[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an infant costume, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an infant costume showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken lines shown throughout the views represent conventional stitching.

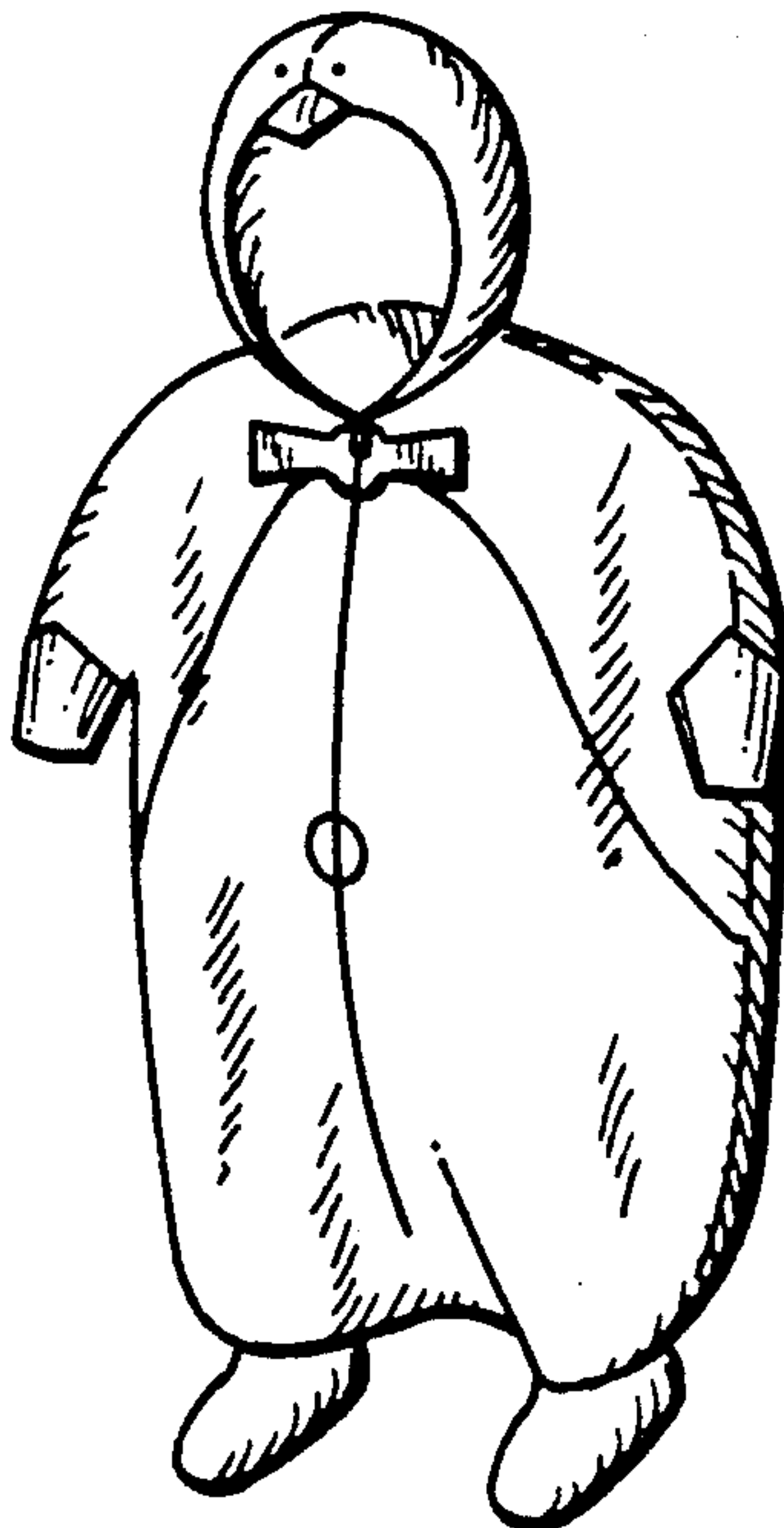

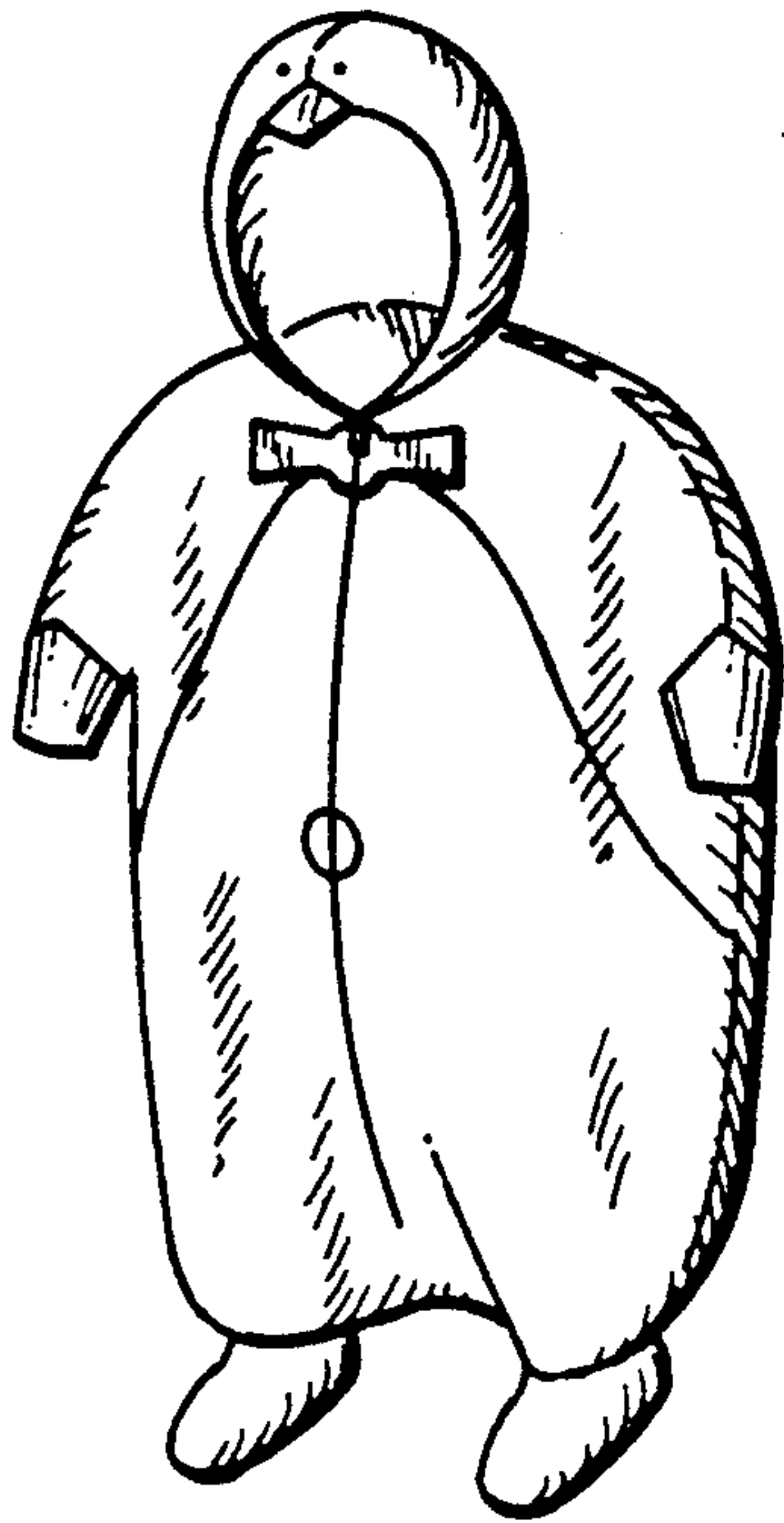

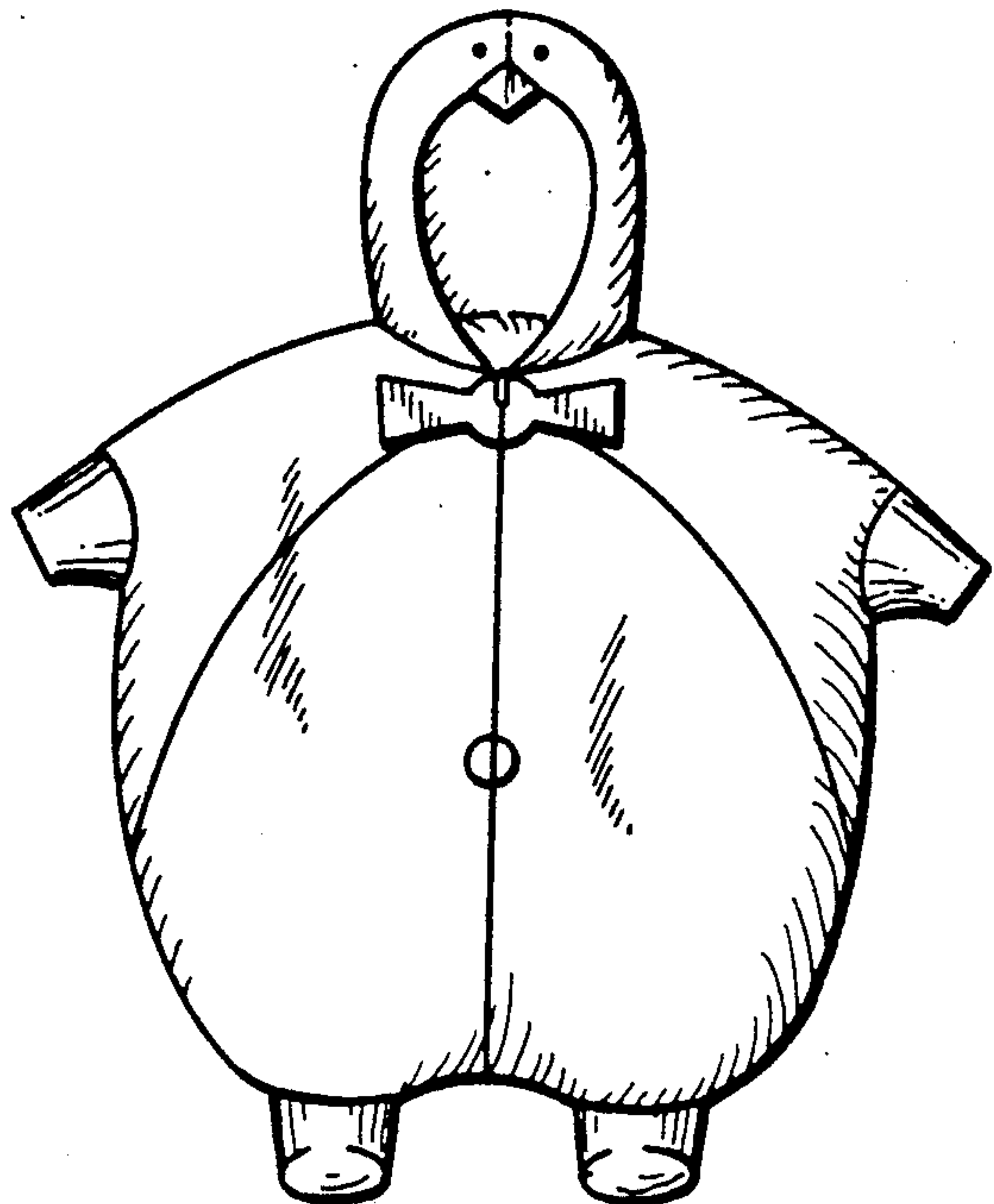

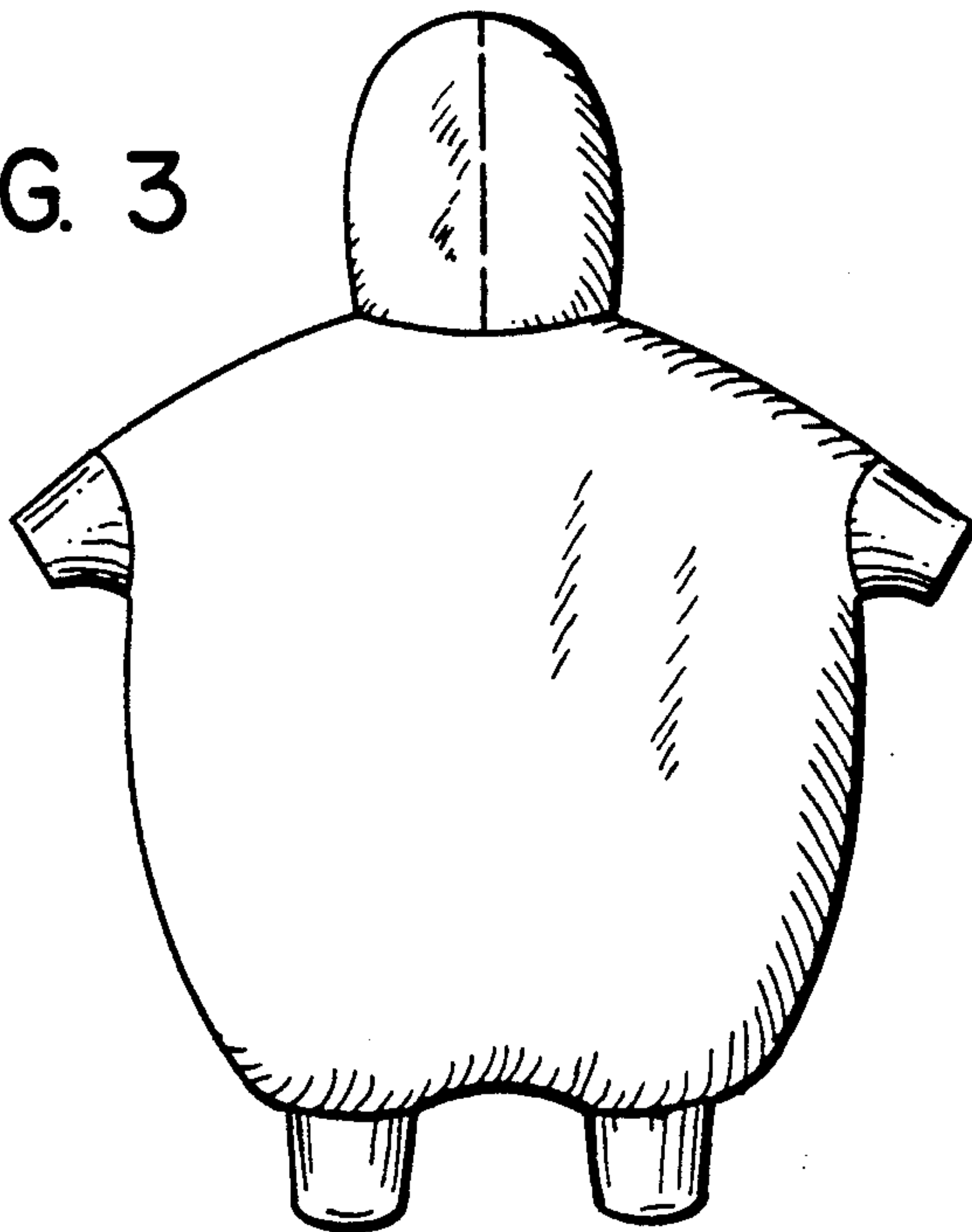

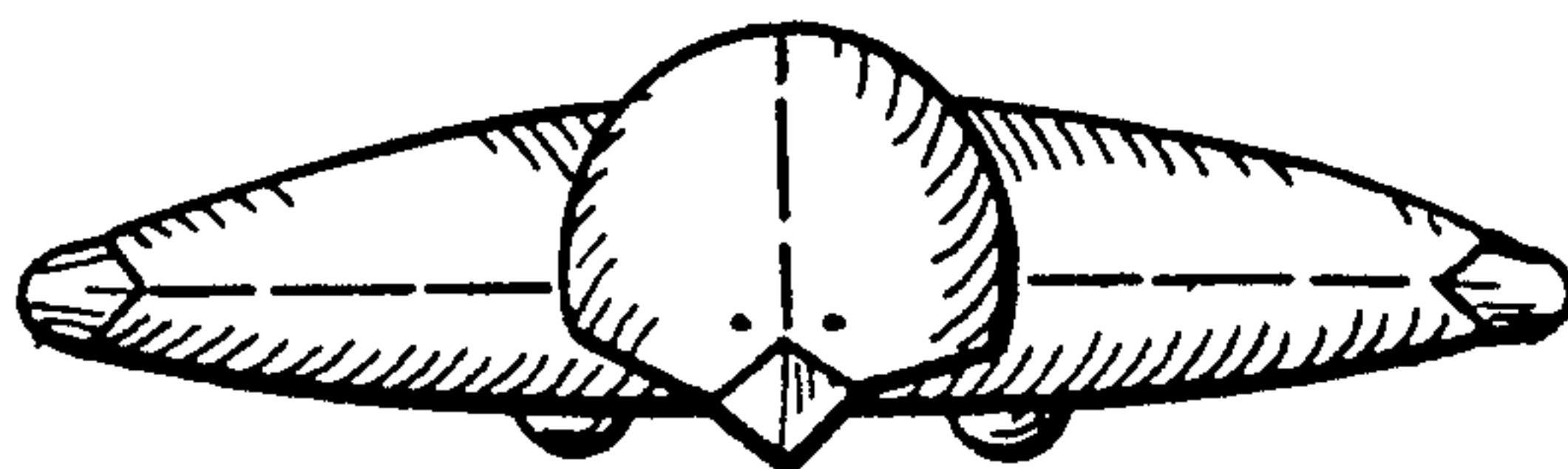
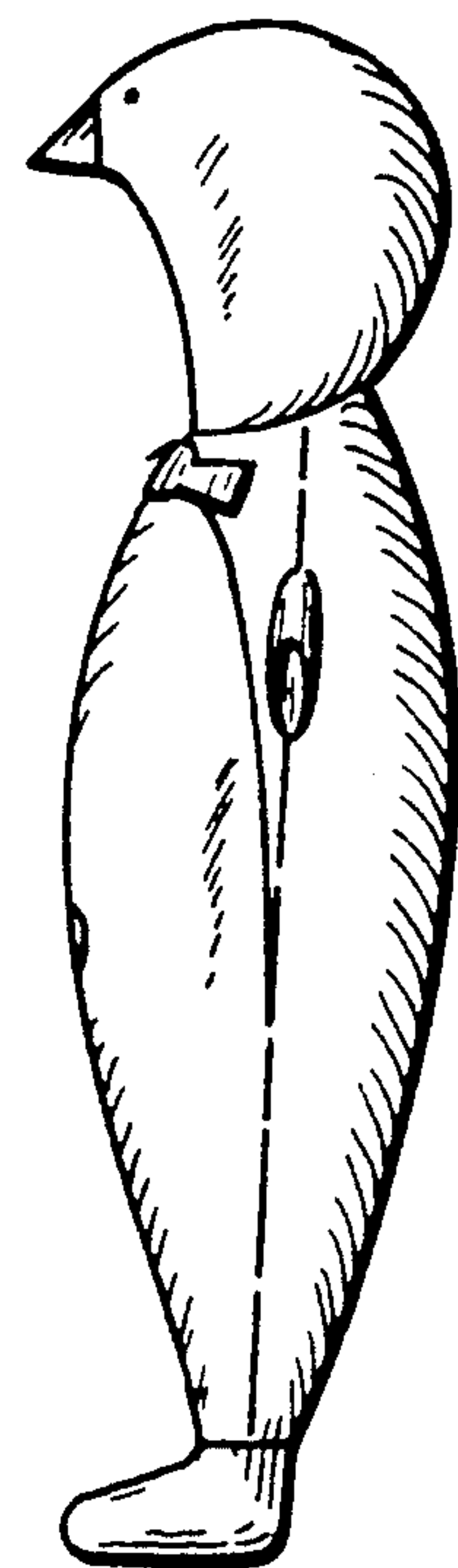

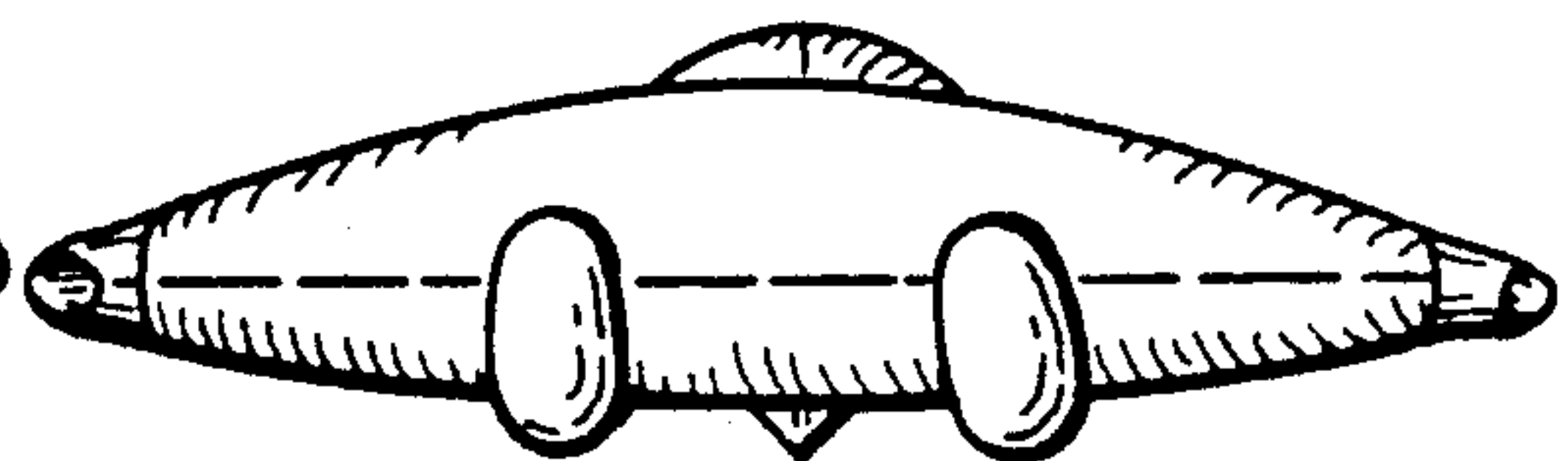
