The ornamental design for a five blade marine propeller, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a five blade marine propeller showing our design; FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.

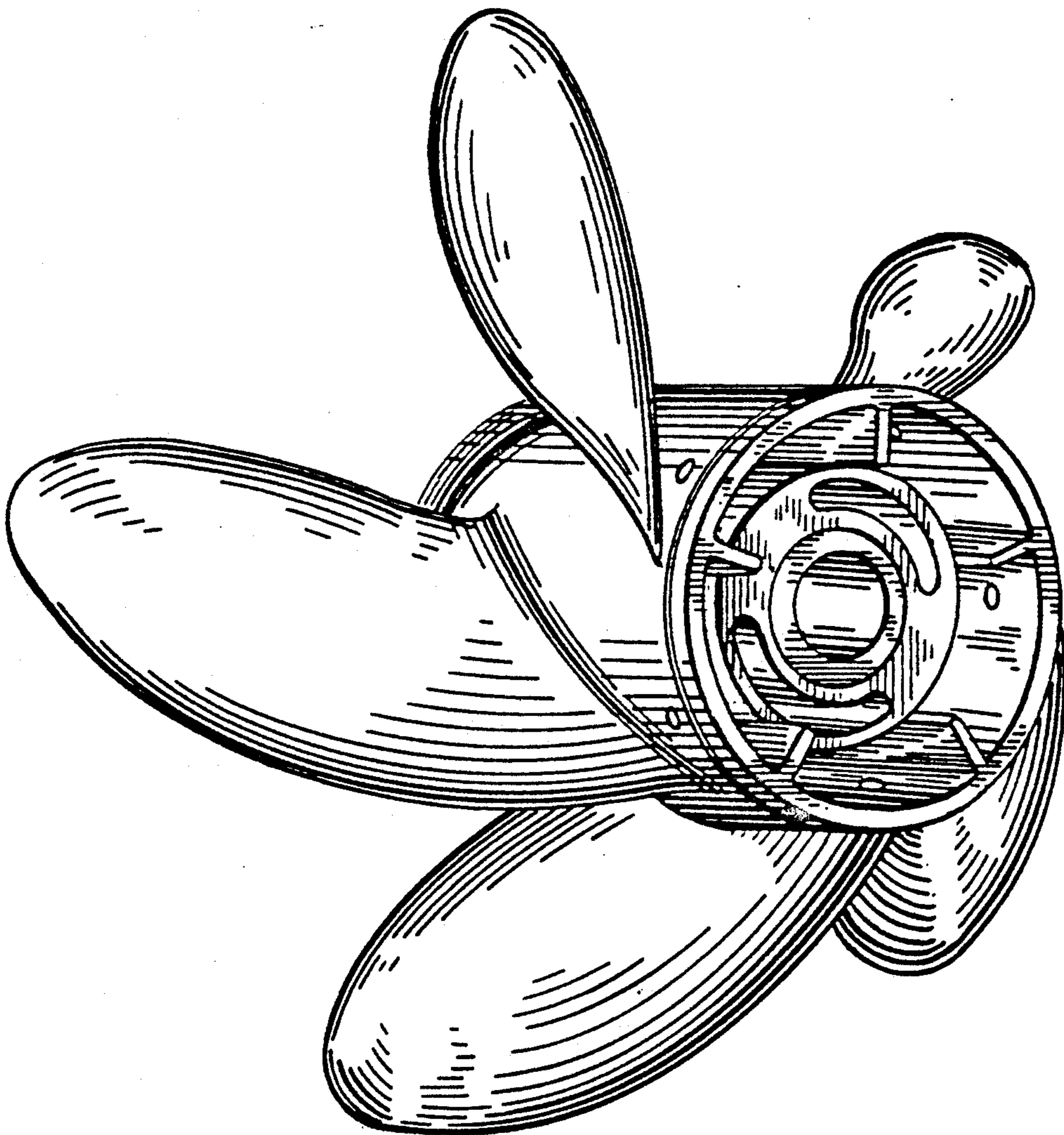

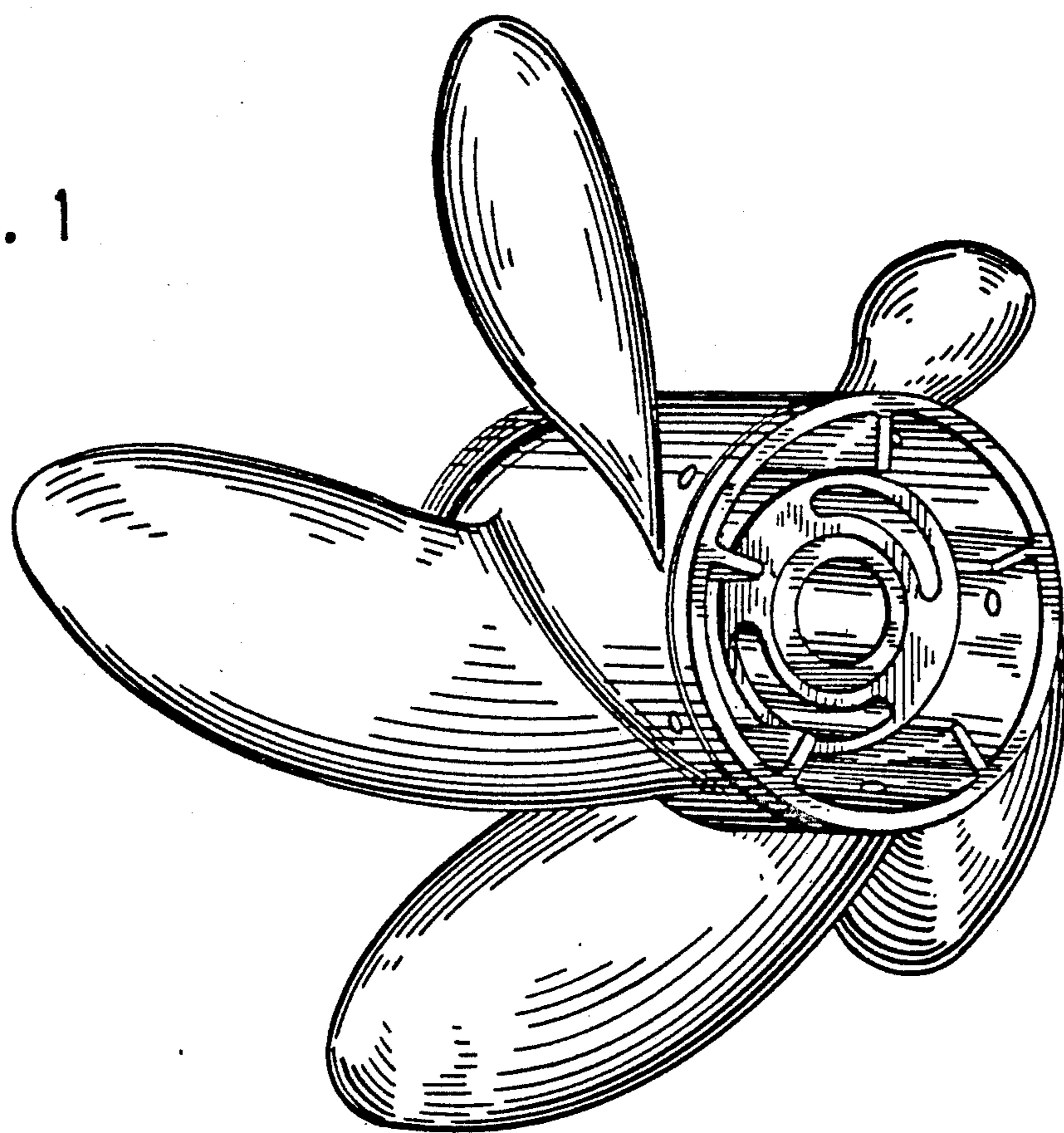
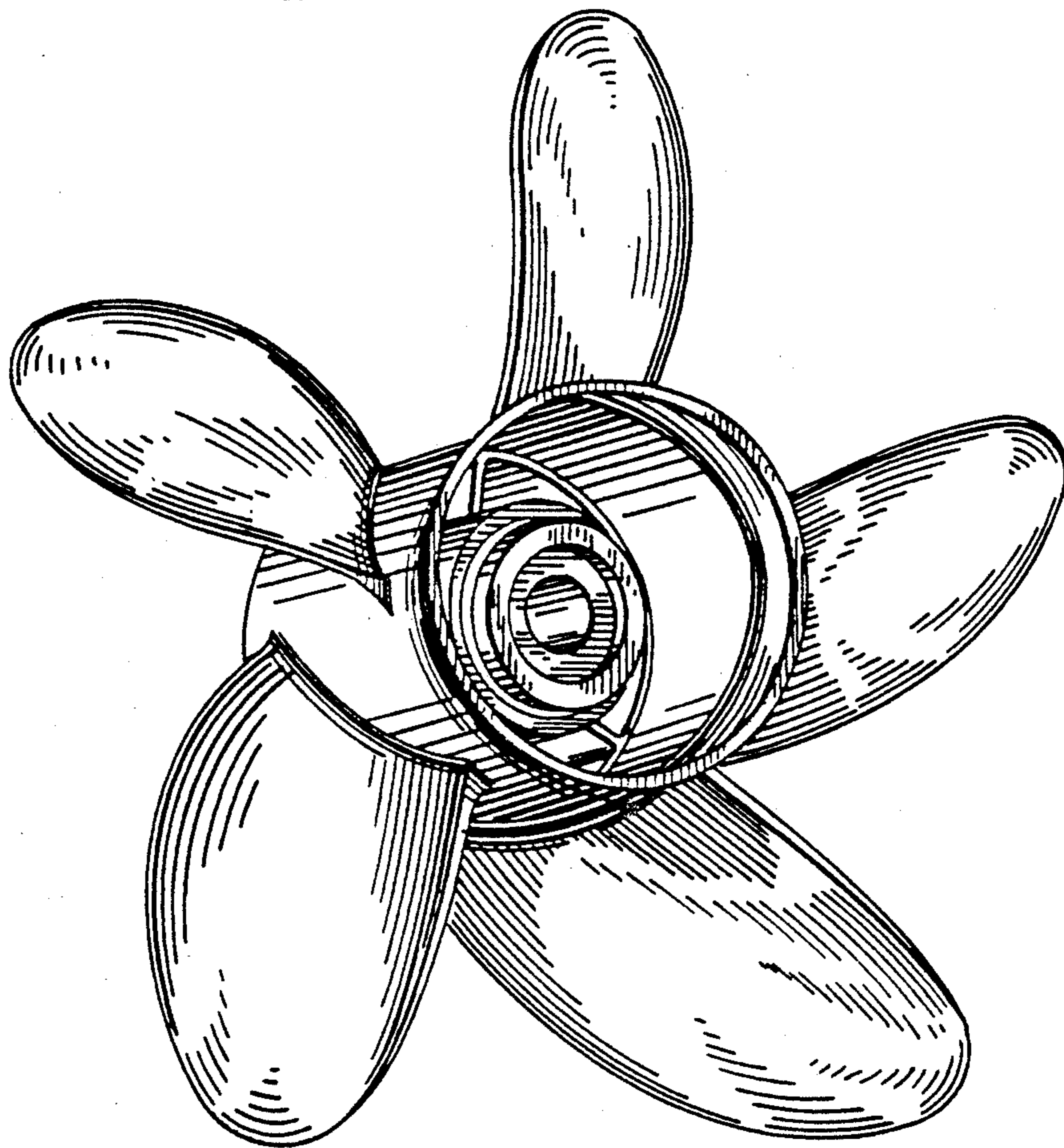

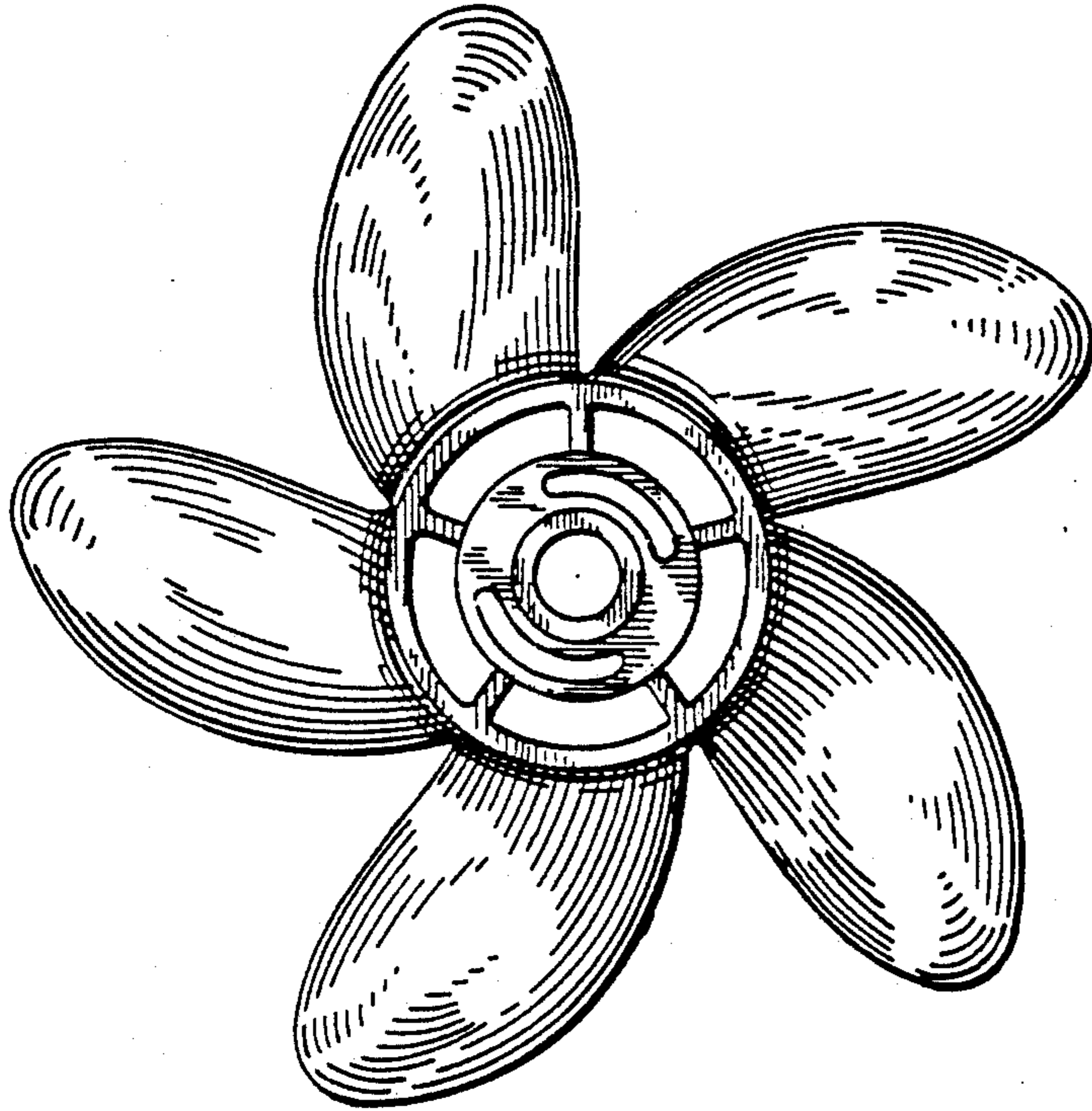

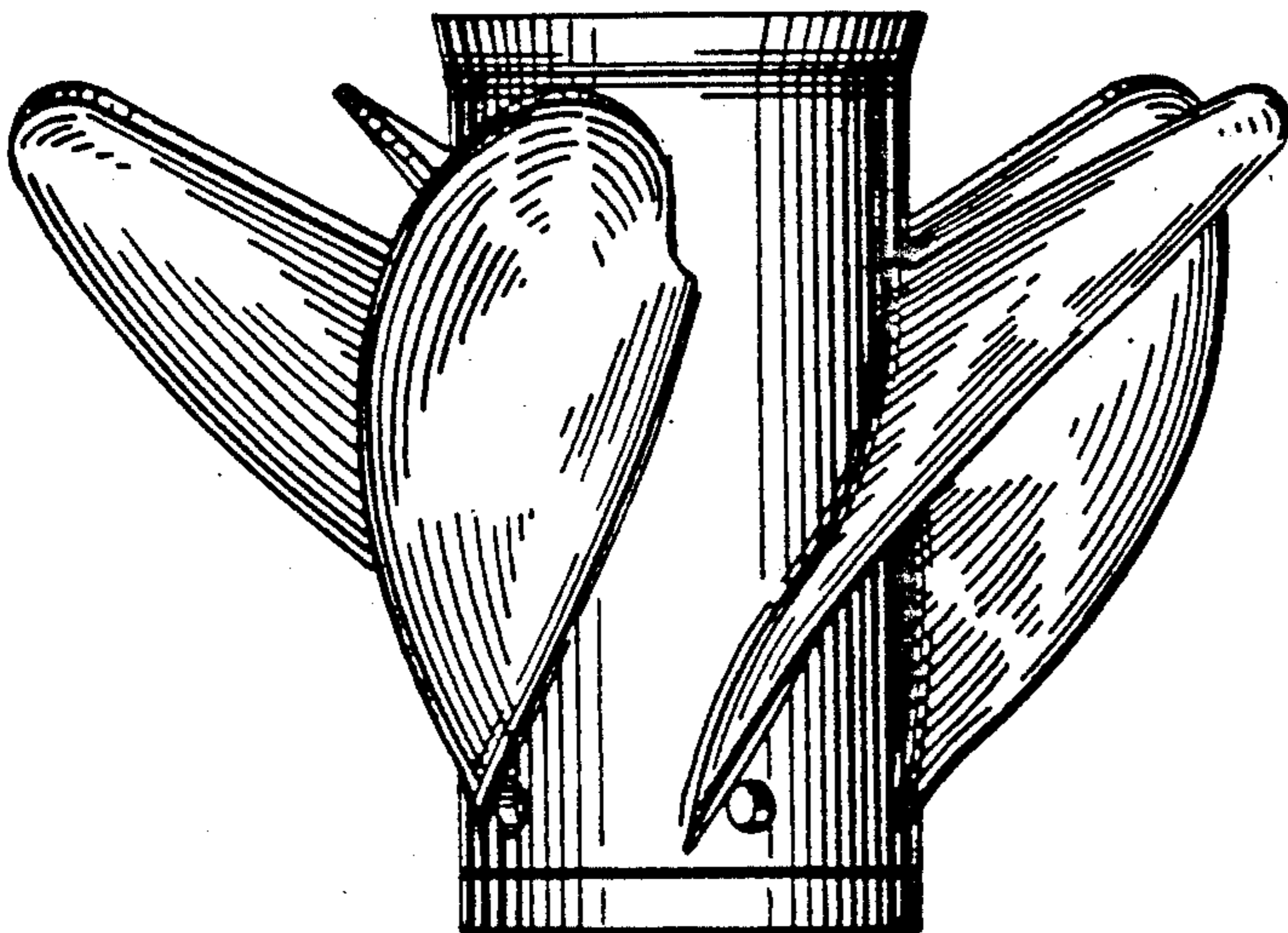
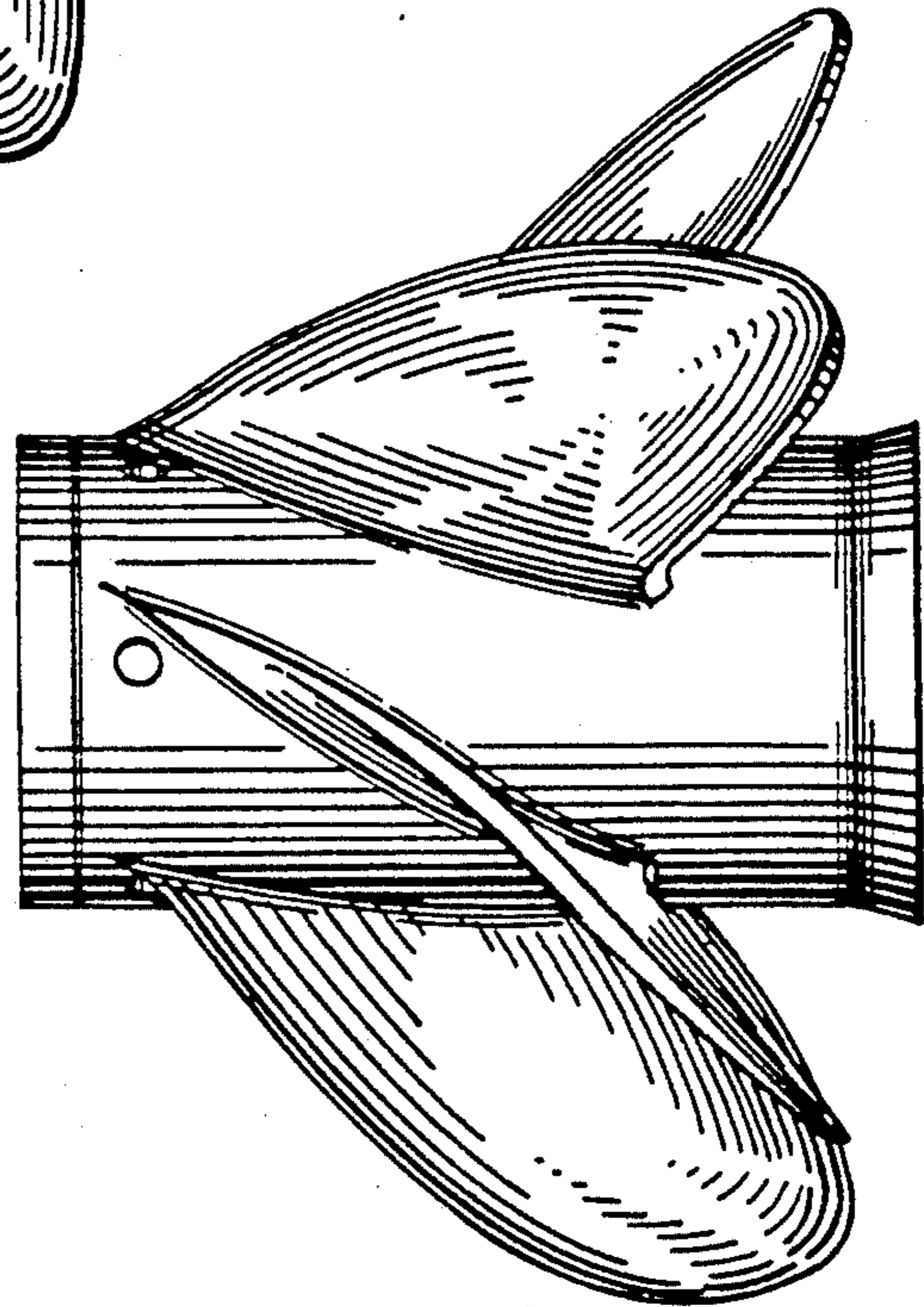

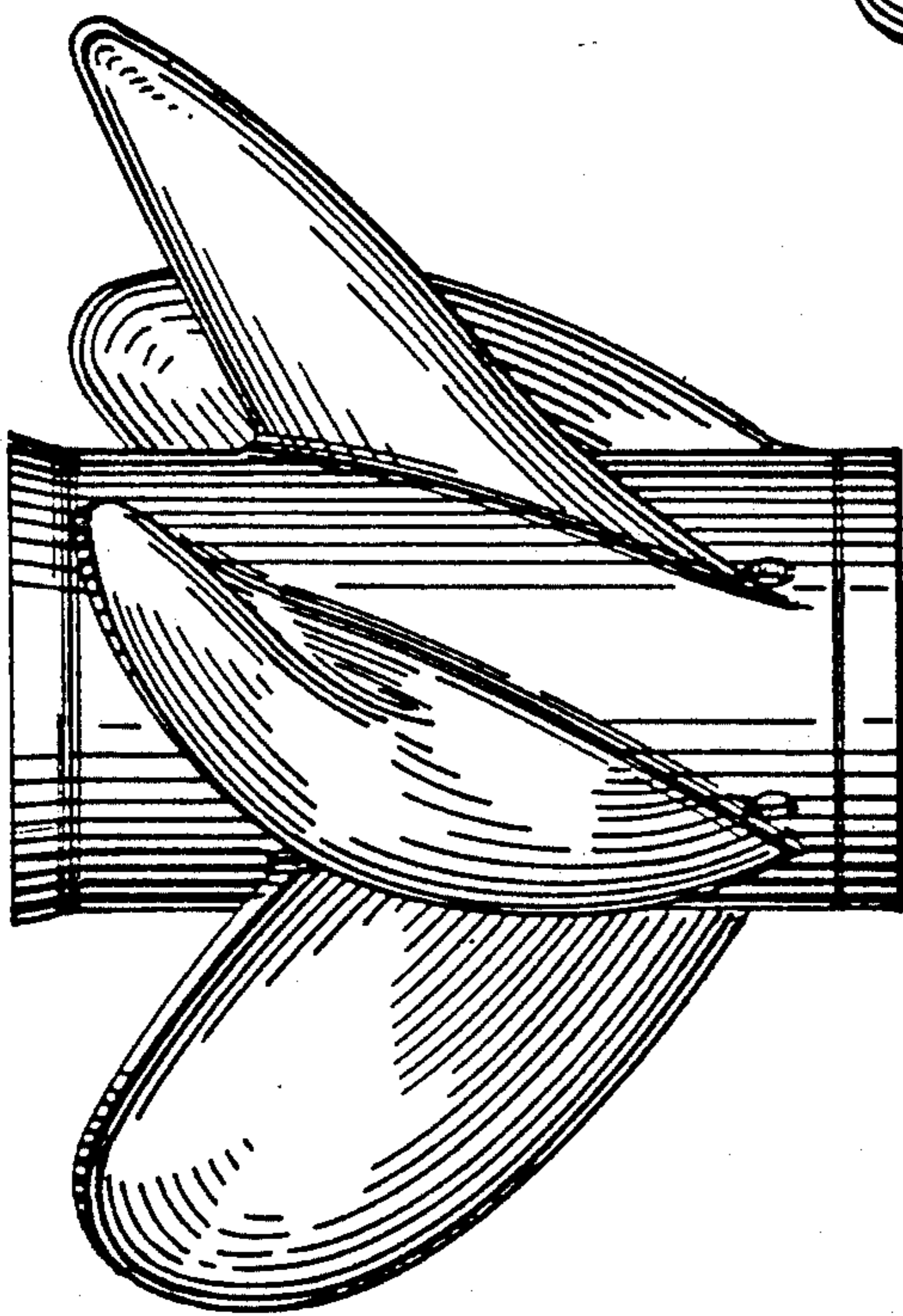
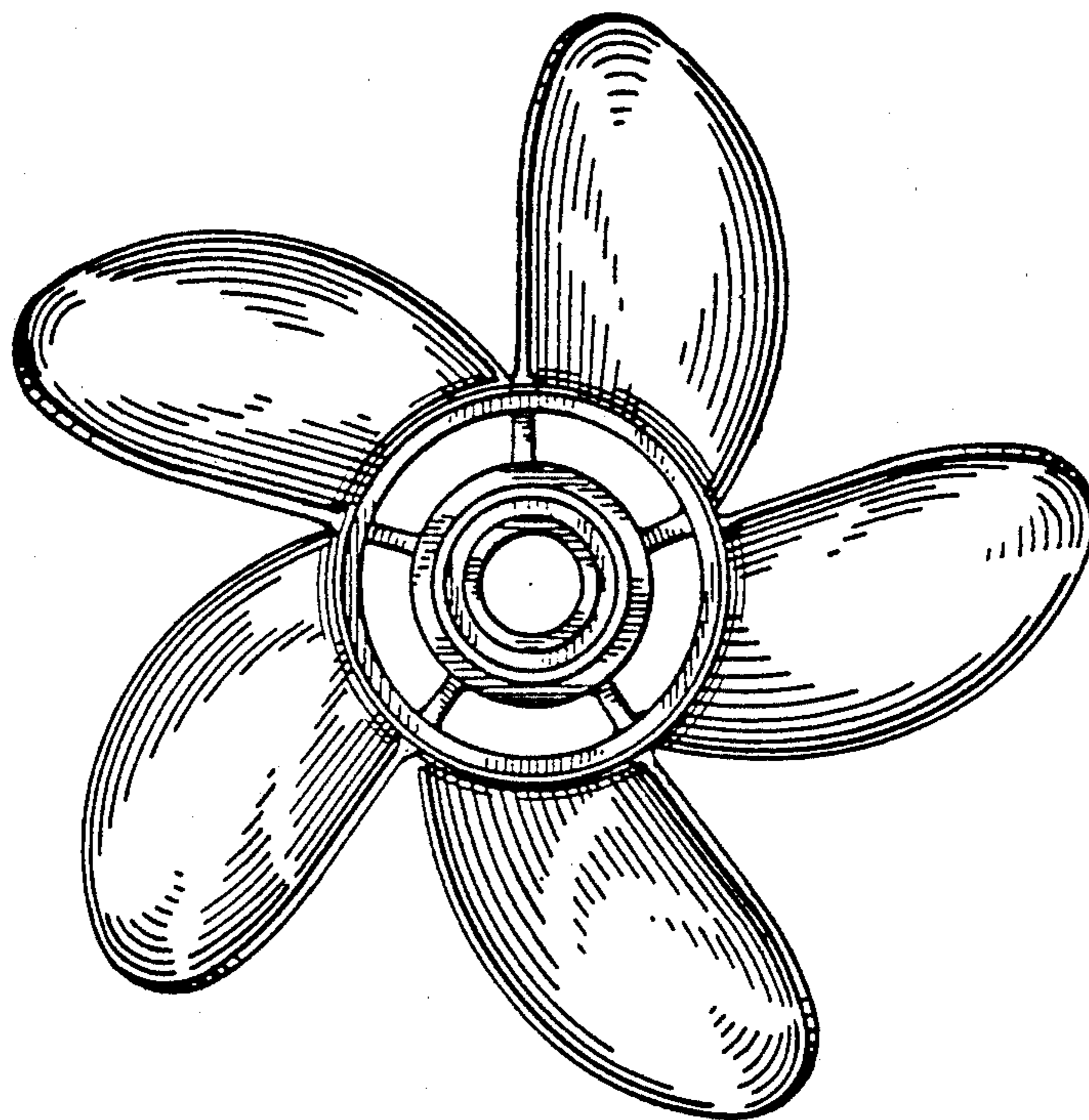
