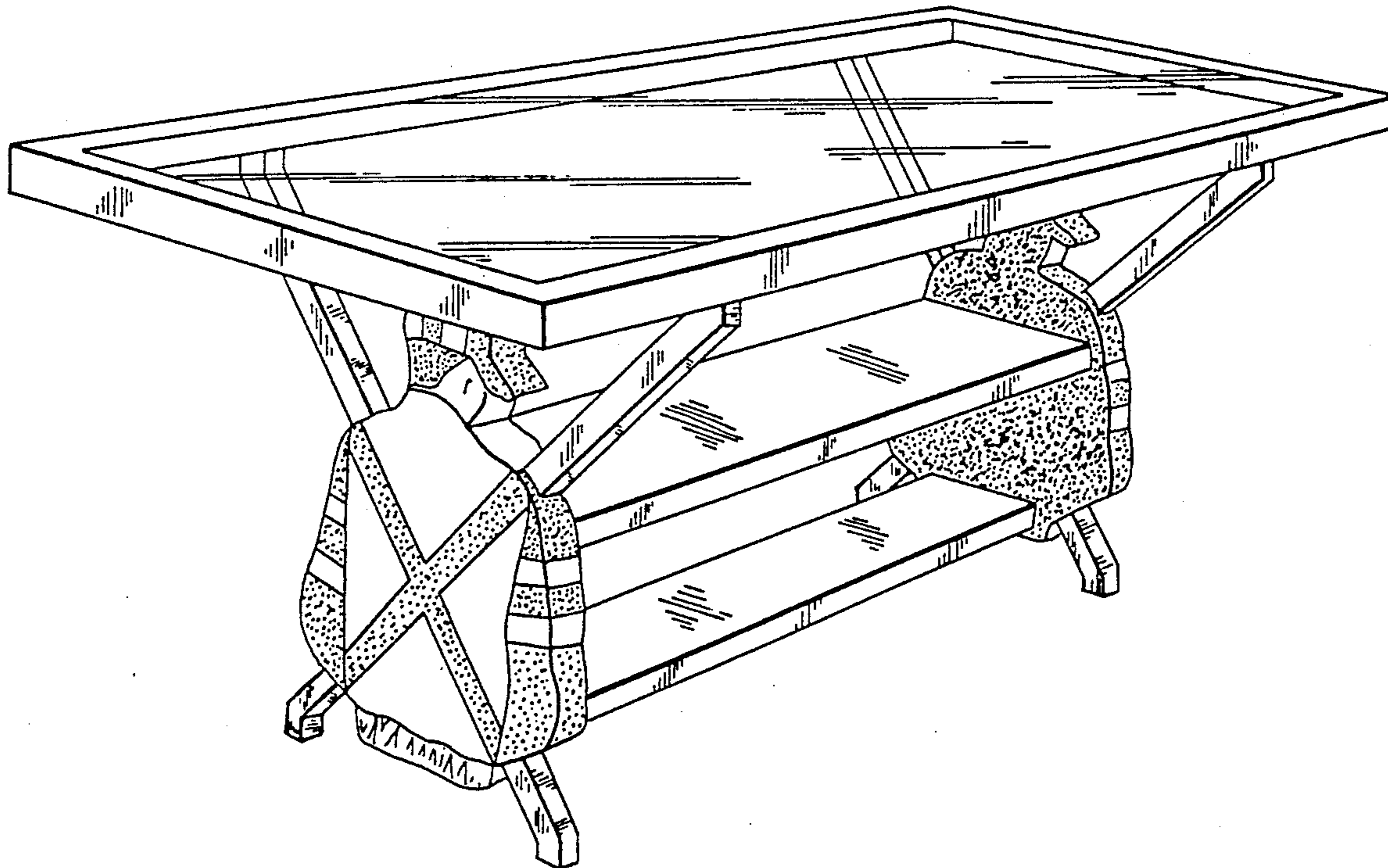

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a table showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is an elevational view, showing the side opposite that shown in FIG. 3 thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is an end elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is an elevational view, showing the end opposite that shown in FIG. 6 thereof.



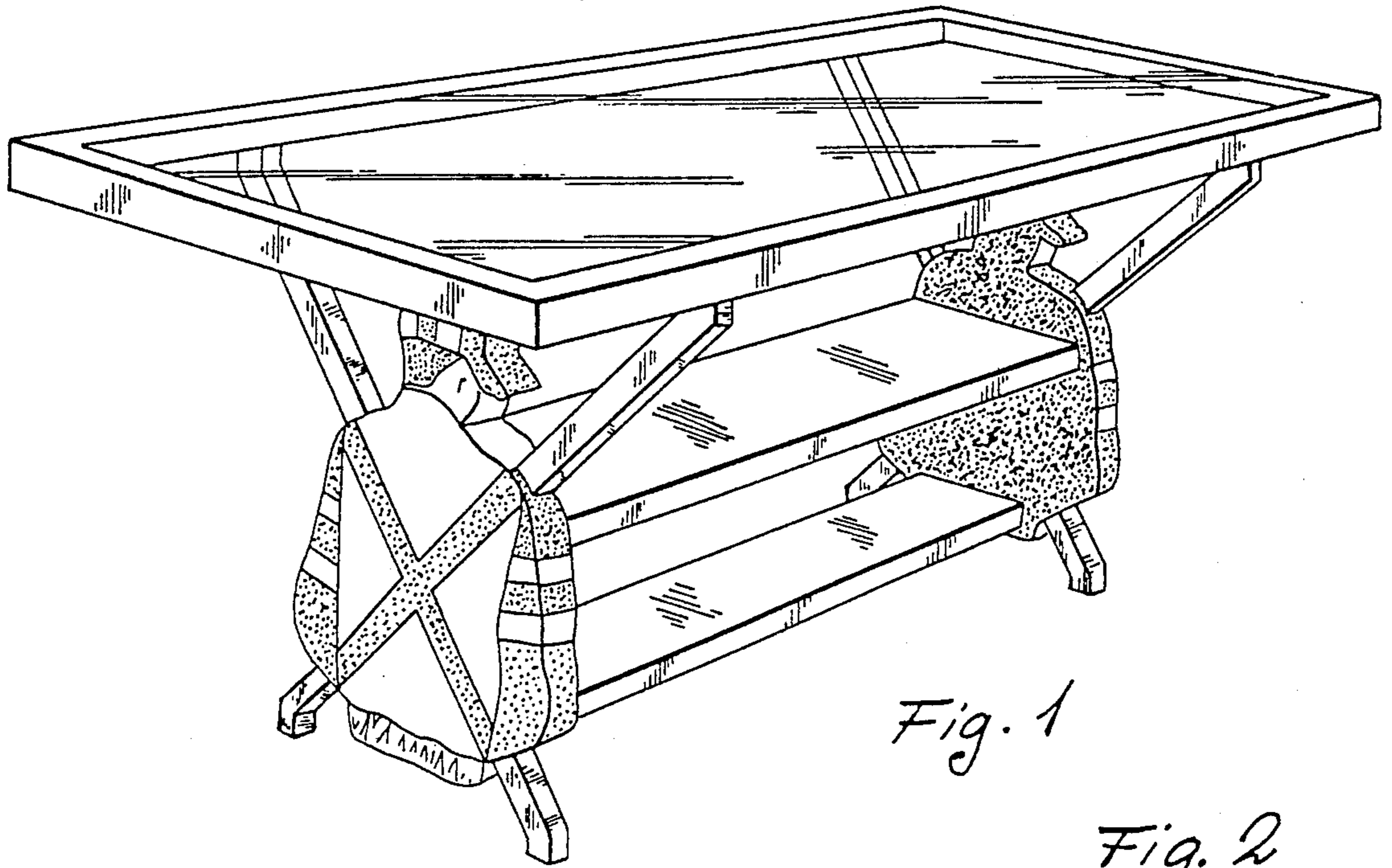

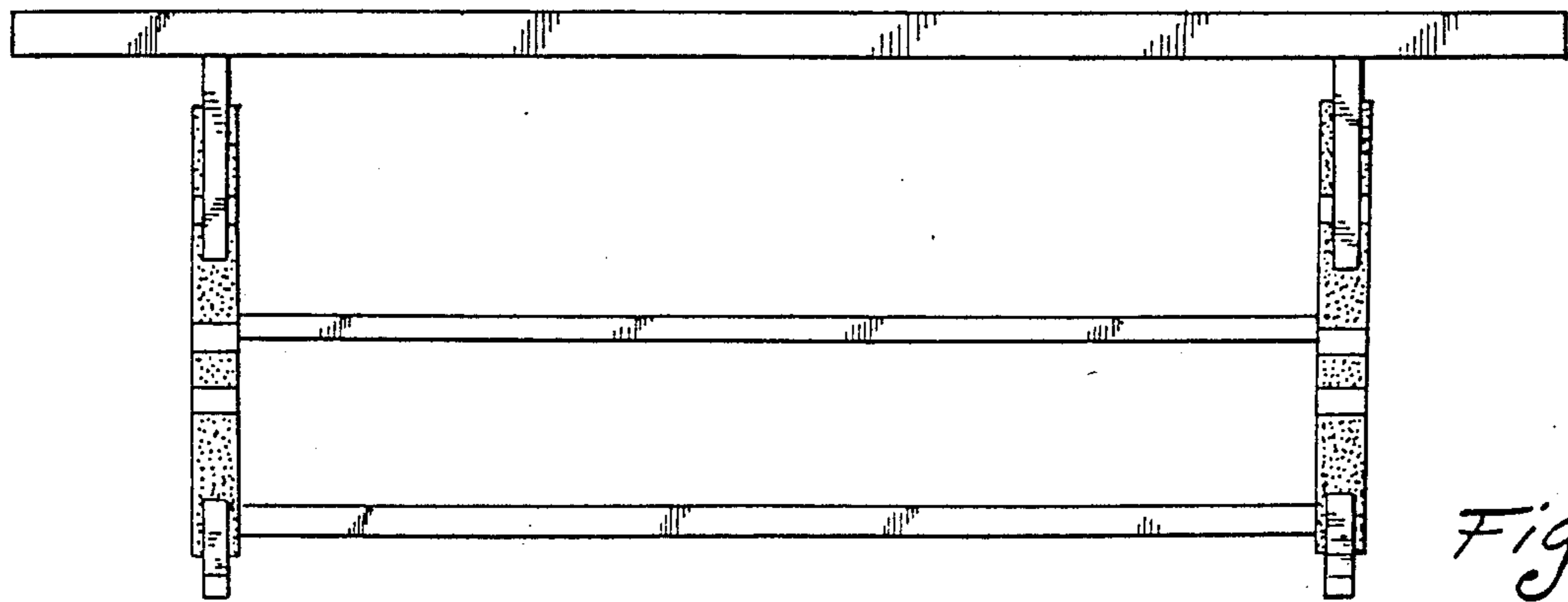
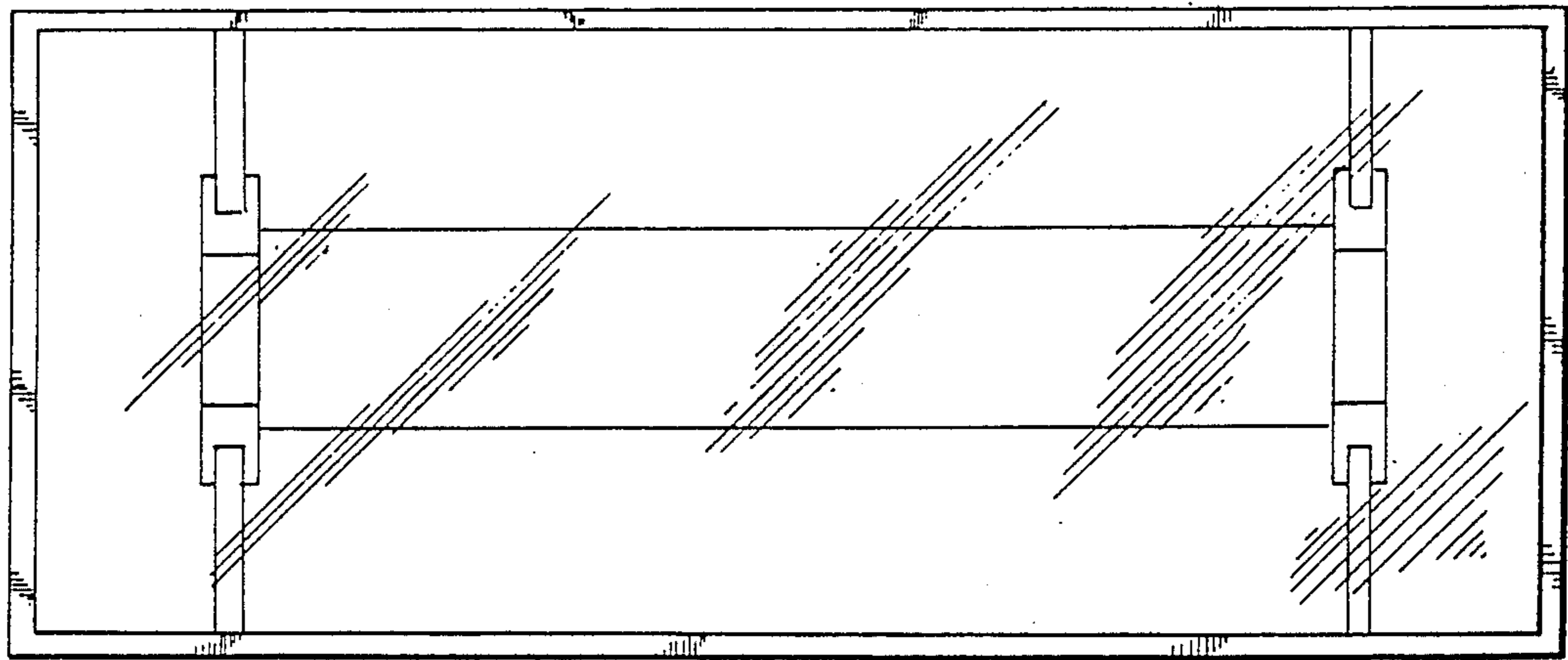

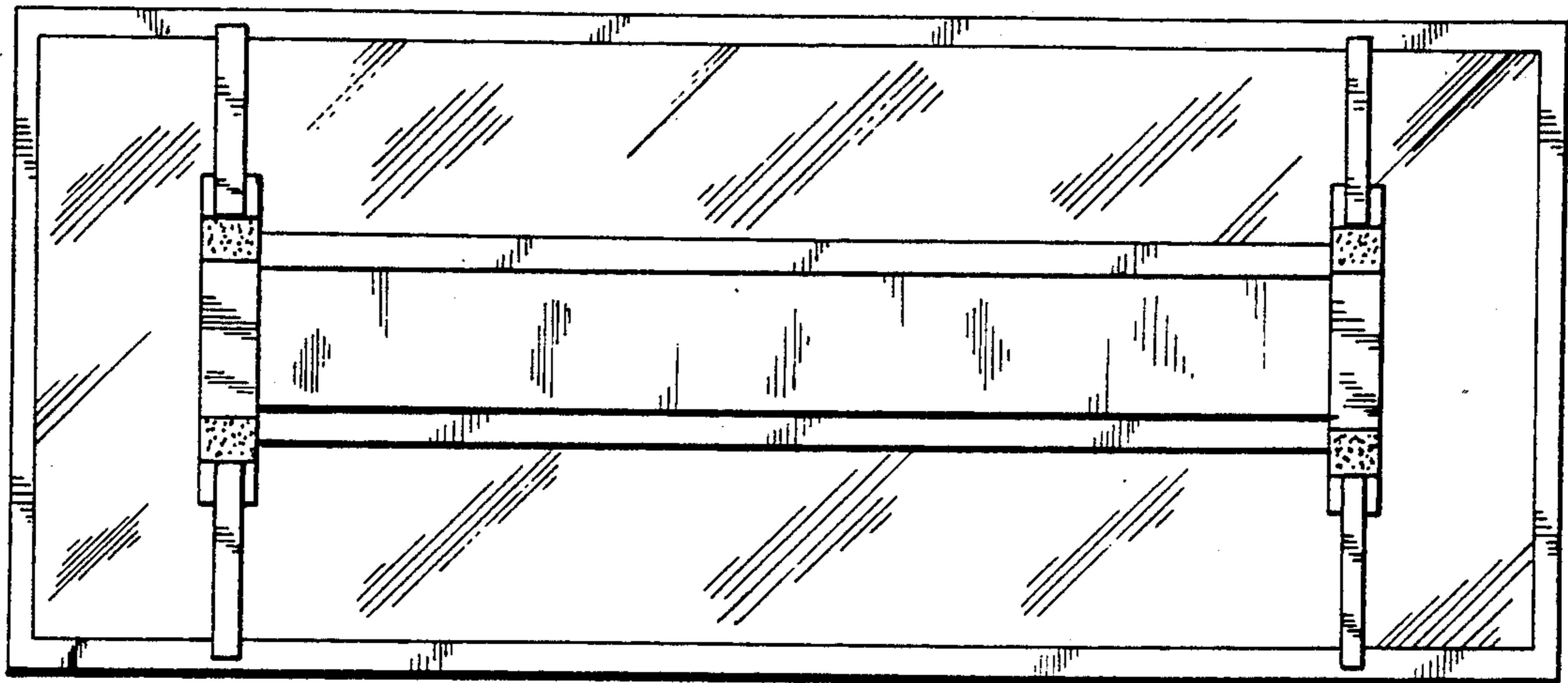

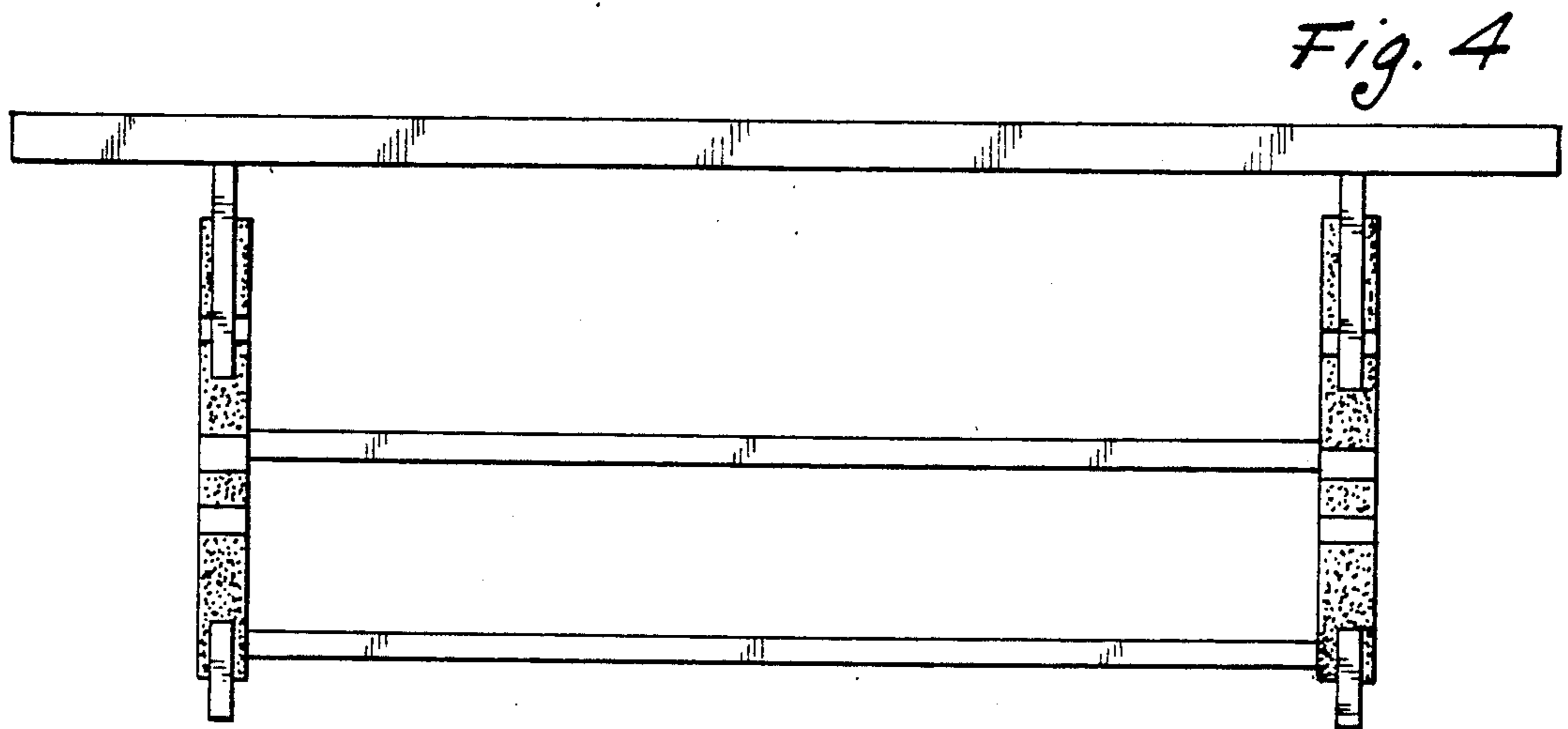

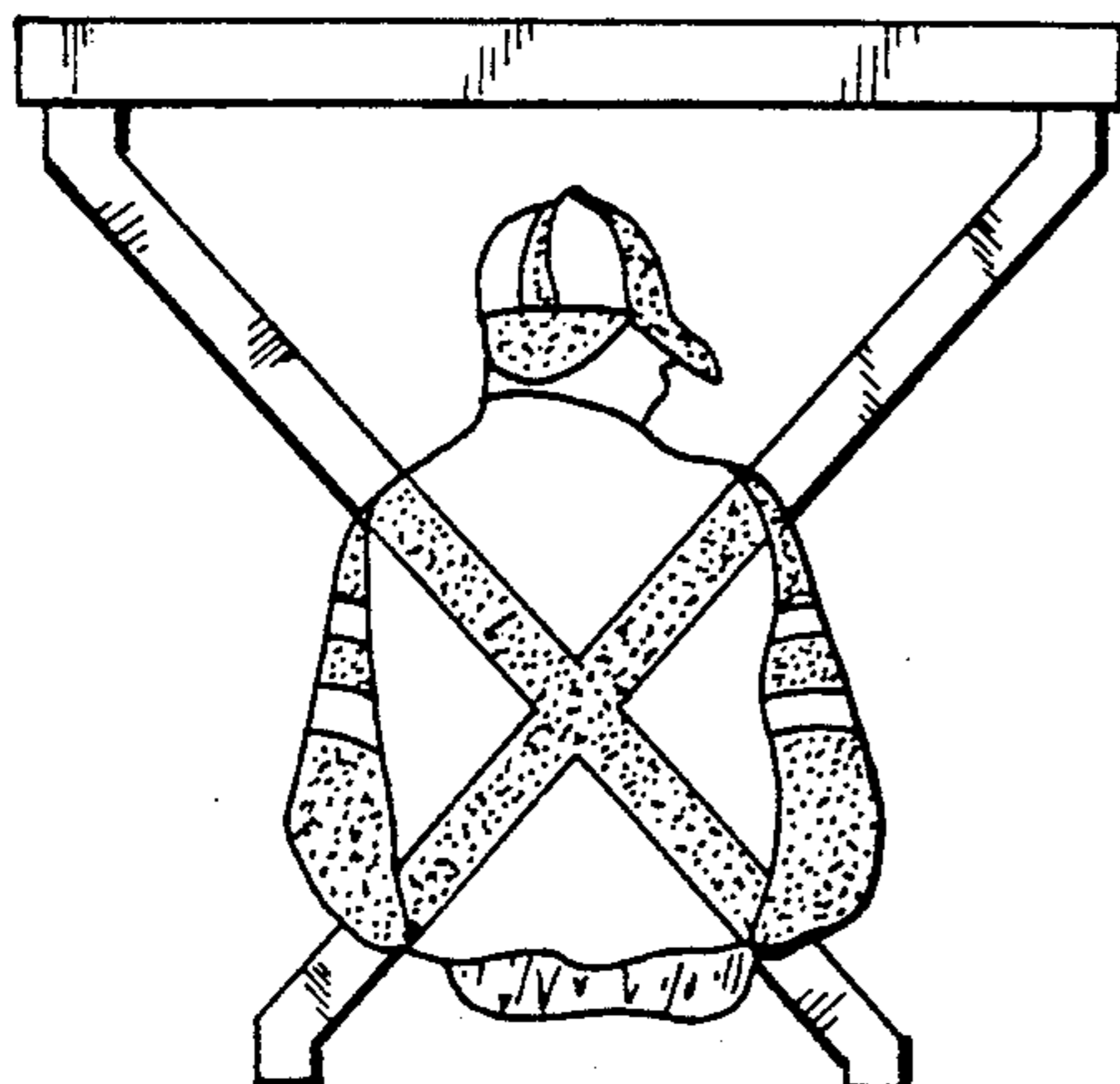
