FIG. 2 is a left-hand side elevational view thereof;

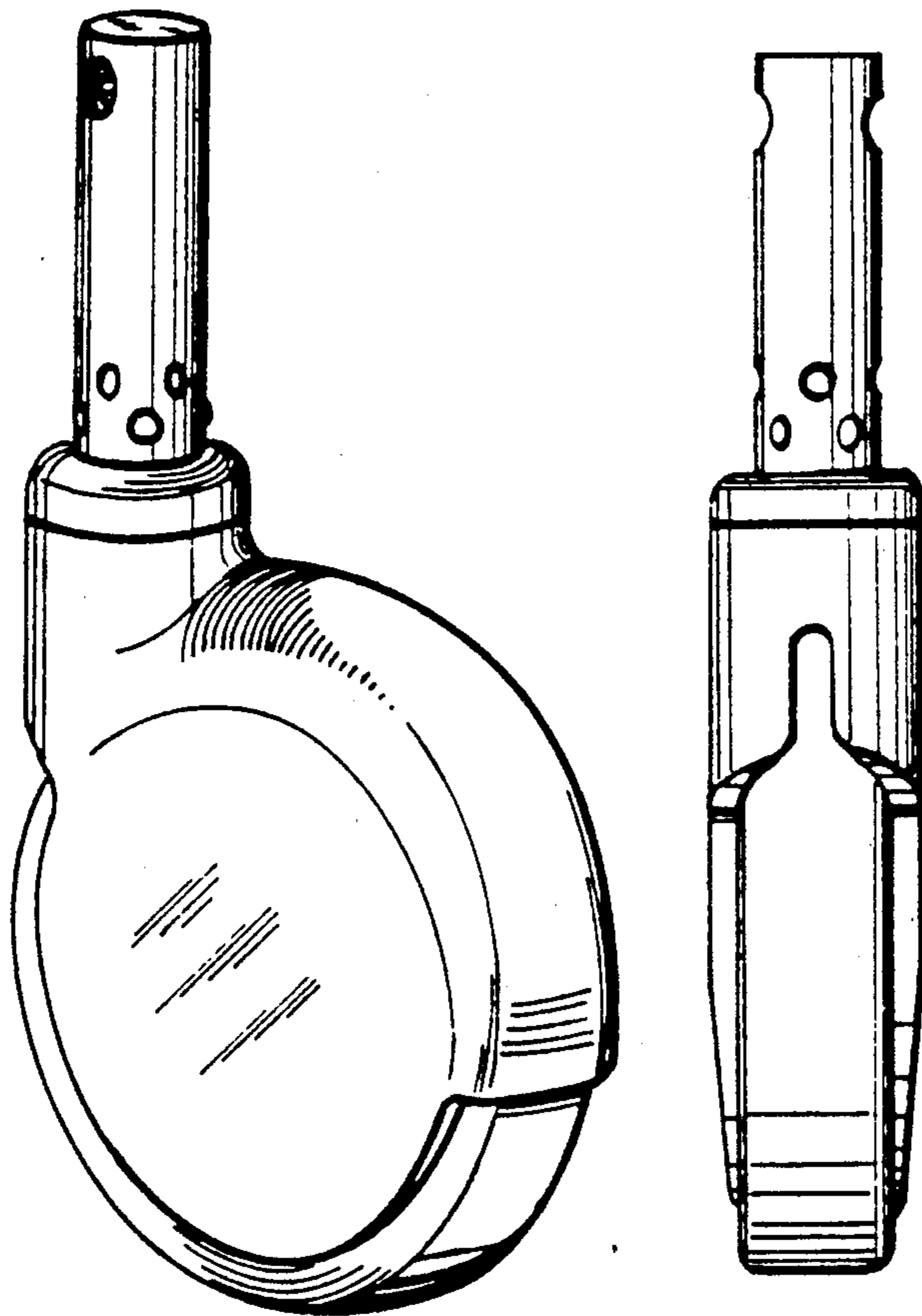
FIG. 3 is a rear-elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof.



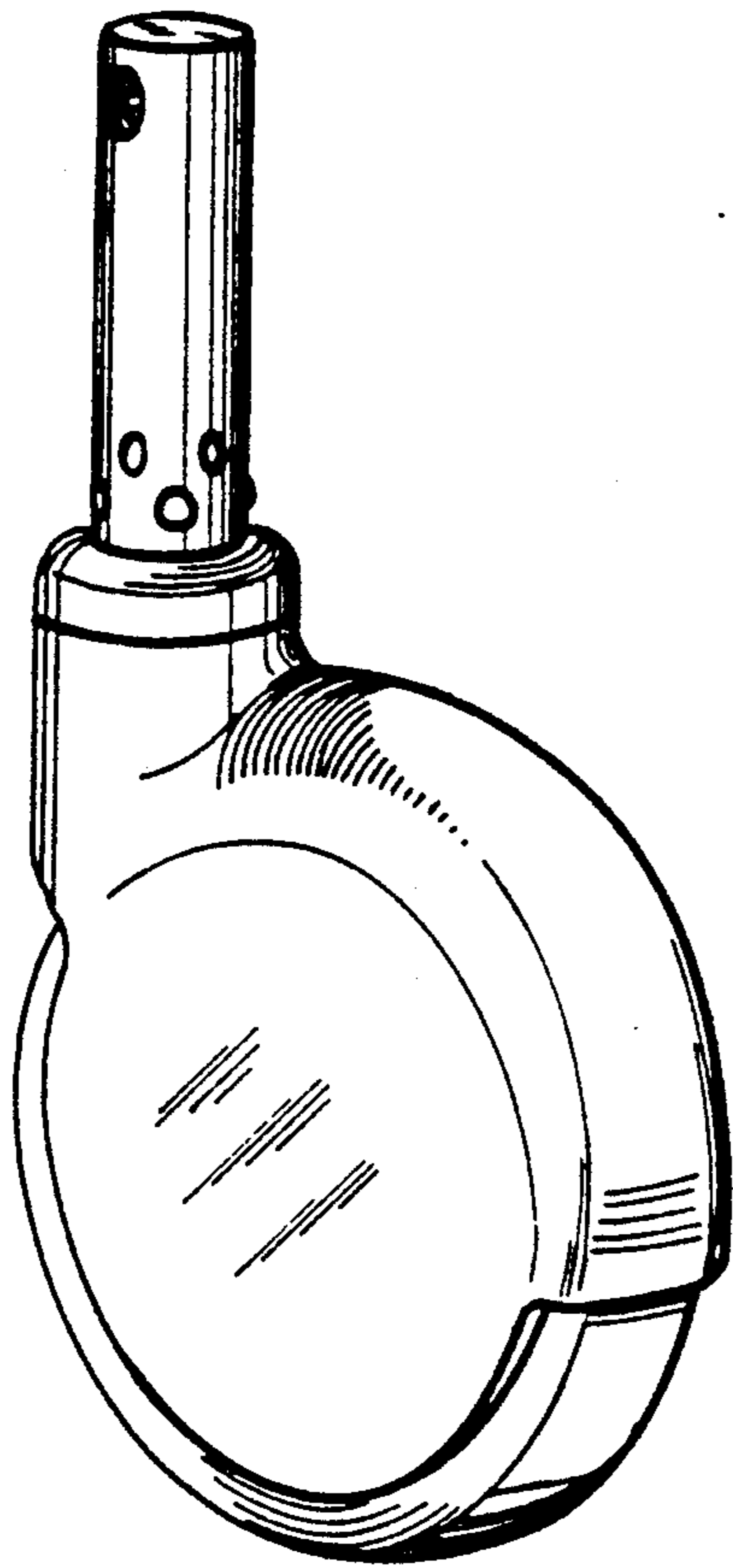

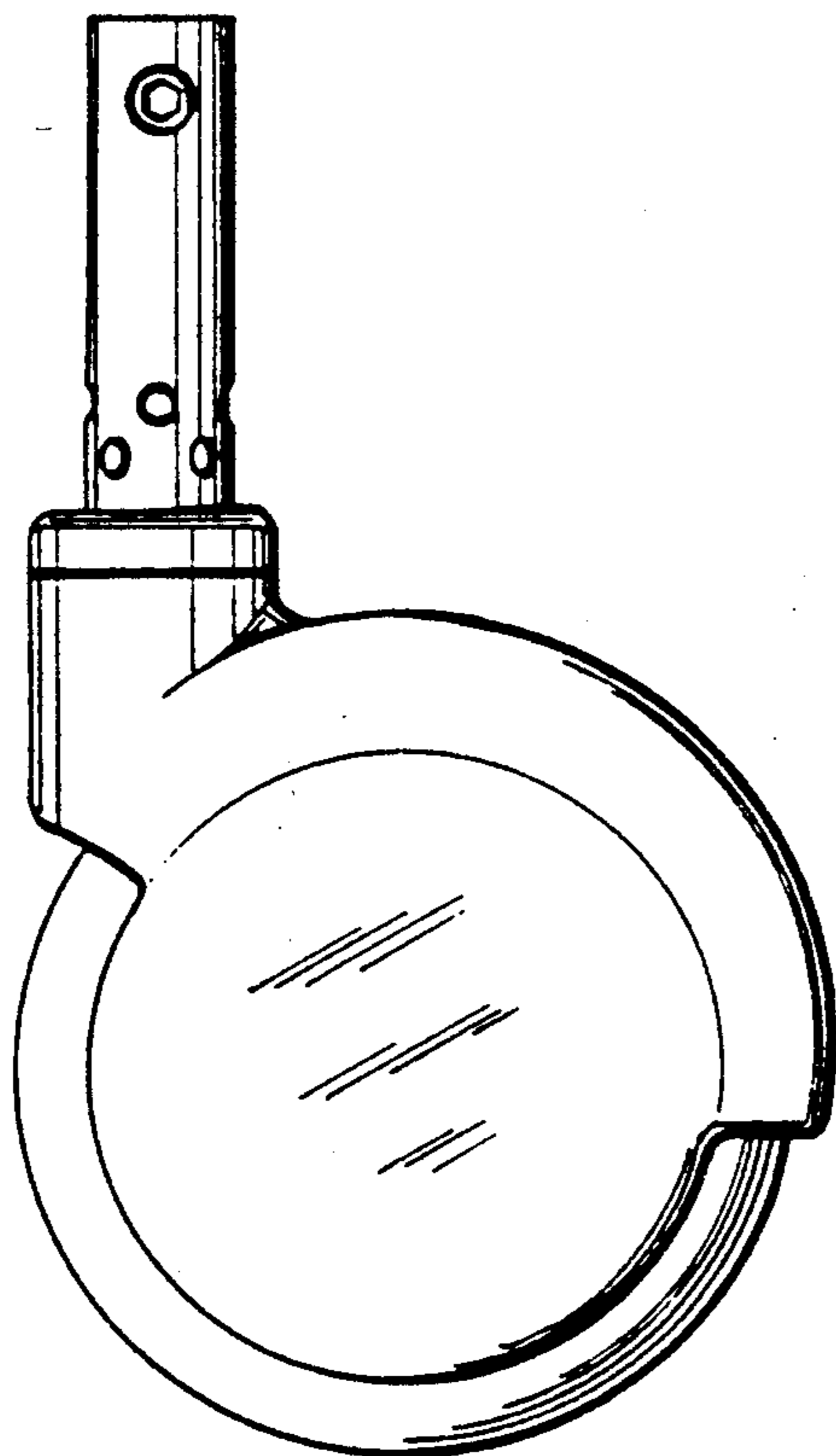

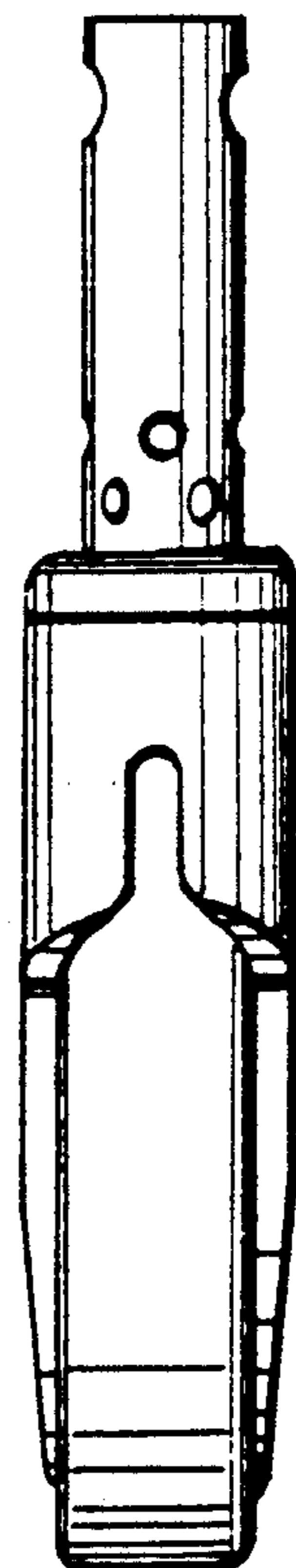

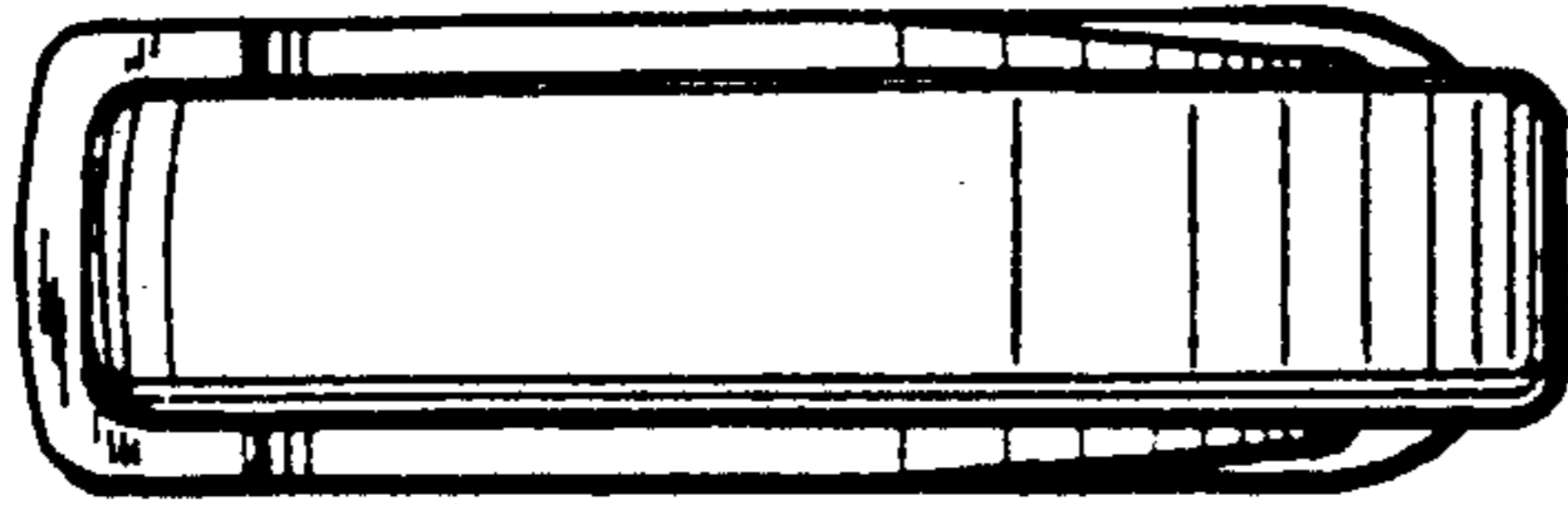

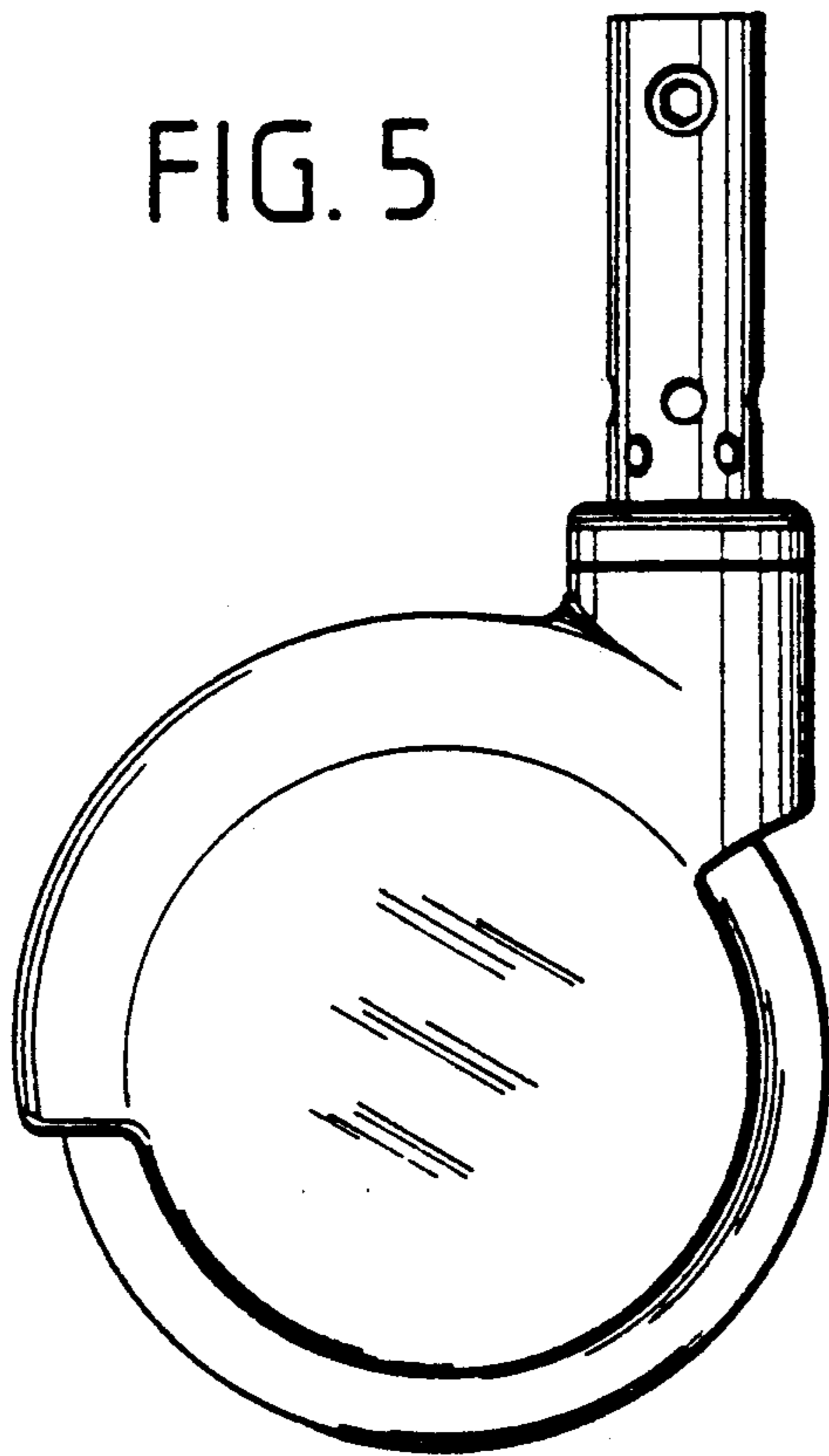

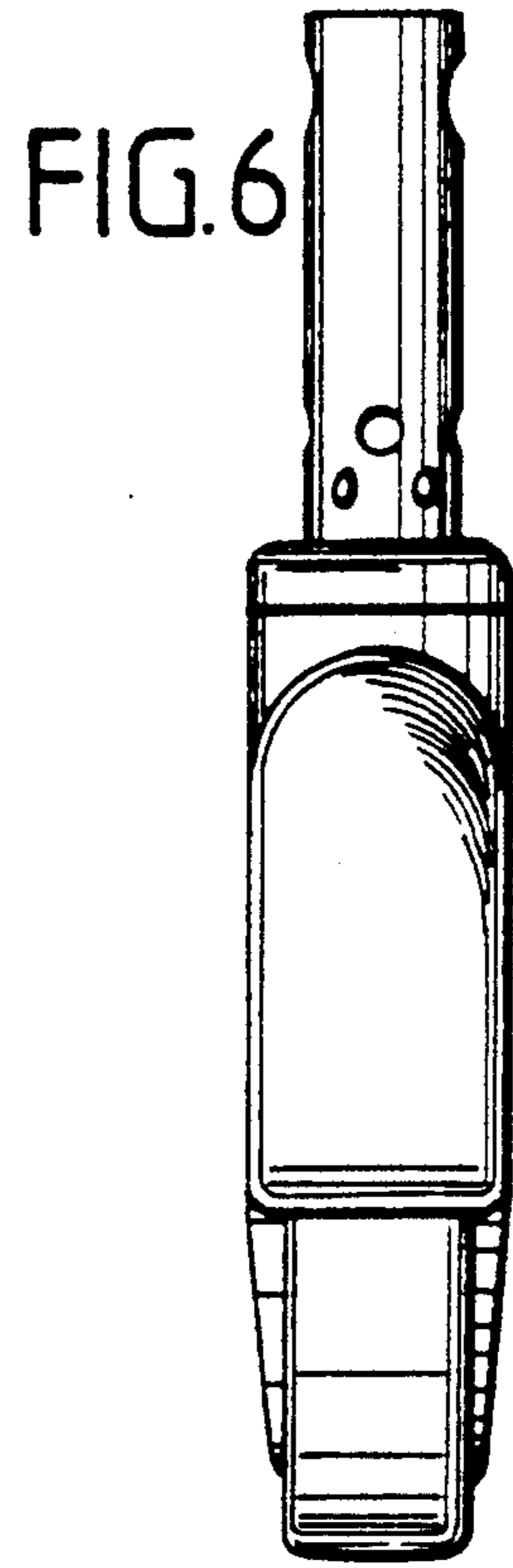
