DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an eyeglass retainer with integral floating preserver showing my new design;


FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a top elevational view thereof; and
