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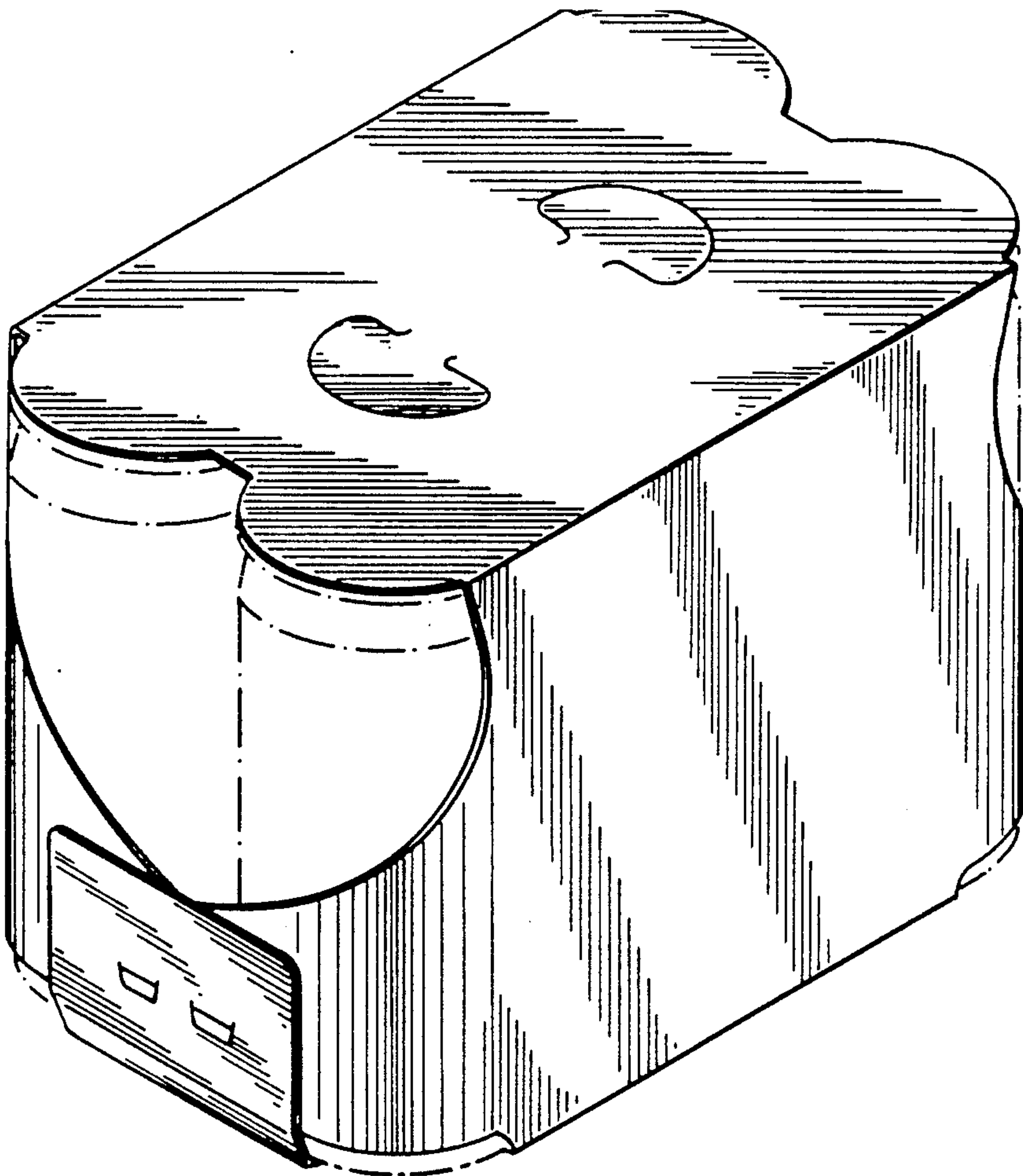

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a beverage can carrier showing our new design, the cans shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, opposite side bring a mirror image; and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



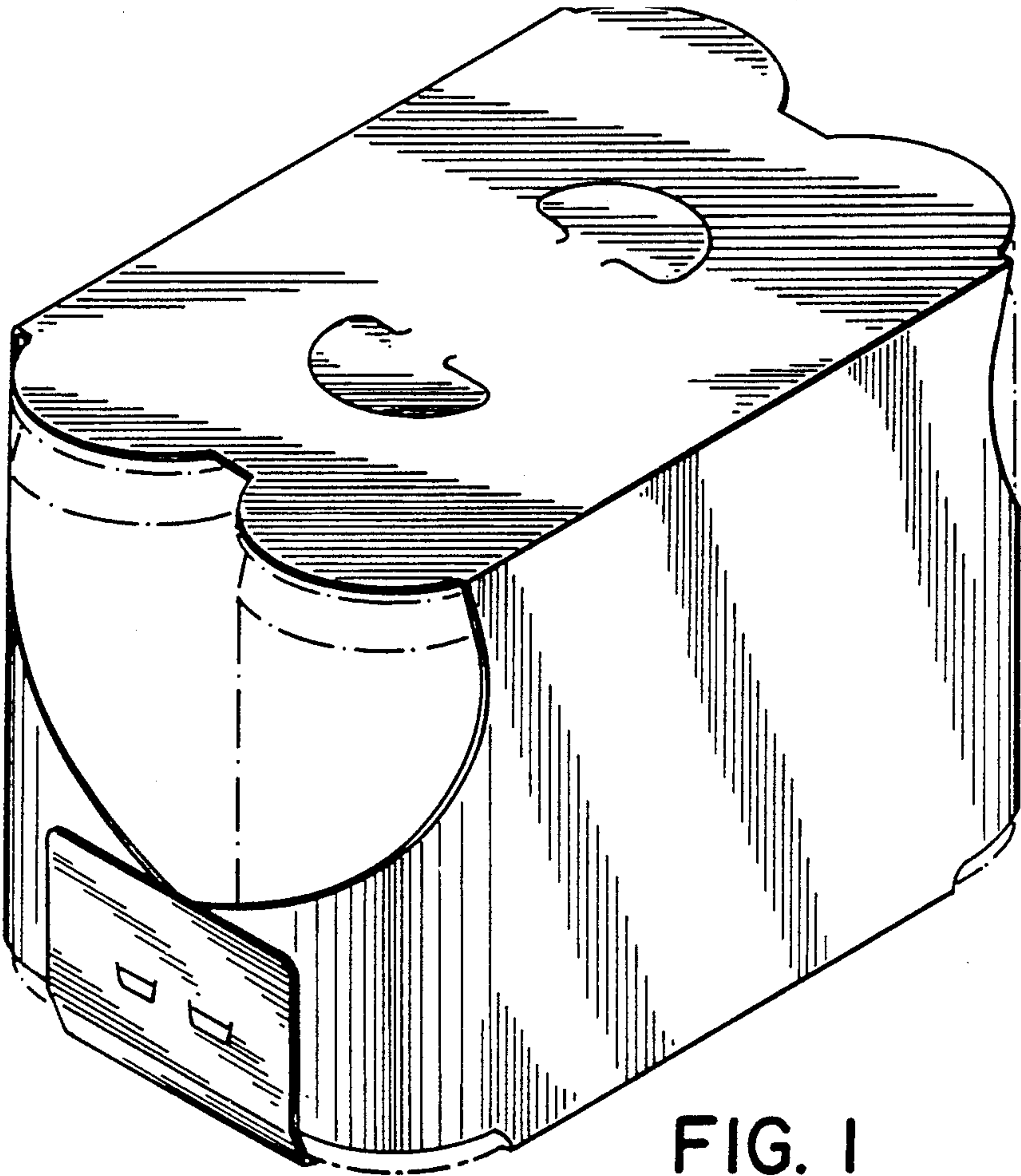

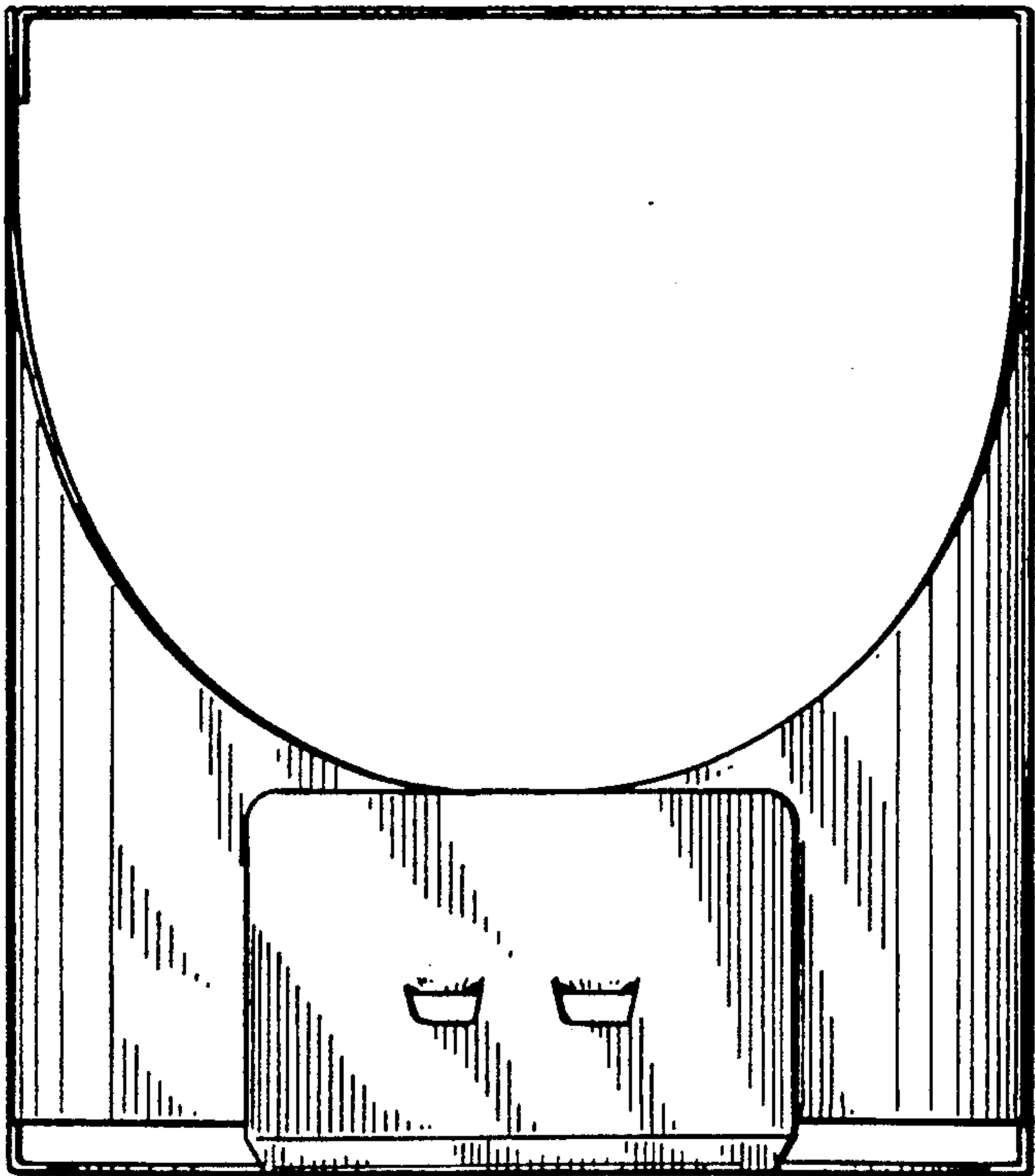

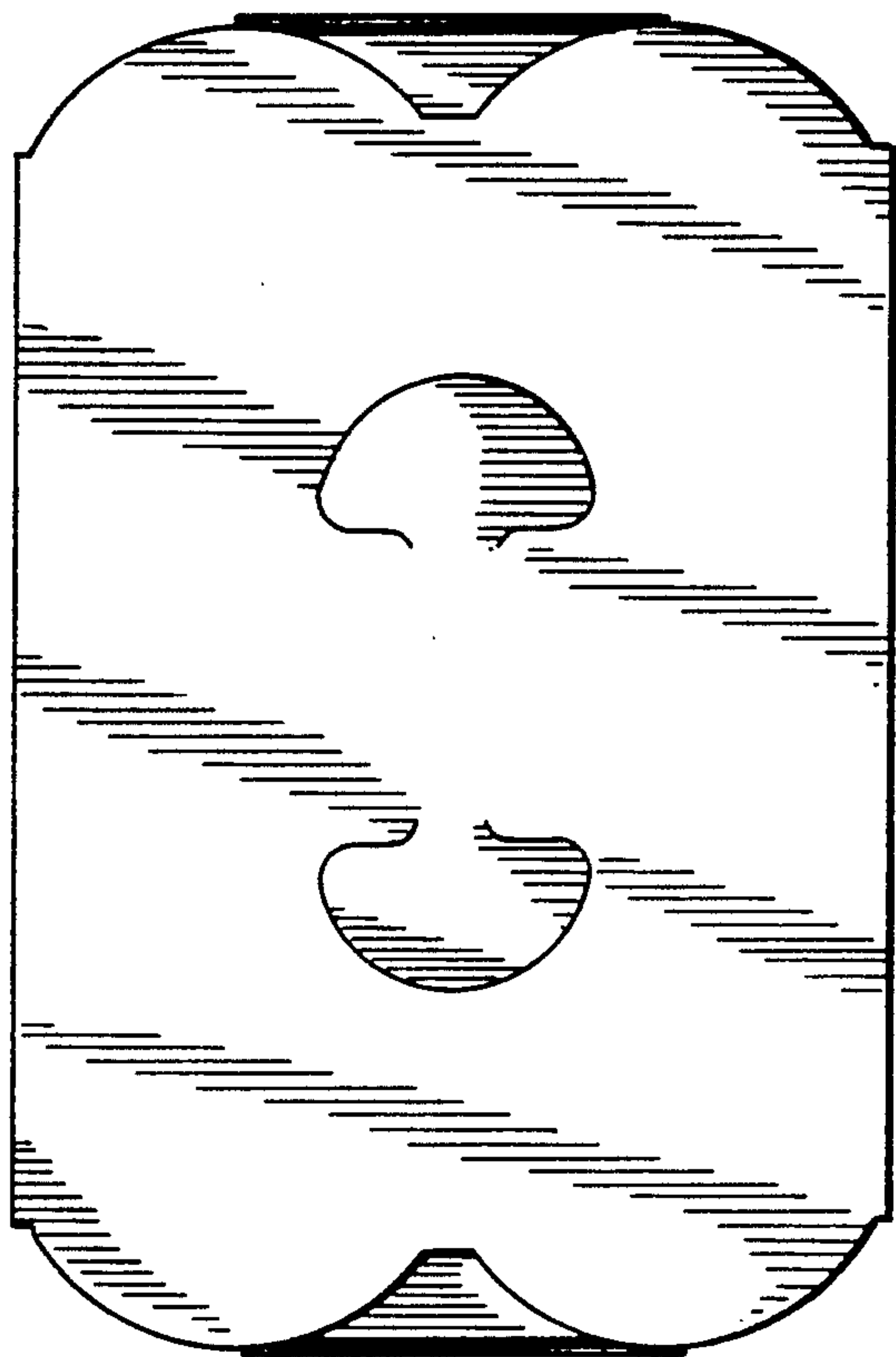

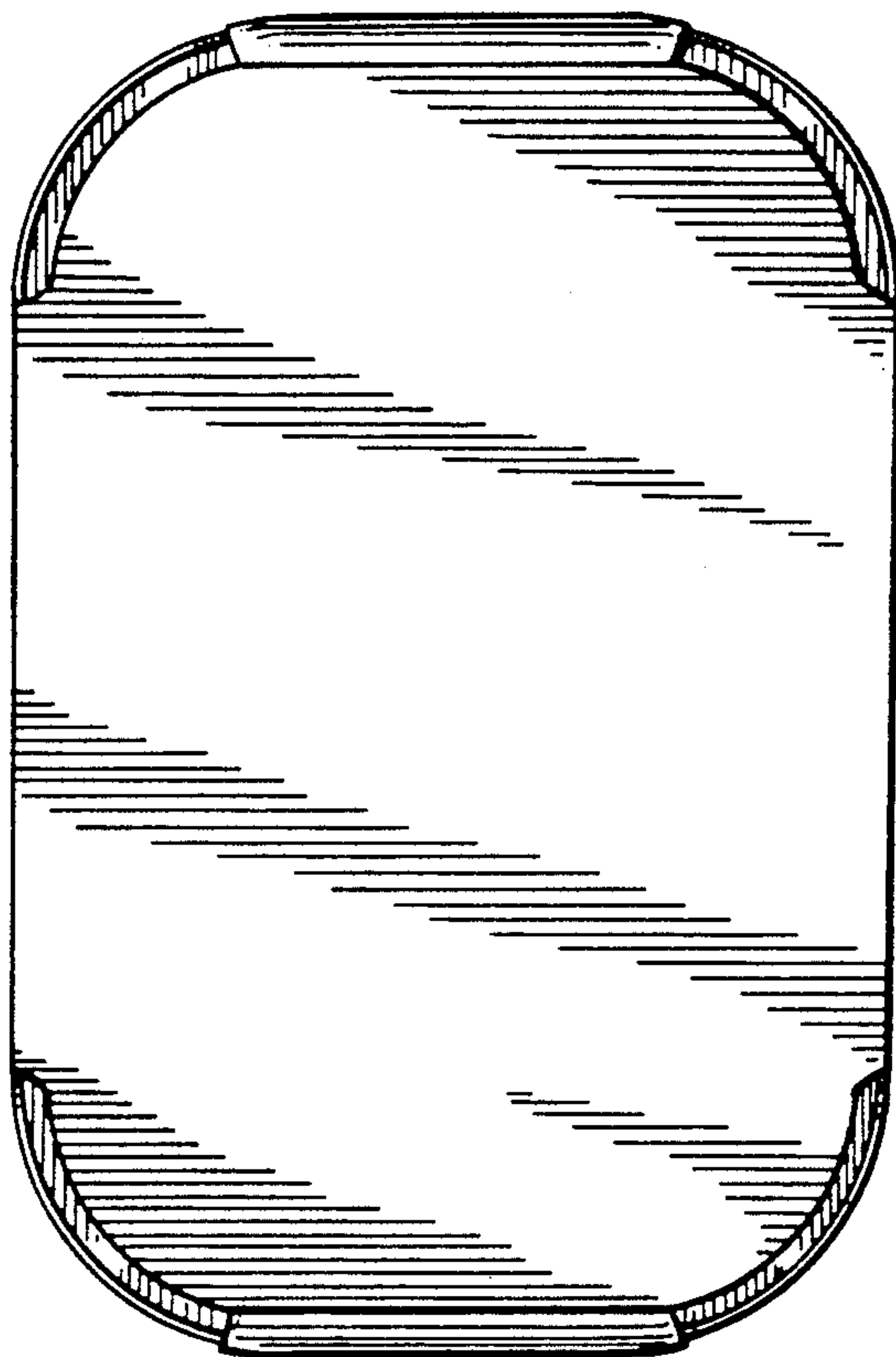

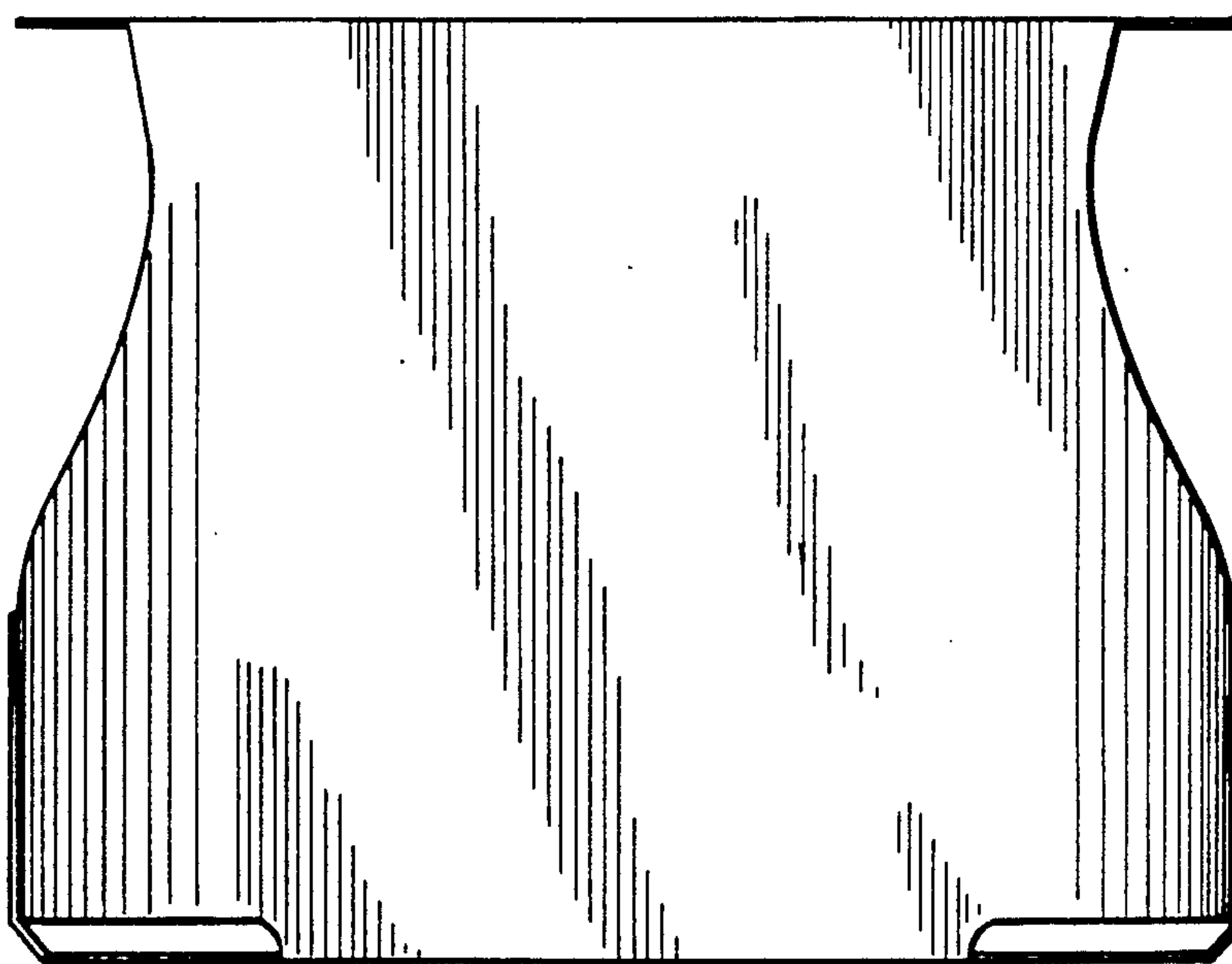
