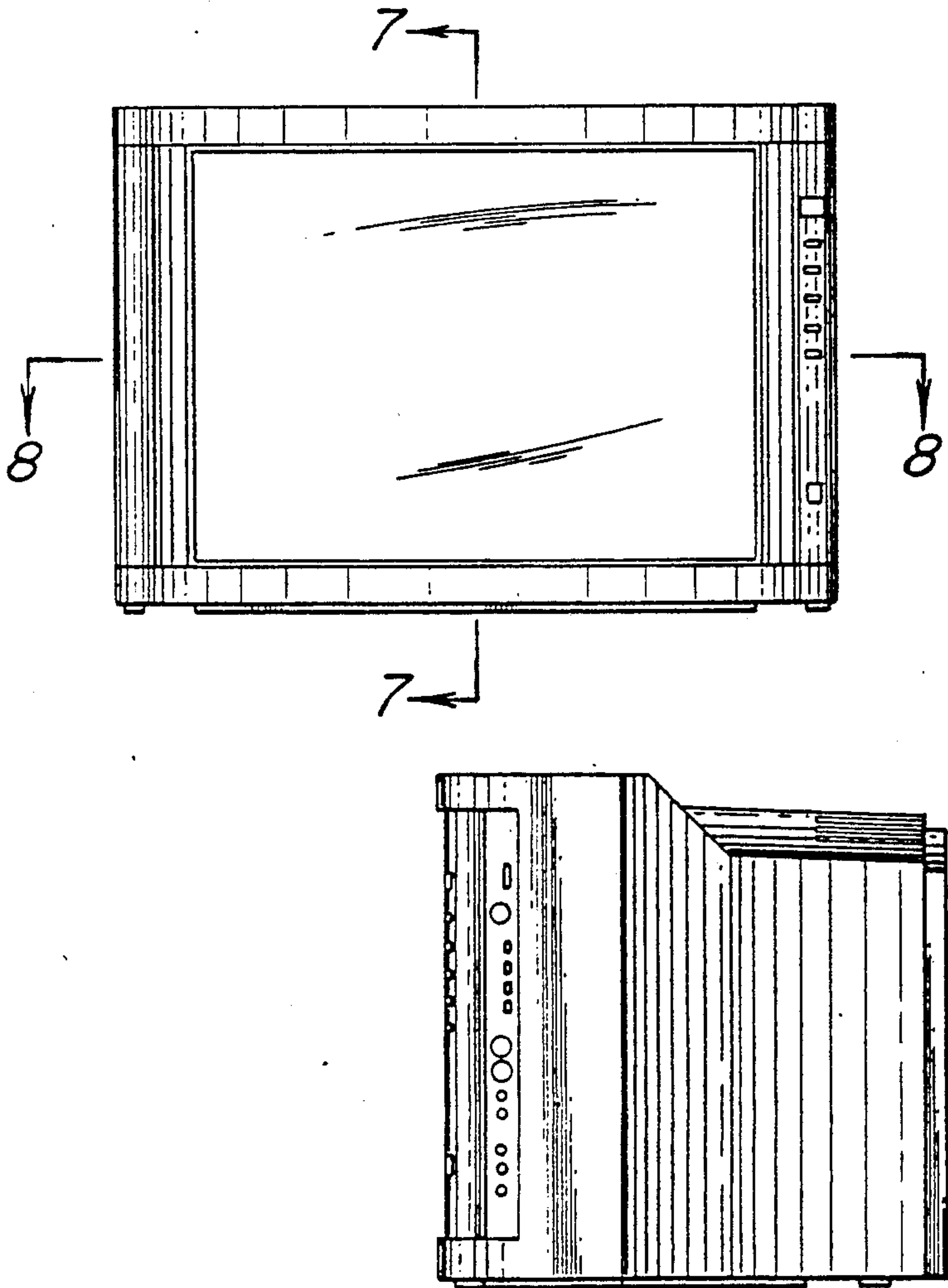

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a television set
showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a sectional view thereof taken along the line
7—7 of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 8 is a sectional view thereof taken along the line
8—8 of FIG. 1.



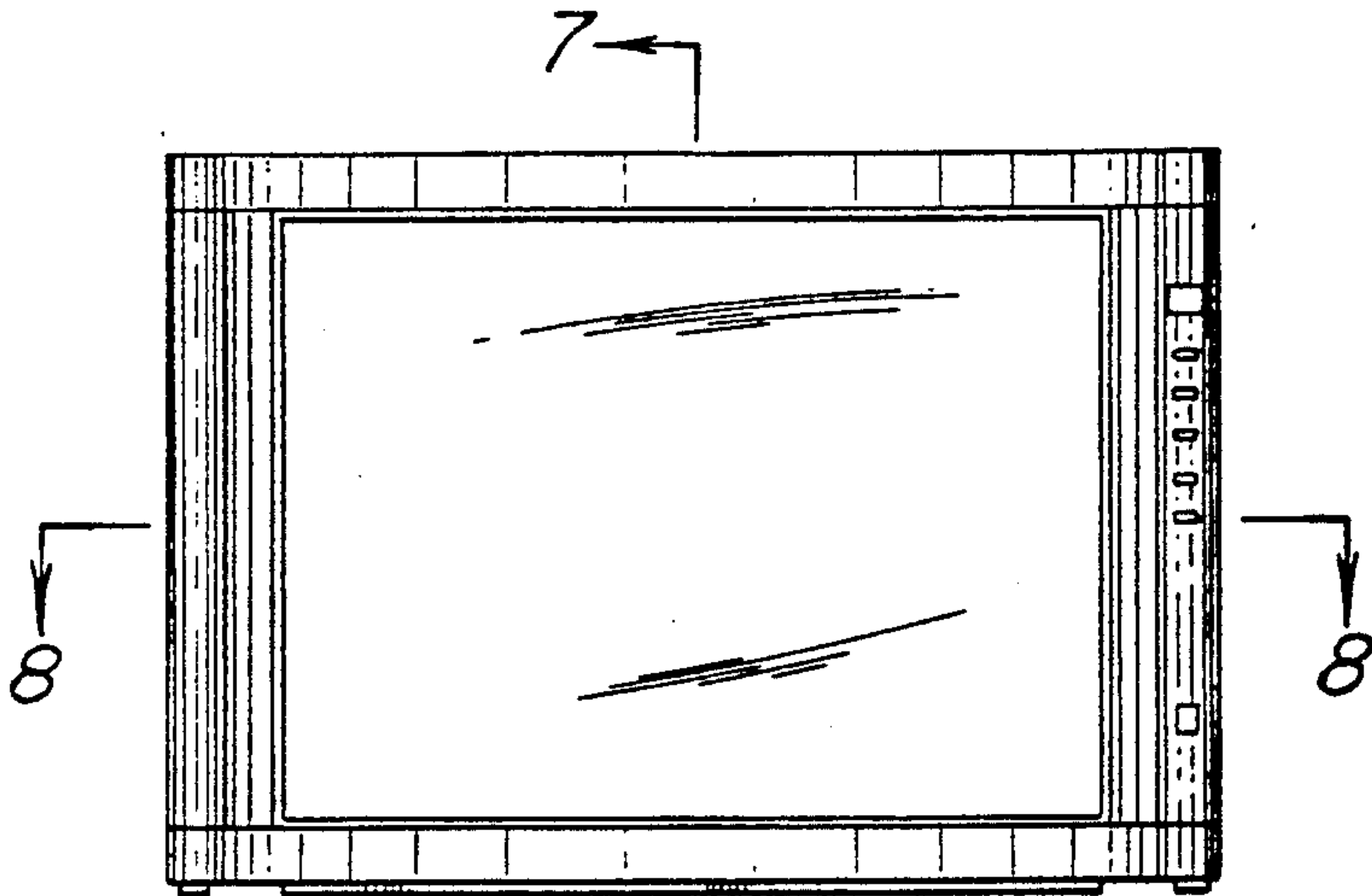

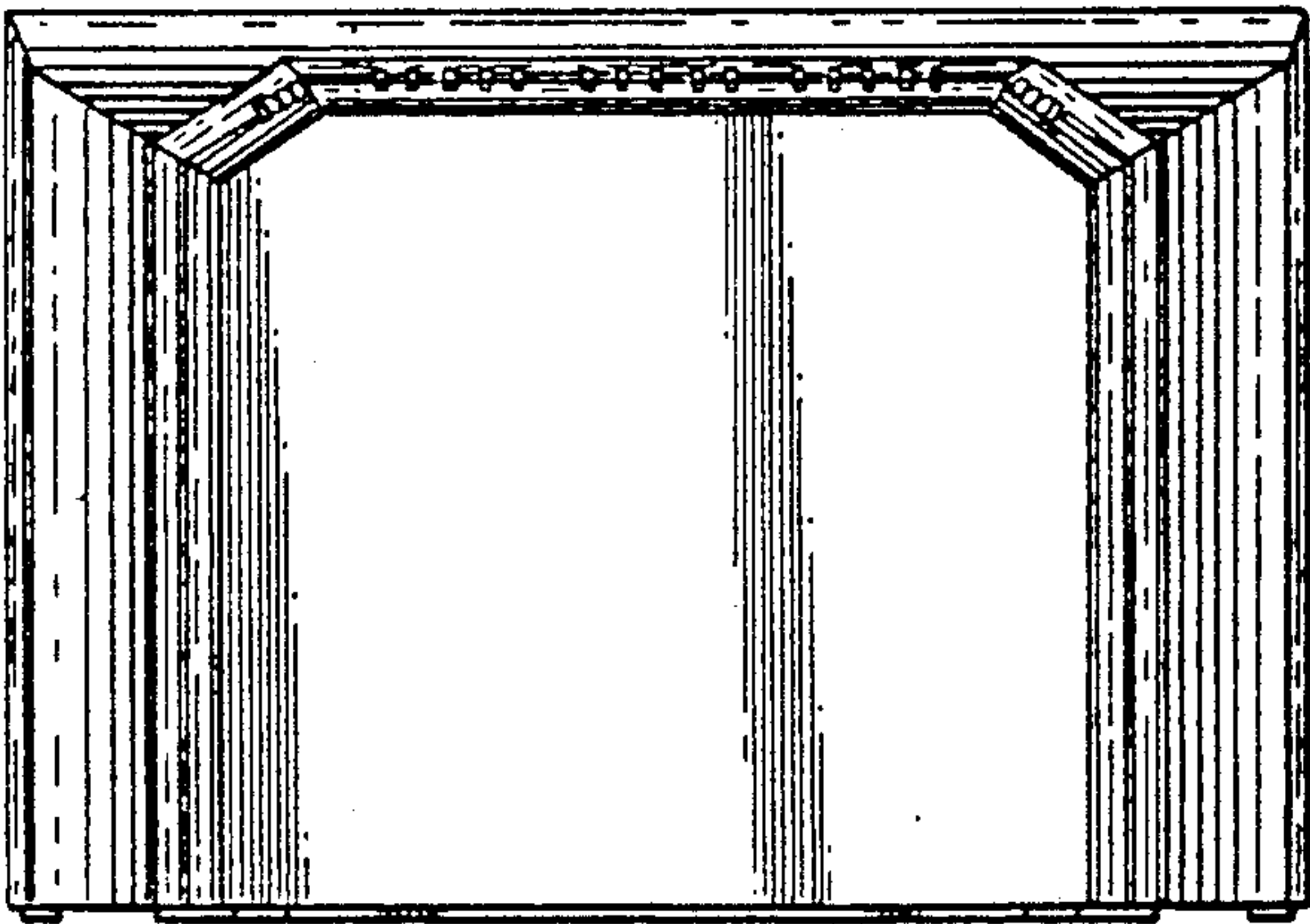

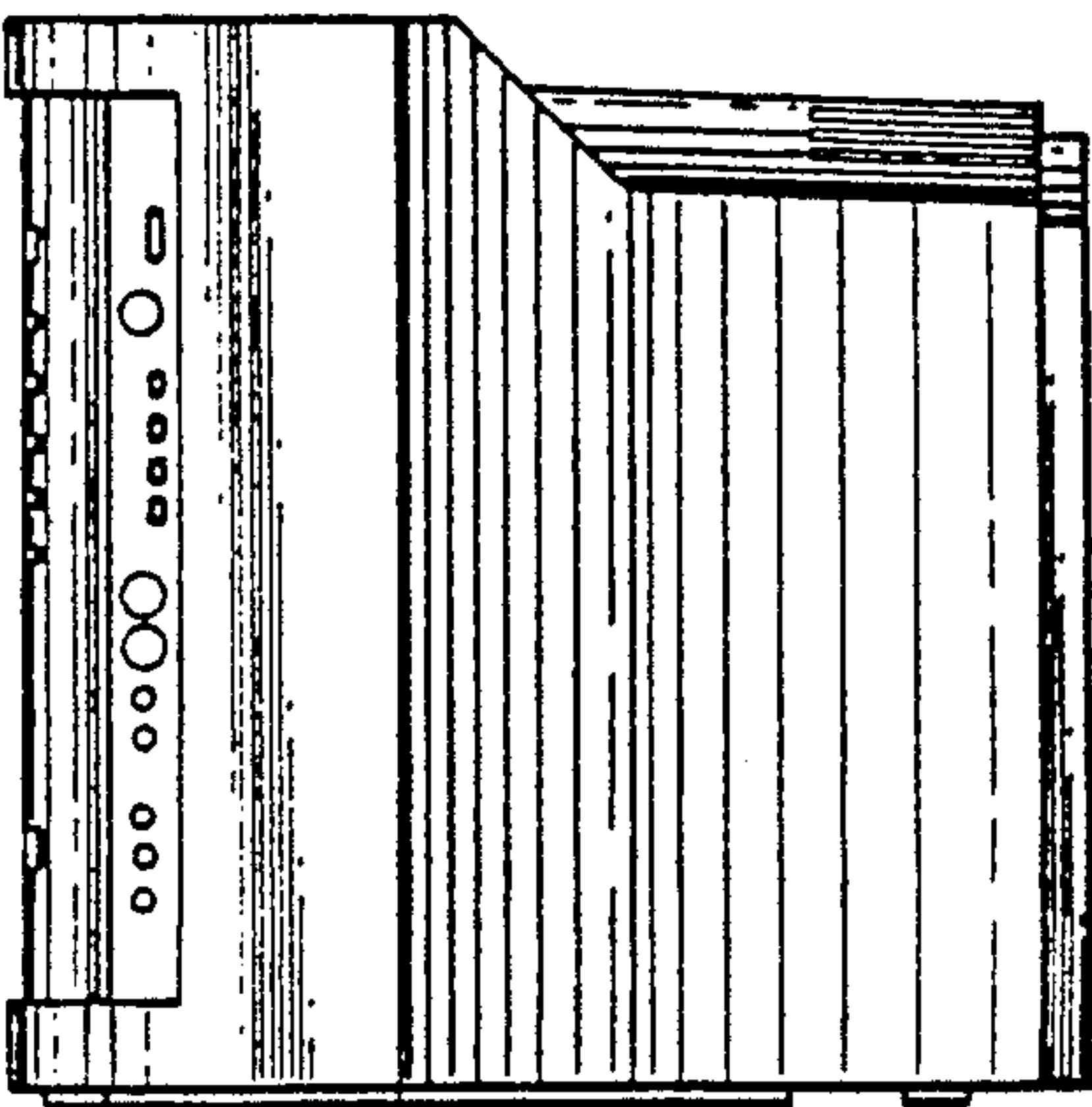

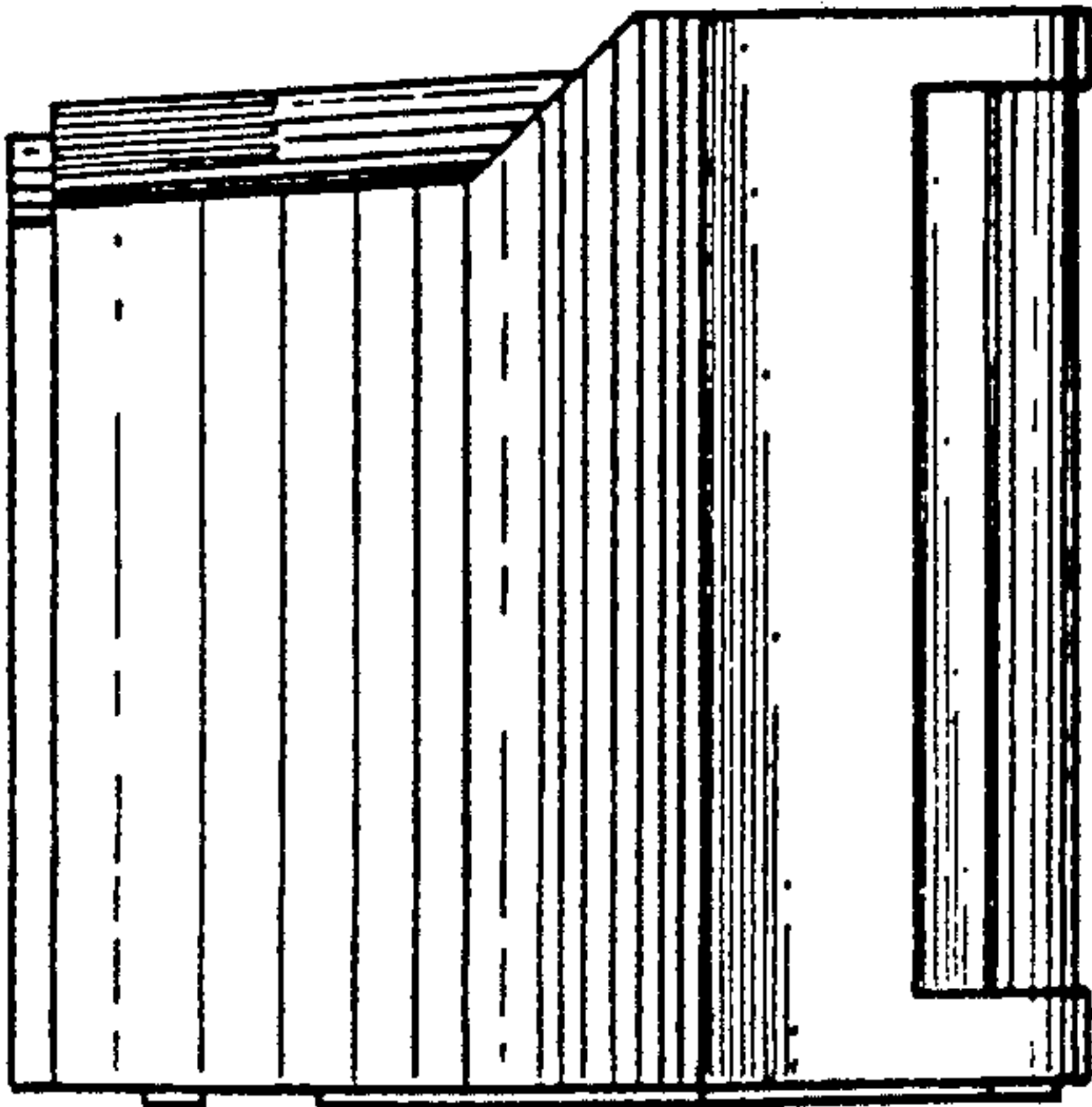

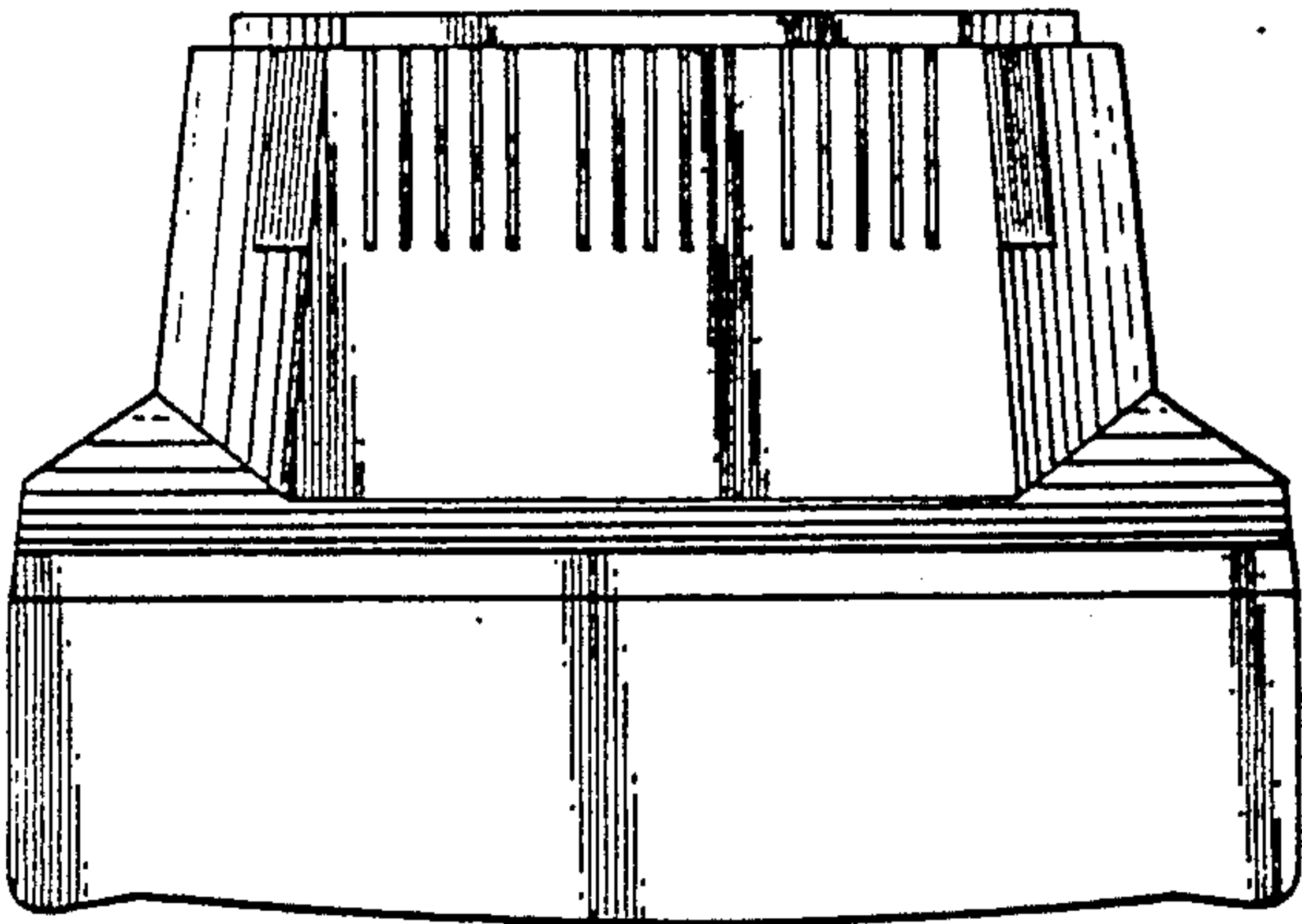

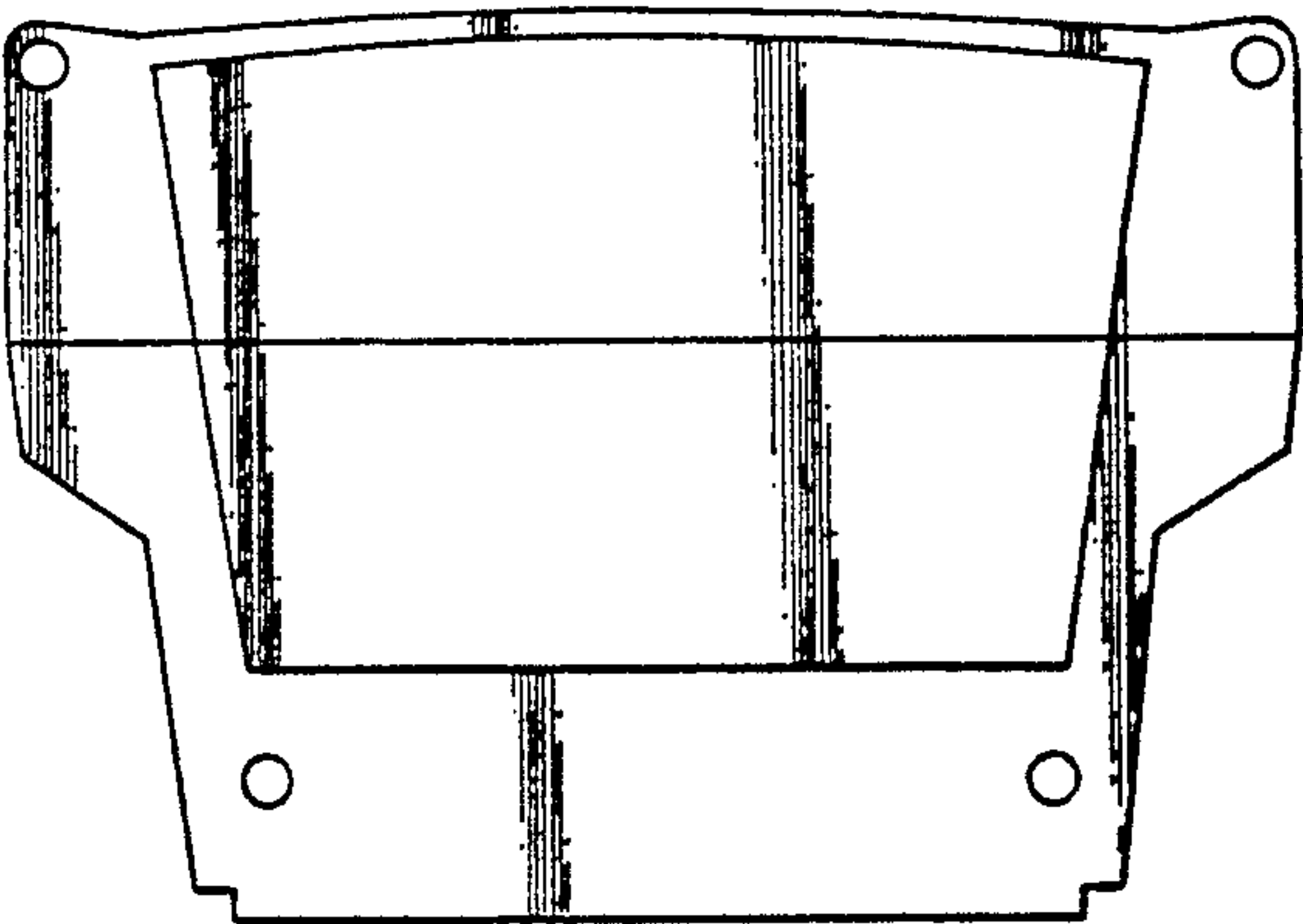

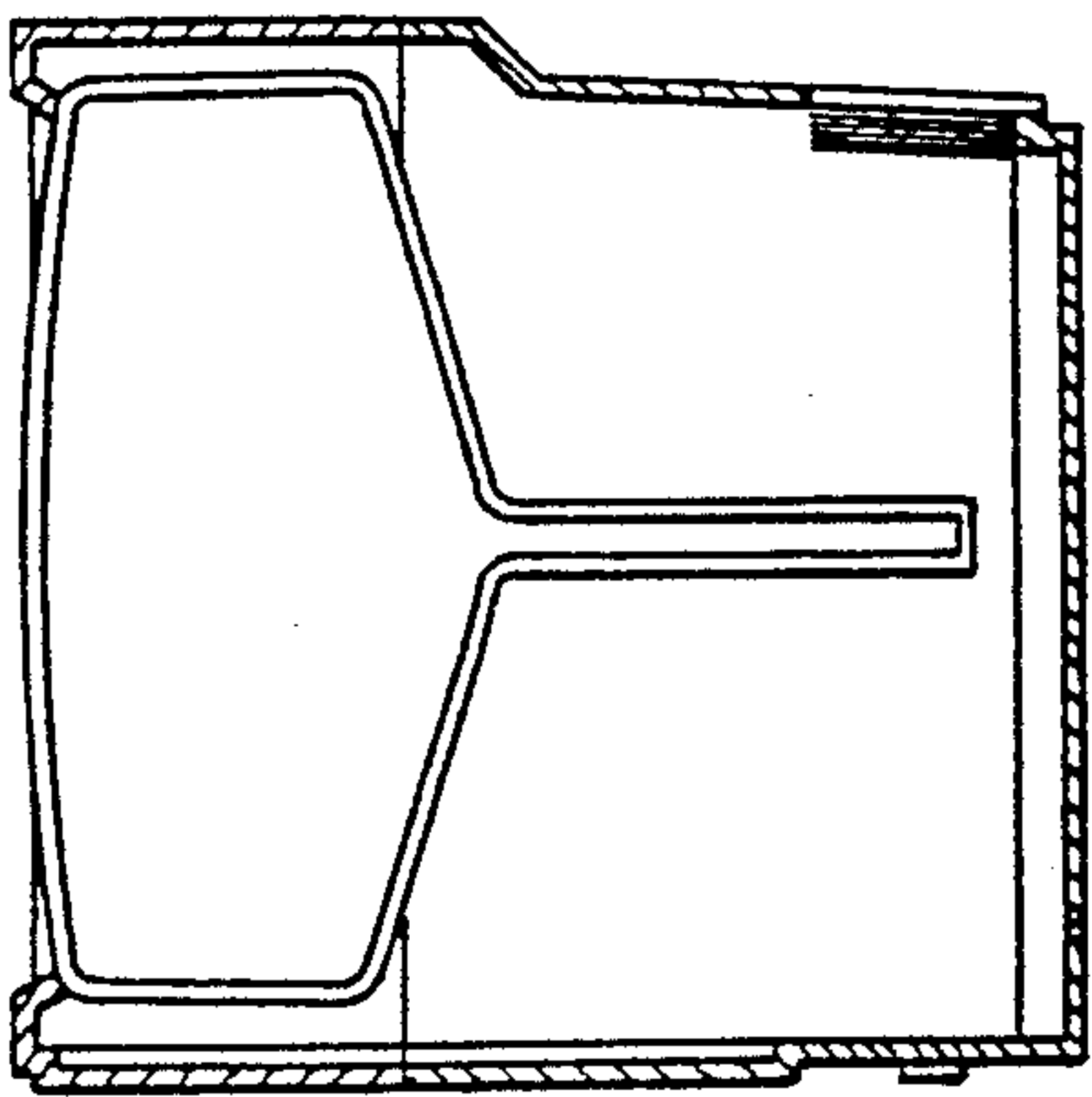

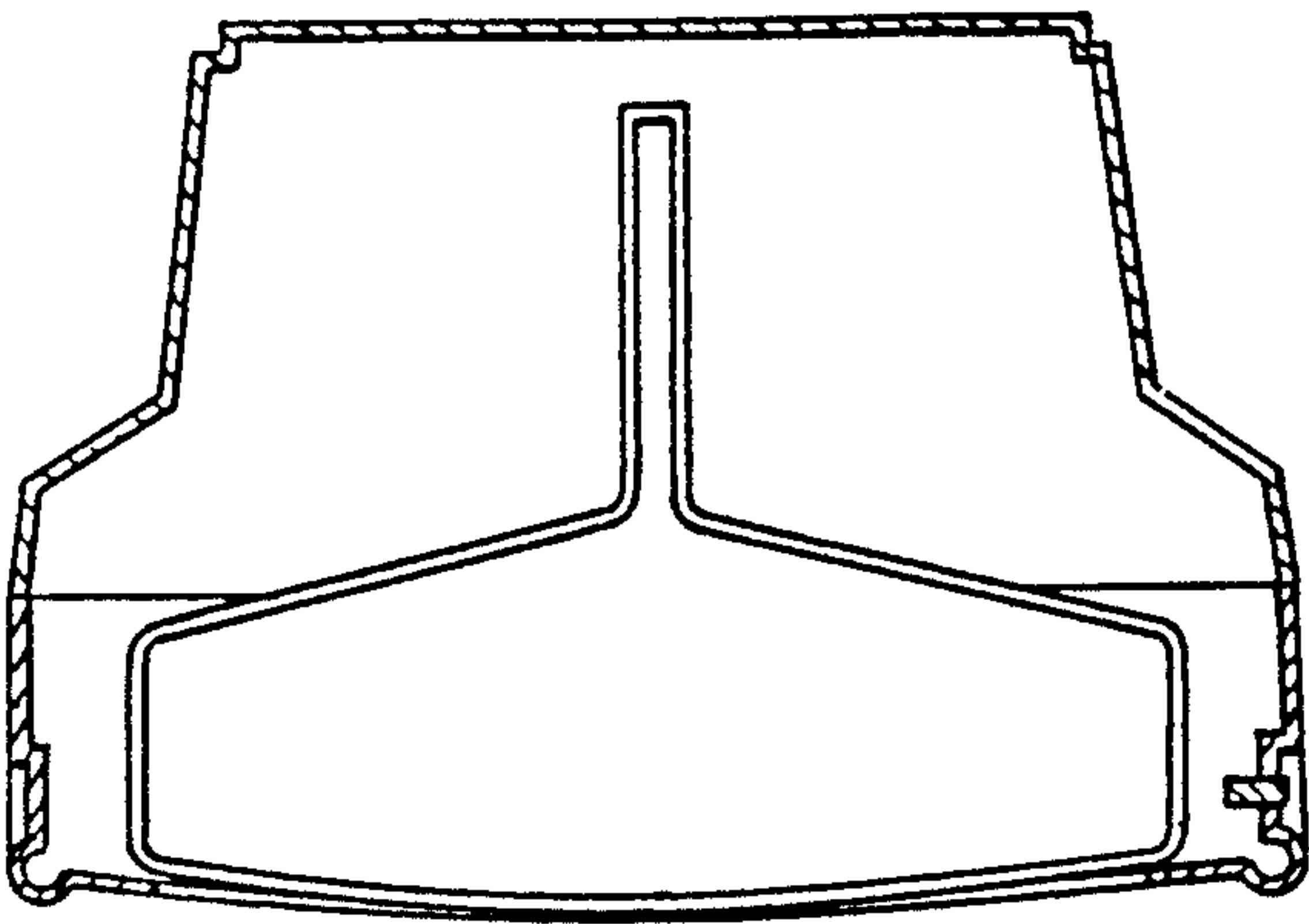
