 FIG. 7 is a sectional view thereof.

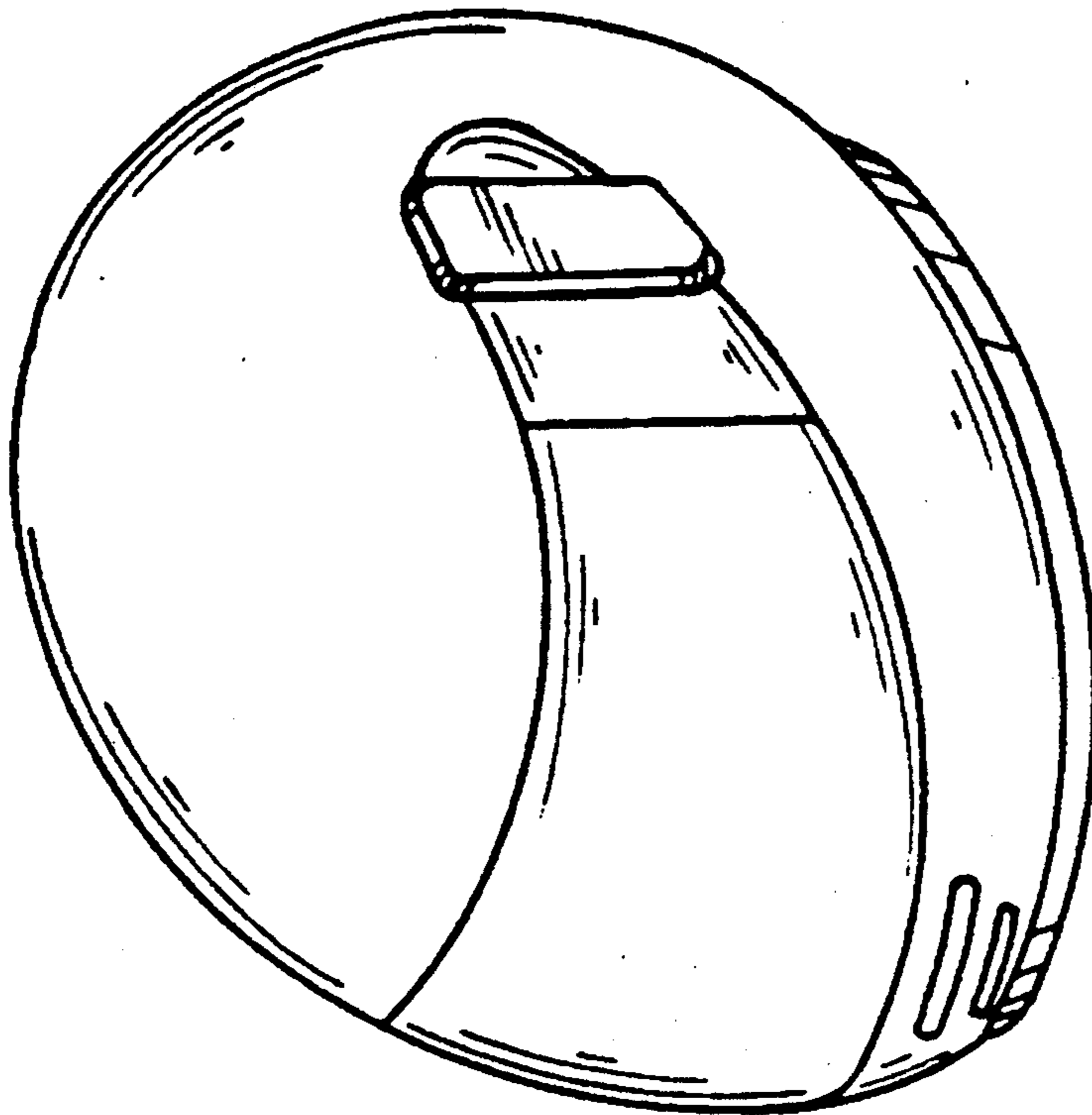

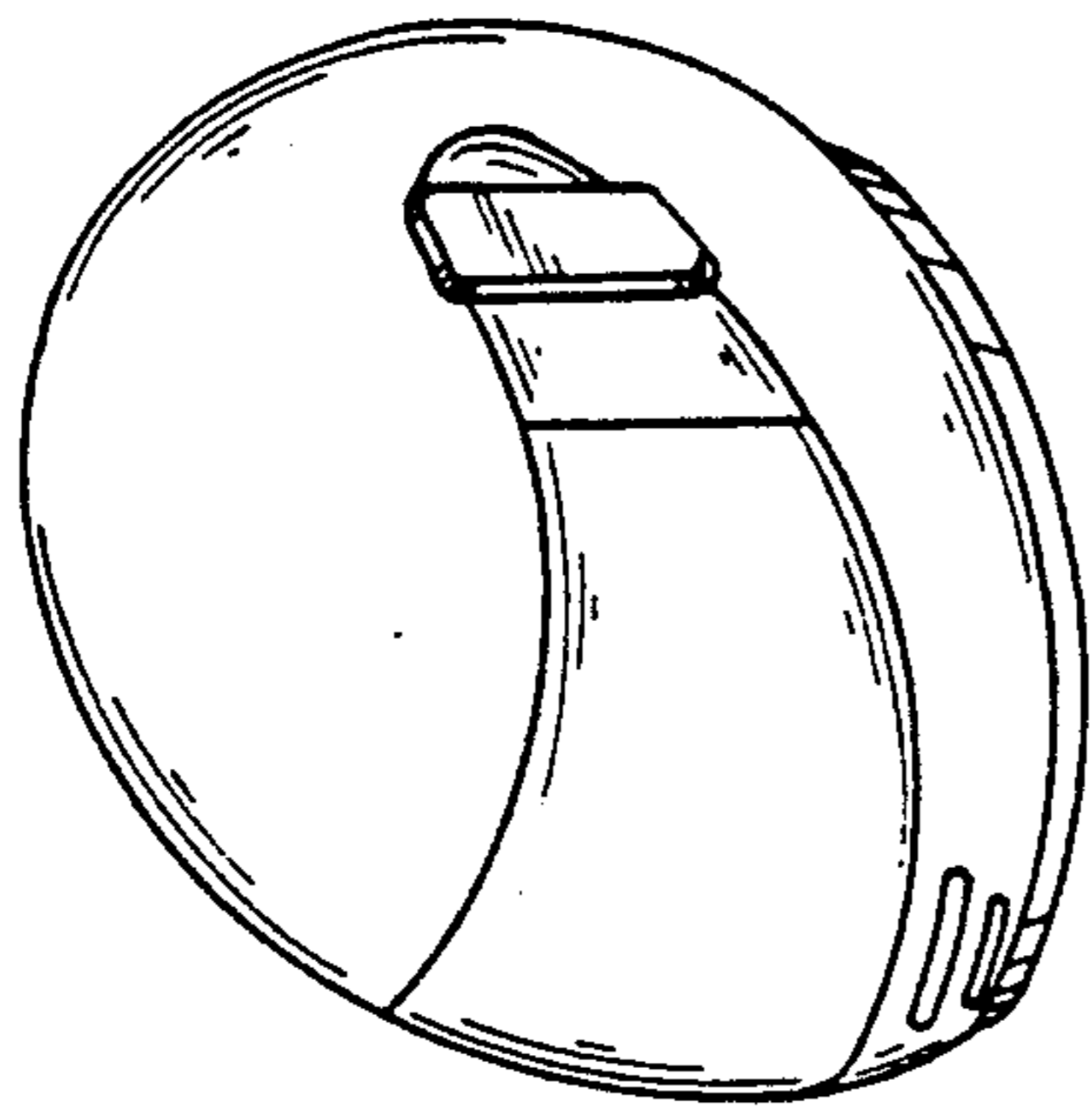

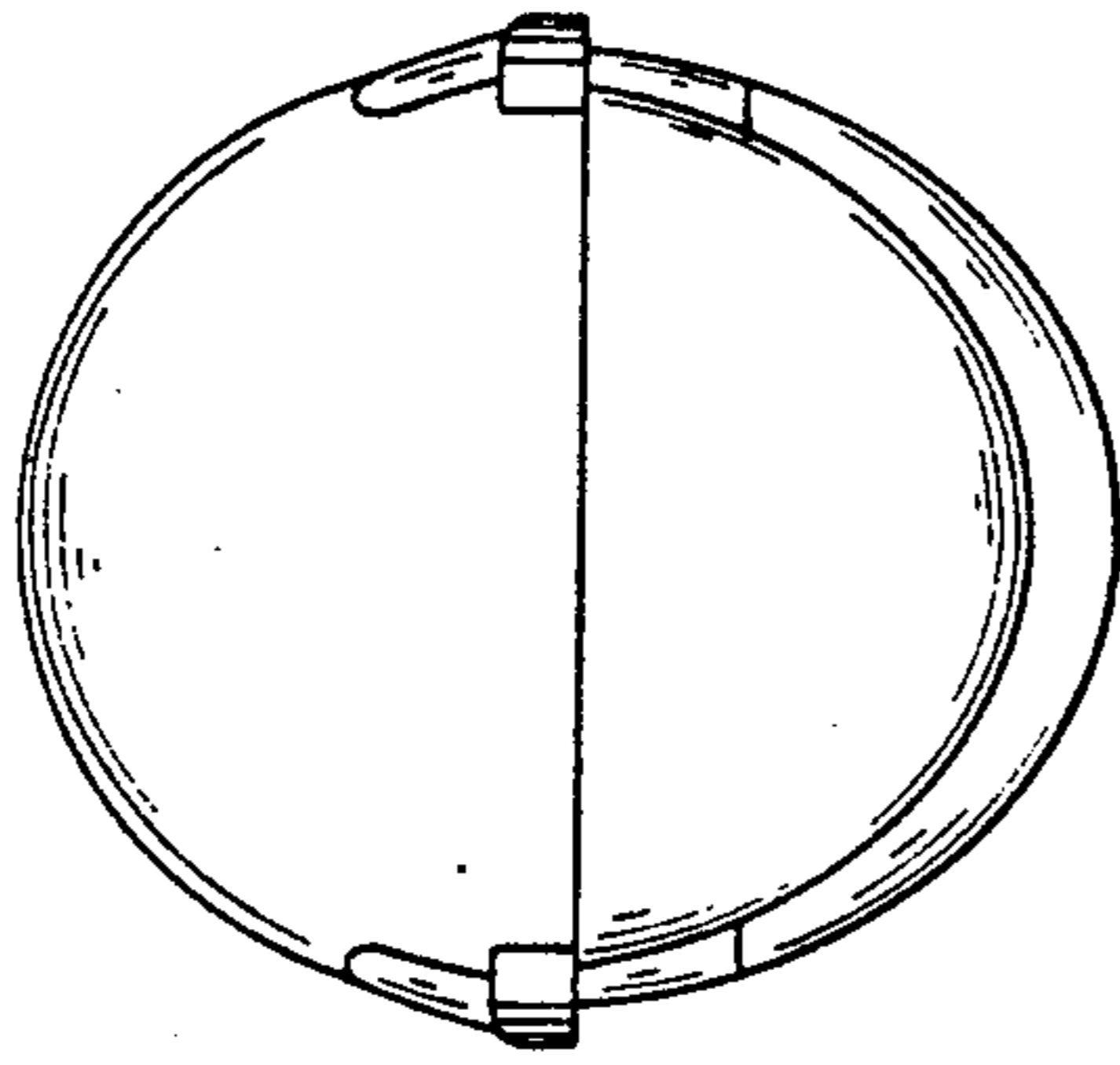

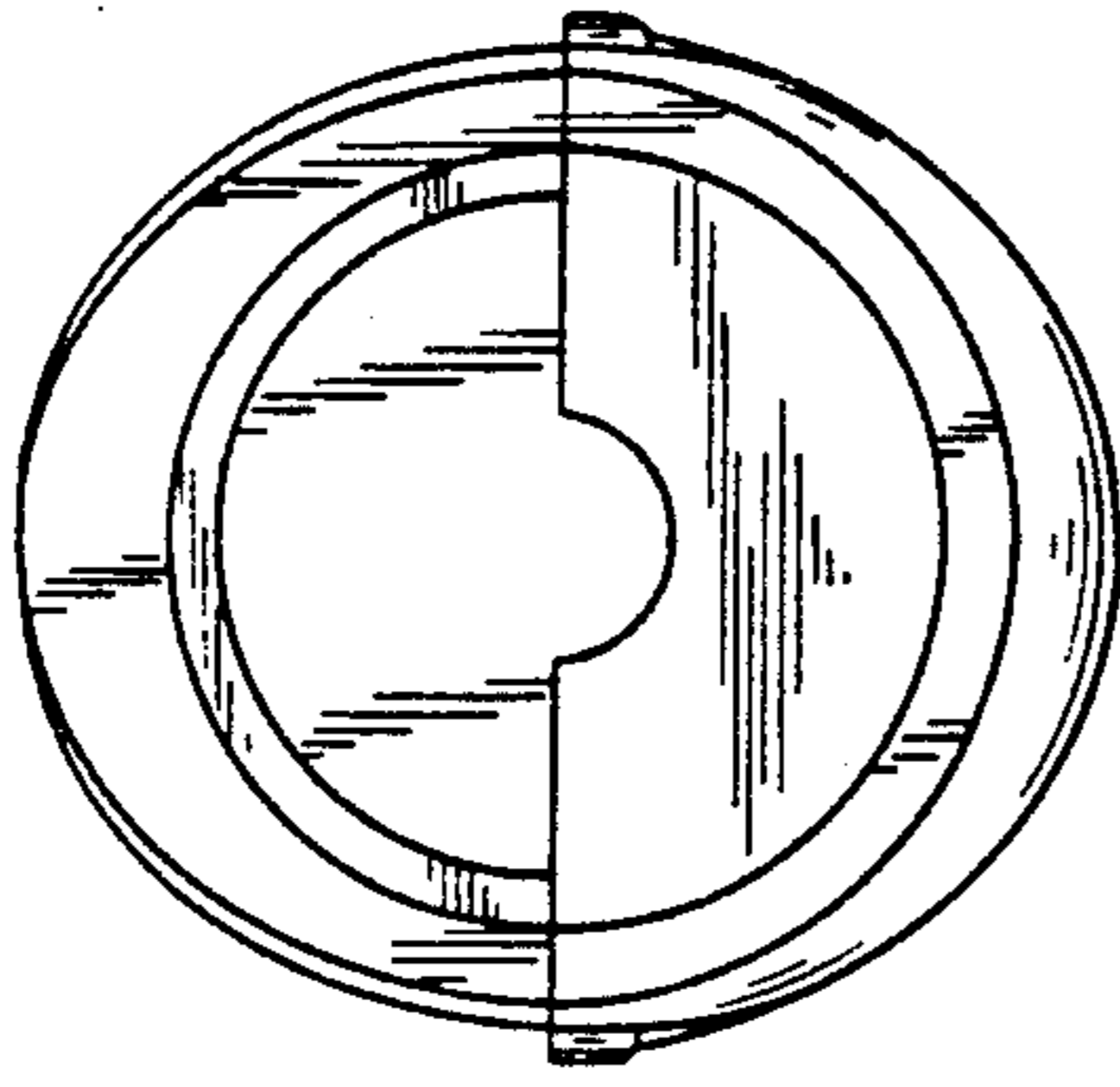

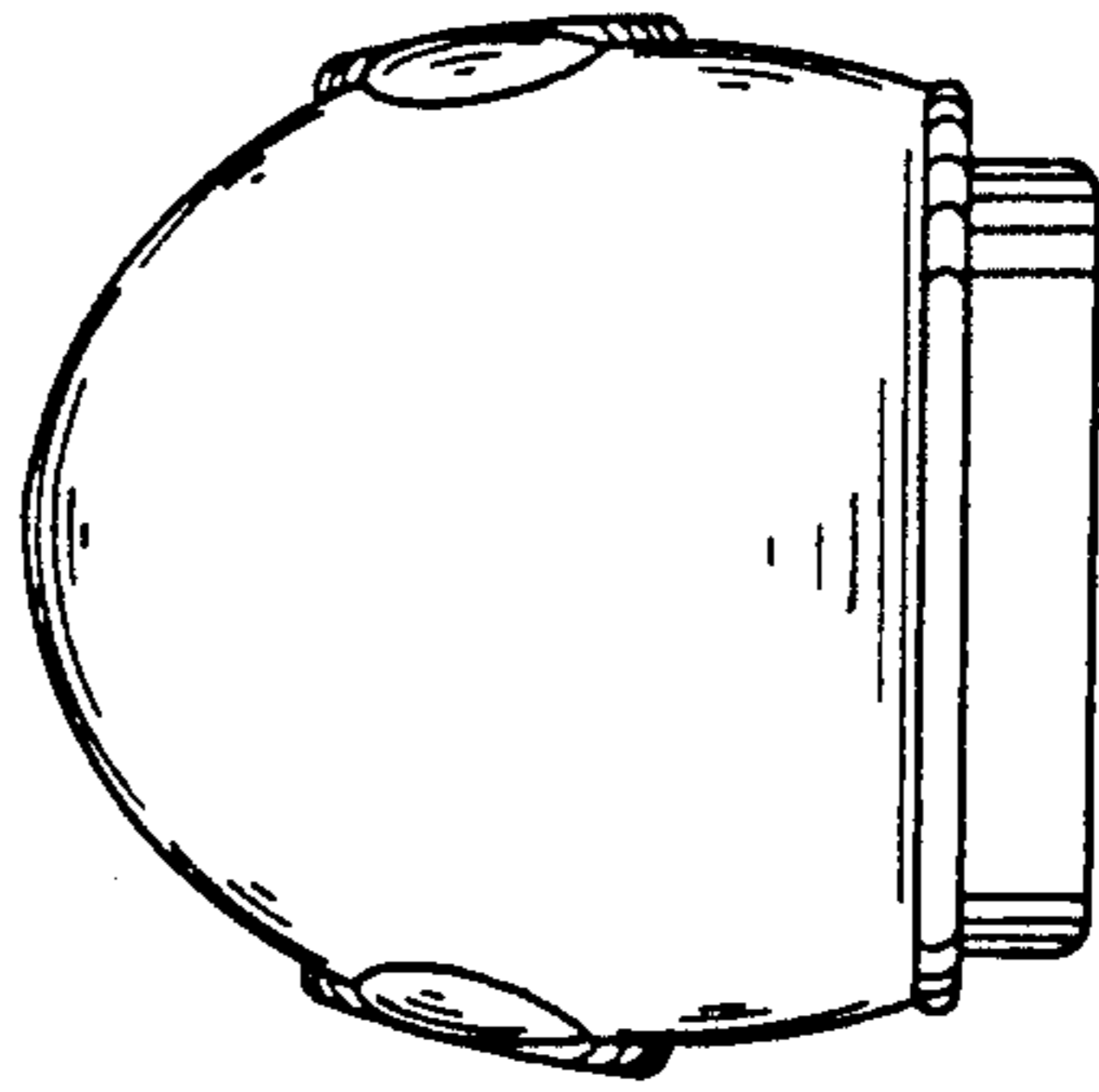

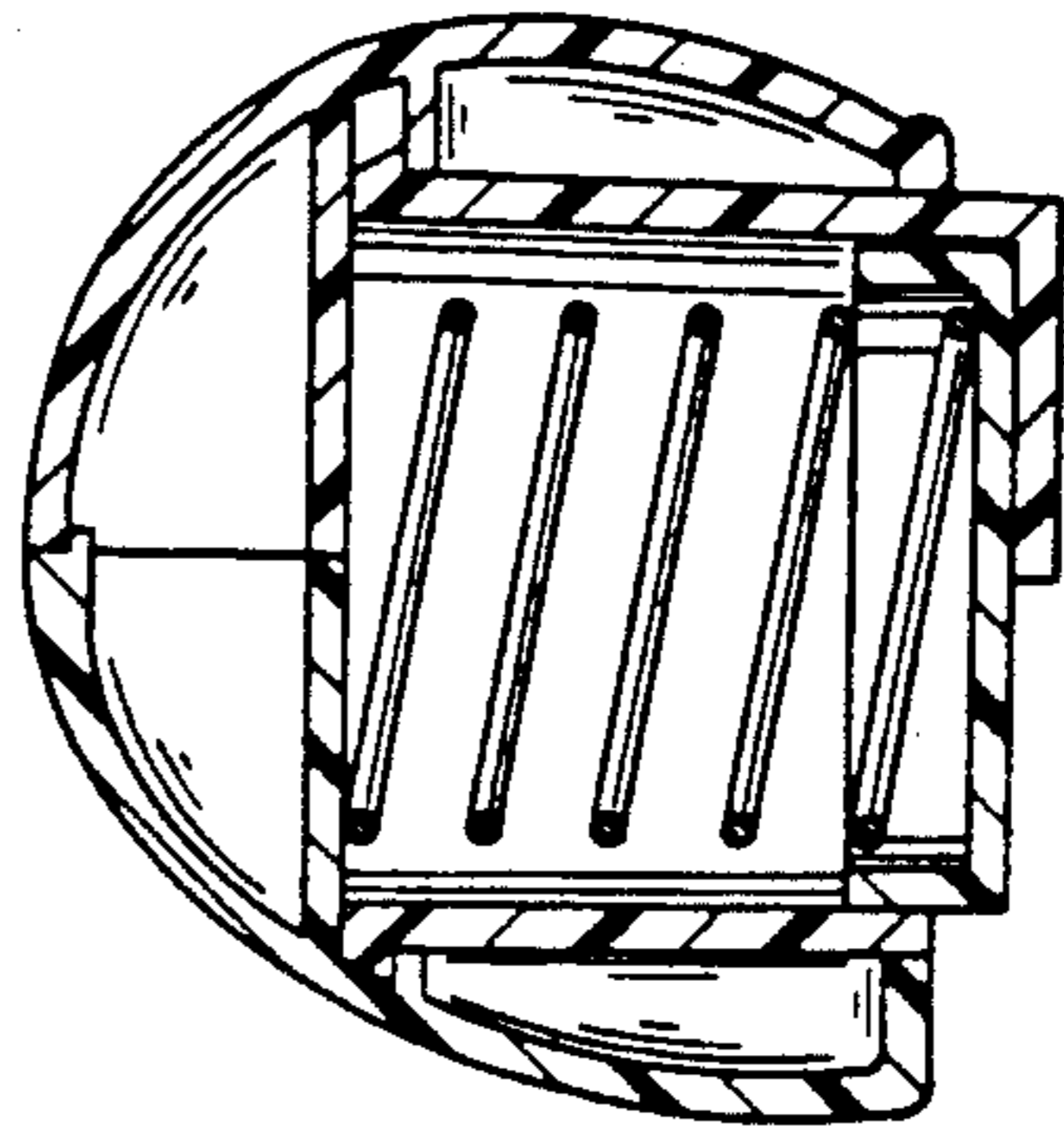

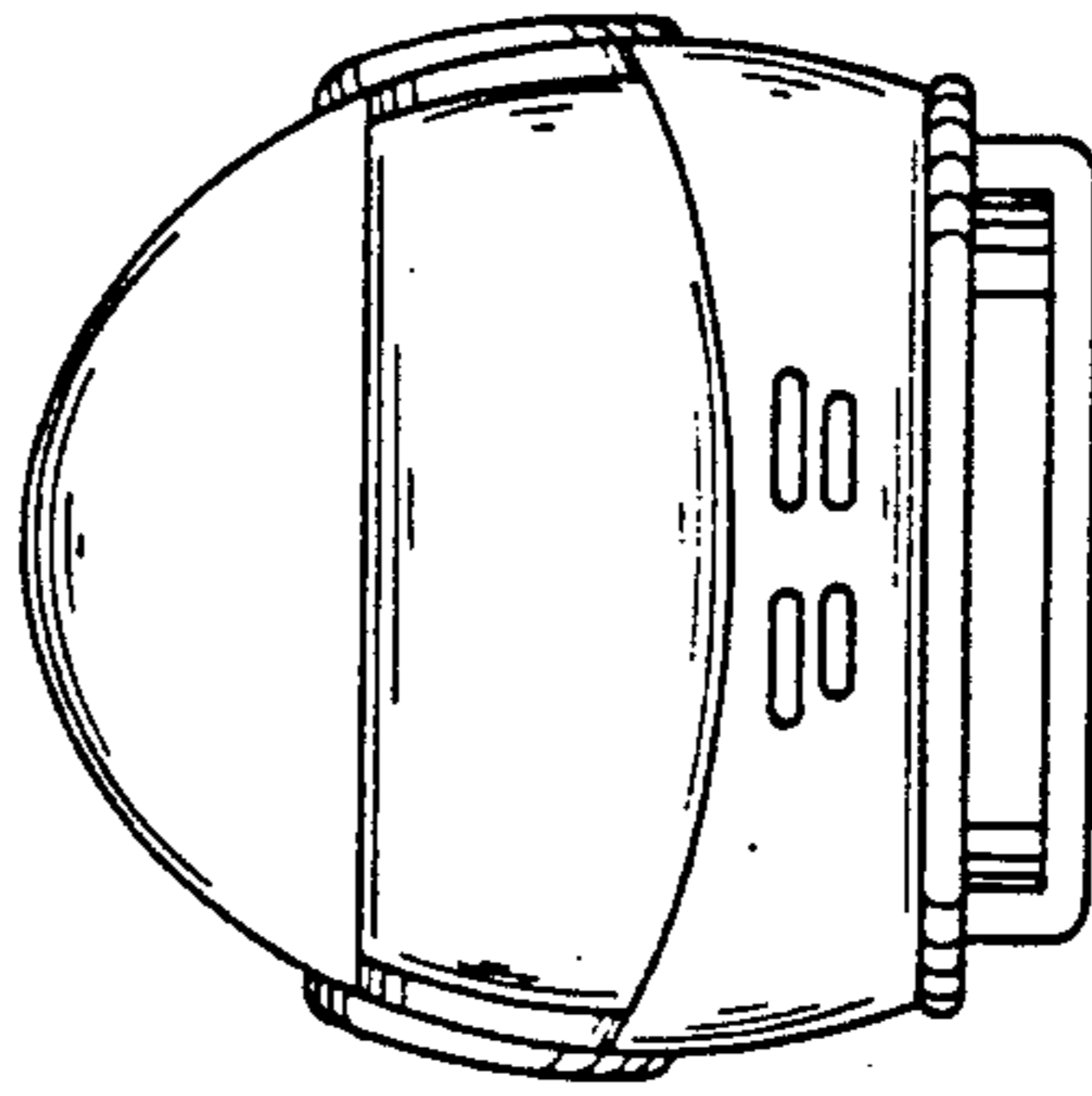
