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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tub or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a frontal top perspective view of a tub or the like showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a frontal top perspective view of a second embodiment thereof;
FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 9 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being identical thereto;
FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being identical thereto;
FIG. 11 is a sectional view thereof taken on plane 11-11 of FIG. 8;
FIG. 12 is a top plan view of a third embodiment which is a mirror image of the FIG. 8 embodiment;
FIG. 13 is a frontal top perspective view of a fourth embodiment thereof similar to that of FIG. 8, but in an island entry embodiment;
FIG. 14 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being identical thereto; and
FIG. 15 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being identical thereto.
The fragmentary broken line representation of an island mounting installation in FIG. 13 is for the purpose of illustration only.

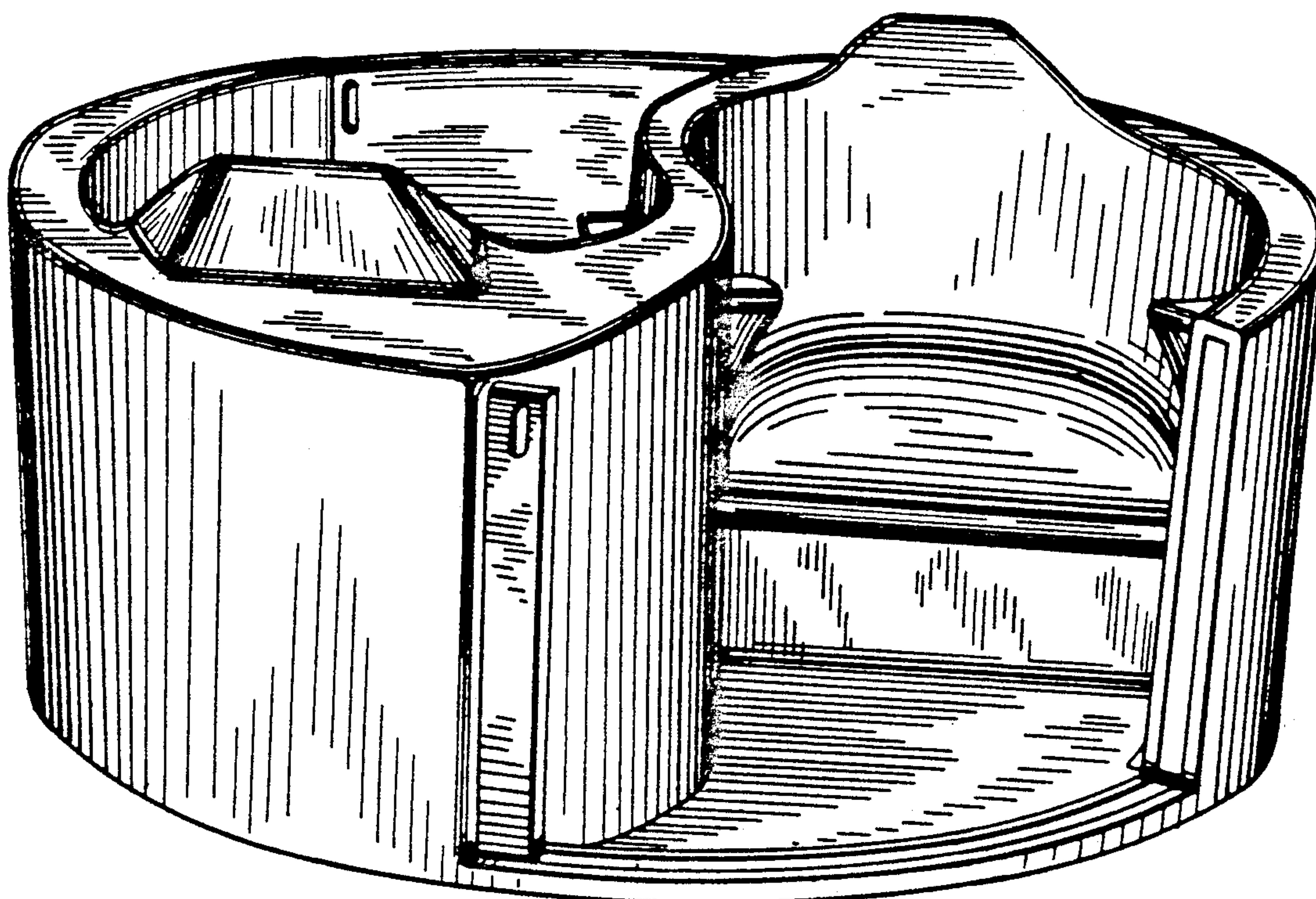

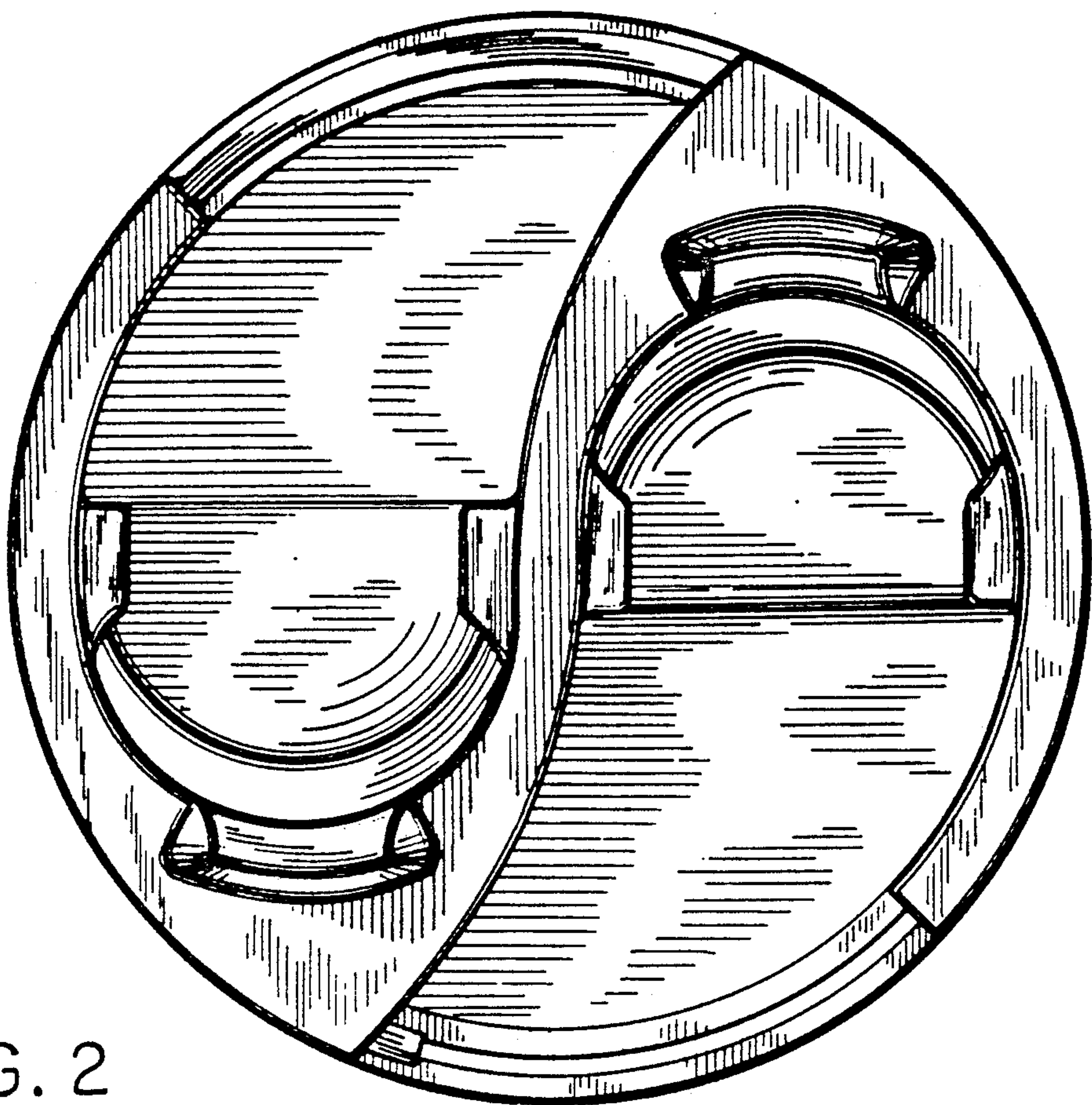
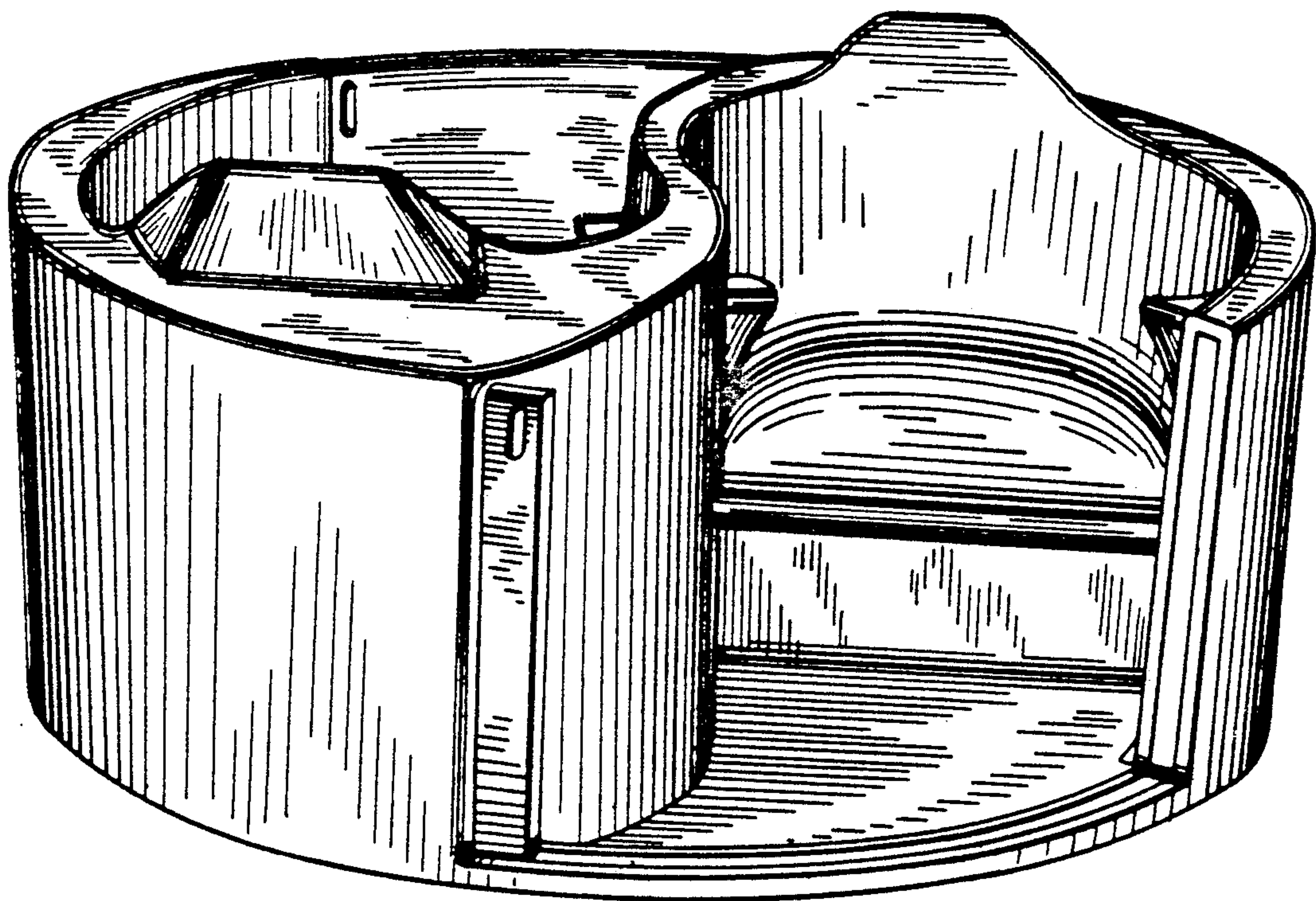

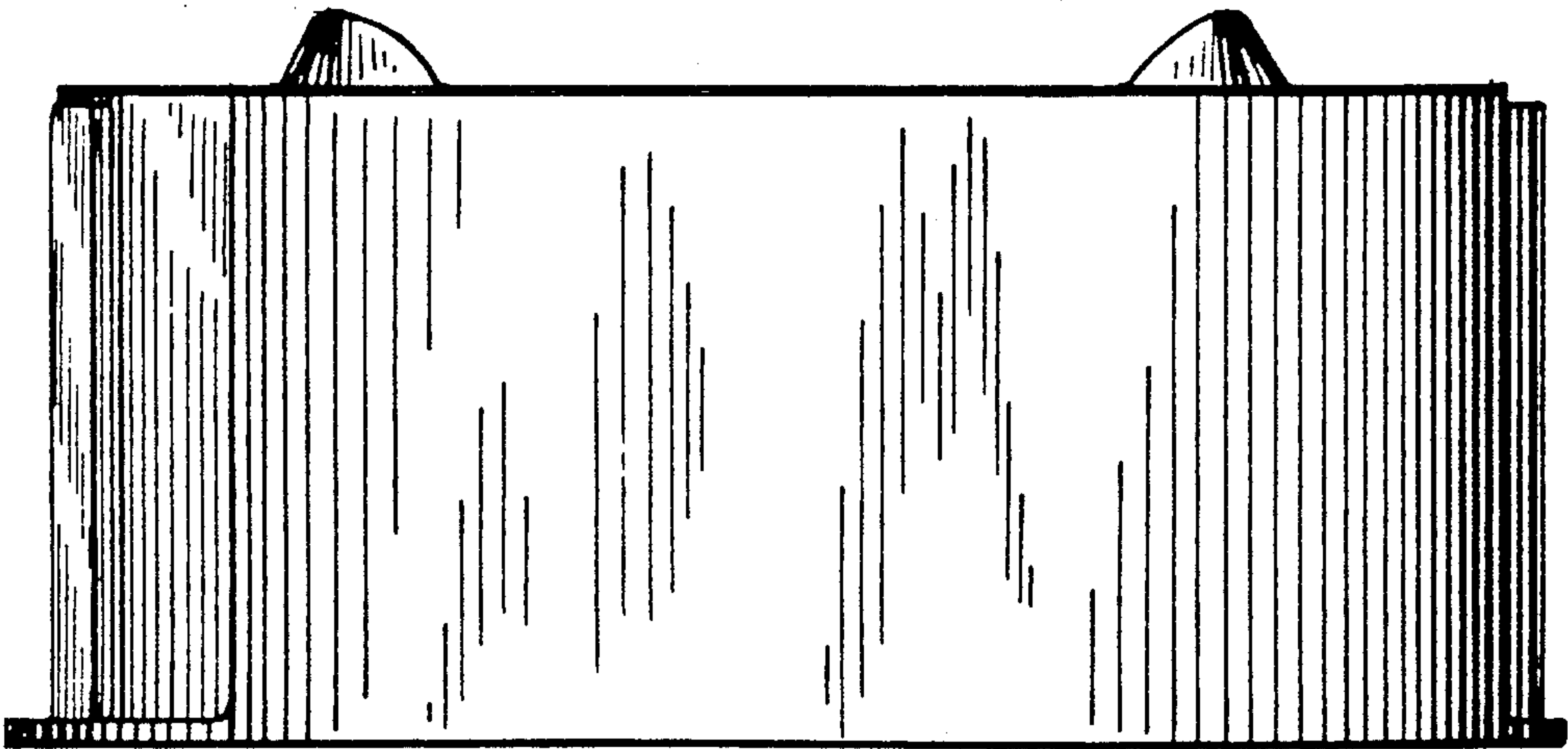
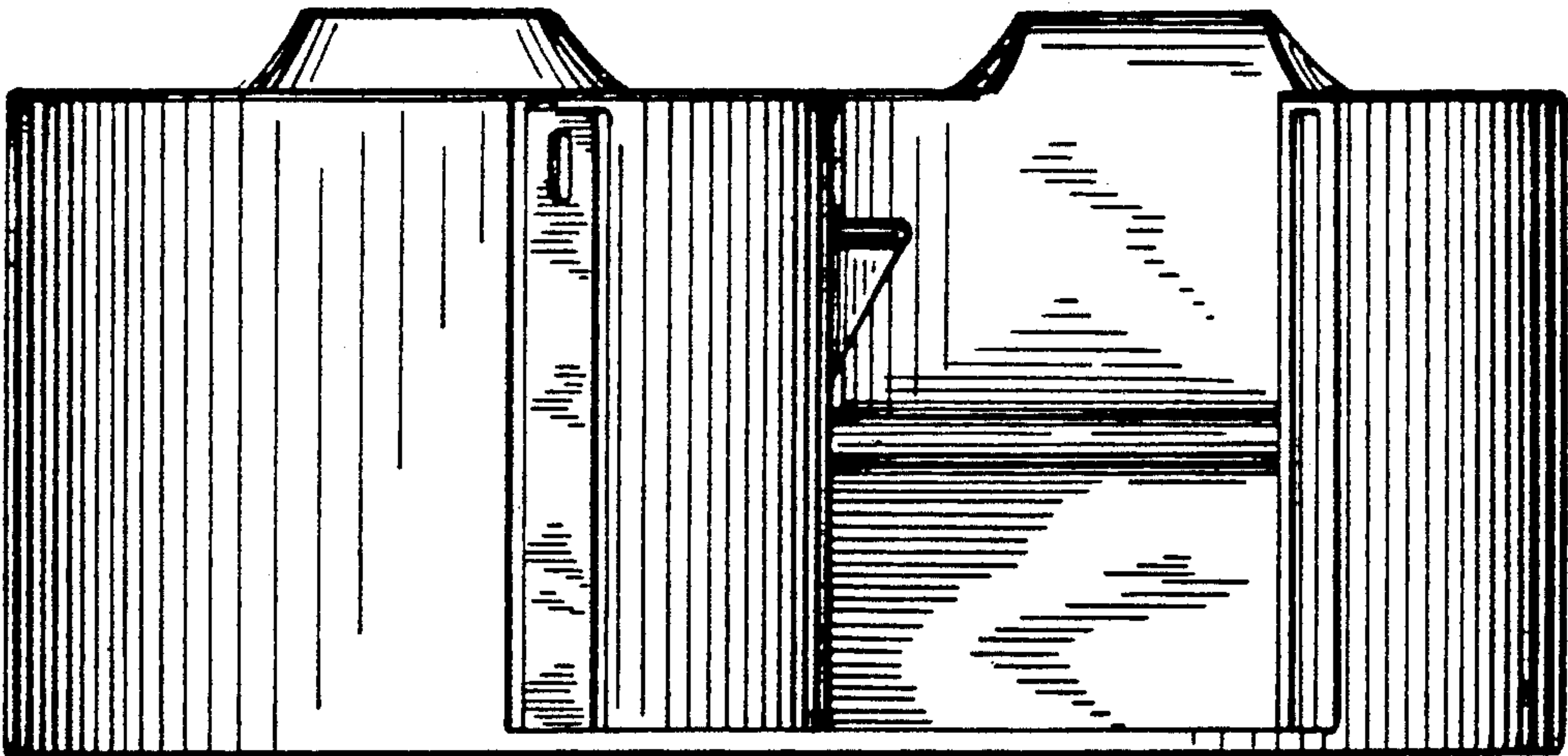

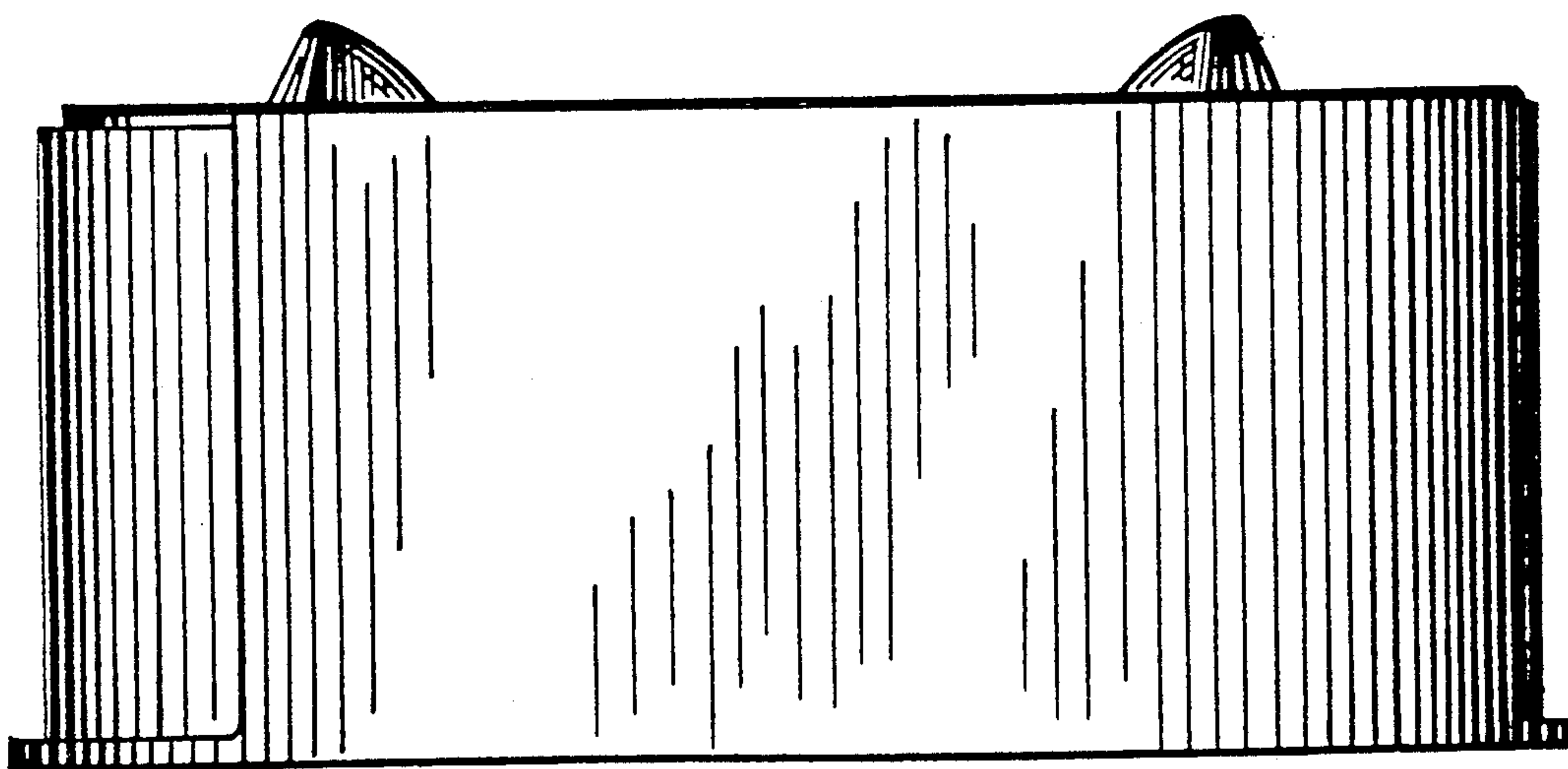
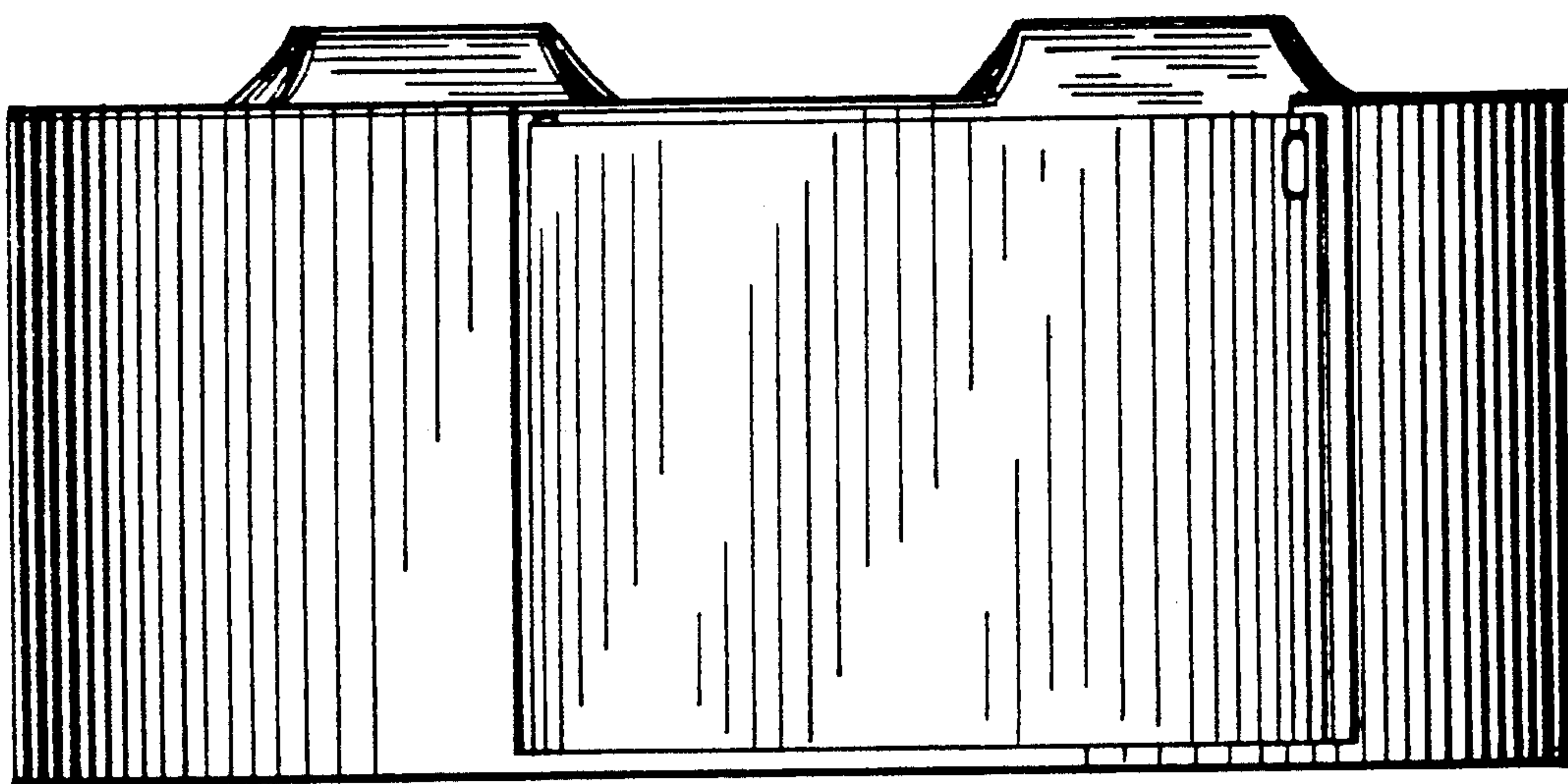

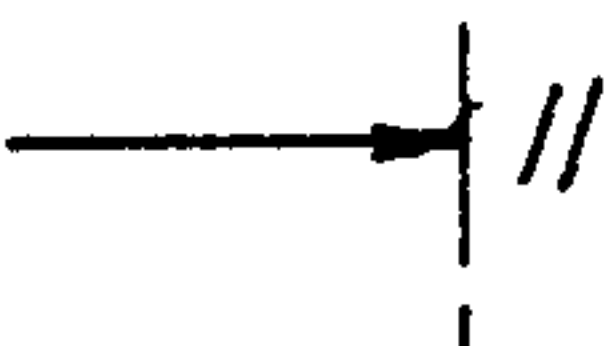
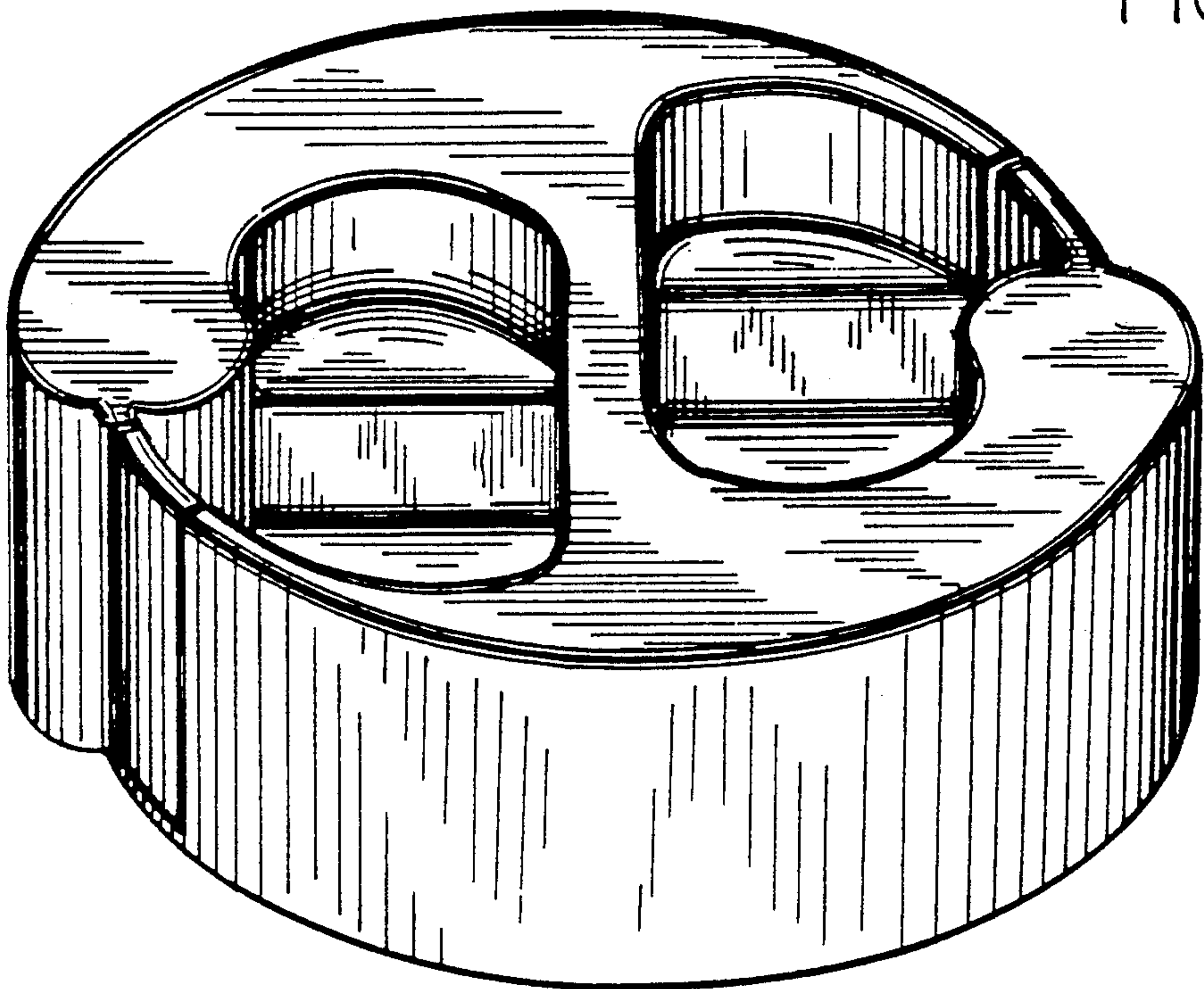

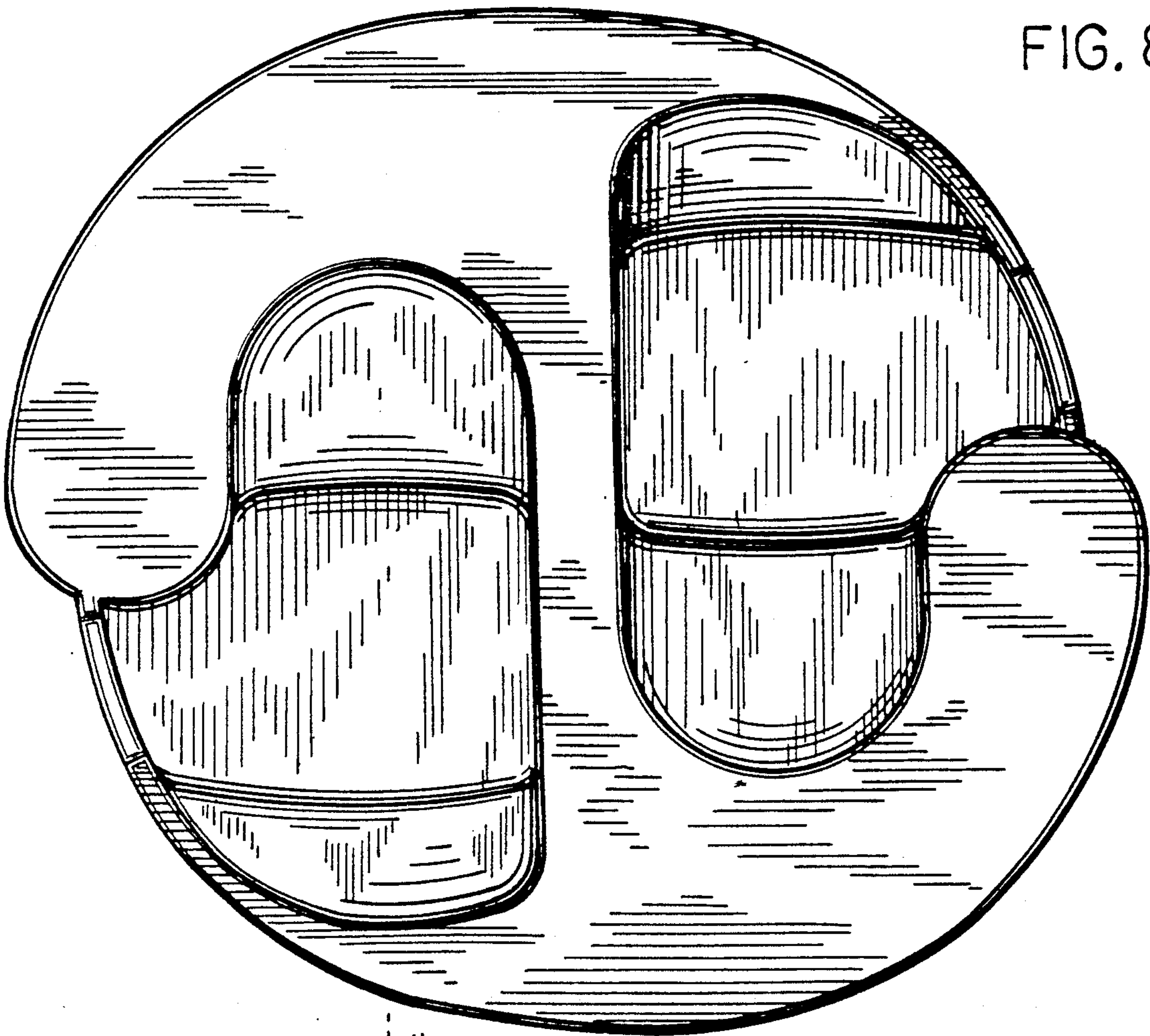

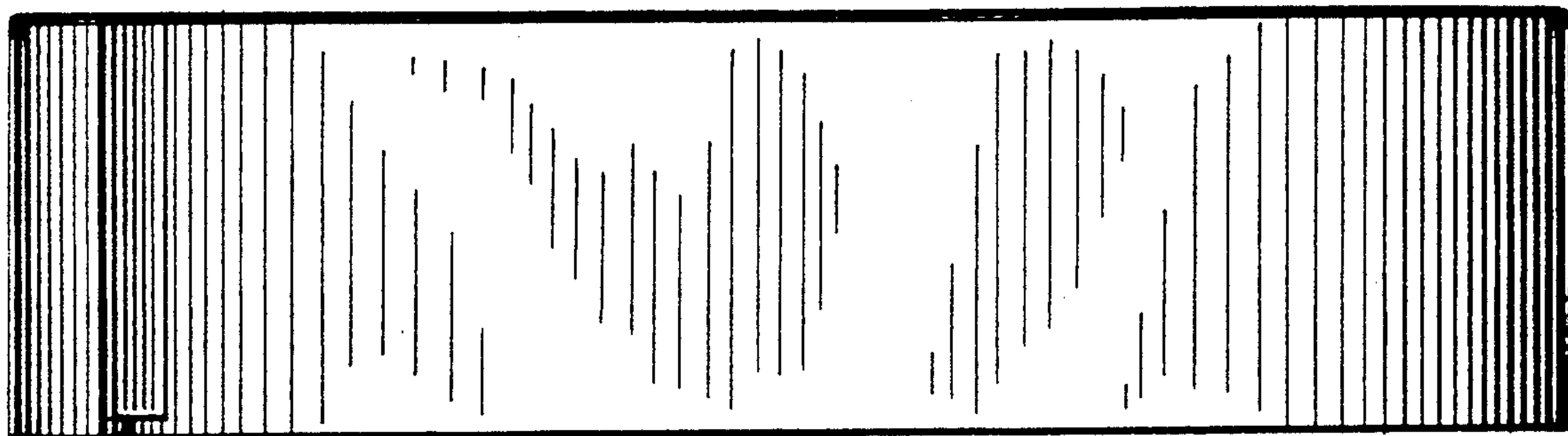

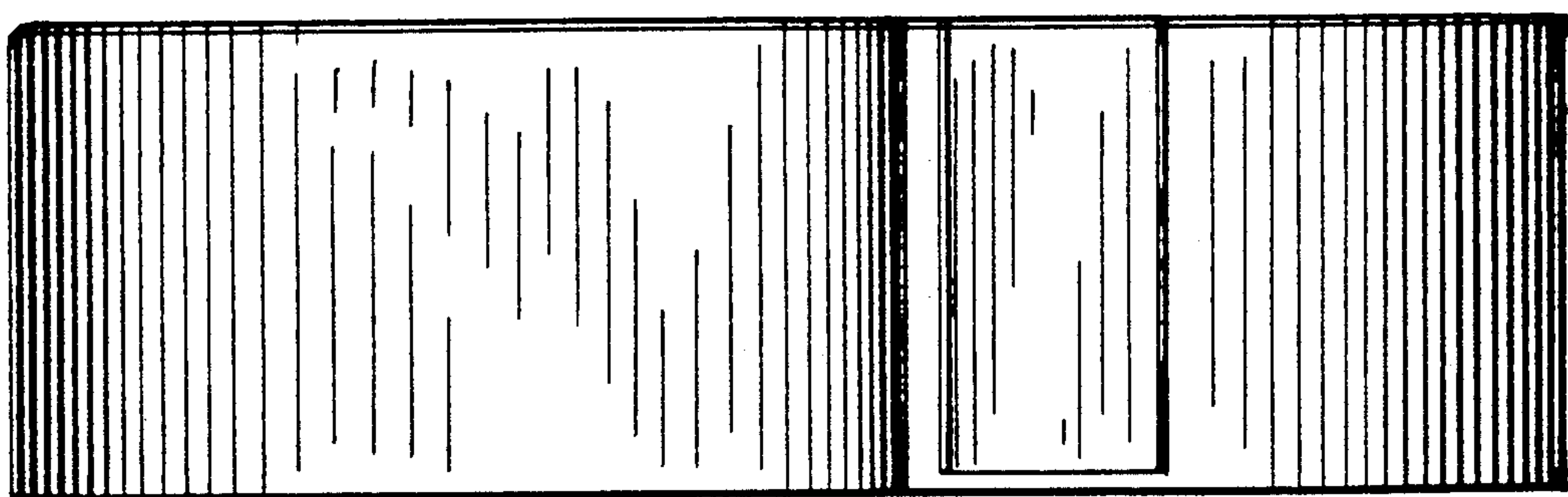

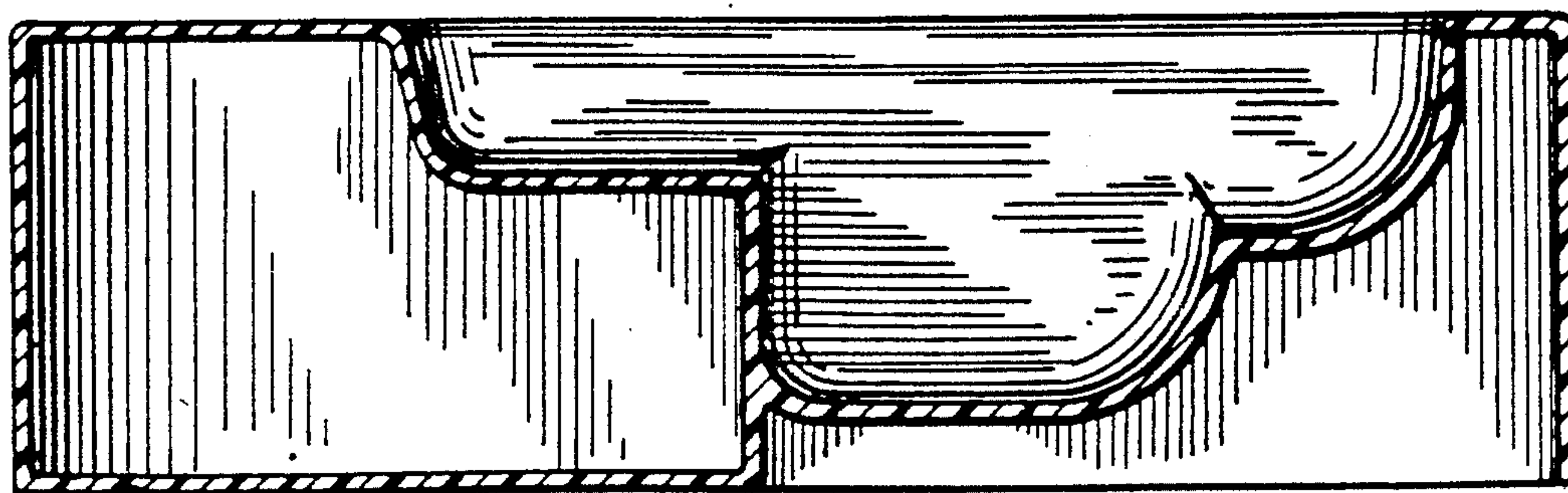

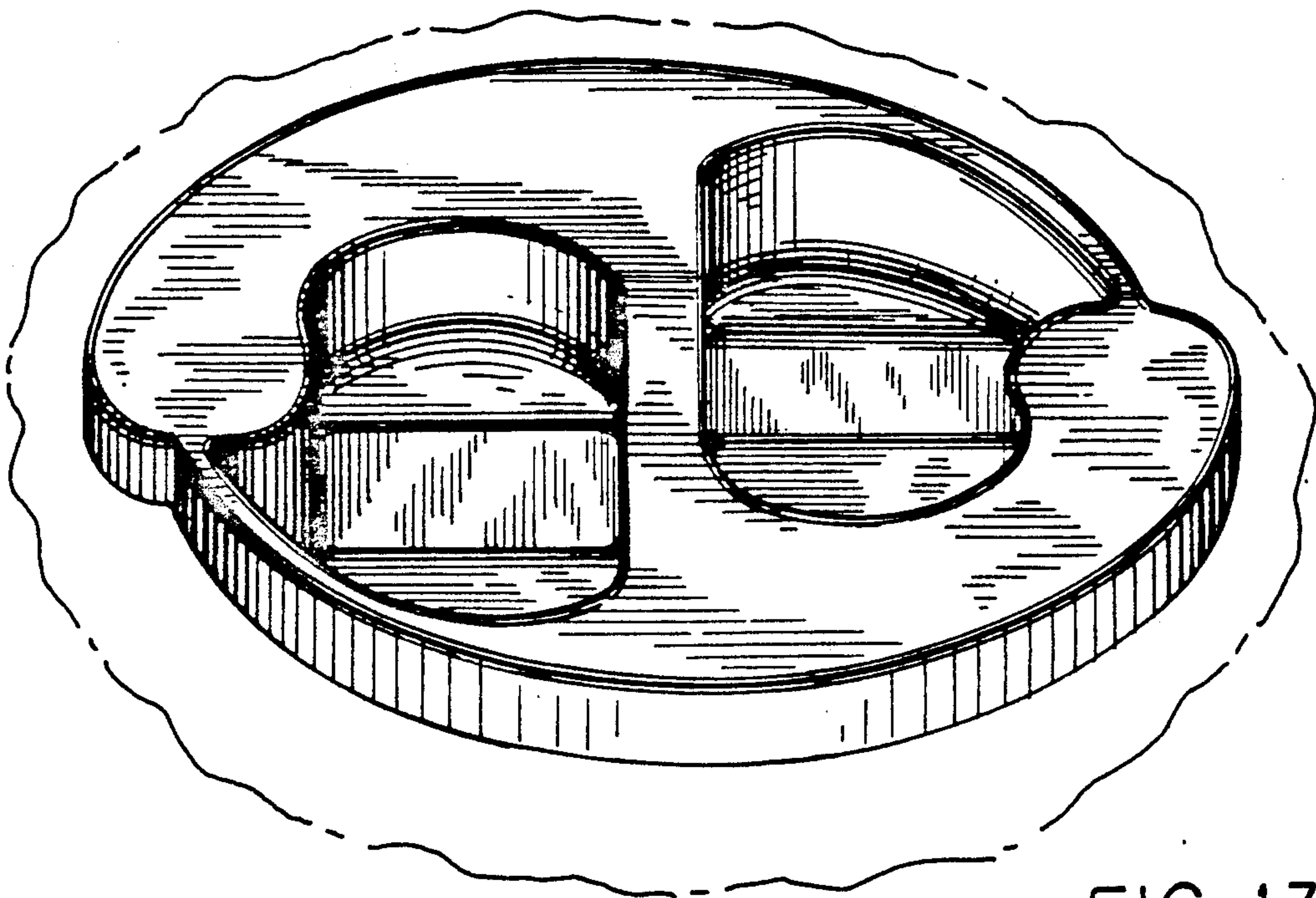
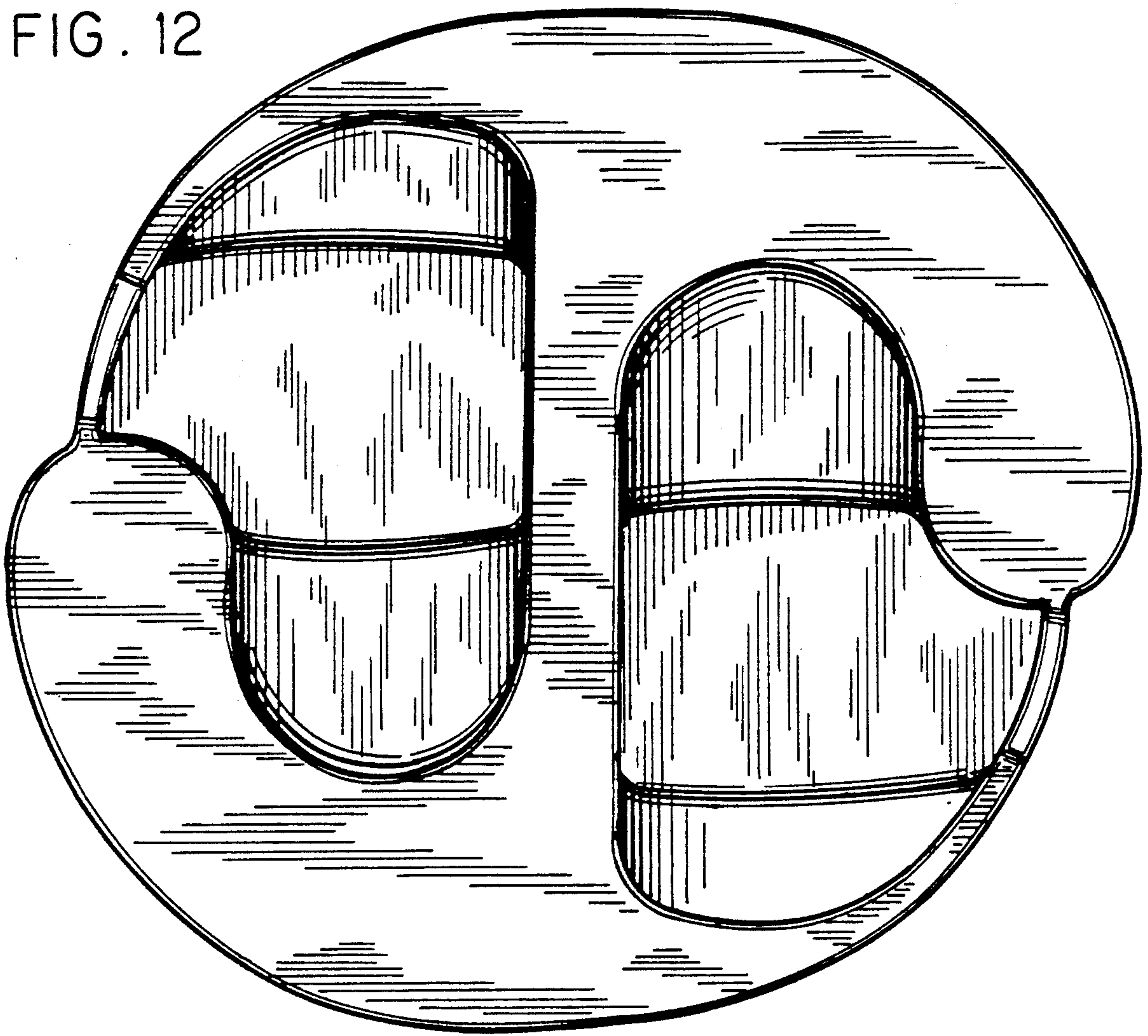

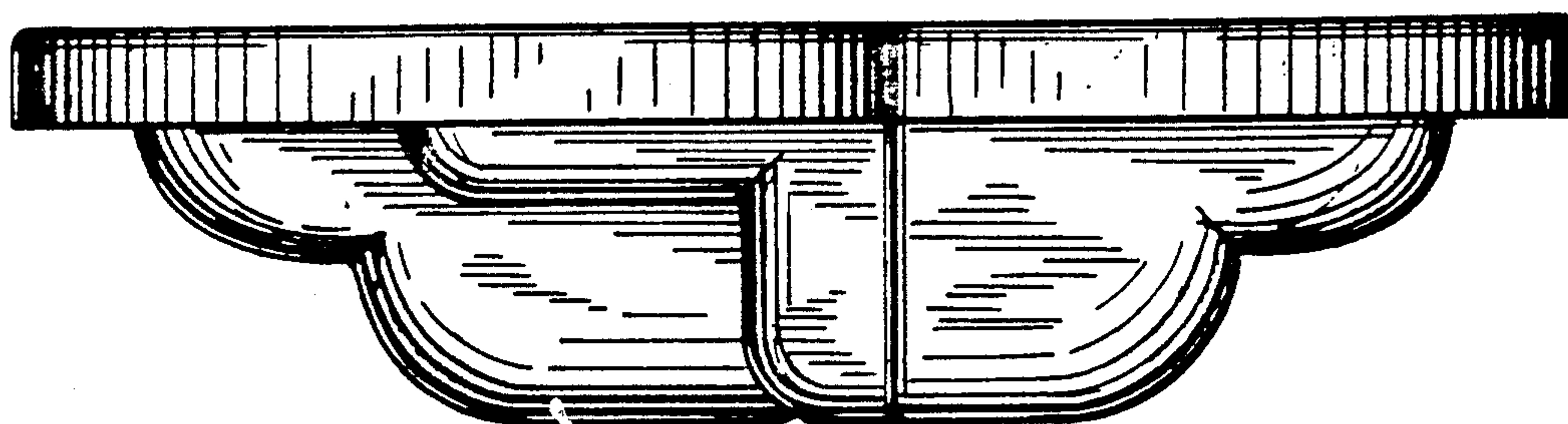
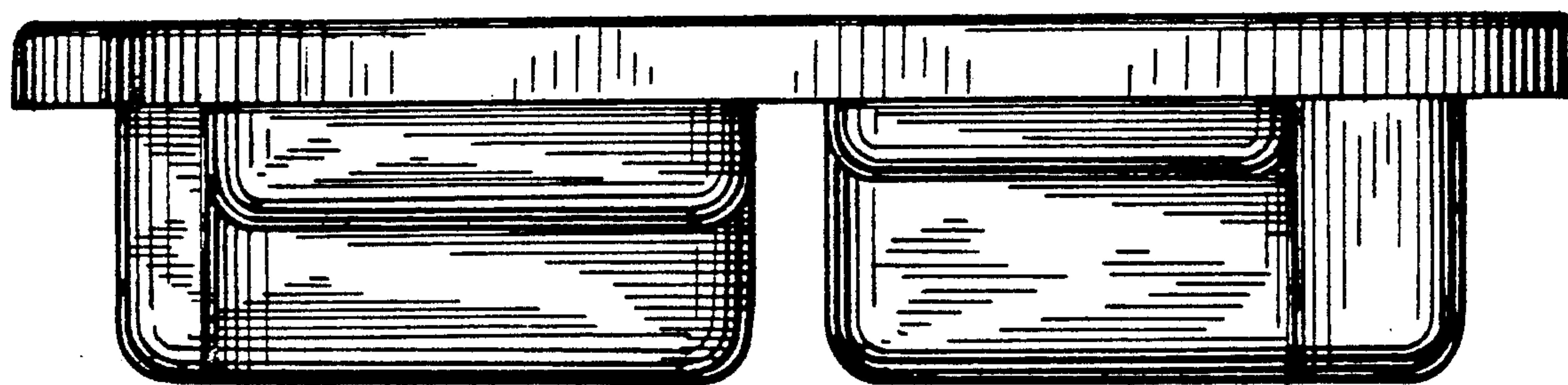
