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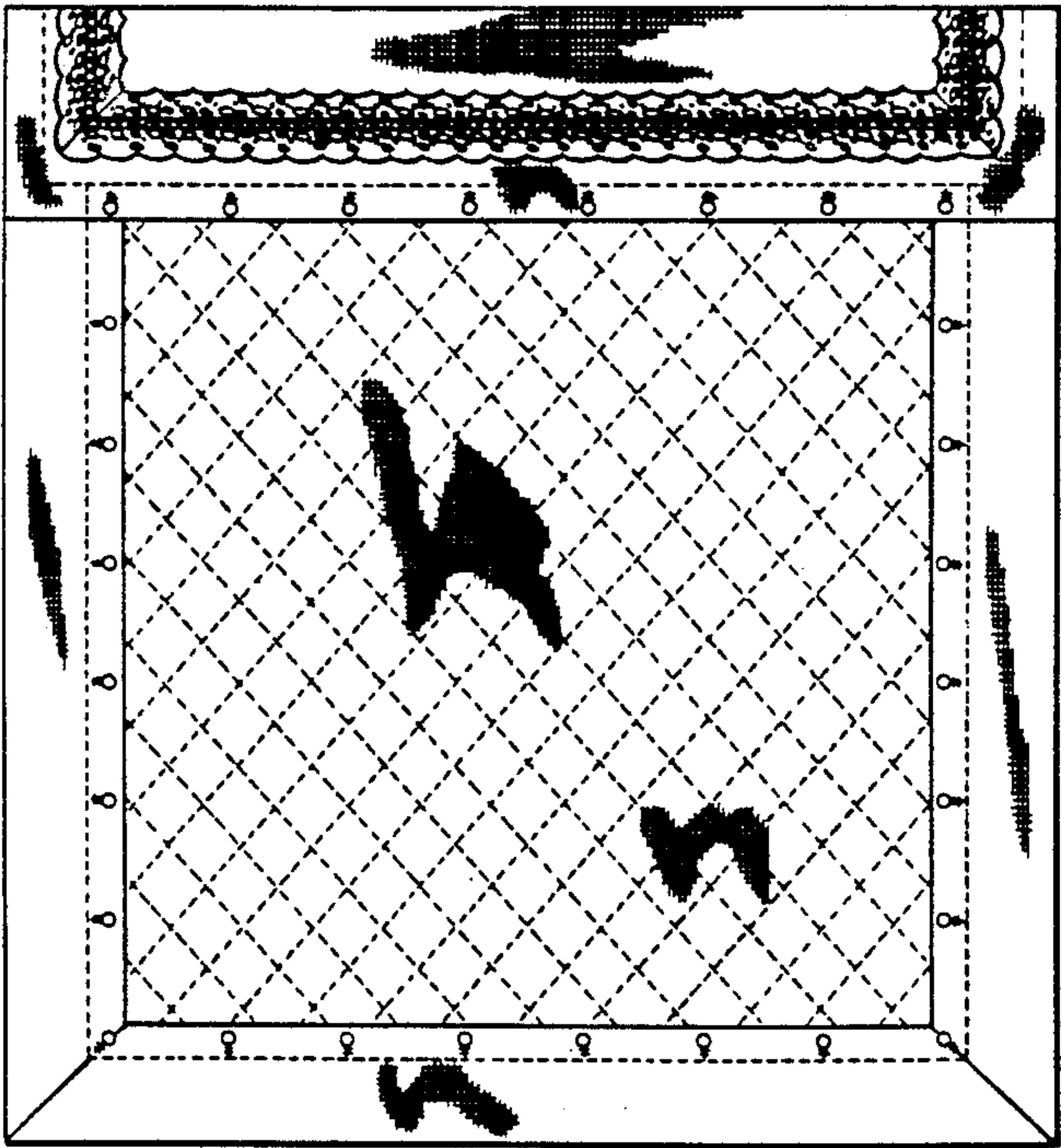

The ornamental design for the sheet for a comforter or blanket, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a sheet for a comforter or blanket showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is an end elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is an opposite end elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is an opposite side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The cross-hatching is intended to represent conventional fabric, and is understood to cover the entire surfaces on which it is shown.



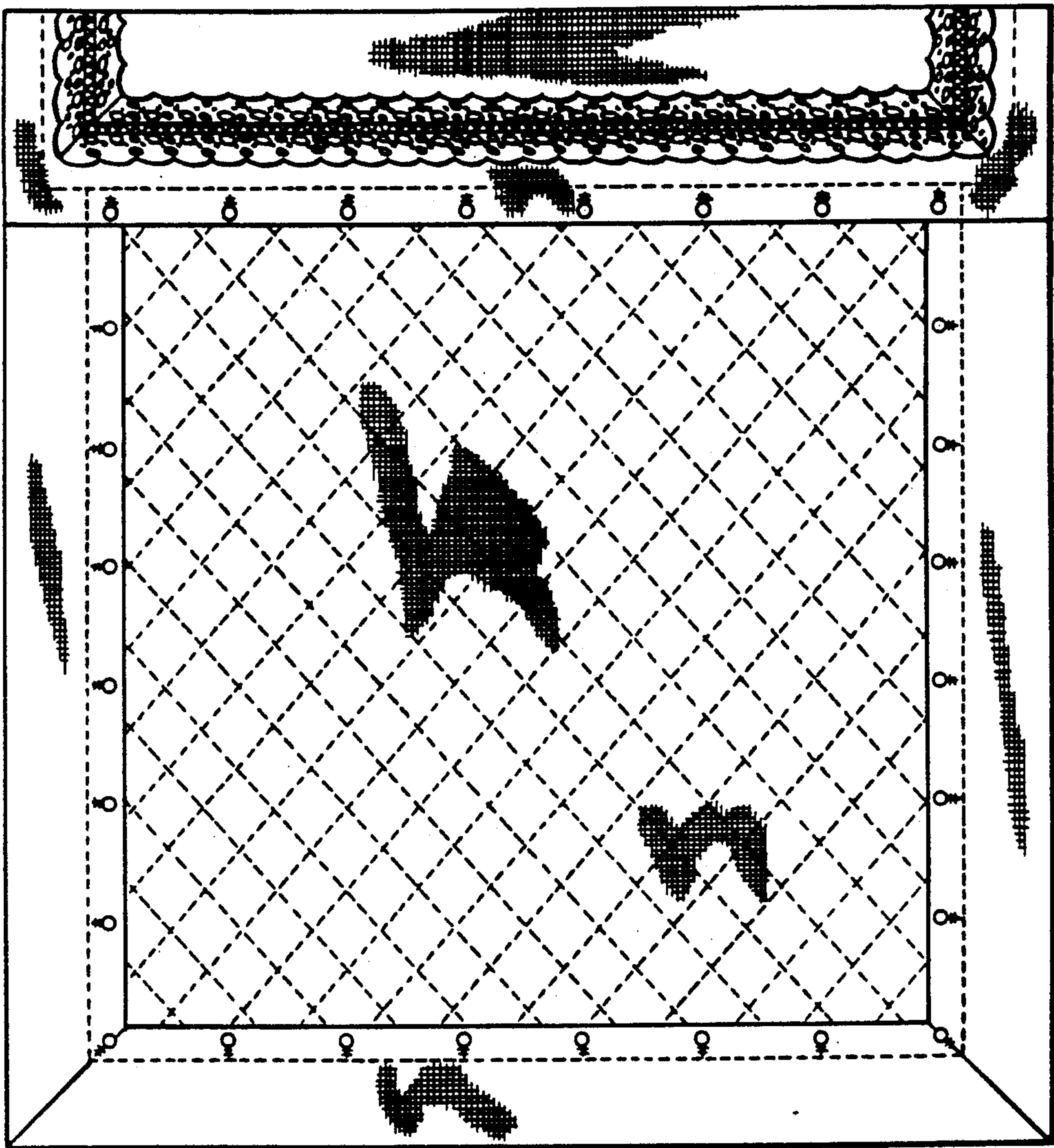
