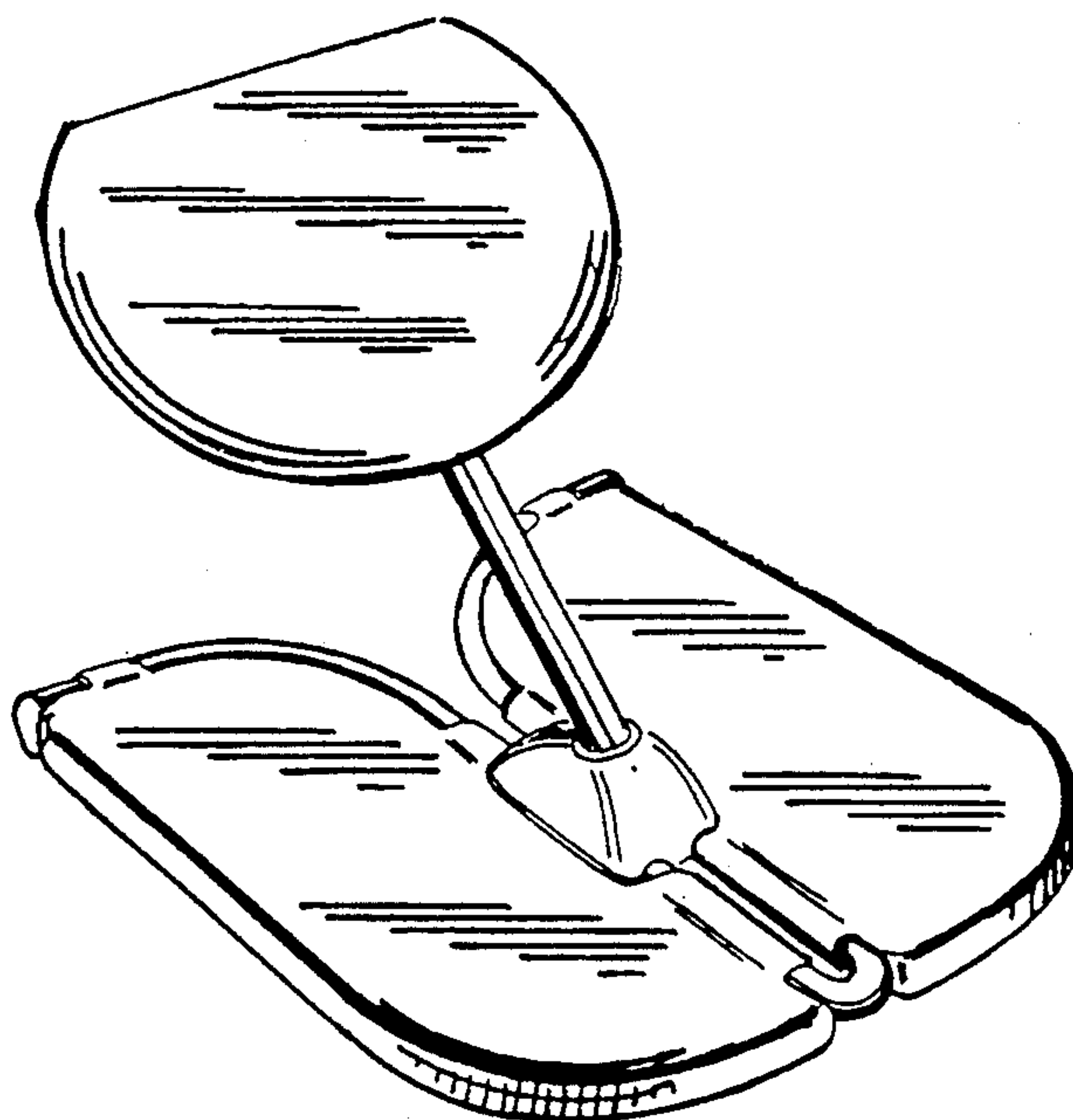

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an adjustable garden kneeler, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a view in perspective of a adjustable garden kneeler as seen from the front top and side in an open position showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a view in perspective as seen from the front top and one side in a closed position;
FIG. 3 is a view in side elevation as seen from the side opposite that shown in FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is a view in top plan thereof;
FIG. 5 is a view in bottom plan therefor;
FIG. 6 is an end elevational view; and
FIG. 7 is a view in end elevation thereof as seen from right to left of FIG. 3.



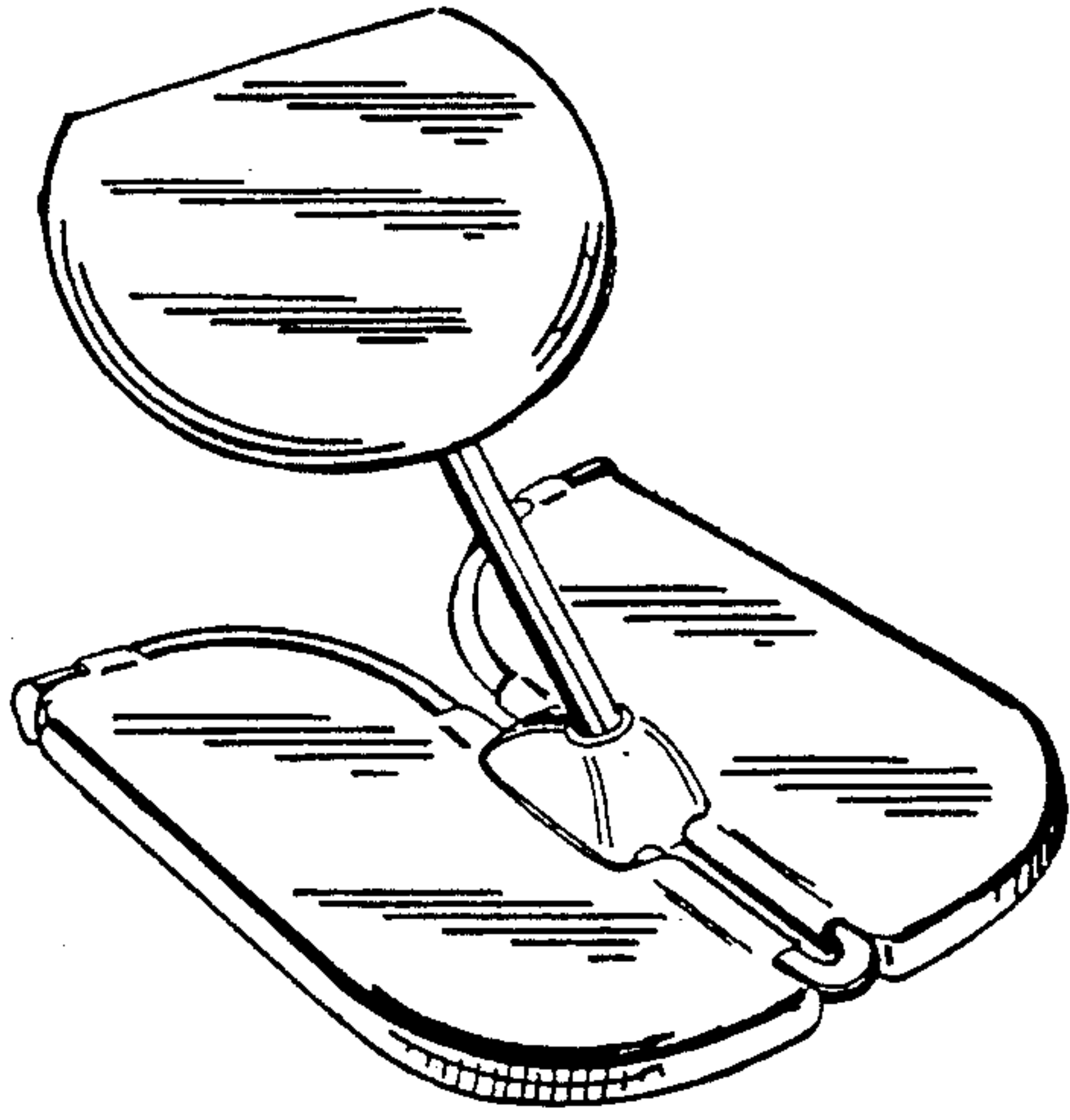

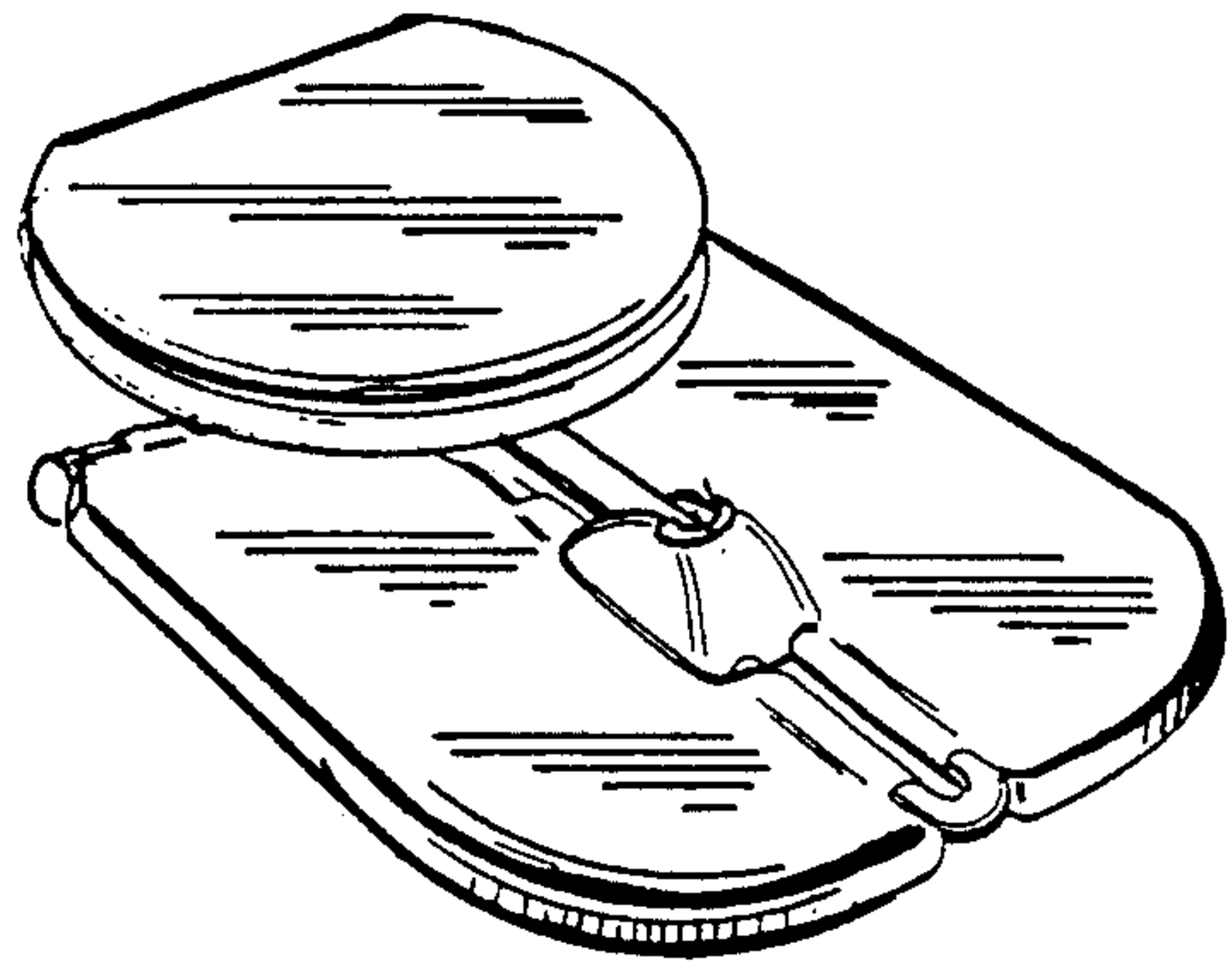

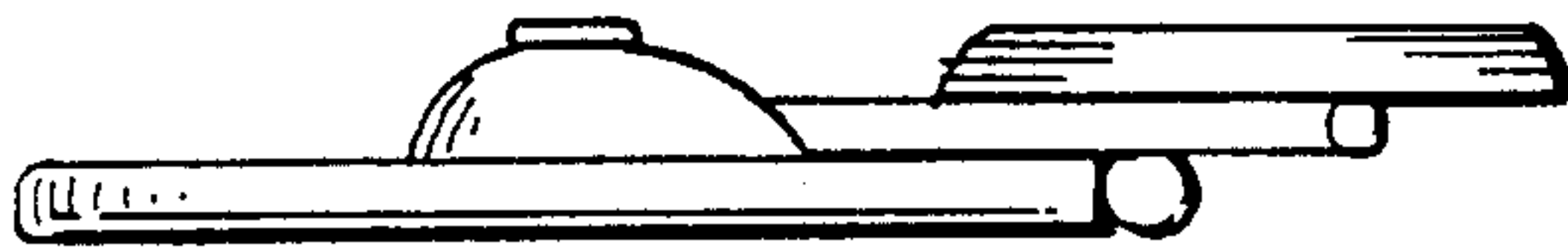

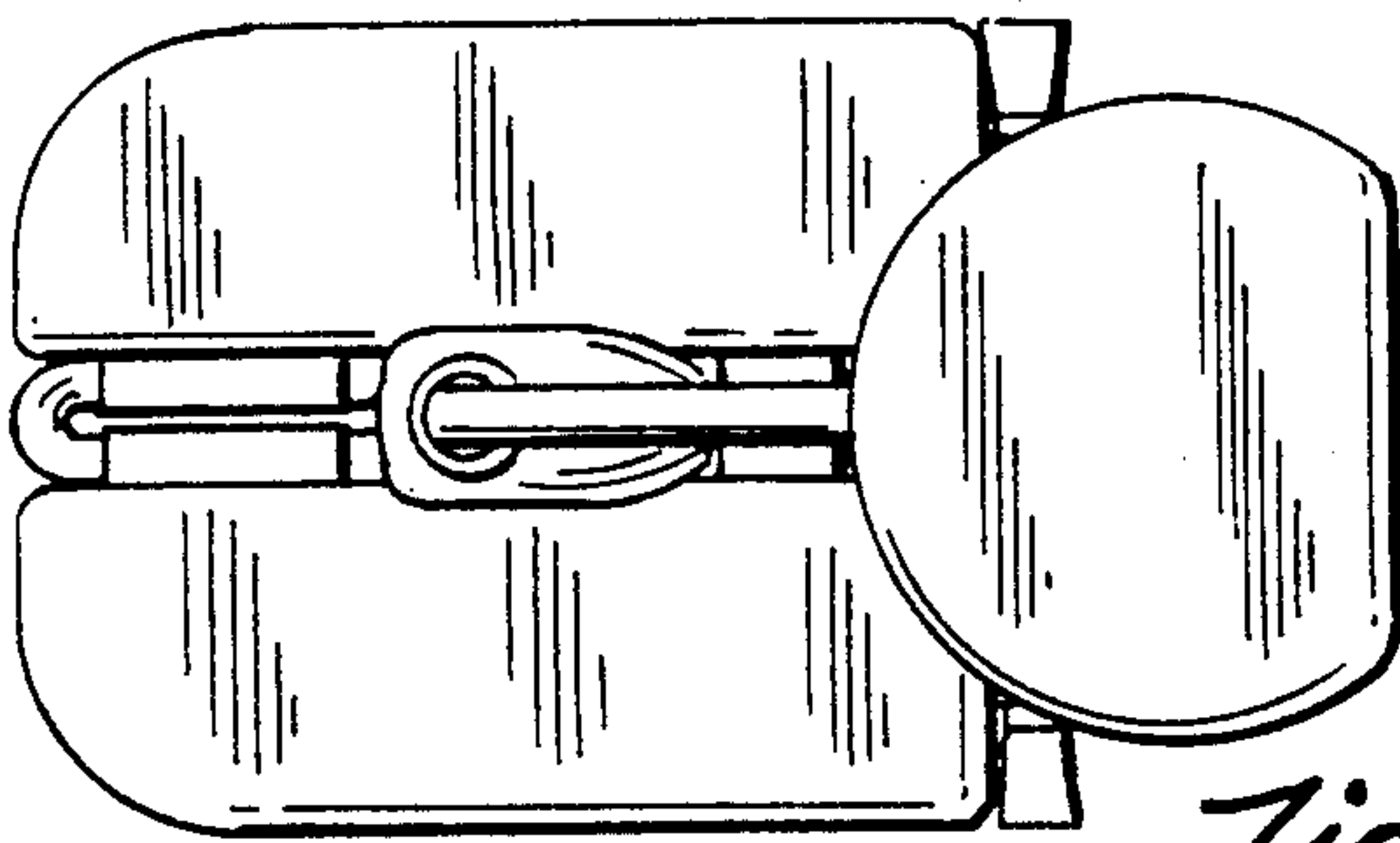

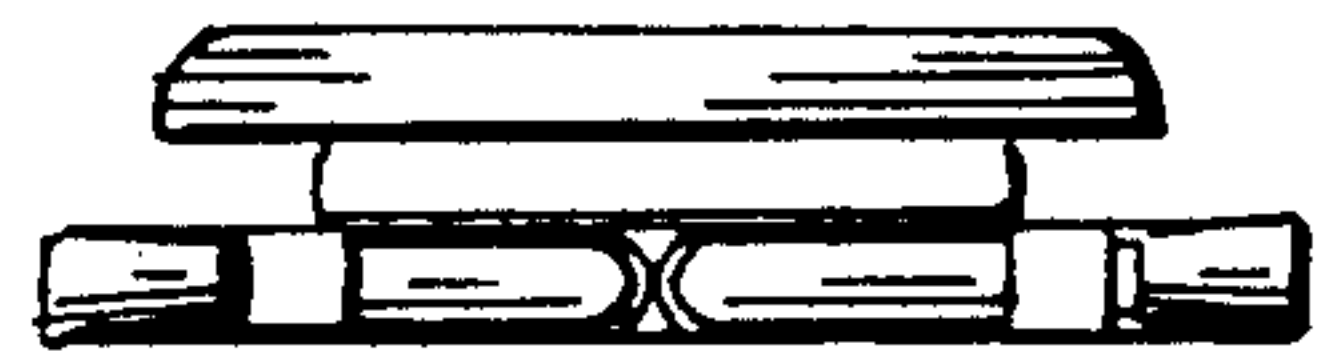

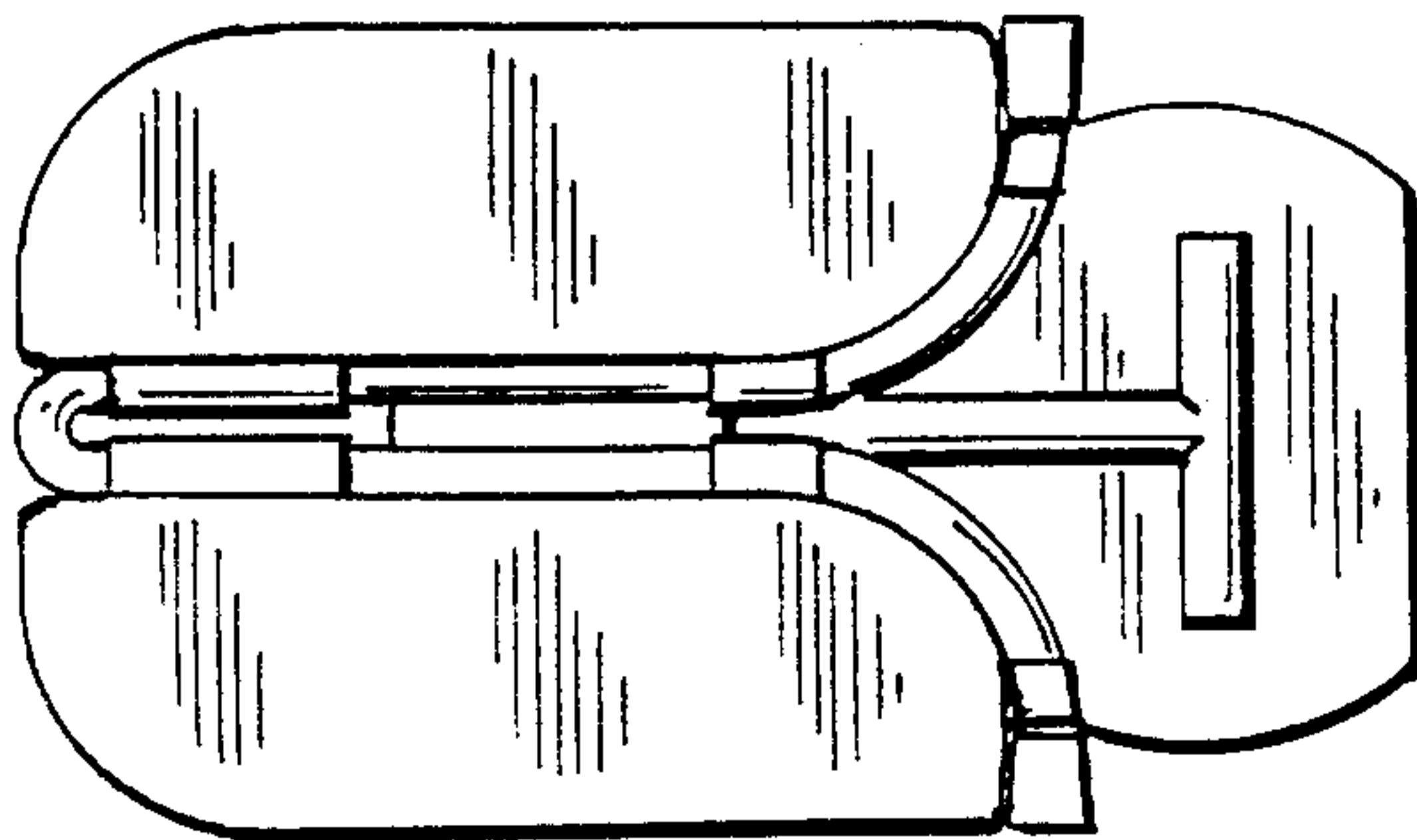
