FIG. 1 is a top and rear perspective view of a bowling bag shuttle cart showing my new design; the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

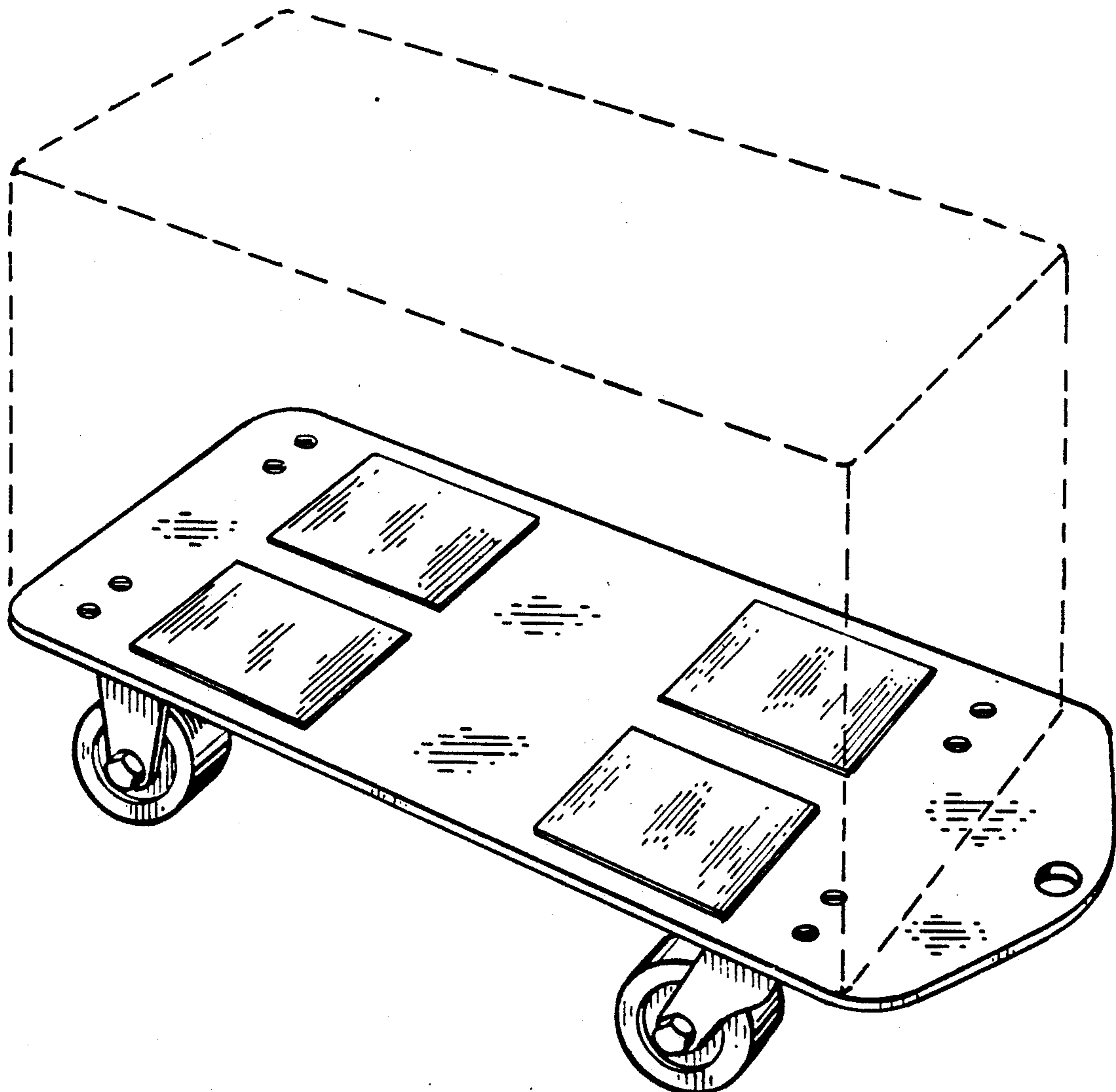
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.



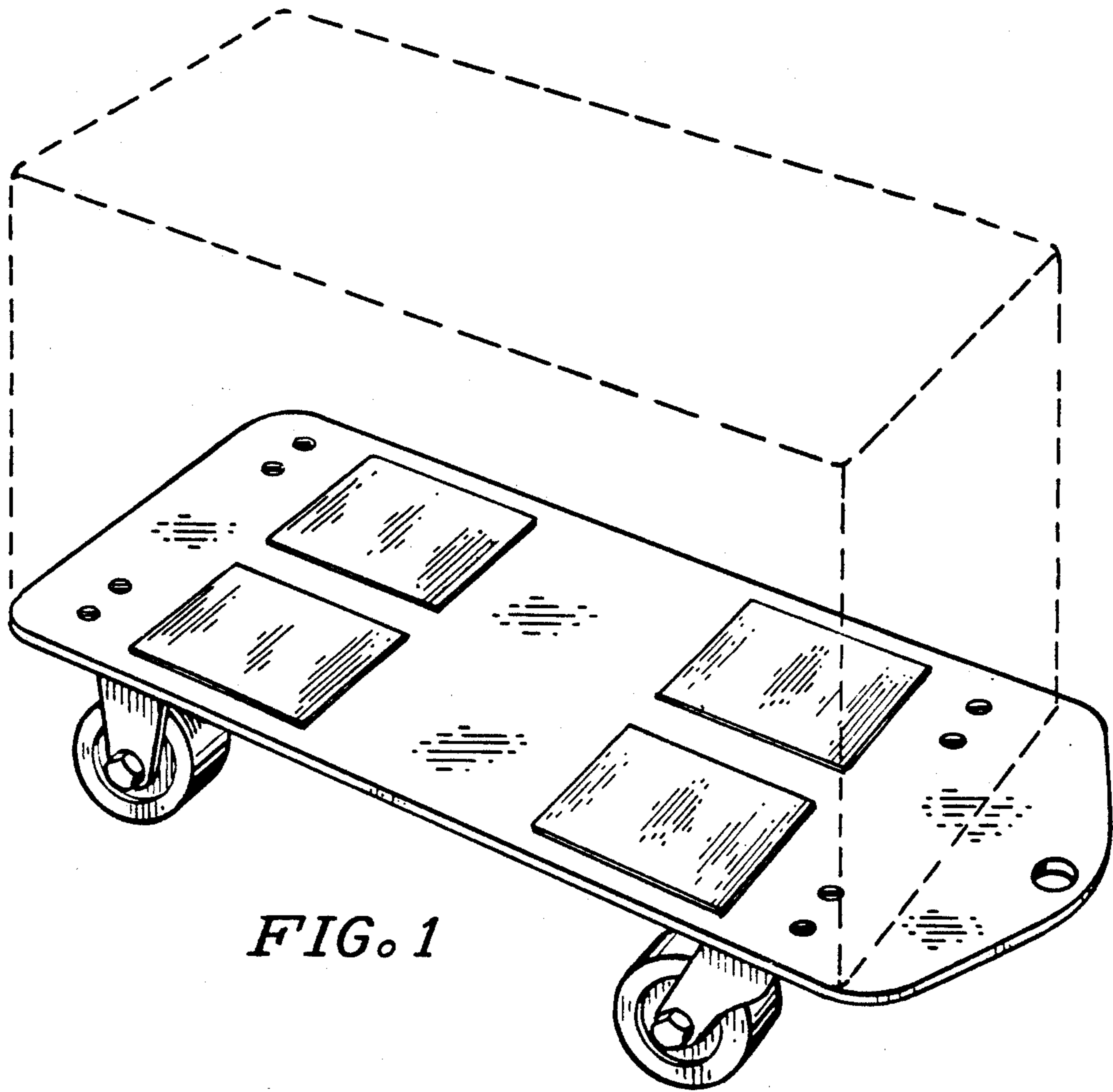

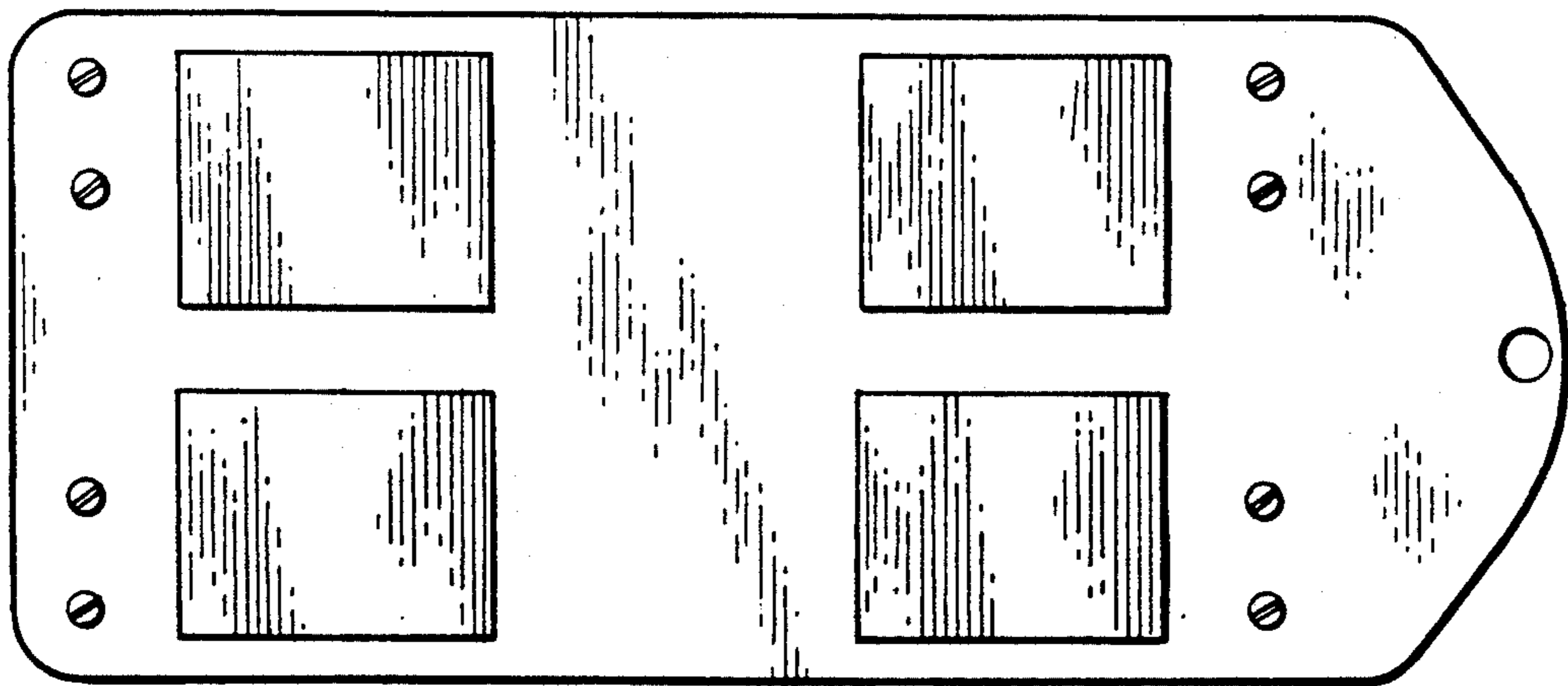

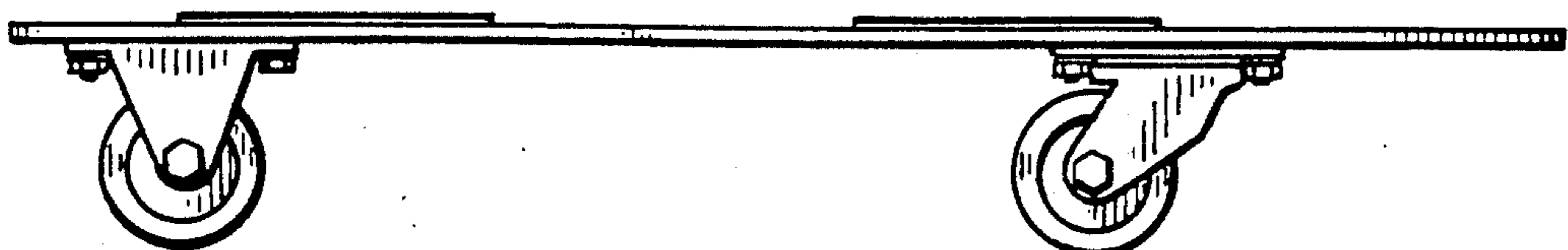

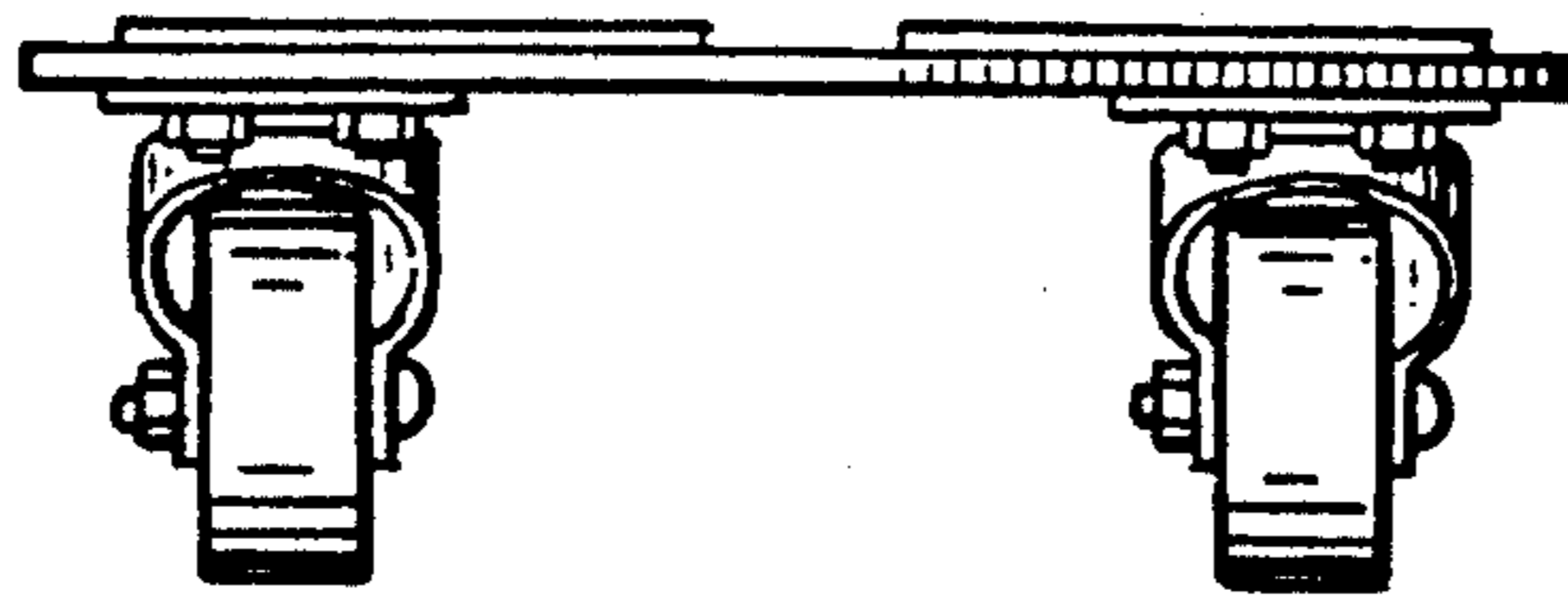

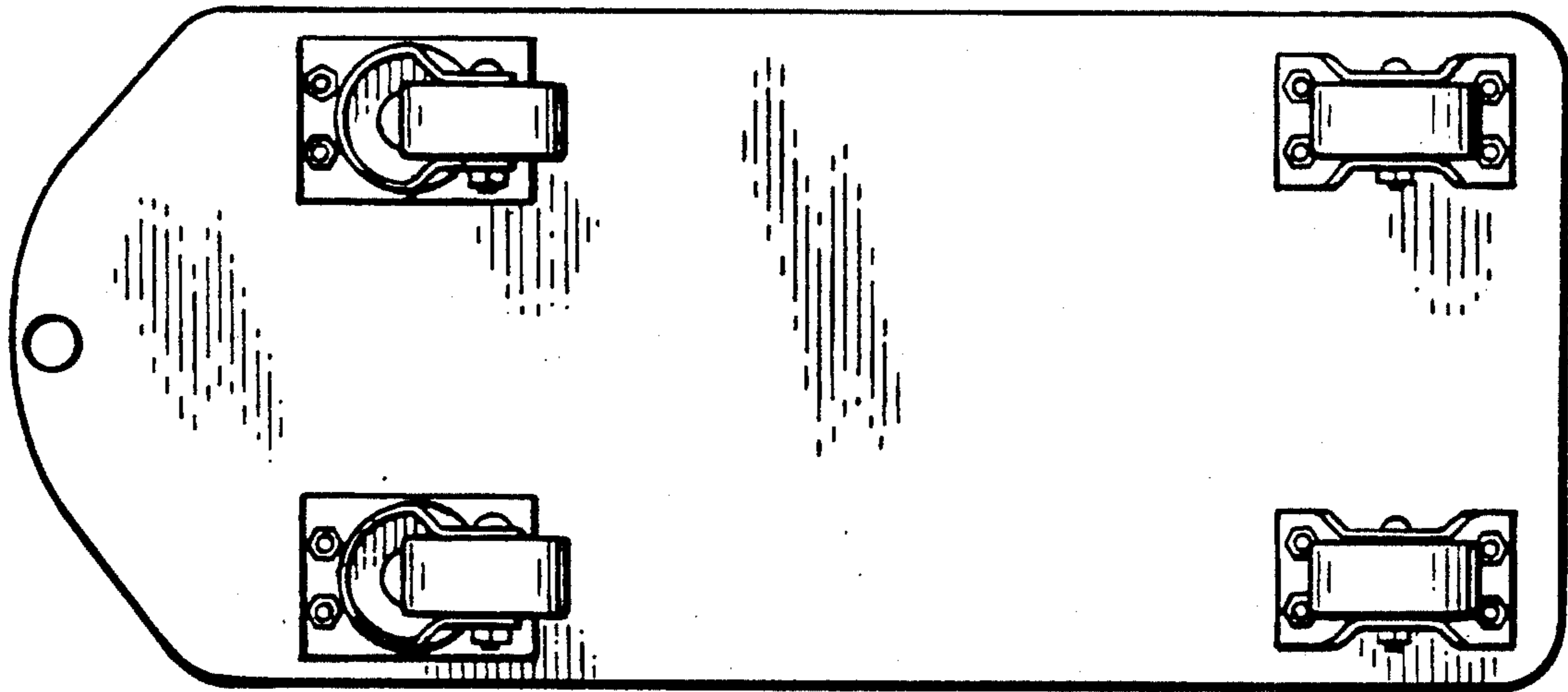
