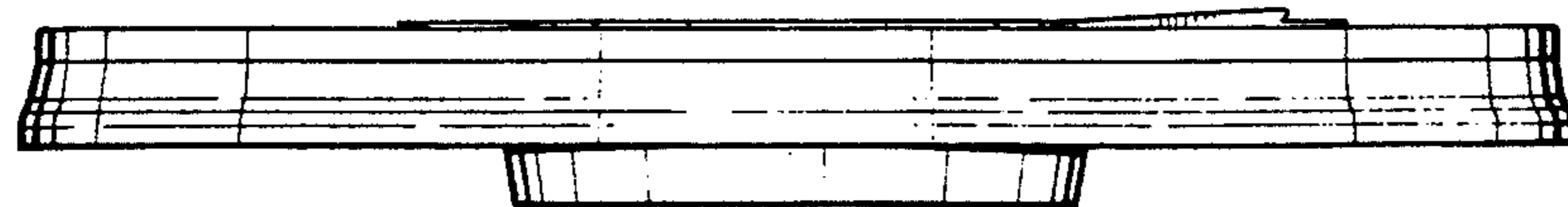
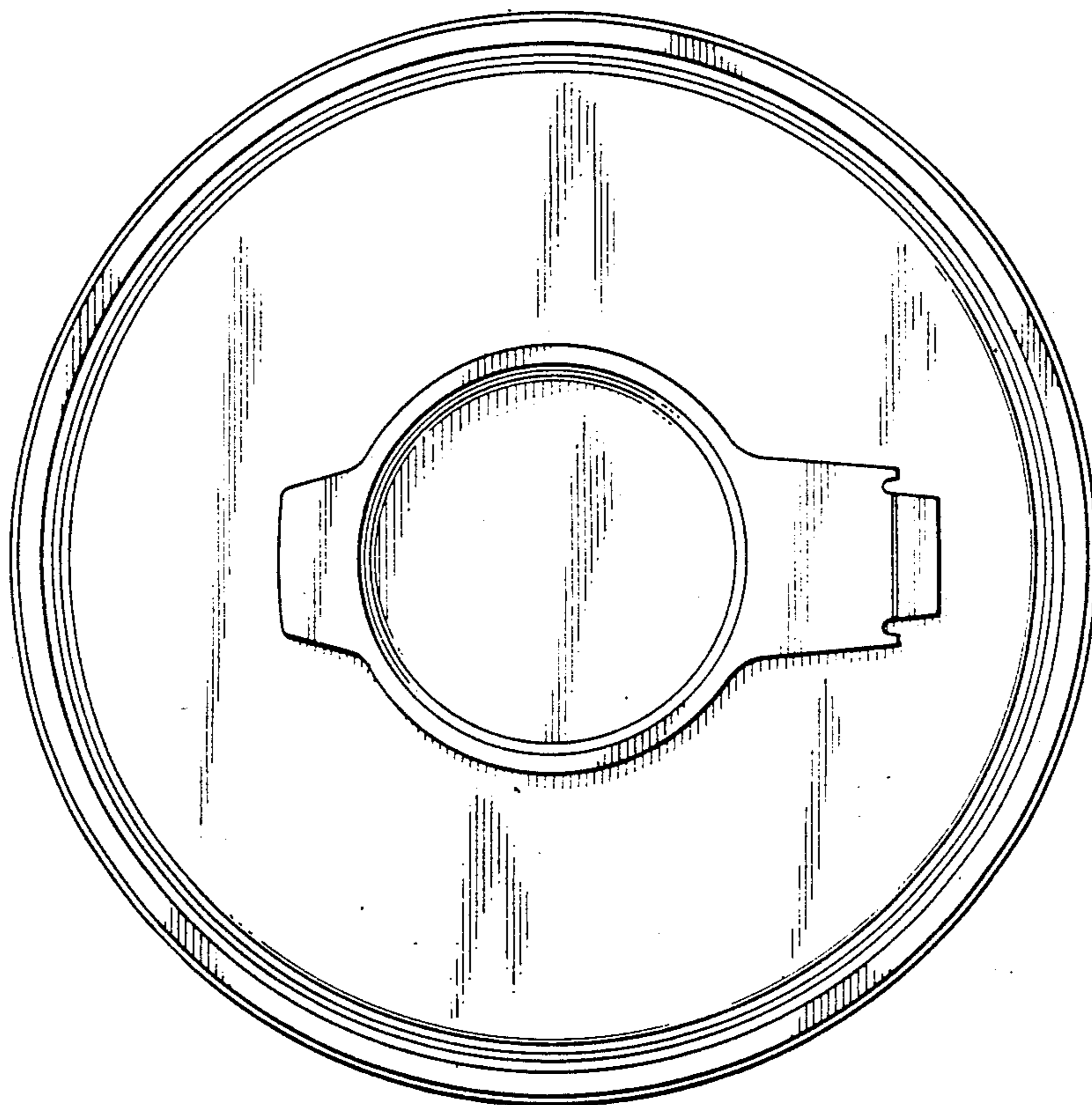
The ornamental design for a lid for a container, as shown.

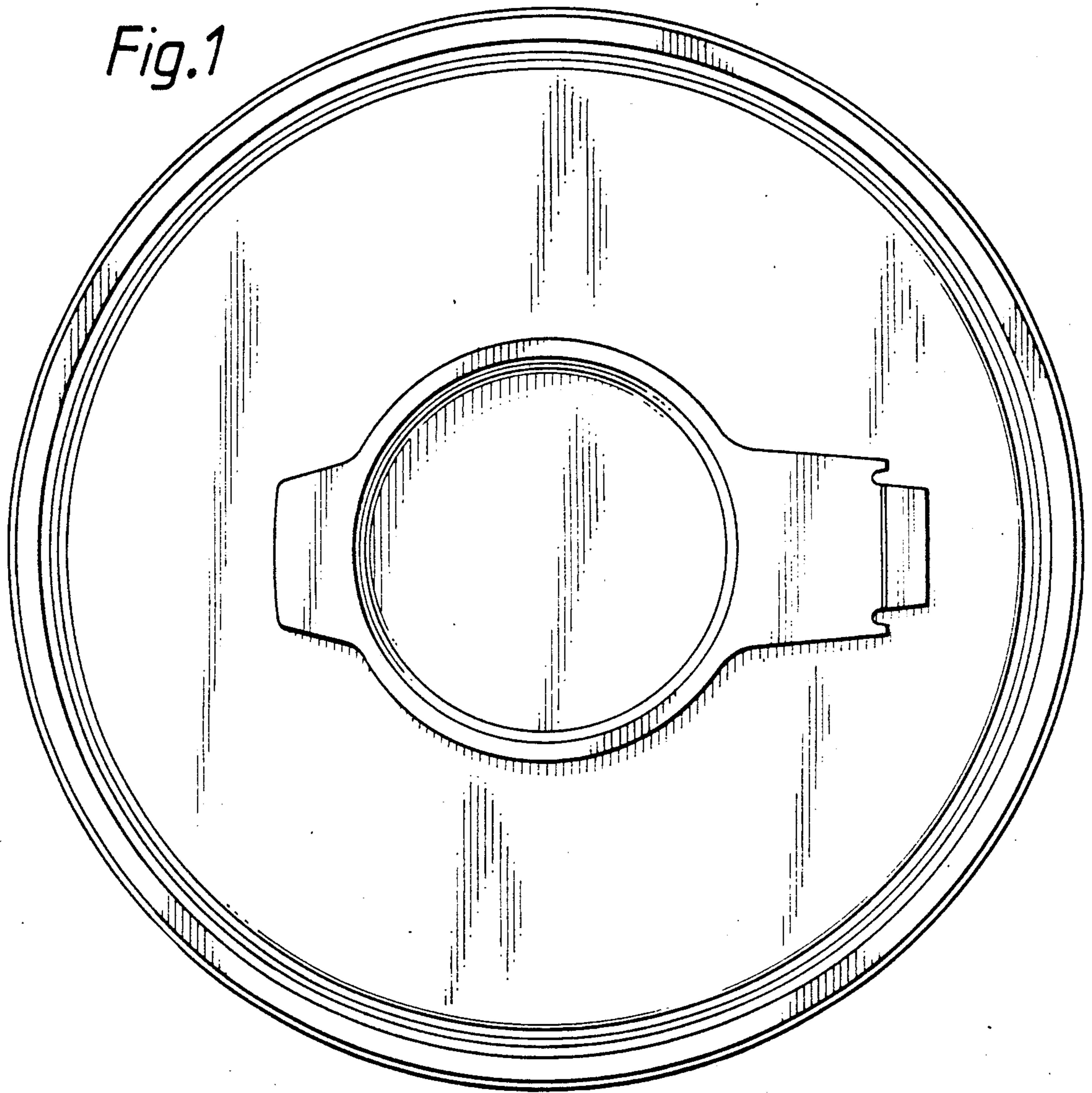
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a lid for a container showing my new design;

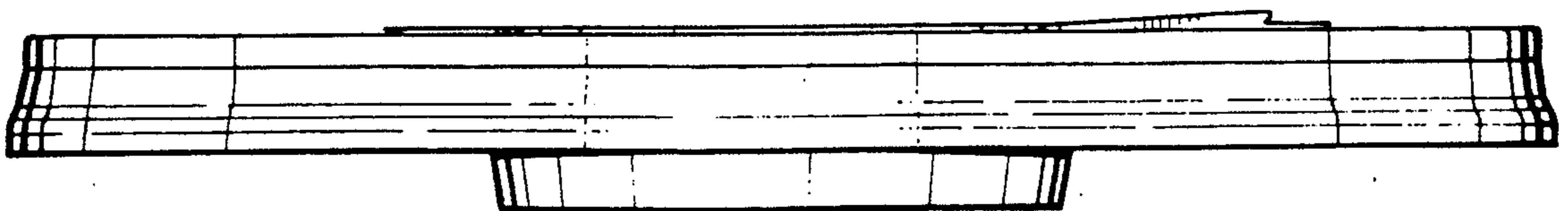
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
