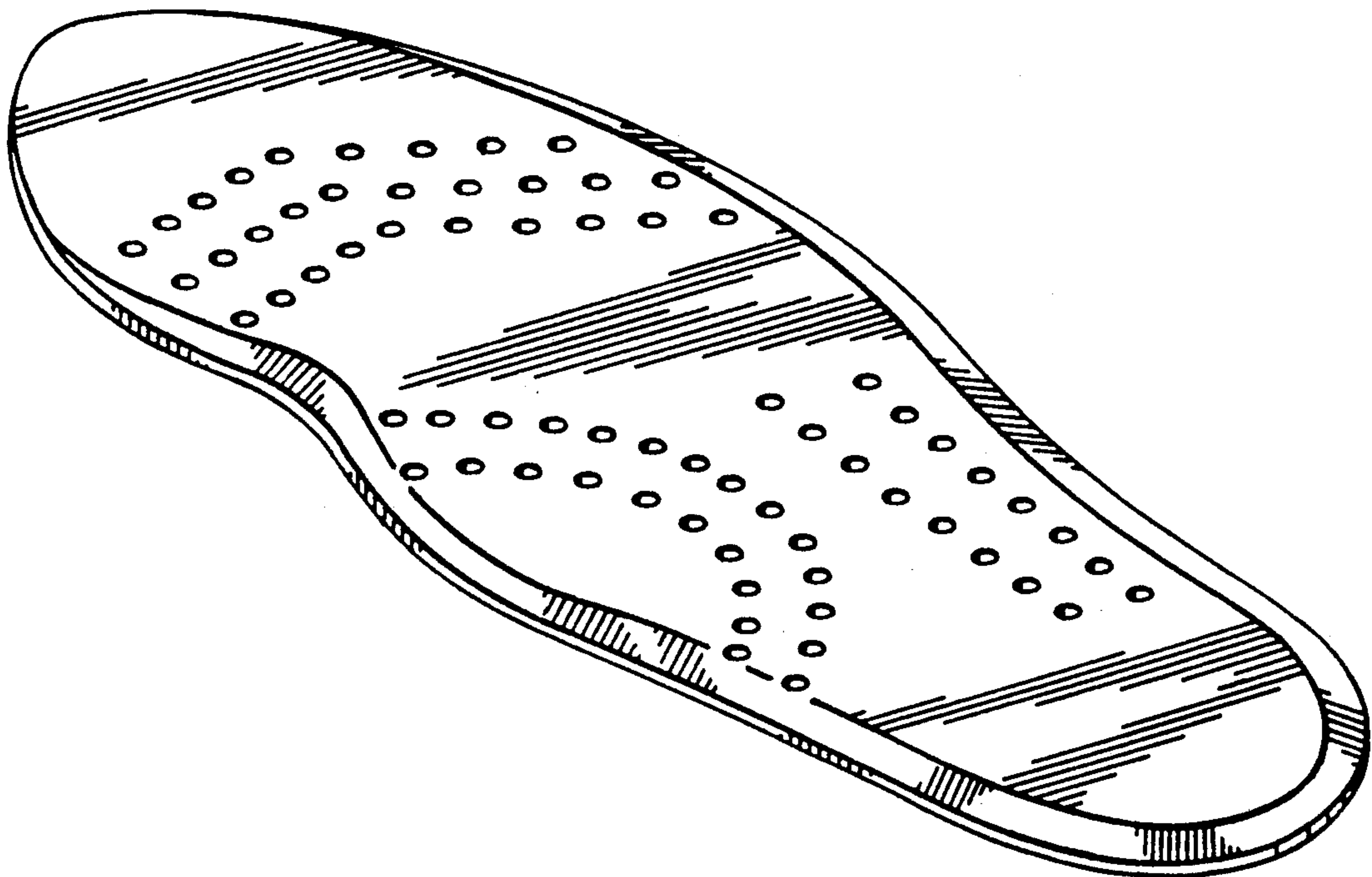

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the insole.



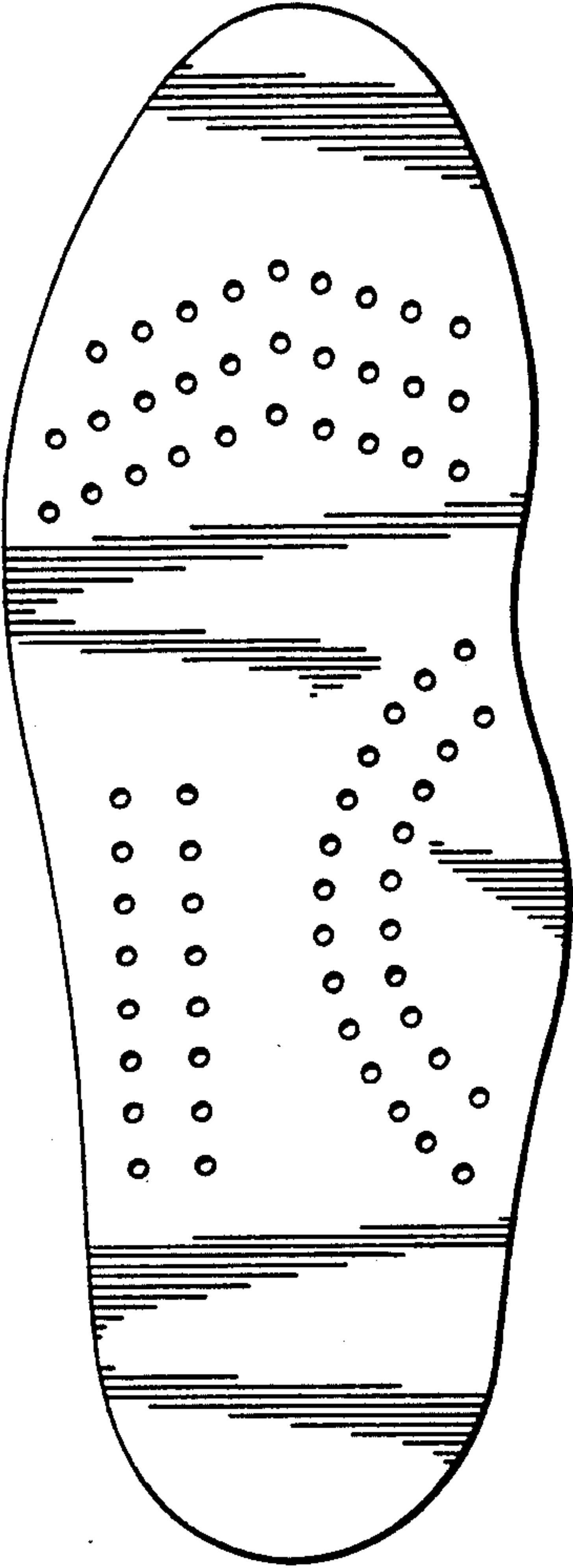

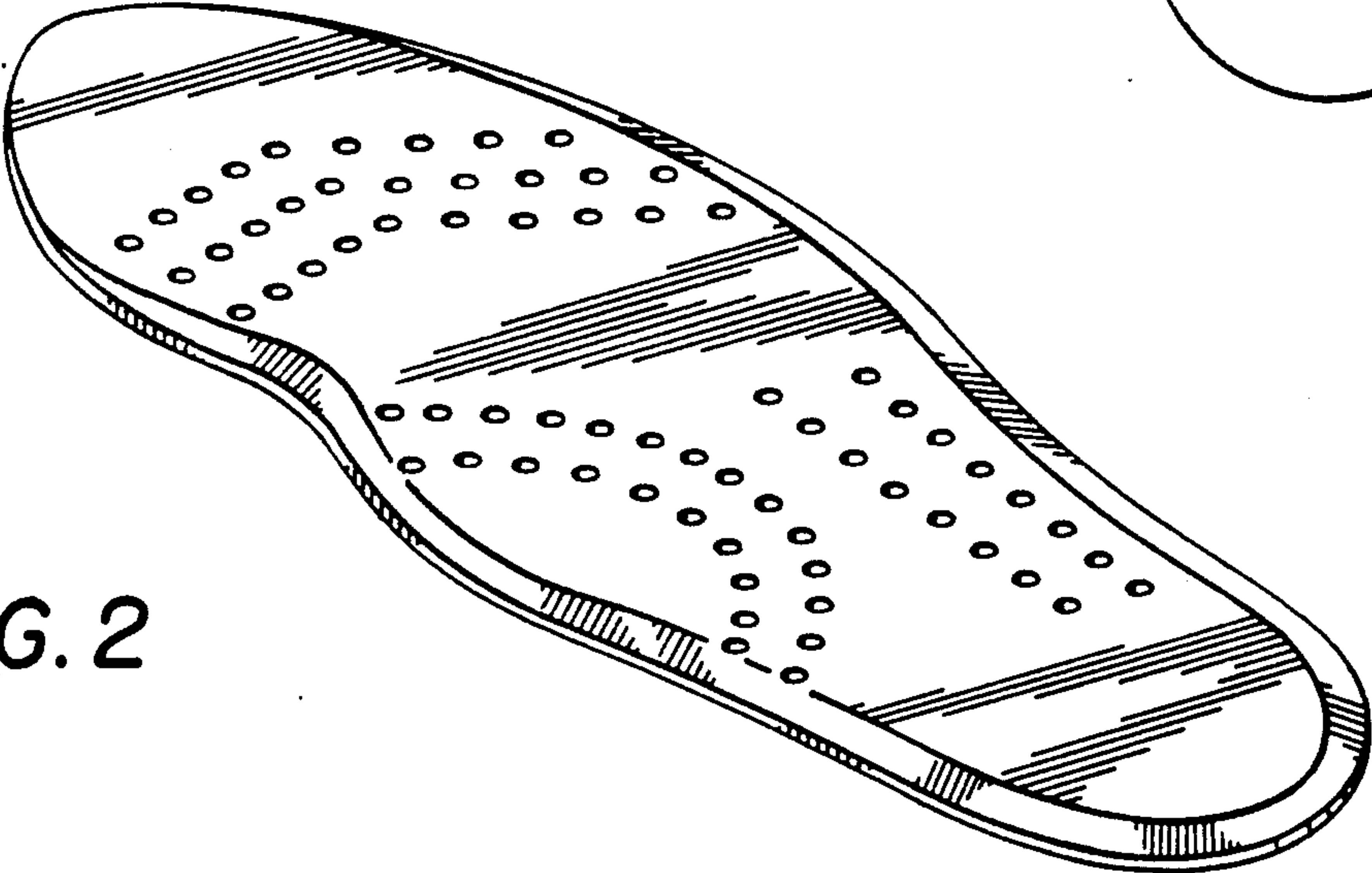

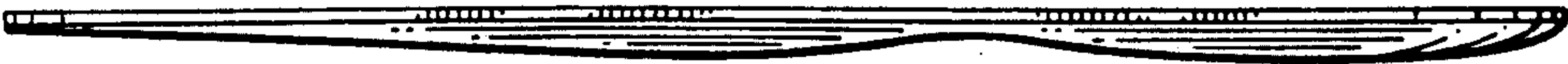
