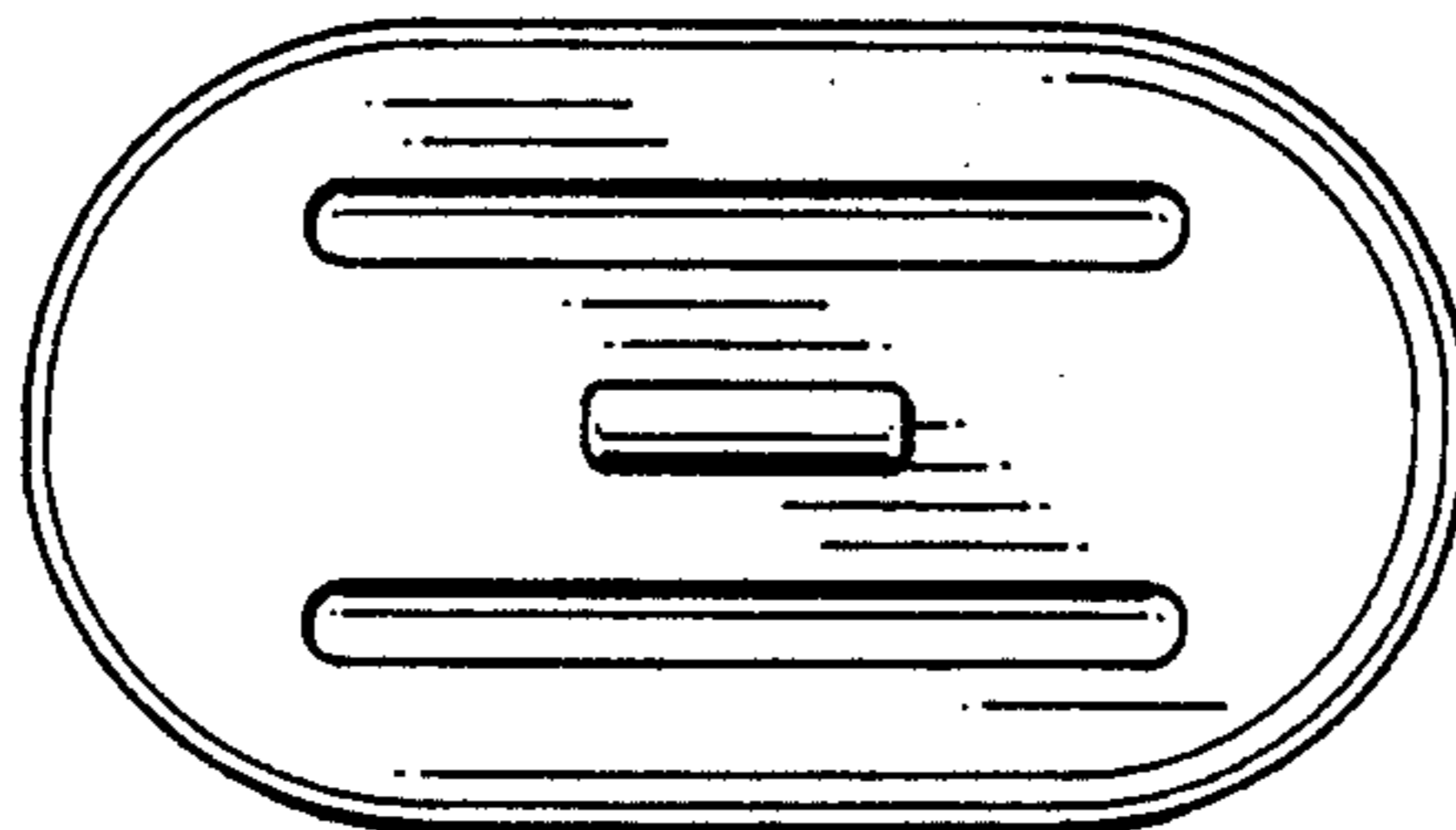
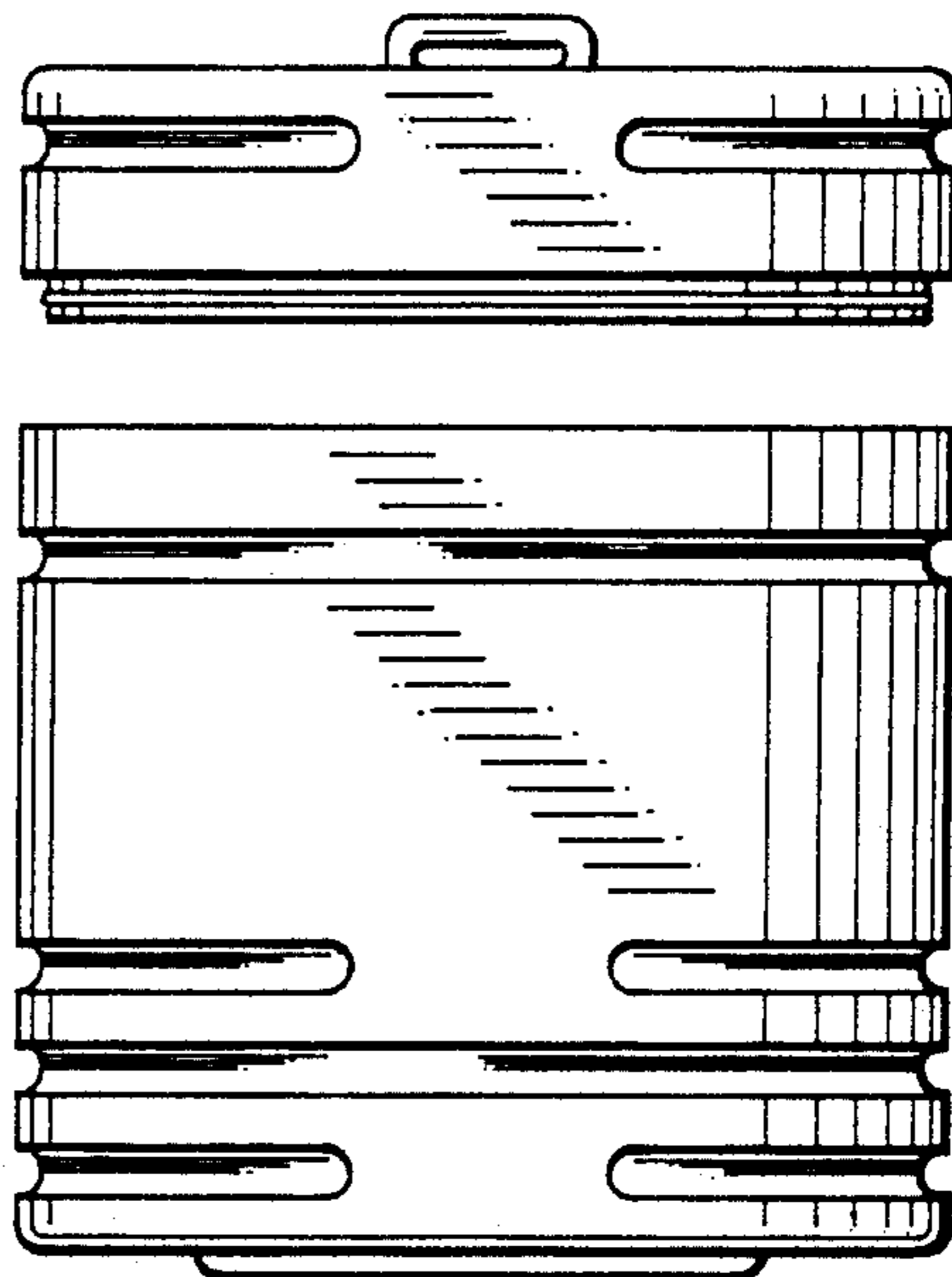
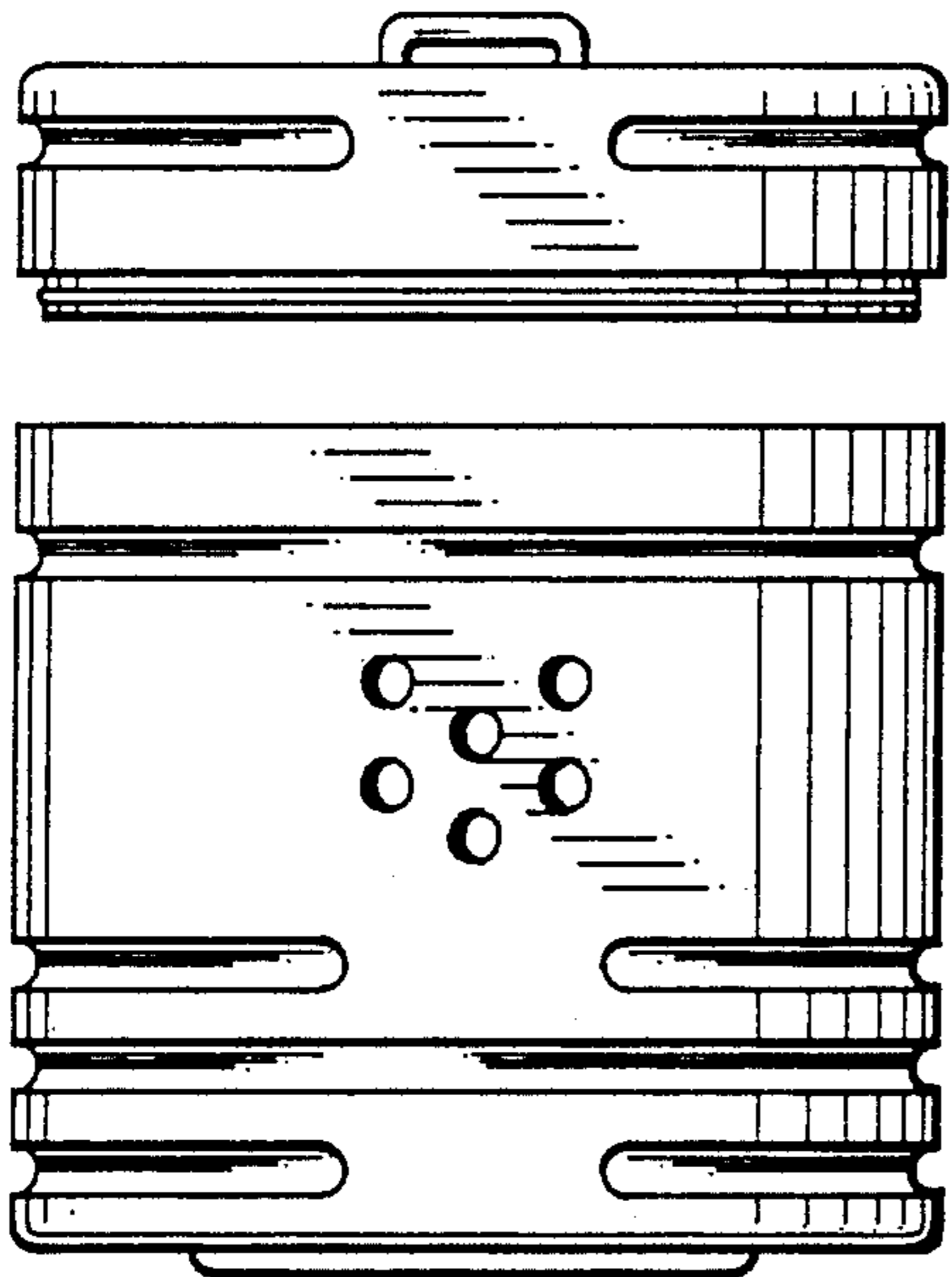

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an exploded front elevational view of a toilet tissue canister showing my new design; FIG. 2 is an exploded rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is an exploded left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is an exploded right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



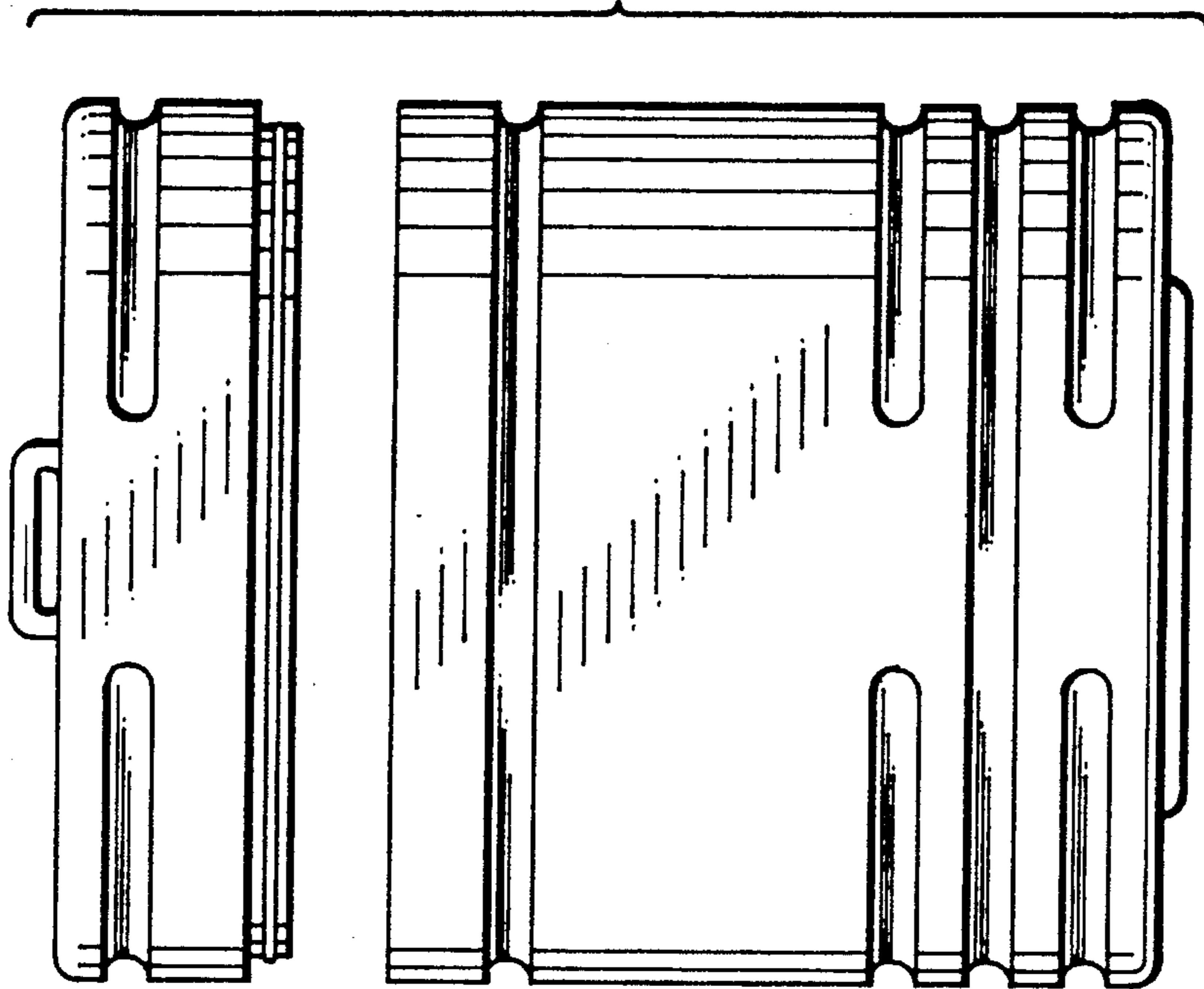

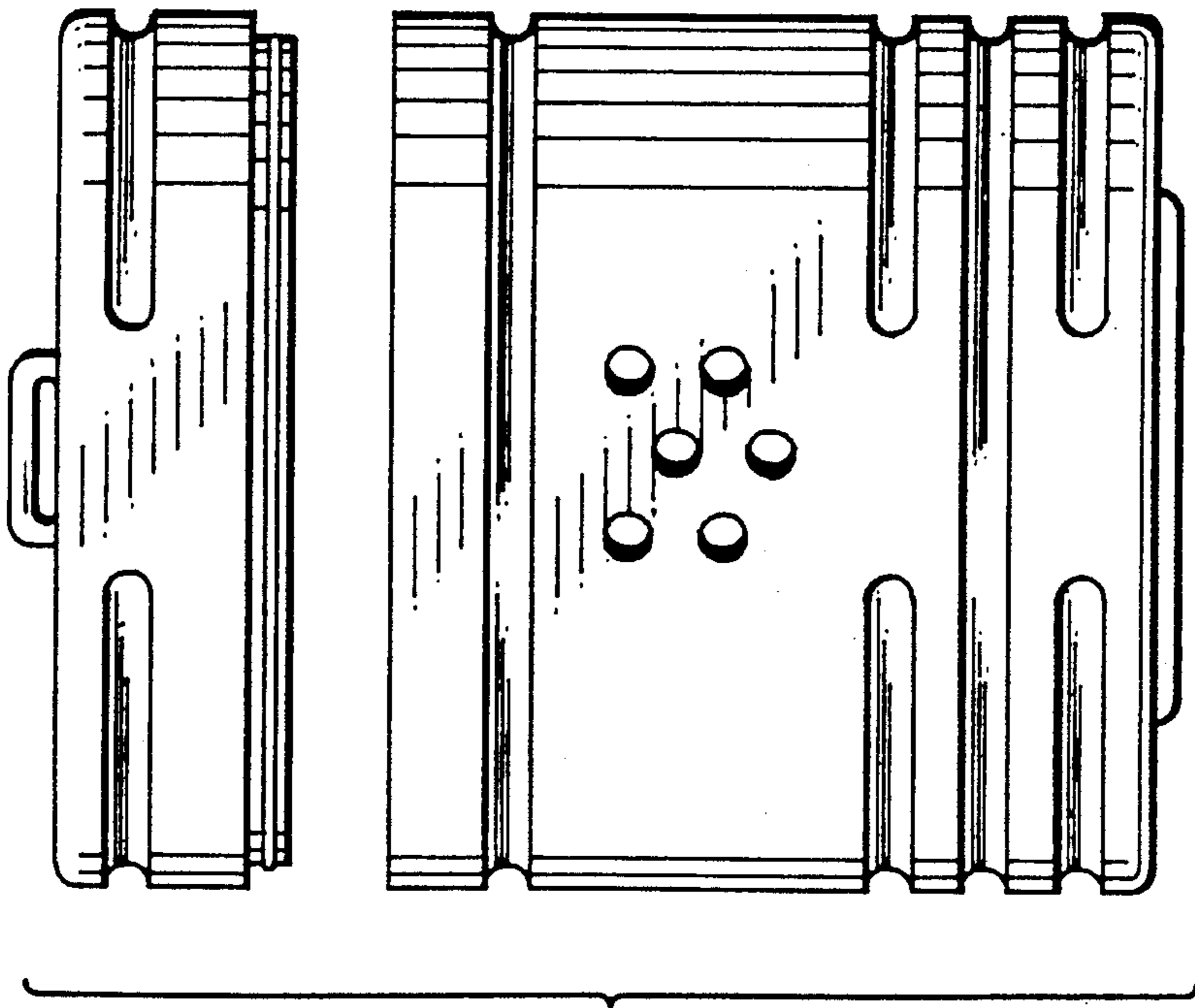

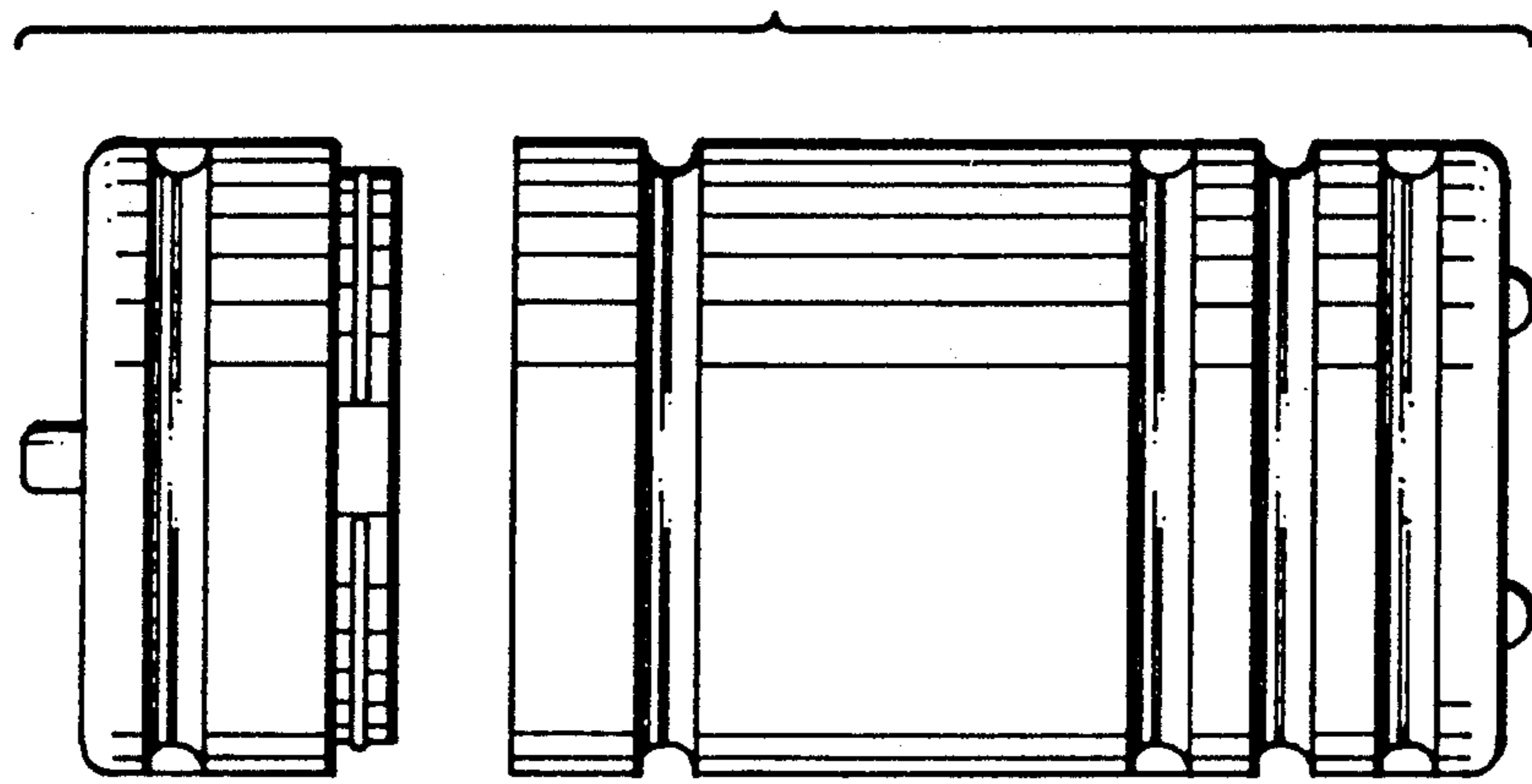

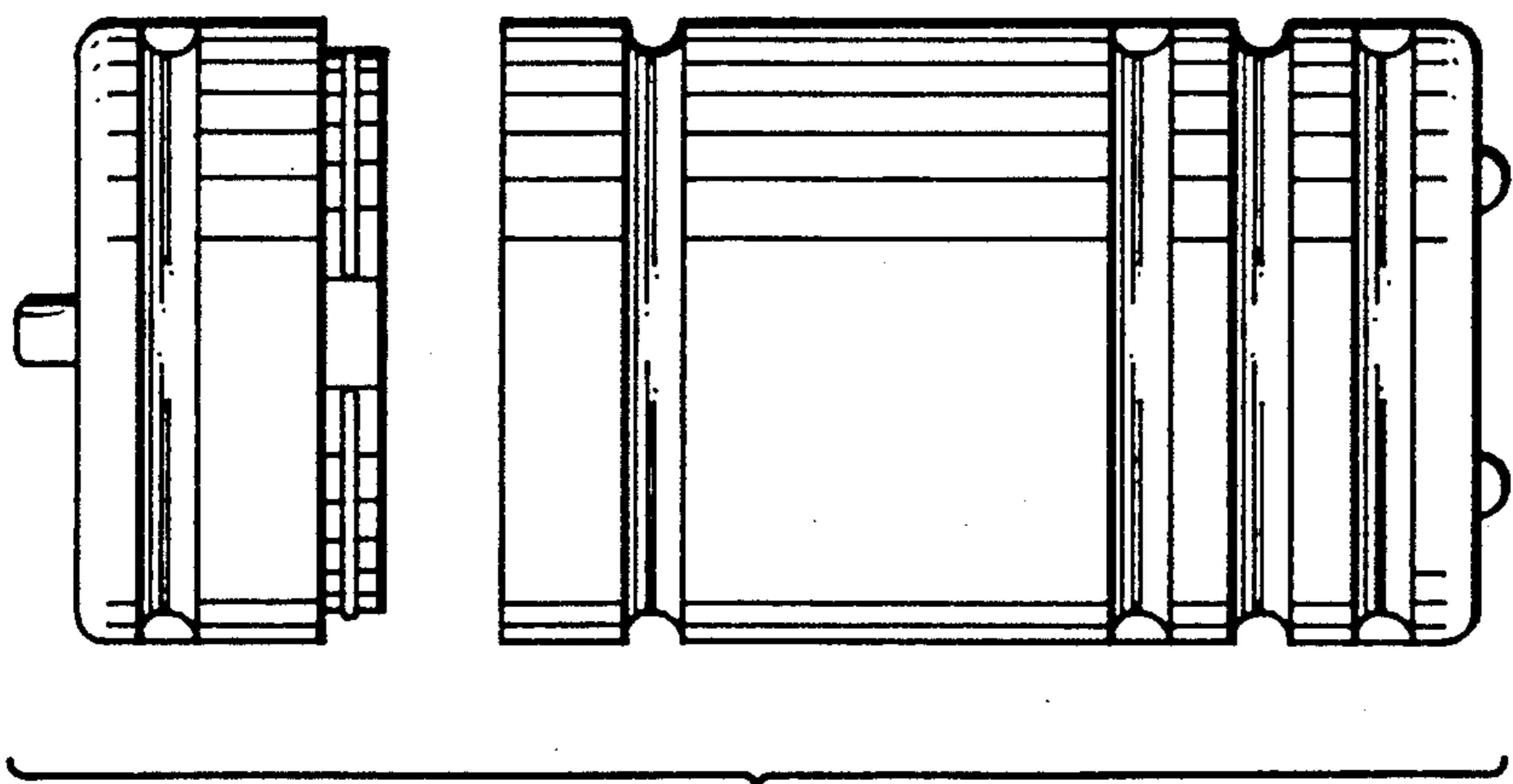

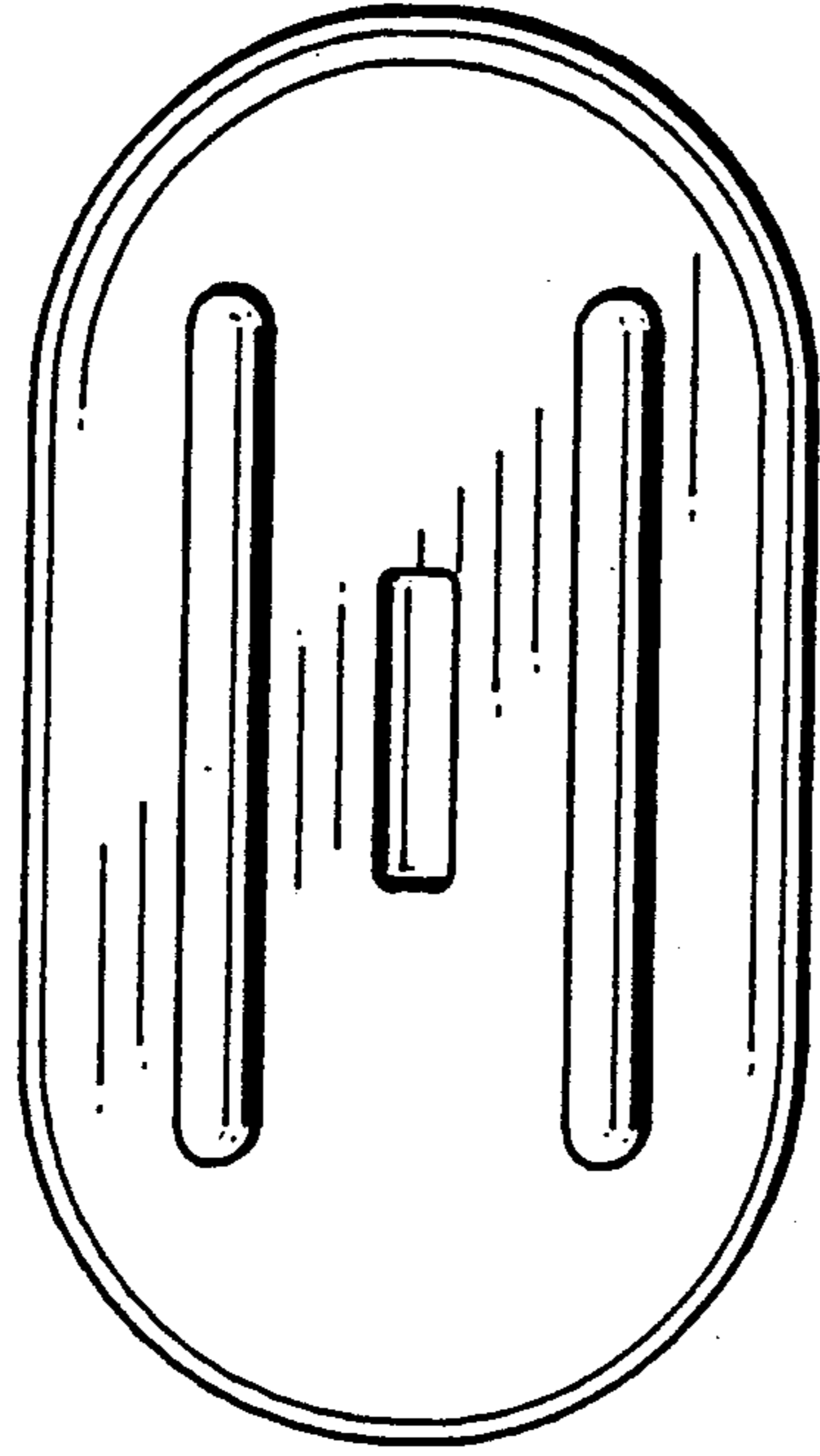

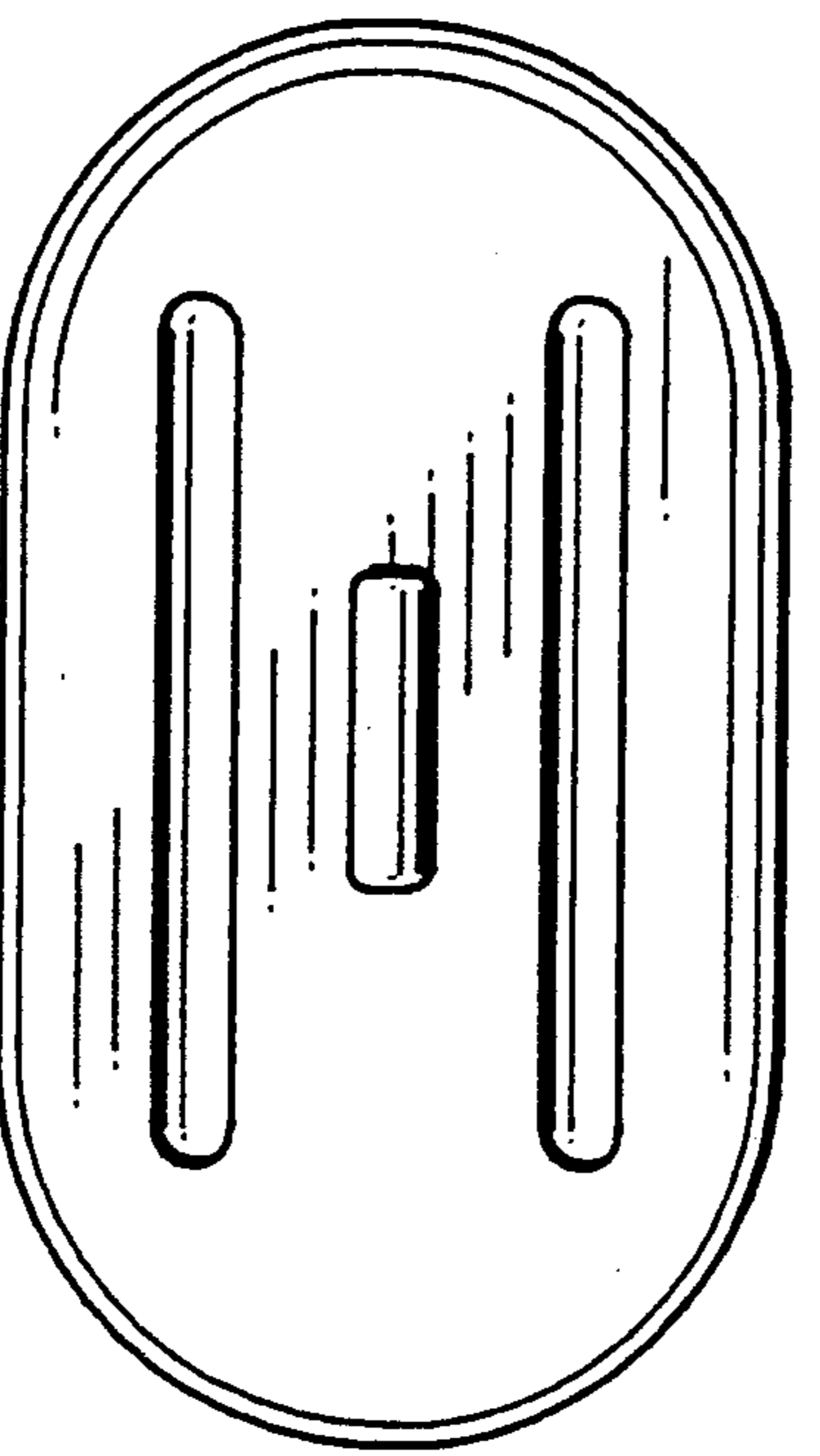
