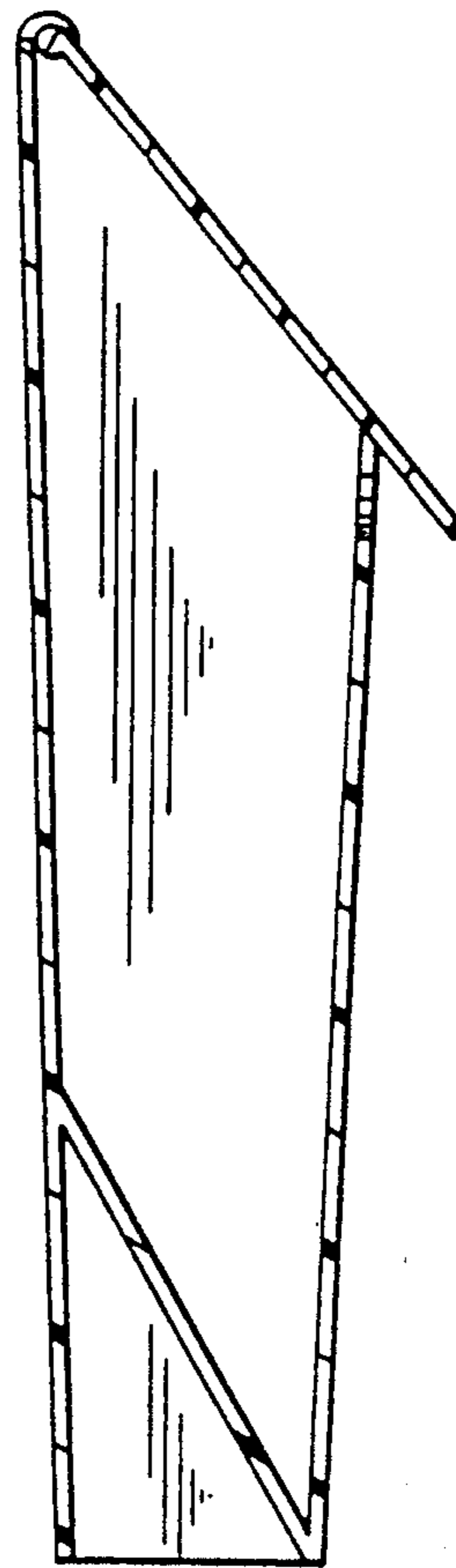
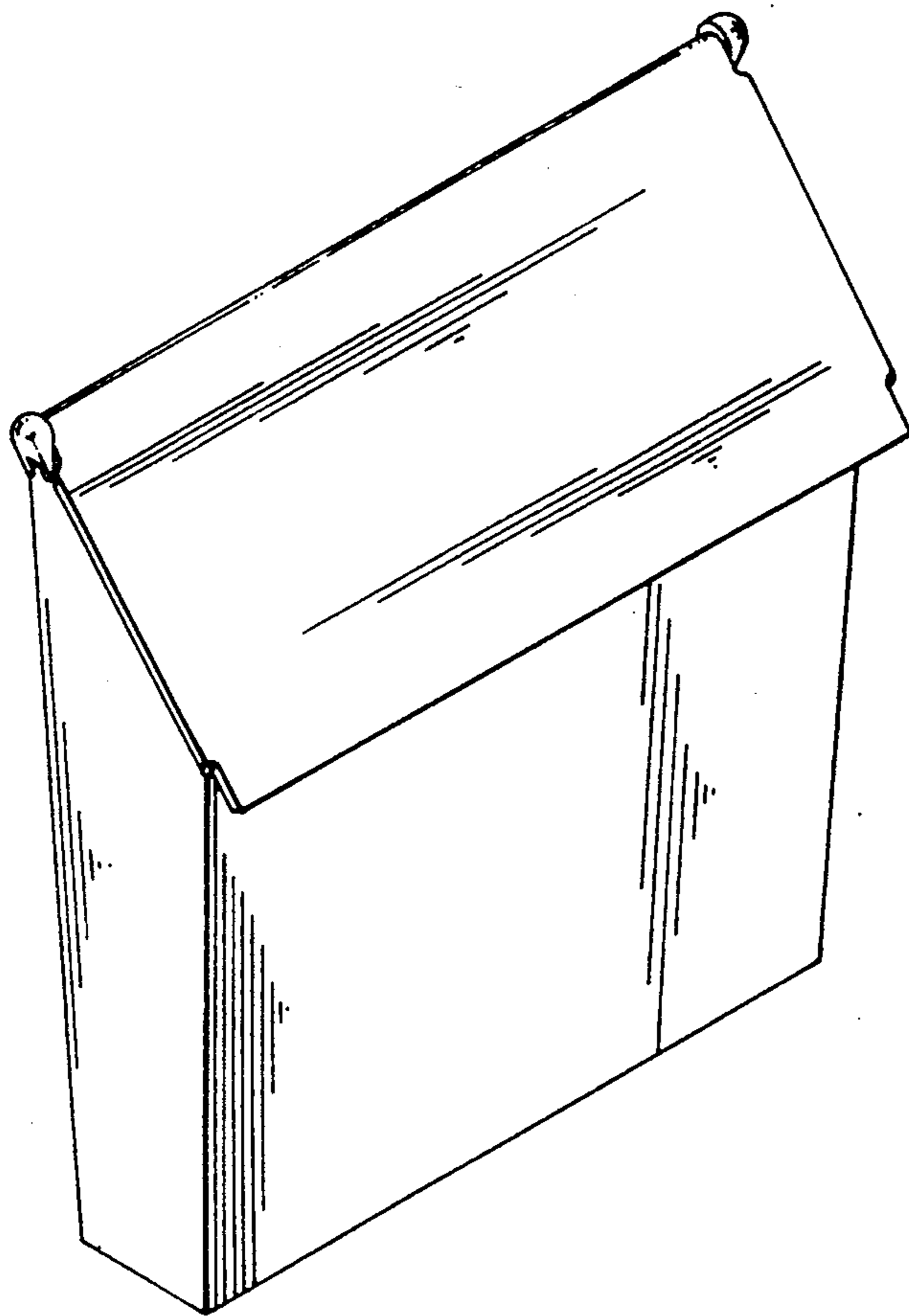

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a computer diskette holder showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof.
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view, the right side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view with the corner in a raised condition;
FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 9 is a sectional view taken along line 9—9 of FIG. 2.



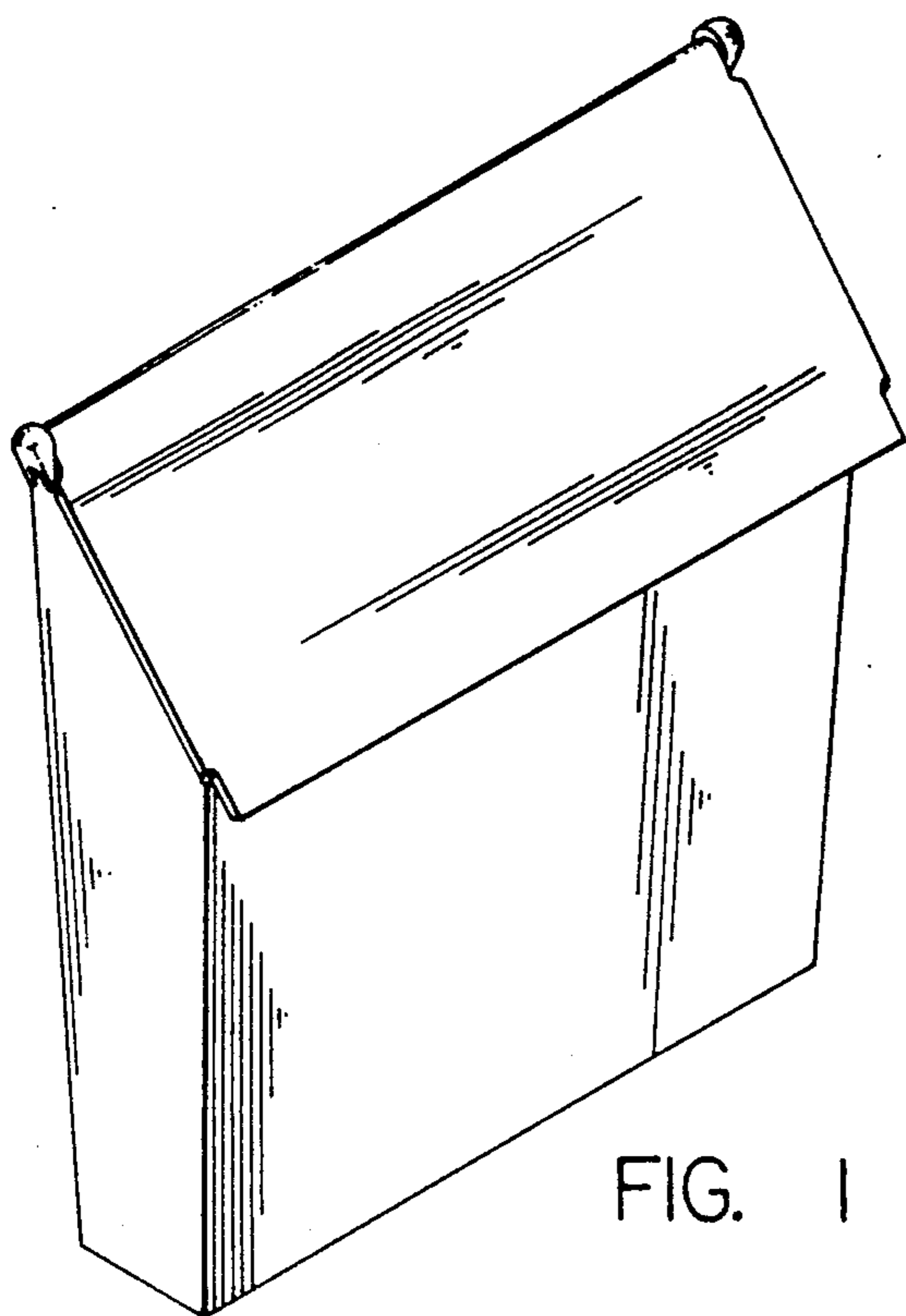

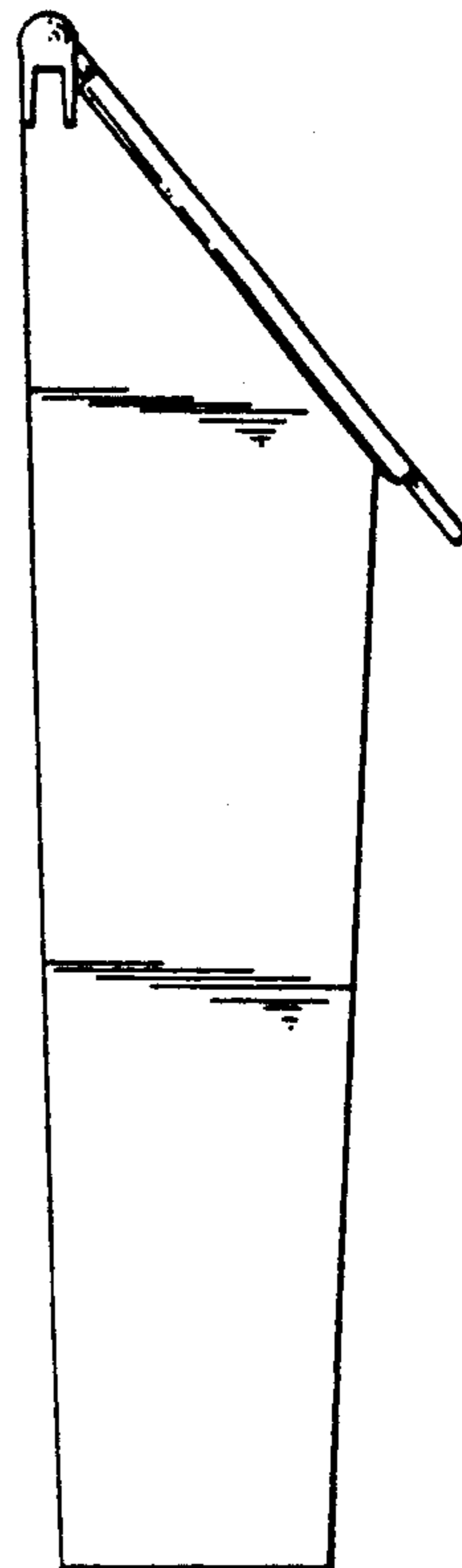

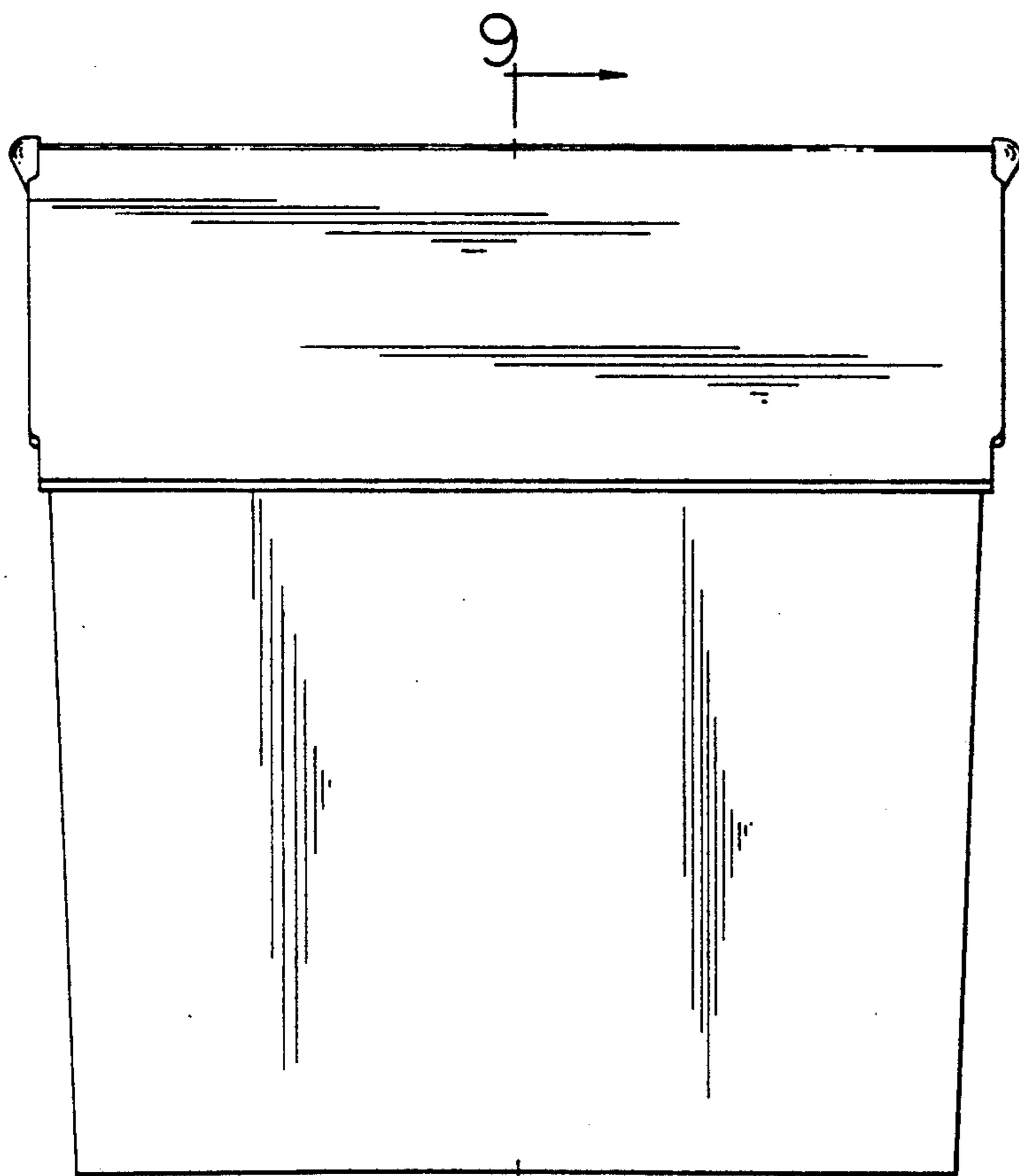

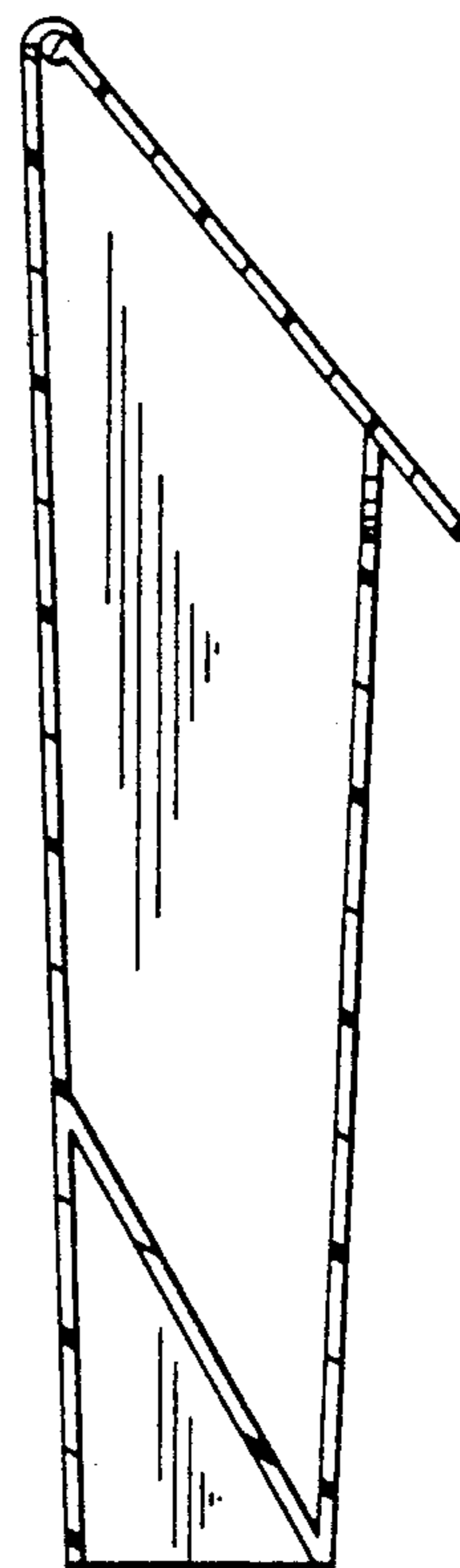
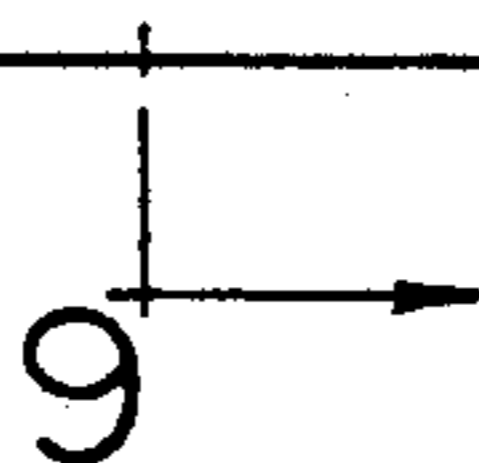

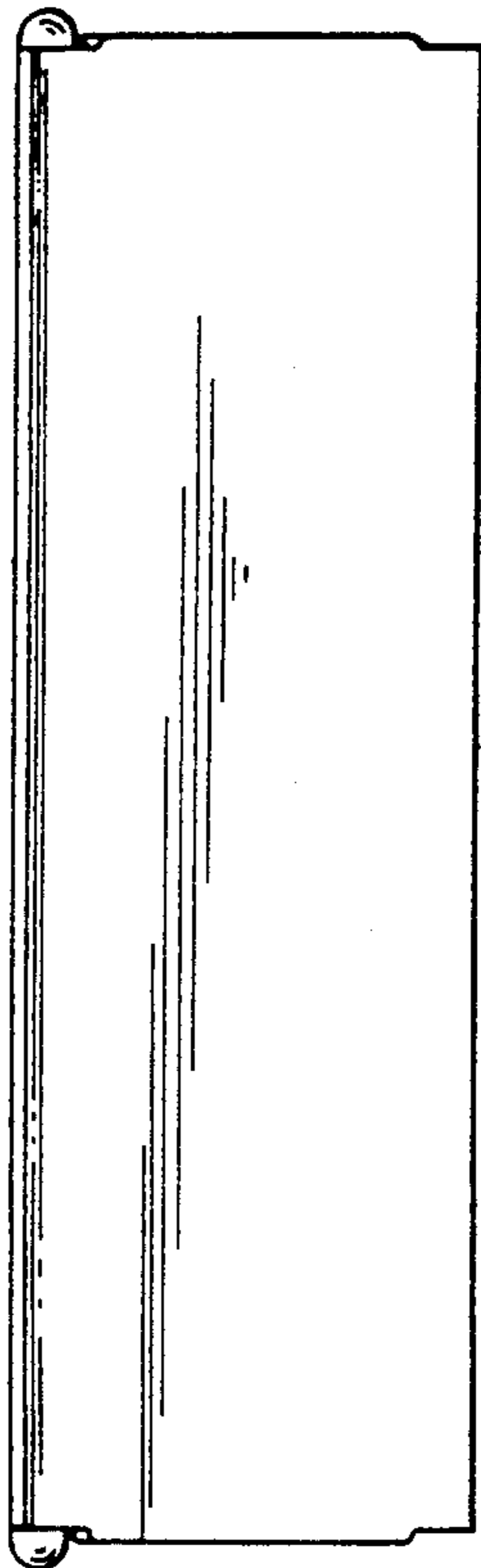

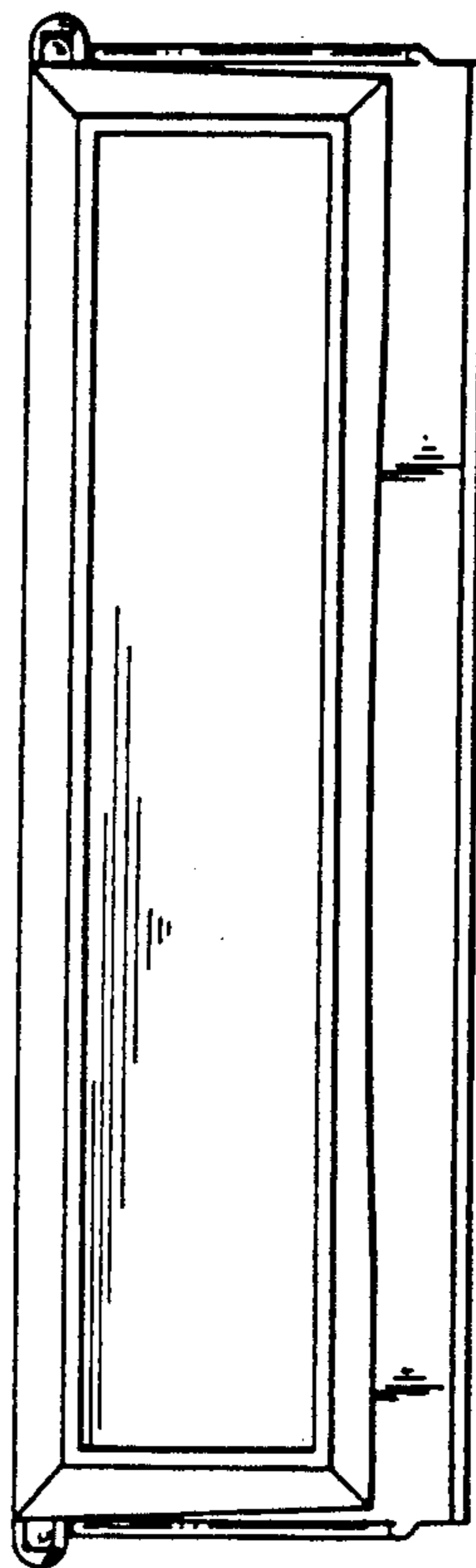

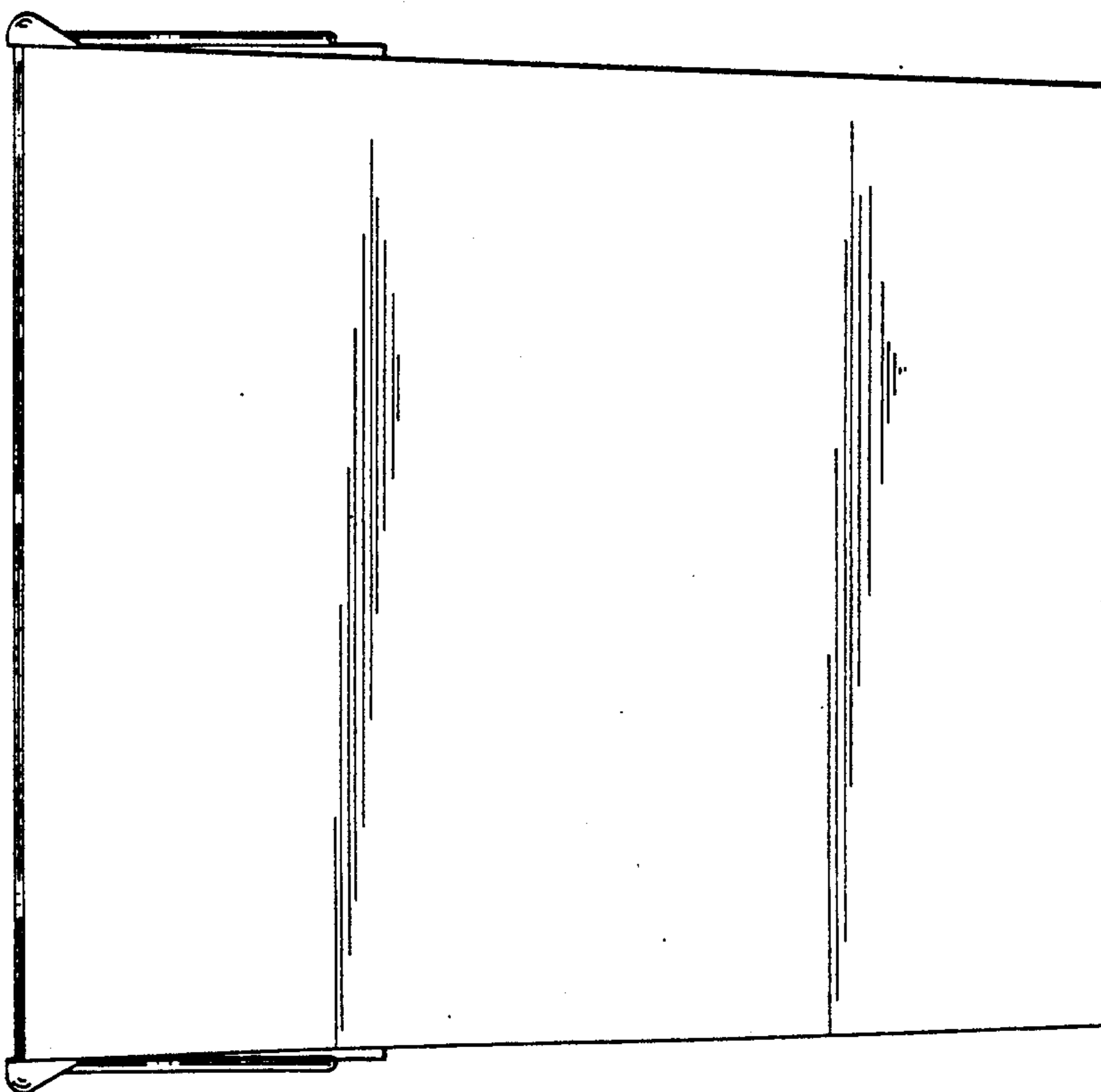

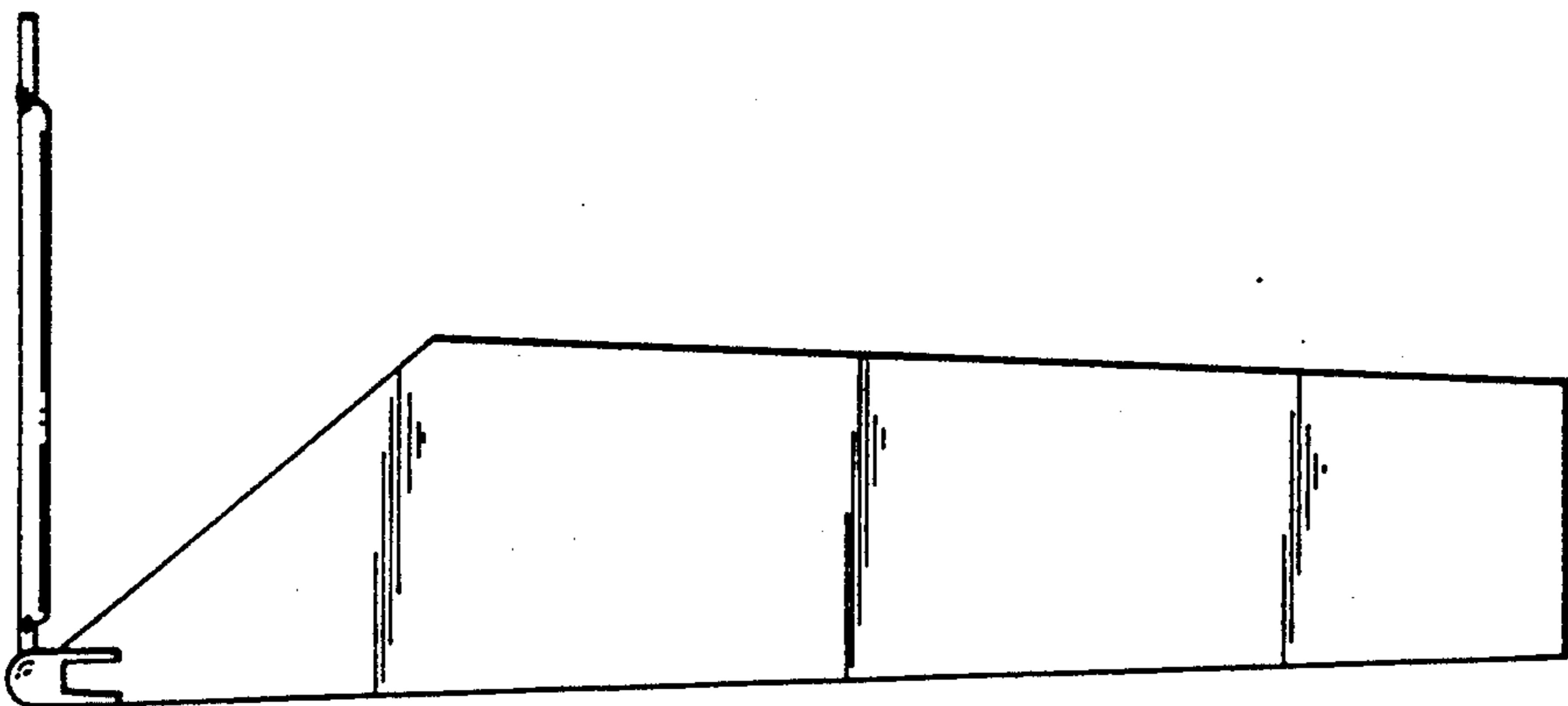

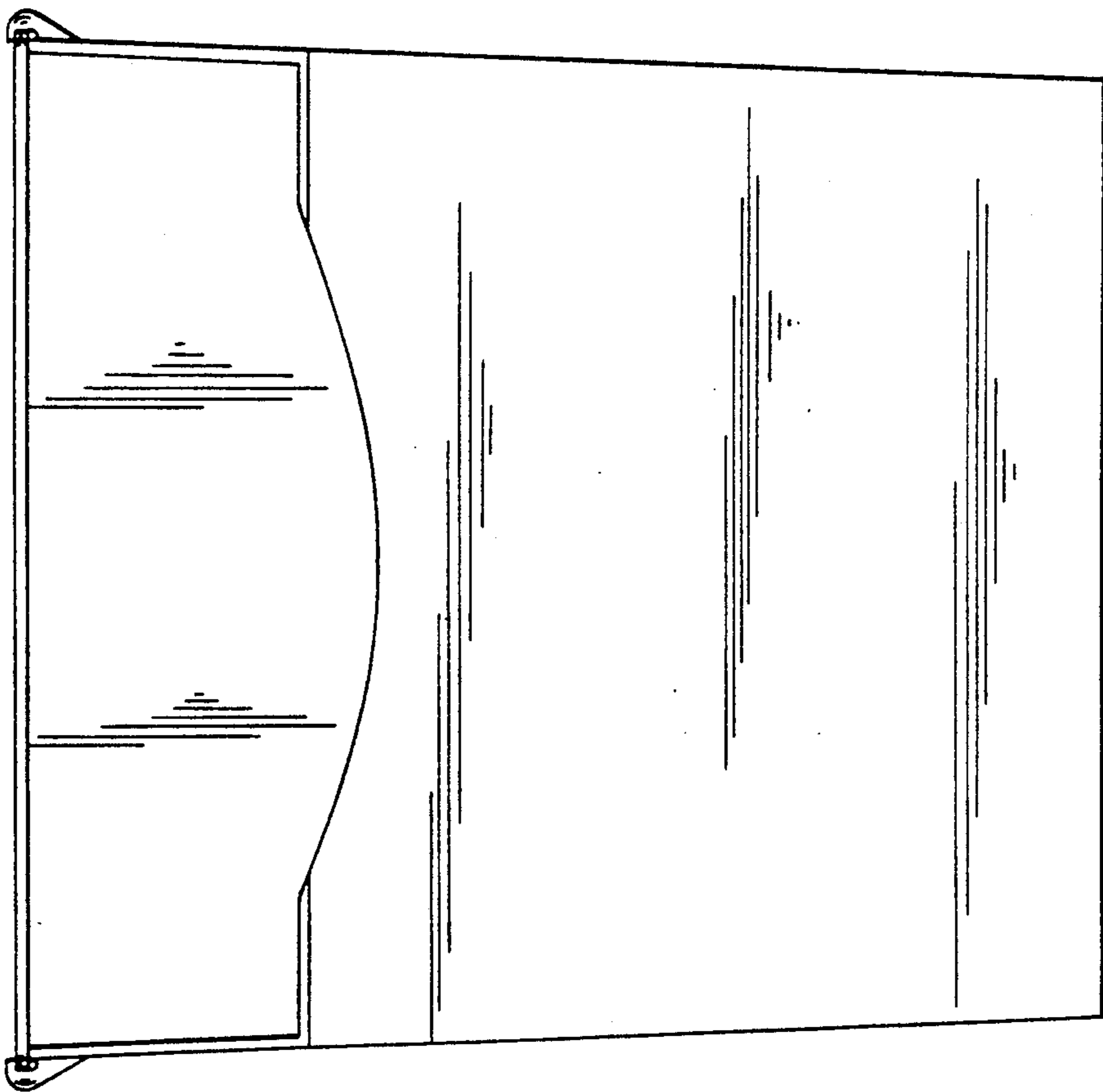
