[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a holster for holding tools, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a holster for holding tools showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view, in cross section, taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 2, the right side being a mirror image thereof.
