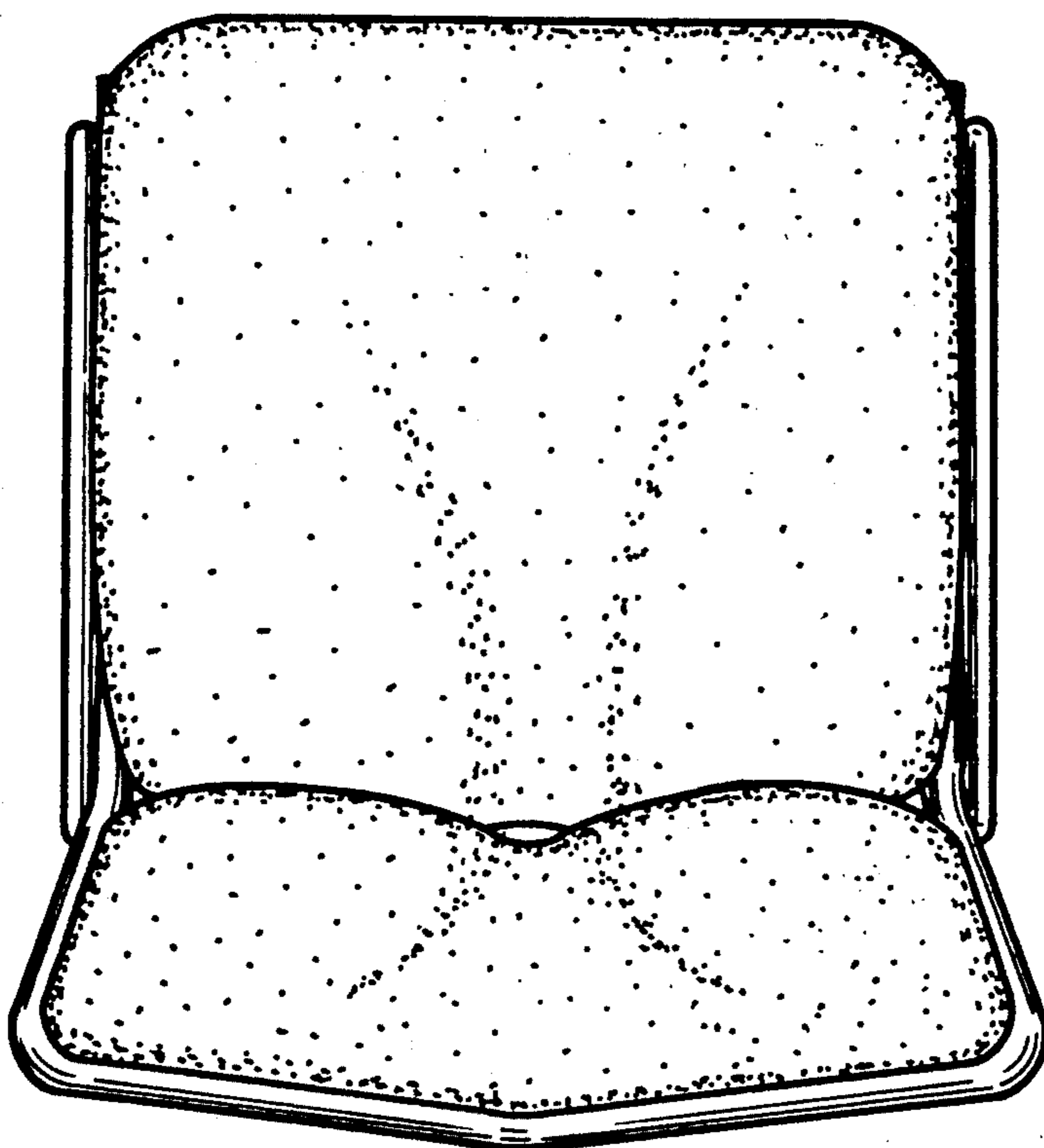
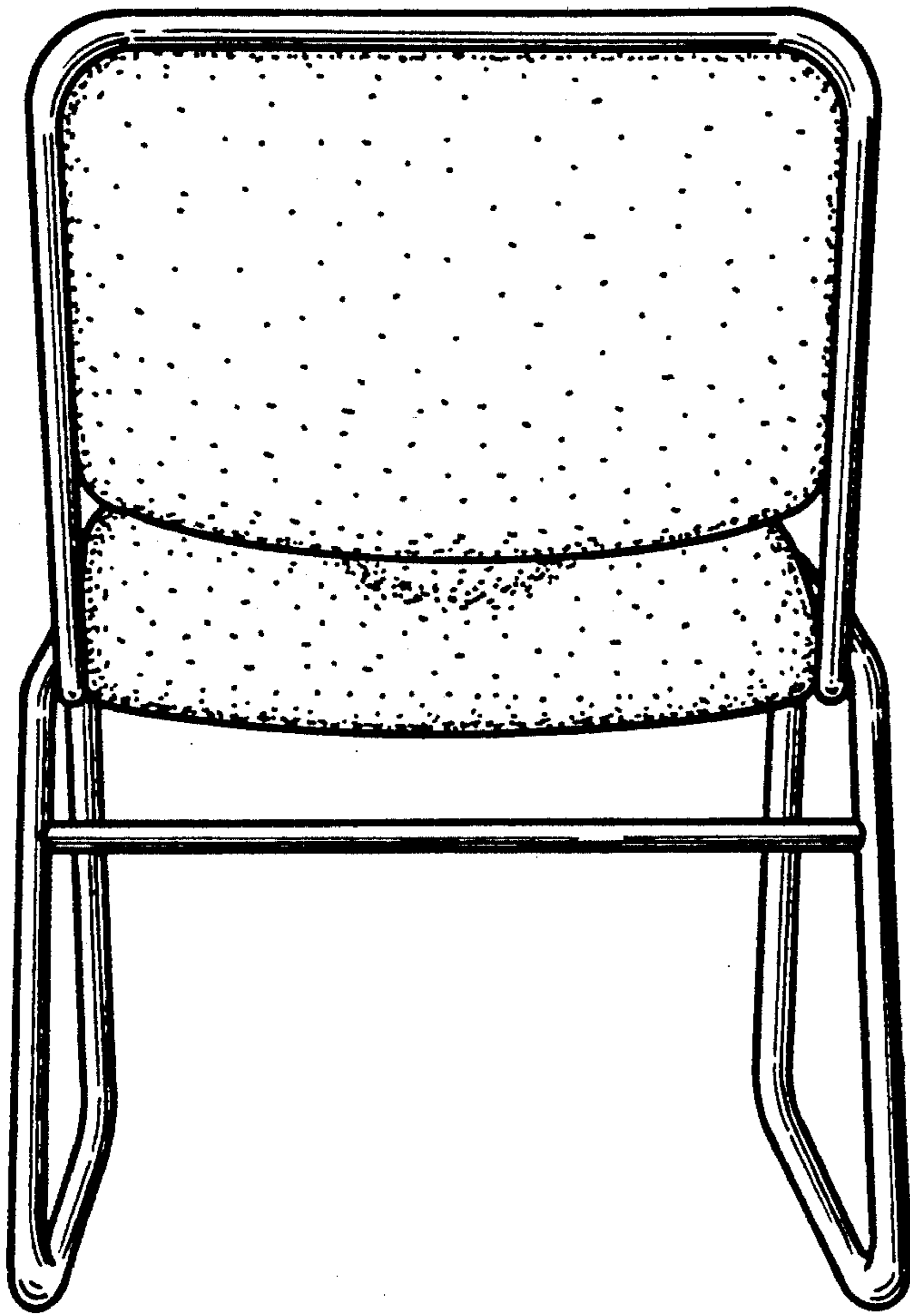
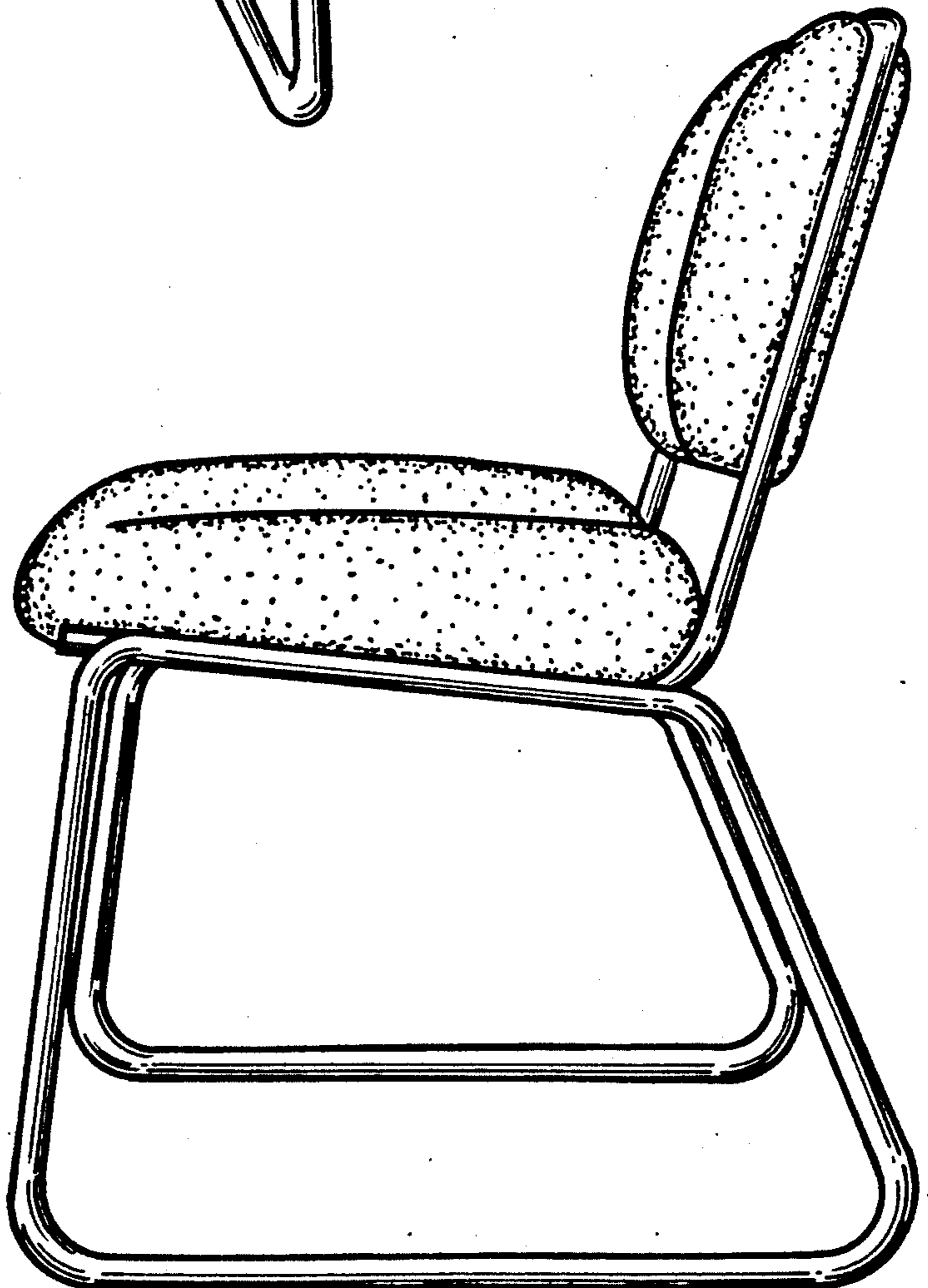
