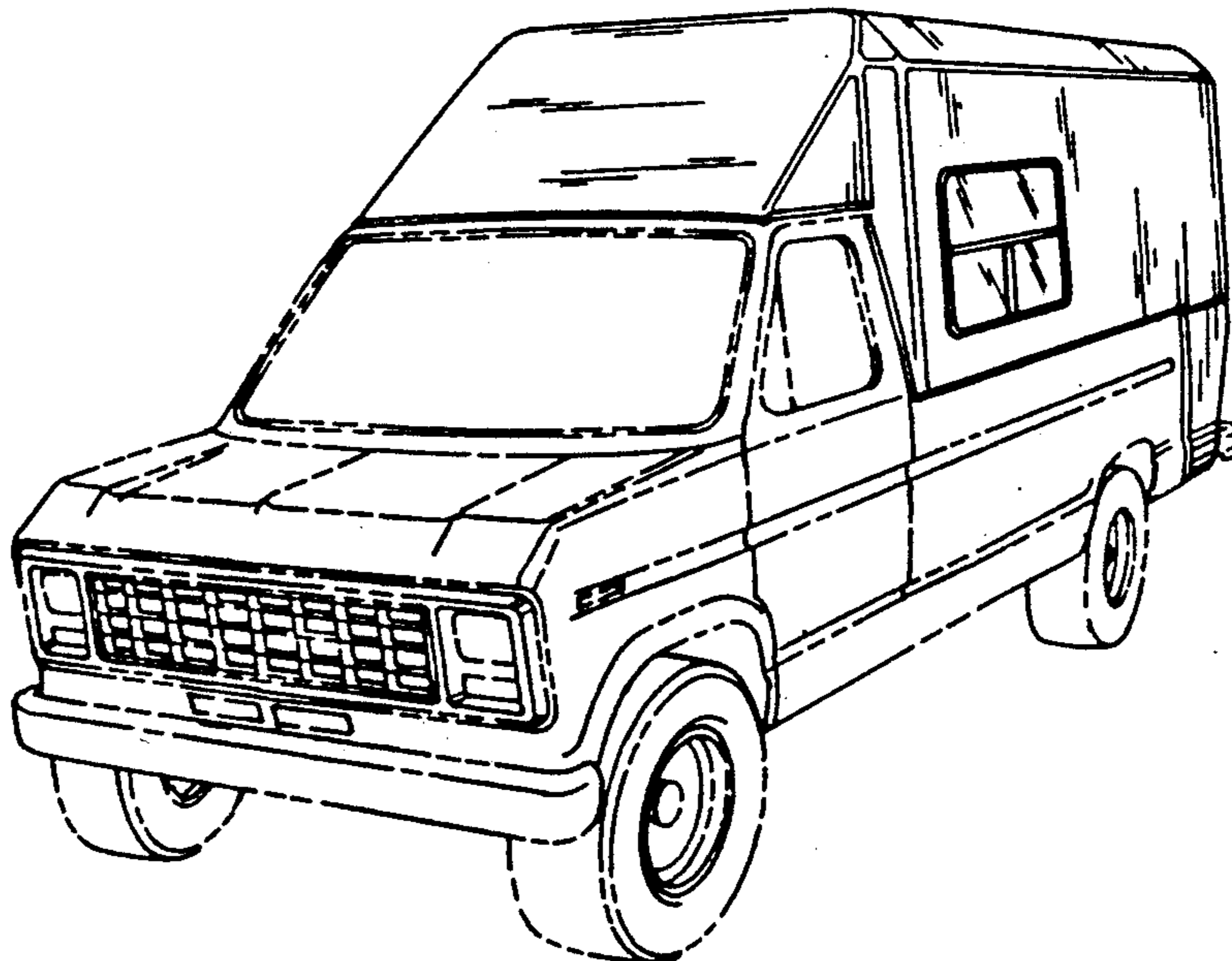

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a van mounted camper body, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a van mounted camper body showing my new design, it being understood that the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design; FIG. 2 is a side elevation thereof shown at an enlarged scale as viewed from the right-hand side of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is an enlarged side elevational view thereof opposite to that of FIG. 2; FIG. 4 is an enlarged front elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is an enlarged rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 6 is an enlarged top plan view thereof.



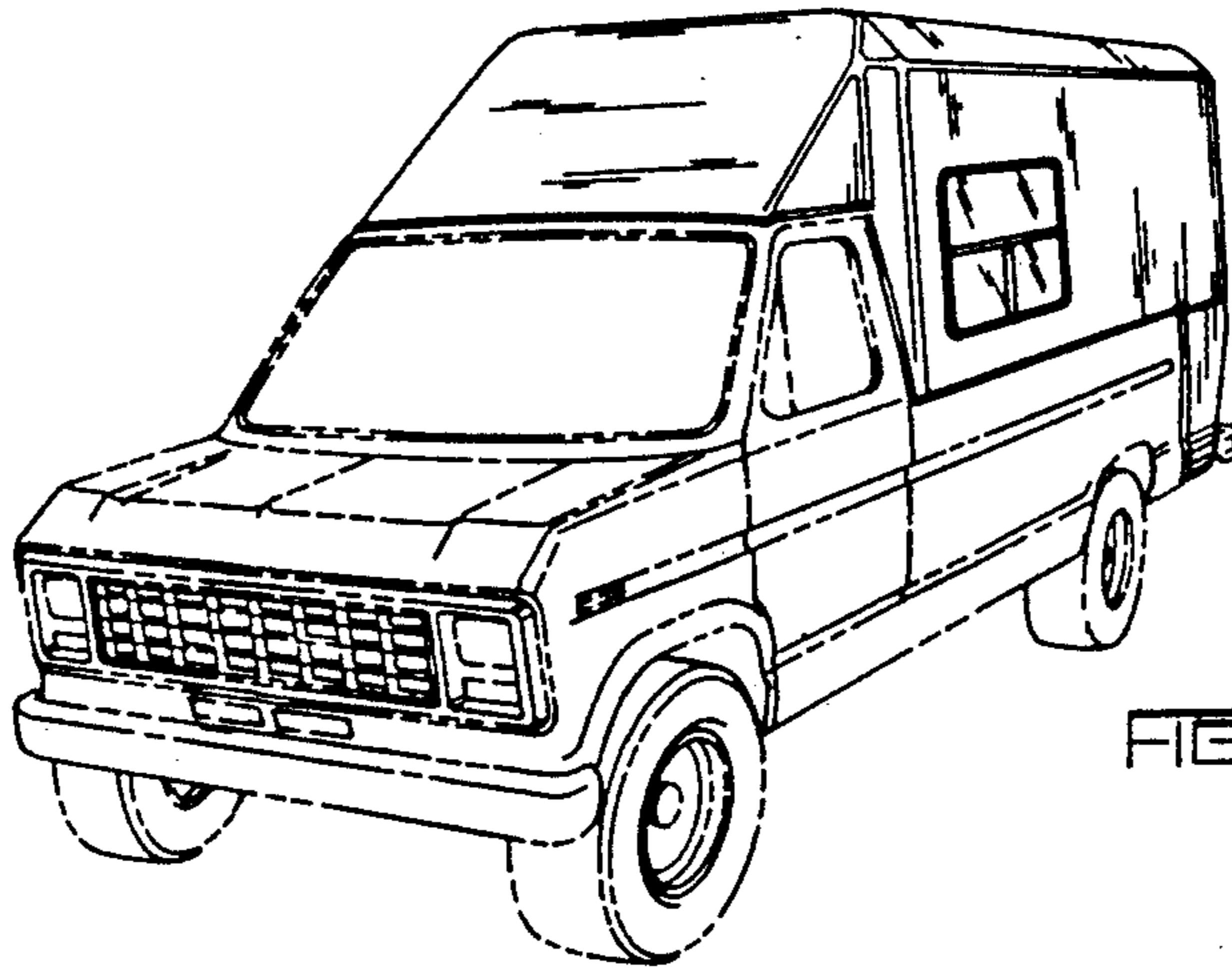

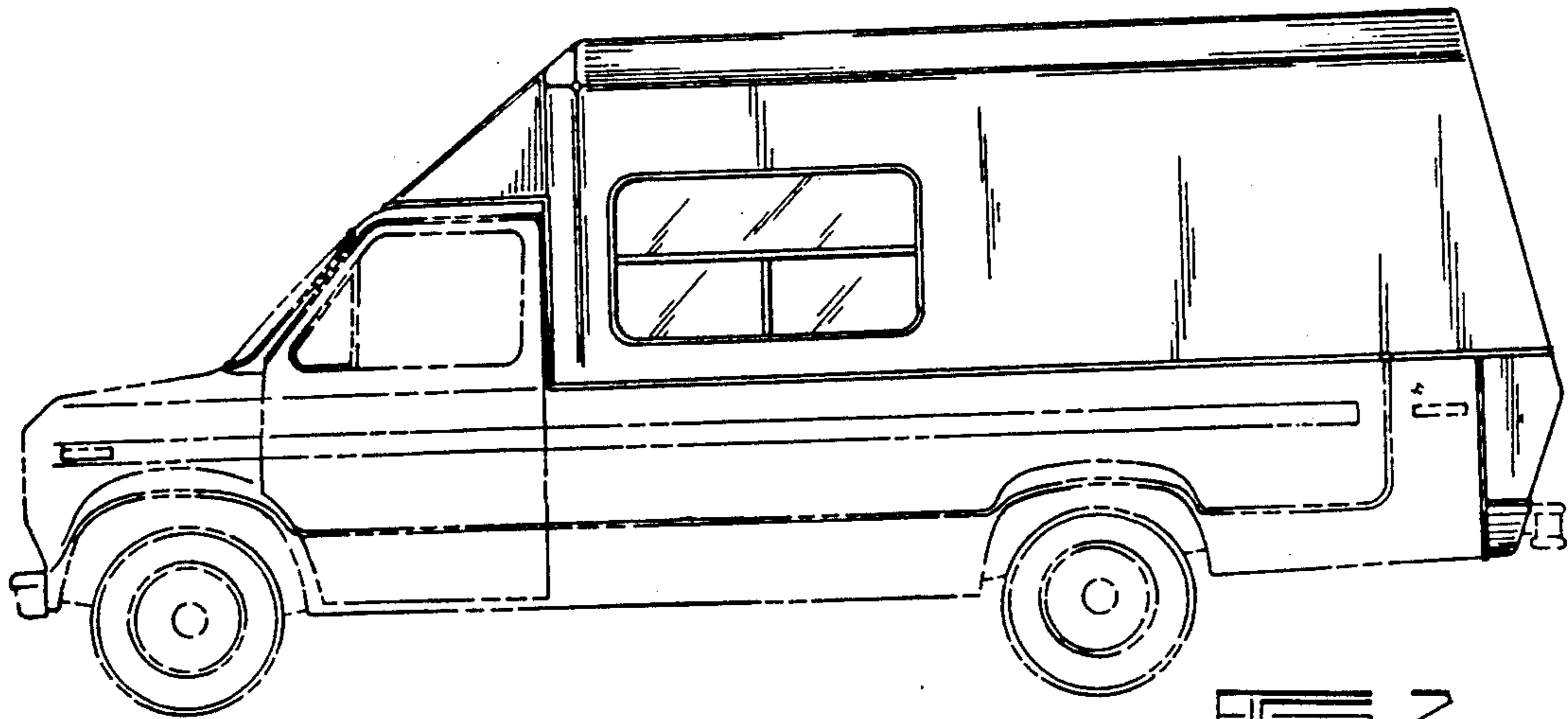

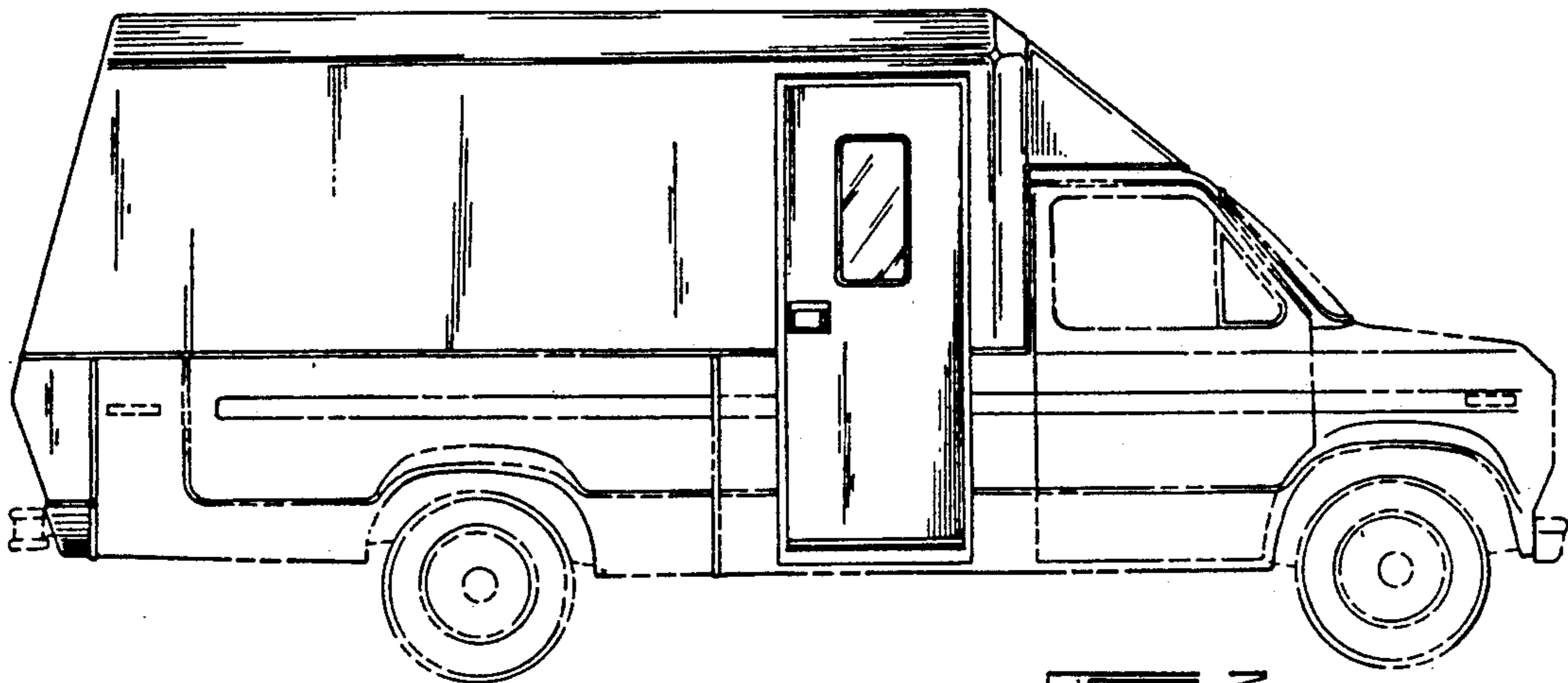

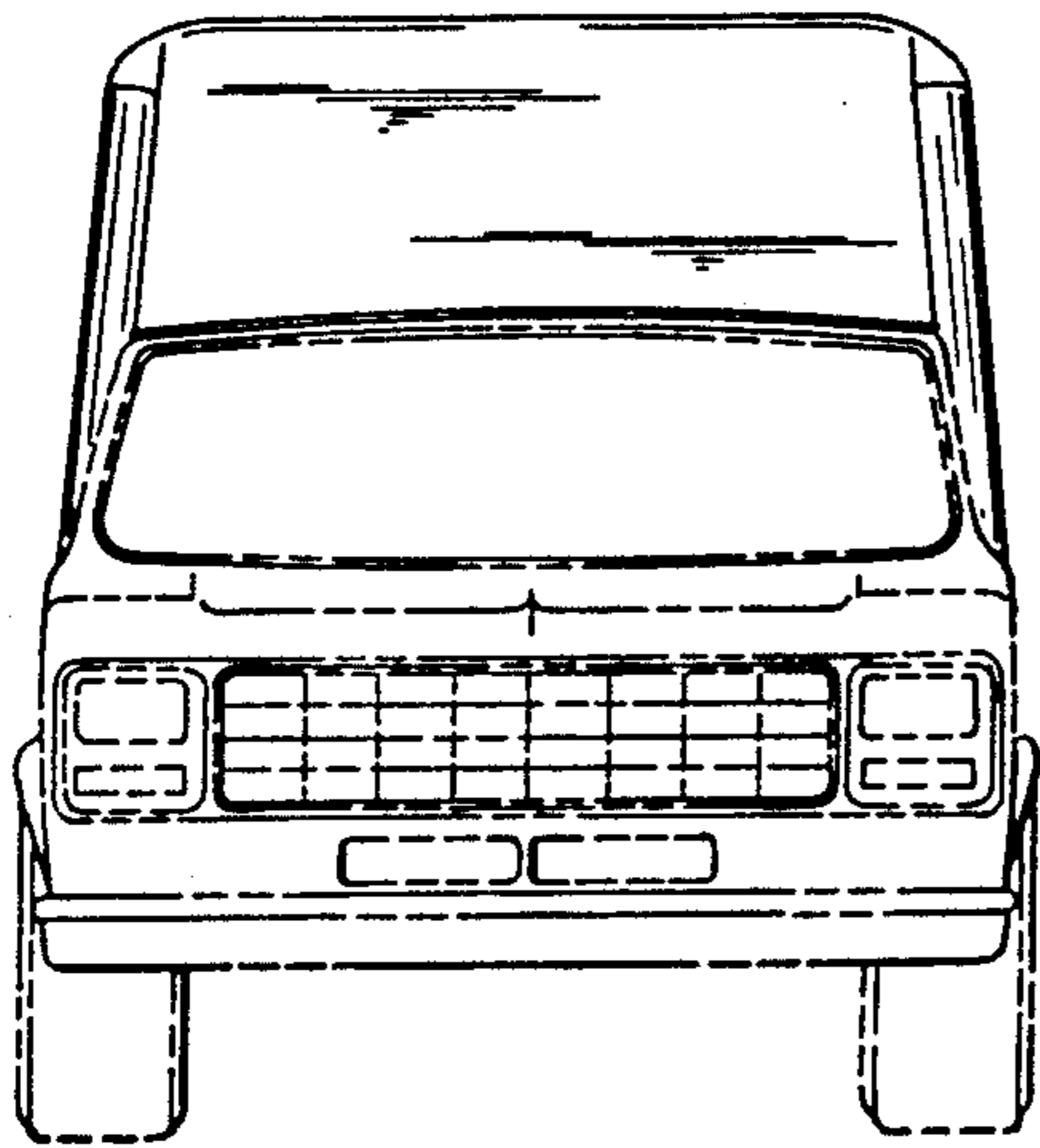

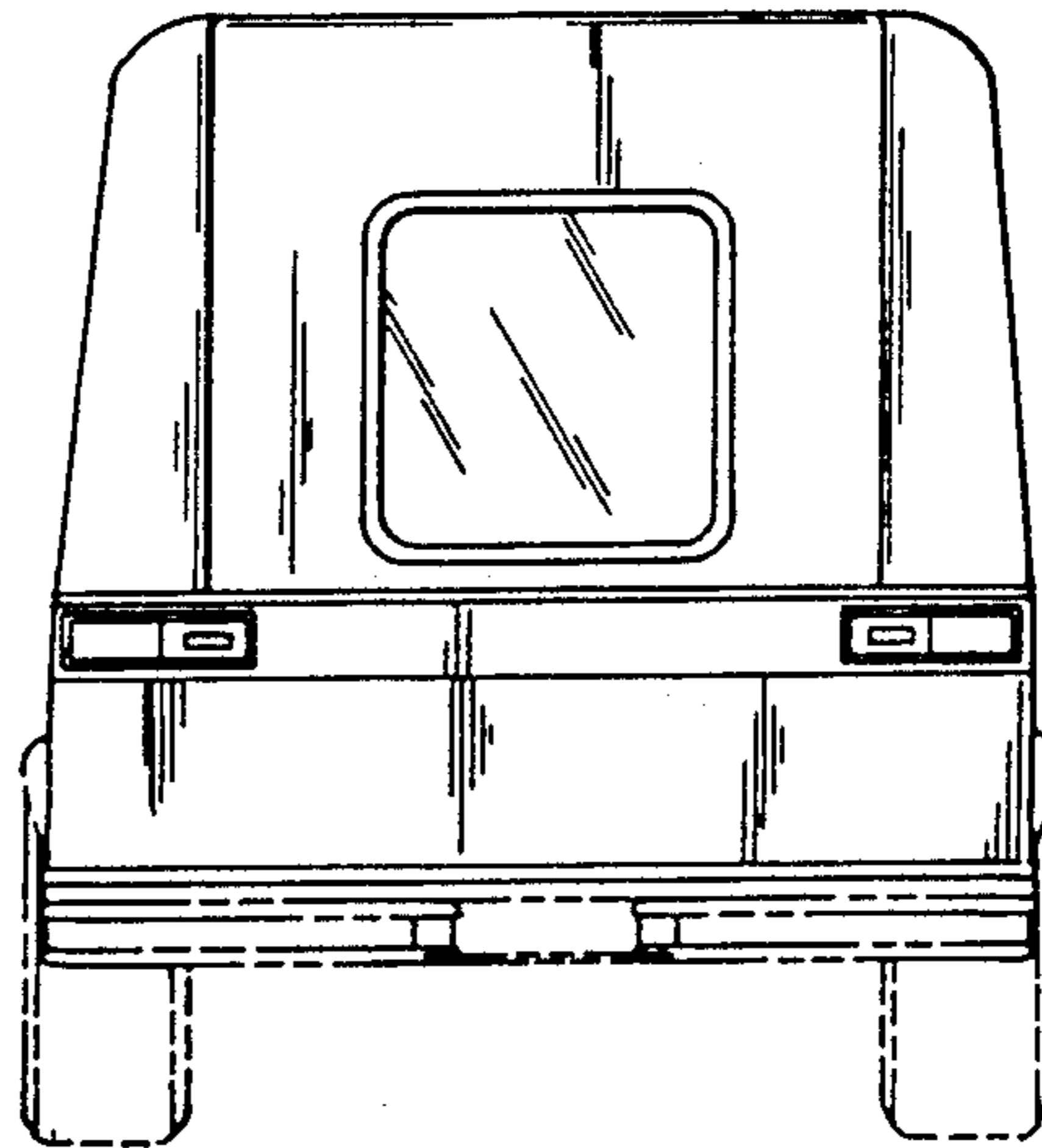

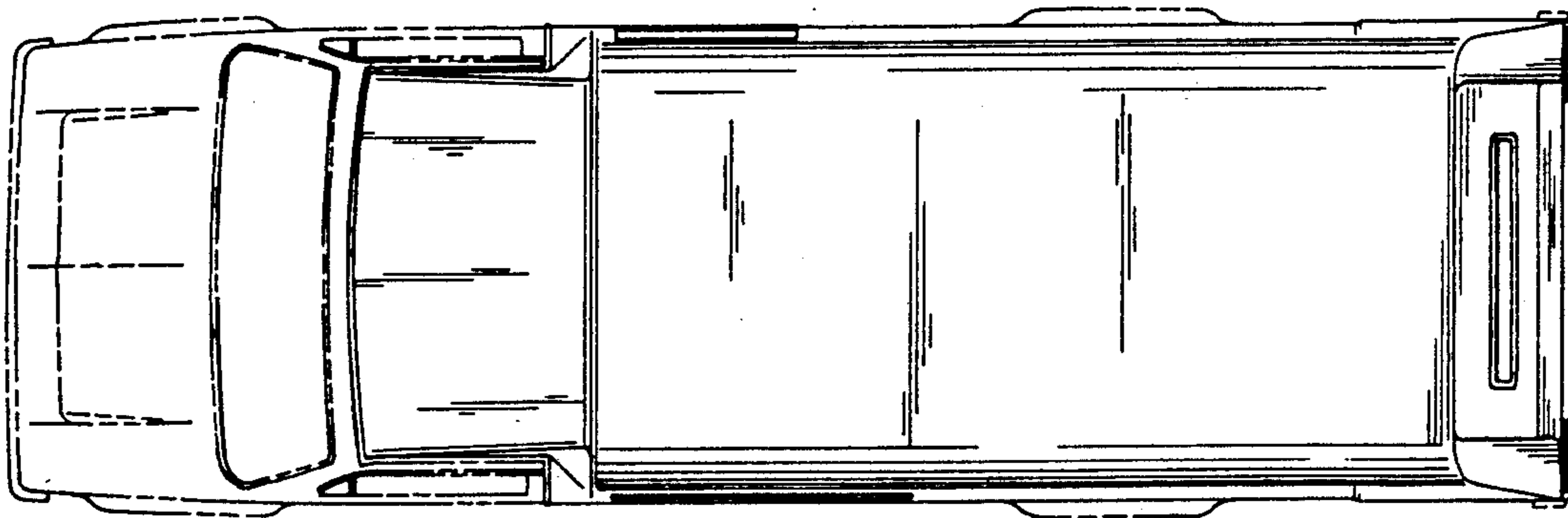
