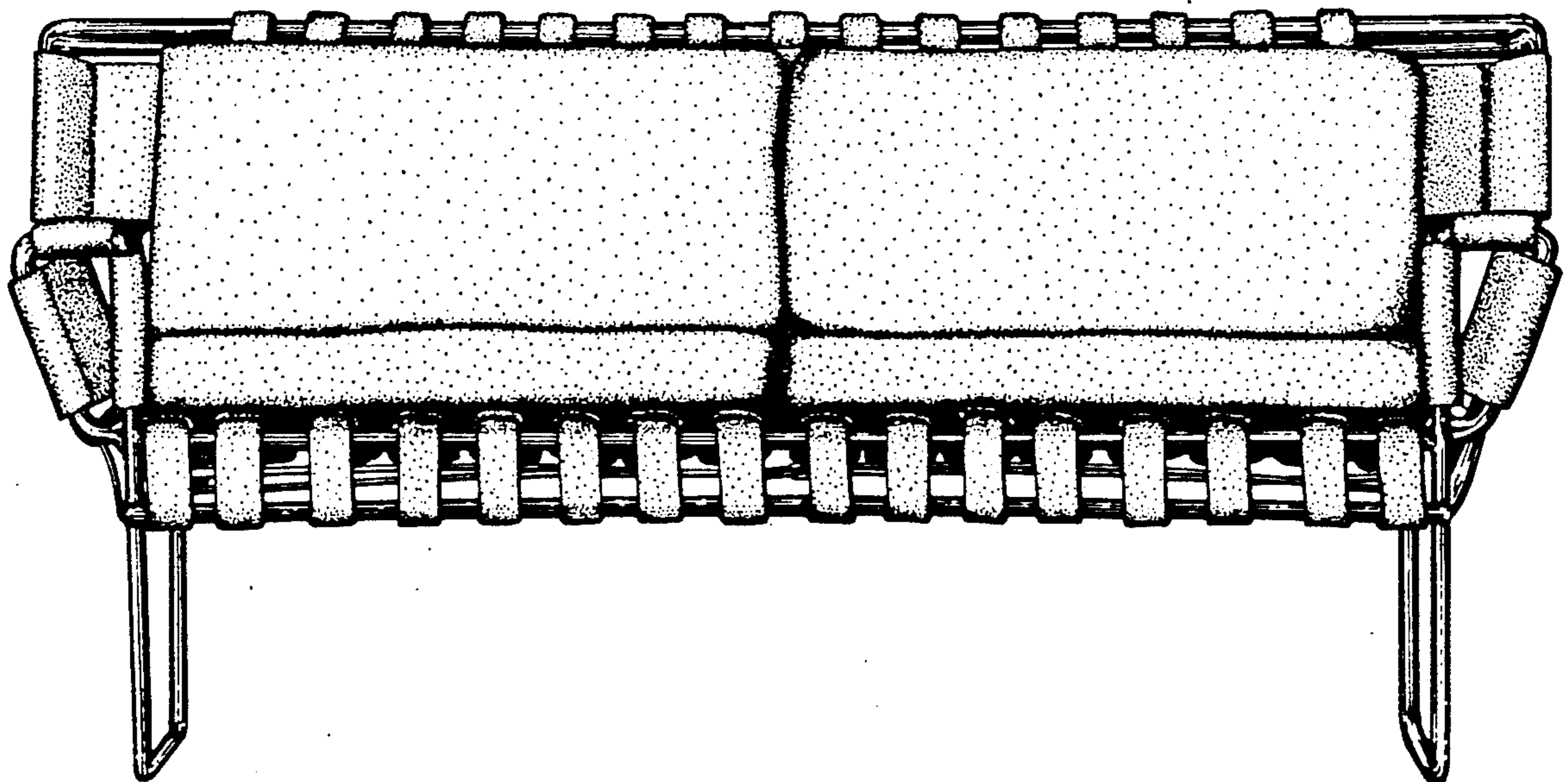

The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a chair showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side perspective view;
FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view; and
FIG. 6 is a top plan view wherein the cushions have been omitted for convenience of illustration.
The side of the settee not shown is a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 2.



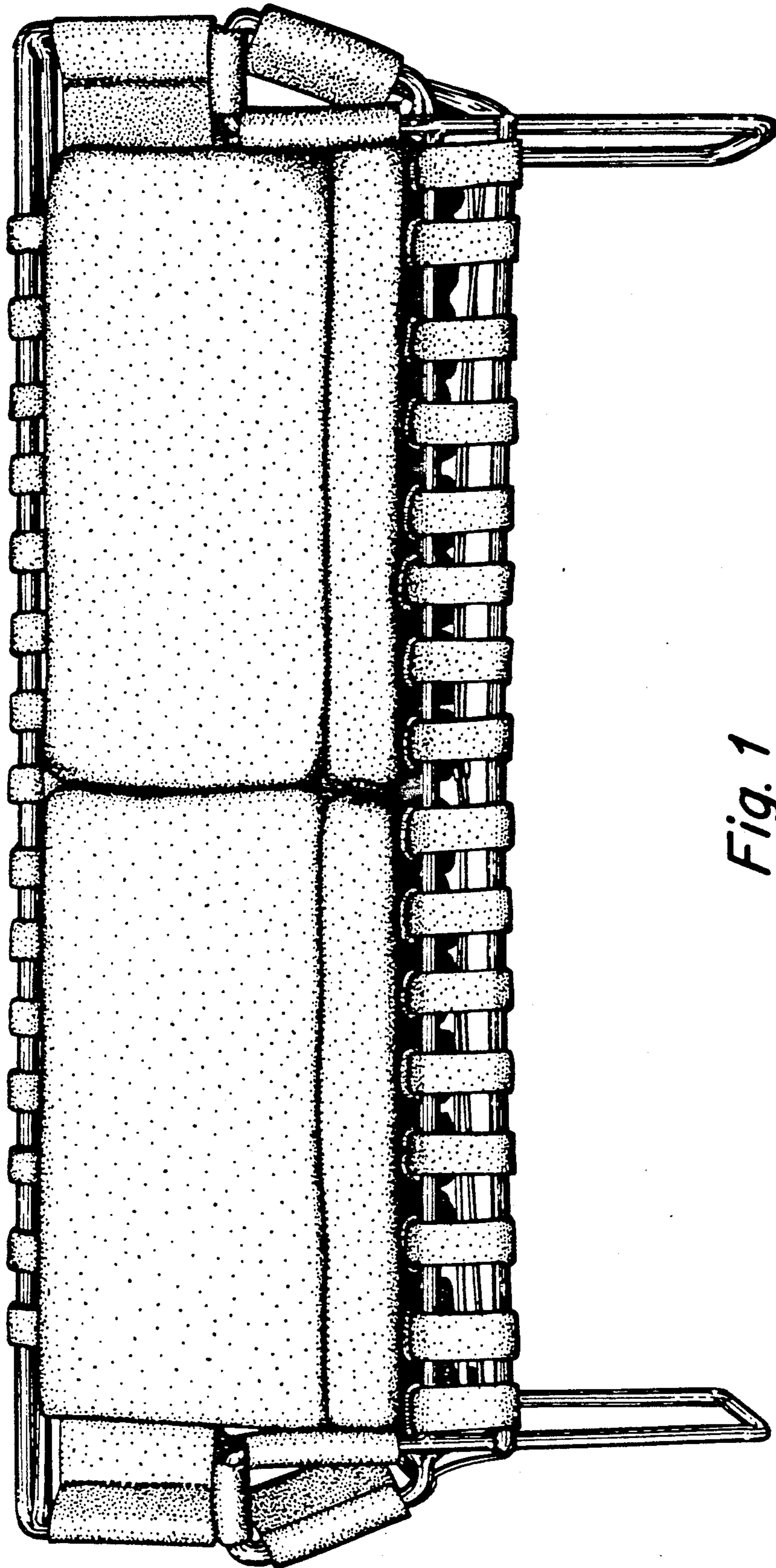

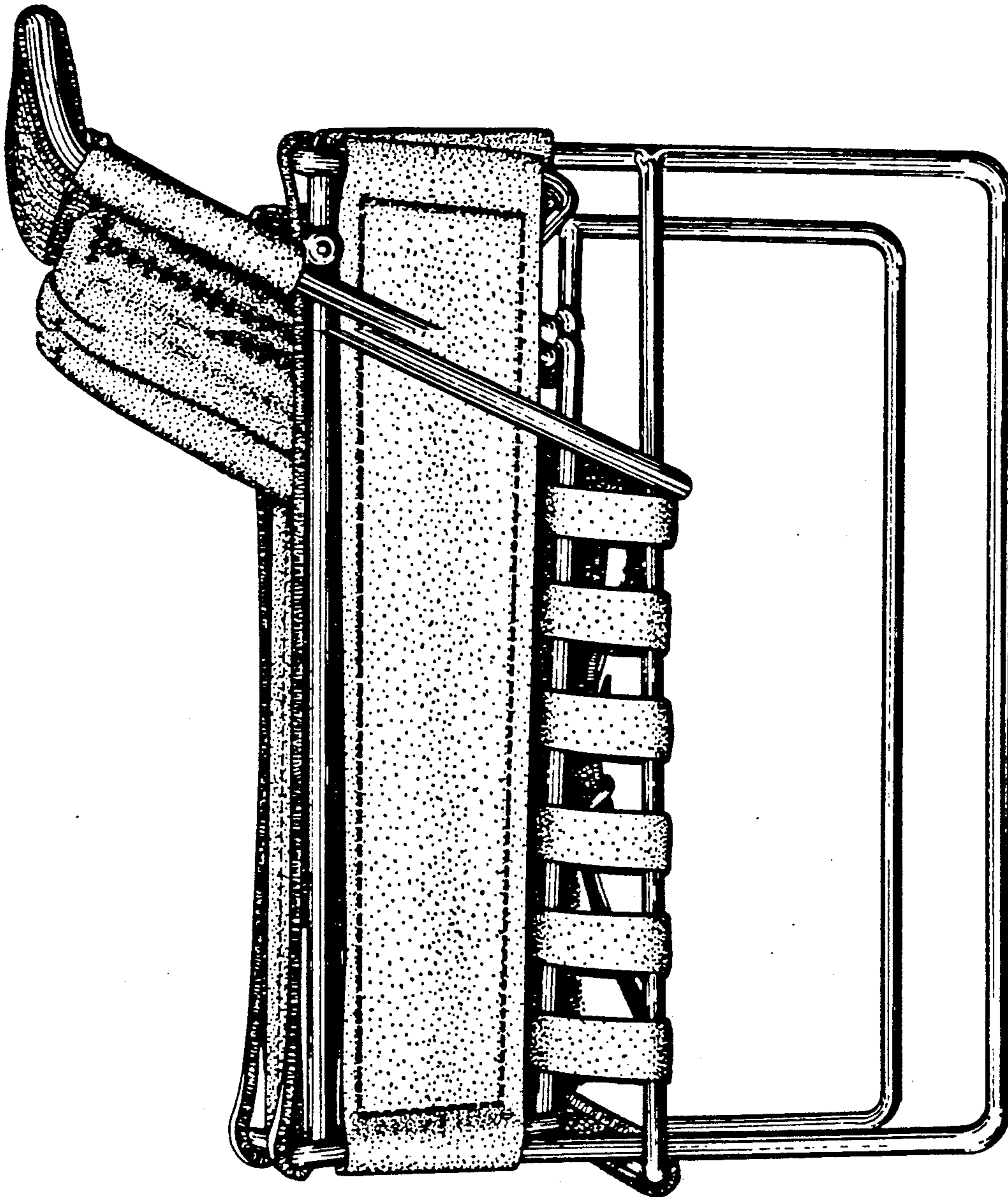

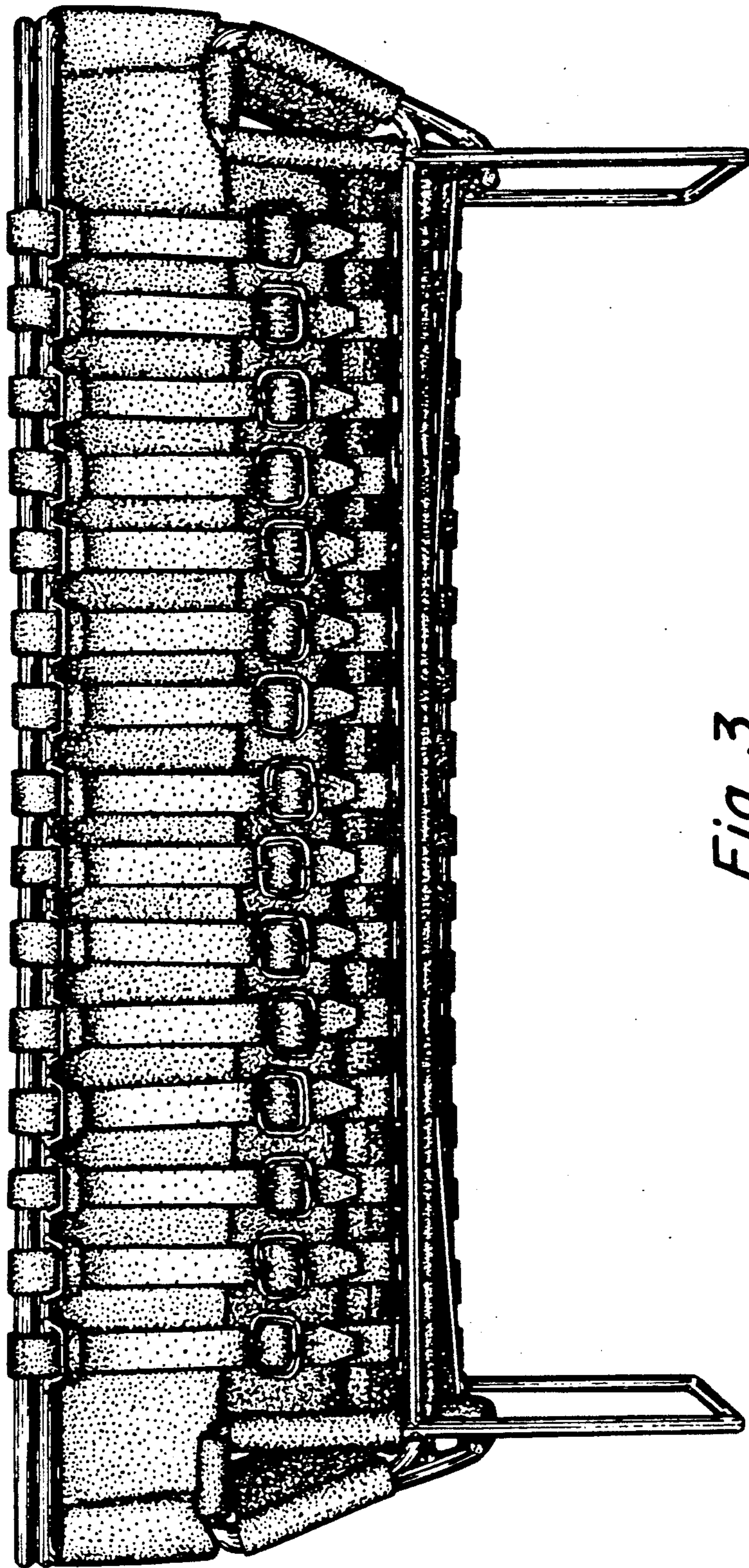

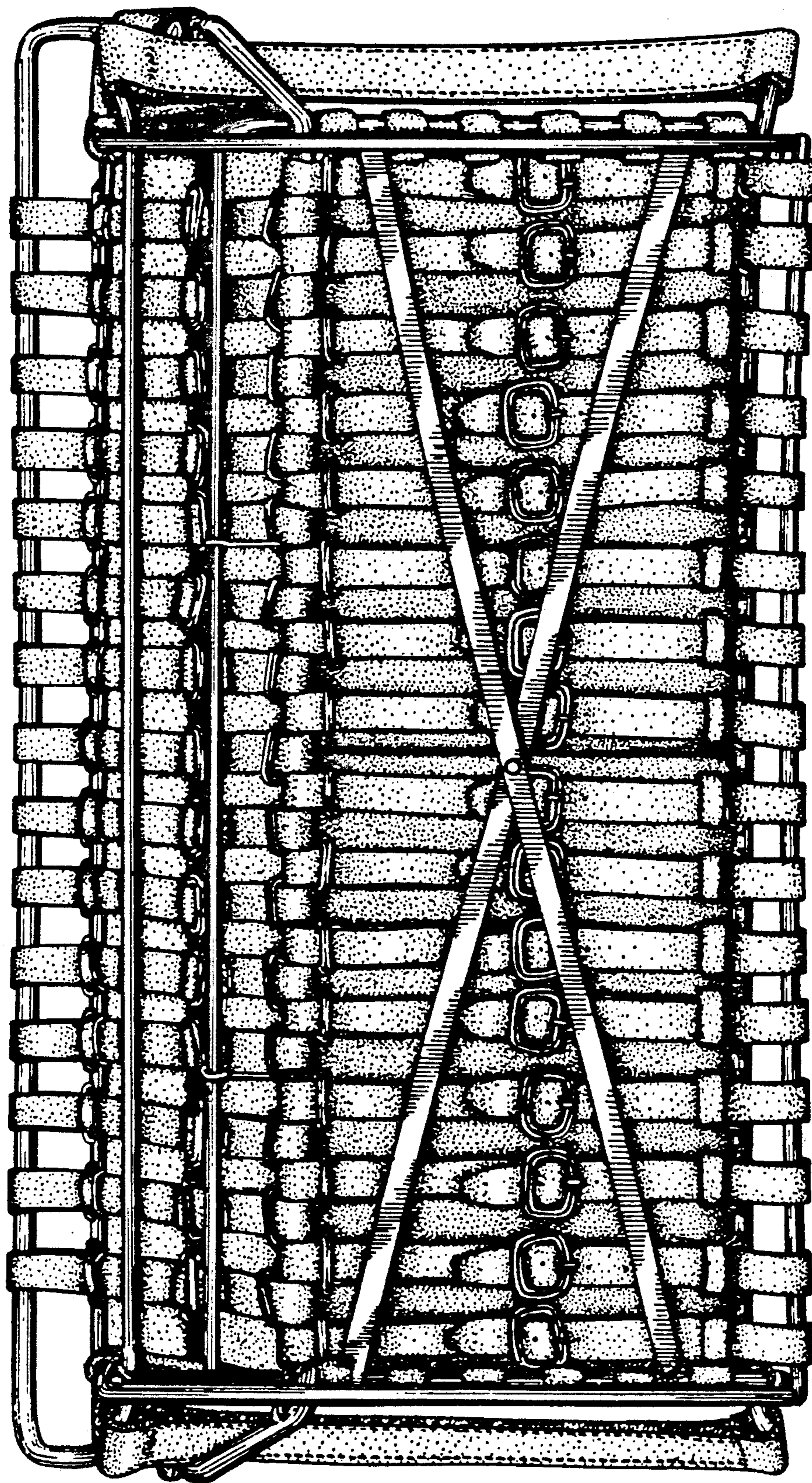

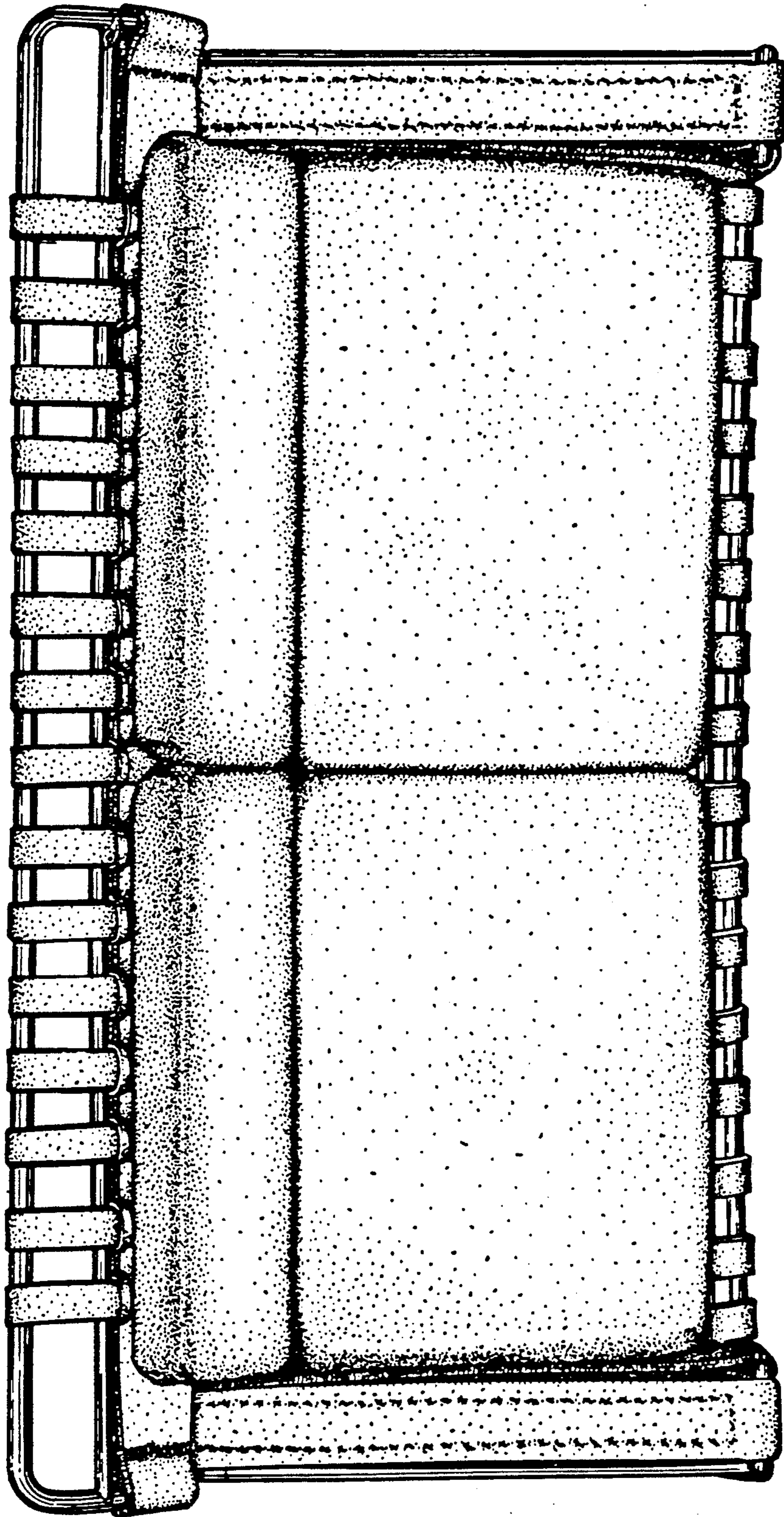
