The ornamental design for a catamaran yacht, as shown and described.

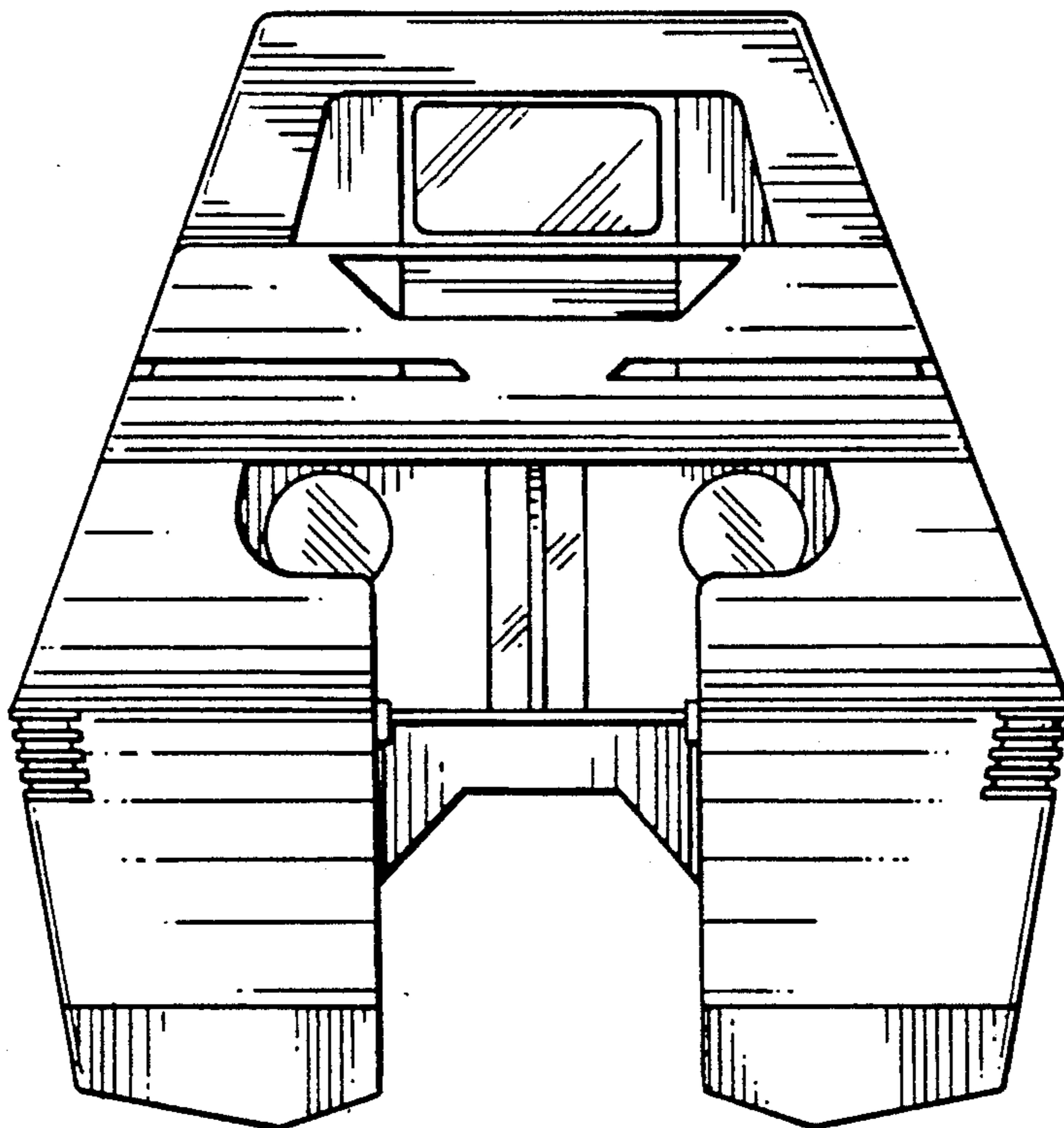
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a catamaran yacht showing my new design, the right side elevational view being a mirror image of that shown;

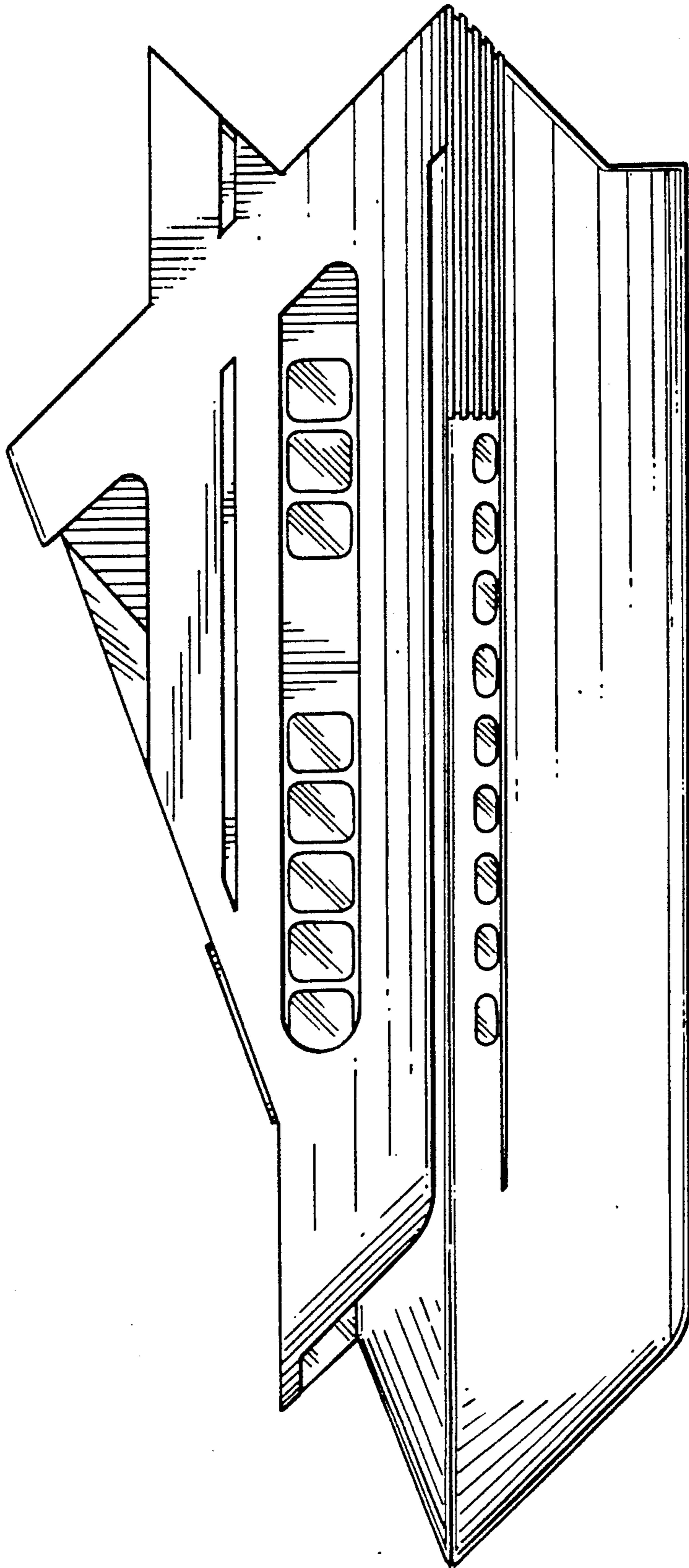

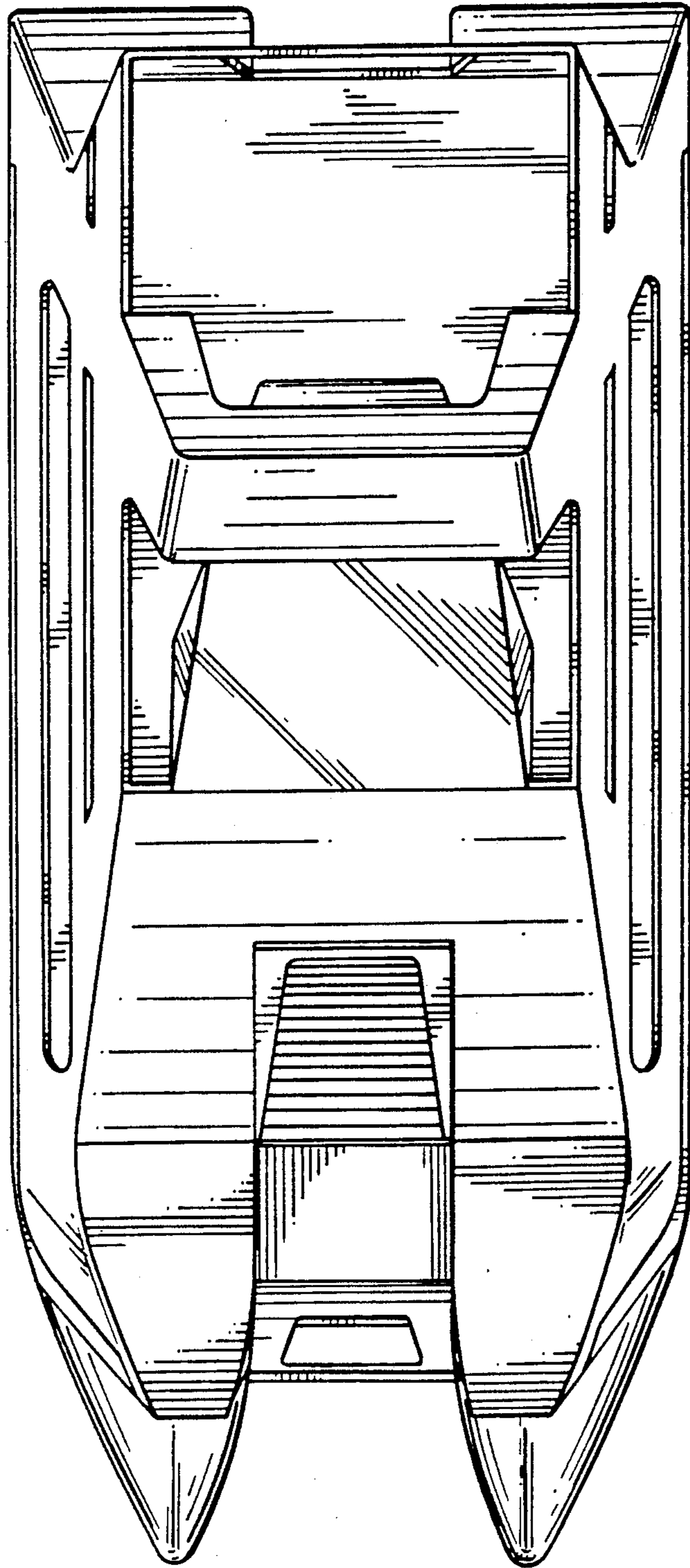

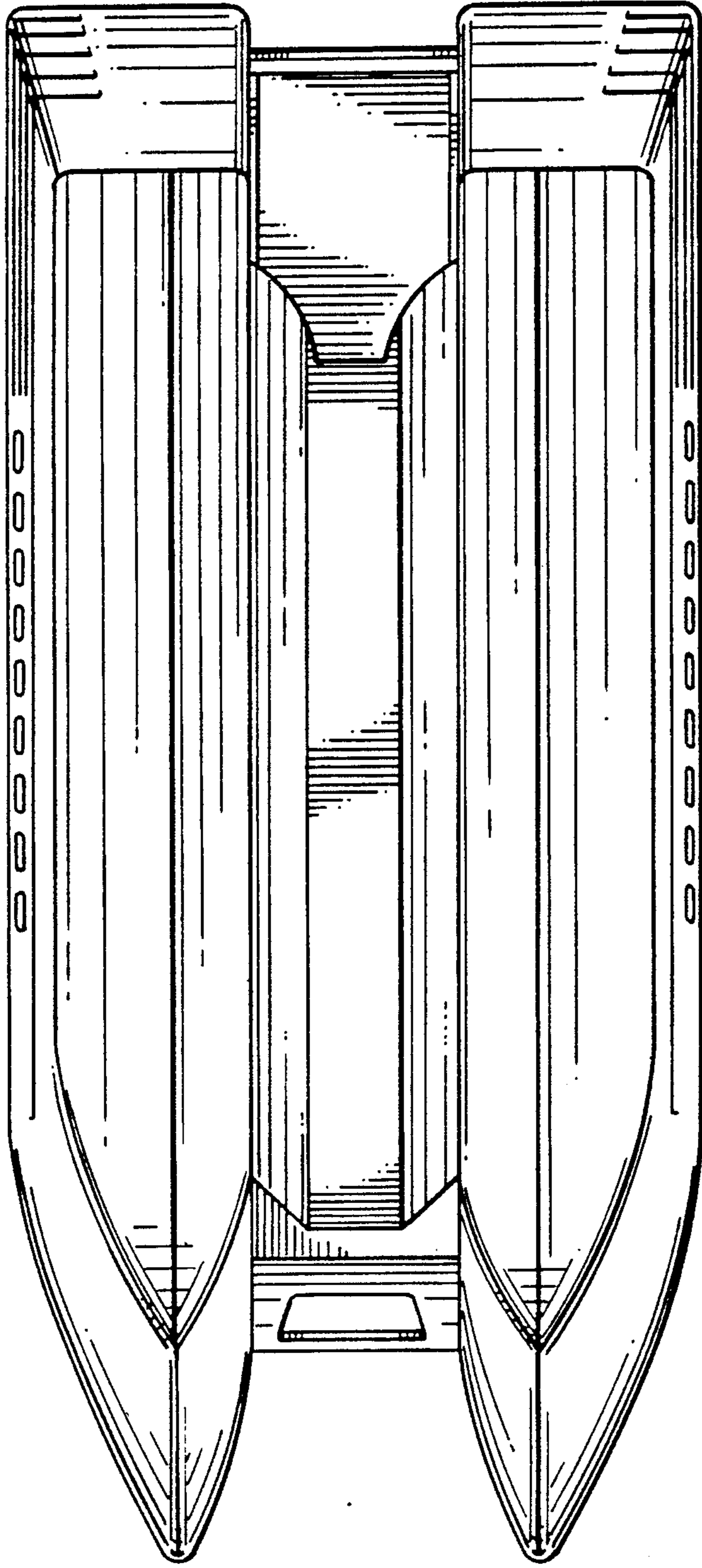

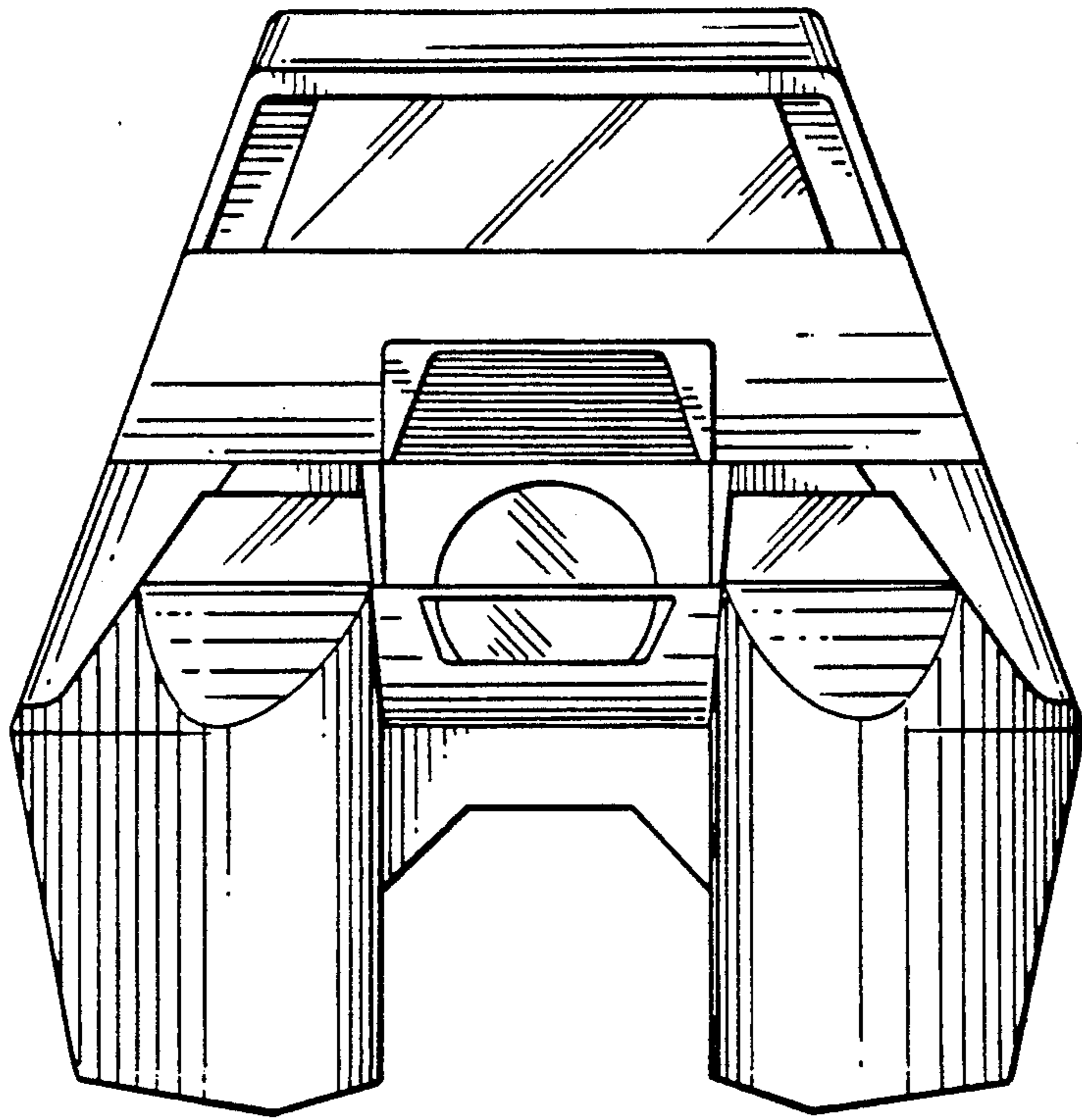

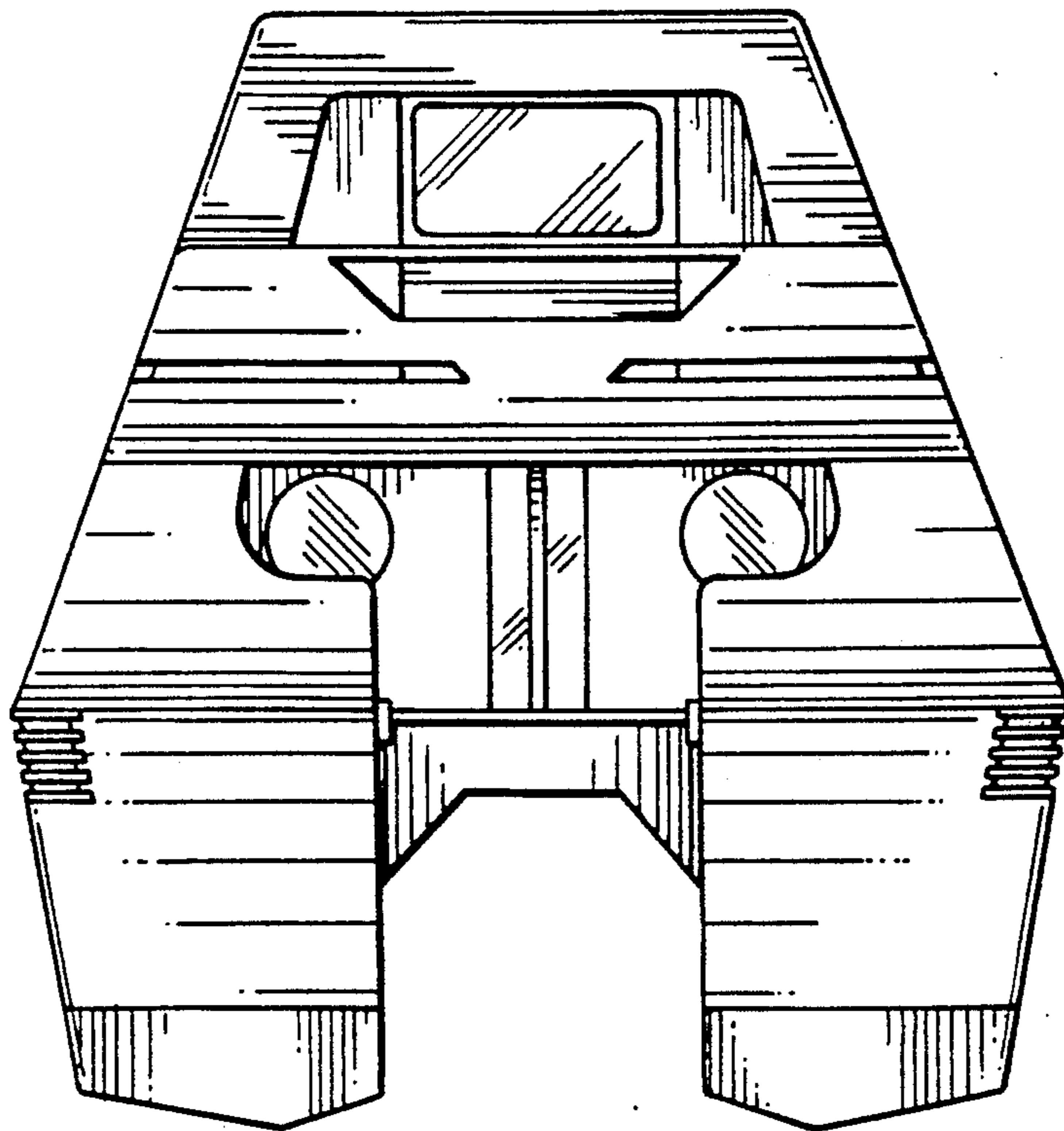

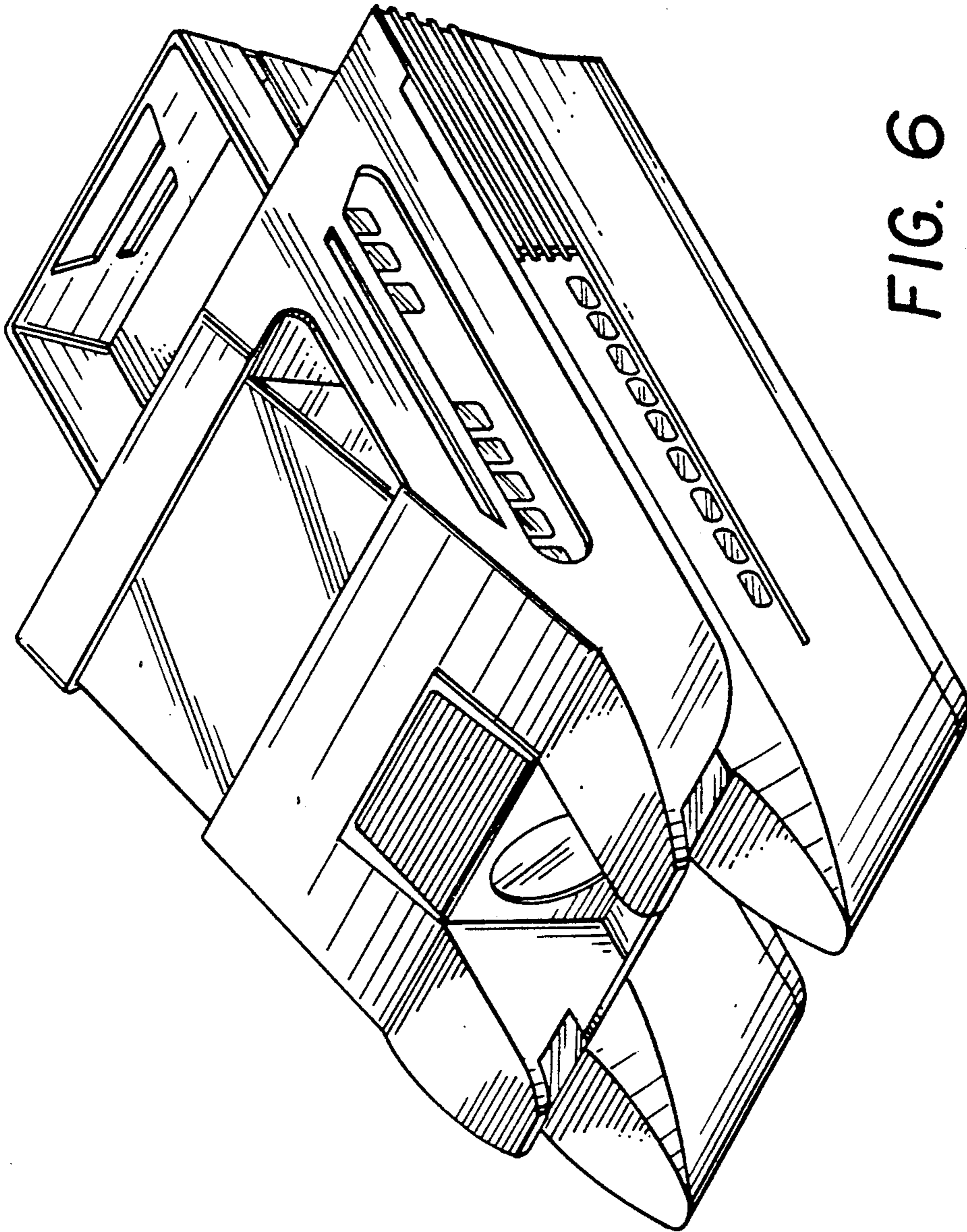
