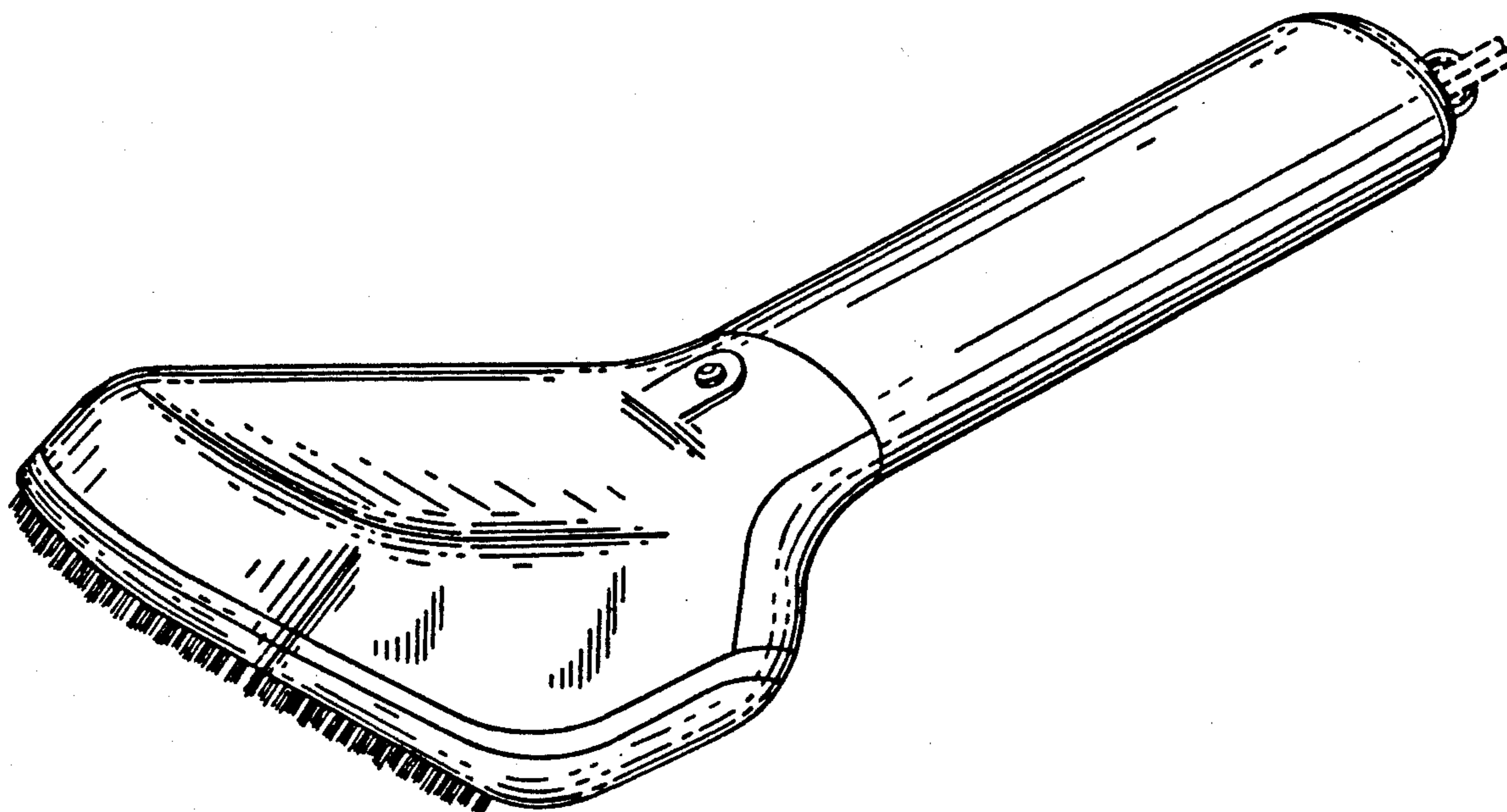

The ornamental design for a garment steamer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a garment steamer showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the garment steamer of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The broken line showing of the cord connections is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



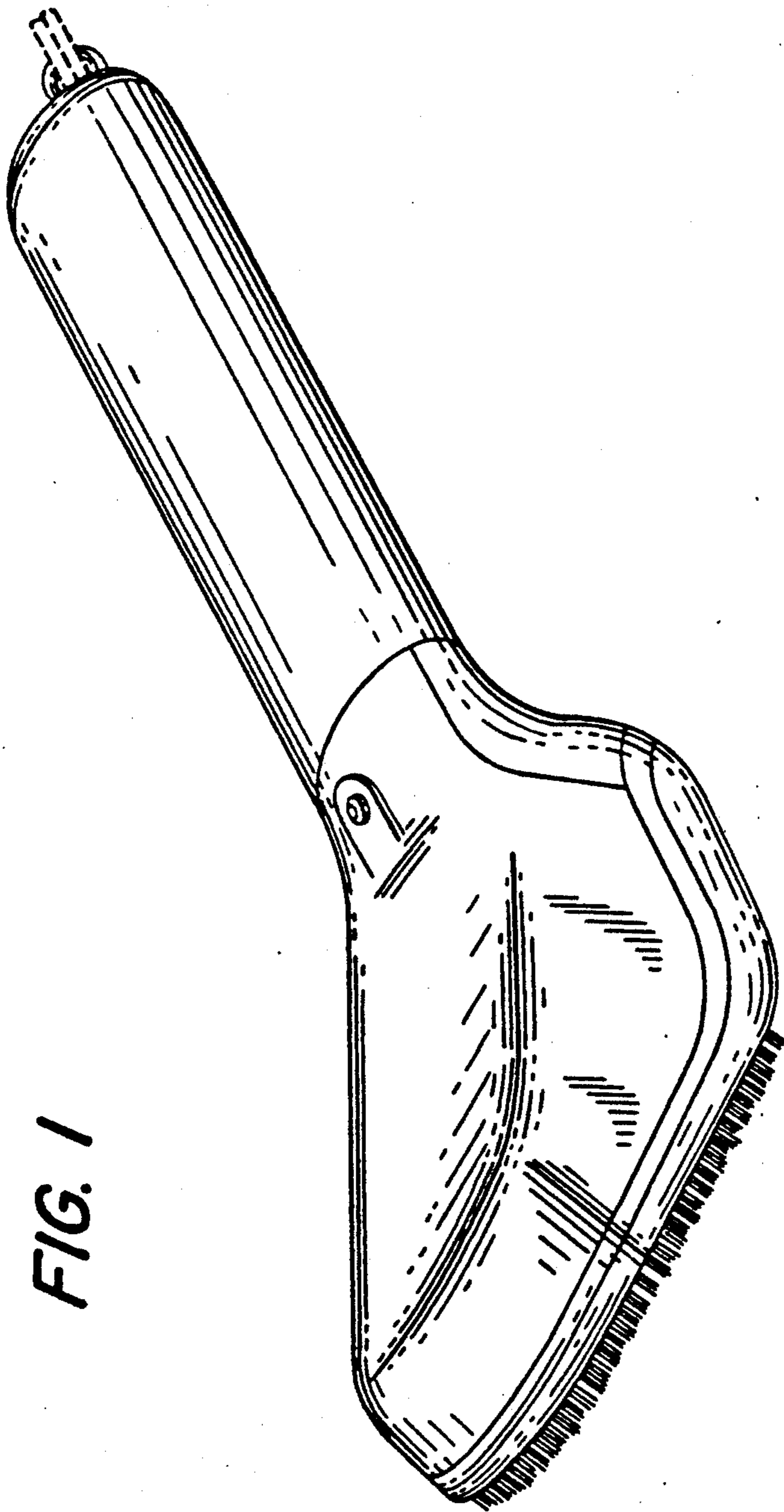
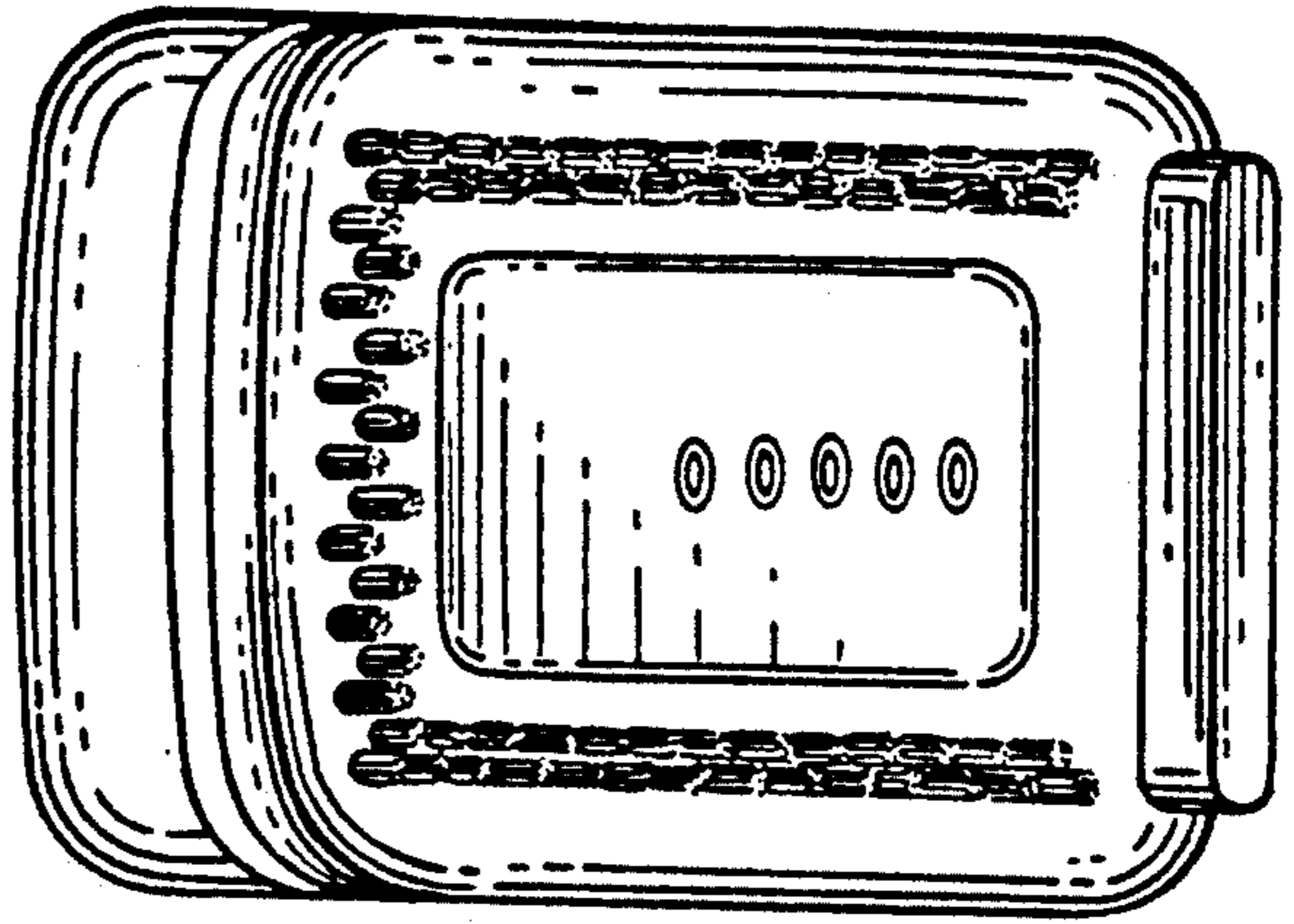

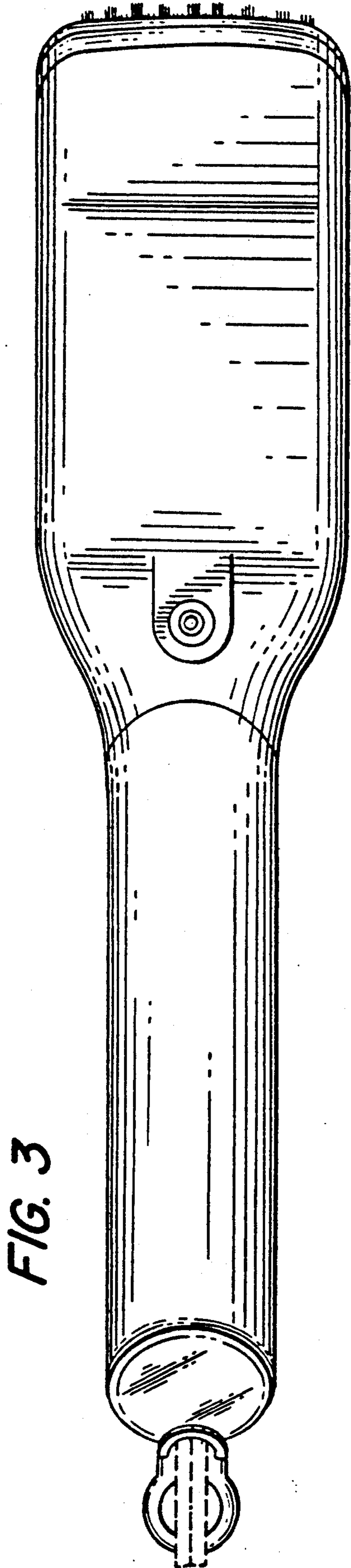

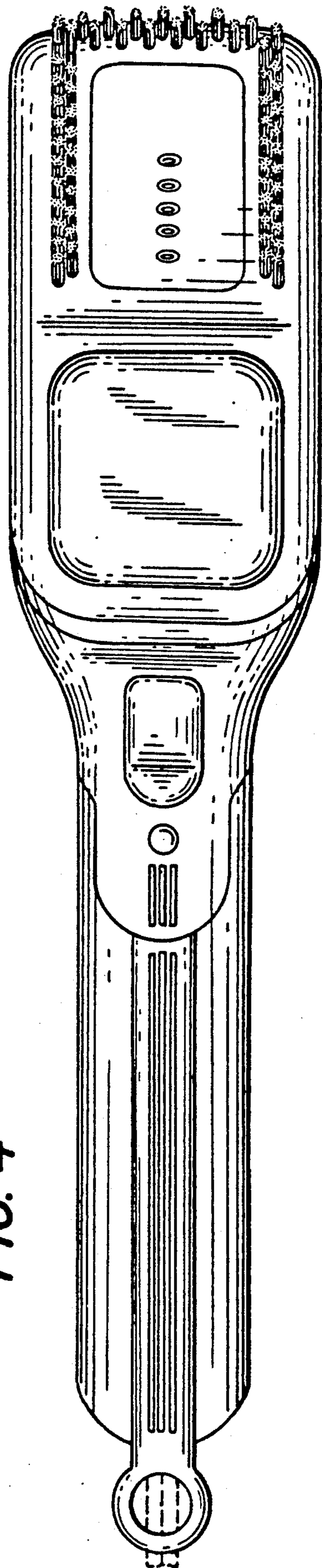

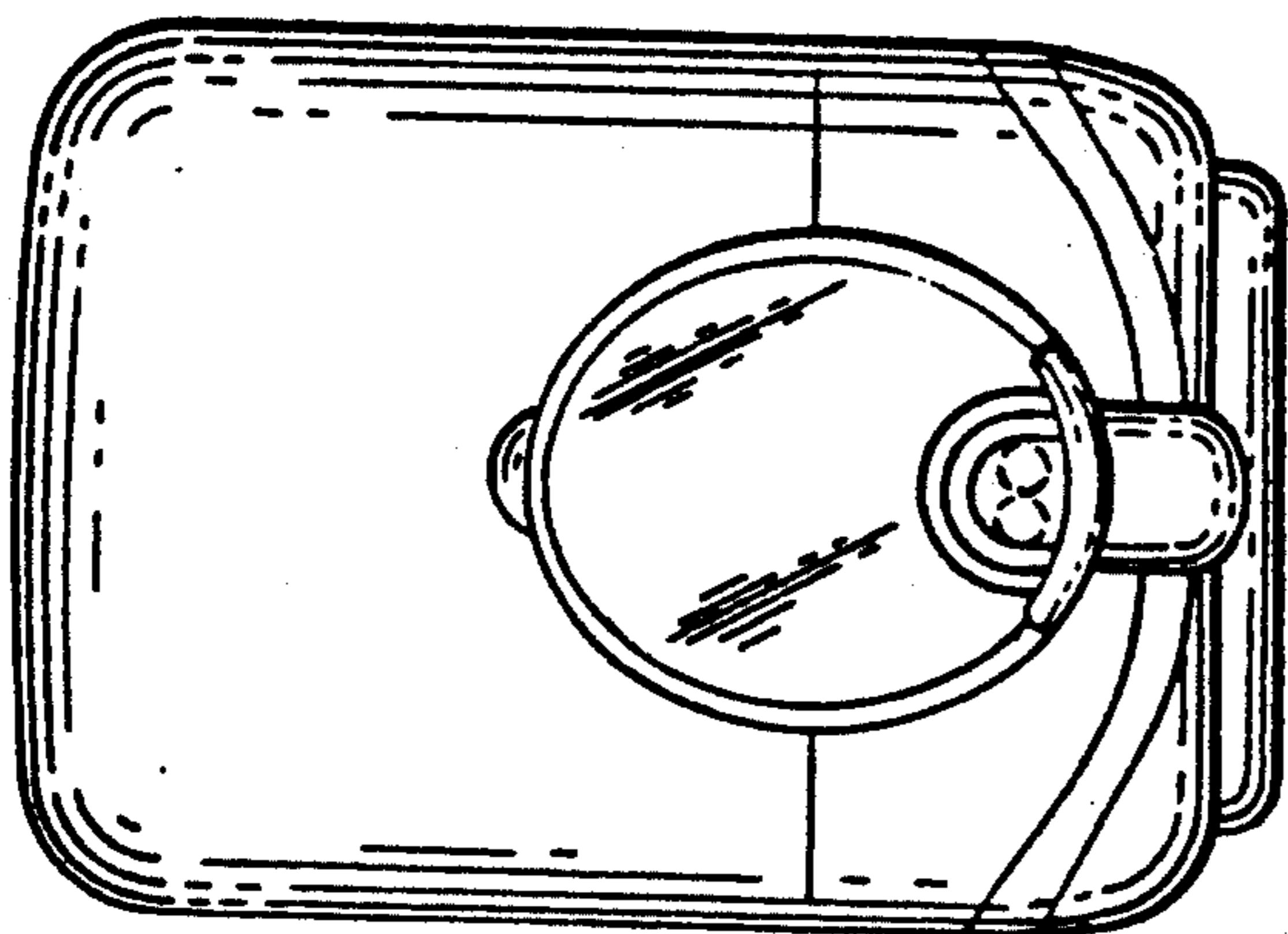
